

The afternoon address on Lily Dale Day will be given by Arthur Myers, followed by a message service by Maude Kline. At this meeting an Assembly fund collection is to be taken. "I hope everyone will remember to bring their pocket books to the afternoon service," smiled Mr. Knox.

Benefit octagon seances, with the money going to the Assembly, are to be held Saturday evening by Mrs. Ida E. Stritzel, and Sunday and Wednesday evenings of first week by Rev. Sarah Cushing.

DR. MCIVOR TYNDALL

Dr. Alexander J. McIvor Tyndall, distinguished white haired Englishman who has long been a familiar figure at Lily Dale, is scheduled to deliver the address of Tuesday afternoon, August 18, and to present one of his famous entertainments of "Mirth, Marvel, and Mystery" Thursday, August 20.

The theme for the Tuesday afternoon lecture will be, "The Coming Crisis: Has Spiritualism a World Message?" The Thursday evening program will include features by Mrs. McIvor Tyndall, Converse Nickerson, and a group of entertainers from Dunkirk, as well as demonstrations in mental telepathy by the famous "mental magician".

Insisting that he is "full of life and joy and health", Dr. Tyndall is able to look back across more than ninety years, those years scattered in every country of the world, and including experiences not better by any others who have climbed to the top of the psychic ladder.

Dr. Tyndall is known to spiritualists as a lecturer and writer, and for his intellectual and philosophical theories, rather than for his "tricks". For many years the brilliant elderly gentleman served as a member of the Board of Directors of the General Assembly of Spiritualists, and every summer has taken an active part in the program of the Lily Dale Assembly, where he and Mrs. Tyndall make their home. This summer Tyndall is chairman of the Forest Temple.

Dr. Tyndall has been pastor of many spiritualist churches, recently serving the Church of Spirit Communion, which meets in the Hotel Statler, Buffalo.

EDNA BRENNAN

Mrs. Edna Brennan, medium from middle west is making her third visit to Lily Dale, this time to stay for the entire season. Her daughter, Mrs. Ralph Sprang and two children, are with her. "I have tried to boost Lily Dale all I possibly can in Ohio," she said.

Mrs. Brennan makes her home in Mansfield, Ohio. She has, in the eight years she has been in the work, conducted spiritualist churches in Mansfield and Bucyrus, Ohio and served the Wooly Park camp in Ashley.

"My mediumship seemed to come to me more as a revelation than anything else," she declared. "A medium to whom I went for a reading told me I had psychic power although I did not even know what she meant. I remember the first vision I ever had. I was ten years old and distinctly saw a child's face looking in the window. I was terribly frightened, and for years would never look at that window again at night!"

English Visitor To Dale
Scathingly Indicts The
Politics Of Spiritualism

Lily Dale the "Light Citadel
Of Tomorrow"



"I know little more than can be deduced from observation about the inner working of organised spiritualism in America but as one who has been intimately associated with the machinery of organization in the English movement I have no hesitation in describing the politics of spiritualism as rotten to the core!"

These words, uttered by Horace S. Hamblin, Moon Trail's world-renowned medium, were greeted with applause given by an enthusiastic audience composed almost entirely of mediums. This meeting last Monday was presided over by President of Lily Dale Assembly Millard L. Knox, and was probably unique as representing a gathering of those in whose hands rests the welfare of the wise of spiritualism.

Hamblin pointed out to the audience that while those who were by circumstance forced to administer the organization of the movement but laid the blame upon the mediums whose example was a good. He recalled how he on attacking the members of his own directing Council in London, accusing them of praising the high quality of Moon Trail's teachings without attempting to live them, and how, after (Continued on Page 3)




