INTERNSHIPS

The word INTERN or INTERNE means "An advanced graduate or a recent graduate in a professional field who is getting practical experience under the Supervision of an experienced worker."

An Internship then is serving a period as an Interne, or an activity offered by an org by which EXPERIENCE can be gained.

Internships have been arranged this long while for every auditing class.

A COURSE GRADUATE BECOMES AN AUDITOR BY AUDITING.

That means LOTS of auditing.

A NED graduate who doesn't then audit under an experienced Case Supervisor who knows and demands the standard actions rarely gets to be a NED AUDITOR. It takes tons of hours to make a real Dianetic auditor who can toss off standard sessions and get his routine miracles.

So if a NED doesn't INTERNE, but simply goes on to the Academy Courses or SHSBC he has skipped his apprenticeship as a Dianetic Auditor.

If he gets his Class VI and never interns but goes on to VIII — well, we now have somebody who has long since lost touch with the reality of why he is studying.

Regardless of Class as a course graduate, a C/S MUST INTERNE HIS AUDITORS FOR EACH INTERNSHIP MISSED ON THE WAY UP.

The "ok to audit" system is used.

One takes any graduate and Internes him on the lowest Internship he has missed. He reviews his material, gets his drills checked, gets his misunderstood words cleared and gets an "ok to audit" for that level. If he goofs he is crammed. And sometimes wholly retreaded. The "ok to audit Dianetics" would be his first okay. This suspends if he has to retread.

When he then has turned out pcs, pcs, pcs, pcs, 5, 6, 8, 10 hours a day for weeks and weeks and is a total success as a Dianetic Auditor, he can go on up.

Then one day he is word cleared, checked out on his drills, and he qualifies for "ok to audit" for IV or VI.

Now it begins all over again. Flubs — Cramming, midnight oil, audit audit cramming audit audit new word clear new drill work audit audit audit 5, 6, 8, 10 hours a day.

Now he is a IV or VI auditor.

His next real step is a VI or VII Interne at an SH. If he has been a good IV Interne Auditor his VI Internship after his SHSBC will be a VII Internship. VII is an Interne activity.

If he is going to be a good VIII-IX auditor he will Interne in an AO or SH under an experienced C/S.

Whenever this function is neglected, you don't get auditors. You get doubtful students and out-tech.

On Flag C/Ses have to catch up every missed Internship to make a high volume high quality auditor.

The world renowned Superiority of Flag Auditors is built just like I am telling you here.

There is no reason just that same quality can't be built in any org.

And one day you have IN tech and high volume high Class auditing all over the place.

There IS a right way to go about it. It is by Internship.

The Cycle of An Internship at ASHO

An Internship is the major step an individual must take to accomplish the flubless level of expert auditing ability that most people aim to achieve when they start training as an auditor.

STARTING AN INTERNSHIP

When a student completes a training course in Scientology, the first requirement now for acceptance onto an Internship is to satisfactorily pass a written test covering the Course one just finished, in order to show that the Graduate really does know the material for that level and no longer has any attention on the Theory of it at all. Passing this examination verifies that the new Graduate has his materials down cold, and is ready for the action ahead.

After actually routing onto the Internship, a person may have a short period of time where he still thinks of himself as a Student. But he quickly realizes that Courses and Internships are two separate and distinct activities. He has stepped onto a whole new plateau where the stress now is not on studying Theory and learning materials, but on *doing*, and full application of the materials one has already been taught. An Internship is "on-the-job" training under skilled supervision. The newly arrived Intern does receive a Checksheet (some of them personally drawn up by L. Ron Hubbard himself). The materials and drills on the Checksheet need to be fully checked out on the Intern in order to get an OK to audit. These new Checksheets are very streamlined, and a person can usually finish these preliminary actions in from 3 to 5 days of full time work in most cases. Once

these basics are established to ASHO Qualification Division standards, a person is OK'd to audit. And now comes a total insistence on doingness and application. The preliminary checkouts for the Class VI Internship are most extensive, but a parallel system is worked out whereby the Class VI Intern gets right into auditing while these other checkout actions are being worked on.

GETTING GROOVED IN

Once the preliminary checkouts are completed, the new Intern gets assigned a Buddy, under the ASHO Internship Buddy System. The Buddy is an advanced Intern who knows the ropes. All the lines (any sequence through which a message of any character may go) and the people he will be dealing with, are shown to the new Intern. Soon the newcomer knows exactly where the Director of Processing's office is, where the Director of Technical Services can be located (for all auditing supplies) also where to drop off Preclear folders to be sent to the C/S, and where to pick the folders back up again once they return. The new Intern also learns who the Cramming Officer is, where one does his crams, and many, many other in's and out's of working in a highly sophisticated organizational system for delivering the very best auditing available.

The new Intern now meets the Director of Processing, who is his direct Administrative Senior for the time he will be Interning at ASHO. And immediately the Director of Processing starts to set the schedules and lines up preclears for the Intern to audit. The Internship schedule starts at 7:30 am each morning, and the reason an Intern is required to report at that time is to do any correction or preparatory work (cramming, etc.) needed to get ready before his first pc is taken into session, which is usually at 9:00 am sharp. ASHO's Hubbard Guidance Center (where the Intern will be working) daily delivers a great volume of auditing hours to preclears from all over the country. And now the Intern is expected to match up to high standards of Ethical and Professional discipline.

CRAMMING

Immediately after the 7:30 am Roll Call and a short Muster each morning, the Interns work on any Cramming orders given to them from the day before, to correct their auditing. It's expected that if at all

possible the Intern will get his cramming done in time for his first preclear session at 9:00 am. The concentration in Cramming is on finding the misunderstood that went just before the person flubbed. Once he locates that and fully clears it up, the Intern also gets any drilling connected with the action so that he can be flubless when he gets back into session. It is a fast line. ASHO's Power Class VIII Cramming Officer has personally trained under L. Ron Hubbard, and is one of the best on the planet. He has this to say: "Every person that I know of in ASHO's Qualification Division, including myself, handles the Interning auditor like they are THE most important person. And everything is done in a validative way. If they get a cram and make an error, we make it very safe to come to cramming and get their misunderstood found. That's what it is. It's not handled by H.E.&R. ever. It's doesn't have to be, because when they come in, they're upset because they wanted to do well in the first place. And so they find their MU and they're rehabilitated instantly! It's incredible, every time they make an error, they find their MU, or they do just that extra drilling, and then the Internship just becomes easier and easier and easier as that happens."

USING THE VIDEO

The Video — an instant playback television recording machine — is a very important tool used on ASHO's Internships. And Interns are expected to do daily Video recordings of their auditing sessions, which later are closely inspected by the Cramming Officer who writes critiques on any errors that need to be handled. Then the Intern is expected to correct, by appropriate drill, whatever is found to be less than optimum in his auditing delivery. Only one thing at a time is handled, not everything at once. Sometimes a person's own false self-impression has to be overcome, and he can't believe he made such an error, and he has to play the recording back to see it himself to believe it. By use of the Video recordings, flubless perfection is rapidly achieved on ASHO's Internships.

RUNNING OUT DILETTANTISM

At times an Internship can be tough, but that's because the product being worked for is someone who has the quality of being able to confront anything with the preclear, and being able to handle it. An Interning auditor

has to be tenacious and increase his ability to confront preclears who have Banks. Where a student is mainly dealing with the Theory data of a Course, and a relatively small amount of practical application, an Auditor Intern is daily facing and handling the guts of life. It definitely helps build a higher unshrinking confront and fortitude, along with an increased causativeness in life. ASHO's Qualification Secretary also has this to add: "An Intern has to also confront his own discipline in getting and applying the Tech standardly. There's a million ways how you can do something wrong. But there's only one way how you can do it right, and that's standardly, with Standard Tech. So this activity kind of 'runs this out' on the person, and also it runs out dilettantism."

HIGH HOURS

An Intern is expected to eventually produce high hours of auditing: 6, 8, 10 hours a day. If for some reason he is not auditing in the evening, the Intern is expected to work if necessary to complete any drilling or corrective actions for the next day's sessions.

COMPLETING AN INTERNSHIP

Toward the end of an Internship, the crams have long since dropped off, and the Intern is definitely producing high flubless auditing hours. He daily receives consistent VERY WELL DONE's for his auditing sessions, and his Video sessions have achieved the level of perfection set by ASHO's very high standards. Auditing is by-the-book and has become an effortless activity for the Intern. The wins grow daily. Finally the Intern writes up a full assembled package of information for the Case Supervisor, and requests that he be approved on his auditing to graduate from the Internship. The Senior C/S reviews the Interns Log of auditing sessions, and also does a final Video check of the Interns auditing skills. If all is OK, and the Intern has achieved the product of being a Flubless Professional, the Intern is given approval to graduate. He is no longer a Provisional Auditor. By perseverance and hard work, he has earned the high honor of being awarded with a Gold Seal affixed to his Certificate, signaling that he is now a Permanent Auditor for that level of training. The Graduate Intern now proudly ranks with the very best in Scientology . . . one amongst many of the finest auditors on the planet.

A Day With An ASHO Intern

It's 7:15 am and the city of Los Angeles is gently rousing and shaking off a night of slumber. The bright California sun is slowly starting to warm the day, and the calm morning feels comfortable and balmy at this hour. Mary Lynn Haberman, from Minneapolis, Minnesota, a Class VI graduate of the Saint Hill Special Briefing Course, now on her Internship at ASHO, is awake and in motion, anticipating the busy day's schedule ahead of her.

After dispatching a nutritious breakfast and bidding her husband goodbye, it's only a few steps for her to walk from where she lives across the street to the American Saint Hill Organization to meet the 7:30 Internship roll call where it's now all smooth and precise activity.



2) Interns listen intently to L. Ron Hubbard giving an auditing session.

Quickly settling down to work, Mary Lynn is soon absorbed along with the others in one of the tapes played daily of L. Ron Hubbard giving an actual auditing session. By the end of their Internship, each auditor will be expected to match the quality and delivery they are listening to now.

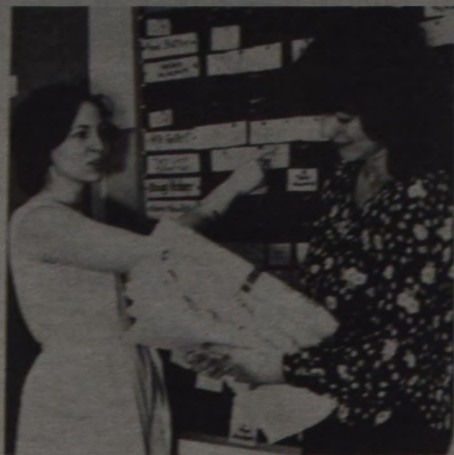
After the tape play, a short Muster is held where news or special items are gone over. And then it's a scramble to look into auditing folders which have come down from the Case Supervisors to see if any Cramming Orders have to be done from sessions given the day before.



3) Cramming is where you find your misunderstandings.

"You come in and see your buddies each day," says Mary Lynn, "and ask, 'Hi, did you get a Cram?'" The crams can be pretty heavy in the beginning and it's pretty hard," she goes on. "You go in there and look over the reference and say, 'Oh yeah, I forgot that. That was stupid.' And sometimes you think, 'where did THIS come from?' Interns in cramming can go through different H.E.&R, but ASHO's Cramming Officer, a Power Class VIII, is so good, he's just like the total definition of Power: he holds his position in space. You can go through all this emotion and effort over your crams, and he just holds his position and says: 'Go to the Word Clearer, or 'Do this Drill', and you finally come out of there confident that you'll know what to do the next time."

"After a time you get to a point where you're a good auditor," Mary Lynn goes on, "and then you come in in the morning and maybe you have just one or two little things... finally you don't have any crams. And then you really start cooking! It gets effortless, and your Tech goes totally in!"

When any Crams needing to be done are completed, Mary Lynn heads for the Director of Processing who is her Senior in the Hubbard Guidance Center. An Intern soon enough learns the big difference between being an Intern and being a Student on a Course. A Course is where you learn the theory necessary to perform auditing actions. But now on the Internship it's all totally put to use, and the emphasis is on perfecting the application by doing LOTS of actual auditing. "The Director of Processing gives you your pc's and she's your Senior," says Mary Lynn. "If you've got Crams to do and she's got pc's sitting there waiting, it can be pressure. But it teaches you to be professional. It's rushing around, doing TR's getting into session, and so on. And you've got to really keep your Ethics IN. Really strong. Your first pc in session goes overtime — you better cook into your next pc! Your pc's are scheduled and the Dir of Processing expects you to be there at 9:00 am for the appointments. It's very professional. One thing about an Internship: it makes you a tough thetan. You get so tough you could do anything. All you have to do is decide to do it, that's all! That's how tough you get."



5) Mary Lynn gets plenty of experience each day at auditing.

The activity picks up momentum and now Mary Lynn is really into the business of the day: AUDITING, and LOTS of it! "The thing is," says Mary Lynn, "the tech is so standard now, pc's blow out so fast that sometimes an Intern can have 3 to 4 pc's each day."

Throughout the day, ASHO's brisk activity of getting beings free of their Banks and moving them up the Bridge doesn't weaken. "If you come out of one session earlier than expected, the Director of Processing will call your next pc to come in earlier. Or give you a Dir of Processing Interview to do. Or give you a new pc folder to study. You're just plain busy," says Mary Lynn. "Getting new folders to study ties in with being tough, and just being able to take the pc right into session."

When asked how fast does she take to now study a new folder, Mary Lynn answered, "Half an hour to an hour. Because you've got all your stuff down. You study the pc's folder, get the Dir of Tech Services to give you all the auditing Lists and supplies you need. Then you get the pc, get in

comm with him and take him in session. You get to the point where you can do anything. You don't have to go and Drill the action you'll be doing anymore, or go and find out something about it. You just get your pc and go in and audit."



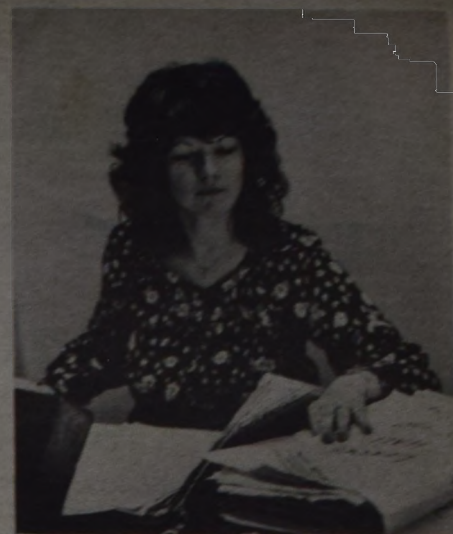
7) A big hug is often part of the thanks one gets.

Hardworking Interns are often acknowledged and thanked in their prelearns success stories. And it's not unusual for one of her prelearns to express delight and gratitude to Mary Lynn with a big hug for a session well delivered.



8) At dinner break, Interns often converge in an informal way to talk and unwind from a busy day.

Comradery is high amongst ASHO's Interns, and the free and easy fellowship that develops is an important part of making it. Says Mary Lynn, "You'll make friends that you would never make like you do on the Internship. The whole group is tight and you really start respecting each other." As dinner break draws near at the end of a busy work day, the Interns often gather for informal companionship and chatter. "Auditors stay together," says Mary Lynn. "Somebody can be plopped on the floor, somebody else sitting with their legs up, all sitting around going blah blah blah... You talk about funny things that happened during the day, and actual victories you made during the day, because you make a lot of them. Like 'Had a good day...', 'Oh my pc had this win...', then somebody will say, 'I had a stack of Lists THIS THICK that I corrected today!! And sometimes the C/S will stick their head around in the door and look in... The C/S's really love their auditors, they really care about you...'"



9) After having dinner, time is spent to write up sessions and send them into the CS.

At 6:00 pm Mary Lynn takes her break for Dinner, and then returns to ASHO to either audit another pc, or to work on writing up the auditing reports on her sessions for the day.

When sessions are finally finished and all written up, now comes the time for burning the midnight oil that Ron talks about when he speaks of Internships. Each day the Interns do Video recordings of their sessions and the Cramming Officer daily reviews these and writes critiques on errors he spots. "He writes great critiques and they're always ARCful," says Mary Lynn. "then you get your twin to go over them with you to watch and drill you on what exact thing is wrong."



10) The Video is very useful to help improve auditing skills.

The use of the Video brings to mind the lines of the famous 17th century Scot Poet, Robert Burns, who wrote: "O wad some power the giftie gie us/ to see ourself as ithers see us!" and the Interns find that using the Video as a training tool is an excellent way to "see ourself as ithers see us!" Says Mary Lynn, "It really is hard to believe you made that mistake, and that's the value of the Video machine. When I first started the Internship I was making all these really corny errors, and the C/S just couldn't figure out what I was doing wrong. So I did a Video, and I was laughing and giggling and having a party partically, and I couldn't believe it! Right in session. It was terrible. And I corrected that and all those errors I used to be crammed on just totally fell out. It was worth auditing for a year, just that one Video."



11) A fulfilling day is ended and Mary Lynn heads home with fellow Interns.

When all the last day actions are finally finished, the ASHO Interns end-cycle on a busy and highly productive day. They have each boosted themselves up to new plateaus of ability, and the time spent on the Internship itself seems to fade into nothingness. "When you're on an Internship," says Mary Lynn, "It's like a whole part of your time is just taken out of the Time Track. It's like you're not on the same Time Track with other people. You'll think, 'God, it's the end of June. How could it be the end of June?' Well, it's like, you're so much in Present Time, and so doing what you're doing, that it just As-ises the whole thing."

ASHO's Interns truly become the real Lions of Scientology.

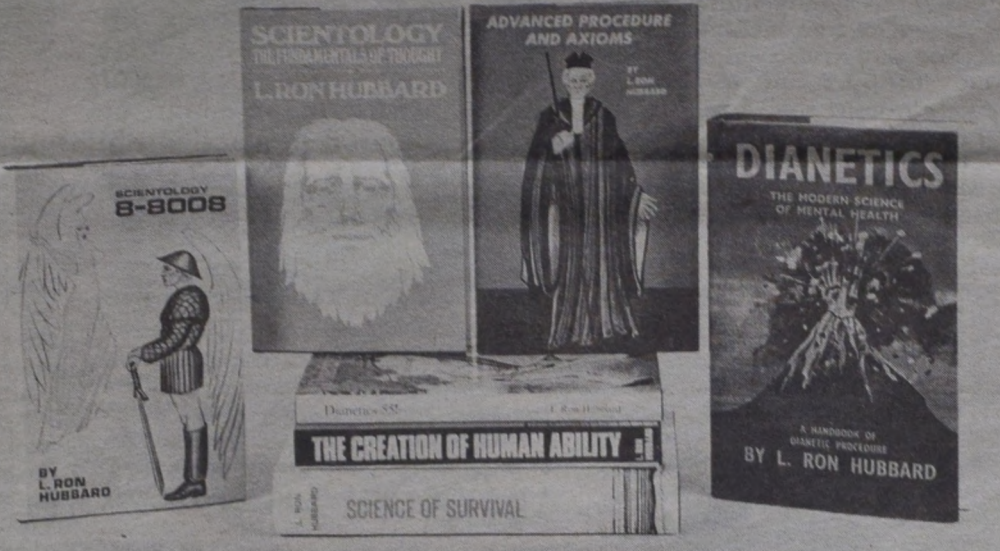

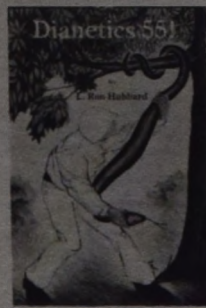

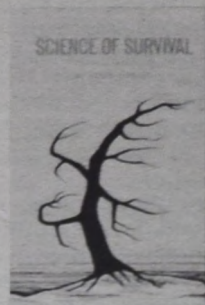

Interned Auditor

Is Winning In The Field



Reed Slakin, from Detroit, Michigan, has been in Scientology since 1963, and is now O.T. VI and trained up to Class VIII. Reed interned at Saint Hill, Sussex, England, and the American Saint Hill Organization. He did 3 Internships during the years from 1976 to 1977, and immediately afterwards began auditing in the field. He has very successfully continued his field auditing and disseminating as a profession ever since. Here is what Reed has to say about his career as an auditor:

Q. What influenced your decision to become a Professional auditor?

A. I had been studying Scientology for many years and when it came time to make a decision about a career, it was simple — I couldn't think of another profession that would be as interesting, rewarding and useful to others as auditing.

Q. How do you compare your auditing ability before and after your Internships?

A. Interning was the turning point for me as an auditor, particularly under ASHO's Case Supervisors. I can honestly say I felt I could handle any case after putting in the hours on the Internships. Whereas before, I mostly felt that I could audit someone as long as nothing odd came up.

Q. Did you have any particularly notable success on the Internships?

A. One of my favorite wins was the validation of the Tech that several of my pc's voiced in deciding that they wanted to be auditors.

Q. How have the Internships helped you as a field auditor?

A. On the front lines of disseminating Scientology to new people, one in a sense is auditing constantly. The same principles apply on a standardly done dissemination cycle as apply in a standard auditing session. The certainty one gets in handling cases on the internships is vital when contacting the public and making Scientology known to them.

Q. Has your Internship training been useful in other areas?

A. The Internships produce discipline and confidence, and of course these help across the Dynamics. Also familiarity with the Tech gives you instant accessibility to the data and the ability it takes to handle all kinds of situations.

Q. What are your future plans?

A. I've achieved success in getting people into Scientology and auditing them up the Bridge. So that will continue. I'm also going to be doing my Class VIII Internship at ASHO in the next few months. I can't stress enough the importance of Interning! One's success in applying Scientology depends on it.

Class VI Revitalize's Dissemination

A lot of excitement is going on in the field of Scientology Dissemination these days. Sioux Bushman, Class VI, ASHO Graduate of the Saint Hill Special Briefing Course, is revitalizing Field Staff Members and helping to make them vital to the field and financially successful.

Sioux is the Executive Director of the Professional Field Staff Member Association. From her experience as a Class VI Auditor, Sioux knew the importance of having tech and drilling it. "An auditor would never think of auditing unless he had thoroughly drilled the action he was going to audit," says Sioux. "So what makes Scientologists think they can disseminate without thoroughly drilling. They're just setting themselves up for failure."

Prior to doing the Saint Hill Special Briefing Course, Sioux had a boutique in Berkeley, where she sold clothes of her own design, and costumes for singers and films. She decided to go full time on the Briefing Course at the American Saint Hill Organization, and says, "It's the best thing I ever did."

Sioux has been a Scientologist for eleven years, with big aspirations to expand her abilities at Disseminating despite numerous losses in the area. She persisted through on a decision to BE a Field Staff Member. The breakthrough came a year ago — one month after she gave up fashion and started

the Briefing Course. Immediately after that she became internationally known.

The next step was to draw from her experiences as a trained auditor and get others to become successful at Dissemination. From her Auditor viewpoint, she was able to observe lack of tech and drilling, people trying to Disseminate without knowing how, or just not drilling.

What grew from this is the Professional Field Staff Member Association, which began in December, 1978, and is now a place where Field Staff Members get together weekly to do drilling. The success of this operation led to the establishment of the Super FSM Workshop Series. This is a five week program of Dissemination training, drilling, with a seminar on, "How To Get Your Friends and Family Into Scientology." The workshops are conducted Sunday afternoons at Celebrity Center in Los Angeles, from 2-5 pm, and on Friday Evenings, at the American Saint Hill Organization, from 7:30 pm — 10 pm. The next Workshop is scheduled to begin July 29th at the American Saint Hill Organization.

Sioux, having just completed OT III, will start NED for OTs soon. "This", says Sioux, "is totally as a result of FSM Dissemination, which is a result of my auditor training on the Briefing Course at ASHO."

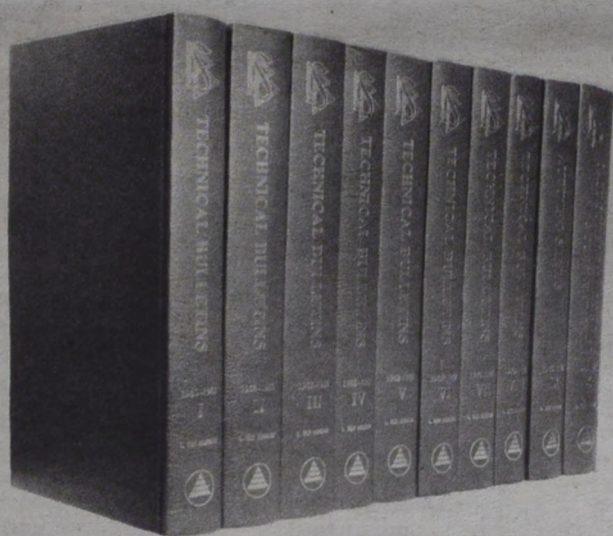

- (1) What would you tell an auditor in the field who has completed a Training Course but, because of some reason, hasn't routed onto an Internship yet?
- (2) What wins have you had on the Internship?



Jim Paterson completed his NED and Class VI Auditing Internships, and also his NED and Class VI C/S Internships.

(1) First off, if they have back-off, that's a real good reason why they should do an Internship. An Internship is the thing that makes you into an auditor, because you have to audit, audit, audit. And you get Crammed... good Cramming. And you do Videos. So as you sit out there, you may not know what's causing your back-off; or you might know somewhat. But it can get handled!

(2) I'd audited thousands of hours before my Internship and I could handle preclears. But by doing the Internships... getting any questions or uncertainties cleaned up, gave an air of professionalism that I'd had somewhat before, but this really put the icing on the cake. With my C/Sing Internships... before there were just certain areas of Tech I hadn't had to duplicate exactly correctly; with the C/S Internships I found out where those areas were and got them corrected.

(1) They ought to do it because that's the only way you learn to be a flubless auditor. On a course you only get to do a little bit of Practical at the end, and you don't get to do that much actual auditing. On the Internship, you just do a little bit of Theory and then it's ALL Practical. So you really get a lot of good experience under really hot C/Ses.

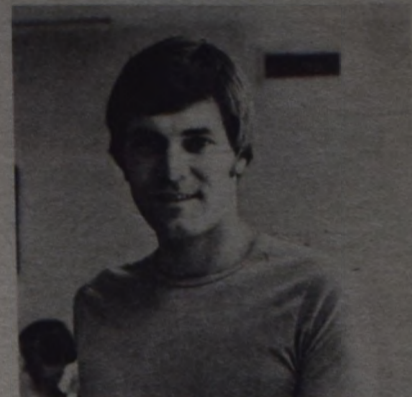
(2) I've gotten my TR's in really well, and that was a great win. It's really nice to see how good they are in comparison with how they were before.

(1) They actually haven't applied the data they've got to a life situation. And therefore I think they're missing part of it's use. So definitely go in and do an Internship.

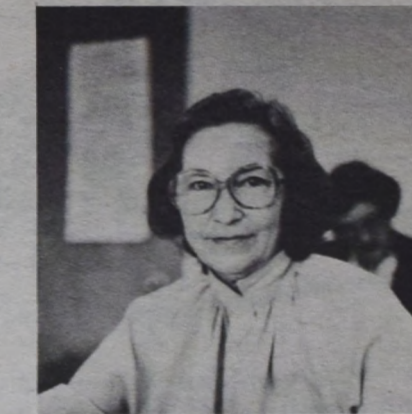

(2) My main win was in feeling such a resurgence of Cause, and making everything go right.

(2) My PC's have been good products. Scientology Definitions

ADMIN: A contraction or shortening of the word administration. Admin is used as a noun to denote the actions involved in administering an organization. Also used to denote the action or fact of keeping auditor's reports, summary reports, worksheets and other records related to an auditing session.

ANTAGONISM: At the level of tone 2.0, affinity is expressed as antagonism, a feeling of annoyance and irritation caused by the advances of other people toward the individual.

ARC: A word from the initial letters of Affinity, Reality, Communication which together equate to understanding.

AS-IS: To view anything exactly as it is without any distortions or lies, at which moment it will vanish and cease to exist.

ASHO: American Saint Hill organization.

AO: Advanced Org.

AUDITING: The application of Scientology processes and procedures to someone by a trained auditor.

AUDITOR: One who has been trained in the technology of Scientology. An auditor applies standard technology to preclears. One who listens and computes; a Scientology practitioner.

BANK: A colloquial name for the reactive mind. This is what the procedures of Scientology are devoted to disposing of, for it is only a burden to an individual and he is much better off without it.

BLOW: The sudden dissipation of mass in the mind with an accompanying feeling of relief. A definite manifestation and the pc must say "something blew" or "it disappeared" or "it's gone" or "it vanished," not "I feel lighter."

BRIDGE: A term originating in early Dianetic days to symbolize travel from unknowingness to revelation. The route to Clear, the Bridge, which we call the Classification Gradation and Awareness Chart.

BRIEFING COURSE: Saint Hill Special Briefing Course.

CASE: The way a person responds to the world around him by reason of his aberrations.

CASE SUPERVISOR: The C/S is the case supervisor. He has to be an accomplished and properly certified auditor and a person trained additionally to supervise cases. The C/S is the auditor's "handler." He tells the auditor what to do, corrects his tech, keeps the lines straight and keeps the auditor calm and willing and winning. The C/S is the pc's case director. His actions are done for the pcs.

CHECKSHEET: A list of materials, often divided into sections that give the theory and practical steps which, when completed, give one a study completion. The items are selected to add up to the required knowledge of the subject. They are arranged in the sequence necessary to a gradient of increasing knowledge on the subject. After each item there is a place for the initial of the student or the person checking the student out. When the checksheet is fully initialed, it is complete, meaning the student may now take an exam and be granted the award for completion. Some checksheets are required to be gone through twice before completion is granted.

CLASS: Refers to the level of Classification of an auditor.

CLASSIFICATION: An award earned by an auditor that entitles him to audit certain levels of processes, and that shows that he has attained the ability and skill to do so by actual test.

CLASSIFICATION, GRADATION AND AWARENESS CHART: The route to Clear, the Bridge. On the right side of the chart there are various steps called the states of release. The left-hand side of the chart describes the very important steps of training on which one gains the knowledge and abilities necessary to deliver the grades of release to another. It is a guide for the individual from the point where he first becomes dimly aware of a Scientist or Scientology and shows him how and where he should move up in order to make it. Scientology contains the entire map for getting the individual through all the various points on this gradation scale and for getting him across the Bridge to a higher state of existence.

CLEAR: A Clear is a being who can be at cause knowingly and at will over mental matter, energy, space and time, as regards the First Dynamic (survival for self).

CRAMMING: The cramming section teaches students what they have missed. This included trained auditors who wish to be brought up to date on current technical developments.

C/S: Case Supervisor.

DIANETIC CLEAR: The State of Dianetic Clear means the pc has erased his Dianetic case or mental image pictures; he has attained the ability to be at cause over mental matter, energy, space and time on the first dynamic.

DIANETICS: Man's most advanced school of the mind. From the Greek *dia*, through the *noos*, soul, thus "through soul" or "through thought".

DYNAMICS: The dynamics are the urge to survive expressed through eight divisions (1) self, (2) sex, and the future generation, (3) the group, (4) mankind, (5) life, (6) matter, energy, space, time, (7) theta, (8) the Supreme Being.

E-METER: The E-Meter is a religious artifact used as a spiritual guide in the church confessional. It is an aid to the auditor (minister, student, pastoral counselor) in two-way communication locating areas of spiritual travail and indicating spiritual well-being in an area.

ENGRAM: A mental image picture which is a recording of a time of physical pain and unconsciousness. It must by definition have impact or injury as part of its content.

ETHICS: The rules or standards governing the conduct of the members of a profession. Ethics has to do with a code of agreement amongst people that they will conduct themselves in a fashion which will obtain to the optimum solution of their problems. That which is enforced by oneself, his belief in his own honor, and good reason, an optimum solution along the eight dynamics.

FLAG: Flag Land Base.

FSM: Field Staff Members, they are missionaries who disseminate Scientology, sell books, courses and counseling services, and introduce people to the Church. They often support themselves in the field by receiving ten per cent payment from their local Scientology Organization on the donations paid by those they select for Scientology services.

GRADE: A series of processes culminating in an exact ability attained, examined, and attested to by the pc.

H.E.K.R.: The counter emotions and reactions which aberrated human beings express when they are guided toward survival objectives. They are usually below 2.0 on the Tone Scale. (Ed. note: for 2.0, see Antagonism above.)

IDENTITY RUNDOWN: We have never before had a Dianetic process specifically directed to getting a pc into valence. The Identity Rundown now handles that. It specifically takes up and handles valences the pc may be in by using the New Era Dianetics tech. Freud said that people who are detached and to whom things are unreal could never be handled. This one makes him wrong and the pc right.

IN TECH: When tech is in, we mean that Scientology is being applied and is being correctly applied.

INTERN(E): An advanced graduate or a recent graduate in a professional field who is getting practical experience under the supervision of an experienced worker.

INTERNSHIP: Serving a period as an intern, or an activity offered by a Church of Scientology by which experience can be gained. The apprenticeship of an auditor is done as a Scientology Church intern. A course graduate becomes an auditor by auditing. That means lots of auditing.

IN VALENCE: What we mean by "in valence" is simply in the valence he was in when the engram occurred. Now when we say out of valence we mean simply and entirely the pc was not in the body he was occupying during the incident. (Note: see Own Valence.)

LEVEL: Grade and level are the same thing but when one has a grade one is a pc and when one has a level one is studying its data.

L.R.H.: L. Ron Hubbard, Founder of Scientology.

M.U.: Abbreviation for misunderstood.

N.E.D.: New Era Dianetics.

NED for O.T.'s: New Era Dianetics for OT's Rundown was developed especially for Dianetic and Scientology Clears who have completed the Grade of OT III. L. Ron Hubbard's most major breakthrough since 1968 when he released OT III, it can only be delivered at Advanced Organizations and at Flag Land Base by Class IV, OT III Advance Course Specialists. The end phenomena of "NED for OT's" Rundown is: Cause over Life. ORG: Organization.

ORG BOARD: (Organizing Board) a Board that shows what functions are done in the Org. The order they are done in, and who is responsible for them.

O.T. (Operating Thetan): A Clear who has become familiarized with his environment to a point of total cause over matter, energy, space, time and thought, and who is not in a body.

O.T. LEVELS: The solo auditing levels OT I through OT VIII. . . There are perhaps 15 levels above VIII fully developed but existing only in unissued note form, pending more people's full attainment of OT V, OT VII, and OT VIII.

OUT TECH: Means that Scientology is not being applied or is not being correctly applied.

OWN VALANCE: His own concept of himself. He's at the point of view from which he viewed the picture while it happened.

PC: Preclear.

PRECLEAR: A spiritual being who is now on the road to becoming clear, hence preclear. One who is discovering things about himself and who is becoming clearer.

PRESENT TIME: The time which is now and which becomes the past almost as rapidly as it is observed. It is a term loosely applied to the environment existing in now, as in "The preclear came up to present time", meaning the preclear became aware of the existing matter, energy, space and time of now. The point on anyone's time track where his physical body (if alive) may be found. "Now."

PROCESS: A question or set of questions or directions used by an auditor in a session to help a person find out about himself and life.

PROCESSING: See Auditing.

REACTIVE MIND: Comprises an unknowing, unwanted series of aberrated computations which bring about an effect upon the individual and those around him. It is an obsessive strata of unknown, unseen, unsuspected data which are forcing solutions, unknown and unsuspected, on the individual — which tells you why it remained hidden from an for so many thousands of years.

RELEASE: A release purely and simply is a person who has obtained results in processing and has a reality on the fact that he has attained those results. That severely is the definition of release.

SCIENTOLOGY: An applied religious philosophy dealing with the study of knowledge, which, through the application of its technology can bring about desirable changes in the conditions of life. (Taken from the Latin word SCIO - knowing in the fullest sense of the word, and LOGOS — to study.)

SESSION (AUDITING SESSION): A precise period of time during which the auditor listens to the preclear's ideas about himself.

SOLO COURSE: While this is a course, it is a prerequisite to the auditing levels to follow, as they are all "Solo" auditing levels, in that the person does the auditing himself. This course trains one how to solo audit.

STANDARD TECH: That tech which has absolutely no arbitrariness. Standard tech is not a process or a series of processes. It is following the rules of processing.

STUDENT HAT: Trains one on how to study successfully and how to resolve study difficulties before they defeat one's willingness to study. This course is vital for the study of Scientology courses and would be of great benefit to any student.

TECH: By tech is meant technology, referring to course to the application of the precise scientific drills and processes of depending context. The technology referred to is normally that contained in Hubbard Communications Office Bulletins, Books and Tapes by L. Ron Hubbard. It also means the "Technical Division" in a Scientology Church (Division 4, the division of the org that delivers training and processing).

THEORY: The data part of a course where the data is in books, tapes and manuals is given.

THETAN: The personality and beingness which actually is the individual and is aware of being aware and is ordinarily and normally the "person" and who the individual thinks he is. The thetan is immortal and is possessed of capabilities well in excess of those hitherto predicted for man.

TIME TRACK: The time span of the individual from beingness to present time on which lies the sequence of events of his total existence.

TONE ARM: Meter control lever on the E-Meter. (See page 8 of this issue for photo and information on the E-Meter. Also read E-Meter Essentials by L. Ron Hubbard available from Scientology bookstores.)

TRS: Training regimen or routines. TRs are a precise training action on Scientology courses which train students to communicate and audit.

VALANCE: A valence is a synthetic beingness, at best, or it is a beingness which the pc is not, but is pretending to be or thinks he is. That beingness could have been created for him by a duplication of an existing beingness, or a synthetic beingness built up by the descriptions of somebody else. A valence is a substitute for self taken on after the fact of lost confidence in self.

VIA: Means a relay point in a communication line. To talk via a body, to get energy via eating alike are communication by routes. Enough vias make a stop. A stop is made out of vias.

PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE EXPIRY


Any person who has obtained a certificate without having done a full internship and demonstrated his competence is subject to certificate cancellation if the certificate is not validated at the end of one year.

Therefore, all former — and present and future — students who have not done a full and properly conducted internship after a period of one year from the date of course completion shall have their certificates cancelled for the class not interned.

All past provisional certificates which have not been validated by an internship and which are one year old from the date of course completion are hereby cancelled.

Such students should be notified and should be enrolled on the internships for the class.

If a properly conducted internship is satisfactorily completed, the certificate may be reissued.
