It is probably a mistake, too, to assume that the operators of these 'Discs' and other etheric craft are all alike in size and appearance, or that all the craft are alike or come for the same purposes. The phenomena are constantly increasing in variety, and there, is reason to think they will become very frequent and familiar sights to everyone.

Sphere We Go Again; It's Flying Saucer Season

TV Technician Takes Pictures

The flying saucer season, usually as unpredictable as an oboe player's moods, has arrived in New York at last.

So quietly, indeec. did the season arrive—Sunday, May 15, at 4 p.m., if you're interested in making a note of the time—that it might well have gone unnoticed had it not been for the alertness of a young television technician named Warren Siegmond and an attractive French girl, who as it turned out—well, there's no point in going into that.

What happened was simply this: Mr. Siegmond rented an English reflex-type camera for \$1.25 on May 13 and bought two rolls of films to make pictures of the attractive French girl, whose name is Jeannine Bouiller and who works for the French Government Tourist Office.

Taking Pictures on Roof.

On the Sunday afternoon when the flying saucer season opened they were in Mr. Siegmond's apartment at 7 W. 15th St. when he suddenly said the only decent place to take pictures was on the roof. Up they go. Mr. Siegmond began making pictures of Miss Bouiller, he clicking, she smiling, when she gasped and cried out, at the same time pointing.

There in the skies above the familiar water tanks, grimy roofs and angular structures of the Union Square neighborhood was a spherical object without markings. It moved rapidly. Obviously it was in the hands of a skillful pilot, and a daring one, moreover, since the risks of saucer flying in the Union Square area are so well known. (Apparently familiar with police regulations

against low flying, the pilot kept well above the legal limits, indicating to Mr. Siegmond that he was a disciplined flier.)
Film Developed.

Mr. Siegmond, himself a well-disciplined young man—he served from 1943 to 1945 as a gunner in an anti-aircraft battalion in England — shifted his camera quickly and began taking pictures. The strange aircraft wheeled, its sharp metallic glitter faded, it became a blur and vanished.

Dazed but gallant, Mr. Siegmond helped Miss Bouiller downstairs and had the film developed at a drugstore. Then he brought the negatives to the World-Telegram and Sun.

The pictures were shown to an Air Force officer familiar with the inquiry into flying saucer reports. "Whatever it was, it was moving," he said cryptically. Moreover, that was all he'd say.

To get a less austere reaction, a W-T & Sun reporter showed the pictures to Mrs. Margaret Rigberg, president of the Flying Saucer News Club, an organization of people who watch the skies for flying saucers.

Mrs. Rigberg runs a little bookshop at 1597 Third Ave. where books on metaphysics, occultism and spiritualism are prominently displayed.

Mrs. Rigberg looked at Mr. Siegmond's pictures and said, "Ah-h-h." Of course, they weren't the first photos of flying ships she has seen. Man over in New Jersey has some; sells them at \$1 each.

As the owner of the largest bookstore to deal in flying saucer material, Mrs. Rigberg spoke with authority. Her husband is vice president of the club. Mrs. Rigberg has never seen a flying saucer, probably because she is too busy with her books.

But her husband saw one

last month. About 6 in the evening as he was leaving a small eatery where he works as a daytime counterman. (This would place the arrival of the season earlier than May 15, but Mrs. Rigberg didn't care. Let somebody else claim the credit if he wants to.)



The present conception of rocket travel is the utilization of a chemical bi-fuel system (presently considered is Hydrazine and Nitric Acid).

It is believed by the group exploiting this method of interplanetary flight that may prove itself more desirable. To date, however, there is no indication as to just how this can be accomplished.

FLYING SAUCER STUDY INDICATES NEW THEORY.

In the recent book, "SPACE TRAVEL" by Kenneth W. Gatland and Anthony M. Kunesch, the authors state, in the final chapter, that even the stars are considered as possible destinations for future space ships. It would require more than 130,000 years to reach the nearest star with a chemical rocket, it is claimed, but an atomic one might need only 350 years.

Since Flying Saucers (or Unidentified Flying Objects-UFO's-as they are now popularly termed) were widely sighted in 1947, those who were openminded enough to consider their existence began to wonder what propulsive power they may use.

Aftermany years of research the present consensus of scientific minds at work on the subject indicate that the greatest possibility is that of an electro-gravitational force-or, sometimes shortened to G-field. The reported changing color in sightings, tremendous speed, shape (a

circular airfoil would seem to have definite advantages), lack of visible means of propulsion, rapid acceleration and right-angle turns while traveling at thousands of miles per hour, all seem to indicate this.

SAVANTS DECLARE VIEWS

Professor Hermann Oberth, world famous German mathematician and rocket authority, told the International Astronautical Congress at Innsbruck, Germany, August 1954, that he not only believed in the existence of Flying Saucers, but also was convinced that they are extraterrestrial.

He added that the behavior of flying saucers ruled out any means of propulsion known to us, and certainly rocket propulsion. A possible explanation he declared, was the use of an 'Anti-gravity device.''






