



The Voice of The Soul

There seems to be a great deal of misunderstanding and misinformation about just what the soul really is. It is often confused with "mind", which is our thoughts and feelings, or with "intellect", which is the power of knowing—or, in other words, our receptive faculty.

The psychologist will tell you the soul is a part of our mind, or conscious experience. The philosopher says the soul is rational thinking and will power, which places man above the brute. The scientist says it is man's moral or emotional nature, the center of his real life, his vitality, his action.

Then there are those who say "spirit" and "soul" are the same. They are not. Spirit is the life-principle, the breath of life, the gift of God. The current use of the word "spirit" means a disembodied soul, as spirits of the so-called dead, or a being which never had a physical body, a being created by God as a celestial messenger, and having lived in spirit form only: Spirit has the power to think, to know, to move, to speak.

The word "spirit" as used in the Bible denotes either the divine breath in the body, or out of the body. We, each one of us, are a spirit, now clothed in a physical body. When we pass out of the physical body, we shall still be a spirit, but a spirit in a spiritual body. The divine breathe is expressed in its highest form in the Holy Spirit, which is God in action. It is the power of the Holy Spirit with which we are able to heal, and to receive spiritual messages, and spiritual inspirational lectures, the Holy Spirit working directly through the spirit guides, hence through us to those we would serve with spiritual food.

The soul is the whole unitary spiritual process, whether in the body or out of the body, and is, likewise, a gift of God, to whom alone it owes obedience. We verify this in Romans 13:1—"Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God; the powers that be are ordained of God."

The early Church Fathers, St. Augustine, in particular, called the soul the spiritual or immortal part of man, and the seat of all imperishable truth.

From the earliest times, the soul has been recognized as a vehicle of human existence, separate in nature from the body, but

in the body. The Egyptians considered the soul of divine origin, and while in the body, its mission was to strengthen and elevate the good in the constant warfare going on between good and evil. The soul's future state was determined by divine judgment. This, in the main, is the belief of all Western people.

Christian Spiritualism recognizes the soul as the "likeness of God" spoken of in Genesis 1.26, where God says man shall be created in His image and likeness. And being in the likeness of God, the soul must manifest all noble qualities of man's nature, such as courage, patience, sympathy, forgiveness, brotherly love, and it cannot be anything less than immortal even as God is, in whose image it is created.

The voice of your soul calls to you, urging you to rise up to your full height, to be the perfect specimen of manhood and womanhood God intended you to be when He first thought of you. The voice is always there only we still its utterance by smothering it with materiality. The power to accomplish **all things**—material, physical, or spiritual—is within each one of us. It is this mighty power that the voice of the soul seeks to bring man to recognize within himself, and to put into instant use in his everyday affairs. In proportion, as a man's faith—the key to this power—developes from a tiny mustard seed stage to that of a towering mountain, huge, immovable, so shall that man progress from serfhood to Kingship. The moment a man listens to the voice of his own soul—the Spirit of the Almighty dwelling within him—in that moment that man has ceased to be a slave to circumstance, and begins to climb up, to claim his heritage of all good and perfect gifts from his Heavenly Father.

Jesus said, "Seek ye first the Kingdom of Heaven"—within the voice of your own soul. Then shall all power be yours to banish poverty and pain, fear and anxiety, and even death itself shall be conquered.

We read in the Old Testament that Enoch walked with God, that Noah was a just man, and walked with God, that Johosaphat's reign was prosperous because he walked with God. Each of these prophets understood the purpose of his birthright—evolution up and each listened to the voice of his own soul—the Spirit of the Almighty within—and each walked with God. For the voice of the soul leads only in one direction—**UP**—to Celestial Realms—to God Himself.

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The main purpose of the voice of your soul is to awaken you to the Presence of the Spirit of the Almighty—the Christ within, and to the Kingdom of Heaven therein.

When the scribe said to Jesus: "Well, Master, Thou hast said the truth; for there is one God; and there is none other but He; And to love Him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices," Jesus answered him, "Thou art not far from the Kingdom of God".

The second purpose of the voice of the soul is to attune our psychic ear to the call of the voices of other souls in or out of the body, and thus, together—our soul's voice and other souls' voices may unite and create a universal service to humanity, to spirit here and spirit out of the body. This second purpose must take second place always because unless a man finds the Kingdom of Heaven within, there will be no spiritual need of the second purpos. A man may find a psychic need for this second purpose, but the psychic without the spiritual brings little reward.

Jesus says: "For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world and lose his soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?"

If your mediumship—that is, the voice of your soul communicating with other souls—if your mediumship is not Christian Spiritualistic in belief and in practice, then your psychic power is likely to draw to you undesirable guides, or it may run a limited course, and then leave you suddenly and forever. There is no soul-satisfaction and content in any mediumistic power outside Christian Spiritualism. Jesus the greatest medium, healer and teacher of all times, cavs: "I am THE WAY, THE TRUTH, and THE LIFE. No man cometh unto the Father but by Me". Jesus, the Christ, taught and practiced Christian Spiritualism, and He, and all the prophets of old, who, likewise, practiced it, reach out to you, at this very moment, with the voice of their souls calling to the voice of your soul—to guide you aright in your search for the truth.

How can we train ourselves to hear the voice of our own soul? Through prayer, aspiration, and meditation in the silence. Draw near to God, realize His presence, and in the silence, where peace and harmony reign, you will hear the voice of your soul as it speaks to you, and as it attracts to you wonderful souls, who will develop spiritual strength and spiritual beauty within you.

Bible Course

HIS course is free to subscribers of the the Christian Spiritualist Quarterly. The only expense to you is a stamped, self-addressed envelope for reply when writing to Rev. Barker. At the close of the year, a written examination will be given, and at the close of the complete course—the reading of the entire Bible—a certificate will be issued, if the grade is 85 percent or more.

For the Fourth Quarter, read and study Numbers and St. Luke from the Spiritualist viewpoint. Choose an hour or more, once a day, or once a week, and the same place in which to study. This is very necessary so that you may get a spiritual vibration—that is, create your own vibration through contact with the Spirit Side of Life. Each time, ask the Spirit to manifest by guiding your interpretation. Your equipment is a Bible, a pencil and a note book. Mark your Bible with a colored pencil, underscoring or placing in parenthesis any verse that may attract and hold your attention. On the first page of your note book, write the date, followed by one verse, which is to be your key for that day, and which you are to memorize and repeat as often as you think of it until the next verse is written. Every day write a date and a verse.

Begin at Numbers 1:1 and St. Luke 1:1 and read slowly and thoughtfully as much as you can during your Bible period; one day read Numbers, the next day read in the New Testament. At the close of the quarter, you will be surprised at the progress you have made spiritually along the King's Highway, the road that leads back to God and Soul Peace.

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Jesus, The Preacher

The greatest preacher the world has ever known came from Galilee to the River Jordan to be baptized by John, the Baptist, to prove to the world that every man must repent and be baptized before he can enter into the Kingdom of Heaven.

After He was baptized in the river, (which is only a symbol of cleansing of the body, for the baptism we seek when we repent is the baptism of the Holy Spirit, as It descended from Heaven in the shape of a dove, and alighted on Jesus' shoulder), He went into the wilderness and fasted forty days, and was tempted by Satan. Having proven His faith in God, the Angels came and ministered unto Him.

When He heard that John had been cast into prison, He went to Galilee, and began to preach the salvation of the Lord. His works were so effective that large throngs of people followed Him about, listening to His sayings.

The Sadducees and the Pharisees would try all manner of schemes to trap Him into blaspheming the political faction. If they had succeeded, the law would have thrown Him into prison, but He was too far ahead of them, seeing what they had in their hearts, and thus they could take nothing to court against Him.

He would go into their churches and preach the doctrine of God, which was that all men are equal in the eyes of the Lord, if they live His laws, and that resurrection of the soul is His gift to all mankind.

This was against the teachings of the Sadducees and the Pharises. At this time, there were three divisions of the Jews: 1st, the Pharisees, the celebrated or richer Jews; 2nd, the Sadducees, the priestly aristocracy; and 3rd, the Essens, the class to which Jesus belonged, and which is related to the religion of Christian Spiritualism. The Pharisees taught the people to believe in the immortality of the soul, while the Sadducees taught there was no life after death, but there was transmigration of the soul from plane to plane. Jesus promised immortal life, and He said if man believed in God, he would not die but have life everlasting. The priesthood collected alms for

the atonement of sins, if a man were a Pharisee; if he were a Sadducee, he paid money into the church for the privilege of being able to do as he pleased while on earth.

The teachings of Jesus would lose money for the priests and the churches, as His words put doubt into the hearts of the people. He would go into the churches, and throw out the money changers, who were robbing the people by selling pigeons, used for offerings, at large prices. All this added to the hatred of the Pharisees toward Christ but little could they do because Jesus executed His commands so efficiently and they were afraid. He had a new religion; something in His sermons that touched every soul.

Today some say: "Wouldn't it be wonderful if Christ were here to preach to us!" We Christian Spiritualists are assured Jesus is here every day, every hour, knocking at the door of our heart, beckoning, pleading for us to repent, and be baptized of the Holy Spirit, and begin following in His footsteps, back to our Creator, His Father and our Father.

It is the purpose of our Creator to give each one of us the lifelong task of finding the joy of living within ourselves, and to radiate it, to pour it out upon others—to touch the lives of our fellowmen with its power and beauty. We are not fair to our better natures, and we dishonor God when we permit circumstances to take away our joy of life.

Pollock Channing, the noted playright, and a wealthy man, said: "Out of fifty possessions that I listed as my most valuable ones, I found that forty-eight of them had not cost me a dime!" He spoke of a yacht he once owned. But that did not mean anything for if he wished to enjoy a challenging wind and a choppy sea, they could be his on a tramp freighter, or on a ferry boat, or in his neighbor's dory. But the joy of living that he wouldn't sell for a million dollars was not found in material things. It did not cost him money, and the sacfifice of his leisure and his independence, yet it was the real wealth of the world.

We must learn to adjust ourselves to our environment, harmonize ourselves with those we daily contact. For the beginning of the joy of living, also, is in the expression of our love to those near us. "Love ye one anther, as I have loved you", Jesus says. Perfect joy—lasting happiness—is to be found only in working from within out—finding the joy of living through love and service to others.

Our inward joy should be so real, so bubbling over with flowerlike fragrance that its sweetness will be apparent to all about us.

That the souls out of the body are fragrant with the perfume of the joy of service, and are capable of manifesting it to mortals is frequently demonstrated by one of my high Spirit guides, Madge Kinkaid, a healer, who has been with me for years. Many times in my own home, and often in the homes of those I assign her to heal, she brings a decided odor of perfume as of spring flowers. The fragrance sometimes lasts only a few minutes; again it may linger for hours. She is not the only spirit to demonstrate thus. Mary, the Carmelite nun mentioned in my booklet, "Why I Am A Spiritualist", brings a distinct perfume, as of many flowers, into our home, the fragrance of spirit souls, she says.

Often when I am reading for someone who is deeply troubled, or one in spiritual doubt, a mother, or some spirit loved one will shed such a fragrance of sweetness about us that the doubting Thomas will ask, "What is that that smells so sweet?"

The joy of the unfettered soul is to realize the Kingdom of Heaven within, and to find the peace and the poise of the Savior. Be a living example of the glow and the presence of the Christ—the joy within—so others, seeing your joy of living, may understand how you have found the zest of life, and are able to radiate it to your fellowmen.

Phillips Brooks said: "Be such a man, live such a life, that if every man were such as you, and every life such as yours, this earth would be a paradise."

Paul and Silas, in the Philippian jail, knew the joy of living, the abiding grace of God. Likewise, Daniel in the lion's den; Christ in the garden of Gethsemane; and certainly Christ upon Calvary, where He endured the cross and despised the shame for the joy that was set before Him.

You and I, each one of us, are crowned with honor and glory, joint heirs of the Christ, and are created but a little lower than the Angels. Therefore claim your heritage—joy in your present—absorb the life-forces of the universe as they seek to guide you in your rightful place as a mortal now, and later on, as a spirit out of the body.

Your joy of living, your zest for life, will measure the amount of the Christ principle you permit to work in and through you to the joy and completeness of yourself and all those you contact. Let joy be your life motive-power just as it is the motive-power or keynote of the universe.

Joy is a divine gift, and it does not depend upon external conditions but upon the within—uninterrupted fellowship with God, the Almighty, the abiding companionship of Jesus, the Christ, our Elder Brother, and teacher, and the baptism of the Holy Spirit, the latter being the power of God in action, the power through which we demonstrate high psychic phenomena and healing.

Begin now, where you are, to do all within your power to bring more joy into your own life, and into the lives of others. "Brighten the Corner Where You Are." Pray constantly that God will open your eyes to the good in your neighbor, and the good in the world at

large. "As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he." Be an optimist, and God, seeing your efforts, will manifest for you the condition you visualize. It is the lack of knowledge of The Truth—God's Law for all of us—that deprives us of the joy of life. Our days are needlessly shadowed by constant prohibitions. If good fortune smiles on us, we are afraid to enjoy it because we tell ourselves we will have to pay for this . If our health is good, we know it will not last. We hug our trials close; we shut ourselves up with our sorrow, and at every turn we checkmate the joy of living. Our cup runneth over, yet we hesitate to drink of it.

No exceptions, we can place ourselves in the proper attitude of mind so that we may hear the voice of the Christ, the Master, within, and respond to His call.

Christ, on the eve of His crucifixion, comforted His disciples, "Let not your heart be troubled," and He promises us, "your sorrow shall be turned into joy," for "These things have I spoken unto you, that My joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full."

One of our poets, John Saxe, said: "If there is a way, find it. If there is none, never mind it." Decide not to worry over matters you cannot help. Those you can help, you do not need to worry about.

Being created in the likeness and the image of God, man is miserable when he has drifted away from his Creator, or when, in his life here, there is a lack of knowledge of God's will for mortals. There is no excuse for this lack of knowledge. Planetary Configurations and Health

The NEW AGE, or, as it is known to Astrologers, the Aquarian Age, is soon upon us. Orbs are forming now which have a great significance, but, first, to some little explanation of the planets chiefly concerned.

Uranus has to do with up-sets and changes, be these in ideas, methods, custom, or things material. We all know that before the physical must come the metaphysical, "Meta" meaning "before". Planetary influences are before the physical influences. We shall note these before physical influences presently.

Mars is noted for his destructive influence—for his tearing down qualities, but he likewise has a constructive side in that it is necessary to remove an old structure before a new one may appear, be it mental or physical.

Course In Unfoldment

The information in these lectures is very necessary, if you are seeking knowledge and development in mediumship, and a clear understanding of Spiritualism and its laws.

Ministering Angels and Ministering Spirits, the latter the subject of this sermon, are not the same. Ministering Spirits are celestial beings, Messengers of God, dwelling near the Creator in the higher realms of the Heaven Land. Ministering Spirits are Messengers of God, also, but rather relay messengers, the Angels being the direct messengers. The Ministering Spirits, or Relay Messengers, are a very necessary part in God's plan of salvation for man.

The Lord told Moses, (Ex. 33:20)"—there shall no man see Me and live". God is Light—such a powerful magnetized Light, that should a man look upon The Almighty, he would be consumed by the great radiance of his Creator. There are Angels—those who are "the spirits of just men made perfect", and who are so highly devoloped spiritually dwelling as they do so near God—whose appearance and whose words would prove a consuming fire should they contact mortal man. Hence, in God's plan for man's spiritual evolution all graduations of Angelhood and all graduations of Spirits are required.

Thus, in order for man to contact God, he should make his prayers or his petitions direct to the Lord. God hears all supplications at all times, but he does not answer them direct—personally. His Will is expressed to the Son, Jesus the Christ, who, in turn, expresses the Father's Word to the Angels of the celesti al realms. From then on, it is sent, like lightning, down from plane to plane, from Angels to Spirits, until it reaches a Spirit Messenger near to man, and then it is ready to go direct to the latter without injury to him.

All Spirits have to lower their vibrations else in contacting a medium and his client both could be instantly taken out of the body

—"killed" the general public would term it. The Spirit vibrations of those even in the first plane is higher than electricity, and as a Spirit evolves upward the electric rate becomes higher accordingly.

In Jacob's vision, in Genesis 28:12-13, we have this gradation of Angels and Spirits expressed as a ladder set upon the earth, and the top of it reached the heaven: and the Angels of God ascending on it. And the Lord stood above it. Each rung of the ladder, from man up to God, is a stage of unfoldment of Spirit-Life, and all the Angels and Spirits on the various planes are the Ministering Spirits sent forth to serve those who shall inherit the salvation Paul speaks of in Heb. 1:14.

When we are sufficiently developed to receive heavenly truths, and to know how to put them into practice, these Ministering Spirits draw near to us, and endeavor to serve us materially, physically, mentally, and spiritually. The lowest service that they can give us is that of the material; the highest is that of the spiritual. By assisting us materially, they provide for or relieve us of problems of the earth life. In the physical, those from the Spirit Side of Life can actually rebuild and regenerate our bodies by bringing us the chemicals we have lost through overwork, illness, incorrect diet, or old age. Mentally, they strengthen and quicken our minds so we are able to acquire a knowledge of God's Law, and devolop the courage to give it out. Spiritually, they create within our souls a desire to reach up to, and become a part of the Christ-consciousness, thus, sharing in the mind, wisdom, and power of God, the Almighty. Through the work of the Ministering Spirits, our guides, we daily may unfold and evolve up to such great spiritual heights that we will be able to realize God as vivid and as perfect a Father as Jesus knew Him to be.

In the Old Testament, there are instances where there is a distinction made between Angels and Spirits. In Job 4:15, the perfect and upright Job tells of a Spirit that passed before his face, and a Voice spoke to him. In Sam. 28:3-9, the Spirit of Samuel talked to King Saul, when the former sought to advise him from the Spirit Side of Life.

The New Testament, also, recognizes Angels and Spirits as different types of the heavenly spheres. In Acts 23:8, we read, "But the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither Angel, nor Spirit: but the Pharisees confess both". In the next verse, the

9th, same chapter, "The Pharisee scribe said, We find no evil in this man (Paul), but if a Spirit or an Angel hath spoken to him let us not fight against God". The Pharisees not only admitted there were Angels and Spirits, and that they could communicate with God, but they also, gave God the credit for the phenomena—the materialization of those out of the body.

In the olden days as now, men sought and believed in the messages from the Spirit World. Over there, as over here, there are all kinds of Spirits. If a man is honest and truthful here on earth, he will be the same as a Spirit. If he is immoral, a liar, and a thief here, the so-called "death"—passing out of the mortal body—will not change him one iota. A liar and a thief he will continue to be until he desires to be otherwise. The moment he seeks and asks for aid, there will be some Ministering Spirit or some Christian Spiritualist redium ready to show him The Light that leads back to God, his Heavenly Father.

In I Kings 21:22, we have a record of a Spirit saying, "I will go forth, and I will be a lying Spirit." Many of the Spirits in the earthbound sphere are lying Spirits, liars here and liars there—by choice, and their sole objects is to make trouble and to lead others into temptation.

In Matt. 12:45, a Spirit of this type takes seven other Spirits, more wicked than he, and returns to the field of his labors, and together, these evil Spirits cause more mischief and crime than the one, working alone, could do. When an evil Spirit gets hold of a mortal, and obsesses him, that man is made to become a fiar, a thief, a dope addict, a drunkard and, sometimes, a murderer.

One of the greatest slate mediums who ever lived couldn't leave drink alone. He would spend every cent for whiskey, and then beg or borrow money to buy more. He had borrowed so often of his friends, and had become so poverty-stricken that people were getting tired of helping him, only to have their hard-earned money go for liquor. So one day when this man begged a bartender to give him a free drink, the latter said, **Certainly not!**"

The man then made this proposition to the bartender, "Will you give me a glassful of whiskey, if I go to the end of the counter, and the glass will come to me?" The bartender agreed, and the man

said, "John bring me that glass of whiskey." to the amazement of the bartender the glass began to slowly slide down the counter until it reached the man. He took it, of course, and drank it.

Now John, who did that levitation act was probably a guide from the lower or earth-bound sphere, else he would have had no desire to give that poor, pitiful drunkard more whiskey.

But that isn't the end of the story. Later, when we went into the trumpet seance, one of the first Spirits to speak was this man, out of the body many years. He greeted several of the old-time Spiritualists by name, and said: "I heard all you said about me, but I don't drink any more.I'm all over that now. For a while after I came over to the Spirit Side, I would hunt up some poor, weak-minded man, and I would impress him to drink. But I know better now, and I want to thank you," he addressed one of the old-timers "for refusing to give me any more liquor that night before I passed. I had delirium tremens, and I fought like a madman, but you wouldn't give me another drink. I want to thank you for what you did for me." The old-timer verified the man's story. It was true just as the man had told it, for the old-timer sat up with him the last night he was in the body.

O, if people could only realize the numerous crimes committed by Spirits in the earth-bound spheres!

It is a known fact among those familiar with psychic investgation that John Wilkes Booth, when he assassinated Lincoln, fled, thinking the President only wounded. Later, Booth, passed out of the body, with revenge still in his heart, and like Satan, he, as a Spirit wandered to and fro in the earth searching for someone to do his will. Years passed, and he found a victim in Charles J. Guiteau, who shot Garfield, the latter living 80 days.

Once more, Booth, now in Spirit, fled from the scene of the crime thinking his revenge unsatisfied. And again years passed, and again, he found a victim to do his bidding. He impressed Leon Czolgosz to assassinate William McKinley, who lived 8 days. President McKinley, great soul that he is, when he passed to Spirit Life,

sought out Booth in the earth-bound sphere, and convinced him that revenge harms most he who seeks it. Little by little, so the story goes, McKinley was able to lead Booth to see The Light, and to find the path back to God. The Ministering Spirit of William McKinley has put a stop to further assassinations of our presidents. This is word that comes from the Spirit Side of Life, and this we Spiritualists believe.

There are many such Ministering Spirits on the other side, devoting most of their time to guiding lost souls, here and hereafter, and impressing them with the desire to strive to evolve up to higher planes. Pat McDonald, my trumpet guide, tells me that one of the missions of my own father is that of a Ministering Spirit to souls in darkness.

No matter how advanced we are in our spiritual development, some Spirit is constantly with us, seeking to encourage us in all our efforts to progress. For Paul tells us in Romans 8:16, "And the Spirit itself beareth witness with our Spirit. (26) Likewise, the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: (that is spiritual healing) for we know not what we should pray for as we ought; but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us—(27) according to the will of God." —Lesson 3, "Ministering Angels", a mimeograph booklet, 10c—
