

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• AMERICAN INDIAN DAY •



Having already passed the House of Representatives, upon its final passage in Congress, a new bill is designed to set aside as a National Holiday the third Saturday in September as American Indian Day in recognition of the role of our redskinned brothers in our national heritage. Fourth in a series of prophecies appearing in recent issues of Chimes, what Nostradamus has to tell the world of coming events has, on every occasion, created tremendous interest. So, "as the great kaleidoscope of the heaven speaks", let us see what additional interesting commentaries await us from Nostradamus.

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Within the past year, the great prophet, Nostradamus, has spoken direct voice with the writer four times. Many of his predictions already have come to pass and others are being fulfilied almost daily.

. We all know the important principle of Spiritualism that says, "The precept of prophecy contained in the Bible is a divine attribute proven by mediumship." ministration under President Kennedy is proving to be controversial and investigating. However, the true impact of his forcefulness as a leader has not yet been felt. He will change and will alter many former ideas held to be his predictions. This is as it should be. He will pave the way for a "new" government - - which is on its way even now.

Watch young Robert Kennedy for more reform and changes. The great scandal concerning the stock markets predicted last year has come to pass. This was unearthed by Robert Kennedy. There will be many more things in the nature of public revelations concerning graft in high places that will come out in the open, not only this year, but in the years to come, during this administration. The economic status of America, and the political atmosphere that affects it, shall continue to fluctuate in the next few years. The American stock market will reach a low, a bottom almost comparable to the 1929 fall. This is vet to come. Part of it has already come. It will rise again and fall again. However, it shall level off, and greater economic stability will be achieved.

International relationships will continue to fluctuate. Russia, always the great controversial figure, shall continue to figure prominently in newspapers and headlines of the world.

Amazing developments, both in nuclear science and in aeronautical science, shall come out of Russia in the next year. There shall be a continuing race between the two major powers for space supremacy (They will not be allowed, of course, to take over anything - I asked him about it). Russia is inherently weakening, but on the surface is more strong than suspected." (He had once said that Russia would fall as a rotten tree, decayed within, and I mentioned this to him.) He replied,

"It will still come that way, even as a rotten tree.

tree. "Beware of Russia's entanglements in all foreign countries, for its purpose is to annex, to confiscate, and acquire by any method, possession to itself. Thus a policy of aggrandizement shall be followed. Do not be surprised by statements issued from political leaders from Russia concerning its platform or its attitude concerning current issues.

"Trouble shall break out in China anew, and in Indo-China there shall again be war.

"Africa, a current troublesome place, shall continue to bring forth more trouble, and more disputes before the eyes of the world. One by one, the various sections of Africa shall gain their independence. It will take time to do this, as well as bloodshed and strife.

"India will continue to function prominently as a nation, and in the scheme of maneuvering, much shall be learned about the inherent strength of the Indian people or causitive issues.

"South America is a place of discord and inharmony. Much is to be revealed and will be forthcoming regarding political strategy and maneuvering for the actual freedom and independence of many of its countries.

"Scientifically speaking, your world is advancing at a terrific technicological rate, far beyond the ethical and spiritual development of man. This rate shall continue in the next 50 years, and the world in which you live shall become so mechanized, you will scarcely be able to recognize it as a natural world. Every field of science shall contribute great ideas and advances which shall help man better to understand the world in which he lives. We pray that it will belp him better to understand bimself.

"The religious aspects of your development are coming with greater force to the earth than ever before. People will be found willing and waiting for more truth as it is revealed. This shall continue with alternating storms. earthquakes, tidal waves, eruptions and other natural disturbance and destruction - - destruction that will make man more mindful of his spiritual duties. All of these things eventually will make and cause man to know that he produces his world, which is most vile, for the natural forces about you are directly influchied by your own thought atmosphere and attitudes. The byword of the coming years is to reveal light in darkened places, for there shall not be any place in the world that will not be touched by the hand of spirit. "GUILTY or NOT GUILTY"

. . . How can we find the peace and freedom we seek until we Cease Stoning Ourselves Mentally? . . .

Life is forever forgiving us. We must let the scales of superstition fall from our eyes and become aware of simple Truths which were always known. Truth has been distorted, twisted and prostituted beyond recognition. This is why guilt is universal.

In all ages people have been told to banish this sense of guilt, and they employed various ceremonies and rituals for this purpose. In olden days they sacrificed their bullocks or doves to propitiate the god of wrath. When storms came, crops ruined, or a great draught prevailed, the people believed the gods were angry. The jungle priest had to give the people an answer; if he did not give an explanation, they killed him. Therefore, the jungle priests gave answers which satisfied the superstitious imaginings of these people.

In remote parts of the world, people have sacrificed their children to appease the so-called angry gods of flood, fire, and famine. This is somewhat like paying a gangster, giving him tribute every week so that he will not throw a bomb into your store, in order to curry favour with him.

If you burn your hand, life forgives you, reducing the edema, giving you new skin, tissue and cells. Life does not hold a grudge against you. If you injure your hand, cutting it severely, life forgives you. New cells build bridges over the cut. Life is always forgiving you. Life is givingness and forgiveness. If you take some bad food, life forgives you, too, and causes you to expel and regurgitate it. Life has no ill-will against you.

We must learn to use the Lifeprinciple the right way and cease going against the stream of life. When a child is born it is a Universal Life individualizing itself and appearing in your home; rejoice! The child has no discrimination nor discernment; it has not begun to use its reason as yet; therefore is subject to the mood of parents.

Every child wants to follow its own inner inherent drives, and it thinks nothing evil about these things, but the father or mother who does not understand says, "You little brat, you are a sinner. You are a naughty boy. God is going to punish you. You are going to suffer for this." The child is baffled; he cannot reason out what is wrong, as he lacks discerment. He, therefore, feels cut off from love, protection and security, for this is what the mother represents to him. He feels that his mother is angry, and reacts perhaps by micturating at night, indicating that he wants to drown his mother in resentment. The child may also react in this way by becoming timid, weak and inferior, showing a deep sense of rejection.

A young boy might react to a cruel tyrannical father by becoming hostile, belligerent, and resentful. He knows his father is a big man, so he suppresses his anger. His rage is suppressed and it becomes a festering sore. Later on he finds himself opposed to authority because he has been against his father all his young life. He gets in trouble with the policeman, the professor at school, and other symbols of authority. He is always fighting his father, and he does not know it because no one has ever taught him how his mind works.

We have to live and adjust to authority. Wherever we go there is authority. We must learn to establish control over our thoughts, feelings and responses. We must take charge of our own minds. Man must take charge of his own mind and not permit others to govern it for him. Creed, dogma, tradition, superstition, fear, and ignorance rule the mind of the average man. The average man does not own his own mind at all. It does not belong to him; it is often-times ruled over and governed by the rank superstition of others.

We must realize that a great sense of guilt comes from what is called conscience. A great number of people believe that the voice of conscience is that of God; it is not. Conscience is your inner feeling and the voice of someone else; oftentimes it is the voice of ignorance, fear, superstition, falsehoods, and weird concepts of God. I knew a boy who feared that he would be punished by God because he did not go to church on Sunday. This is the inner voice of superstition and false belief implanted in his subconscious by his parents or teachers. This belief on the part of the boy gave him a sense of guilt, and he felt that he must be punished.

When you were young, you were given taboos, restrictions, homilies and a series of don'ts; you were perhaps told that you were evil, a sinner, and that God would punish you. Perhaps you, were told of a lake of fire waiting for you, if you did not behave and believe in a particular creed. The minds of children are contaminated and polluted with all kinds of strange notions and false doctrines.

A young boy said to me. "If I ride my bicycle without lights, I

would feel that I must be pumished, that I must fall because my mother said, 'You will fall; you are going to be hurt; you are naughty; you are going to be punished!' "

What a disastrous thing to tell a child. It would be so much better to tell him that he should not ride a bicycle at night without lights. Mother and father should explain thoroughly to the boy that the insructions are for his own good, for his own self-preservation. It is much better to tell a boy that God's Love will always take care of him rather than frighten him with dreadful, hypnotic suggestions of danger.

Children should never be told that they were born in iniquity and conceived in sin. They should be taught that they are children of God, that God is their real Father, and that God is Love. They should be taught also that Love cannot do anything unloving. Of course, there is the good conscience where the boy is taught the Golden Rule, love of others, and that honesty

RESCUE WORK

From the inner world, we who are on this plane see that many of your hearts are heavy because of what you call "tragedies" wherein so many of your loved ones are leaving your outer world so frequently through accidents. Behind the veil, however, there are millions and millions of helpers who work at what we call, "Rescue Work."

In our great Temple of Science here we have a department that teaches this Rescue Work. Many are qualified for this special type of work, yet who are not very spiritually minded as it is a very practical type of service. In this Temple one learns to use thought forces to create all that is necessary to assist the in - coming souls.

You, too, use your thoughts on the outer plane to build or create, but you have the tendency to create negative things much quicker than positive ones. Learn all you can, beloved ones, while you are here about the control of thought and how to use it to build constructively, for your thought affects your body and your circumstances. If you have fear, worry, grief, or hate in your mind, you attract these negative things to you. Léarn to build postitive thought habits.

Always pray for those who are crossing from the outer to the inner planes, for you will give them spiritual strength, courage and greater understanding of their new life and new experiences. When you read in the papers or hear about accidents, remember, that everyone is taken care of immediately regardless of the type of accident. When people leave the outer plane in great numbers through carthquakes, war, ava-lanches or disasters by fire, water or by air, then the Corridors are used for them. However, when only a few people pass, they are met by the Workers individually and the Corridors are not used.

Your hospitals on the outer plane are looked upon by us as a place of exit, and entrance, in the same way as you would look upon a great station where travelers are either coming in or leaving. Helpers are always on hand at a hospital to receive the out - going soul, and others are there to assist the in coming ones.

On the outer plane you go to great lengths to be sure an in coming soul is properly taken care of, do you not? You want the little new baby to have good health, and if there is an indication of weakness or a negative condition, the little one receives special care. We do exactly the same thing on the inner plane, with every facility at hand and munerous helpers to do this work joyously because they desire to do it.

There is never a time when these faithful helpers are not on duty around a hospital, because we do not know the exact moment a soul will pass. We wait, and if the waiting is long, then the helper is relieved by another, so there is no strain or stress. The Father carries out His Plan of helping His beloved ones perfectly. This work requires a great number of helpers, not only to help at the moment of passing, but also to help in the Recovery Homes, or Resting Places, as they are called.

Those who have had a difficult experience, either in passing or before, sleep and rest here in beautiful surroundings. The same idea is expressed on your plane with the new - born infant. After birth, it is placed where it can have quiet and rest until it awakens naturally. When a soul is thrown violently and suddenly out of the body through an accident with water or fire, etc., it is not immediately unconscious. Take a ship wreck, for example. The ship is sinking and people are struggling in the water. As they leave their bodies, they see what they think

is a boat coming to their rescue, and those aboard help them into the boat. If they are deeply religious, they think they see an angel picking them up out of the water. These blessed Helpers do literally take them into their arms, and they fall asleep to awaken in a beautiful place you might call a hospital where one who is called a "Watcher" sits by the new arrival and waits until he awakens. The length of sleeping time depends upon the needs of each soul.

Upon awakening, it is just as natural as when you awaken from your sleep each morning. One looks into the smiling face of a kind helper, perhaps of one of their own immediate family, who calms one's fears and explains the arrival into what is called the world of the "dead", though they feel so well, happy and alive.

To those who are trapped in a burning building, the Rescue Workers appear as firemen with every kind of apparatus for the saving of life. Those taken from the burning building think that they have been "saved", as they call it. It is the same with a plane accident. They think that the pilot has brought the plane out of the dive and that they have landed safely. Always everyone is taken care of during the transition, regardless of the state of evolution of the soul.

It is the loving Father's will that there should be no shock to the out - going soul and those who make the transition under these circumstances do not know until later they have entered into a new world. These dedicated Rescue Workers need your prayers, for you are the link between them and those they are trying to help. Send out on the Wings of Prayer a blessing to these unselfish workers who are constantly helping souls over the invisible line. They give this service joyously because their hearts are full of love to God and love to man.

What Says The Bible of REINCARNATION?

So many ask the question. "If the law of reincarnation is true, why isn't it mentioned in the Bible?"

Reincarnation is mentioned many places in the Bible, but people know little of the Divine law because of their lack of knowledge and have therefore placed a different meaning upon the passages in question.

"There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bore children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown."

The oldest Bibles, before many of the later translations, read as follows - - - "There were Nepthalim on the earth in those days Who were the Nepthalim? · · · · They were different from the men of earth, as is plain in the state-ment which calls them the sons of God. They were giants. Giants in stature, or Giants in ability? for they were mighty men and the sons became mighty men of old. How? Unless they were reincarnations of the men of old? It certainly does not mean that the daughters of men gave birth to old men!

However, the quotation reads, "When the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men - - -" This clearly leaves a distinction. There were two groups referred to - the Nepthalim and the sons and daughters of men. This could be confusing unless we differentiate between the two groups.

According to the Masters, the real story is as follows. Man began to look away from his source even began to deny God. So, God sent the Kumaras from Venus with a retinue of volunteers to teach the creation called man, whom Elohim had created on Earth. The Kumaras and their helpers instructed the most capable of the sons and daughters of men in the Divine Law. Through their understanding of the higher laws, man was enabled to create and build great civilizations.

Man also started the Mystery Schools under the Kumaras and the Nepthalim. The Pyramids and the Sphinx, a mystery unto this day, were built under the instructions of these advanced ones. They also studied mathematics, astronomy, and levitation.

The Pyramids were built by use of the law of levitation. Scoff if you like, but can man, even today, duplicate them with any known machinery? Can be project huge rocks, hewn to the proper dimensions of those in the pyramids, to the exactitude that a knife blade cannot be inserted between them? They were built without cement!

The question also remains: Who are the Scraphim? Who are the Cherubim? Yes, my friends, who are the Nepthalim? They are mentioned in the Scriptures also. They are part of GOD'S creation in advance of those known as man. If they were mighty men of old. mighty men of renown, they came back from somewhere. If they came back once, why not twice, and even more times? It gives one something to think about. In Matt., 16:14 there is a passage which reads as follows: "Some say that thou art John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets." This passage certainly is confusing, if reincarnation is not considered in its meaning.

Among the Jewish sects, there were four, we are told, two of which did not understand reincarnation, and two that believed Jesus was a reincarnation of Jeremias, or one of the prophets.

Is it not strange, that a passage in the Bible has been so little understood that in most cases it is misquoted or ignored altogether. Jesus said, "Follow thou me," but in reading and listening to various ones who propound the scriptures, I believe they must have thought he said, "Interpret thou me."

Why would John be asked if he were Elias or Jeremias unless it was believed they could return? If so, wouldn't that be reincarnation? The idea of resurrection would not do, because one would have to have come back from the dead. If we believe Jesus at all, we would have to give credence to His statement: "I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob! God is not the God of the dead, but of the living." That statement also tells us that these three were still living, not having died at all. Evidently then, they made their ascension. The only other meaning could be that having died, they are now reincarnated and among the living.

I cannot be accused of interpreting the words of Jesus. I can only be accused of taking them literally. If lesus did not mean what He said, why quote Him at all? That would mean that He was confused, not sure of what He meant. Nowhere in the Bible have I found where Jesus said. "In the years about 1900 and thereafter will come those who will correctly understand my words and translate them for posterity." John the Bap-tist did not deny that he was the reincarnation of Elisha, who was a contemporary of Elijah. When they asked him if he was Elijah. he said, "No." What could he say otherwise? He told them he was Elisha, the voice erving in the wilderness. If he were Elisha, he had been born again, a cousin of Jesus, son of Zacharias and Elizabeth. If that is other than reincarnation, someone explain it to me.

In John 3:3, we have his passage; "Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." And in John 3:7, "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again." My belief is that Jesus said what He meant; meant what He meant; and meant what He said.

Jesus said of John the Baptist, "This is Elias which was for to come," and the Disciples knew He spoke of John.

Now we come to the place in the scriptures which reads as follows, "Who was it that sinned, this man or his parents that he was born blind?" St. John 9:2.

How can a man sin and be born blind lest he had lived before? I have had people tell me that Jesus, in reply, said, "Neither, but that the God in him be made manifest." Here Jesus makes two mighty statements, to wit - - The God in him (the blind man), and that the God Self might manifest.

Was this blind man different than other men except for his

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Part I

My interest in genstones and jewels was originally stimulated by the readings of Edgar Cayce. Frequently, he recommended the wearing of a specific jewel or genstone in many of his psychic readings. He believed they increased the vitality of the body and affected the spiritual side of man. Cayce said these were not psychic toys, but tools that could aid in spiritual development. He also warned that if used for selfish purposes, they could "turn and rend" the user.

Many ancient philosophers be-lieved that jewels, gemstones and certain metals, correctly selected and directly applied to the human skin, would exercise an electromagnetic influence over the physical cells. Cayce said that this force was not electrical. He said that the vibrations of a correctly selected gemstone would assist in stepping up the sensitiveness of the human body. Some of the ancient philosophers believed that gemstones, through the vibratory forces arising from them, could help man to attune to the Creative Force of the universe. Often they have been used in periods of meditation by psychically and spiritually advanced peoples of all ages. Our own American Indian made such use of them.

When I moved to the Southwest, I made my first contact with the American Indian and the use of turquoise in his beautifully designed jewelry. Many of the Indians are excellent craftsmen. I met several while living in Flagstaff and Prescott, Arizona. When they knew of my sincere and serious interest in turquoise, they gave me many types to check on my electronic instrument. I also learned much of the story behind their very beautiful turquoise jewelry. Some of it cannot be published.

Turquoise, from the French, means Turkish stone. It was introduced to Europe through Turkey. Turquoise occurs in comparatively few places on our planet. It is confined almost exclusively to dry and barren areas. There are mines in


Arizona, Nevada, Colorado and in the Los Cerrillos mountains in New Mexico that produce turquoise of fine quality. It varies in color from a delicate sky blue to a deep, rich blue usually known as turquoise among painters and artists. My own investigations revealed that the turquoise from various areas has a different vibrational frequency when tested electronically.

Turquoise occupies a prominent place in the mythology and folk-lore of the Navajo Indians. It is used in the Mountain Chant and the Night Chant, two of the most important Navajo ceremonies. The Indians believe that the eyes are strengthened by looking at tur-quoise. The Navajos also believe that turquoise helps its owner to victory over his enemies. I doubt if we can get Congress to see that a piece of turquoise is attached to each of our defense missiles, but I am sure the Navajos would approve it. My Indian friends also tell me turquoise protects the wearer from injury. A young Navajo girl told me this beautiful, blue stone makes the wearer liked by all men. This could cause a lot of trouble if turquoise wearing became a fad.

I watched an Indian jewelry maker working one afternoon. He was using pure coin silver to mount the polished and cut pieces of turquoise. I asked him why he did not use some of the cheaper alloys. He told me that the mixed metals destroy the vibrations of turquoise and pure silver does not effect them. This was the first time I knew the Indians were vibrationconscious. I tested his theory and found him to be correct. The Navajo usually is, when he speaks. When I heard that the Navajo

wears his turquoise jewelry for the benefit obtained from its vibrations, 1 decided to check this stone for its vibrational frequencies. I was given a wide variety of turquoise for this research. Some from a secret mine that only two Indian tribes know about. That particular turquoise was so high in its vibrational frequency that it went off my instrument recording dials. Also, I soon found out that all turquoise is not filled with vibrations. When the slightest trace of copper. is in the stone, it will register zero when tested. After making this series of tests, I had decided that what was once supposed to be folklore was now fact, as far as I was concerned. Turquoise did give off vibrational frequencies which could raise the white light energy of the human body when worn.


dead or the undertaker would not close the coffin lid.

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Though out of print, this book by Dr. Wickland, which has been appearing in excerpt form in Chimes, has become a classic in the study of obsession by spirit entities. In the chapter which follows, the teachings of Christian Science are discussed by spirit entities. It is hoped that in presenting these excerpts people will be stimulated to think more for themselves, accepting no theory or doctrine at face value, learning not to lean on others, but conquering the self, and in so doing, learn through spiritual progression, where our true life is.

Chapter IX

Orthodoxy

The science of religion should teach an intelligent realization of the nature of God and the life hereafter, but humanity is still kept in subjection by fear, superstition, dogmas and creeds, and has not yet attained liberation through a full understanding of what becomes of the dead.

Passing through the change called death, a great majority remain in entire ignorance of their condition, and are bound for a time to the earth plane by their false doctrines. These cling to their orthodox ideus, often influencing those still in the body, and the mental derangements which frequently follow in the train of revivals are examples of these obsessions, as are the phenomena known as "The Gift of Tongues," and "Seizure by The Power," which accompany many revivals.

Religious exhortations readily lead to mental aberrations since invisible religious fanatics always are present who are unconscious of their transition and, having found no higher life, retain their mortal bigotry, and by their presence add to the insane fervor.

These spirits often make themselves audible to excited sensitives, for at such gatherings many are encouraged to listen to "the still, small voice," supposedly of God. During religious excitement, the psychic faculty is highly sensitized, giving mischievous spirits, as well as fanatical spirits, the proper opportunity to impress credulous persons with their whisperings.

Such entities, for their own deceptive purposes, may pretend to be angels, the "Holy Ghost," or "The Spirit of God," and the thoughtless victims, elated and unwilling to listen to reason, heed these whisperings, which so frequently lead to obsession and possession, resulting in madness, insanity and other psychoses.

The most difficult to enlighten of the earthbound spirits are the religious fanatics. Dominated in earth life by one narrow, fixed idea, opposed to logical analysis and independent thinking, they are found, after passing out of the physical, in a state of self-hypnosis, ceaselessly repeating their empty "religious" jargon.

Nothing exists for them but their dogmatic creed; they are adamantly set in their self-assurance, and it is often many years before they can be brought to a semblance of sanity.

Christian Science

The domination of any one fixed opinion to the exclusion of further mental growth holds the spirit in a state of non-progression, as has been attested by intelligences who on earth had held strongly to the Christian Science teaching regarding the non-existence of matter, and who have told of the difficulties encountered in freeing themselves.

A friend of ours had been a deep student of Christian Science and at the same time an investigator of the facts concerning spirit return. Shortly after he passed away he was brought to our circle to be awakened through controlling Mrs. Wickland, and has since told us something of the conditions in the spirit world.

Ella Wheeler Wilcox says in one of her poems that "the joy of a journey lies not in its speed." This is certainly true of psychic development. The pattern of mediumship in any given direction can yield an intense personal satisfaction to seekers if they know where they are going.

Every explorer is confronted with difficulties. Unknown terrain holds many frustrations, and psychic exploration is no exception. The trouble with would-be psychics is that many rush in where angels fear to tread without an adequate priming of knowledge. To desire mediamship is not enough. Some who sit for physical phenomena have no understanding own loved ones is also proved by the scent-power.

Once a psychic circuit is established with a sensitive, the only requisite from sitters demanded by guides is harmony among the group. The pattern of development cannot be decided by the aspiring psychic, yet this fact is often completely ignored. Development is decided by the psychic blueprint inherent in our bloodstream. The gate of gifts is closed at birth. Mediums are born not made. There can be no compromise with a psychic faculty. If it is within us in embryo, it will work its own way out.

Physical mediumship never attracted me, yet at my second visit to a physical circle I was subjected to a dramatic inpouring of power through the olfactory system. A strange oriental "tobacco" seemed to invade my system. I knew that a psychic circuit had been opened for me if I wished to take advantage of it. Five years have elapsed since that first visitation, but despite regular weekly seances the full pattern has not yet come into play.

We sit with our fingers lightly touching a small table, polkadotted with luminous paint. Music of a light, robust nature is played on a stereophonic recorder. Tablerappings of the message variety are not encouraged, but the table moves through an incredible performance of aerial gymnastics. The proceedings are: aided by the "piping-in" of scents peculiar to the psychic operators. Survival of our of their own personality. Imitation of conventional mediumistic patterns is the "kiss of death."

Development is a slow process, but the seeker can aid it by using his senses. There is much beauty in the everyday pattern of living. With a wild scream she leaped out of bed and fled into their room, where she spent the rest of the night. In mid-flight she noticed that the figure was rapidly disintegrating into thin air; and this may or may not have added to the speed of her get-away. Of course a search of

After that, things went from bad to worse. Once as my friend was coming down stairs, the mystery steps were going up, and as they passed he felt a cold current of air sweep by him. 
While my own experience in this field is admittedly limited, I have seen and heard enough to convince me of its reality. It is not necessary, however, to need one's own personal experiences to accept the existence of another dimension. An open mind is essential, however. Innumerable books on the subject yield a wealth of exciting reading by such reputable writers as Sir Oliver Lodge, through which, vicariously, one can enjoy the thrills of the supernatural. However, I believe the word "supernatural" to be a misnomer. As Ernest Holmes says, "Anything which occurs in Nature is natural, and the so-called 'supernatural' is merely a natural phenomenon which is not understood." To the ancients, thunder and lightning were "supernatural."

Man always has been fearful of that which he does not understand. We of the Western world have been much slower to accept the reality of the fourth dimensional powers than those peoples of the Far East, where the unseen forces of Nature are not only accepted as a matter of course, but to a large measure are controlled. Dr. Enid Smith, widely read world traveler and teacher of occult sciences, has written many vivid accounts of her experiences throughout the world in Chimes.

The marvelous achievements of the East Indians in the matter of apports, control of material matter with the power of mind, healings, accurate predictions of the future, and many other wonders are well known. But, instead of accepting these marvels for what they are, the skeptical Westerner will usually say, "It's a good trick, but I don't see how he does it.'

The Western mind is so deeply immersed in materialism it must have three dimensional proof in order to accept an explanation of any phenomena. Naturally it is impossible to give a physical explanation for a non-physical occurrence. But with such institutions as Duke University and numerous churches giving more and more thought to these unexplained phenomena, while hard-headed science is hot on the trail of a force which they admit is there, the time may not be far distant when the occult mysteries of to-day will be as "unmysterious" as thunder and lightning.

Robert Louis Stevenson experienced many strange things in the South Seas where "tupapas", or ghosts, were taken for granted and accepted as part of life. The "stonefalls" on his roof the night before a ship arrived have since then been reported by several other travelers. But with the advent of jet-planes, skyscrapers, and hot-rods these evidences of the Fourth Dimension are rapidly disappearing. Perhaps some wayward traveler on his way to the moon will make contact some time in the future, and that will settle matters once and for all.



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
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LESSONS FOR STUDENTS . . .

"Your Aura And What It Reveals"

Part II

Continuing in the study of the human aura, we learn that it is an infallible guide to the constitution and character of the individual . . . for all that he is, thinks, and does finds representation in his aura.

The study of the aura demonstrates the potency of thought upon ourselves and others, showing the necessity of regulating and consciously directing the mental energy and creativeness of our thoughts. Auric study teaches us that the invisible realms about and within us are not only realms of power, and therefore the most dominant realm, but are also realms of true beauty and loveliness. By fitting ourselves to see and recognize these higher spiritual realms, we come into harmony with them.

All beauty of the physical plane is but a reflection of the real beauty of mind and spirit. The practice of prayer, meditation, study, and selfpreparation will assist in developing clairvoyant power and the ability to see the auric emanations surrounding all persons and things. Following this, an understanding of color interpretations will prove helpful, and while space does not permit an exhaustive description of them here, the major colors and their auric meanings are outlined briefly.

It is to be remembered that the darker and more forbidding colors denote the lower mental - emotional characteristics of man, while the lighter and more lovely colorings are indicative of the higher qualities Also, just as there are many shades of any given color, so are there many shades of meaning produced in the auric colors. The blending together of several colors produces an over-all tone that needs careful and exact interpretation. However, the student should not become discouraged, for a knowledge of the basic color values may easily and quickly be attained with a little study and concentration.

We find *black*, which is the absence of all color, at the very lowest point of the spiritual scale. It denotes an almost complete lack of soul qualities. One may safely consider a person so surrounded to be malevolent, filled with base passions, even with murder in his heart. Often this blackness is shot with streaks of red, denoting the presence of anger to the point of physical violence.

Next in the scale of colors is brown, generally denoted as an earthy, material color. When it is dull, and of a reddish tinge, it indicates a nature filled with a desire for material things, often miserly, and living only for the satisfaction of the 'sense' life. Such an individual shows no human sympathy for the woes of others, living entirely unto himself, and creating an astral shell imprisoning him from which it may be a long and difficult task to gain freedom. Even when passing into the spirit world, advancement may be quite slow, because the soul powers of such an in-dividual have become almost dormant.

Next in the color scale come the various shades of grey . . . the color of sadness, depression, and sorrow. Often these grey color tones color the very skin of the person exhibiting them. The facial expression registers hopelessness and dejection. There is no buoyancy, no expectation or hope of coming good. Such a person has a depressing effect on everyone around him. Even one such person entering a room filled with happy people can bring into it a sense of uneasiness and disquietude, for moods are easily transferable qualities of the human soul. Mixed with red, grey denotes fear and often causes the face to turn ashen and the entire body to tremble.

Red is the next color to be considered. Here we have various interpretations, for clearness and color tone are the indicators. If dull and intermingled with brown, it denotes selfishness. On the other hand, in one whose nature is exalted, pure and unselfish, filled with love for God and man, a beautiful, clear rosy red glow appears, inspiring to behold. A person of such a nature asks no recompense for himself, but finds joy in serving others. When such a love is centered on spiritual things, it brings to itself the intellectual blue color, which, when blended, forms an indescribably lovely lilac color.

Lower in the scale of red, and lower in its spiritual value, is the color of *orange*. This is a shade of pride and self - ambition. It denotes a desire for personal prominence and renown, and is often linked with the emotion of irritability. A person with this color predominating would have little self control or tolerance for the desires or weakness of others when they clash with his own wishes and well - being.

Now comes the beautiful colorof green . . the shade of adaptability . . and when in clear, pure shades, has a great variety of meanings. When mixed with brown or grey, and dull in color, it denotes the self - seeking emotions of slyness, conceit, and pride. This predominates in many savage races. whose whole desire is for self gratification. In its darkest shades, it may indicate complete dishonesty and utter unreliability. Yet in its highest, most beautiful clear tones, one may find some of the loveliest qualities of human nature. the deepest sympathy and compassion and ability to see the needs of others and to minister unto them. When this becomes a pale, luminous blue - green, it denotes some of the best qualities in human nature.



we refuse to do this, we must suffer the consequences. I was an example of such a consequence. I went into Science with full will power and full faith that there is no such thing as matter and that we should overcome it. I tried and failed.

"Mrs. Eddy is suffering now for advancing that idea. When you have a dress that is wearing out, you try to get some material of the same color and quality with which to mend the dress. We do not do that with our bodies. We think the body should develop the substance it needs when it wears out.

"I did not get enough elements in my food to build up my physical body, my organs became atrophicd and sluggish and were inactive because I did not take the right food to give them proper activity.

'I should have gone to a physician to have him put me in a normal condition, but instead I tried to use my will to make things work. I tried by intelligence to overcome and build up the weak part of my body. That is just as if one refused to mend a worn place in a dress, insisting that no hole could come in that dress. I was just as foolish about my body, and I had to suffer the results.

"Probably some day things will be so understood that there will be no death . . . I mean, that we will merely step out of the physical body into the spirit world. If one would prepare himself for passing out of the body as he does for a journey, he would be able to say: "Now I am ready to go. I am through with this world. It is time for me to go, and I want to go to the spirit side of life." Then there would be no dread.

"Many Christian Scientists ruin lheir bodies by lack of right care anl often go as far as I did; they use will, no reason, and take improper nourishment, or not enough.

"I should have liked to remain on earth long enough to do the work I felt I should do but I will do the work on the spirit side of life, and when my wife comes, we will work together.

"I really lost all thought of things material, and I guess I thought we could live on air. I always thought conditions would change some time. I did not realize what was happening. I was so hypnotized in my work that I hardly lived in the material world.

"Don't let yourselves be hypnotized by ideas. Every theory has some good in it, but let us take the good and discard the rest.

"As Mrs. Eddy now sees these things, she wishes she could correct many of her statements. She now has to suffer for her mistakes, and it is very hard for her. Her followers come to the spirit side of life and expect to find things as she taught them."

Mrs. Eddy, herself, has spoken m our circle several times, and has brought invisible audiences which she has endeavored to free from the misconceptions acquired from her teachings relating to the problems of life and matter.

Experience: February 24, 1918 Spirit: Mary Baker Eddy Psychic: Mrs. Wickland

"I am here again, and I feel so sad. Do not doubt me, do not doubt me! Why will people doubt

me? "Help me! God help me! I am in a terrible condition.

"I knew about the wonderful truth of the life beyond. I knew it well while in life, but I shut the door because I wanted a religion of my own. Spiritualism belonged to the past days. I wanted something new, something higher, something better than spirit return.

"I taught that you must not let any entities control you, or influence you, or give you any inspiration, but that you must be yourself and develop yourself, and be one with the Infinite. Shut the door to the spirit world and be selfish . . . that was I. I had the truth of healing the sick. I was a medium, and in my younger days, my childhood, I was obsessed. As I grew older, no one knew what was the matter with me, for I had such queer spells. Now I know what it was ... an influence was controlling me whenever I had the spells. I was of a very nervous temperament, and I was cured of those spells by Dr. Quimby. He believed in the work of obsession. I took some of his doctrine and used it for my own. The doctrine would have been alright if I had not denied the finer forces in Nature.

"I was a trance medium and 1 gave readings, but I must confess I felt that was too common. I wanted to reach more intelligent people, because I found that Spiritualism would not reach the pepple I wanted to reach, so I took Quimby's doctrine and the vision I had of mortal mind in the Spirit world and combined the two. 1 want it understood that I used to give readings in Boston. I was very selfish and wanted to be somebody and have some kind of a religion where I could have a following. I wished once that on my birthday, church bells all over the United States would ring, and before I died I had that wish. I wanted to be the one that would be looked up

to. "I denied matter, but friends, as I told you one time, I had a vision, and I saw how they treated patients in the other world, but at that time I thought it was a dream. They were teaching the spirits that

there is no such thing as matter. They said: 'Forget it, it is only imagination. You are not sick, you just imagine it. That belongs to matter. That is only your mortal mind. You should overcome and develop the spirit within you.' I thought that this vision meant that 1 was to teach that on earth, and I set to work. Now I see my mistake, because there is matter, and so long as you live on the material plane you have to recognize matter. When you reach the spirit side of life your mind has to be taught to overcome matter, not eling to it, because spirits in darkness are clinging to matter as much as we cing to matter when we have our physical bodies.

"During the last of my days I was not myself very much. All through life I was back and forth on the invisible plane. You know, I was a psychic and I could have been a very good one, and have done more good to the world through my psychic power than I did. At the last I was too obsessed to be responsible for all I was doing. If I had used my psychic power, I could have helped thousands

"Many who were followers of my Church have gone into New

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ware ware a

Thought. From New Thought they come into a more spiritual understanding. New Thought is more liberal. In New Thought they branch out and, being liberal, will look into spirit return. They are more liberal in their reading of books. I forbade my people to read anything but Science books. That was because of my selfishness. I wanted a church of my own with my people under my thumb.

"How I do wish I had taught obsession, which I knew was true, but I did not. When I used to go into trances I wrote a great deal, and when I came to myself, I would deny what I got.

"If only I could get people to recognize matter and recognize the truth of life. If I could only go back to my Church and teach the truth, the genuine Truth of God! God is the Spirit of the Universe and we are a part of that Great Spirit. Understanding this, we can overcome matter."

Mrs. Eddy was then asked a question. "Is the little pamphlet called. "Confession by Mrs. Eddy from the Spirit World," authentic?

Spirit: "Ĉertainly it is. I am trying through every avenue to speak; I am not going to stop here. I will take advantage of every chance there is for me to tell the truth and reach my people. You may hear from others that I have talked with them. I want you here to help me spread the news, not much, just a little thought now and then will help. I will get my people together over here and bring them to you, if I may come once in a while, for I can reach them more easily when I control a mortal body."

Further evidence of the fact that Mrs. Eddy, when on éarth, knew the truth regarding the spirit side of life and the earth-bound condition is found in one of the early editions of the Christian Science textbook in the chapter on "The Science of Being."

"If the Principle, rule, and demonstration of Being are not in the least understood before what is termed 'death' overtakes mortals. they will rise no higher in the scale of existence at that single point of experience; but will remain as material as before the transition, still seeking happiness through a material instead of through a spiritual sense of Life, and from selfish and inferior motives. So long as the error or belief lasts, that life and mind are finite and physical, and are manifested through brain and nerves, so the penalty of sickness, sin, and death will continue. To the other, the spiritual class, relates the scripture: 'On such the second death hath no power'.

Science may say this is incorrect and unscientific. But science once said the world was flat. We agree that it is quite round now. Science once said a trip to the moon was scientifically impossible, but our government is now planning one. Maybe science will agree with the Navajo one day and say turquoise does have beneficial vibrations in it. The Navajos and I believe it right now.

The turquoise from the Los Cerrillos mine appears to be of a very high vibrational frequency and high in quality. This mine was used by the Spanish Conquistadors when they were in that part of our country many years ago. Another favorite type of turquoise is that mined in the north of Arizona called Broken Sky Turquoise. I was also fortunate in obtaining some turquoise from the Lost Apache Mine known to only a few Apache Indians. It was a beautiful genstone with a very high frequency of vibration in it.

A middle - aged mother is distraught, inconsolable. Her lovely young daughter's body lies in state in a closed casket at a local funeral home, denied Christian burial services by the church to which the family has belonged for generations. Condenned to wander, a lost soul, in the dark mists of eternity forever and ever, according to the dictates of creed, this unhappy child would never again be reunited with her loved ones. Even the youthful body must lie in unhallowed ground until the end of time.

Thousands upon thousands of times this scene, with variations of kaleidoscopic phases, has been repeated since the world began. Whether it be a son, daughter, lover, husband or wife, or other dear one - - anyone of us might find ourselves faced with the agony of losing someone by suicide.

When orthodox churches turn away in this time of great need (though, fortunately, this is becoming more rare as time goes on), the surviving relatives and friends ofttimes look to Spiritualism in the hope that they will be comforted. Because religion has not comforted them, many surviving ones have felt that they have been given a stone instead of bread, a husk instead of hope. They have wept until there were no more tears, in desperate, futile helpessness. Why should a hasty, regretful decision to end one's life bring with it the price of eternal extinction or damnation? Surely a just God would not be so vengeful! Isn't "His will done in heaven," even if not upon earth? Would we be asked to forgive our brother "seventy times seven" if He would not forgive us, His children? We are told that with the Father, even the fall of the sparrow is marked. Does He care less for us?

Granted, suicide may be wrong, and in most cases there is a way out. Many suicides would have lived a long and useful life had they not in one desperate moment terminated it. According to most modern authorities, however, such a victim is a very insecure person - Ann Landers terms them as "desperately disturbed".

Must they suffer until the end of their natural life - span, as some Spiritualists believe? Just what is envisioned here as a "natural" life span? Are we all set in motion by Fate, who ticks off each allotted second, then gathers us to our ancestors at the stroke of twelye? Absurd!... unless we abolish free will entirely. Conversely, without free - will, suicide would not be possible unless ordained. In this case, the punishment of helpless puppets would be a huge farce and utterly senseless.

Just for the sake of argument, how many of us live out what could be called our natural lives? Sup-

pose, at birth, we have a longevity of one hundred years, provided the body is expertly cared for, and is fed a correct diet (diet is a subject on which even the "experts" in nutrition do not agree) for the individual physical and chemical combination for that particular type of organism. Under these conditions, barring accident, we might live out our time. However, most who do reach the century mark have inherited sturdy physiques, and, in reality, should have lived to one-hundred fifty or beyond! However, most everyone treats his body much worse than his car or

crimination. That's the physical side of it.

Now, let's look at the spirit side of Life. A baby dies after taking only one breath. What becomes of it? We are told that the infant is taken into loving arms, mothered and cared for by spirit friends or relatives, or is taken to a "mursery" until the proper home is found to receive the child. There it grows rapidly, until adult stature is reached. These spirit children are happy and live an entirely normal life, none the worse for not having finished out their normal life span in the physical. This may seem like

his furniture. From birth, we stuff ourselves with pastries, soft drinks, tobacco and alcohol. We avoid vegetables and fruits - - we skip vitamins, minerals and proteins. So, we lose our teeth and we crack up mentally and physically at an early age. Isn't this a form of suicide?

Many of us also indulge in temper fits, worry, fear, and other destructive emotional binges - - another way of shortening life. Some of us literally drive others mad, causing them to take their lives! Examples: A lover deserts his pregnant sweetheart. A mother ties her child to her with ropes of selfish love, and will not allow the child a life of his own. Then there a digression from our subject, but it illustrates how the spirit body is *not* dependent upon the physical body, as some seem to think. The reason for this is simple.

The reason for this is simple. While some schools of thought hold that the spirit body is nurtured in the cocoon of the physical envelope, from spirit we are told that the spirit body has reincarnated many times during which there was ample opportunity to acquire a complete spirit vehicle. However, the change of rebirth does leave the imprint of the new physical body, and the spirit generally will grow into this form, or be remodeled by it . . not always, however. Sometimes older souls revert almost immediately to a

is the husband who, in his brutality, drives his wife to take the "only way out". So, who are the guilty? Who are the condemned?

There are also those who take needless *chances* and come to an early death . . . the stunt man, the test pilot, the astronaut, the speedracer, etc. What of these?

Let us admit that death is no respecter of persons. Whether one is one second old or one century old, death comes to all without disformer-life shape and personality, probably the one held in the incarnation before the short infanthood. Usually, this is what happens in the case of premature death of the unborn, whether abortion or miscarriage. The deciding factor here is: Did the infant breathe? If it took one breath, it drew the waiting spirit entity into it and started a new cycle. (Even though in premature cases where the breath was unnoticed or unrecorded on 'earth, if the spirit was drawn into the infant body, it will very likely take that form in the astral world.) This is the answer to the unfinished or immature life span theory; it applies to any kind of death - - - suicides included.

Conclusions: There is no socalled "normal life span." The spirit body is not dependent upon the physical for development.

Self-murder can be caused by emotional instability or insanity brought on by great emotional strain, malnutrition, drugs or chemicals. A Soviet scientist of repute, the late G. Yu Mallis, disbelieves that hereditary factors are a cause of schizophrenia. He claims there is evidence of toxins as a cause of this phase of mental illness, including toxins from viruses. Considering the many poisons we encounter daily via sprays, drugs, etc., it is a wonder any of us escape becoming a schizophrenic! Remember, this is only one form of mental illness.

Question: Are the emotionally ill responsible for self murder? Of course not! Then how about the one who goes temporarily beserk and ends it all - - is he responsible? Shouldn't he have controlled himself? Perhaps he was not in control, simply because he was obsessed by a spirit entity. He may not even have been in his own body at the time, having been dislodged by the obsessing spirit. In this case, it was no suicide, for it was the entity in control that killed the body that was not his! This is murder, not suicide.

Then what happens to the rightful owner of the body? According to spirit information, he may be entangled in a negative condition for a time, but help will arrive and he shall be set free. If we pray for such a victim, it draws spirit attention to him sooner that he might be set free. Always pray for those who have met a violent death. This brings aid to souls lost in a vibratory field, or dimension, far removed from higher spirits. Such souls are sometimes caught in a web of time and space, so to speak (not always, however), but they need help, if such should be the case.

What of the ones who were ill, driven by torment until they went mad with pain, and ended their physical life to stop the agony? We "put our dumb animals away" when they are incurably ill, old or injured - - but not so with human beings. They must suffer to the last bitter gasp. Could you or I undergo such agony? Perhaps. It depends upon the threshold of pain which differs with each individual. Some suffer more than



is the best policy. When a boy is about to steal, there is that within him which tells him, "No, you should not do that."

The parents are there to teach the child the difference between a rat-poison and butter, the difference between the skunk and the cat, the difference between what is right and what is wrong. The child has to go to school; he has to learn manners; but indoctrinated properly, he learns what is right, true, noble, and God-like. Yet how many are taught these qualities today?

Everyone wants self-esteem, wants to feel worthy, wants to be recognized by his neighbours as honest, sincere and good. You want your children and your wife to love you. You want the respect of the community. When a man falls short of expressing himself in doing the right thing, he feels a sense of guilt and proceeds to punish himself.

I knew a man who worked every night until about one o'clock in the morning. He paid no attention to his two boys or his wife. He was always too busy working very hard. He thought people should pat him on the back because he was working so arduously and persistently past midnight every night. He had a blood pressure of over two hundred and was full of guilt. Unconsciously, he proceeded to punish himself by hard work and completely ignored his children. A normal man does not do that. He is interested in his boys, etc., he does not shut his wife out of his world.

I explained to him why he was working so arduously, "There is something eating you inside, otherwise, you would not act that way. You are punishing yourself." He did have a sense of guilt; it was towards a brother; then he realized what he had been doing to himself.

I explained to him that God was not punishing him; however, if we misused the laws of life, we would suffer accordingly. If a man puts his hand on a naked wire, he will get burned; electricity itself is not evil. The only sin is the ignorance of the law, and the only punishment is the automatic reaction of man's misuse of the law.

If a man misuses the principles of chemistry, he may blow up the office or the factory. If he strikes his hand on a board, he may cause his hand to bleed. The board is not for that purpose; its purpose may be to lean upon or to support your feet.

The man realized that God does not condemn or punish anyone, and that all his suffering was due to the reaction of his subconscious mind and to his own negative and destructive thinking. He had cheated his brother at one time, and the brother had now gone on; still he was full of remorse and guilt.

I asked him, "Would you do that now?

He said, "No." "You felt that it was the right thing to do at that time?"

His reply was, "Yes." "But you would not do it now?" He added, "No. I am helping others to know how to live."

I added the following comments, "You have a greater reason and understanding now; the past is dead, nothing lives but this moment; you change your destiny. Forgiveness is to forgive yourself. You cannot forgive another without first forgiving yourself. Forgiveness is getting your thoughts in line with the Divine Presence and the Divine Law of Harmony. Self condemnation is hell, forgive-ness is heaven!" This man was completely healed and became free.

Self-condemnation is one of the most destructive of all mental poisons, sending psychic pus all over your system. It destroys your vitality, enthusiasm, energy, and may affect all. If you have a glass of dirty water, you may condemn, resent, and curse it indefinitely, but you will not get clean water. However, if you continually pour clean water into the glass, you will have clean water.

A man who had committed a crime in Europe came to see me in Los Angeles some vears ago. He was suffering from great mental anguish and torture, believing that Cod must punish him. He explained how he had done the crime on the spur of the moment. This had happened about fifteen years ago. In the meantime, this man had married and had three lovely children; he was in a position where he helped many people and was a transformed man.

My explanation to him was to point out that physically and psychologically he was not the same man who did the crime, as every cell of his body had changed every year. Moreover, mentally and spiritually he was a new man; he was full of love and goodwill for humanity. The old man who had committed the crime was dead and gone; actually he was condemning an innocent man!

This man understood and realized that death and resurrection are constantly taking place in our lives. Man must die to that which he is, before he can live to that which he wants to be. This man realized the significance of the Truth in the Bible: "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord; though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." (Isaiah 1:18).

others, depending upon capacity. Judge not!

Even in such a case, the soul - because of conditions of torment, is hurled into the lower astral planes, will revive, and be aided by spirit bands of rescue workers whose task it is to revive such souls. He will not have to await any certain "time" limit in order to enter the higher planes and find the larger life where normally he would have belonged had he not contracted the illness that drove him to an untimely end.

Do none suffer the consequences of self destruction? Do all go free? No! If suicide is done for a trifling reason, the entity reaps the adverse rewards for his act. An example of this is the trumped-up "accident" of one man who faced bankruptcy and wished his wife to receive his insurance. How long one suffers for taking such a step is not for any mortal or immortal to say. It varies. Time is extremely variable in the spirit world. Years can pass like days, weeks, or hours, or hours can be like days of our time. We can be sure, however, that any trifling reason for suicide would have dire consequences. Of that, make no mistake!

Here is an actual case history: A young boy shot himself in the head. He had been a brilliant student, scientifically inclined, had a good home, and apparently was emotionally well adjusted. He left a note that was found after his death. In this he gave the reasons for taking his life. "I wanted to find out what it feels like to die," he stated. Being of a scientific turn of mind, he had given this subject quite a lot of thought, until the experimentation obsessed him beyond the point of no return.

After his death, I contacted my spirit guide, Helen Dearman, and asked what had become of the boy "over there". She told me: "He is alone in semi - darkness, like a twilight, or what we call 'the gray zone'. He brought this upon himself, and he must stay there and think until he realizes his wrong. He was very selfish in cutting his life short and causing untold grief to his loved ones. Nor was he mindful that his untimely 'end' may have deprived others of the results of his labors to help humanity, for he was extremely gifted.'

I asked, "How long will he be in this condition?" Helen replied that she didn't know exactly, that it all depended upon how soon his conscience was awakened. "Then he must do all in his power to help others, and so make up for the great mistake he made. But he will be alright, "He is a good soul under-





is usually made in a manner which suggests that science is the final word in relation to the problem under consideration. This definitely is not true. Scientific facts have been discarded over and over again during the last one hundred years. Let us get this point quite clear; a scientific fact is knowledge and belief which is based upon the present limit of man's understanding. After all, science is merely a system of inquiry. It is the most reliable system as yet known to man, but it is not infallible. Even in relation to the unit of life known as man, science has not vet been able to locate, let alone handle, the human mind. That mind is a reality, science will agree. They have no option, because mind produces effect, and there can be no effect from illusionary objects.

Spiritual healing produces effect and, by the same process of reasoning, it must have a basis of realism. Spiritual healing produces effect far greater and with equal regularity to the effects produced in the laboratory in relation to other researches. In the laboratory, atomic changes take place; so also do they take place as a result of spiritual healing.

The removal of a goitre, the unlocking of a joint, the restoration of sight or hearing, the removal of pain which has defied even our greatest medical men, these and many other conditions which are corrected by spiritual healing, all have shown the same reaction to a cause, as have the greatest experiments ever conducted in the test tube. Today it is not a question of whether a change takes place; that has been demonstrated often enough to convince even the most hardened skeptic. It is more a question of the relationship between the effect and the cause. If the effect of healing is not produced by a cause known and accepted by science, if it is not produced by a natural cause, then it must be produced by some other force or power. There are no effects which are the result of a miracle. Only a law-governed force can produce healing. Healing is a law-governed force directed by Spirit.

Science has taken man a long way towards knowledge and understanding. It has solved many of the problems of land, sea and air. It has increased the human span of life. It has freed man of much pain and suffering from some of our most dread diseases. But alas, science has brought untold suffering by its mis-use of knowledge. By the immoral application of nature's gifts, science has brought the human race to the verge of destruction.

Science has never attempted to reconcile the physical with the metaphysical. It has concerned itself purely with the physical body of man. It has never ventured bevond bone and flesh where life has been its study. That man is Spirit clothed in a physical body for the purpose of its short period on earth, has never presented itself to science even as a possibility. Science, like all other forms of human thinking, is governed by the very laws which it has itself brought to light. It is governed by cause and effect. Science cannot forever reject supernormal phenomena as being phenomena, not within the scope of its study. Sooner or later it will be compelled to face the fact that there is something more than a physical body.

Spiritual healing will one day become the object of scientific research. The work of healing will then be simplified. There will be no need to search for effect. Science will search only for the cause. How tragic that it should do so after the facts already have been established that healing is a gift of Spirit. This fact was known to man long before the coming of science.

neath it all; being only a child, he is not as responsible as he would have been had he been older."

Another case is that of a friend's relative, a woman, who took her own life. I do not know the details, but he told me that upon contacting her spirit, she spoke of being in a dark place and climbing hard marble stairs for three years following her "death". She had been climbing, climbing, with no end in sight yet. I told my friend to pray for his relative. Also, if he had contact again, to try to explain her condition to her. Probably she was not aware that she had "gone over".

In closing, let us say to those who mourn and grieve for loved ones who have taken the "easy way out. . . pray for your beloved- pray, pray, pray! Let the prayers be of hope. Ask the Father's blessing and help that through evolved spirit forces they may find and aid these lost ones. Above all, do not hold gloomy thoughts of grief or despair when thinking of your loved ones. Send your affectionate, happy greetings, your hopeful wishes. Send flowers and lovely things to cheer them in their dark hours. 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
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
