FLYING SAUCERS AND EVOLUTION

Flying saucers, space craft from other planets, various types of fireballs, focussed streamers of light, and so forth, have been attracted to the planet Earth at this particular time because the human race on this globe has reached a new high point in evolution. This forward step may not be apparent to humanity in general for the reason that the perspective is too close. However, to inhabitants of other planets where evolution is more advanced than on this globe, this remarkable achievement is recognized as the greatest cosmic event which has taken place in this narrow corner of the universe during the past 21 million years. SAUCER SIGHTINGS

PILOT SIGHTS a "FLYING DISK" A"large, white, disk-like object" was sighted near Boston and kept in view for a full 10 minutes in plain daylight yesterday morning by a TWA Paris-to-New York air-liner pilot who later insisted that it was not a weather ballon as suggested by the Grenier Air Force Base at Manchester, N.H. Some jet pilots also saw the objects.

"That weather ballon stuff sounds to me like a cover-up," said Capt. Charles J. Kratovil at his Port Washington, L.I., home where the Air Force message reached him.

"I was there; I saw it. There was no basket on it as the Air Force describes. There was a 60-mile-an-hour wind blowing and this object was moving against it at high speed. We had it in view for a full 10 minutes as it flew parallel to us and high above us. How could a ballon move against such a wind if it had not some kind of power?"

Capt. Kratovil spotted the object first at about 9:30 A.M. when he arrived at International Airport here he reported that he had radioed the Boston airport control tower about it and that he had received word back that a flight of jet planes had been sent aloft. Pilots of the jets saw the object when they reached 10,000 feet and according to the message from Boston, said it appeared to be "about 10,000 feet above us and climbing ver fast."
