THE PSYCHOLOGY OF SLAVERY

The conditioning of the minds of the masses today, by ruthless, ambitious world leaders through artificial stimulation, Flying Moons, and Mutniks, has fostered the greatest crime against Man, on this earth.

America won two World Wars by the force of arms, yet lost the peace at the conference tables. Teheran, the Berlin Conferences, Geneva, Panmunjon, and Sputnik, in the space race, are a disgrace to us.

The American mind has always been conditioned to complete victory. History repeats this fact since our Revolutionary War, but today the minds of the American people are beset on every side with defeatism.

The Communistic regime, which is only a handful in comparison, controls great masses of people throughout more than a quarter of the globe. The Communist Party, in Russia, has only a membership of 6,000,000, but holds the whip hand over 200,000,000 of its own countrymen. Why?

The answer lies in the individual and collective use and training of the subconscious, or reactive minds of the masses. Its practical, psychological use began in the Western World about one hundred years ago when Mesmer endeavored to prove the influence of mind over matter by hypnosis. On the other hand, the subject has been a serious source of study for centuries in the eastern world, under the guise of religion and philosophy.

Responsibility for the struggle of control of the modern mass mind belongs to Karl Marx, Nicolai Lenin, Josef Stalin, Adolph Hitler, Joseph Goebells and Benito Mussolini. These ruthless leaders took a page from the studies of Ivan Petrovich Pavlov, the short-sighted Russian scientist and Nobel prize winner for some research in conditioned reflexes, on human consciousness, and used it for the practice of the world's greatest crime -- the enslavement of man.

The shooting of a dog into space by modern Russian scientists is only an extension of Pavlov's experiment with dogs. Furthermore, if one would take a look at the scientific progress carried on in Russia for the last hundred years it will be found that their upswing in the development of missiles and rockets came shortly after World War II when captured German scientists were put to work on this program.

Pavlov (1849-1936) was one of the first scientists of modern times to prove that the habits of the reactive mind rules the individual, the family units, masses and nations. He furthered the researches of Jackson and Sechevov in the study of human consciousness. However, since the dawn of time, the practice of controlling man through the mind has been employed by priestcraft, rulers and conquerors.

One of the basic discoveries in the western world is the power of the reactive mind to form habits and force the analytical mind (the conscious mind) of the individual to conform with these habits. The old adage "Like Father, like Son," has a deep meaning of truth. Political leaders appeal to the reactive mind of voters; business and advertising agencies know the value of forming habits in the customers' buying field.

Ancient habits still have jurisdiction over the peoples of the Far East countries through their reactive minds. The beliefs and customs of lower classes have changed astonishingly little under the impact of modern civilization because the reactive mind has a strong characteristic of its own. This is to resist any change except under dire necessity of protection for the physical body.

There are several schools of thought in the field of psychology, but in the U. S. the main interest is the Russian study of the mind, influenced by the works of Pavlov.

Pavlov was a brilliant man, though serving totalitarian governments, and his work is the basis upon which the marvelous, but vicious propaganda machines were built by Mussolini, Hitler and Stalin that created much of the grief, sorrow and fear of modern times.

While the western psychologists were first working with the study of human consciousness, Pavlov turned his attention to the animal world, selecting dogs for research on the effect of the reactive mind, and the body.

His discoveries brought forth a vast amount of writings by Pavlov, each bringing him greater fame. These studies influenced Lenin, Stalin, Mussolini and Hitler to recondition their respective peoples for world conquest. They also influenced the western school of psychology, advertising and propaganda.

Pavlov spent a lifetime experimenting with artificial reflexes in animals and human consciousness. He found that not only dogs responded to whistles, dinner bells, lights, music and other artificial stimulations but man reacted in a similar manner. As a result of this startling revelation, business, military leaders and dictators seized upon it for their own use in winning the minds of the masses.

The pattern of human behavior under the stimulus of artificial devices for establishing habits in the reactive mind of the average man gave the Communists their first great opportunity.

After their Revolution in 1917, little time was lost in replacing the national Russian symbol of the Czar, with those of the Communist Party. The mailed fist became the symbol of Russian might, and trick emotional stimulants for mass meetings, with cheering, blaring bands and weaving lights brought the masses under general control.

Those who did not respond to these conditioned reflexes were subjected to a method of terror and fear. By the use of these ruthless techniques the Russian leaders welded the mass of peoples in the Soviet into working for a common purpose -- the conquest of the world.

The Fascists took a page out of the Communists' book, and whipped the peoples of Italy into line through conditioned reflexes of their reactive minds. Mussolini strutted briefly across the pages of history trying to regain the ancient glories of Rome but failed miserably.

Adolph Hitler, late dictator of Germany, rode to power in one of the greatest feats known in the history of mass control. Engineered by the brilliant Dr. Goebells, the peoples of that nation were conditioned to become absolutely obedient to the will of der Fuhrer.

Hitler built a soon to-be-defeated robot army using mechanical, animal techniques in training the conditioned reflex-

es of the troops through marching in goose-step and a standardized saluting. He educated the will power of the German soldier until, as a unit of the troops, reacted similarly in battle.

Hitler's next ambition was world domination, but he was confronted with the problem of expansion without great loss of lives and inflicting suffering and poverty upon his own people. Then he turned to science.

A simple experiment upon a pig brought the answer. For years science had been experimenting with the consciousness of pigs to respond to various bells, lights and whistles at feeding time. To obtain its food, the pig was forced to leave its pen, run down lanes and through gates at each of which a different bell, light, sound or smell gave it artificial stimulation as it entered the gates.

So the pigs became bundles of artificial or conditioned reflexes, and the experiments came to a halt for there was nothing more to learn from their subject. Then someone decided to change the food boxes and shuffle the stimulation into new patterns.

When the experiment was run again the pigs did their best to work through the confusion but met with constant frustration and defeat. Finally, they gave up and retired to the pen and refused to move again. Examination showed the pigs had indications of a slight, nervous breakdown.

This gave the dictators their answer. The reaction of the pigs were similar to that of people of ordinary intelligence when confused. They reasoned that the ignorant were less complicated than the learned and had less ability to resist artificial conditions. They had now learned that man took life's obstacles in stride when things were reasonably normal, but when issues became too confused he sat down, did nothing, and had somewhat of a nervous breakdown.

This was a weapon of mighty strength for the totalitarians. With it the Russian Geopolitics began a careful plan of alternating periods of peace and threats of war with the free world. For over a period of forty years the following pattern has kept the peoples of the western nations off balance: 1917-21, a period of hate; 1922-28, a period of love; 1928-41, a period of hate; 1941-45, a period of love; 1946-55, a period of hate, and since that period a race for control of the outer space has caused the Russian leaders to keep rattling the saber with open arms of love.

Hitler developed this master deception. His promises of peace, followed by terrible threats of war, worked easily, for the world could not understand him. The peoples in the western nations went around in circles, got in one another's way, and finally like the pig, sat down unable to do anything until Hitler forced them.

Lenin called the Russian bag of tricks "Tactics of Zizagging". He said, "Be one day an internationalist, next day, a nationalist, conservative, or revolutionist, orthodox, or Mohammedan, Pan-Slavic, or Pan Arabic."

His planning brought results, for since 1939 approximately some five million square miles of land and some 1250 million peoples have come directly or indirectly under the Red influence, including the Suez Canal, and maybe the Moon if the western nations don't speed up their satellite program.

The pressurized propaganda which builds the habits of reacting under artificial stimulation confused the people so that they have been forced into accepting defeat. To build an attitude of defeat into the minds of the enemy is the constant goal of the dictators.

Fortunately for the human race there are capable individuals who, like L. Ron Hubbard, founder of Scientology, leader of one of the many groups, are working to help man free himself from such ruthless control. Freedom from artificial conditioning of ingrained reflexes against enslavement of the reactive mind makes such individuals dangerous to the totalitarians. Scientology can undo, fortunately, the poison of psychology the mass-mind has been fed.

But mass psychology as invented by Pavlov, used by Hitler and Stalin and totally subscribed to by our own modern universities, may be good for dictators but it has never been anything but chaos to people. The only defense developed against it is Scientology, an American development.

The interest of science in helping man to understand himself is turned against him in the greatest crime known in history -- "modern psychology". But strangely the error of truth does not remain in man's mind too long. Sooner or later this error is cast out and the masses of people, under the leadership of those who resist enslavement rise up to destroy the false Gods of the dictators.

Then man is left with freedom to work out his own destiny.
