

Spirit Phenomena

THERE is no question in the mind of the sincere medium that Spirit phenomena is a reality. The door between this wonderful manifestation of the continuity of life and man's mere mortal comprehension of same will be thrown wide open, if those who seek proof come into the seance room with reverence for this expression of eternal life, which they are about to witness, also, they must be grateful to those on the Spirit Side of Life, who make the demonstration possible. For it is very necessary that spirits develop and prepare themselves over there to be able to lower their vibrations to the low rate of the earth plane, and to be able to communicate with those still in the body. There is trickery—yes!—in much of the phenomena presented to the public. That is the reason the whole world today is not of one religious mind—believers in Spiritualism. The honest investigator of Spirit phenomena sincerely hopes to be convinced. Then he contacts a medium, who once had wonderful manifestations, but because of immoral living those on the Spirit Side have taken away the power, and the bereft one, rather than admit he or she is no longer able to demonstrate, resorts to cheap trickery. Sometimes that one proceeds to earn a living on the stage by the so-called exposure of Spiritualism. Immediately the cry goes

up that all Spiritualist mediums are fakes. We have never been able to understand **why** the Spiritualist Church errs in this respect more than any other sect—**why**, because of a few illiterate or untruthful mediums we all are fakes, as the general public would have us branded. In all denominations, we find black sheep—erring preachers, who are a disgrace to the religion they represent.

We Spiritualists have only pity in our hearts for those who condemn us. In the first place, they are tampering with God's holiest expression of His greatest creation—eternal, continuous, expressive Spirit life. In the next place, they miss so much! Because of their determination (or shall we say "stubbornness") not to be convinced, and the great loss in failing to contact and communicate with the so-called dead—they close the door on comfort, advice, and aid for the material as well as the spiritual side of their being. If every mortal realized what Spiritualism really is, how it makes of life a vivid, ever-increasing adventure, something more to look forward to than a gray, monotonous existence, ending in old age, and finally, in so-called death, there would be no other religious belief but the soul-satisfying, life-guaranteeing creed of Spiritualism.

We make no statements we cannot prove—both by the Old and the New Testament, and by experiences in our own lives.

To be a Spiritualist is to live a life of peace, poise, and power knowing we are never alone, never forgotten by the higher forces of life. To be a Christian Spiritualist is to follow the teachings of the Christ exactly as every Orthodox church does today, and in addition, to prove eternal life by Spirit return and Spirit communication; also to prove Jesus' promise: "The works I do you can do, and greater works" (healing).

The truth of Spirit phenomena has become an acknowledged fact, its investigators being men of scientific reputation.

Mrs. Grace G. Durand, in her interesting book "Sir Oliver Lodge Is Right," quotes the Rev. H. W. Thomas, the great Methodist preacher, as saying: "I am a Spiritualist. I would have to give up the Bible if I denied the ministering spirits."

"Henry Ward Beecher said: 'There have been times in which I declare to you heaven was more real than earth; in which my chil-

children that were gone spoke more plainly to me than my children that were with me . . . It is generally admitted from the very beginning of things that this world has been open to the influence of spirits. That false notions have arisen during the ages concerning Spiritualism does not prove its fallacy by any means.' ”

Apropos of this last, “The Rev. R. H. Newton (Episcopalian) said: ‘Spiritualism is a truth which is embodied in the records of the very beginning of our Christian religion.’ ”

“Rev. Joseph A. Milburn (Presbyterian) said: ‘You cannot laugh at Spiritualism. Only shallow people laugh at Spiritualism. Only ignorant people laugh at Spiritualism. The thoughtful man no longer laughs at the Spiritualist. That man is reaching for a truth beyond the truth that he can find within the boundaries of the visible church.’ ”

J. Godfrey Raupert of London, lecturing to Catholics, said: “‘It is no longer possible to put the phenomena aside . . . Consequently the Pope has asked me to tell Catholics just the attitude to take toward this mysterious subject . . . The Church admits the reality of these phenomena.’ ”

“Archdeacon Colley of England says: ‘Spiritualism comes as a God-send to millions who are incapable of believing the Christian faith without its aid. It teaches that death is the gate of life, hence that there is continuous and immediate and conscious being without no sleeping in the grave.’ ”

“‘Italia’ of Rome, a few years ago, said: Joan of Arc recently appeared to Pope Pius and addressed to him solemn words of encouragement and exhortation. It was while the Holy Father was indulging in devout prayer and meditation in his private oratory immediately after the ceremony of reading the decree of beatification that the spirit appeared.’ ”

Mrs. Durand, herself, says: “When I can stand today and say openly and fearlessly that I speak directly to those who have passed over to Life Eternal, or what the world calls Death, the worldly wise, the skeptical, the ignorant, superciliously smile or perchance may pity. Nevertheless it is a fact that it is as natural for

me to speak to those on the other side,' as we say, as it is to speak to those in the flesh. The voices are as distinct, oftentimes more distinct, than the voices of some human beings."

Personally, the writer has experienced marvelous Spirit phenomena when only three people sat in a seance. The strong, clear notes of the guitar, and the organ-like accordion played the accompaniment as another spirit guide's distinct words came through the trumpet, joining one of the mediums and a student in singing "The Old Rugged Cross," "Face To Face," and "There Is Power In the Blood." The fact that this was the first time the guitar had been brought into the seance room and Rosa, the educated Gipsy guide, played it with strength and expression, and without a pick, made this demonstration out-of-the-ordinary.

Joe Blevins, who, when on the earth plane, had been a professional accordionist, had soloed in the seance room twice before. Likewise, Pat McDonald, the trumpet guide, often sang with us, and if he did not know all the words, he would continue to carry the tune, finishing with a vigorous "ta-ta-ta-tee-tum." But the remarkable feature of this performance was that there were only three people from whom the Spirit Forces could draw the necessary chemicals for the demonstration. Yet the Spirit music and the Spirit voice would have been a credit to a public entertainment.

Oh, the wonderful strength and knowledge displayed by those on the Spirit Side! Wonderful, too, the patience and the desire to please the instrument in any request, and the enlistment of the Higher Forces when a medium will not tolerate anything but The Truth in the seance room! Over there, like on the earth plane, there are Spirits good, bad and indifferent, and all are eager to demonstrate that life is eternal for them and every one else. Like attracts like, here and hereafter. If you desire only the best in Spirit phenomena, ask for it, prepare yourself for it by raising your standard of living to balance it; then open the door only to the highest, and as you seek, so shall you find.

Your Health

The Spine

YOUR body is the temple of the Living God, so you should do your part to keep it healthy and supple.

Start with your spine. Make it flexible, and keep it that way by the following exercise. Just before retiring at night, and immediately upon rising in the morning when you are wearing no restricting clothes, is the time for exercise.

With your soles flat on the floor, and as if they were glued to the floor, stand with your feet 3 inches apart. Then lean slowly forward, the body limp, and touch, or try to touch your toes. Not easy at first, but you can accomplish it, if you make the effort. With the head and arms at your sides limp, wiggle the spine until every vertebra seems to move. Then sway the limp body in a half circle. Straighten up, always keeping the body limp, and sway backward, forward, and from side to side. Next, erect again, loosen the shoulders by wiggling them up and down.

With your feet still glued to the floor, and arms above your head, reach up until you feel every muscle in your body stretching, glowing with vitality.

This exercise, practiced twice a day, once at night, once in the morning will put spring in your step, youth in body, and roses in your cheeks.

Your Eyes

Your most treasured physical organ should be the windows of your soul—your eyes. Correct foods (those with the "eye" vitamins), exercise, cleanliness, and sufficient rest are necessary for eye health.

For correct foods, eat plenty of Vitamin A, such as butter, cream, egg yolk, milk, lettuce, corn, carrots, tomatoes, celery, prunes, oranges, pineapples, bananas, and apricots. The deeper the color of the ripe fruit, the yellower the corn, the greener the lettuce, the better the course of Vitamin A therein.

Exercise: Blink the eyes often, slowly, then faster, and while blinking look up, look down, and from side to side. Roll the eyeball slowly from right to left. Then reverse.

Cleanliness: Use an eye cup, and a weak solution of salt water, or weak, lukewarm tea to clear the eye of dust and mucus discharge. Weak tea will clear the eye of a blood-shot condition or red-rimmed eyelids. Never use the same eye cup solution for both eyes. If one is diseased, the other will become infected. When one eye is cleansed, empty the eye cup, and fill with fresh solution before treating the other eye.

Sufficient Rest: Do not use the eyes continually. Rest them for short periods. A few minutes' rest, with the eyes relaxed and closed, is helpful. Also, correct lighting for reading or working is important.

Call upon Spirit to manifest in all your health efforts, and great will be the result thereof. Take normal care of your eyes, and they will be healthy, and serve you for a lifetime.

Over half the population above 40 are so affected, most of them unknowingly, because the internal organs usually break down without warning. This is one reason why you should exercise special care in your elimination. Watch the skin, the lungs, the intestines, and especially the kidneys. They eliminate 75 percent of poisonous waste, much of it in highly concentrated form. Your precaution: bathe internally and externally. Drink plenty of good pure water. Get sunbaths and airbaths. Eat properly and avoid any damaging drugs, such as alcohol, tobacco, etc. Drinking plenty of water washes the poison out of the system. Yes, indeed, life may begin to end at 40 or it may begin to really start. We hope it is starting for you."

The Course in Unfoldment

The Silence

“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.”

THE FIRST step in unfoldment is to go into the sanctuary of your being — into the silence — the secret place of the Most High — and learn to concentrate. If you would hear the voice of God — guidance — you must be still and listen to that which speaks within you. When you are able to center your consciousness on the Divine — the Spirit of the Almighty within — your soul unfoldment begins, and wisdom, inner understanding, and Spirit Illumination are yours. You then are at peace with yourself and your God, and truly you shall abide hence forth and forevermore under the shadow of the Almighty.

Going into the silence means to quiet the mind and body, to be perfectly relaxed, and unconscious of time and space. **GOD-CONSCIOUS** we may well call it. To realize this, when alone, lie down fifteen minutes each day. Stretch out comfortably, and take three deep breaths. The breathing brings quick and thorough relaxation, and lying down takes all strain off of the heart and nerves, the two main tense centers of the body. Close your eyes, and lie limp and quiet, your mind a blank. In a few minutes, all material problems will be cleared out of your consciousness, and the Spirit will take possession. What you receive you may choose to call the voice of Intuition, but it is Pure Spirit speaking to and through **you**.

We must surround ourselves with peace and harmony, if we would have our soul grow and expand. It may seem utterly impossible at first to forgive some people, or to hold a cheerful attitude of mind under some conditions, or to smile when pain twists our bodies, but easnest effort on your part, and God's ever-abiding, merciful guidance will bring it to pass. You will learn to regard your Silent Hour as a necessary part of the beginning of your day or its close, for with each sitting comes a feeling of being blessed by God and the Angel World. This all-enveloping sense of strength, knowledge, and Divine guidance goes with you when you close the door of your sanctuary, and take up the duties of the material.

For this quarter, go into the Silence as above instructed. After which, once you have learned complete relaxation, you may practice the Silence sitting in a straight chair, which is the way most people do it.

May you ever realize the presence of The Master, and may God, the Almighty, and the Spirit World draw very near to you, and bring you the desires of your heart. Remember always: "With God all things are possible."

For the First Quarter, read and study Genesis from the Spiritualist viewpoint. Choose an hour or more, once a day, or once a week, and the same place in which to study. This is very necessary so that you may get a spiritual vibration — that is, create your own vibration through contact with the Spirit Side of Life. Each time, ask the Spirit to manifest by guiding your interpretation. Your equipment is a Bible, a pencil and a note book. Mark your Bible with a colored pencil, underscoring or placing in parenthesis any verse that may attract and hold your attention. On the first page of your note book, write the date, followed by one verse, which is to be your key thought for that day, and which you are to memorize, and repeat as often as you think of it until the next verse is written. Every day write a date and a verse.

Begin at Genesis 1:1, and read slowly and thoughtfully as much as you can during your Bible period. At the close of the quarter, you will be surprised at the progress you have made spiritually along the King's Highway, the road that leads back to God and Soul Peace.

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
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
