past, which are either a repetition of things so learnt that they have become almost automatic, or the breaking down of psycho-mental crystallizations. Positive accomplishments, on the contrary, are things which constitute a constructive step forward, the birth of a new faculty.

This problem of orientation along lines of cleavage touches the very roots of astrological symbolism. We can never understand an astrological chart save on the basis of those diametrical relationships which link opposite houses, and to a lesser extent, signs. The essen tial quadrature of a chart, the vertical and horizontal lines formed by horizon and meridian, is the key to all the deeper types of astrological interpretations; for here we deal with the most primordial process of cell-segmentation and multiplication. Every growth, every manifestation of life takes place along certain axes; and while the conventional axes of space (North, South, East, West, Zenith, Nadir) form the structure of the development of individual selfhood, the nodal axes (or lines of nodes) give us the directional forces of Destiny.

This is true above all of the Moon nodes axis; but also, in a less obvious way, of all planetary nodes. Every planet represents a particular quality of the whole life-process, and thus a psychological function. The nodal axis of the planet stands for the main line of stress in the development of that quality. In more trivial terms, things will happen along that line—insofar as this quality is concerned. The characteristics of the two houses affected by this "line of stress" will indicate what departments of life, what phases of individual selfhood will experience the strain. The zodiacal signs involved will tell something of the way in which the planetary quality operates on earth at a particular time—especially if the symbolical meaning of the nodal degrees themselves is taken into consideration.

The axis constituted by the Moon nodes is most vital because it deals with the very process of individuation. Here we see at work the forces which try to integrate the particular "I" and the greater Self, the lunar and the solar selves; the faculty of assimilating new substance of living and of rejecting the values which are no longer useful because they have been shorn of all that was of vital necessity for the individual personality. We may even go so far as to say that there we have a line of metabolic action, not unlike that tubular channel which stretches from mouth to anus. At the north node life is being absorbed, the substance of experience is being ingested and reduced to assimilable material; at the south node we assimilate the contents of life, automatically, effortlessly, and eliminate the refuse.

In this physiological illustration the earth stands for the diaphragm. Above the diaphragm is the North node realm, below, the South node realm. The former represents the new foodstuffs and the active process of digestion; the latter the old food now digested and being assimilated, turned into automatic instinctual activity—plus the rejection of unassimilable residue. Marc Jones calls the Moon's nodes axis, the "fate axis." But undoubtedly the digestive axis, including stomach, bowels, etc., is the "fate axis" of our body—a real fatality for most of us!

This illustration, however, is not altogether perfect. In a more general sense the North node represents the point where a particular entity absorbs or receives the substance of life. It is the channel through which the power of integration (which is Life) enters the earth and her inhabitants; for there the Moon becomes a vase into which solar life is poured and from which it flows to our planet. On the contrary, the South node is the point where the Moon becomes the automatic distributor (and ejector) of the earth-assimilated force that was once solar. At the South node the Sun and the Moon are absolutely unrelated. The Moon scatters at the South node, and focalizes at the North node. Thus integration (at the North pole of the axis) and disintegration (at the South pole): or indrawing and distribution. *Progress* is made at the North node through exertion. *Habit* is established at the South node through automatism, based on repetition.

If we should lie along the nodal axis we would look into the future facing North, and accept the past facing South. The North node deals, therefore, with the work to be done, the new accomplishment, the new faculty to be developed: and if we are willing to exert ourselves in that direction, from it we shall receive power in abundance. The South node represents the work that has been done, the well-known accomplishment, the routine performance already gone through many times, perhaps—the easy way out. Thus the opposition between: on one hand self-integration, individuation, effort, the line of greatest connection through exertion—and on the other, self-undoing, automatism, inertia, the line of least resistance.

The South node is always in any chart a wonderful index of the line of least resistance; especially through its house-position. But what do we mean by the line of least resistance, if not that of easy performance? Ease in turn depends on prior repetition of similar performances, which repetition built a habit, or an instinct. What is easy to do is that which we as reincarnating individual souls or as the endpoint of a long chain of hereditary transmission, have done before. It represents thus a past achievement. It indicates that an adequate and efficient instrumentality has been built in the past, that a faculty or tendency has been inherited at birth, for the acquire-

ment of which we have not had to struggle consciously.

It must be clear that such an inherited gift or instinct is not evil, and therefore that the South node in a chart does not have of itself an evil or destructive significance. If it has been called the point of "self-undoing" it is because we have so often a way of following the line of least resistance, that is of keeping to the thing already well known, to the performance in which we can display ourselves most advantageously. By so doing we refuse to progress, to move on to new achievements. We become slave to our great natural gift. Instead of using this natural ability in terms of a new type of development it "runs away with us"—and leads us to our own undoing. If we are controlled by our inborn abilities instead of controlling them, we miss the main purpose of our life.

If the North node is a point of reception of spiritual power, the South node is by no means a symbol of impotency. It is, however, a symbol of mal-adjustment to new conditions. It signifies inborn faculty, but usually we find that life to some extent forbids us the use of that faculty. It belongs to the past in some way, and unless we make it subservient to a new purpose and rather rigidly control it, it will hamper the correct growth of a new vital faculty; one which represents our next step.

On the other hand, when we consider the type of faculty characterized by the North node's position, we find that life forces us in many ways constantly to develop it. Life calls for that power—and is willing to shower it upon us if we exert ourselves in this direction; if we open up a channel. Every effort made in that direction will be usually well repaid—unless we stick stubbornly all the while to the attitude represented by the South node. We may do it unconsciously, if we take care not to do so consciously. If so, a psychological complex is bound to develop. The present will be hopelessly torn between past and future. Then impotency will be the result. And we will experience the tragedy of "fate." The past will have to die before the future may live. And we will find ourselves deprived of our inborn gift by some stroke of destiny; because we had become identified with it, lost in it, "undone" by it. Thus truly our "self-undoing."

One of the simplest examples we could give is that of the nodes in the fourth and tenth houses. Here we have an opposition between home and profession, private and public life. If the North node is in the tenth, public life and the profession will be the channel to self-integration. The South node in the fourth house will indicate that the native has a congenital pull toward the building of a home, and this may cause him to shrink from public life. If he shrinks too much, his home life

will turn destructive. It will disintegrate in his hands even though he runs back to it yearningly, hopelessly. If, on the contrary, he works intently on his professional ideal, he may be able to make of his home (in the largest sense of the term) and of his own concrete basis of selfhood the true foundation for his public life.

The operation of the nodes is not always easy to detect by merely being acquainted with the native. Most of us hide carefully the fact that we are following the line of least resistance. We hide it mostly from ourselves. And the apparent ease with which we may perform certain types of actions may lead us to believe that we should keep on performing them. In some cases we should; but then the meaning we attribute to them would have to be different. Here, as in every case dealing with a spiritual appreciation of behavior, what counts is not the act itself, but the motive behind or within the act.

A study of the Moon nodes helps us greatly to probe our own motives as well as those of others. For, confronted with many situations, we may put our actions and reactions to the acid test of nodal polarities. Did we follow in this situation the line of least resistance or the line of greatest integration? The nodes will tell us when we have the most chances of "fooling ourselves." Possibly even, in horary charts, we may be able to find quite accurately what is our true motivation in a particular instance. But the reading of horary charts in such a psychological way is a rare art indeed, which but a very few will ever be able to master.

In addition, it seems demonstrable that the houses in which the planets' nodes fall may also give us an insight into the polarities of the planets' action. As these nodes are changing but very slowly, this however would only add significance to certain zodiacal areas or degrees. If the area of Gemini ten to fifteen is in the fourth house, Venus' and Uranus' North nodes are also in this same house. The opposition between private and public life can then be said to apply as an undertone of the Venus and Uranus qualities in the native. In the writer's chart the Venus and Uranus North nodes area is on the Descendant; so that the nodal axis of these planets practically coincided with the horizon at birth. The Venus and Uranus forces are very active in his life; and curiously enough these two planets definitely characterize his closest life-associates (seventh house).

We must now conclude these few tentative remarks by expressing the hope that they may be sufficient to arouse interest in a set of astrological symbols, the psychological value of which cannot be overestimated.

### Saturn in Aquarius

"But me—I am one of the rabble."—Jerry Buckley

Saturn going through a sign may limit that sign for a time as well as any planet he contacts, but after he has completed his housecleaning or process of elimination of all unnecessary and even harmful excess, that sign and planet are brought into full and concrete manifestation and thereafter the principles they represent are well organized and directed toward a definite and objective goal—in short, that sign or planet through Saturn's severe disciplinarian measures is made to find its true place in the sphere of life, individually or col-

lectively.

An example of the former would be Saturn transiting over the radical Jupiter. Let us say that prior to this transit the native had felt the need of a true religion for himself, as he had wandered from his original faith and felt a lack of faith or religious elements in his make-up. The ninth house is the department governing religion and in this particular instance we will say that the sign Capricorn fills this department, therefore Saturn himself would control and direct the religious and philosophic principles in this life. Jupiter however, representing the religious urges, is in Aquarius, usurping by sign Uranus in Sagittaries, eighth house. latter configurations would tend to stimulate the native's curiosity and attract him toward unusual or "different" religions, interests and pursuits-Uranus in Sabittaries makes one intensely curious, his natives always seeking to know the reason for everything, and this particular eighth house Uranus would excite curiosity about and deep interest in strange, hidden or secret things—like Pandora this native would find it difficult to resist opening the forbidden box. He would be drawn irresistibly to the unusual in all eighth house matters—to "occult cults" and orders, drawing Jupiter into his often weird interests, exciting the wrath of poor old Saturn who, with his strong power and knowledge of rulership of his own ninth house religious domain bears down on Jupiter in no gentle manner. How dare Jupiter over-step his bounds and be drawn into these forbidden and to his conservative mind "devil" realms into which no mortal should ever think of seeking entrance? And, as Saturn is always the stern disciplinarian, he takes his native figuratively by the "scuff of the neck" and shoves his head into these supposedly mystic premises,

showing him such terrifying sights that he, the native, is henceforth turned away from further interest in "occult lore"—completely cured. "Go back and find the faith of your childhood—your original faith," Saturn finally manages to convey to him, and when understanding has at length penetrated into his consciousness the native only too willingly obeys, glad to escape with a sane mind and a sound body, and promising earnestly never to again concern himself with things in which he, as a particular individual, is not supposed to delve, finding thereafter his joy in simple things, leaving the Temples of Mystery to the more elite,

"Going the way the faithful ones have trod,
Or as a young lamb fares upon the meres;

Not burning with the world's exalted fire,

But humble when he goes to meet his God." For the indications in that particular horoscope pointed directly to such simple faith, and Saturn was forced by these drastic methods to teach his native what he most needed to know in order to find his true destiny-normal love and happiness. But, before Saturn passes on, his duty accomplished, he brings first into direct and concrete manifestation the constructive, wholesome, optimistic, generous, humanitarian phases of Jupiter in Aquarius that they may thereafter blend with his own staid, commonsensible, stabilizing principles, and thus create what the native had sought—an ideal religion one that shall not destroy the constructive part of the new but rather embrace it, taking in much

broader territory than previously.

In the same way would Saturn bring out the desirable elements of any other planet—I say "desirable" with due respect to persons, for what is one's meat can well be another's poison, and a nativity must be carefully studied to determine what is "taboo" and what isn't. Transiting the planet Venus, Saturn would tend to bring to the native that "greatest thing in the world"-love. Through extreme tests and experiences the affections would tend to become definitely concentrated upon some worthy person, the character and nature of whom would be indicated by the position of Venus in the horoscope both by sign, house position and aspects. Of course this might materialize as a new love, or the old one might well be revived and thereafter fully appreciated under Saturn's transit. It would be expected that Saturn passing over Venus would not be nearly as harsh in his treatment as he would be over Jupiter, for Jupiter and Saturn are natural enemies and Venus—well, every planet harmonizes with Venus, although the nature of these two are vastly different. In any case the native would find true and lasting love through their contact and would not feel the inclination to become romantically interested elsewhere for a long, long time, if ever. For when Saturn brings love it is real and enduring—it's something definite and worthwhile, and could be expected to bring great and powerful benefits into the life through the influence of the new person, or through the old one in new ways.

In a more universal or collective sense, Saturn in Aquarius should eventually organize and protect the great majority—the "common herd." It may indeed seem to those who occupied official positions and to those who made sacrifices and worked painstakingly year after year to retain their places that the "rabble" have grown very selfish and extremely assertive of what they consider their rights, but it is the wheel of justice that is turning temporarily in their favor that eventually an equitable balance or adjustment may be made and maintained.

Saturn and what he symbolizes is good, unless carried to extremes as when under heavy affliction, in which latter case he often causes undue restraint and intolerance, denying his natives even ordinary pleasures, looking with belittling contempt upon persons who possess the lighter and happier Venusian traits, depreciating the value of opinions of the types of character different from his own-not realizing that each person should be himself and never a copy of somebody else, that the buttercup should not aspire to be the daisy, but should be the best buttercup it possibly can. Saturn under affliction can also cause his natives to sacrifice present happiness and enjoyment through a stern and rigid sense of duty, through fear of future punishment or for worldly or practical reasons. Even the virtues of Saturn may be carried to excess inasmuch as they might stop all progress by causing people to blindly cling to old forms and worn-out customs to the exclusion of a newer, brighter, more uplifting, progressive and constructive philosophy of life.

As Aquarius is the humanitarian sign, the ruler of which is considered by most authorities to be the progressive and trail-blazing Uranus, Saturn in this sign is bringing into concrete evidence some very original and progressive social ideas by engendering into them some of his practical basic and fundamental philosophy, without which they are but abstract visions "waiting and aware," and Saturn is just the fellow to "bring them down" to earth—organize them, make them solid and substantial and endow them with form, life, energy and power.

This is the first time, since the birth of the Aquarian Era, that Saturn has transited Aquarius under such significant configurations.

An eclipse in this part of Aquarius is said to mean "a change in all things" and, as the twentieth degree of Aquarius is that of faith and religion, Saturn passing over that degree in sextile aspect to Uranus, the ruler of the sign wherein Saturn is transiting, with the eclipse falling within orb should, while having apparently destructive effects at first, ultimately bring constructive and progressive changes and enduring benefits to humanity in religious and philosophic interests. The sign and aspects of the eclipse should eventually help to redeem the greatly misunderstood and long-suppressed "rabble herd" that they may have their chance and find their true place in the Sun. Saturn is materializing as a spirit of friendliness, tolerance and comradeship, and this divine radiance is pervading all who have "hearts to feel with, eyes to see."

It is said, "There is nothing permanent but change." The coming year should bring many changes, financial as well as social and religious ones. Uranus, the accepted ruler of Saturn's present abode, is close now to Taurus, the financial and material sign. A new system of financial exchange is forthcoming wherein money shall no longer be used as a medium of control. Perhaps our money as it stands today won't be worth so much. At any rate there will be much reorganizing done in this department. But let us, even if we be millionaires, meet the New Age smilingly, glad that we have youth in our hearts, though we be ninety, for youth welcomes changes and advancement. It is today that matters—not yesterday, not tomorrow. "One world at a time," said a dying philosopher. "Make the most of what we now may spend," said a more alive one. The future grows automatically out of the present, so let us live to the best of our ability the NOW—the eternal Today, right here on this good old solid earth.

And, just as the greatest Saviour of all time mingled with the common people, picked the uneducated fishermen for his disciples, had a kindly word and wish for the poor and unfortunate, even to the lowliest thief, so is Saturn in Aquarius materializing as humane and compassionate leaders of the masses—and one in particular has begun the great work of organizing and redeeming the "rabble"—the downtrodden and misunderstood "common herd"—that under his sane and sensible guidance their positions may henceforth be established as worthy and faithful members of society.

As it only requires a little kindness, love and faith to perform a miracle—and Saturn in Aquarius really possesses these, and more—the last may be first, the worst the best, under his new order!

For this Saturn is not cold and aloof—"not in lone splendor flung aloft the night," but a friendly star that is scattering his gifts among the "rabble" and regenerating with vital meaning the memorial words of another great Aquarian President—"All men are created equal."

### Kabbalism of American History

PART IV
1863 and The Reconstruction

The numbers of the nation for the decade of 1863 tell a story not to be found in the dusty arid pages of the historian. It was to writhe under the iron heel of a dictatorship for ten frightful years. The prevailing view has ever been that the policy of reconstruction was a hateful, unspeakable, and unnecessary one for the victor to pursue. But had a milder course been taken, who can doubt that the reunion of the nation would have been prolonged indefinitely if not forever defeated? But not for more than six decades were the embers of hate inherited of it to be extinguished, and that in 1928 when the politically solid South was finally broken.

Gettysburg really ended the war, following hard on the Emancipation Proclamation of January 1, 1863. Blockaded and bankrupt, the Confederacy expended its last reserves and ammunition at Chattanooga with disastrous results. Its ragged forces were scattered. Bragg retreated into Georgia, to be shortly succeeded by Joseph E. Johnson. Longstreet joined Lee in Virginia. Grant marched on Richmond, while Sherman swept away the last remnants of the rebellion in Georgia and the Carolinas. But after Chattanooga it was simply a matter of Lee's endurance, for which he has ever been honored, whatever the merit and however forlorn his cause.

Here it may be speciously observed that the ruin and devastation which thereupon followed were all below the Mason and Dixon line. So it was, and just so is that provincial view at the root of all the political and economic diseases with which before and since has this nation been afflicted. The war and reconstruction, for all its localization in the southern states, blighted a large section of the nation's body. Notwithstanding the frightful experience of this period we have yet to learn that the body of a nation, as in the body of a person, is just as sick in the whole as the affliction of any of its member parts can make it. The South was thoroughly whipped, yet vengeance carried on in a crescendo of horror that has not been exceeded in modern history. Nevertheless, the worst that could be written about the Reconstruction show it to have been not too dear a price to pay for what was gained. Temporization and tolerance are not the resources of a youthful race. The victorious Union realized that the permanence of peace depended on stamping out every spark of the rebellion without mercy, otherwise its roots

would have continued to sprout trouble for the Government as long as one militant rebel remained. And violent differences on this policy brought about the weirdest period of our history—the administration of Andrew Johnson and the two of U. S. Grant.

In the octave numbers for the decade of '63, the third number of the national trinity becomes the fourth number of the decade. Arcanum IV, Scorpio, of the BODY POLITIC, takes command of the NATION'S BUSINESS. Thus Aries (First number and GENIUS of the NATION) manifests through Scorpio. The spirit of the people speaks its implacable language. "A terrible determination (Stevenson's "An American History") had become the keynote of the prosecution of the war. It was embodied in no one more completely than by the Federal Secretary of War, Edwin M. Stanton, a man of iron who had great executive ability. Under his able management the vast resources of the North were fully utilized. The generals needed only to ask and it was given them both in men and money." Here we see Scorpio and its ruler Mars working with all their ruthless fury for the REALIZATION (4 Scorpio) of the destiny promised in the octave of the Nation's third century. Mars, its seventh number, pledged the political freedom of the whole Western Hemisphere. A Union of Nations standing four-square to the firmament was its assurance, and this decade was to see its foundations sunk to the center of the earth. That it was done by blood and iron rather than by the peaceful measures of an enlightened humanity simply reflects the phase of evolution which the youthful race had reached. It was an unescapable process in national solidarity.

Whether Lincoln's assassination was a blessing or a calamity, whether Stanton's and Stevens' rough-riding over Johnson was for better or for worse, and whether Grant's election was a happy choice, are questions beyond any hope of unanimity of opinion. But the numbers of the decade answer them. Lincoln's mildness and Johnson's struggles to continue his policies were not in the Tarot spread. Here the grim visage of Fatality confronts us. The implication is there that whatever the numbers foretold was inescapable. That is true until the chain of cause and effect is retraced link by link. Had wisdom and justice prevailed, long, long before, the out-working of the Tarot prophecy would have been toward the highest side of its arcana. Had they been read decades

and centuries before, the course of Government would have been directed to evade the penalty which would be exacted as the price of ignorance. But even had illumination come at the last moment, a spirit of compromises between opposing factions would have been possible which would have vastly ameliorated the retribution which the Union poured out upon its rebellious children of the Southland. Our interest here is in the accurate interpretation of history that we may receive light that will guide us around the repetition of its more ghastly pages in the future.

History does repeat itself, but never literally. The changes wrought by Time in the realms of force and matter preclude its repetition on the strictly physical plane. Its pages simply chronicle the growth of the Sephirothic Tree, the cosmic formula of numerical evolution, as it evokes from the latency of Space-Time Continuum the manifold phases of humanity's conquest of the physical world. The real repetition takes place in the Mental World, for it is a process of growth which has no existence apart from the unfoldment of consciousnessalways a little higher at each turn of the evolutionary spiral. Cosmic force thus expresses in the works of men, finally becoming objective in the realm of materiality in all its gradations from the slime of the primeval jungle to the dematerialization of matter by the astral fire. If history is ever to be of any practical value, here is the place for it, for certainly history is only valuable for what we can learn of it. Do we want such issues to arise again; if not, what can be done to forestall it? Failing in that and in due course, history repeats itself as to issues, would we want to dispose of them through the same servility to the principle of repetition? That certainly seems the prevailing attitude right now-just ten years before the numbers of '53 repeat. While intellectual arrogance prevents any general meeting of minds at present on these matters, it is easily demonstrable that the Nation has faithfully lived the Tarot from 1653 to now. If it doesn't want the bloody pages of history repeated, their psychological roots as revealed by its past cycles can be extirpated whenever its spiritual power is big enough to do it. Then its unfolding destiny will be guided by the Wisdom and Prudence of its Aguarian Soul where now it is the blind puppet of Natural Law-jungle law and the 'rugged individualism" of the sabre-toothed tiger, the python, the hyena, and the jackal.

Only an elementary knowledge of the Tarot is needed to read in any history of this period the exact language of its numbers. The terminal number Cancer (18), ruling the self-realizing aspirations of the decade tells what the Nation would harvest from the course of action impelled by its other six numbers. Through having to tread the fateful path of the XVIII card of the Tarot, it was again to demonstrate its worthiness of the cosmic destiny assigned to it. In its journey it must

choose between the White Pyramid of enlightenment and spiritual power, and the Black one of ignorance and death. It must escape the stark treachery of the black dog; it must penetrate the servile fawnings of the white one and beware; and above all it must risk not the deadly sting of the scorpion hidden in its pretensions to oracular truth. A thoughtful study of this period with an understanding of the XVIII Arcanum will show how accurately its symbology is confirmed in the manifold events that characterized it.

The national horoscope progressed for 1863 shows Uranus on the ascendent in Gemini, which is the precessional ascendent for the United States east of about the 85th meridian. For the Solar Ingress (Vernal Equinox), as indicative of the trend of the decade, Mars has transmitted into close conjunction with the natal Uranus from which he squares Mercury in Pisces, and from there he proceeds to a conjunction with Uranus in transit, thence he goes into conjunction with his own radix place in Gemini and in square to Neptune radix Virgo. (Whatever may be said by its advocates of the Saturn-Jupiter conjunction in the mortality of our Presidents, it is much more convincing to note that we have lost a President in office whenever Uranus has been in a mutable sign, and this writer has the horoscopes of the five of them.) Lincoln's name numbers were 9 Aquarius, 15 Saturn, and 6 Venus. For 1865 his numbers were 2 Virgo, 7 Sagittarius, 9 Aquarius, and 15 Saturn. It was the most violent change of cycle possible to human life, bringing in two mutable signs heavily afflicted in the country's chart as above defined. The country's numbers for the year were—5 Jupiter, 10 Uranus, 6 Venus, and 10 Uranus. Saturn and Venus were in conjunction in the country's progressed chart. Saturn also was by transit retrograding square Jupiter and Venus natal, opposed by the Sun and Neptune in transit.

In Lincoln's chart (progressed), Sun was in opposition to a retrograde Mars; Saturn in exact conjunction with Neptune in Sagittarius, both retrograde, opposition Venus who appears three times in his numbers for the year inclusive of his name and her rulership of Taurus; and Uranus was in conjunction with his North Node in Scorpio. It is also noteworthy that that Saturn-Neptune-Venus figure falls in close proximity with the axial center of the Nation's radical propensities; this Uranus, Mars, Gemini, Aldebaran-Sagittarius, Antares figure. In guises yet to be fathomed, this pattern is the root of our ceaseless internal discord over foreign affairs, in the quicksands of which we will become more and more involved as Uranus by converse motion approaches the Meridian where public affairs and internationalism are focussed.

The terminal seventh is also the significator of the Chief Executive as representing the focus of the hopes and aspirations of the people. And Lincoln was assassinated when the Moon, ruler of Cancer, progressed into conjunction

with Uranus then in the 12th house of martyrdom. Two other Presidents were to meet this fate before this arch-enemy of crystallized political conditions left this house of expiation, McKinley having been shot just on the cuspal change. In the thirty-six years, 1865-1901, while Uranus was here, three Presidents were killed and each died under afflictions of the Chief Executive's number, Garfield lingering for three and a half months until the fatal

figure was complete.

In the octave of '63, Uranus holds the 5th position of GOVERNMENT, and the first word that every student of astrology thinks of in association with that planet is "radical." This arcanum X is ever the ruler of the radical wing of government, of the dictator, and of the anarchist, manifesting constructively or destructively according to its horoscopal course and aspects. The halls of government rang with the term "Radical" and the history of the period is saturated with it, for it was this element, led by Thaddeus Stevens and Edwin M. Stanton, that practically deposed Andrew Johnson and eventually sought his impeachment. For eight months after his succession, Johnson aggressively and with surprising ability carried on the policies of Lincoln in the South. Realizing that he would have to deal with a militant if not hostile Congress when it reconvened, he pushed forward with all speed to accomplish what he could while the power was in him. On December the 4th 1865 Congress assembled with entirely different notions of how the secessionists should be dealt with. The President might pardon and he might re-admit states on his own terms to his heart's content; but Congress held the right of suffrage, for not a senator or representative would be seated except on its own terms. The President fought viciously.

Johnson, totally devoid of every capacity of statescraft that the crucial situation demanded, invited disaster by the violence of his utterances against the opposition and its personalities. It finally united almost all the factions of Congress solidly against him. When the "Radicals" ultimately marshalled a secure working majority in both houses, the horrors of Reconstruction began. No barbarian conqueror ever dealt more harshly with a vanquished foe. The "Government of the Generals" was instituted in the South, and an era of terrorism, devastation, and plunder ensued that is now inconceivable. Describing that period, Judge Jeremiah S. Black of Pennsylvania had this to say: "A conflagration sweeping over the states from one end to the other and destroying every building and every article of personal property would have been a visitation of mercy compared with the course of such a government.' And the President was powerless to halt or even to modify the vengeful spirit with which it was conducted.

Yet for all his coarseness, ribaldry, and political crudeness, Andrew Johnson was an honest man and a thorough-going fighter. Tempera-

mentally, as described by his numbers, he was much better fitted for the issues of Reconstruction than was his successor, Grant. But he was a Southerner by birth, hence neither side trusted him entirely. Any show of mercy for the ruined Southland drove the Radicals to fury, and, except for driving the French out of Mexico and purchasing Alaska, his administration was virtually barren of accomplishment in the stupendous domestic issues of his time. His victorious trial for impeachment was the climax of his stormy and sadly frustrated career, when his arch-enemy, Stanton, was eliminated. But in the Uranus-ruled GOVERNMENT it is quite apparent that Andrew Johnson was a reactionary and a hindrance to the due process of Natural Law in the country's immediate development.

Then came Grant, and the most absurd spectacle that was ever staged in American politics. Grant was a dyed-in-the-wool Democrat—but he was also a war hero. His two administrations are distinguished for nothing so much as memorials to the Republican sagacity and prescience in picking winners for its ticket. Grant cared for nothing but the gold-braid, pomp, and ceremony of the office. These he loved so much that, of all our Presidents, he alone had the effrontery to seek the third term. Under him the Radicals had a free hand, for his natural sympathies were with them, for it was just another phase of war to him.

In this ordered movement of creation under Natural Law, the Ruling Intelligence of the Universe denies to humanity no opportunity to learn its lessons thoroughly. Twelve times each day the Tarot completes the circuit of its evolutionary work in the world. The whole course of a sidereal year is recapitulated in this four minutes of sidereal time, the time wherein the earth moves one degree in its orbit while it is turning once upon its axis. Thirty days completes the three hundred and sixty phases of a circle or cycle; twelve months completes the larger cycle of our common year; three hundred and sixty common years equal the divine year of ten generations of Egyptian chronology; and three hundred and sixty generations of Egyptian Time equal one-half a sidereal year, or a sidereal age representing the normal span of an ascendent race. This is what the Egyptian priests were telling Herodotus in the 5th century B.C. in their allusions to three hundred and forty-one generations of Egypt to the reign of Sethon. Nineteen more generations closed that cycle and inducted the New Age whose date we call the "Birth of Christ." It was in fact the birth of a new sidereal period and the conception of a new ascendent race.

Evidence is becoming more and more abundant that the Egyptians foresaw such a race arising to inconceivable heights of power and glory in the Age of Aquarius, and every page of American history abounds in evidence that the United States of America is that race.

NOTE—"Converse Motion" decreases the longitudinal points approximately one degree per year. Thus can the Causal Sources of Events leading up to and following the war be read: e.g., the North Node (Mass Psychology), preceding for the last dozen years through the first decan of Gemini, fanned the populace into a madness which could have but one end Much will be gained from the study of Uranus, Mars, and Neptune in mutable signs, and the Mutables themselves when on the angles of the horoscope.

Except for the Sun and Angles, which move **forward** approximately one degree a year, the progressed motion is variable, due to the various motions of the planets. However, much can be learned from watching the Sun and Angles: e.g., the Commonwealth (Ascendent) would have no peace until it had progressed through Mars, Radix Gemini 21:26, in about twelve years, where after the horrors of Reconstruction would begin to subside.

## AQUARIUS

#### General Forecast

For Those Born

January 20th to February 18th

Based Upon the Major Transits

#### NEPTUNE

Neptune in transit through Virgo 1928 to 1942 is in the eighth (solar) House of those who come under the Rulership of the sign Aquarius

This department of the Horoscope is most frequently referred to in Astrological Texts as the "House of Death" (and all matters related thereto). This, however, is only a part—a very small part—of the story.

One of the greatest obstacles that confronts the astrological student is the fact that Astrologers (and particularly those who have written texts on the subject) have in the past been so careless in their definitions. Particularly is this true with regard to the House divisions of a Horoscope, and of all the Houses this eighth division is probably the least understood.

We find that the Houses of Horoscope fall readily into a twofold classification and may be best interpreted in pairs. Opposite houses, representing opposite polarities or phases of Being—Cause and Effect. We may accept the upper half of the chart as the realm of EFFECTS and the lower half as the realm of CAUSES. The six houses above the Horizon (7th to 12th, inclusive) are, from this point of view, symbolical of the Past, when present effects were causes, but since these (present) effects are usually (in point of time) totally unrelated to any existent cause, or condition, it often seems that we are receiving something, without any personal effort, as when gifts of fortune—come from the Eighth House in the form of legacies or other gratuitous benefactions or when information comes from the Ninth House as inspirational or intuitional knowledge. In the last analysis, therefore, the upper six houses are Houses of INCOME (supply), (incoming forces), calling, only, for passive acceptance on our part, so far as the present is concerned. From this point of view, therefore, these Houses may be said to symbolize relatively, fatalistic conditions or events, circumstances—"Debts of Destiny"—the Harvest of Past Actions—which, though they are the natural results of past actions, are yet, so far as the present is concerned, beyond our personal control. These upper six houses, therefore, indicate what others do to us, or

for us, as distinct from that which we personally do to, or for others.

The opposite six houses (those below the

The opposite six houses (those below the horizon) may be considered as comprising the realm of causes governing our personal reactions to the *effects* of past causes (or actions) coming from the opposite (upper) six houses. Hence, this lower half of the chart is the realm of EXPENDITURES (Demand)—outgoing forces—positive actions, hence is properly symbolical of the PRESENT and FUTURE, for it is here in the present—the point of union of two polarites of being—that we by our actions and reactions transmute the past and create our future.

The Second and Eighth houses are the two financial Houses—Departments—having special significance for property or possessions. The Second house signifies expenditures, application of income and future obligations now being incurred. Here we look for liquid assets of the individual (with Neptune there—as in the case of LEO at present—these assets would probably be very liquid indeed. Explaining, at least in part, why so many of our Leo friends are so financially anaemic just now).

The Eighth House (with which we are principally concerned with relation to Aquarius) is the house of income and accumulation—Material Reserves and resources, governed largely by obligations incurred in the past and business (social) connections. This department of the chart corresponds to Scorpio, the Eighth sign, which also throws much light upon the significance of the Eighth House. Scorpio is now generally conceded to be correlated with the newly discovered Planet Pluto. In Ancient Mythology, Pluto was accepted as the ruler of the "Nether Regions"—The Realms of the Dead. This harmonized with the popular conception of Scorpio, as the sign of Death and with the Eighth House as the House of Death. The error is in failing to properly define Death, which, philosophically at least, is essentially "Transition"—or "Transformation." Here in this House of Death, the past is transformed (Regenerated—not necessarily improved) and is resurrected (reborn) in a slightly new and greatly augmented form. The seed that is planted in the soil dies, but also produces the

future harvest, and from one seed may come forth many. From this point of view, it is not difficult to understand why the Greeks and Romans, quite often, identified Pluto the Lord of Death with Plautus the "God of Wealth." According to the Greeks, he was blinded by Zeus so that he might not confer his gifts upon the good alone, and he was variously represented, sometimes as an old man, sometimes as a boy—with a cornucopia symbolizing wealth—who came to mortals weak and lame, but departed from them on winged feet.

Ancient Mythology abounds with symbols and references all pointing to Pluto as identical with the "God of Wealth"—the "Giver of Gifts" and "Protector of Harvests"—which, for the Astrological student plainly identifies Scorpio and the Eighth House as the real source of Material Supply. Therefore, if you happen to have been born under the Rulership of Aquarius, Neptune now in the Eighth Department of your Birth Chart, will render your income (and source of income)—your business affairs —distinctly Neptunian, which means that they will be, at best, rather indefinite, and money will come from peculiar sources. This will infuse into your business affairs an element of mystery or secrecy plus certain peculiar complications which may at times be very confusing.

If you happen to have in your nature any traces of Financial Genius, that is to say the Business Instinct—this may place you in control of some relatively large financial enterprise with huge sums of money under your personal direction. This will not, however, be your money-your personal funds-since it is the Eighth House that is involved here we would rather expect this to be public funds—some other person's money—as in the administration of an estate or in the capacity of treasurer to some large corporation, or in connection with the government. Neptune always operates on a relatively large scale and is most frequently associated with Corporate Bodies of the State. By reason of the Twelfth House correlation of Neptune, this may also give a keen interest in and inclination to seek a close connection with public institutions and public enterprises, devoted to social welfare—the upliftment and protection of the lower classes of society. The weak and the downtrodden, the social outcast, the depressed, those who are sick or otherwise afflicted, all come under the dominion of Neptune and must look to him for relief. Naturally, when the business department is stimulated by this planet, such connections would, in the ordinary course of events, be in a financial capacity and may be quite profitable. Our Aquarian President is evidently expressing this Neptunian urge, in assuming the role of Financial Dictator, in order to correct the evils of an Economic System, that in the words of Father Coughlin permits people to "starve in the midst of plenty."

Neptune, in the Eighth Department of your chart, may permit extremely profitable connections along the lines indicated above, but there

are two sides to this picture, and it may bring equally great losses in the same manner through fraud and dealings with various predatory interests. It all depends upon which phase of Neptune (positive or negative) you, personally, may most readily respond. When the impractical, idealistic tendencies of this planet are permitted to go to an extreme in this department, his bungling efforts, muddled methods and impractical schemes may get you hopelessly involved, so that you fail day by day with ultimate ruin as a certain result. Neptune is intrinsically a schemer, he can weave some wonderfully fantastic nets with which to catch the financial fish, but he needs to take care, however, that he does not become tangled in one of these himself. It is a fact (in accordance with the infinite justice of nature) that confidence men are the greatest "suckers" in the world. It is well for you, when under the influence of this planet of idealism, dreams and vision, to remember that "you cannot be too severely practical, or too strictly honest." Neptune naturally adopts complicated business methods and can easily get your affairs into a chaotic condition. Not only may there be considerable mystery about your source of income but usually there comes, with this influence, a disinclination to keep books or any accurate financial records, preferring to keep these records and accounts of transactions on odd scraps of paper, etc. You, personally, may know what this is all about, but no one else would be able to make much sense out of it, only with the greatest difficulty could the average person get any information on your business affairs, and you may have only the vaguest ideas on the subject yourself. Specifically, it may permit success in the marketing of a secret in some form. Something made from a secret formula, or by a secret process, could bring you much money, the same might be true of the marketing of oil, liquids, etc. In the extreme, of course, and if you are susceptible to the negative phases of this planet, you might try to sell fresh air and sunshine

Quite apart from its financial significance this transit of Neptune through your House of Regeneration may offer unusual opportunities for SPIRITUAL PROGRESS. This may mean a variety of things; for some, it may mean the greatest of all steps forward on the path-Death. We are, however, not so much interested in the form of manifestation, as we are in the fact that this is a symbol of powering and secret forces at work in your life, to the purpose of raising you to a higher plane of living (or casting you down) according your merits. This is the home of Pluto.

"That grizzly God, who never spares, Shows no mercy, hears no prayers."

As previously stated, there was in Anchomology two conceptions of Pluto. That conception with which we have been concerns above visualized him as the "God of Wealth—the Owner and Bestower of Products hidden in his Kingdom (below the Earth), especial

grain. He differed from Zeus principally in his expression—which was dark and stern. He was further distinguished by a cap of invisibility. He was pictured as a grim, implacable Deity—enemy of Life—invisible and terrible—not to be appeased by sacrifice—reigning in silent majesty amid the crags and canyons of his dark domain. His Kingdom was gloomy and full of horrors and from it there was no escape. Truly a fitting symbol is found in his Planetary counterpart, wending its solitary way through the cold darkness of outer space.

Neptune, the Brother of Pluto, and presiding spirit over the waters of the Earth, was no less mysterious and on occasion scarcely less cold and ruthless. Therefore, take heed Aquarians—Neptune enacting the role of Pluto in your life may do a powerful lot of damage. "The Goblins will (surely) get you if you don't watch out." Neptune, in any department of life, usually dangles before our eyes some glorious opportunity to get something for noth-Which, if it were a fact, would violate that fundamental law of nature—The Law of Compensation—"Be not deceived, God is not mocked, whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap," and never is it more necessary to keep this in mind than when Neptune is in the House of Financial Supply and makes an appeal directly to the greatest vice in human nature-greed. If you have never, hitherto, believed in Santa Claus, you probably will now. But beware—things are not always what they seem when Neptune is around. This is also the House of Governorship, Inspection and Discipline. Neptune here may symbolize Secret Police—invisible eyes that take note of our every movement and "Walls have ears."

To many persons who have natal afflictions to Neptune, this transit has directly or indirectly brought some ghastly tragedies. Note the birthdates of those recently convicted of capital crimes; also the victims of such. Many Aquarians will recognize in this Eighth House Neptune the "Masked Death" that has, during recent years, visited the homes of those with whom their lives hitherto have been closely linked.

You may determine the year of the maximum power of this Eighth House Neptune in your life by adding one year to 1928 for each two days that your birthdate is later than January 20th. For instance, if your birthdate is January 30th — this is 10 days following January 20th, hence FIVE YEARS added to 1928, gives 1933 as the year of maximum power for this Neptunian influence.

Uranus, your personal ruler in Aries (the Aquarian Third House) has tended to stimulate to an unusual degree the intellectual powers of Aquarius people during the period of

this influence (1927 to 1934 inclusive). This will furnish you with special opportunities to express the intellectual gifts of your sign. It also promises assistance to the realization of your heart's desire coming from this department (relative, journeys, writings, etc.) or this could also be a close friend—one with whom you are associated on terms of closest intimacy, second only to a blood relationship. It also indicates that many such beneficial and intimate relationships may have been formed by you, during this period, and often under circumstances that were in some way extraordinary, or perhaps unconventional. Radical changes in the immediate personal environment are also indicated by this configuration, possible estrangements and finally a complete re-organization of the personal (domestic) life.

You may determine the time of the maximum power of this transit in your life by adding ONE YEAR to 1927 for each four days that your birthdate is later than January 20th.

Uranus will enter Taurus (your Fourth House sign) June 6, 1934, but shortly thereafter (August 7th) commences to retrograde, re-entering Aries in this backward motion October 10th and continuing therein until April, 1935, when it finally leaves this sign and to which it will not return for many years—the Cycle of Uranus is 84 years. Uranus last transited Taurus 1851 to 1858, therefore unless you happen to be quite advanced in years (at least 75 years old) this transit of Uranus, through Taurus (your solar Fourth House), will be quite a new and novel experience.

This will, no doubt, bring many strange events and radical changes involving your Domestic Life and also with regard to your Field of Activity or Base of Operations. It will probably shift your foundations and at times may operate almost like an earthquake—the result of a sudden shift in the lower strata of the Earth. It will be important that you find a suitable LOCATION—some point of anchorage—a point from which you may work freely and find expression for certain original talents of which Uranus will make you conscious. Briefly, this will operate to put a NEW FOUNDATION under your life-under your structure of Achievement. You will, no doubt, BUILD A NEW HOME under this influence and possibly the first manifestation of this transit may be, apparently, rather destructive since it usually commences the work of rehabilitation by tearing down the old structure. You may determine the approximate time of maximum power of this transit in your life by adding ONE YEAR to 1935 for each FOUR DAYS that your birthdate is later than January 20th.

Saturn, in the House of Personal Secrets (1930-1932) probably forced you along the line of duty into close personal contact with the more unhappy or even sordid or tragic aspects of life. Under the whip-lash of necessity (in

some cases dire need) you were compelled to do things you detested doing, to associate closely with people you despised perhaps; or else you may have been obliged to assume a heavy load of responsibility, which, in your private opinion, really belonged to someone else, with the result that you may have stored up a large reserve of unexpressed resentment against many people avowing, privately, to get even yet, if you did bow to necessity and with more grace, and willingly, cheerfully accepted these responsibilities, it is possible that you later realized that what necessity dictated was indeed wisest and best. Saturn, more than any other Planet, indicates what we MUST do. It is the fitting symbol of Fate, if such there be. Those who rebel against the dictates of necessity usually find that rebellion is worse than useless. only results in a further tightening of the screws, and the individual is forced into situations that are more and more difficult, until he finally, in sheer desperation, agrees with necessity and does what he knows in his heart is his duty—because he must. Those who fight too strenuously for freedom from what they may consider a galling yoke of destiny, even should they gain freedom, pay a heavy price indeed. Saturn, in the Twelfth House, especially under such afflictions as it had during the past four years, may indeed have manifested as a most sinister influence; but if met with wisdom and self-discipline, those under such an influence may have, as Rudhyar says: "Become whole through the deliberate willing of their own Destiny." Saturn will then breed neither rebellion nor fatalism. The Stars, that is, Life forces, are not to be ruled but to be understood and fulfilled."

1933 and 1934 Saturn is in transit through your Birthsign. This is likely to give Aquarians great ambition for worldly power and position and will, no doubt, add a dogged determination to ACHIEVE at any cost and by any available means. To many Aquarians this may bring an increase of Responsibility and Authority and a concrete realization of a life's ambition, but it is important to remember that Saturn is but a catalytic agent, that precipitates into crystallized form ONLY the potential powers of the Personality. He cannot give you anything that is not already latent within (as accumulated experience). Such is given freely -though slowly-in accordance with the orderly process of the Law of Growth, but for

anything more that you might grasp and an propriate by unfair means a terrific price will eventually be exacted. You will be taught be bitter experience that the end DOES NOT justify the means. Saturn grants his benefits only as a reward for hard and consistent work and genuine ability. Even then he require much time in which to mature these benefitsbut they WILL come in due course. When Saturn has completed his transit of your Birthsign you will be a real (genuine) personality shorn of all your childish ideas and petty shams —either that or figuratively, if not literally, dead. What you have when Saturn has passed by will be yours—all yours—and that is all you will have. It might be a good idea to balance your books and impartially decide just how much you really do have (potentially) to your credit and then set yourself to the task of making that tangible as soon as possible.

Jupiter in Libra, September 1923 to October 1934, is in transit through your Solar Ninth House and therefore will act as a polarizing influence upon Uranus (in Aries 1927 to 1934) in your Solar Third House. This is a configuration calling for a high degree of Cooperation, a good Sense of Balance and the ability to compromise (give ground) when necessary (m the interests of harmony and mutual efficiency) —in other words a well developed Social Instinct is required, otherwise it may create certain more or less serious conflicts of a revolutionary nature involving intellectual affairsjourneys, writings, legal papers, publishing, advertising and in general Public Life. Such conflicts being most in evidence at times when Jupiter approaches most closely to the exact opposition (to Uranus), that is to say in the months of February and October 1934—that of October is the most important and may be the most difficult to deal with.

The Third and Ninth Houses are basically the Houses of Distribution, communication and transportation. The Third House is the Positive pole—information you give out—that which you are personally interested in (the direction of your personal interests)—that which you Distribute—letters you personally write—papers you personally sign, your personal journeys etc., and as previously explained since 1927 this department of your life has been and is at the present time under the control of and qualified by Uranus (now in Aries).

The Ninth House (now qualified by Jupilo

—in your case) is related to the opposite (passive) pole of Distribution—Information received-those who are interested in you-what others say to you or about you—the direction of Public Interest in you and your products (hence publishing, advertising, etc., through which you may stimulate Public Interest); your incoming mail (letters or other communications received by you-replies to letters written or other messages delivered by you). This is properly the House of Education whereas the Third House is more exactly the House of Intelligence. Your reaction (through the Third House-personal interest) to messages received from the Ninth House determines the degree and quality of your Intellectual polarity —Learning. Here also (to this Ninth House) we look for the nature and results of the writings of others in your interests (as of contracts or legal papers which you would have approved by some other person) and of course also the judgment of a Court relative to you. Whether this be a court of Public opinion or a Court of Law is purely a matter of degree.

The above explanation of Two Houses involved in the Uranus and Jupiter transits should be of considerable assistance in Harmonizing these opposing planets and to which it may be added that Saturn in Aquarius (1933 and 1934 previously analyzed) should also add much, since as it transits your Birthsign it harmoniously aspects both Jupiter and Uranus. Saturn will give the patience, stability, persistence, concentration and in general self-realization necessary to deal with the critical situations that will most certainly arise from the Jupiter-Uranus opposition. This should prevent you flying off the handle at critical moments and will help you to see the wisdom in the other fellow's point of view and will prevent extreme reactions either of optimism or resentment. Jupiter will incite to progress—as rapidly as possible—but Saturn will keep this within the limits of safety (either from wisdom or neces-Uranus will tend to radical changes and readjustments, new interests and strange associations, but Saturn will impel you to retain as much as possible of the old order and will prevent a too radical (dangerous) departure from the path of Tradition. You may consider yourself fortunate that you have this Saturnine balance—which at this time otherwise we fear that the Jupiter-Uranus combination might indeed wreck the works.

Briefly, and for the above reasons, Jupiter in Libra should permit much success in all Ninth House matters—Religion, Law Publishing, Advertising and in general Public Life—also relations with Distant Localities or strangers.

From October 1934 to November 1935 Jupiter. in transit through Scorpio, will be in your Solar Tenth House. Therefore, at the beginning of this period (during October and November 1934) will complete his ascent of your Mountain of Progress and attainment (which ascent has been in progress since the summer of 1931) and will finally cross the Peak of Achievement. When Jupiter enters Scorpio, in October 1934, it will provide you with the first genuine opportunity you have had to rear a superstructure of achievement on the Uranian foundation which you have been constructing. As a result of Jupiter transit, during the succeeding twelve months (up to November 1935) you may expect to really accomplish what you have been endeavoring, with doubtful success, to accomplish since the beginning of 1933. will put a roof over your head and you may get somewhere in actual fact, provided, of course, that you can balance that Uranian-Jupiter opposition previously referred to, for it is also during that month of October that Uranus and Jupiter come to exact opposition, this, as explained above, calls for BALANCE—CO-OPERATION—to a high degree. Saturn will be in harmonious aspect to both planets and will help much, but this does not relieve you of the responsibility of being reasonable. You must fit the House to its foundations and build it according to the Uranian Plan-but you must also see that this Uranian Foundation is secured on the solid rock of logic, commonsense and practical experience, otherwise this foundation may suddenly slip at a critical moment and bring the whole structure crashing down about your ears. The difficulties that arise from Uranus are usually due to allowing emotion to control or influence reason-sentiment rather than logic more often than not determines the policies of this planet—yet he insists upon calling this REASON and logic and all powers of the gods above or below cannot make him change (what he calls) his mind. Leave him alone and he will change it himself for no reason at all. Uranus will teach you that carefully formed decisions on matters of sentiment are merely wasted effort.

### National Affairs

## Based upon Mutual Planetary Aspects During February, 1934

In this Cancer Nation of Financiers, Millionaires and Philanthropists, money always has been and always will be the Central and controlling factor—the measure of Power.

It was a Tax on Tea that precipitated the Revolution, which gave Birth to this Nation and we have been drinking coffee and dodging Taxes ever since.

We are told that the late-lamented "Great War" was a commercial War. Has there ever been any other kind of War? Certainly, this is the only kind of War that could possibly interest an American Business Man, and that War is always going on.

All this is acceptable enough and is not necessarily an indictment of a great Nation, when we reflect on the apparent fact that this nation was created by the spiritual powers that govern the world, that it might stand, as a symbol, of the material Destiny of Mankind. That it might provide a social womb for the gestation of a New Race—a Race which would manifest the acme of material achievement, and through which Spiritual Powers might crystallize and be made practical. For what is money but "Crystallized Power"?

This nation was destined from its inception to be the Wealthiest Nation on Earth—to teach the world the "RIGHT USE" of Money—and the evils of its abuse. The Economic Problem will ever be the major problem of the Day in the United States and this Nation stands or falls on its Monetary Standards and Economic Policies.

It is important that this basic quality of the national consciousness be brought out at this time for it appears probable that during this month of February, the United States may face A FINANCIAL CRISIS. This must not be interpreted as necessarily implying anything disastrous; it merely means an emergency—a turning point—admittedly a critical situation involving the financial structure of the Nation, but it will, no doubt, be safely negotiated in consideration of the complete planetary pattern at this time.

It is probable that October will be the mon critical month in this connection, but, as Jupiter approaches closely to opposition of Uranus and turns Retrograde within one degree of the exact aspect February 7, we may expect about that time some relatively temporary or tentative arrangement. This does not appear to be a final adjustment, but more in the nature of an experiment, but it should reveal clearly in what direction the wind is blowing.

Speaking of wind, we are likely to have plenty of wind (and rain or snow) following February 7, and the balance of the month may be unusually stormy, especially throughout the West and Middle-West. The focal point of the storm center—danger area—seems to be right over the West Coast.

Mars and Mercury are in conjunction and opposing Neptune practically all through this month. This is a configuration productive of great nervous tension and anti-social activities among the people. It produces mob violence, anarchistic outrages, strikes and Labor Riots Finally, as it will be almost exactly on the meridian for the West Coast, it may in that locality result in much destructive activity in the Realm of Natural Forces. Even Mother Earth sometimes becomes nervous under such a disturbing influence. We might in this connection, call attention to the fact that the Total Eclipse of February 13 occurs in an angle (1) the Western horizon) in the Western States which will make it very effective (and probable destructive) in that locality—looks like another Earthquake Zone. Statistical data on these matters is, as yet, so incomplete that we are not in a position to plot these events dehmicor as to time and place, but we can spot the danger zones and it may be admitted that at times " do come pretty close to the center of the targe

It is interesting and instructive to reverthe events of February and March, 1932, who Mars was last in Pisces opposition Neptune Virgo. Mars opposed Neptune in that year on March 4.

#### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION: My sign is Libra, but my rising sign is Sagittarius. Is it not better for me to follow the Daily Guide for Sagittarius?

Answer: When the rising sign is definitely known-I say definitely KNOWN-it may be advisable to read the monthly and Daily Guide for that sign, rather than the Sun sign. However, much caution is required in this for two reasons; first-there is in the majority of cases so much uncertainty with regard to the rising sign; second—the horoscope is a complex pattern involving many factors and for many reasons the centre of power might not be in the ascendant (or rising sign), for this is the department which governs personality and we know that the strength of personality varies widely. For this reason, we have always felt safe in accepting the Sun sign as the central and controlling factor in the chart, although as explained above there may be exceptions to this rule.

QUESTION: Do the predictions of the Hindu Astrologer apply to this country or to India?

Answer: To the best of our knowledge, the Hindu Astrologer does not use a locality chart and his predictions are general unless otherwise specified.

QUESTION: What would be the date of birth and what would the month be called of a Russian (Hebrew) calendar, if the American is August 4, 1884.

Answer: The Russian date for that period would have been July 23, 1884, and the Hebrew date is Ab 13, 1884.

#### THE VERNAL EQUINOX

Our remarks in the January issue of American Astrology, relative to the Vernal Equinox;

has brought forth some enlightening comments, which we present for the information of our readers.

DEAR MR. CLANCY:

On page 17 of the January issue of American Astrology you comment at some length on the position of our Solar system in relation to the constellations.

There is such a wide divergence of opinion as to the date of coincidence that a brief summary of the facts of Precession may possibly be of interest to your readers.

The American Nautical Almanac for 1933 gives the equatorial radius of the earth, based on the United States Geodetic Survey of 1909, as 3963.34 statute miles. The polar radius for that year is given as 3949.99 statute miles.

From this it appears that the earth is not a true sphere, but an oblate spheroid, and that the polar diameter is shorter or less than the equatorial by the ratio one to two hundred and ninety-seven. This indicates a concentration of mass on the earth's equatorial diameter.

The gravitational pull of the other bodies in our Solar system acts in a manner that tends to align the earth's equatorial mass concentration with the plane of attraction of these other bodies. Were this permitted, there would be no Precession, but the centrifugal forces generated by the diurnal rotation of the earth tend to counteract this gravitational effect by setting up a secondary rotation similar to the wobbling of a top. If we project an imaginary pen or pencil through the polar axes of this top and follow its motion on paper, it would describe a circle. Transfer this illustration to our earth and the path of the described circle then defines the Precession.

The astronomical constant given in the Nautical Almanac for the precession rate of motion per year is 50.2564 plus seconds. That is, our

Solar system moves backwards through the constellations at the rate of a little more than fifty seconds per year.

Converting this constant into the rate expressed as the number of years to complete 360 degrees we get 25,787.76 years as the Cosmic Cycle, and dividing by 12 gives us 2,149 years as the time required for our Solar system to pass through 30 degrees of each sign. Reducing still further we arrive at the constant as of the present time of 71 years seven months and eighteen days required to move one complete degree in the constellations.

Newton's Precession formula—very close to that of the current Nautical Almanac—gives a period of 6,541.75 years for 90 degrees precession movement back from January 1, 1844, which fixes the Zodiacal Epoch at 4699 B.C. on the first point of Gemini and the last point of Taurus, or our Solar system entered Taurus at the Vernal Equinox of 4699 B.C.

From 4699 B.C., when the Zodiac coincided with the last point of Taurus through to its coincidence with the first point of Aries, or sixty degrees, required 4,381 Solar years which brings our Zodiac up to the last point of Pisces at the Vernal Equinox of 317 B.C.

From this point, using the annular Precession rate as a calculation base, from 317 B.C. to 0 B.C. gives us 4 degrees and 24 minutes of motion. From 0 B.C. to the Vernal Equinox of 1934 gives 26 degrees and 48 minutes of motion, or a total motion of 30 degrees and 72 minutes.

On this basis, the Vernal Equinox of 1934 points to our position as regards the constellations as 28 degrees Aquarius 48 minutes.

Now a few words from Paul Counsil, whose Mercator Map of the World and the Heavens we recommended on page 3 of our January issue. Mr. Counsil believes that the coincidence of the signs and the constellations should be fixed for a later period and advances the following argument in support of this contention:

"The thing that has confused most researchers is that two precessional movements must be used; one the Equatorial Measured in Right Ascension and the other Ecliptical Measured in longitude of the Zodiac. The total preces-

sion in Right Ascension since A.D. 0 is 24 degrees 50 minutes; the total in Zodiacal longitude for that period is 26 degrees 48 minutes.

Newcomb said (Astronomy for Everybody, page 312) 2,000 years ago this constellation (Aries) marked the first sign of the Zodiac the Equinox was just below Alpha Arietis. Now, Newcomb used the average precessional rate, 50:03 minutes per year, which in 2,000 years would amount to 1 hour, 51 minutes of R.A. In 1900, Alpha Arietis had the R.A. of 2 hours, 1 minute, 32 seconds, this difference of 10 minutes would change Newcomb's round figure to 2,180 years. Subtract from this the difference of R.A., from Gamma Arietis (my basing star) is 14 minutes converted into years or precession, equals 248 years, which gives us 1,932 years of precession since the coincidence of the signs and the constellations.

### Hindu Astrology

FORECAST FOR FEBRUARY, 1934

Translated by PRITAM SINGH GILL, B.A.

Note:—The following forecast is a translation from Urda (Hindustani) of the monthly forecast according to the rules of Hindu Astrology as given in the Mashur-i-Alam Jantry (World Renowned Almanac) published annually at Lahore, India, by Girdhari Lal, Hindu astrologer.

#### 1. GENERAL:

Wheat will show very unsteady movements during this month, going up and down in price quite frequently. At the end of the month, however, an upward price trend will prevail. Rye, maize, corn and lentils will maintain a slightly higher price level during the entire month. Milk, butter, cheese and other dairy products, as also cotton, yarn and manufactured materials will go down in price. Linseed oil, sesame oil and other lubricants used in machinery will be higher. Dyestuffs will receive a stimulus. Spices in general and honey will be up in price. Metals of all sorts will remain inactive in general, except stimulated by governmental action. Wood, coal, tobacco and sugar will be higher. Dangerous month for all blood and skin diseases. There will be many unnatural and sudden deaths.

#### 2. MIRROR OF THE SKY:

Will rain on February 3, 4, and 5. Cloudy on February 12. Cloudy and little showers on February 12, 22 and 23. On February 25, 26, and 27 there is possibility of rain and strong winds.

If on February 2 the moon has a halo, then there will be plenty of clouds in March. If on February 7 there are clouds, then the latter part of March will have a show of halos. If there is lightning on the night of February 13, then there is a danger of great cyclones in June. If it is cloudy on February 17, clear on the 18, and rains on the 20, then the price of all foodstuffs will go up in April. If it is cloudy on February 23 and quite clear on February 24, then there will be a good deal of rain immediately afterwards, and also strong winds. If it rains on February 27, people in general will enjoy fairly good health.

#### APHORISMS

1. If the Sun is followed by Mercury and the latter by Uranus, then the grains will become dear.

- 2. When the Sun is in Aries and Mars in Taurus at the same time, then the people become panic stricken.
- 3. If the Moon be in the 5th or 7th sign from the Sun and Mars in the 6th sign from the Sun, then there are likely to be unexpected happenings not so favorable for the general good.
- 4. If Saturn is in Pisces, Jupiter in Cancer and Mars in Libra, then there is danger of famine and also some unusual malady affecting the live stock.
- 5. When Saturn opposes Jupiter grains in general become dearer and sickness increases.
- 6. If Mars, Mercury, Jupiter and Saturn be followed by Venus, then there are great cyclones, floods and hurricanes of terrific velocity, also lightning and thunder.
- 7. If Saturn is placed between Jupiter and Mars, then there will be great religious fanaticism and intolerance, also argumentations amongst learned people.
- 8. If Mars be placed between Jupiter and Saturn, then grains will be in great demand, thus advancing in price; also possibility of famine.
- 9. If Jupiter be placed between Saturn and Mars, then grains will go up in price, especially in the northern regions.
- 10. If Saturn be followed by the Sun and the Sun be followed by Mars, then there will be a great deal of sickness in the land.
- 11. When Saturn is leading and Jupiter and Mars are behind in the order named, then there is every likelihood of famine and sickness ravaging the land.

#### THE ROUND YUG

As explained in the October, 1933, issue of AMERICAN ASTROLOGY, according to Hindu Astrology there will be a conjunction of seven planets on January 15, 1934, which will have a far-reaching effect on human destiny. One of the major influences of that conjunction is the new outlook assumed by the great powers of the world. France and England will fall in line with Russia, Italy, Turkey, Germany and the United States. The year 1934 will witness the collapse of the Coalition Government of England. Socialism will assume a new force and meaning in that country and will come into power. Asiatic nations will become more independent and Pan-Asiatic movement will receive a great impetus.

## AGE OF THE WORLD By Hindu Chronology

From Suraj Sidhant (Star Science), recognized by Hindu Astrologers as the most ancient and authoritative text on Indian Astrology.

In the sacred books of the Hindus, one complete cycle of this world (i. e. from birth to death and rebirth) consists of 4,320,000,000 years. This is technically known as one KALAP or BRAHAM DAY. Every Kalap or Braham Day is divided into 14 parts known as MANUS, and every Manu is divided again into 71 CHATREGIS and every chatregi consists of 4 YUGS. These yugs, together with the length of their durations, are known as follows:

- 1. SAT YUG=1,728,000 years.
- 2. TRIPTA YUG=1,296,000 years.
- 3. DWAPAR YUG=864,000 years.
- 4. KAL YUG=432,000 years.

Thus, the total of these four YUGS is 4,320,000 years or one (1) CHATREGI or MAHA YUG.

In the beginning of every MANU there is one (1) SINDHI, which is equal to 1,728,000 years, according to SURAJ SIDHANT (the well-known Indian Book on Astrology and the most authoritative) 6 MANUS have already gone by and we are in the midst of the 7th MANU. And of the 7th MANU 27 CHATREGIS have already gone by and we are

passing through the 28th Chatregi, at present and of the 28th Chatregi three (3) YUGS have already passed and we are in the midst of the fourth YUG, known as KALYUG, and of KALYUG 5,034 years will have been passed by the end of the Bikram year 1990 or up to April 13, 1934.

Now, as we have seen above, four Yugs total 4,320,000 years, i. e. one Chatregi or Maha Yug, and 71 MAHA Yugs make one Manu, i. e.,  $4,320,000 \times 71 = 306,720,000 = 0$  one MANU, and 6 Manus have already passed, i. e.:  $6 \times 306,720,000 = 1,840,320,000$  years = 6 MANUS, and 7 Sindhi have already passed, i. e.:

 $7 \times 1,728,000 = 12,096,000$  years.

Now adding the above two figures we get 6 MANUS and 7 Sindhis or 1,840,320,000 + 12,096,000 = 1,852,416,000 years. Now, as 27 Chatregis have already passed of the 7th Manu, we get  $27 \times 4,320,000 = 116,640,000$  years; and as we have also passed the first three Yugs and part of KALYUG of the 28th Chatregi, we get

- 2. Tripta 1,296,000
- 3. Dwapar 864,000
- 4. Kalyug 5,034

or added these become

3,893,034 years

Therefore, all these added together, thus

Subtract from this figure 17,064,000 years of Braham and then we have 1,955,885,034 years, which is the age of the present cycle of this world so far. We have 4,320,000,000—1,955,885,034 = 2,364,114,964 years more to go. So don't worry; after that the world will be born again.

### Market Forecast

For February, 1934

General Indications

At the time of going to press, it appears that the Saturnine influence, now in process of development and which may be expected to quite dominate the last half of January and the first week of February (at least) has also been a dominant factor during this first half of January, with the effect of holding the Market down for the most part and preventing any major advances.

We must admit that we expected the Market to manifest much more life during the first week of January, by reason of a number of harmonious aspects that were in force during that period. However, this expected advance did not materialize to any degree worth mentioning, which merely forces us to again realize the fact that trines and sextiles are of relatively minor importance in the matter of determining the Market trend and certainly do not indicate on which side of the ledger the profit may be found. For the key to the present situation it appears that we must revert to the conjunction of Venus and Saturn, December 21st, which coincided with President Roosevelt's announcement regarding the purchase of Silver. The monetary development which was forecasted in our December issue (page 3)—from the Astrological point of view this may be accepted as the beginning of a chain of events affecting directly the financial affairs of the United States and culminating with the conjunction of the Sun and Saturn, February 8th. With January 17th, 30th and 31st, February 1st, 5th and 8th, each being key dates and marking future important developments along these lines.

It is scarcely possible that the Market may advance to any extent during the last two weeks of January or prior to February 8th. Saturn is a symbol of doubt and fear and is in control all through that period and as Saturn is, at this time, posited in the second house of the cyclic chart, for the Eastern States the general tendency would naturally be to limit demand. It is difficult to say how any announcement, coming from official circles at this time, could possibly have the effect of stimulating the Market to any marked extent. Such might be expected rather to have a depressing influence if at all, certainly the whole tendency of Saturn in any department is towards stabilization and rigid control. We believe that a definite decision and announcement relative to the monetary standard and the future Economic Policy of the United States may be

expected not later than February 8th and we further believe that this will involve REVALU-ATION OF GOLD, devaluation of the dollar and STABILIZATION at a point considerably below par at least in terms of gold. This may call for some form of bimetallism. In the last analysis this really amounts to CONTROLLED INFLATION.

Following February 13th, or possibly a few days prior thereto (following February 8th), the reaction of the Market and the Financial Interests of the Nation may be distinctly speculative. Transportation and Communication Stocks may be in great demand; there is considerable Pool activity indicated here. By this we mean the small trader is doing all the buying, the professional being on the selling end of this deal and the public may be stung plenty as a result. It is possible that the government may float a bond issue about that time and we believe that investment of that kind will be in great demand. By way of clarifying the situation without attempting to be too exact as to time, we shall expect a DECLINING MARKET during the FIRST HALF OF FEBRUARY and a RISING MARKET during the LAST HALF of the month.

In conclusion we would like to call attention to a recent announcement relative to A. T. & T., which reports a sharply increased operating income during 1933 and with special reference to the month of November of that year. We might refer the reader to our analysis of this stock which appears on page 36 of the January issue of American Astrology and which this report would seem to confirm.

#### Your Hidden Genius

Something You Should Know About Yourself

The "Greatest Thing in the World" for Aries is Love. With apologies to Byron, we might say that Love is of (Libra's) life a thing apart, it is (Aries) whole existence. This must seem indeed a paradoxical statement to the Astrological student, when we reflect that Libra is ruled by Venus and Aries is ruled by Mars. But this paradox is reconciled when we consider the distinction between Love and Friendship-Libra is the sign of Friendship. Such people are usually popular—they "like to be liked." They are not even averse to being loved if you don't ask for more than friendship in return. As a friend, Libra may be most devoted, charming, lovable and unselfish—but— Friendship is not Love. Love is one of the Power Urges. It is, in fact, the essence of ambition. It provides the urge to conquest and all through the ages has been the reward for victory. Love is the twin brother of Hate, the capacity for hate and love always go together. Great haters are great lovers and "There is no revenge more bitter, more cruel, than love to hatred turned." Thus it is indeed true that men (often) "kill the things they love." We do not often find Libra involved in crimes of passion, for it is rarely that this sign cares enough about any one person to kill him.

From this point of view, it may not be so difficult to accept Mars as the "God of Love," leaving to Venus the distinction of being the Goddess of Friendship and Social Life—also marriage. We know that the path of true love (rarely) runs smooth, which may explain, at

least in part, why so many Arians find their way to the divorce court. Just as soon as the honeymoon is over, Romantic Aries is off in search of new conquests. Admonition—keep them guessing. Libra is a past master in that art—this is an ideal union. It is curious to reflect on the fact that Mars is the ruler of the Motion Picture Industry (April 14, 1894) and this planet has also been established as the dominant factor in the horoscope of 97 per cent of the Motion Picture Stars. Can this account for the hectic emotional lives those people live and the high divorce rate in Hollywood? To the Western mind, it may seem like rank heresy, yet it is, nevertheless, a fact that friendship (mutual respect) provides a firmer foundation for Marriage as a social institution than does love—or Romance. The Eastern races know all about this. They have known it for centuries.

When we assign to Aries the role of "Great Lover," what matters it if the object of his adoration happens to be himself (as is so frequently the case)? This may eventually result in the greatest of all victories—SELF-MAS-TERY.

This brings us to the major problem of this month of February for Aries—Love—and Friendship— the harmonization of these two poles. This month Aries is likely to be confronted with quite a complicated and perplexing situation involving his social relations and emotional contacts.

#### First Quarter January 30 to February 7

An eclipse of the Moon, January 30th, 11:31 A.M., Eastern Standard Time, in that department of your life that concerns heart interests, is likely to furnish proof to the truth of that old adage "love is blind." Although, in this instance the interpretation may be reversed. Usually this implies blind devotion to an unworthy object of affection, but here it may mean rather that you are blind to the devotion of someone else. Or perhaps you are in love and don't know it. This is only a slight shadow—an emotional blind spot—yet it may cause you to frown and turn your back upon the only person in the world whom you really love, who is, furthermore, your best friend. It might be well, at this time, to consider the value of friendship as against your own emotional ca-

price. "He who would have friends must show himself friendly." In other words, love those who love you for a change.

Mercury conjunction Saturn, January 30th is a "stop sign" on the Road to Happiness. It may offer some friendly advice which you should accept. You cannot laugh this off. Be serious—a reasonable attitude is called for.

Venus conjunction Mercury, January 31st—"Hope springs eternal" and here is where Hope may do some springing. This may indicate a pleasant change or journey, otherwise a new friend—a love letter perhaps—but if this does manifest as romance do not aspire too freely (we said aspire). Saturn is close by and duty calls. Necessity will not be ignored—so sorry

—Venus and Mercury are evidently good friends and all set for a delightful and interesting

time, but Saturn knows best. Venus conjunction Saturn, February 1st, may be a somewhat depressing influence upon your social relations. Someone may be greatly disappointed in you. This is an aspect that chills the heart of friendship and someone may feel quite cold and lonely as a result of your absence or unfriendly attitude. You may have your choice as to whether you sacrifice love (or happiness) to duty, or duty to love—whether you sacrifice your ideals in the interest of necessity, or necessity to an ideal. Eventually you may, in this instance at least, learn that what Necessity dictates is wisest and best.

When Venus, in her retrograde motion, meets the Sun by conjunction February 5th, there should be a revolutionary and fortunate change in your circle of friends. You should find yourself at that time a very popular person and should have ample opportunity to learn the value of real friendship. It is rather unfortunate that as the Sun moves forward to a trine of Jupiter sextile Uranus, February 12th-13th, respectively, he must surmount some serious obstacles—he must transit Saturn February 8th and finally goes into total eclipse February 13th, therefore any promise of a harmonious relationship that may be indicated by the above aspect is not likely to be fulfilled unless consummated prior to February 7th.

#### Second Quarter February 7 to February 13

As the Sun continues forward to a conjunction with Saturn February 8th, he may be expected to thaw out old frozen-faced Saturn and when Saturn smiles something unusual MUST happen. However, we fear there is a sardonic twist to this grin, for in the meantime Mars has moved forward into Pisces (your solar 12th house). This Mars transit into Pisces took place February 3rd and is followed by Mercury, which entered Pisces February 6th, forming a conjunction with Mars close to an opposition of Neptune February 8th. This looks like secret enmity-gossip with much malice involved going on behind the scenes—behind your back. It may be difficult to trace this to its source or you may be entirely unaware of it until the solar eclipse of February 13th brings the matter to a culmination.

It would be well to guard your speech and writings carefully during this period, also control radical tendencies and avoid incurring the enmity of those with whom you are obliged to work. Beware of accidents while traveling, guard the health closely; unfavorable for surgical treatment.

#### February 13 to February 21

A dangerous week. A total eclipse of the Sun at 8:44 P.M., Eastern Standard Time, puts out the light (shuts off the power) in your House of Friends. From some points of view an eclipse of the Sun is just like a short circuit (in consciousness or circumstances)—a sudden flood of energy or unexpected event to which you react explosively, with the result that you blow a fuse in whatever department of Life

it may occur.

The Moon, which symbolizes material (objective) consciousness—awareness of concrete realities or facts-passing between the Earth and the Sun in this manner, appears to symbolize a condition whereby the individual becomes blind to spiritual (real) values and, of course, specifically with respect to the matters governed by the department of life in which the eclipse may take place. "There are none so blind as they who will not see" and from this particular eclipse you may learn that Popularity may, indeed, cut one off from real affection. This eclipse does not necessarily symbolize any lack of friends (acquaintances)—fair weather friends—but the SPIRIT (Sun) of friendship is likely to be lacking—and if the weather should happen to be bad—which calls to mind a very wise remark of a very wise man (Benjamin Franklin), "He who has once done you a favor will more readily do another than he whom you yourself have obliged.'

Mars opposition Neptune, February 18th, is a warning of possible accidents or violence in strange places and under peculiar or myste-rious circumstances. Malicious enmity of a secret nature and for reasons difficult to de-fine, probably from persons practically unknown Choose your associates with care, avoid strangers and strange roads. Avoid hazardous undertakings, also journeys by air or water. Be very cautious in all your undertakings, control the emotions, avoid people who make you angry or such as stir the emotions unduly in any respect. Not a favorable time for surgical treatment.

#### February 21 to March 1

Mercury now turns retrograde and again conjuncts Mars, February 28th, whereupon we shall expect a repetition of the verbal warfare -poisoned darts of malice. We would suggest that you keep your own counsel. Gossips

never make their own arrows—they only supply the poison. Keep silent and they will have less ammunition.

Still dangerous for traveling, writing, surgical treatment and employment.

rus goes serenely on his way, unhurried and unworried. But, this Taurean Rock of contentment and stability is the very foundation of the social structure; without him there could be no security and no permanent progress. It is the possessive urge symbolized by Taurus stubbornly resisting change of any kind which permits us to hold such ground as may be gained. General Grant is the best historical example of Taurus that we can call to mind at the moment, but he is a good example; his life will merit close study by all natives of this sign.


