The First American Sciences Of The Human Being

Dianetics and Scientology have grown together through seven of the highest-game years that this planet has seen in many millennia.

They have grown together. They enter the third dynamic together - side by side, yet separate.

They ARE separate and distinct, Dianetics and Scientology. Their distinctions, their individualities, are something that we of the field know intimately.

Yet now we must define these individualities - these differences - for the public. In launching an advertising campaign on the books of the two sciences, it becomes necessary to define each, and to define the relationship of each to the other.

Dianetics is the first American mental therapy. It is the first American science of the mind and body. It is possible, through use of the techniques of Dianetics, to remove the blocks in the human brain that prevent that brain from operating at or near its potential; to clear the body of its psycho-somatic attributes.

Scientology is the first American technology of Man. It is the science of the awareness of awareness. It is the technology of the full theta-mest universe. Through the techniques of Scientology it is possible to return the person himself towards his native abilities as a thetan - to increase his willingness to have, to be responsible for, and to demonstrate those abilities.

DIANETICS, The Evolution of a Science: and DIANETICS, The Modern Science of Mental Health are actually the first books of both Dianetics and Scientology. This is not determined on the fact that Modern Science of Mental Health was the first of the popular books printed - nor the fact that it was the first that many of us read. It hinges entirely on the fact that the material presented is capable of being understood at the average tone level.

Dianetics enters the case - the public - at a level where there's already know-how. It enters at mechanics - at effect.

Scientology, Fundamentals of Thought, enters the case at cause - a high, a very high level. It is well received both at a high tone level and at very low tone levels - at inversion levels of cause.

The techniques of Scientology are far simpler and more effective than Dianetic techniques. The reasoning of Dianetics is far simpler and easier to understand than the pre-logics of Scientology.

It's like the relationship between a T-model Ford and a turbo-jet. Any mechanic or teen-ager can understand the reasoning behind the T-model Ford, and can probably design a motor for one. It would be rather complicated to build.

The reasoning - the pre-logics - behind a turbo-jet require an understanding of the laws of inertia, of thermo-dynamics, of physical mathematics. Any reasonably good mechanic can build a turbo-jet after it's been designed, but it takes a high intelligence to properly design one, or to recognize its pre-logics.

Dianetics is easy of understanding, and it contains the materials of the first four dynamics, and of the parts of the ARC tone scales below cause. On the Affinity scale, it treats of the tone levels from mystery to think. On the Communications scale it treats of the tone levels from apathy to covert anger. On the Reality scale it treats of the tone levels from create to waste, substitute, waste.

Dianetics treats of the theta-mest combination that is the body and the mind. It treats of the theta-mest combination up to the point of cause. But a body cannot be cause, no matter how combined with theta. Bodies and minds are tools, vias - a computer and the android that contains and repairs and reproduces itself and gives perceptics and data to the computer. Mest cannot be, even partially, cause. Mest is created. Theta is cause.

Scientology requires knowingness for understanding of its pre-logics, for it deals with Man himself - the awareness of awareness. Scientological techniques are simple and they are rugged. They go far below and far above where the techniques of Dianetics can reach. They must be rugged, of necessity.

When dealing with theta, you are dealing with the tone scale from top to bottom, for cause is senior to and responsible for effect. When dealing with theta you are dealing from cause point. You deal with effect point, but from cause point. Scientology deals with the tone levels below cause point, but it deals with them from the points of the ARC tone scales above cause point. On the Affinity scale it deals from the tones between effort and

know, even though it reaches down to mystery. On the Communications scale it deals from the tones between overt anger and enthusiasm. On the Reality scale it deals from the tone levels between have and create, even though it reaches down to created.

Thus we have two sciences - the first American sciences of the human being; Dianetics, the science of the human mind and body; and Scientology, the science of Man - the maker and player of games.
