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The City Half as Old as Time: ROSE-RED PETRA

SITUATED HIGH on the eastern wall of Jordan's Arnon Gorge, Petra is a natural fortress surrounded by sandstone cliffs into which buildings have been carved. Nestled in a craggy canyon of red, pink, white, brown and violet rock, the city is practically invisible from the air and impregnable from the ground. The brook Moses called forth by smiting the rock twice with his rod still flows through its center.

The natural caves that honeycomb the area were home to man thousands of years before history began. Remnants of prehistoric encampments give evidence that the site was occupied as early as the Ninth Century B.C. In Petra is one of the "high places" mentioned in the Old Testament (II Kings 14-15) where incense was burned and sacrifices made to pagan gods.

Petra was the capital of Edom when the children of Israel neared the end of their 40 year exile . . .

POSSESSION AND EXORCISM

WHEN DOBSON, women's editor of the Washington Star-Free, interviewed Fr. John Nichols, Roman Catholic priest and a leading authority on exorcism, he told her the story of a 14-year-old Mr. Ralston, Md., boy who Father Nicola believes was possessed and successfully freed of the possessing evil.

About two weeks after the death of his aunt the boy began to hear scratching sounds under the floorboards of his room where he had gone into partial seclusion. Father, Mother and Grandmother also heard the scratching noises which grew louder. Believing they came from rodents the parents called an exterminator who put down poison but found no sign of rats or mice.

The noises increased. Articles and furniture began to move around the room. One Sunday afternoon as the family sat in the living room the heavy lounge chair on which the boy was sitting jerked, tipped forward and threw the boy onto the floor. A vase rose from its place, shot across the room and crashed into the wall.

Similar things occurred at



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school. The parents took the boy to a medical doctor, then to a psychiatrist, but neither could find an explanation for the phenomena.

So far this is the account of a classic poltergeist case. But then came a second stage which Father Nicola calls the obsession. The boy would appear to be in pain. The sheets of his bed would stand out stiffly; his mattress would levitate or bounce. The family was Lutheran and their minister took the boy to live in the parsonage until he too saw the mattress "lift and swirl around the room and zoom sickeningly under the bedsprings."

The Lutheran minister then consulted some priests and the boy was sent to Alexian Brothers Hospital in St. Louis, Mo. By this time, Father Nicola says, the third stage had been reached and the boy was "fully possessed."

He had several fits each night. He barely could eat or drink and was near death from malnutrition. "He cursed his parents and God in the vilest language."

Cardinal O'Boyle appointed an exorcist who worked over the boy for three and one-half months.

lic and had masses said. But the

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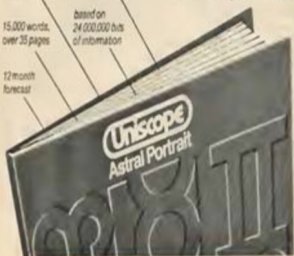
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"ghost" stayed on. They asked the Church for help but received none.

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GOVERNMENT-TRAINED MEDICINE MEN

PSYCHIATRISTS at the federal government's Indian Health Service at Window Rock, Ariz., finally have conceded that the traditional medicine man may know something after all. Dr. Robert L. Bergman went so far as to enlist six Navaho medicine men to teach 12 young Indians the elaborate chants that seem to cure Navaho emotional problems. Western-trained psychiatrists have become aware, reports Dr. Bergman, that every culture has given rise to healers of one sort or another who are as effective with their own people as psychiatrists are among Westerners. Cultural expectations seem to play a crucial part in the healing process.

Anthropologists and physicians have studied Navaho medicine

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A RESEARCH team working at Detroit's Lafayette clinic under an eight-year grant from the National Institutes of Health has concluded that schizophrenia, the mental disorder suffered by half the patients in America's mental hospitals, is the result of a chemical malfunction in the brain. 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lectomy was performed April 21 on male nurse Gary Chinn, aged 31. The Chicago operation thus preceded those in New York although it was not announced until later. Weiss' director of anaesthesiology Dr. Wei Chi Liu personally inserted the acupuncture needles in Chinn's right arm above the wrist and another in his left arm. Chinn remained fully awake but felt no pain during the time surgeon Ralph Levin operated.

The reluctance of Weiss Memorial Hospital to publicize the operation became quite understandable when the American Society of Anaesthesiologists blasted the operations as "premature," suggesting that patients were exposing themselves to potential physical and psychological dangers. The society demanded "objective evaluation over a period of years" before acupuncture is practiced in this country.

Dr. Warren praised the medical board of Albert Einstein College for their open-mindedness in permitting the operation. He credited two Michigan physicians, Dr. Ping L. Man and Dr. Calvin H. Chen of Northville State Hospital, with developing a theory that may explain acupuncture's success in achieving anesthesia. Man and Chen argue that besides the gate in

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the peripheral nervous system at which pain impulse may be blocked there is a second gate in the thalamus, the main relay center for sensory impulses to the brain's cerebral cortex. The acupuncture impulses, created when the thin needles are inserted into the body and twirled, are relayed not only to the first pain gate but via a complicated nerve tract to the thalamus. This theory, Dr. Ma says, has been confirmed by work done by a surgical group in Canton, China.

A theory which explains acupuncture might go a long way toward overcoming the objections of the anesthesiologists and permit Western medicine to overcome its 2000-year lag behind the Chinese.



"TELYOUALL"

TWO MEMBERS of a religious sect in Seattle, Wash., were dead last January as a result of participating in a "rite of breathing" in which a substance known to the cult as "tellyouall" is placed in a plastic bag and the fumes inhaled. The communal group of about 50 members calls itself the "Love Family" or the Church of Armageddon.

After a Sunday rite of breathing William V. Eddy, 38, and Gregory L. LeMaster, 32, were found dead, although cult mem-

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bers denied they were actually deceased. If they really are dead, said spokesman Happiness Israel, then they must be "disbelievers." "Tellyouall" is described by cult members as a "gift from God" but the medical examiner's office said it appeared to be paint thinner.

SOME Connecticut horse owners attribute supernatural strength to bobcats. An article in the *New York Sunday News* of September 18 reports that horse owners of Wilton, Conn., are taking turns guarding their animals at night after a series of attacks during which horses have been mauled and at least two killed.

ROSE-RED PETRA

The Siq, a silencing tunnel-like gorge which is the only entrance to Petra, narrows to 12 feet in places, its walls towering hundreds of feet overhead.

Although some scholars are skeptical Petra is generally believed to be the Sela of the Old Testament. The word sela is Hebrew for rock and petra is the Greek equivalent. In verses where the King James Version of the Bible speaks of Sela, the Catholic version uses the Greek word Petra (i.e., Isaiah 54:1). There is little doubt that both refer to Umm el-Biyara, the gigantic rock mass towering over the western edge of Petra.

Petra was the capital of Edom when the children of Israel

reached the end of their 40 years of exile. They were encamped at Kadesh-Barnes, some 50 miles to the west, when Moses sent messengers to the king of Edom to ask that his people be allowed safe passage along an ancient route called the "king's highway" which passes a few miles east of Petra. The king was afraid that allowing an entire nation to enter Edom might lead to his own people's subjugation.

As the citadel of Khazneh comes into view, the most elaborately decorated monument in Petra, from this point a handful of men could have defended the city.

Hor is but it is traditionally thought to be Jebel Nebr Harun, south of Petra in the Selr mountain range. While some authorities believe that a mountain 25 miles west of Petra is the true Mount Hor, the Arabs are convinced that Aaron's tomb is on their "Nebi Haroun" at Petra — despite the historical near-certainty that Moses chose not to risk war by entering Edom.

Flavius Josephus (37?–105 A.D.), the last of the ancient Hebrew historians, agrees with the Arabs and places Mount Hor at Petra — but this proves nothing. Although he was an accurate historian of his own time Josephus' Old Testament accounts are not

considered reliable so the true site of Aaron's tomb remains unknown.

* * *

AFTER THE Roman conquest of the Nabataeans, the people of Petra, in 105 A.D. its history is relatively clear. But the mystery which archaeologists seek to illuminate concerns the early period of Petra's history when it was an independent city. They believe that the earliest construction at the site took place in the Third Century B.C. and the ancient historian Diodorus Siculus records that Petra became the capital of the Nabataeans about 312 B.C., after Antigonos, a Greek ruler of Syria, sent two armies against

them. The Nabataeans managed to destroy the first army and to buy off the commander of the second. But these invasions made them realize how vulnerable they were. They chose to make the natural fortress of Petra their capital—a wise choice because a handful of men could defend the city's narrow entranceway.

As they grew stronger the Nabataeans expanded their dominion over most of what had been Edom. This gave them control of Southern Arabia's overland trade routes. Petra was on the way toward becoming a wealthy trade center if its serious shortage of water could be remedied.

The springs and wells dotting the land furnished enough water for personal use but not enough to irrigate the desert and supply a major oasis. However, the Nabataeans learned to be among the finest hydraulic engineers in history. They built terraces and dams to stop erosion and they cut from solid rock a system* of aqueducts and cisterns which preserved nearly 100 percent of the available water. Even the

flash floods of winter storms were channeled quickly through the aqueducts and into the cisterns.

The cisterns were large caverns made either by enlarging natural caves or by hewing out new ones. Narrow openings kept evaporation low and sedimentation traps kept the cisterns clear. This gave Petra enough water to coax crops from the



arid land and eventually to become an international marketplace.

In the beginning the Nabataeans plundered caravans en route from the south to markets in the north. As their society grew stronger and water became plentiful, the plundering gave way to more orderly systems of profit-taking. Petra began charging tolls to insure the caravans

safe passage and taxing all merchandise that entered the territory. Petra's development as a caravan oasis provided still another source of revenue.

The merchants were willing to pay Petra's exorbitant tolls because their own marketing capabilities were tremendously improved. Now they could more accurately predict the profits for each trip because the danger of

Yemen) on the Red Sea. From there they joined caravans of Arabian tribes in caravans traveling what came to be called the "incense road." The main caravan routes went along the western edge of the Arabian plateau, through Mecca to Fatah. Departing from Fatah caravans fanned out to Egypt, Syria, Persia and Mesopotamia. Even distant Rome patronized Fatah's rich export-import business.

The international marketplace located near the approaches to and caravansary probably were and caravan routes probably were located near the approaches to the gorge leading into the city, about where the modern village of Wadi Mous (Tij) now stands. Thus the city was not choked with heavy traffic, yet customers were provided with water and protection. Such a location obviously would have places for animals to rest and feed and rooms for merchants and caravans for merchants and caravans drivers to sleep and cook. A nearby sheltered area, designed for unloading and storing cargoes, must have been the heart of Fatah's marketplace. A glance at the map makes one wonder how the overland trade routes developed. It would appear that products of East and West easily could be shipped through the Red Sea, to and from ports in the Gulf of Suez. From these Egyptian markets would be immediately at hand

being robbed was gone. Fatah's taxes, tolls and service charges became part of a caravan's overhead, along with camels and drivers. For their money Fatah's customers were protected by a series of forts which were spaced out at 10- to 15-mile intervals as far south as the Gulf of Aden. These forts not only provided safety but they were convenient overnight stops.

Caravans converged on Fatah from all directions and the city soon became an international marketplace. Arabian incense and Indian war elephants fed her coffers, along with Syrian slaves and Egyptian beer, grain, incense, glassware, papyrus, oil, fruit, silk, wine, dyes, minerals, precious stones and spices. One silk was raised in Fatah. It continued before Marco Polo set out to open Cathay to the West.

Of all the goods traded at Fatah, none was more exotic than Arabia's own myth and magic. These aromatic resins, gums were so highly prized in the ancient world that along with gold they were the first Oriental goods to be widely traded in Europe. and Palestine and Syria just short caravan trips away. Instead, Arabian merchants chose to travel over 1200 miles of desert, mountains, gorges and plains.

These early traveling salesman had valid reasons to avoid the Red Sea. Valuable cargoes were in constant peril from the sudden squalls and changing winds that occur along both coasts. The Red Sea's peculiar submerged coral reefs are an ever-present danger. Such reefs usually are marked by water boiling over them as tides and breakers stream past. But moving water flows undisturbed through the unusual porous coral

of the Red Sea reefs, making them an invisible threat to shipping. These were the dangers that kept valuable cargoes off the Red Sea and gave Petra 400 years of prosperity.

* * *

THE CITIZENS of Petra spoke Arabic as their everyday language but many of them knew Latin and Greek as well. They lived in a democratic society which knew neither poverty nor taxation. Petra's wealth was only one of the reasons her citizens paid no taxes. Public services were considered a community responsibility — to be performed by everyone, high and low. Wealth and prosperity were

virtues that carried with them the civic responsibilities of cleaning streets, guarding water supplies and performing police duties. The people of Petra dearly valued property, both public and private. They levied fines against anyone who did not maintain his own property and honored those who increased its value.

Class distinctions also were unknown in Petra. Few of the slaves sold in Petra's marketplace found buyers in the city. In fact, there weren't even any servants. Nabataean custom called upon everyone to serve himself, even the king. Furthermore, the king's financial accounts and even his royal conduct were always subject to civil examination.

The king's only distinction was in dress. The Nabataeans wore girdles (mincloths) and slippers without tunics—but the king's girdle was purple, the color reserved for royalty.

While the camel, indispensable to desert travel, might be said to be the backbone of Petra's economy, the Nabataeans also had large oxen and sheep—but no horses.

Although merchandising was their main source of revenue the Nabataeans developed a number of other industries. Perhaps their most remarkable achievement

lay in irrigating wastelands but they also were highly skilled in ceramics, architecture, engineering, art and metallurgy. Nabataean sculpture often are compared to the Greeks; pottery was probably their most outstanding art form. It is as delicate as porcelain, thinner and finer than any thrown by hand today in nearby Jerusalem. Yet it was not highly valued by the Nabataeans. Petra's "city dump" was piled high with pottery fragments.*

As to most of the Mediterranean world Roman domination finally came to Petra. It started off casually enough when Pompey visited the city in 63 B.C. to establish friendly relations with the Nabataeans. To him Petra was just a buffer state between the Roman Empire and the untamable desert. For the next 170 years the Nabataeans managed to maintain a balance of power between Rome, Egypt and the Seleucids who then ruled Syria.

During the First Century B.C.

*The "city dump" has been a haunt to archaeologists. One of their most important achievements has been the clearance of a First Century A. D. Nabataean house, mentioned in The Illustrated London News (November 17, 1951). The house is remarkably preserved, in contrast to Roman houses an extensive rubbish dump covered the ruins, protecting it from erosion. Artifacts discovered at the site can be accurately dated and the layout and arrangement of the pottery and fragments are of great importance in tracing the Greek and Roman influences on Nabataean culture.

Petra reached its greatest heights and the Nabataean civilization continued to flower until the death of King Rabbel II. When this last independent Nabataean king died in 105 A.D. Petra began its slow decline. A year later it became the capital of the Roman colony Arabia Petraea (rocky Arabia) and Nabataean independence was at an end. One by one, all of the caravan cities fell to the Romans who now controlled the trade routes to the East.

Rome fully expected Petra to continue as a profitable business center and the Romans embellished old structures in the city and built new ones. It was during this time that the larger facades appeared in the city and in the reign of Trajan (98-117 A.D.) the great colonnaded road was built. But time and money were wasted. Other forces already were at work changing Petra from a prosperous city into a ghost town.

Prosperity ebbed away as caravan routes gradually moved eastward, bypassing Petra and converging on Palmyra farther north. Meanwhile, Roman and Egyptian sailors finally conquered the Red Sea and began syphonning off some of Petra's trade. As always, political ruin followed economic decline and Petra slowly died of the very

thing that had given her life — economic change.

For a time Petra lingered on as a headquarters for a few local princes but even they finally abandoned her. The silent cave-riddled city fell into limbo, to be mentioned only in rumor and myth, its location known only to local tribes and its existence doubted by the outside world. To this day, many local Arabs are superstitious about entering the dead city of Petra. It was re-occupied briefly during the Crusades and some of the castles the Crusaders built still stand. Then it sank back into obscurity for five more centuries.

* * *

PETRA WAS rediscovered in 1812 by a young Swiss explorer, Johann Ludwig Burckhardt. En route from Damascus to Cairo he heard rumors of a forbidden city somewhere nearby. His curiosity was aroused and he asked to be taken there. No amount of money would induce his Arab guide to lead him to Petra, so Burckhardt resorted to trickery.

Making use of one of the rumors he had heard, he told his guide he had vowed to sacrifice a goat to Haroun (Aaron, brother of Moses). The ruse worked and Burckhardt was taken to a nearby village where another Arab agreed to escort him into the city.

Although he was supposed to go only as far as the Spring of Moses (Ain Musa), he succeeded in conniving his way into several of Petra's structures before his suspicious guide began making discouraging motions with his rifle. Reluctantly Burchardt slaughtered his goat and followed the guide back out of the city. Nevertheless, he put Petra back on the map and paved the way for its revival and a different kind of financial success. Today the city is a flourishing tourist attraction, a valuable asset to Jordan's economy.

* * *

PETRA IS a spectacular collection of temples, gymnasiums, baths, theaters, tombs, cisterns and aqueducts—all hewn from solid rock. Their most distinctive features are the two storied Greco-Roman facades that adorn many of the temples and tombs. The rooms behind these elaborate carvings are unfinished caves with little more than connecting staircases.

The Siq is no less spectacular than the city it leads to. It winds for more than a mile between multicolored cliffs which tower hundreds of feet above the canyon floor shutting out most of the daylight. At times the trail is so narrow it seems one may touch both walls at once.

Just when it seems the trail

will go on forever we round a turn and find ourselves face to face with one of the world's most astounding sights. The canyon suddenly widens and the first rock-cut structure comes into view. Framed by the darkened cliffs of the gorge the Treasury of Pharaoh (el-Khaznah) glimmers in the brilliant sunshine. The vivid rose-coral facade is believed to have been built in the Second Century B.C.

The Treasury's facade is similar to all those in Petra, adorned with statuary and Roman columns. Its two stories bring it to a height of 45 feet and the pillars of the ground level are almost freestanding. Only their ends are still fast to the cliff. The top story is decorated on either side with columns carved in relief and it has a small circular kiosk in the center. The entire facade is trimmed with intricate designs which are almost as sharp today as when they were carved.

High on the Treasury's facade stands a bullet-chipped urn. For decades passing Arabs have been trying to shoot it open to get the riches they believe it contains. But the urn is solid rock; the legendary hoard is nonexistent.

The canyon continues narrow for a short distance beyond the Treasury, then widens into the

Plan of Peking near a high ground (center). This well-circular center is about 25 yards in diameter and has 22 tiers of steps—room for more than 1,500 spectators.

Peking's largest structure, the Miaoan (Mi-Dan), has a facade 160 feet wide which towers 120 feet above the plain. The building on the Miaoan is, of course, with only a hint of the minute detail that distinguishes the Treasury, scholars' quarters. It may have been under construction and left unfinished when Peking's political and economic decline began in the Second Century A.D.

One other rock-cut structure worthy of mention is the Palace of Paoan (Pao-Tsun). It has a two-tiered facade with a simple, flat-topped roof and no further that is broader than it is high. Unfortunately, the Palace stands at the widest point in the valley where it gets little protection from windstorms. As a result much of the lower story of the facade is deeply eroded.

A great example of open ground near the center of town once was occupied by beautifully ornamented freestanding buildings but the only one left is the Temple of the Sun (Qian ti Sun). A square structure with intricate stone walls, it probably dates from the Second Century A.D.

Under the Roman emperor Trajan who reigned from 98 to 117 A.D. the Romans constructed one of their famed colonnaded roads and it became the city's principal street. It now lies in ruins but we do have some idea of what it looked like when the city lived. Both roads were at least a half mile long and up to 15 feet wide. Flanked sidewalks and shops under arcades bordered both sides and where the streets entered the main roadway the colonnades were interrupted. Peter's road did include the triumphal arch the Romans were so fond of but little of it remains.

The cliffs surrounding Peter's house were built up into the rock. Many have elaborate facades and some have been given names—the Dr. Three-Barked, Cornelian and Obelisk—which describe some of the features. Patches resembling those on the larger Peter's house; the earliest ones were marked by simple pyram towers. Each house has a number of burial chambers and a large central basement room cut into the floor.

Many open-to-the-sky terraces were situated around the groups of Peter. One of these is the most complete specimen of an ancient Semitic structure.

ever found. It has an altar for burnt offerings, a place for killing victims, a cleansing basin and two obelisks, all hewn from solid rock. The names of worshippers carved into the foundation rocks below still are legible.

JORDAN HAS no travel restrictions. You can drive a car right up to a new rest home near the entrance of the Siq. You can get a room *Qere*, or if you prefer, you can stay in the heart of Petra. Docile ponies and Arab guides are ready and willing to help you explore.

It will take two or three days to do and see everything. You can climb rock-cut stairs to rock-cut terraces, explore tombs and temples and examine the gigantic facades. You can climb to one of the Old Testament's "high places"; you can explore the nearby castles that were built, then deserted, by the Crusaders.

As you walk the ground where some claim Moses walked, perhaps you will share the emotions that moved John William Burgon, the Victorian English poet and biblical scholar, to describe Petra as "a rose-red city half as old as time."



RUSSIANS REVIVE FOSSILS

SOVIET geochemist N. Chudinov has revived microscopic organisms 234 million years old, reports Soviet news agency Tass as quoted in *Parade*. Chudinov was examining a piece of potassium ore in his laboratory at Dzerzhinski Potassium Combine in the Ural Mountains. Interested in determining the origin of the red color in the ore, the scientist had dissolved a piece in distilled water. Chudinov noticed that strange flakes like bits of moss were beginning to float away from the specimen. These were lighter than water and bore no resemblance to any scale.

Under a microscope the geo-

chemist found that each flake contained a world of microorganisms. Several days later when Chudinov checked his flasks he couldn't believe his eyes. The primordial micro-world had come to life and the water was swarming with reanimated organisms.

The revived fossils grew in test tubes and reproduced normally. Chudinov believes that the organisms had remained in a state of suspension, locked in potassium crystals for 234 million years. The tiny creatures once had flourished in the great Perm Sea which historically covered Russia from the Urals to the Ukraine.

"I've reached that age when everybody looks young to me. What school did you go to?"

"The University of Iowa."

"That's a terrific school," I murmured approvingly. "Did you play football there?"

He opened up and went on to tell me how he had played on the Newark High School team for three unbroken years before going on to college. He talked so easily, he said, because he was so active in athletics he was tired at night.

"My mother sat up with me every night at the kitchen table to see to it I did my lessons before crawling into bed. The weekends I had free after the game. When did the name for my brother who is going to graduate in psychology and who intends to play pro basketball. He's a lot taller than I am and a better athlete all the way around," he assured me proudly.

"My kid sister is a great fan,"

he went on. "She would come to every game, all in the rain if need be and cheer me on with 'All you, Mike, I could hear her screaming from the bleachers 'Get off my football!' And I'd grin, 'Hey guys, hear that! Mind my kid sister out there!'"

Several weeks later I wrote the story of meeting Mike Hagler on the plane and made the point that communication between people of different races promotes better understanding and erases prejudices. I ended with my son's words, "Gee, Mom, that's cool." And I sold it to *The Christian Herald*.

Then I called our family doctor, Allan Levy, who coincidentally was the team doctor for the Newark Bears, and explained that I had written a story about Mike Hagler that a magazine was interested in publishing and I wanted Mike to read the article to be sure I had not written anything to offend him. Would Mike Hagler call me? Allan assured me he would convey the message and before another day had passed I was talking to Mike Hagler on the phone. I arranged for him to come and read the article I had written, although he seemed mystified that I would write an article about him. I found out why shortly.

That evening promptly at 8:00 P.M. the doorbell rang. When I

answered a rather slight black man stood there. He was accompanied by a pretty girl companion, a cheerleader from the Newark Bears. As I looked at him, lean, no more than five feet nine inches tall, I recalled my son's words, "One of the smallest, fastest men in pro football."

"You're Mike Hagler?"

"Yes, I'm Mike Hagler."

We stared at each other curiously.

"I've never met you before," I said. "Do you ever recall seeing me?"

"No," he said, "that's why I was puzzled at your call."

"Under the circumstances you were especially kind to come to see me. Please come in." I smiled trying to conceal my confusion. "I have something I want to show you."

I sat both the young people down in the living room and quickly explained that I had met a man on a plane who had said he was Mike Hagler and that I had written an article because of that meeting. I had titled it, "The Man I Met In The Sky." The real Mike Hagler read the story thoroughly, then read it a second time before looking up at me in utter amazement.

SEAGULL SAGA SCORES

AN ADULT tale that resulted from "a videotaped spooky thing" has brought a small fortune to author Richard Bach, nephew of frequent *Fate* contributor Marvin Bach. Young Bach was walking along a canal in Belmont Shore, Calif., 10 years ago when he heard the words "Jonathan Livingston Seagull." Bach went home and started to type out a story which seemed to be "unraveling like a motion picture." But the "film" abruptly stopped after he had completed 10 pages and he was unable to think up a proper ending.

Several years later when Richard was living in Ottumwa, Iowa, he woke up at five o'clock one morning with the ending of the story vivid in his mind. He went off the tale of a gull who learned to fly and loved it in *Flying* magazine, which turned it down. Later *Friends* Pilot magazine published the story, and it was reprinted in *Soaring*. A friend urged him to publish the fable as a book. Bach sent the manuscript to Harper and Row who had published his earlier

three books dealing with his experiences as a pilot but his editor there rejected it.

Meanwhile Marmilian editor Eleanor Friede had sent Bach a routine letter inquiring if he had any aviation stories to submit. Bach sent in a copy of his seagull tale, which Miss Friede persuaded him to revise into a tale for adults. Marmilian published the 30-page volume in late September 1978 illustrated by Russell Munnell's photographs of seagulls in flight. Though Marmilian planned no advertising campaign, the first printing sold out before Christmas and orders continued to pour in. Hundreds of readers of the book have written fan letters to Marmilian commenting on the story's metaphorical overtones. The book is now in its fifth printing and has sold over 140,000 copies, netting the 33-year-old author nearly \$100,000. With part of his royalties Bach has purchased a 1947 Lincoln coupe and named it, naturally enough, "Jonathan" after the seagull that has brought him fame as well as fortune.

WE ALL were sad when my eldest son Wilmer "Butch" Giddens left for Vietnam in 1968. Our family never had been separated before and his wife Janice was expecting their first child. The day he left everyone cried but me. I said I would save my tears for the day he came home safely.

Butch served as a sergeant with the army's 190th Light Infantry Division. The division was constantly in the news, in the papers and on television. Things were bad in Vietnam at that time and we were losing a lot of boys. Butch was a machine gunner on a small tank called a half-track and there was continual danger from mines. Mother, Bobby and I hurried to the hospital from our home in Princeton, N.J. Uncle Sonny was waiting for us. He explained that Grandma had died in the apartment; nothing could be done for her. I asked him where he had found her and we all gasped when he explained that Grandmother was slumped over in her favorite green chair, her lips purple and her eyes looking like glass — just as Bobby had seen her in his dream about 18 hours earlier. — *Hopewell, N.J.*

Stigmata

... an unsolved mystery

A product of divine intervention or hysteria? Heated debate has centered around "the wounds of Christ" for ages.

ONE OF THE most exhaustively studied stigmatics in the history of this inexplicable phenomenon is Louise Lateau, a simple Belgian peasant girl whose case attracted more than 100 doctors and many eminent Catholic churchmen to the tiny village of Bois d'Haine in the province of Hainault.

Louise was born in Bois d'Haine in 1880 and lived a relatively ordinary life until she was 18 years old. Then, after she suffered for a time from an ill-defined illness involving intense neuralgic pains, the stigmata first appeared on April 24, 1898. Bleeding wounds showed on the palms of her hands and on her feet, as if nails had been driven through them. Blood flowed from her side as from a spear wound and droplets of blood circled her brow. Her stigmata appeared between midnight and 1:00 A.M. every Friday morning and lasted for 24 hours. By every Saturday

the stigmata were dry and painless and remained so until the next Thursday midnight when they again began to bleed and hurt.

None of the doctors or churchmen who examined Louise ever had an explanation for the phenomena nor did they find any indication of trickery. Finally, at the request of religious authorities she spent 20 weeks in the fall of 1898 under the supervision of Dr. Lefebvre, an eminent Louvain specialist in nervous diseases. During this time many of his medical colleagues also examined the girl and witnessed the appearance of the stigmata at regular intervals.

A few years later a Dr. Warlomont, who believed Louise herself might be inducing the bleeding in some manner, conducted further experiments, sealing her hands in gloves each Thursday. Nevertheless, when the seals were broken on Friday afternoon her hands were found

to have bled as usual. Dr. Warlomont then devised a glass cylinder in which her arm was sealed in such a way that it was impossible to get at her hand. When her hand was encased in the cylinder on Thursday, January 21, 1875, there was no sign of bleeding but on Friday when the apparatus was examined in the presence of medical witnesses, some of them anticlerical skeptics, the hand was found to have bled.

As a result of this careful investigation of Louise Latour's case the Belgian Academy of Medicine passed a resolution affirming the reality of the phenomenon although several members rejected any supernatural interpretation. And today we are no closer than were these 19th Century medical men to understanding stigmatization.

. . .

ALTHOUGH THE phenomenon is never commonplace it occurs more frequently than we realize. Over the centuries churchmen have investigated every known case of stigmatization with great care and thoroughness looking for evidence of divine intervention. Medical men study the stigmatic to determine whether hysteria is involved and psychic researchers investigate it for any para-normal factors in evidence. With

all this scrutiny it is not surprising that few cases of stigmatization ever are acknowledged as authentic.

Stigmata most often occur in Catholic mystics who have been obsessed with Christ's wounds. Yet the Catholic church is reluctant to admit that any given case represents miraculous intervention. Bearing the wounds of Christ is not considered evidence of superior virtue. Of hundreds of reported cases of stigmatization over the centuries only 30 stigmatisms later have been canonized as saints.

The first stigmatic recognized by the church was St. Francis of Assisi. Lesions through his hands and feet appeared and within the wounds was a hard and horny substance in the form of nails.

Fr. Herbert Thurston, writing in the *Proceedings of the Society for Psychical Research*, Vol. 22, 1922, on "The Phenomena of Stigmatization," tells us many other cases are on record in which the facts are reliable and reported by responsible witnesses. Among those cases Father Thurston considers authentic is that of Gemma Galgani, a middle class young girl who lived in Tuscany (Italy) and died in 1902 at the age of 25. From childhood Gemma was ascetic to an extreme. At 19 she had men-

ingitis and suffered paralysis of her limbs and total loss of hearing. After more than a year of suffering she suddenly and miraculously recovered. Four weeks later she experienced her first ecstasy. Her confessor and biographer, Padre Germano, quotes her description of the ecstasy:

"While spending part of the night in prayer all of a sudden I lost the use of my senses. I found myself before Jesus crucified. He was bleeding all over. I prostrated myself with my forehead on the ground and there remained for several hours. I came to myself with the wounds of Jesus so deeply impressed on my mind that they have never since left it." Several weeks later she developed bleeding wounds which appeared every Friday.

Always recognizing the possibility, even likelihood, of an hysterical origin for the stigmata, Father Thurston says, "It will be readily seen why I emphasize the fact that the wounds in Gemma's body corresponded in position and size with those of the great crucifix before which she was in the habit of praying." Yet, in the presence of accounts by well-known ecclesiastics who investigated Gemma Galgani, he adds, "It seems to me there is no middle

term between either accepting the story as substantially accurate or accusing the writer of deliberate falsehood."

"Perhaps one of the most satisfactory cases I have come across from the evidential point of view," writes Father Thurston, "is that of Blessed Dionisia Allegri, a young nun of Florence (Italy), 36 years of age." In 1877 she sustained a serious illness from which she never recovered. She was so ill that two nuns sat up with her after she had lain unconscious for 24 hours. During the night of Ash Wednesday a change came over her. She assumed the position of Christ on the cross and seemed to be suffering great anguish. During this time her hands bled. A number of church people were called in to witness the phenomena which reappeared on Good Friday. Dionisia then lived until the following December.

* * *

STIGMATIZATION is not a condition known only in ages past. There are several well-known modern stigmatics. The best known is Padre Pio* of Foggia, Italy, a humble, simple man who shrank from publicity and who would not show his wounds. (Interestingly, his case

is the only well-attested example of complete stigmatization in a male since the time of St. Francis.")

Father Thurston has accounts of him from two eyewitnesses. One was Monsignor Kenealy, Archbishop of Simla, who visited Foggia in 1900. Father Thurston writes, "Being himself a Capuchin and a prelate (Monsignor Kenealy) was able to exercise a certain authority over Padre Pio but the Father after allowing his hands to be examined begged so piteously to be excused from any further inquisition that the archbishop felt he could not insist. Still his testimony as to the reality of the wound-marks in the hands, which are always hidden from view by mittens, is positive."

In view of the repute of witnesses who reported on the stigmatized Father Thurston writes about, he concludes, "We seem justified in admitting the reality of these manifestations, though hardly any two examples are exactly alike. But amid a very great diversity in the character of the wounds, the order of development, the periodicity of the bleeding and so on, there are certain features found in nearly

all the cases . . ."

First there is a background of illness, then a vivid realization and concentration on the wounds of Christ for some time before any bleeding appears. "Wherever we have the opportunity of studying the subject's frame of mind," Father Thurston says, "we see the intensity of the mental impression. One would think that if any imagination could produce a powerful physical effect upon the body it would be such as is revealed to us in some of these stigmatics."

Even in today's era of psychosomatic medicine we hesitate to ascribe so profound an effect to mere "imagination." Yet if the conscious mind is not capable of such manifestations, can they be brought about by the unconscious mind? Hypnotists have produced bilaters and other wounds simply by suggestion to hypnotized persons and in 1885 one Dr. Riggs produced cruciform marks on the chest of one of his subjects. In his report in the *Journal of the Society for Psychical Research*, Vol. 3, Dr. Riggs tells of having "magnetized" a Santa Barbara, Calif., girl. He gave her the suggestion: "You will have a red cross appear on the upper part of your chest, only on every Friday. In the course of time the words *Sancta* above the cross and *Crucis* beneath it will also

appear; at the same time a little blood will come from the cross." Dr. Biggs then touched the girl's chest with a cross made of rock crystal. On Friday a pink cross appeared exactly at the place he had touched and after that it appeared every Friday for the period of time he had designated (about four months). It was invisible on all other days. Blood was noticed once and also part of the letter "S" above the cross.

A case highly suggestive of hypnotic influence is that of St. Veronica Giuliani of the Capuchin Order (1688-1727). Her stigmata seemed always to open and bleed at the command of Father Crivelli. This was observed by Bishop Eustachi, who investigated St. Veronica for the Inquisition at the end of the 17th Century. Both priest and bishop witnessed the wounds opening and closing.

However, Father Thurston comments: "I confess I get the impression that if bleeding stigmata have never been artificially produced . . . it has not been for want of trying . . . We may perhaps fairly draw the conclusion that the autosuggestion of the mystic—if indeed it be autosuggestion—is an immensely more powerful influence than hypnosis."

If we conclude with Thurston that hypnosis is ruled out as a

possible explanation of stigmatization we must turn to the condition called hysteria. Hysteria is seen as an overwhelming invasion of the conscious mind by the unconscious. In this state, according to Fr. Reginald Omer in his book *Psychical Phenomena*, "We observe a raging egocentricity, with an intensification of feelings, emotions and passions and a sort of irresistible craving to make oneself interesting, to attract attention, to be talked about, to be blamed and condemned just as much as to be admired and praised."

At times the hysteric is genuinely convinced she has seen, heard or done all her imagination has created, and she believes she is in truth the interesting, illustrious, heroic or tragic person whose part she acts. This conviction can become so intense that the hysteric is capable of swearing false oaths to prove her lies are true. It makes her capable of exposing herself to severe punishment, as if she were guilty of all the sometimes abominable things of which she accuses herself.

Thus in the face of so-called paranormal phenomena of any kind the first question to be asked is whether hysterical mythomania (propensity for lying or exaggerating) has played a part. This was the verdict in a case of a stigmatic who aroused

considerable attention in the 20th Century — Therese Neumann" of Konnersreuth, Bavaria, who lived from 1891 to 1942.

For many years the faithful flocked to witness the phenomena of bleeding and wounds which she began experiencing in 1926. Yet when the Bishop of Bavaria asked her to enter a university clinic for medical observation, she refused, saying her father would not permit her to go. Her family's opposition also made it impossible for doctors to examine her intensively enough to verify or reject her claims.

Members of a church commission which investigated her never actually saw blood oozing from her tissues. Bleeding never occurred except when Therese was hidden under the bedclothes or when every single witness had been compelled to leave the room. It was concluded that no real stigmatization existed and Therese was simply an hysteric.

Prof. Jean Lhermitte, one of the doctors who examined her, stated, "To ends the story of Therese Neumann. A major hysteric with the deceptive streak that accompanies severe neurosis; it is thus that the stigmatic of Konnersreuth reveals herself to us."

Father Thornton cautions, "We might then rest content with the solution that the wounds of the stigmatized mystic were produced by autosuggestion if the problem were limited to the data which we have so far been considering. But this is not the end of the matter. There are other alleged phenomena — phenomena for which very respectable, if not convincing, evidence is producible — which demand a still further extension of the range of the mind's influence over the body. We are informed upon the testimony of surgeons of note in the 17th and 18th Centuries that in the case of several stigmatized persons the tissues of the heart, as revealed in a postmortem examination, have been found to exhibit unmistakable traces of tremendous lesions or indurations of old date, lesions which under normal circumstances would have rendered the continuance of life impossible for more than a few minutes. (It will be remembered that the blow of the lance was commonly supposed . . . not only to have pierced the side of our Saviour, but also to have reached the heart.) Our first impulse would naturally be to dismiss these statements as mere fairy tales, but they are not quite so easily disposed of. They rest, in many cases, upon the sworn evidence

of medical men who, though belonging to a less scientific age than ours, were nevertheless experienced anatomists."

St. Theresa tells us in her autobiography that she had a vision of a glorious angel who thrust a long golden spear with a fiery point into her heart. After the saint's death her extracted heart was found to have a wide horizontal fissure. However, Father Thurston believes this evidence is unsatisfactory, for her heart was removed by unskilled hands.

An example he believes to be better, for it rests on the testimony of several eyewitnesses whose depositions are still available to us, is the wound in the heart of Caterina Ravelli of Soana, Italy. After her death in 1691 the traces of wounds in her hands and feet became perfectly plain and when her heart was extracted it was found to have an old deep fissure. The physician and surgeon who signed the final attestation declared that without supernatural intervention it would have been impossible for anyone to live with such a wound.

Previously mentioned St. Veronica Giuliani believed that the "Instruments of the Passion" (cross, sword, pillar, chalice, nails, etc.) actually were reproduced in miniature in her heart.

During her life she drew more than one plan of the arrangement of these objects. When she died a postmortem was performed by a surgeon and a physician in the presence of several ecclesiastics and others. All signed a formal instrument attesting that they discovered in her heart the exact symbols she had described, quite hard in texture and clearly defined in shape in the same relative positions she had indicated in her drawing.

Somewhat less astonishing, Father Thurston believes, but still very interesting, are the instances of exposed rings found on many stigmatics. The mystics believe these rings were placed on their fingers by Christ as a token of their spiritual nuptials. Such a red ring appeared in the flesh of Marie-Julia Jahenny. Dr. Imber-Gourteyre, professor at the Medical School of Clermont-Ferrand, France, studied her over a period of 20 years with the sanction and encouragement of the bishop of her diocese. In 1872 when she was 23 she exhibited in successive stages the various phenomena of stigmatisation. These were crowned by the appearance of a mystical ring, a hoop of vivid red encircling the ring finger of her right hand. In later years the ring seemed like red coral sunk into the skin on

her finger and it remained visible all her life.

Despite our marked advancement in knowledge of the human mind we know so more about the cause of stigmatisation than did

the 17th-Century ecclesiastics. However, we describe it—as hysterical ecstasies or a miracle of God—we are no clearer than they were to explain it.



REINCARNATION IN NIGERIA

A NIGERIAN housewife has bewitched her family and neighbours by asserting what seems to be proof of having lived a previous life. Mrs. Abagus, 18, of Oye in Nigeria's Eastern State, woke up one morning declaring that her parents actually were not her mother or real father at all. She demanded to be taken to her real parents, a Mr. and Mrs. Abagus Ekeon in the village of Nigrah, 20 miles from Oye. Ekeon's former David Abagus argued with her but failed to change her mind.

Trying to get thoughts of her previous life out of Ekeon's mind the Abagus moved to the Nigrah capital of Lappa, where the girl remained as "Ekeon's" niece. But the first war in Nigeria drove them back to Oye, where the girl again demanded to be taken to her rightful parents. The Abagus considered various doctors but said that this was useless.

One morning Ekeon took a bicycle taxi and found her way to Nigrah alone. There she went to the home of the Eke. Abagus Ekeon, a deaconess in the Anglican Apostles Church, and introduced herself as the child who had died 22 years earlier at the age of eight.

Mr. Ekeon was bewildered:

"He had talked last in eight years, all was 22 years before. To prove her story Ekeon told how she had become ill and was carried to the hospital on a horse. On the way the bell of the bicycle alarmed her son Mr. Ekeon although this was true and was further confirmed when Ekeon showed him a note she wrote on her jaw at the place Ekeon's son was injured.

When he was taken to get better at the hospital, Ekeon reported, the Ekeon had returned him (her) to a prophetic vision he (she) had died two days later. Neighbours crowded the house to hear the girl's story.

"Where is my mother?" asked Ekeon. Mr. Ekeon replied that his wife was at a nearby farm. Ekeon ran to the farm, embraced Mrs. Ekeon and cried, "Mama, I have come back. I am poor child who died 22 years ago." The woman was so frightened she ran screaming from the farm. But once back at her home she locked doors and welcomed the girl.

The Ekeons reported the whole episode to the police headquarters in the nearby city of Calabar. This later inspired her story to Ekeon Osumbelem Betty Osum.

Ghosts of “The Great Gray Barn”

LUSTFUL MALE eyes were watching me take
a midnight bath. I knew it. But when I
whirled and looked around the bathroom there
was no intruder—visible, that is. Moreover, I
knew I was alone and all the doors and windows
were securely fastened from the inside because
I had checked them only moments ago when I
also searched the house.

As I became aware of being watched I heard
footsteps on the stairs, heavy, raspy, steady foot-
falls coming closer. And who is more vulnerable
than a woman in a bathtub?

I wished desperately that my friend Mary
Hecker had come in with me. We had left my
home in Charlotte, N.C., early that March morn-
ing in 1969 for a day in Durham. Arriving back in

Charlotte at 11:30 P.M. I was exhausted when Arlene let me out of the car.

She drove off as I walked up to the 50-year-old greenish-gray house we had nicknamed the Great Gray Barn because of its shape. I had locked the house securely when I left and now for some reason my key wouldn't work in the front door. The door was seldom used anyway and its lock was tricky so I tried the rear and side doors—with the same result. Thoroughly frustrated, I remembered a front window we had jimmied open once before. I got it open and crawled through, then locked the window tightly behind me. My

next move was to search the house, checking all the doors and windows, before I went upstairs to draw my bath.

Preoccupied by the mystery of the doors I couldn't unlock I was ill-prepared for the next shock. The linen closet door had been perforated by small holes which looked as if they had been made by an icepick. I soon realized the holes outlined a regular pattern—a human form my height and shape! Chips and litter on the floor indicated the holes had been freshly made but whatever tool was used was no longer around.

Once again I searched the house and found nothing out of

the ordinary. Although I remained apprehensive I undressed and got in the tub. Almost immediately I felt that stare, then heard the heavy footsteps on the stairs. I could see into a full-length mirror which reflected the space at the head of the stairs but as I watched in terror nothing came into view and the footsteps stopped.

Hopping from the tub I grabbed a robe and flipped on a light to illuminate the stairway. No one was in sight. Nothing moved on the stairs. Only that linen closet door full of holes reminded me that something strange was going on.

. . .

THE EVENTS of that evening were only a climactic part of the many supernatural occurrences at the Great Gray Barn during the years I lived there—from August 1967 to August 1974. The "look over your shoulder" feeling that hostile eyes were watching persisted throughout that time. My husband John felt the challenging and unfriendly eyes in many parts of the house as did a procession of day maids and many of our guests. But while this mysterious scrutiny made us uncomfortable, other events were more serious and sometimes frightening.

For months I had a running battle with a strong-willed spiri-

tual entity who seemed to dislike the way I placed vases, flowers, dollies, books and bric-a-brac in my rooms. And I didn't care much for her taste or her interference.

Between October and December 1967 almost every morning—and sometimes from hour to hour—I would find flowers moved across the room. Starched dollies were shifted to strange places and small vases were switched around, substituted and even hidden. Sometimes flowers were pulled from containers and scattered on the floor. My prized embroidered tea napkins constantly changed locations (turning up in place settings for four around the coffee table, for instance) and several disappeared. I always will wonder if she took those linen napkins back to her etheric realm. Some valuable figurines were dashed to the floor and broken and books were rearranged on the shelves almost daily. I found it difficult to pacify—to say nothing of keeping—the maids who knew of these constant changes.

I felt the presence of this woman so vividly that I began to try to communicate with her telepathically. I learned that she was a Frenchwoman and she gave me the mental impression that her name was Madame

Dashell.² Before she was taken to a nursing home to die she had lived in our Great Gray Barn for many years. Now she apparently believed she still lived here and I was the intruder. Only many months later did I learn that her death coincided with the time her visits to us began. The knowledge I had of the existence and eventual fate of Madame Dashell was confirmed in a casual conversation with a friend, David Rose, who knew all about her and that she had died in the Randolph Nursing Home in the fall of 1947.

By putting up with her interference and talking to her many times I think I persuaded her to leave our home and pursue her own orderly progression on the other side. At any rate her antics discontinued.

I'm sure she was the one, however, who played with my new electric stove, turning it off and on at odd times and changing the temperature setting. On two different occasions I left a chicken and a roast in the oven overnight, with the stove turned off, only to be awakened by the acrid smell of burning meat and to find the oven mysteriously turned to "broil."

Doors and windows, too, were

mysteriously opened. Often when we got up in the morning or returned from a trip we would find them open. One evening five of us — Dick and Tim Baldwin, Don Larson, Lila Jones and I — were rehearsing a play to be given at church. The sound of the doorknob turning attracted our attention and we watched as the door opened, although no human hand had touched it.

The horizontal door which covered the outside entrance to the cellar was so heavy it was difficult for one person to lift. Yet it slammed open and closed apparently by itself, once ripping off a hinge and lock.

One poltergeist-type act in December 1948 almost blew my mind. I had bathed and dressed and sat reading while waiting for a friend to arrive. I could see down the hallway to the kitchen door. Abruptly my eyes seemed to be pulled from the newspaper and I looked down the hall toward a china cabinet.

It really shook me up to see the glass cabinet door slowly swing open and a large amber pitcher move out through the door to hang in midair for fully 30 seconds before it dropped to the floor. From a height of about five feet it shattered into bits almost as fine as sand. I rushed to look at the debris and just then the hall telephone rang. I nearly

jumped out of my skin.

"I had the most horrible feeling you were in danger, I had to call and see." It was Dick Baldwin, one of the group who had seen the doorknob mysteriously turn. When I began to babble about the pitcher Dick said he would come right over.

We never figured out what made the pitcher fall but we did determine that had I been walking past at the moment it fell it would have clonked me on the head.

* * *

MY HUSBAND and I had separated in February 1909 under quite unpleasant circumstances. I am not saying that the ill feeling between us provided the psychic energy for the events that happened after that, for our spooks seem always to have been with us in the Great Gray Barn. However, the most macabre experience — finding the ice-pick-riddled closet door — did happen only two weeks after our separation.

In late March 1909 I made a business trip to Mexico and Central America and returned to Charlotte in July. Soon after getting home I was sleeping late one morning and was awakened by my girl friend Vera McConnell. We were having coffee in my bedroom when I noticed that Vera was staring at my high-

posted antique twin beds.

"My goodness, your shoes look peculiar!" she said.

My heavy brogans, perched atop the bedposts, had been slashed to ribbons, right down to the soles.

"You must have the damndest rats around here," she began — but we both knew no rat could have mutilated shoes so thoroughly.

I distinctly remembered kicking off those shoes in the hallway the night before when I went upstairs to bed. And of course the house had been locked up tight.

Then we saw that the other twin bed — unoccupied since my separation from my husband — looked as if a giant hand had pressed down on the center of the spread and twisted, corkscrewing the fabric into many curved and wrinkled ridges.

"If you don't call the police about this, I will," Vera said.

I did call and a young officer soon came and looked around. After he had checked the shoes, bedroom and grounds he expressed his personal opinion, saying rather sheepishly, "Lady, I think your house must be haunted!"

On the record the destruction of the shoes remained an unsolved mystery but the police were not ready to give up. An investigation was begun by Sgt.

WID Haight and Lt. Michael Johnson of the Charlotte police force and Chris Townsend, a private detective who worked with the police department. The officers came so often to check on the Great Gray Barn that we became friends. They sometimes came to the house after duty hours because they had taken a personal interest in the supernatural manifestations—or perhaps they thought I was in danger.

Ellwood Wallace, the acting district attorney, decided it would be a good idea if I were armed. Mr. Wallace came to my home and loaned me his own pistol and instructed me in its use. Sergeant Haight and Lieutenant Johnson insisted that I let them know if I were to be out late and they volunteered to escort me home on these occasions.

One night in August 1909 when we reached the house Sergeant Haight and I went to the back door and Mike Johnson waited outside the front door. When we entered through the back door, the front door (which had been securely locked when I left the house) suddenly burst open. Either brute force or sheer surprise thrust poor Mike back into the laurels at the edge of the porch. A thorough search of the house turned up no intruder, no pos-

sible explanation for the forced opening of that front door.

Sometimes I arrived at the supposedly empty house to see lights on and hear music inside. Once I hurried in and found the turntable still revolving on the stereo and the mechanism warm. On several mornings I saw the turntable slowing down as I entered the room. But no human intruder ever could be found.

Often I found scraps of my lingerie shredded and forcibly impaled on the rough wood of the cellar door; other personal items just disappeared. One morning when I entered the den I found an expertly-whittled wooden pipe with its stem stuck in the grinning mouth of a mounted capuchin monkey which I prize.

Also, my "invisible smoker" frightened many of my visitors. In the early evening we could see the flowing embers of burning tobacco, like those in a pipe, cigaret or cigar, some distance away in the yard. Occasionally the embers moved as if the invisible smoker moved the burning tobacco in and from his mouth.

One night in September 1909 some of my guests were getting sandwiches in the kitchen when everyone grew very still.

"Who's he?" someone asked.

We looked down the hallway and there stood a ghostly gray

man who beckoned as he turned and walked down the hall and through a closed bedroom door. Two of the men rushed to open the door and search but the apparition had vanished. Previously unwilling to believe that ghosts exist, they were understandably shaken.

* * *

I WAS PROBABLY the most frightened the time someone or something tried to batter its way into the room where I was sleeping. I was alone in the house and confident that all the doors and windows had been securely fastened. I was awakened by the feeling that I was being watched. I turned on lights and looked around. I found nothing amiss but I could hear a slight rustling sound.

I called Chris Townsend, the detective who had helped with the investigations, and told him what was happening. He tried to get me to leave the house immediately but I refused. I hated to move at all, especially to open the doors.

When the noise and the uneasy feeling of being watched continued, I moved into the bathroom, piling blankets and pillows into the bathtub where I intended to sleep. I moved in my telephone too on its long extension cord. The bathroom had a heavy door with a good lock and a

strong chain lock on the inside.

I tried to read, then dozed off only to be awakened by the rattling noise outside the door. Then the door rattled and the knob turned. Suddenly the key flew through the air and landed inside on the floor as if it had been punched out by a sharp blow. I was too petrified even to scream.

The door cracked open, held now only by the chain. It crashed against the chain, closed, then battered against it again.

I remembered the telephone. Frantically I started dialing the police to get Sergeant Johnson. Suddenly the phone began to slip away from me as if someone were pulling on the cord. I crawled along the floor with it, dialing as I moved. At last my friend Mike Johnson answered.

"Get over here fast!" I screamed. That's all I had time to say before the line went dead.

If Sergeant Johnson didn't arrive in time I knew I had two alternatives—to confront whatever was outside my door or to open the bathroom window and drop 13 feet to the ground.

The door continued to jerk and rattle until a patrol car roared up in the driveway below. The would-be attacker apparently heard it too, for no further attempt was made on the door.

I don't know how the officers got into the house but they

came bounding upstairs yelling my name. I collapsed in relief. They searched the house but found no evidence of an intruder other than the obviously strained lock chain anchor on the bathroom door.

Changes in my family situation and in vocational pursuits

necessitated my selling the Great Gray Barn and moving soon afterward or I probably still would be battling those spooks. I often wonder if they manifested to me because of my psychic sensitivity. Were they the perverted attentions of spirits who really had it in for me?



UNDER ATTACK

IF THE Tabor's at 229 24th St., San Francisco, Calif., fell as if their home were under attack, they had good reason, reports the *San Francisco Chronicle*. Early on the evening of February 26, 1951, the five-room house began to shake. Margaret Tabor blamed an earthquake until she discovered a large U-Best trailer blocking her front door. The vehicle somehow had come loose from its moorings 20 feet up the hill, rolled through the Tabor's fence and hedge and wedged itself against the house. The bumper was severe enough to knock over three lamps in the house next door belonging to Phil Johnson.

Traffic officers Hank Hogue and Jerry Foster investigated and ordered the trailer removed. But runaway vehicles are common in hilly San Francisco, they told Mrs. Tabor.

Her husband Owen heard about the incident when he returned from work shortly after midnight. As his wife was describing it, there was a crash and the house shook again. This time a red Cadillac was

wedged up against the house in the same spot the trailer had stood five hours earlier. The driver of the car had lost control and the vehicle had rolled over the Tabor's fence and hedge. Officers Hogue and Foster had more trouble calming the Tabor's after this second incident. The Tabor's began to suspect a conspiracy by their hippie neighbors up the hill but the two policemen joked that perhaps "the full moon" was to blame for the incredible coincidence.

"Weird," muttered Hogue to his partner as they strolled up the hill to their police car. "It could never happen again in a million years."

Just then the men heard a popping noise from their patrol car and the auto began to sway. When they reached the car, they found that the emergency brake had just snapped loose. They estimated that if the car had started to roll, it would have headed down the hill, through the Tabor's and over the hedge right into the Tabor's ten-story house.

During a spectacular flap last July and August numerous witnesses scattered over the central part of Kansas reported odd flying fireballs or flashing red and green lights.

SOMETIME AFTER midnight on August 19, 1972, John Caulkins, assistant manager of Nickerson Farms Cafe near Colby, Kans., was awakened by barking dogs at his home in Gem, nine miles east of Colby. A few moments later he called the Colby

police to report that he had observed "a thing or a couple of things hovering over the horizon" flashing red and green lights. The UFO report was relayed to the Thomas County sheriff's office and dismissed.

Not long afterwards Colby Police Sgt. Paul Carter began his early morning patrol and about 2:07 A.M. saw an object with bright red and green flashing lights come from the northeast and pass toward the southwest over Colby. He set out in pursuit. Sergeant Carter later told International UFO Bureau investigators that he followed the UFO for

about two miles before it stopped. While he was in pursuit he realized his fellow officer Donald Brown, who was returning from cruising in the Goss area. Carter said that the object was about "seven or eight city blocks" ahead of him as he chased it southwest down Country Club Drive and that he attempted to photograph the UFO with his FV-160 camera.

The UFO paralleled the county road south and then abruptly stopped and hovered over a plowed field. Sergeant Carter pulled his patrol car off the main road near the Interstate 70 overpass two miles south of Colby and saw a huge disc-shaped object 30 or 35 feet long hovering about 100 yards away.

"I watched this object for 15 to 20 seconds," explains Carter.

"All the time it was flashing red and green. It resembled a normal hotel turned upside down and it was about 35 feet wide and about 15 to 20 feet tall."

Suddenly the object began to glow with a white light so bright that Carter no longer could look at it. The UFO illuminated the field that Sergeant Carter could see several jackrabbits sitting nearby. As the UFO shone brighter and brighter "a little white dust" appeared to drip from it but Carter did not see this material touch the ground.

After approximately eight minutes, at about 2:15 A.M., without warning the UFO "made a whooshing sound and went straight up into the sky, with the intense white light going out as it lifted off." The "whooshing sound" could not be heard after the initial blast-off. Within three seconds the UFO was too high to be visible.

Officer Donald Brown was approaching Carter's position from the northwest. His view was blocked by a slight hill but he

could see a glow of light coming from behind the hill. He had almost reached Carter's position when the UFO made its rapid ascent. But after about 20 seconds the UFO rapidly descended into sight again. Both Brown and Carter now could see the craft flashing red and green lights and Officer Brown attempted to photograph the UFO with his Instamatic camera.

Then the multi-colored flashing object headed southeast from Colby toward the Mingo interchange on Interstate 70 about 10 miles away. At 1:21 A.M. Officers Carter and Brown contacted the police at Oakley, Kans., 20 miles from Colby, and asked them to be on the lookout for a UFO heading their way. Less than a minute later Oakley police authorities spotted the UFO three miles outside of town.

Officer Earl Wood, Jr., said, "There appeared to be six lights on the object, the three in the rear being white and the three in the front being either amber or red and green." Wood added that the colored lights "continuously flashed from dim to bright. There was no trouble identifying that it was a circular object." Wood also saw something fall from the UFO but said it disintegrated before it hit the ground.

After hovering in plain view for five minutes, at 1:25 A.M. the

UFO moved north and out of sight of the Oakley policemen.

During this time police in Colby received several reports from citizens who could see a UFO. John Caulkins, the first man to spot the UFO, now reported "Two or three objects" were moving about near Gem, Kans., "making weird noises." Colby Officers Carter and Brown drove towards Gem to check out the reports.

Upon arriving at Gem Carter and Brown found the UFO had indeed returned and was again flashing multicolored lights. While watching the UFO from outside their patrol cars the officers tried an experiment. "We extended an arm," explained Carter, "locking it and bracing it against the car roof and sighting the UFO over an extended thumb." By watching the UFO in relation to this fixed point both men reported that the craft appeared to waver in the air while it hovered.

Soon the UFO again moved away from Gem towards Rexford about nine miles to the northwest, where again it stopped and hovered. Officers Carter and Brown followed it but already were beyond their legal jurisdiction and decided not to pursue the UFO farther. However, they continued able to see the UFO in the distance and observed it for "several hours." While watching it they also saw

between four and eight smaller objects zipping through the night sky.

"The smaller lights moved from the west to the east and back again," remarked Brown, "sometimes moving from one horizon to the other in less than five seconds."

At 1:00 A.M. these smaller UFOs began flying in formation, forming patterns of circles or squares, then scattering and regrouping.

Shortly after this Sergeant Carter talked to an unidentified Missouri couple who had been traveling down Interstate 70 when the sky ahead of them "suddenly lit up" and an intense white light swept down the highway, nearly blinding them, before passing overhead at a high rate of speed. At first the couple thought a commercial airliner was attempting an emergency landing on the highway. But a later check of fields in the vicinity of their sighting showed no sign of a landing.

The Instamatic film taken by Officer Brown was rushed to Hays, Kans., for processing but came out blank. Sergeant Carter told investigators, "I got one half-decent picture . . . but any skeptic could tear it apart in about 10 seconds." The print, Carter explains, shows something resembling a car headlight but there is

nothing to indicate the scale. The photo has even been blown up to poster size but "all you get is a bigger object," he says.

Sergeant Carter summarized his reactions to his sightings by saying, "I was a firm nonbeliever until seven minutes after 2:00 but I found I could change my mind pretty fast."

. . .

THE UFO sighting by Carter and Brown was far from the first in central Kansas. A similar craft was spotted in the Dighton, Kans., area in late 1971. At first the sightings attracted little interest, explains Dighton Police Chief M. R. Shelton. The police assumed the craft was a military plane taking infrared photos "to check fuellet runoff." When sightings persisted into 1972, however, police began keeping records of UFO appearances. Daniel Garcia of the International UFO Bureau kept in touch with Dighton officials by phone and letter and finally visited Dighton on August 12 and 13, 1972, to interview witnesses.

Chief Shelton told Garcia that the unidentified craft "appears round and is red-orange in color. It hovers about 30 feet off the ground and appears about 10 miles west of Dighton," he said. The UFO seemed intelligently controlled and changed its position whenever police officers

tried to investigate. "The thing will remain stationary until an investigating officer radios another unit about it," explains Shelton. "Then it begins to move away. Every time we transmit it moves."

Capt. John Banninger confirmed Shelton's statements. Banninger first saw an unusual light northwest of Dighton on March 22 at about 10:20 P.M. Ten minutes later he reported this by radio and the UFO moved rapidly to the west, going out of sight in less than four minutes. The same thing happened when he spotted the light two days later on March 24 at about 10:15 P.M. As soon as he radioed in a report the UFO took off westward. His next sighting was on July 1, 1972; this time the light disappeared into the clouds before he could report it.

Two nights later on July 7 Banninger again spotted the UFO southwest of Dighton at 4:45 A.M. It sped west as soon as he reported it. The UFO reappeared at the identical time two days later. This time, however, after Banninger called in the report at 3:08 A.M. the police dispatcher radioed the police in Scott City, 24 miles to the west. Scott City Officer Reginald Ford saw the UFO coming from the east but then it abruptly halted, retreated eastward again and then disap-

peared to the south. Officer Banninger described the light as the "blue-white cast of an iodine quartz light varying to a peach-colored glow."

Dighton was in the path of a "bright flashing multicolored craft" which flew across central Kansas on August 13. UFO reports that night began at 10:30 P.M. in Hays, Kans., when unidentified citizens began phoning Police Dispatcher Jim Girvan to report a "red glow, making no sound and remaining almost motionless" over the northeast part of the city. An unidentified member of Police Unit 183 watched the UFO and later reported, "It's just like someone turned the switch off and it just disappeared."

The next UFO report came from Russell, Kans., 25 miles east of Hays. At 12:03 A.M. Russell police watched an unidentified light head west towards Hays. At 12:34 Lt. Ralph Augustine and Officer Dave Wasinger of the Hays police spotted the UFO northeast of the Hays airport, lost sight of it momentarily and later saw it again near the KAYS radio tower.

At 2:33 A.M. police in Ellis, Kans., 15 miles west of Hays, saw the UFO circling the town at "about 5,000 feet high." At 3:11 Ellis Police Unit 28 saw four UFOs. The single UFO apparent-

ly continued westward and at 3:35 A.M. was seen over Dighton by Officer Banninger and Rodney Lance who was with him this time. Both men watched the craft as it headed west over Dighton and disappeared, all within about two minutes.

Banninger reports, "From the front it appeared red and green. As the UFO passed directly overhead the green lights were lost. On the underside were two red lights towards the front and two white lights towards the rear. Based on the configuration of the lights the object seemed to be triangle-shaped and about 1200 feet in the air."

At 3:43 A.M. residents of La Crosse, Kans., saw the UFO pass westward from Hays toward Liberal. At 4:02 it was reported at Yocemento. Over the next three days UFOs were seen at Ellsworth, Platteville, Stockton, McCracken, Lyons, Ellinwood and Great Bend, Kans.

* * *

COULD THESE many reports be due to suggestion or some sort of mass hysteria? Girvan tended to dismiss this explanation, pointing out that the first public announcement of the UFO sightings came over Colby radio

station KAYS at 4:00 A.M. on Wednesday, July 18, hours after multiple sightings were reported the previous night. Girvan also pointed out that multiple witnesses to some of the sightings all reported the same thing.

Although the Kansas sightings in July were the most striking, International UFO Bureau collected reports during July and August over a 10-state area of the midcontinent.

We can only speculate as to the motivation for all this UFO activity. The purpose appears to have been peaceful reconnaissance of some sort and it is interesting that many sightings were near water reservoirs.

UFO researcher Kenneth Larson suggests there might be a connection between the concentration of sightings in central Kansas and America's geographic center. But he does not elucidate this concept.

Perhaps someday we will understand the purpose of the UFO visits but for the moment we can only agree with the observations of Colby Police Officer Carter who said, "You'd think we were maniacs except for all the people who saw this. It's true; that's all I can say about it."



The Strange Story of the YELLOW BIRD



Did the bird in King Tut's cartouche portray a predestined victim of his infamous curse?

IT IS WELL known that misfortune befell a number of persons who dared penetrate King Tut-ankh-Amen's tomb, thus lending credence to the widely-publicized "curse of King Tut." It is not so well-known that one of its victims was a tiny yellow canary.

The "curse" has been a subject of controversy for 50 years and many authorities have stated repeatedly it is only idle superstition. Be that as it may, Prof. J. C. Mardrus, a French Egyptologist, insists the tomb was protected by a curse he found graven on a tablet at the entrance. He called it the "Stein of Malédiction" and translated it:

"Let the hand raised against my form be withered! Let them be destroyed who attack my name, my foundations, my effigies, the images like unto me."

Most mysterious of all the strange happenings that harked back to the curse was the fate of a pet canary. Howard Carter, the Egyptologist who discovered the tomb, loved to stroll through Cairo's colorful old bazaars. One day, haggling over the price of an object, he was stopped short by the pure trilling notes of a birdsong. Listening entranced,

he asked to see the bird, a yellow canary, and immediately determined to buy it. However, the tradesman refused to part with the warbler until Carter offered a fantastic sum. Happily he returned to the Valley of the Tombs of the Kings at Thebes carrying his newfound prize. The voice of the flaxen-feathered songbird filled the air. She sang constantly and was silent only when sleeping or eating.

Carter discovered the tomb of King Tut-Ankh-Amen on November 4, 1922, and soon thereafter he carried the bird inside. Immediately a change came over her. When the vault was opened she fell silent in mid-song and resumed singing only when the door was closed. Later, when the seals of the guardian statues were broken to reveal the burial chamber, again her voice was stilled — until the entrance was reclosed.

The day the sarcophagus lid was raised Carter left the canary at home. All his attention was centered on his first sight of the body of the young monarch which had lain undisturbed for 32 centuries. On King Tut-Ankh-Amen's brow lay a golden dia-

dem with vulture and sacred asp, symbols of the gods of Upper and Lower Egypt. Gold covered each toe and finger and on either side of the body were the wings of a sacred bird. His magnificent death mask of massive gold with eyebrows and eyelids of inlaid lapis lazuli was an admirable portrait of the young Pharaoh. Stripes of blue glass laid in gold formed his magnificent headdress.

At the moment the inner tomb door was opened, the canary — at home in her cage in Carter's garden — fell silent. According to all Carter could learn from the servants whom he later questioned repeatedly, almost simultaneously with the bird's silence, a serpent slithered into the garden and struck the bird in its unguarded cage.

The curious behavior and grotesque death of the canary remain an insoluble mystery. Had the tiny bird sensed danger and death in the ancient tomb?

To add to Carter's bewilderment, when he deciphered the inscription identifying the burial chamber, he was astonished to read: "Chamber of the Yellow Bird."

An 80-Year-Old Grandmother Insists

CHOPIN

Guides Her Hands

AN 80-YEAR-OLD woman who communicates with the spirit of Frederic Chopin has stunned European music critics by performing in public concerts the great composer's "new" works—although she has had almost no musical training.

Mrs. Karin Harms of Copenhagen presented several recitals in Denmark in 1971 and 1972 which left critics amazed. They say that her pieces seem to be authentically those of the great

Polish-French composer who died in 1849.

Hans Volgt, music critic for the country's leading daily newspaper, *Berlingske Tidende*, told me, "Mrs. Harms knows quite a lot of the ways in which Chopin treated his music, the way he expressed himself in music. And after all, this cannot be a fraud from her side. The concerts she has given were not static. There was something there from the inspiration of Chopin,

something more than herself. She certainly seemed sincere to me."

Unable to offer any explanation for Mrs. Harma's ability to play such complex music when she can neither read nor write notes, Voigt concludes, "You never know about these things and so you must not reject what you do not understand."

Articles about Mrs. Harma in mass-circulated magazines aroused my interest and led me to visit her. She is a pensioned widow and lives in a small apartment. She has

tremendous energy and spends many hours a day practicing on the piano. She admits she has no technical understanding of music. She once took piano lessons for three months — 48 years ago. Yet she now plays intricate études, polonaises, mazurkas, sonatas and other complicated works — all Chopinesque music which requires ability and technical skill.

Mrs. Harma told me she has been in contact with Chopin for about nine years. "He talks to me," she said, "and we practice together and he dictates his compositions to me. Since I cannot read or write regular musical

notes, we have worked out a system of letters which I am able to translate into music."

I saw some of the alphabetical "notations" written on manuscript paper. It's some kind of shorthand system she has devised which would have no meaning for anyone else. She often writes the be-

ginning of the piece or enough to remind her how it goes and also notes down certain passages which would be hard to remember. Thus she really works mostly by memory.

Chopin prompted her to hold her first concert, she told me. "I was a bit nervous at first about playing before the public. I didn't want to make a fool of myself. But Chopin said the time

was right to prevent these new works."

Of course she hadn't any idea how to go about arranging a concert. But with Chopin prodding her, in May 1871 she telephoned Dr. Phil. Borge Friis, whom she knew only by reputation, and told him about Chopin's em-mu-ni-cation.

Friis is a pianist and music critic for the *Frederiksborg County Newspaper* and for the leading *Jættland* daily. Aarhus *Supplende*. His version of her call is interesting. When I talked to him in October 1971 he said, "She phoned and told me about Chopin and how they were working together. I didn't know her and I must admit it certainly was a strange phone call. When she said that Chopin had advised her to telephone me I was naturally skeptical but I must say that she has a charming manner. She sounded sweet and genuine."

"Although her story was strange, almost unbelievable, I didn't discount it entirely. Certain types of psychic phenomena are true and valid, I think, and no matter how small the chances might be I do not think anyone should deny the phenomena of-hand."

Soon thereafter Friis and an associate arranged to hear Mrs. Bernus play. His associate was

Karel Cornelius, the cultural editor of *Frederiksborg County Newspaper*. After the audition the men decided that Mrs. Bernus should have a chance to play the new Chopin works before the public. Friis arranged her first concert for November 25, 1971, at the Frederiksborg Cultural Center in Hillerød, a city a few miles north of Copenhagen.

It was acclaimed a "big success" and according to the *County's* concert manager Jens Simonsen, "It was one of the most interesting and unusual concerts we've ever held here."

Her second performance on December 21, 1971, at Odd Fellow Palæet, a Copenhagen concert hall, was arranged and sponsored by Denmark's Society for Psychological Research and was attended by the members of the society as well as the public at large.

"Seen entirely plausibly," wrote Hans Volgt in his critique in the *Berlingske Tidende*. "Mrs. Bernus' presentation was impressive in many ways. Chopin's melodic phraseology, tenderness and certain sides of the emotional quality which mark his productions were remarkably well performed. . . ." The Copenhagen daily, *Politiken*, commented, "Chopin was unmistakable in these works."

Such newspaper accounts and hundreds of friendly congratulatory letters Mrs. Harna received make it evident that the concerts went off very well and left the audience impressed. International magazine and newspaper reports soon generated interest throughout Europe in the 80-year-old great-grandmother's communication with Chopin.

Povl Strube, the founder of the Society for Psychical Research in Denmark which now has 1700 members, says, "Mrs. Harna probably was born with this extraordinary awareness. We've known about her for many years now. Her ability to play posthumous compositions by Chopin seems quite genuine."

. . .

CHOPIN first entered Mrs. Harna's life when she was only five years old. She heard one of his waltzes, a sad one, being played.

"Suddenly something strange happened," she recalls. "Time seemed to be flowing around me as if the years, the centuries, were streaming by. Memories of

the past, of things far outside the world of a child, welled up within me as I listened to his music."

However, that long-ago incident scarcely prepared her for what was to come. The only manifestation of her psychic abilities, she says, has been

Our Occult Revival

The Old and the Nouveau Witch



PART TWO

What motivates modern youth to take up witchcraft or satanism as a faith and how deep are their commitments?

By Mariella Truzzi



Last month we dealt with the important revival of occultism and particularly its role in today's youth culture, with emphasis on the clearly predominant interest in astrology. As we shall see witchcraft and Satanism are running a very close second.

WITCHCRAFT and satanism follow astrology as the second most popular focus of current attention in occultism. The large number of recent popular books and articles dealing with these subjects attests to this upsurge of interest. (Often these publications are reprints of much older volumes.) Although witchcraft and satanism are commonly linked together, they actually represent very different belief-systems and each has an existing variety of forms. This variation is not surprising because broad differences over the question of the existence

of the devil do exist among Christians. While 66 percent of the Roman Catholics in the United States apparently believe in the actual existence of the devil, only six percent of the Congregationalists, 13 percent of the Methodists and 21 percent of the Presbyterians believe in his existence. The Southern Baptists (32 percent) are the only major group that seemingly remain solid in their belief in an actual devil.

The alleged difference between so-called white versus black magic is one major distinction discussed in much of the occult

literature. White magic is supposed to be the use of magic for socially benevolent ends; black magic is supposed to be the use of magic for malevolent ends. Even though some ritual forms of black magic clearly involve calling upon such malevolent forces as the devil or his demons, most magicians basically view magic as a value-free "technology-of-the-supernatural" (supernatural is a term preferred by many magicians). They believe their own motives determine whether their use of magic is for good (white) or for evil (black). As one of my traditional white witch informants put it, "Magic is like a knife. A surgeon can use it to perform an operation to save a life or a madman can use it to murder someone."

Contemporary witches usually do not consider themselves satanists. Satanism is basically the worship of the Judeo-Christian devil which is at times only a symbol and at other times very literally real. Varying degrees of fundamentalism exist among satanists. Practitioners in witchcraft do not usually view themselves as an heretical offshoot of Christianity but satanists do view themselves, either literally or symbolically (since many satanists are atheists), as members in league with the Christian's devil. Most witches perceive witchcraft

as a folk tradition of magical beliefs. Many if not most of them further perceive it as an ancient pre-Christian fertility religion that the Christian churches sought to suppress, primarily through the Catholic inquisitions and the Protestant witch trials. They believe that their religion became misrepresented and distorted as an heretical worship of the devil. On the other hand, satanists often do constitute a kind of inverted Christian sect. And oddly enough most of history's satanists seem to be direct outgrowths of the Christian churches' misrepresentations of early witchcraft practices. The inquisitions so impressed some individuals with the fantastic and blasphemous picture of satanism that they decided they would "rather reign in hell than serve in heaven."

Several different varieties seem to depict the nonheretical, non-satanic or white witches. The important division is the sociologists is between those witches who are individual practitioners and those who belong to organized witch coven. Most frequently encountered, the former variety represents the independent or solitary witches who can be further subdivided into two somewhat oversimplified classes: (1) one represents those who, having learned the secrets of the art

through some special knowledge to another subject which practice without as a naturally inherited art. (2) The other representative of those who, having obtained their practices from the social literature, practice within-craft as self-designated within.

My investigations show that the vast majority of within are in fact and especially after the 1881 publication of the late Ger-

ard Gardner's first book on the subject. Gardner's works were very influential in British occult circles and many esoteric orders and many esoteric societies between the which comes

formed before and after the 1881 period of Whitcraft have in fact and especially after the 1881

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holds a secret register of covens existing around the world. This, however, seems to include only the Gardnerite covens which, according to Mrs. Wilson, numbered several hundred at that time. In 1969 another well-publicized witch, Sybil Leek, told me she estimated that approximately 200 covens were operating in the United States. The fact is that covens, especially those in existence before 1951, have little communication with one another. Members sometimes migrate and join or begin a new coven but no central hierarchy or witchcraft organization exists. Except for Mrs. Wilson and Mrs. Leek most witches know little about those in other parts of the country or world. These women are somewhat unusual because their extensive publicity and travels have brought them into contact with a great many witches wishing interaction with them. It is, therefore, impossible to obtain any sort of accurate estimate of the number of covens now in operation. Because a great number of new covens did begin after 1951 they appear to represent the bulk of the known witchcraft groups about which we read today. More may exist but I did locate three pre-1951 covens in Michigan and thus I estimate that at least 150 such traditional covens probably exist in Great

Britain and the United States.

According to Margaret Murray the maximum number of persons in a coven is 13. Thus Great Britain and the United States together probably can claim no more than 1,950 coven members, a rather small part of the mass market currently devouring the many marketable witchcraft items and books. Coupling the coven members with the solitary witches (many of whom are really not very serious) still leaves us with a relatively small number of witches in the United States, the maximum being probably less than 1,000. Like the interest in astrology, the popular interest in this form of occultism is very superficial. Like astrology, witchcraft represents a play-function for the major portion of its current popular audience.

Satanists also represent two distinct types: the solitary agents and those operating in groups. We know next to nothing about the former. If some individuals believe they have made contractual arrangements with the devil it is understandable that they might not wish this widely known, particularly if they are doing evil things. There are at least four major varieties of satanic groups. The first and probably least frequent variety follows some nonheretical (to them) interpretation of Christianity in

of Satan has received vast inter-

national publicity over the past

five years.

Although the church will de-

pend heavily upon the charisma

of its founder it is structurally

governed and now has two

churches (San Francisco and New

York) plus a number of still

more (to the general public)

branches scattered around the

world.

Although in 1970 the church claims that

it really represents a "black mass,"

and a "to the maximum extent possi-

ble, the government has shown the Church

of Satan the way out of its predicament

country. Because contributing members pay an initial fee of \$30 for their lifetime membership the church has had a relatively prosperous economic beginning.

The Church of Satan defines magic as "obtaining changes in accordance with one's will" and perceives of magic not as supernatural (i.e., forever scientifically inexplicable) but simply as supernormal (i.e., not yet fully understood by science but amenable to eventual explanation). The church actively rejects spirituality and mysticism of any sort and espouses an elitist, materialist and basically atheistic philosophy. Satan constitutes a worship of one's own ego. Unlike most atheisms, the position of the Church of Satan is that these symbolic entities are powerful and indispensable forces in man's emotional life and necessary for the success of greater (Ritual) Magic.

The Church of Satan takes a position of extreme Machiavellianism and cynical realism toward the nature of man. Its major feature, however, is its emphasis upon the importance of myth and magic and their impact in a world of people who still can be manipulated through such beliefs and emotions. These satanists, then, are the ultimate pragmatists.

This predominant form of sa-

tanism does not represent a new mysticism at all. It not only denies the existence of anything supernatural or spiritual but it even condemns narcotics, hallucinogens and other agents that might act to separate rational man from his material environment. These satanists do not seek escape from reality; they wish to control reality and are willing to use all forces—including irrational elements—that will help achieve their desired ends. Unlike the acid culture satanists who seek identity through mysticism and other levels of "consciousness" these satanists are much opposed to the hippie culture of acid and altruism. As a result many conservative, authoritarian, anti-hippie persons are strongly attracted to the Church of Satan although it has no political ideology or preference for a particular economic system. In some of the recent church literature a rising note of appeals to patriotism has occurred.

I argue that, like those interested in astrology, the major followers of satanism represent not a search for a new spiritual meaning but only a disenchantment with our pedantic religious orthodoxy.

HOW ARE WE to assess this rising tide in interest in the occult?

I have shown three major facts in this paper. First, the interest in the occult is multidimensional, not the simple integrated and consistent "bag" that many, especially writers in the popular press, have described it to be.

Second, many persons involved in following today's occultisms are not simple identity-seekers as some have portrayed them; these occultisms serve a variety of functions quite apart from offering new normative structures as an escape from disorientation, anxiety and isolation.

Third, most of those involved in the current occult revival have a relatively superficial connection with it. For most Americans it is a leisure-time fad of popular culture rather than a serious religious search. I believe we may rightfully refer to the mass version of occultism as pop religion. I argue that it shows a playful contempt for what many once viewed (and some still do view) seriously. I further argue that the current mass interest in occultism represents a kind of victory over the supernatural. We are seeing a demystification process of what once were fearful and threatening cultural elements. Most significant is the playful attitude of most of the persons involved. What in the past were fearful, dark and awe-

inspiring secrets known only through initiation into arcane orders now are fully exposed to the eyes of Everyman.

Years ago few persons would have dared to enter an allegedly haunted house. Now an allegation of haunting brings a rush of inquisitive teen-agers who desire to spend the night just to see the ghost. Would it be proper to interpret this interest as a renewed belief in ghosts? It is precisely because we no longer believe in the fearsome aspects of the occult that we are willing to experiment with them. Most of those who would willingly draw a proper pentagram on the floor to invoke a demon would do so precisely because they do not believe that some devil's emissary who might pluck their souls down to hell will visit them. If we fully believed in demons we certainly would not dare to call them up.

This assessment does not deny that the number of true believers in the occult has grown. Nor does it deny that other nonoccult phenomena which indicate a growing number of persons seeking new religious meanings have occurred.

Certain mundane factors however, were bound to cause an increase in occult activity: (1) the increase in our general population, (2) some disillusionment

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TALE OF TWO CITIES

AMONGST the flurry of psychic conferences held across the nation in recent weeks were two which measured close enough at hand for me to attend. In early October a Psycho World Conference, sponsored by the extensive division of the University of Wisconsin and the newly-formed Wisconsin Society for Psychological Research (121 W. Wells St., Rm. 200, Milwaukee, Wis. 53201) was held in Milwaukee. WSPR is largely the brainchild of hypnolist Steven Yael and began with some of his students. This conference was their first attempt at a large public meeting and to my mind it was a resounding success. About 100 persons pre-registered for the weekend and an additional 200 or so attended at least part of the sessions.

The best known personalities on the program were Ruth Montgomery and Robert Monroe, who has written of his out-of-the-body experiences. Chicago astrologer Katherine De Jersey and Yael himself spoke also. Most interesting to me was a panel of three noted parapsychologists,

Charles Houston, Robert Van De Castle and Robert Morris. Houston and Van De Castle reviewed the rather familiar material on the dyson-telepathy research at Maimonides Hospital in Brooklyn and Houston related more recent research with hypnotically-induced dreams. Morris described an investigation of a haunted house during which a cat, a dog, a laboratory rat and a rattle-snake were brought into the room where the alleged disturbances occurred. All but the rat showed definite fear reactions, the rattle even assuming a striking pose while staring at an (apparently) empty chair in the haunted room.

Afternoons with the lectures were smaller workshop sessions on all manner of topics: yoga, psychometry, astral projection, hypnosis, etc. Fair reviewer Paul Dimmitt and I attended Robert Morris' workshop during which he described some of

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the fascinating work being conducted on the subject problem by the Perichol Research Foundation in Durham, N. C. WPSA is to be commended for an excellent conference.

The following weekend was the second annual Midwest Festival of Psychic Arts sponsored by PSL, Inc. (227 N. Madison St., Indianapolis, Ind. 46202). The 1971 one-day affair was expanded in 1972 into a two-day program that took place on three floors of Indianapolis Athenaeum Turners Club. This festival was organized quite differently from the Milwaukee conference. PSL presented only two main speakers, the internationally Katherine De Jersey and Chicago's Rev. Clifford Mayne, Jr. The lower floor of the large building was devoted to booths featuring various activities and organizations—astrology, cartology, Tarot readings, etc.—Silver Mind Control, Concept Therapy, Inner Peace Movement, Spiritual Frontiers Fellowship, Camp Charterfield, A. R. E., Theosophical Society and Park. Throughout the day there were lectures and demonstrations in eight different rooms on the upper floors.

Admission, which included all the different readings that were available, was only \$2.00 a day, which was a pleasant contrast to many of the overpriced affairs I am advertised. This economy was possible through the use of numerous local volunteers and guests (I gave four slide lectures during the weekend myself). Although the attendance was not up to the highly optimistic number projected it was enough to assure another such event next year. PSL recently has established new permanent headquarters where classes in astrology, numerology and palmistry are conducted. This organization has been very successful in the few short years since its founding in August of 1969.

but except for brief forays into
Maryland and New York it deals
almost exclusively with California
psychics, most notably Doug Johnson
and Bill Corcoran. David St. Clair, on
the other hand, deliberately limited
himself to *The Psychic World of
California* (Doubleday & Co., Garden
City, N.Y., 1972, 288 pages, \$5.95).

If it seems strange that the same
publisher produced both these vol-
umes, I hasten to explain that the
approach of the two authors is quite
different. Briefly, Stearns is more
concerned with phenomena and St.
Clair with personalities. Both books
are well written and worth reading.

But I hope you will refrain from
following the suggestion David St.
Clair makes in his brief introduction.
He writes, "Those who find history a
bore . . . are advised to turn to page
47, where the 1970's begin." Anyone
who follows this advice will miss the
most fascinating part of the volume
— St. Clair's history of occultism in

Californian. An astonishing cast of characters parades through this brief chapter and I find myself hoping St. Clair someday will present an expanded version of this material. The remainder of the book is organized in terms of geography. Three extensive chapters describe northern, central and southern California and their respective practitioners. As a result chapters run nearly 100 pages in length and I found this a little unwieldy. The geographic arrangement also entails Tibet readers following on the heels of astrologers, followed in turn by healers or numerologists. As this suggests, St. Clair includes proponents of the occult sciences in addition to psychics. Perhaps a sorting by type would have made more sense. Only about a half dozen examples of "readings" by practitioners are included. In the main, St. Clair gives character sketches, analyzing the psychic's start, his philosophy of life, how he uses his gift, and his views on the occult explosion. In some cases one cannot be sure whether St. Clair actually believes the statements of some of the further-out personalities or is holding them up to ridicule. However, having met him personally, I very much doubt he intends deliberate ridicule but the extravagant statements frequently appalled me.

Since the volume's arrangement makes it something of a guidebook to your local psychics, I was surprised that addresses are totally lacking. I asked St. Clair about this, mainly because I fear a rash of mail to Fats requesting the addresses of Mr. X and Madame Y. (Some readers assume Fats possesses the addresses of every psychic known to mankind, which is far from the case.) David explained that if readers will write to him in care of the publisher (Doubleday & Co., 271 Park Ave., New York, N.Y. 10017)

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enclining return postage, he will send out a mimeographed list of addresses of all these psychics in the book who wish their addresses made public.

This volume well might set a trend. I can see similar volumes recounting the psychic worlds of Illinois, New York or Florida (South Dakota, Wyoming or Delaware might not provide enough material!)

INFALLIBLE GUIDANCE?

BY CHANCE or by design Stearn's volume concerns only psychics who were omitted from St. Clair's. He organizes his material by type of advice being offered, with separate chapters on business affairs, romance, family problems and the like. An interesting chapter deals with psychic healing, primarily that of Lee Arnold Doug Johnson (not to be confused with British medium Douglas Johnson). Other chapters deal with the possibility of spirit contact and with misinformation.

The major flaw in Stearn's eminently readable book is the one-sided portrait he paints of his psychics. Perhaps his title forces him to portray them as "miracle workers" who are never wrong. He takes cracks at ineffective people who waste time running from one reader to another but why shouldn't they if readers are as infallible as he portrays Corrado, Johnson and Maya Perez? Alas, this seems inevitably to happen in popular accounts of psychics: they are either always right or (if the author is a debunker) always wrong.

This tendency marred even Brad Steiger's biography of Irene Hughes. I noted with interest the inclusion of Mrs. Hughes at the end of Stearn's book, where a few of her "predictions" are quoted. If Irene read my column in the May 1971 *Fort* in which I discussed what is and what is not a valid prediction, it has had



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no effect on her pronouncements.

She continues to issue series of "productions" that are nothing of the sort, as witnessed by the central chapter of her own book, *ESPECIALLY JRENE* (Steigerbooks, Barre, Vt., 1972, 120 pages, \$3.95). This paperback volume also contains Mrs. Hughes' views on psychic development, prayer and meditation and psychic research. While not particularly profound she is unquestionably sincere. Readers might enjoy the insights into the thinking of this well-known seeress.

STEIGER'S SAFARI

A MORE impressive account of Mrs. Hughes is contained in a recent paperback by perennial author Brad Steiger, *JRENE Hughes on Psychic Safari* (Warner Paperback Library, New York, N.Y., 1972, 174 pages, 95 cents) is far better than Steiger's first book on Jrene, *Kama the Future Today*, simply because it sticks to the record and avoids exaggerated claims. Taking a clue from Hans Holzer's repertoires, Steiger arranged for Mrs. Hughes to visit nine reputedly haunted locales to see what psychic impressions she would receive. The results are impressive, although I am not certain how to interpret her work. In some instances, it seems probable that she was picking up information telepathically from witnesses who were present. Indeed, some of the "hauntings" seem to be mental constructs by living persons. In other instances, the possibilities of mediumship seem stronger.

Psychic Safari also represents an advance over some previous Steiger volumes when it comes to analysis. Brad seems far less reluctant than in the past to state his own evaluation of the phenomena he reports. I was particularly intrigued by the case in which he himself "picked up" the ghost while Mrs. Hughes

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external world, warnings or reminders the waking mind has pushed aside — prescientive and clairvoyant dreams fall into this category. Second, dreams point up our real attitudes and prejudices toward the person about us. Third, dreams reveal inner hindering weaknesses and conflicts and also the strengths needed to bring about helpful changes.

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MONSTER HUNT by Tim Dinsdale, Acropolis Books, Washington, D.C., 1972, 295 pages, \$4.95.

The bulk of this volume appeared in England in 1960 under the title *The Leviathans*. For its long overdue publication in this country Dinsdale has added some 75-odd pages of new material dealing with recent events at Loch Ness and Loch Morat. Dinsdale is a former British aeronautical engineer who got "hooked" on monstrosities. In 1960 after fruitless weeks of waiting and watching on the shores of Loch Ness with a 16-mm movie camera with a six-inch telephoto lens Dinsdale filmed "something" apparently swimming in the loch. Fortunately he had the presence of mind to have a powerboat of known dimensions run the same course while he then filmed it. Years later the Royal Air Force analyzed the film* and concluded that the obvious wake was caused by a submerged "animate body" about 25 feet long.

Dinsdale then examines marine unknowns in general. Unfortunately

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this was written before Heywood's
departure in the Wake of the Sea
Serpents and that is somewhat clear-
ly although perfectly satisfactory
for readers desiring a less detailed
account.

Of major interest is the new mate-
rial. Most readers on this side of the
Atlantic are unaware that during the
past five years a considerable
amount of scientific and engineering
talent and a daring array of equip-
ment were brought to bear on Loch
Ness. That an monster was seen is
less an indictment of human efficien-
cy than of the vile Scottish weather.
Morning fog, midday mist, afternoon
drizzle and frequent high winds
made observation difficult. Dinsdale
states that during one season of
"monster watching" from May 18
through October 1 only five days
really were suitable for watching and
photographing. Despite these handi-
caps sightings were made and photo-
graphs taken. Along with most for
tracking the movements of schor-
lax aquatic life, underwater sound
detection apparatus verified the exis-
tence of "large animate bodies" in
the murky depths of the long narrow
loch. Dinsdale's is a fascinating ac-
count.

As this is written, word comes that
Scottish authorities have denied a
new lease for the mobile headquar-
ters of the Loch Ness Investigations
Bureau and also denied them per-
mission to build a permanent head-
quarters. Thus the future of investi-
gations at Loch Ness is cloudy and
Monster Hunt remains the best sin-
gle account of what has happened —
George Easley.

SAI BABA, MAN OF MIRACLES by Har-
old Mophet, Transcendental Arts, Lev-
ittown, N. Y., 1971, 208 pages, \$8.50

This book should attract two dif-
ferent groups of readers: those inter-
ested in psychic manifestations and

those seeking spiritual advancement. His subject is a 46-year-old man who lives in Pattapurli village in southern India. He must be one of the most remarkable men on earth today, judging from the books about him and the accounts of his disciples.

A human channel for seemingly superhuman knowledge and energy, Satguru Sai Baba consistently and effortlessly performs what we still call miracles: healing by touch and thought, communicating telepathically, actually projecting, multiplying food, transforming one thing into another and—most impressive—out of thin air materializing objects, including holy images and lingams, jewelry, sweets, surgical instruments for his own on-the-spot operations and an endless supply of robust, or sacred ash, for physical and spiritual healing. "His only motivation is a pure love for his fellow man," writes the author. "The underlying theme of all his training is that we must seek God through self-surrender and devotion."

Indeed, the main fault of the book is that it documents too many miracles and tells us too little of what Sai Baba stands for. An impressive as these miracles are, Sai Baba brings them about in the hope that the recipients and witnesses in turn will heed his teachings. At the same time Murphet maintains the detached perspective of a man of sound education and worldly rationality. In approach and attitude this book is better balanced than two 1971 books about Sai Baba, *Sai Baba* by Arnold Schulman (Viking Press, New York, N.Y.) and *Satguru Sai Baba* by N. Kuttari (Sri Satguru Sai Education Foundation, Turin, Calif.).

All three books make the reader want to travel to India to see this extraordinary man. But if a firsthand view is not possible, Murphet's book is the best substitute. — Joseph M. Becker

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his "consciousness" for ultra-consciousness, as he termed it: can be induced by scientific, clinical or chemical means, but that state of ultra-consciousness transfigures the mind. Perhaps we are witnessing a mental evolution and have reached the point that psychic astronomy should be taught in the colleges and universities.

Mr. Bell described various states of consciousness including "Consciousness III" to be Charles Birch in *The Greening of America* and the melting into others or "oneness" through the use of "I." Can this "I" be controlled and extended into a sort of "field consciousness?" New experiments and interest in the alpha brain waves aim at ways to control and enlarge the alpha wave and indicate that ESP is at its best when the alpha wave is highest.

Dr. Schwartz related examples of humor and ESP, inferred perhaps by telepathic impressions — for instance, those between parent and child and doctor and patient. Some of his examples obviously were appreciated by and read to the audience, as the contagious laughter confirmed.

Dr. Eisenstadt highlighted the importance of prior detailed verification and description of facts in pre-cognition cases. Such prior verification is necessary and contrasts sharply with the "double talk, generalities, mumbo-jumbo, claptrap and sheer junk" that is paraded in the popular press as pre-cognition.

Dr. Eisenstadt's remarks about the non-Euclidean mind included the idea that we must be ready to accept radical, new, unexpected and far-out concepts.

Captain Mitchell talked interestingly about his field of endeavor and made a plea for a willing, open, receptive attitude for whatever notions or new concepts we face.

The limited question-and-answer session which followed indicated the

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depth of interest in the psi field. A medical doctor asked about psychic surgery; another referred to the aura; yet another sought more specific ways psi study could assist in therapy.

Among the well-known persons in attendance were Dr. Shadex Kurgala, eminent neuropsychiatrist and author of *Breakthrough to Creativity*; Gary Smith, researcher and author of *Human Personality and Its Survival of Bodily Death* and numerous other works in the psi field; Harold Sherman, longtime researcher in ESP and author of "Wonder" *Realms of the Philippines, You Live After Death*, and many other books.

The entire presentation consisted of intellectual stimulation and challenge in the psi field as wide as all outdoors. Let us hope that the gap between those who research and talk about psi and those who do not experience psi phenomena continues to narrow for mankind's benefit therefore. This meeting was a step in that direction. — Glen Hudson, Fort Worth, Tex.

WHEN THE SOUL LEAVES . . .

D. Scott Rags's "Deceased Victims and Survival" (June 1973 *Fate*) is a profound contribution to psychic literature. He presents material which very nearly amounts to scientific proof of life after death.

Mixing truth the same ground as Rags, I formulated a rule "Field Theory of survival" in 1962. It is certainly not without flaws nor anywhere near its final form. Yet it has served me well as a sort of anchor in the chaotic seas of psychic research.

Rags mentions the experiments of Dr. Duncan MacDougall who weighed patients at the point of death. He states that the weight losses MacDougall recorded "... even today never have been explained." They have been explained and fully. What MacDougall weighed was about four

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doctrines. From a background of training and experience he or she should be able to offer psychological assistance to troubled members when they encounter difficulties. Many "doctors" and "ministers" on the occult scene obtained their credentials through the mail by paying \$10 to some so-called church. It is a sure bet that disciples who encounter difficulty will not be able to depend on such leaders for assistance.

(6) Most reputable organizations impose a membership fee. This helps persons who are merely curious and enables the organization to provide better service. The usual amount of annual dues ranges from \$10 to \$50. Anything above that amount is automatically suspect. And let's face it — especially when dealing with a guru or spiritual teacher you cannot get something for nothing. If financial reimbursement is not requested, you can be certain some other form of payment eventually will be demanded.

(7) Once you have joined a legitimate organization or group, be prepared to study, work and learn. Membership in an occult church, sect or lodge doesn't make you an experienced practitioner automatically. Be prepared to devote months, even years, to your inner development. Proceed slowly and cultivate perseverance. In the long run you'll find the rewards are worth it.

A final word: Some authorities declare that only a few gifted individuals are allowed to join occult groups. This is ridiculous. All men and women have the right to discover universal truth. Legitimate organizations recognize this and welcome sincere newcomers. This information should help you distinguish occultists from charlatans. Use it as insurance against unfortunate involvement.
