DIVINE UNION

TO MANY students of the higher law how God works His will on earth remains a great mystery.

In this article we will try to make clear some facts which will enable thinking minds to see that God can work on earth only through man, that man is the natural and only channel through which He can make His will and purpose manifest.

First realize that man in his true nature is made in the image and likeness of God. Why? Only so God, when all is ready, can perfectly express His Self and His Nature through him. Think! Must this not be so? Otherwise why should God make man at all? Why not be content with the animal and other kingdoms of nature where there are no minds or wills to burden or limit the perfect expression of the species? Why create or bring into existence anything that might thwart His will and cause inharmony in an otherwise seemingly perfect world? For, from

all reports, it was only when man appeared as a permanent resident on earth that sin and its consequent inharmonies came into existence.

Thinking minds, and especially those who are conversant with the teachings in our articles on the Soul, realize that man is the final evolution of form which permits of God's endowing His creatures with many of His own attributes, and of course for the sole purpose—when the creature man has unfolded in consciousness sufficiently to make it possible, by recognizing and acknowledging the God attributes and qualities in him—of enabling God to express freely His Divine Self and Nature and to manifest His will on earth even as in Heaven.

So that God is and must be working His will in and through man, even if as yet man cannot see it and will not admit it. We will now try to show you definitely how this must be so.

We will not attempt in this article to tell of God Himself, of Who He is or What He is; for we wish to tell you instead of His Representatives, of Those He has sent here purposely and consciously to do His will, to make of earth and all upon it like unto the Kingdom of Heaven, the Divine Idea God had for this earth from the beginning.

We therefore ask you to realize that these Representatives are the Sons of God we told you about in the Soul articles—are your own Higher Selves. Think what this means! If it is hard for you to realize that God dwells in you, is you, is your very Self, then know Him in His Representatives—your Higher Selves. For in very truth is your Higher Self a ray of Him, a reflection or reflector of Him in matter, even if most poorly outpictured in flesh—as you see yourself through the imperfect lens of your human mind—but a truly perfect image and likeness of Him in your Real Nature.

This may be difficult for some to realize who are not yet conscious of the Loving One Within, but these words are intended chiefly for those who have found Him and know He is there, deep within their hearts, who are waiting upon Him there, seeking only to please Him, concerned only that they are doing perfectly what He wants them to do. They are the ones we wish to know that He whom they have found there is not only the REAL You,

your I AM, but is an actual Son of God, is very God, Himself, reflected in You.

From this you may glimpse how God works through man, through you—even if you are not yet very conscious of Him. Without such an understanding of these Sons of God as your Higher Selves, God cannot be satisfactorily explained to the human mind. Not that the human mind in its natural state can ever clearly comprehend God, the Ineffable One, but we feel that it must be brought to some understanding that satisfies its reason, before it can be lifted into a consciousness where it is able to grasp the fact of its own non-reality as a separate or human state of being. The principal purpose of this article is to give the final push that will not only lift it into but will establish it in such consciousness. In other words, our effort will be to bring about its union with your Higher or Christ Consciousness.

We ask you to think for a while what this means—what union, complete oneness with your True Self, a direct Ray of or Descendant from God, would mean, were you to accomplish it while still in the flesh. Try to see yourself as an actual, conscious Son of God, conscious of all that has happened from the very beginning-of all your countless lives on earth; of your descent from the Celestial Realms; of your activities there; of your many previous experiences and training in world building; of your existence preceding that as a human soul on another planet long before the earth was born; of your long, long journey back to your Father's Consciousness: of the vast Wisdom gained from such experience, extending back through a million millenniums of time,—for such a Son of God you actually are, and such is the knowledge you possess and which you can pass down to your brain mind whenever there is a need for it to know any part of that knowledge.

Think long and earnestly upon this so that you will remember it and understand when later we make very definite statements about your having all knowledge within you.

Try to realize this, and that the sole purpose of your physical life is to bring your brain mind into the full consciousness of your divine mind and into the all-knowing of your Real Self. This must surely come when the Wall of Self has been destroyed and

there are no longer two selves—only one, and you know you are that one—a conscious Son of God.

Now we are going to speak to you from the consciousness of a Son of God in order to help lift your consciousness into oneness with that of your True Self.

First realize that We, as your Higher Selves, are all one in consciousness, are one in that same consciousness from which Christ Jesus spoke, when He said, "I and my Father are one," and also "I came forth from the Father and I am come into the world; again I leave the world and go unto the Father." Which means We have such oneness of consciousness that We are not—of ourselves, knowing We are but attributes of the Father through which He is expressing His Divine Nature on earth.

As your Higher Selves, Our constant effort is to get your recognition of Us within you—not as a Master or Teacher separate from you, but that you may feel and know Us within your hearts as the Great Love of the Father there, seeking to express through that Love and to explain to you Our life and nature. This means that that part of you, your human mind and intellect which have their abode in the head, and which for so long have encouraged and maintained for you your sense of self and separation, must be dethroned and be brought to realize Us within the heart as the Source and directing Cause of their being, and be taught to wait upon and lovingly serve Us there.

Through such service in time the sense of self and its importance will gradually disappear, for Service and the consequent blessings that We cause to manifest will not feed or encourage such a sense; instead more and more will there grow a realization of and dependence upon Us, learning that We are really doing all that is being done, that the human part is merely a covering, a channel, developed and prepared by Us for Our use.

In "The Impersonal Life" and its companion books, We spoke to you as God, as the I AM of you. Now, in order for Us to make it more intimate, to come closer and thus enable you to see how God works in and actually is in You, We, your Higher Selves, living Rays of His Spirit, will tell you about Ourselves, about your REAL Selves, in order to help you remove that Wall of Self you ignorantly built between you and Us in consciousness long ages ago in the dim past.

So all We now require is that the human mind of you be ever in a listening attitude, thus waiting upon Us, you yourselves letting go completely, knowing that We will assume full charge and responsibility, and of course know always what is best; for have We not all knowledge, all power, and all the capacity and love of the Father's Mind to draw upon?

You, when you have truly learned all the lessons out of the many experiences We necessarily brought to you to teach you this, will realize first intellectually, in your mind, and then, by feeling its truth in your heart and soul, that We are not separate, but that We are Yourselves, and you no longer exist as selves—We only are. Then, of course, you will not any more seek to do anything of yourselves, but will wait for Our urge to do or say it, and then confidently will start to say or do whatever We impel, knowing it will all be perfectly done, which it always is when you thus let Us do it.

Now let us see if you know just who "you" are, when We thus speak of you. But in order to make it still more intimate, so that each one who reads may know that his or her own Self is speaking—which will be actually so, if you will listen within—your own Higher Self will speak to you as a Son of God, as your Divine Self.

As you read you will perceive that it is only to a true disciple or one who has found Him, is conscious of Him abiding in the heart and is waiting upon and serving Him there, that He speaks. And while all that is said applies in a way to those who do not yet know Him within, and to them He seems to talk as from above and without, even they will get a glimpse of a very great truth. Hear now His word.

You, My child, have learned from the teachings given you through "The Impersonal Life" that "you" are a soul or ego which through many long ages I have finally brought to that stage of consciousness where I can abide in and work from you—that is, in and from your soul consciousness or your soul body. For where you are in consciousness you find yourself in a body peculiar to and of the nature of that consciousness, and in which you live and work. You have learned to love, or more strictly speaking, to let Me love through you and thereby to use you and to work through you. This has lifted you as a soul consciousness to where I, as Love, can dwell in you.

Remember, I am a Son of God who descended from the Celestial Realms of My Father's Consciousness to redeem "you", who as a soul are the sum-total of My mistakes of a former world period. During these long ages I have caused you to take on many bodies of flesh, that is, to descend into generation in order that you, as a composite center of My sins given birth out of a consciousness of generation, might be taught the lessons which would permit of My Love awakening you and of its being recognized by you and which would lift you, My thus re-born consciousness, back through regeneration into My now God Consciousness, redeeming you and bringing you up into consciousness with Me and eventually with Our Father God.

Now I may have caused you, as a soul in some past life in the flesh, to learn this, and ever since as a soul you have co-operated with Me in one or more lives on earth, aiding Me to accomplish what I sent you into incarnation to do. Or it may be this is the first clear recognition you have had of yourself as a soul and of your relation to Me, your Real Self, a Son of God.

But remember, when incarnated in a mortal body, in your brain mind I may or may not have disclosed to you My purpose for you, except enough to unfold more and more of your love nature so I could teach you to serve, and thus accomplish the awakening and helping of others seeking the light of Truth. Gradually, I am thus bringing you unto a full recognition of Me, of My Love, Wisdom and Power, so that you are learning to give over all to Me, to wait upon Me and to let Me direct you in all ways.

If you were to know your past lives on earth—which I will make known to you in due season, when you are trusting all to Me—you would perceive the reason for many things, why I put you through this or that experience, and the necessity of developing certain soul qualities still lacking and which prevented our fully accomplishing My purpose in former lives—My purpose never being for our benefit alone but chiefly for the benefit of humanity. All I now send you to earth for is to accomplish as much as possible of the Father's Will and Purpose of bringing all human consciousness back into His Consciousness and Love—the only reason for Our descent from Our Celestial home.

As you know, comparatively only a very few in the world are conscious in their brain minds of Us, their Divine Selves. But at

this particular time, the end of a dispensation, many of Us have come into incarnation for the express purpose of ushering in the New Age, even as We came many times before for the same purpose, and therefore many of Us are quickening Our human instruments, through the great Spiritual Force now being poured down upon the earth, so that they are awakening in large numbers and becoming aware of and are more or less consciously co-operating with Us in what We are here to do. But these large numbers of awakened ones are few compared to the millions who are yet asleep and whom We must awaken, and the many millions more who will not and cannot be awakened because they are young and laggard souls who, through ignorance, undevelopment or laziness, refuse to learn their lessons. For this reason every awakened soul is required by Us to turn about and use every effort possible to carry the Light to those whose personalities are wandering in darkness but whose souls are seeking Truth.

The Apostle Paul tells you that Christ Jesus was the "first fruit of them that are asleep." When I tell you that in the beginning We all descended to earth together under Christ's leadership, He, our Elder Brother, being the Representative of the Father, to Whom We dedicated Ourselves to follow and serve, you will get a glimpse of what is the real Christ Consciousness and how We are truly One in Christ and are guided wholly from There; for the Christ Consciousness is Our Father-God's Holy Spirit, the Light of His Divine Love pushing through and shining in the darkness of earth wherever We are.

In that descent to earth, it was not actually a descent into mortality, but only far enough into the inner realms surrounding the earth to permit Our overshadowing the souls We had evolved into human beings and for which We are responsible.

The soul known as Jesus of Nazareth naturally was the first human soul to be awakened by His Higher Self, the Christ, into the full consciousness of His Divinity, or into conscious oneness with His Father-in-Heaven—into His Christhood. Thereupon, humanity now being ripe for it, He assumed His true position as the Light of the world from that time on—after His Resurrection and its proof of His God Nature, and He became the Great Leader, the Way Shower, the Example for all humanity, even as He was

for Us in Spirit, His life and His teachings showing clearly the way for all who were willing and ready to follow Him.

Remember that We are all Sons of God, are Reflectors of Him, but that very few of Us as yet have been able to reflect God fully in and through our human instruments, your personalities; but eventually through the power of Christ, the Spirit of God, Whose Light shines in the darkness of all upon earth, We shall lift up not only you, Our human reflections, but the consciousness of the earth itself and all partaking of its nature, into oneness with Our Father-God's consciousness.

In the meantime, as shown in the articles on the Soul, all souls whom We have not yet been able to awaken and thereby to purify so We could enter and dwell in them, We will overshadow and direct from the Spiritual realms, waiting until they ripen so We can bud and blossom forth in them the Divine Spirit of Love and in that Spirit can find an abiding place.

But as for you, Our dear ones, who have found and know Us within as that Love in your hearts, We have told you of these high truths in order that you may know your identity with Us, may establish yourselves in that knowing, so that you will begin to think, speak and act from Our Consciousness.

That is the goal We have set for you and which We are leading you to, as fast as We are able to prove to your human minds the unreality of its Wall of Self. Divine Union awaits with all the glories of which We have given you a glimpse, and We urge that from now on you carry about with you the consciousness of your identity as a Son of God, that within you is all knowledge, all truth and that you try to think, speak and act always in such consciousness. As surely as you faithfully do this will We establish you in that consciousness, for We will cause gradually to disappear all sense of separation, and you will forget the Wall of Self, so that the union will be complete.

SOUL KNOWLEDGE

AS a soul am conscious of all the truth which I have experienced in all lives up to that point in evolution where I now stand. I am trying to discipline the vehicle which I, as a soul use, that it may through my mind, become conscious of soul knowledge.

There is a distinction between knowledge and learning. The mind is the vehicle for learning. The soul has imbibed knowledge. During the intervals between incarnations the soul has discarded all that is not real, or is not truth. That is, it has transmuted mis-interpreted learning into truth, for there is nothing that is not a part of truth. There is only mis-interpretation of truth. The soul is not conscious of defects.

My human mind sees in separation. My soul is seeking to show the mind how to interpret as a whole. The root of the word interpret, Webster says, is of uncertain origin. The definition is given as: "to explain or tell the meaning of; to translate into intelligible or familiar language or terms: to expound, elucidate, translate." It may be possible that there is a vital connection between this word and the word integer, meaning the whole. The soul seeks to translate the whole to man.

When the mind obeys this stimulus that it receives from the soul, it co-operates with the soul, and separative functioning or so-called thinking, ceases. The mind is therefor, the disciple,—is disciplined by the soul. The cause of separative thinking lies in the reaction of the mind to all that is without. This is due to sense response and reaction. The cause of integral thinking lies in the co-operation of the mind with all that is within. This is due to soul response.

If, when perplexed, we ask ourselves "How may I co-operate with my soul in this matter?" We will instantaneously get our answer from within. Practice in so doing is the method advised by Jesus. It implies seeking first the Kingdom of Heaven and His Consciousness. It is the seeking of His Consciousness in distinction to reacting to the without. It leads us to use our spiritual senses, and builds the bridge between the Higher and lower self, known in occultism as the Antaskarana. Spiritual response is the

material for the house (or consciousness) built upon the rock. Physical response is the material for the house built upon the sand.

Spiritual response overcomes separative thinking. Critical sight is lost when integral sight is used. Critical sight is ever separative thinking. Learning becomes knowledge. Thinking becomes knowing. The application becomes wisdom, and wisdom is wise love.

The heart gives the stimulus to all such endeavor. First the heart, love, then the mind, will. The quality that binds is faith. Whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in Heaven, and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in Heaven. In fact, the separative cannot exist in Heaven.

"I Am the Way." "I Am the Truth." "I Am the Light." "I Am the Resurrection and the Life."

THE LORD IS A SUN

IT HAS been said that a writer of deep subjects merely introduces a reader to his own mind, then takes a little walk, so to speak, and leaves him to get acquainted. This is so because reality is too vast to be put into our limited vocabulary. We must imbibe the Spirit in order to conceive it in full. If we are to progress in truth and light as rapidly as the materially-minded have in discoveries and inventions, we will have to receive new ideas with the same open mind, meditating long, thinking much, and proving all things as the scientists do before accepting or discarding a thing.

The Master Jesus said: "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now." This being true we may expect their revelations to be, more or less, a jolt to us and beyond our immediate comprehension. Mortal mind is a creature of habit, clinging to the old and reluctant to accept the new. Men of inventions and discoveries were ridiculed, some branded insane, until time proved their worth. So it is with religious progress. Our Master Jesus began His ministry preaching direct to the people. The tension of the multitudes grew against Him. He then tried preaching in parables with no better results. His teachings were condemned. He was crucified.

But words filled with life and truth cannot die. They were preserved by secret Orders. Not until about three hundred years after the crucifixion were the books of the Bible printed, first in separate books, then all bound together. The Book of Revelations was added last. Persecutions and wars followed. The hundred and fifty years of Christian War, known as The Crusades, were climaxed with the historic event called The Big Bon-Fire. It was ordered that every Bible throughout the land be piled in one heap, and at a given date, burned. Penalty of death awaited anyone possessing an original Bible after that date.

After the Big Bon-Fire the politicians of the day formulated the Bible to suit themselves. It is the one we have today, with slight modifications, and is, as our critics say, a history of the Jewish people and the life of Jesus. It contains some of His teachings but far from all of them. An apology to this fact, to passify the rebellion, is found in the last verse of the book of John: "And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written."

In re-writing the Bible, the scribes, in their spiritual ignorance, let some mighty big truths slip through their pen. This accounts for the many contradictions. The sheep who know His voice have perceived the Light, kept the Bible living down through the ages, and kept us in communion with Him who said: "Blessed are they who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled." With His promise: "Lo, I am with thee always, even unto the end of the world," let us have no fear in attempting to take one step closer to Reality.

With Him present, showing us the way, let us picture ourselves seated in a Spiritual Laboratory, wherein we can dissect every new thought submitted, amputate it if necessary, or let it pass into oblivion. We are advanced enough now to understand that God is All in all: "Lo, not here, Lo, not there, but Lo everywhere." We also understand polarized mentalities, and can easily see how the sun might be the Christ force, the Christ consciousness, or very Life itself in manifestation, streaming out from the sun, in and through every human being.

We do not know what the sun is. We know it gives life, and without it there would be no life on earth. Every material thing we possess is made from growing things produced by the sun. We know the sun has healing, caressing rays, and that the word Jehovah means healer, lifegiver. We know "God is love, God is spirit," also, "God is light, and in Him there is no dark-

ness at all." We know there are many suns in the firmament, all revolving with their planets around a great central sun. We may rightly presume that behind this central sun is a Spiritual Sun, the God Almighty, the Most High, operating through the material qualities of the suns which we see with our mortal eyes. Then we, by the same token, as sons of God, would be actually suns of God of smaller degree, made in His image and all created equal.

The writer has had several revelations that may prove we are suns of Jehovah God the Sun. I will cite them as briefly as possible. One night I was sitting before the glowing fire-place meditating on the scripture: "No one hath ascended into heaven but he that descended out of heaven." What does that mean? I asked. "I AM the Light of the world: He that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness but shall have the Light of Life." The Logos that this light of life contains, is so vast it makes one's head reel for the few moments in which it is presented to a mortal mind. All advanced truth students have experienced these moments of glories unutterable.

The children of darkness ask: "If this is true why don't you prove it by giving something vital to the world?" The children of light may answer that question by asking another: "Why does not a student of mathematics grasp the fundamentals in one breath?" Or, "why can not a beginner in music play a symphony the moment he hears one played?" After hearing many concerts he still cannot perform the act or tell another how it is done. Why? such ease and grace? They just know how, comes the reply. Yes, they just know how, but did they know how without much mental effort? So it is with truth. We have to know as the Masters know. This is accomplished in degrees; as the light penetrates our mortal consciousness we take on immortality.

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, ye must be born again," said the First Born, the only begotten Son. "Ye must become as little children." While we are growing into truth and light let us bear in mind the song we use to sing in Sunday-school: "Jesus wants me for a sunbeam, To shine for Him each day." Then, to prove we are sunbeams, this is how it is done: Look up into the sun, at not over seventy degrees, for a few moments, close your eyes, and watch: If the sun is not available, a bright electric light will do. You will see lights of different hues whirling about. They may stay close to you or swing far out into space, according to your growth or ability to receive the light.

You will find that the highest point is just as vivid as the lowest; that this is your Father's house in which there are many mansions, abodes, planes; that there is no space or separation; that we are all one: we in Him, He in us. You will find your memory quickened and awakened, and will fully understand the scripture: "Glorify thou Me with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was." That is, before worldliness claimed us, the Mystery City, Babylon the Great, that is doomed and will be no more.

The things of this world grasped our attention the moment we were born on earth. Just because we forget the glories is no proof they never happened. When someone reminds us we say: "Ah yes, I remember now!" So it is when we find our way to our Father's house in the re-birth. We are reminded, then we remember. When we were born on earth we were born in sin, that is, darkness; when we are born again we are born in the light, which is the kingdom.

As we grow into the kingdom of light, the Christ consciousness, we find that eventually we can see things spiritual with our mortal eyes open. It is just a matter of raising our rate of vibration. When a wheel stands still we can see the spokes, but if the wheel is whirled around, they all blend. If we were on another wheel, going around at the same rate, we could see the spokes clearly. So it is with our mortal body; its vibrations must be raised to that of spirit, then we can see spiritually.

"Every eye shall behold Him," when He pours out His Spirit upon all flesh. In the meantime we enter into our inner chamber, close the doors, or our mortal eyes, and see through the "single eye" which is located in the middle of the forehead. When our eyes close they naturally turn upward to this single eye. Hence to "look up and watch" is as normal as breathing. If the power makes the eyes quiver, place both hands, one across the other, over the closed eyes. Sometimes a powerful white light, like the sunlight at noonday, flashes over the eyes. This may happen anytime, anywhere, when one least expects it. The eyes quickly close, the hands go over them, and we see right through as clearly as we see with our eyes open, people and material things around us.

Spirit does this in order to prove that our seeing is a fact, not a fancy, and that the things which we see in the kingdom are just as true as the things we see in the world. Sometimes this All Powerful white light takes us on a local sojourn, out of the body, to places on earth we are very familiar with, in order to prove that the journeys we take to higher planes are a fact, not a fancy. These are very happy moments: "In the presence of the Lord there is fullness of joy."

Advanced truth students are prone not to mingle much with the world, as people often tap their solar-rays. "Someone hath touched me; for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me," said Jesus, as the woman touched the hem of His garment and was healed. "And the whole multitude sought to touch him, for there went virtue out of Him, and healed them all." We have to give as well as receive; light the world as well as receive the light, and we must not forget the parable of the talents.

One night, after having mingled with "publicans and sinners," who tapped my solar-rays and left me in low spirits, I retired early, asking in prayer: "Just why am I forsaken?" Quickly I fell asleep. On awakening, a light like the sunrise at dawn was streaming forth from my innermost Being. The whole room became illumined. I looked at the clock. It was five minutes to ten: just one hour of sleep, yet it seemed like many, I was so refreshed. The wisdom of eternity was dawning in my mortal consciousness, when suddenly I fell asleep again.

Once more I awakened. It was five minutes to eleven—just one hour and the same experience. This was repeated every hour

Seeing the sunlight stream forth from our innermost Being we can perceive the truth hidden in some of our old hymns: "Let the Blessed Sunshine in;" "Sunlight, Sunlight, in my Soul today;" "Sun of my Soul, Thou Saviour dear;" "Jerusalem the Golden," we can vision with our light shining in full. The Logos that this light contains would certainly be the new Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God: "And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it; for the glory of God did lighten it."

Once a heavenly scene was presented to me that was repeated some time later, as I did not grasp the full significance the first time. Purple substance, whirling about through space, formed a tunnel that extended from me high up into the heavens. Through the opening at the top I saw, very clearly, a world of peace and beauty. A huge ball of golden light, like our setting sun, was slowly revolving, casting forth colored light-rays in every direction.

The second time this was presented, the golden sun was perfectly still. Two gorgeous Beings, which may rightly be called Angels, were floating leisurely about, when suddenly one of them headed towards the tunnel and came downward with terrific speed. Its power pierced every fibre of my Being until it seemed my soul would be rent asunder. When I could stand it no longer, the angel floated out of the tunnel and disappeared.

BUILDING A NEW BODY

DO YOU realize that you, the Real You, never sleeps? We have been accustomed from childhood to say, "I have been asleep," or "I am going to sleep." This assertion, however, is not accurate, for that which sleeps is not the "I", or the "I Am," but merely the physical body which sense-dominated man has outmanifested by his imperfect material, thinking and believing.

Certainly the I am inhabits and uses this body for contact with the physical world. It was built as a useful vehicle through which necessary development and experience might be gained by the soul. But in the process of time man succumbed to the thrill of sense experience and indulging in it, gradually accepted as predominant the belief that he lived only in his outer body. But such is not man's real body, for it is only a materialized thoughtform, unstable, weak, and as impermanent as the vacillating thought which made it: a form subject to sickness and decay, and altogether inferior to the glorious, eternal, spiritual body which God gave to His Son. This true body is made of Divine Spiritual Substance, and cannot express discord or death, being eternal and perfect as Spirit.

In the preservation and renewal of the physical body, sleep plays an important part. The physiological reason for sleep, lies in the fact that the body becomes for a time quiescent, ceasing its sense-conscious thinking and negative activity, and is submissive to the renewing work of Spirit which can then proceed unhampered by the erroneous thought of the materially minded man.

When the body sleeps, consciousness is withdrawn, and the soul of man functions joyously in its native element unobstructed, by the action of sense-consciousness. The body and its condition, even pain, is forgotten, and when it awakens, it is refreshed and rehabilitated by reason of the temporary release from material consciousness and discord, which discord only exists through man's belief in its reality.

But there is a better way, and that consists in learning to still the outer consciousness in what we call our waking life. If we learn to do this at will, we shall achieve the realization of ourselves, as the Image and Likeness of God, and we shall express and manifest complete well-being even in our visible bodies, automatically sustaining their perfection and life by continuous conseious contact with our Divine Source.

This can be done by us all, and it has already been done by those exalted ones who now seek to lead the race back to its original condition of being fully efficient channels for the expression and activity of our Father God. It is not beyond your power or mine to accomplish. We need but realize Truth and thereby know ourselves for what we really are, viz. spiritual beings. If we will go to the trouble of achieving this understanding, we shall yearn to "return to our Father's home" which is the Kingdom of Heaven within every man. Like the Prodigal Son, we shall say, "I will arise and go to my Father." For who would be content to remain in bondage and "eat the husks that the swine did eat," once he knew it to be in his power to abide consciously in the heavenly Father's love, care, and home!

"Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? . . . The temple of God is holy, and such are ye."

Our bodies, then, are holy, and house Almighty God. But do we always remember to treat them with the profound reverence that we should offer to that which is holy? Do we nourish and renew them with clean and natural food and drink, keep them spotlessly pure, give them the rest they require at their present stage, and try to build into them a living spiritual consciousness? For every part of the body has a consciousness of its own, every cell composing it, having its own brain. If we do not do this, we are guilty of desecrating God's temple, guilty of irreverence to the Most High, and the result is that we render ourselves unable to receive the constant influx of the renewing life of Spirit, thus starving the body of divine replenishment and lowering it into a weak and inefficient instrument that has lost contact with its life-giving Source.

But let us learn to still these senses. Let us conquer material thinking, speaking, and body building, so that the Life and Light of God may permeate our entire being and we shall then, though gradually, build and enjoy a glorious spiritual body wherein the supernal power, perfection, intelligence, and life of the I AM may

function freely and vitally. Then shall the body become an ideal vehicle for the spirit of the awakened man, the Christ who sleeps not nor needs to sleep. It shall become vibrant, harmonious, and beautiful, a fit channel for the expression and activity of God in the external world.

As we have said, this achievement will be a gradual process requiring the application of the spiritualized will, set steadfastly to encompass its purpose, requiring in him who undertakes such purpose, an understanding of Truth and a turning away from the outer and illusory world of things in order that the mind may be freely focussed upon the Kingdom of Heaven within. It involves the achievement of non-reaction to all that is not of God, and the elimination of personality, so that true individuality—Godin-us—may reign. And it means a steady refusal to be entangled with negativity and friction, and the ability truthfully to declare when these are brought to our notice: "None of these things move me."

Does all this seem beyond your power to accomplish? It is not! Certainly, he who is immersed in the life of the senses, he who refuses to follow the Light of Truth when it shines before him can not achieve it, but if you, having seen the Light, sincerely essay to walk by it you will soon recognize, acknowledge, and use the divine power of your Real Self which will guide you to victory.

Think it out! If you are one of those who have given years of your life to acquiring proficiency in some art, profession, or specific line of work you will remember how patiently you strove, how earnestly you studied each problem that faced you until you understood and conquered it, and you finally became master in your chosen occupation.

Admittedly you studied systematically and under competent instructors. But it was neither the system nor the instructors that eventually rendered you efficient. It was the I Am within you, the ever-active Will of God to express Himself, which inspired you to the devotion, perseverance, and faith wherewith you overcame every obstacle and at last attained proficiency.

And is not the achievement of a purified body worth equal effort? A body harmonious, unlimited in power, able eventually to transport itself, when fully developed, as easily as you think,

to wherever your thought be directed, even through solid objects which can offer no obstruction to its tenuity, a temple that is never weak, tired, sick, or subject to death. Surely it is! And even though its complete attainment will take time, the sense of joyous release from carnal limitations that is experienced during the process more than compensates for the effort put forth.

And we should not imagine that in building this perfect body we shall be called upon to separate ourselves from the dear human contacts, or deny ourselves reasonable human amenities. On the contrary, the man endeavoring by the light of Truth to attain a spiritual body becomes more and more aware of his oneness with all, discord cannot disrupt his peace and he fulfills his worldly activities and duties with an ease that would be impossible to the sense-enslaved man functioning in a sense-built body.

Such an achievement involves systematized study and hard work. We must prepare ourselves by training and disciplining the mind, which in turn governs the body and the emotions. With a quickened desire for attainment, the disciplined mind will in the fulness of time, turn to and make the contact with the Master Within. It is a law that desire in the heart of man brings its own fulfillment, and he cannot desire anything which he has not the power to attain if he will go about it the right way.

Part of the process—a very important part—lies in giving sufficient time to correct and regular meditation, for in the silence we are enabled to commune with God, and to know ourselves as one with Him, as having for our heritage as His Son, His power and perfection. In such an illumined condition we realize what must be done to achieve our purpose and we cease to regard ourselves as a physical body having a soul, and know ourselves as Spirit using a soul and a body. Then we commence to think and live from the standpoint of Spirit.

This means that our desire to be profoundly and consciously at one with God, increases until it becomes the dominating factor in our lives. With such a divine ambition we shall cease to regard external happenings seriously. If we are misunderstood, mistreated, frustrated, we shall not allow the condition or any hurt in relation to it into our consciousness. Refusing to react to it we shall not think about it, and hold resentment. For to the one yearning with all his being for union with God, such things are

revealed in their true nothingness and, overshadowed by the greater and real issue, they disappear.

The real power back of the symbol which we call money is our faith in it and our love for it. Our love for it is based upon our belief in the power which its possession will give us. Faith is the power that brings substance into visibility. That in which we place our faith always manifests to us—good, bad or indifferent. "Even as thy faith, so be it unto thee."

Money is local. Each Government has its own peculiar symbol for its medium of exchange. On the other hand, substance is universal, interplanetary, omnipresent. Substance completely fills that incomprehensible all space-filling infinity, those mansions in the sky, to which our Heavenly Father has made our title clear.

When faith, "the substance of things hoped for," is taken away from money, we see it for what it really is—just an empty symbol, without life, intelligence or substance. "Fiat money," we call it. Some years ago I bought two million German Marks for twenty-five cents in American money. I wanted the Marks for a curio, nothing more. Why did the man sell me two million Marks for an American quarter? Because he had perfect faith in the American symbol of money and none whatever in the German Marks.

I know a man whose friendship I prize very highly. The mining boom in Goldfield, Nevada, made him a multi-millionaire. Stored away in an attic he has a trunk full of mining stocks for which he once refused five million dollars in cash. One day I was fortunate enough to catch him in just the right mood and he opened the trunk. For awhile I revelled in the wealth of another day—a wealth which had been, but is no more. I held millions of dollars worth of the empty symbol of an erstwhile fortune in my hands. Gone was its value, gone its power. Even the printer's ink, which had once festooned it in gay and colorful magnificence, was faded and dead. Whimsically my friend said: "Its old and worthless now, like myself; but we both have our memories, and fond ones,

too. Men long ago lost faith in those stocks and their value is now gone."

Years ago, as a boy, it was my privilege to "play" with countless wealth that once had been. I scooped up thousands upon thousands of dollars worth of cancelled Government Script. The Government had removed the faith of the public from it. Without the public's faith in was worthless, powerless.

By our faith in the power of money we make of it a Calf of Gold, before which we bow down and worship, not realizing that our faith is the real substance back of it, and that the Golden Calf of money before which we grovel, is just an empty symbol. Even at its best, money is only an accepted standard by which we measure values—values more or less uncertain and always fluctuating.

Gold has always been considered the most lasting, enduring and reliable standard of money. For the possession of gold men have suffered every known privation, including death. Human beings have been known literally to starve to death rather than spend a little of their hoarded gold. In the hope of securing it, men have committed every known crime, from the "little white lies" of deception, to the most fiendish murders. And the best they can do with their gold after they have gained possession of it is to hoard it.

This habit of hoarding is the cause of most of the suffering in the world today. Millions of men, women and children, deprived of sufficient and proper food, are living below the level of nutrition, slowly lapsing into despair, because of man's insatiable greed for gold. When man is healed of this insane desire to hoard the symbol of wealth, the ever-present super-abundance of God's limitless Substance will become manifest.

In view of the foregoing facts, man's manner of handling gold is most mystifying. After having suffered every privation to get it out of the bowels of the earth, he solemnly proceeds to bury it again! Every "gold standard" nation has its gold reserve hidden in some specially constructed and carefully guarded vault. The gold reserve of France is said to be buried somewhere beneath the streets of Paris. Just now, while the war clouds are lowering so

menacingly over all Europe, millions of dollars worth of gold is being shipped to the United States because it is thought to be safer.

If we can find no better use for gold than to bury it again, why mine it in the first place? How long will men foolishly continue to worship the empty symbol and completely ignore the real substance? The habit of hoarding is the outpicturing of thoughts of fear, and fear is lack of faith in God. Therefore by faith shall we be healed of the poverty caused by hoarding and come to realize the ever-present presence of God's abundance, always and instantly available. Truly the Lord is our Shepherd, and we shall not want when our faith is quickened.

Substance is the living mirror which faithfully reflects our mental images upon the screen of visibility. Our innermost, habitual thoughts take form, and, filled with substance, present themselves to us for our consideration and disposal. Thus are we given dominion over all things. We are free-will agents, not mere automatons, and we can control our thoughts, if we have sufficient courage. By controlling our thoughts we control conditions in our environment. On these were great balls of blue sapphire, and from these to the East and to the West a beautiful fence of pearl. Attached to the gate was a tiny, golden chain and a small golden padlock. The angel unlocked the padlock with a tiny key of gold and placed it in the palm of my hand. The gate was open and I held the key; the angel vanished and I stood alone.

Following the death of my father four years later, I had this same identical dream, except as I stood holding the key, the gate and the fence seemed to vanish with the angel, and beyond me was a great field of ripened grain. There seemed to be hands of all colors reaching up in supplication. As a back-ground to this there seemed to be a number of figures clad in white. Their hands were also extended in supplication with a moan proceeding from their lips. They appeared to be lepers.

It seemed as if I were enshrined in a halo of golden light with the key clasped tightly in my hands. I knelt in a spirit of adoration or worship. When I awakened I was still conscious of the presence of the key in my hand.

Your dream is evidently a series of Soul Initiations in which you were required to prove your ability to pass unaffected through the test of fire, earth, water and air. That of fire symbolizing the fires of affliction; that of earth, the mastery of the animal forces or the laws of earthly nature; that of water, the mastery of the emotional nature; that of air, the ability to enter the Kingdom, the Highest Consciousness, whose pearly gates were opened to you. The later part of your dream, with the great field of ripened grain before you, and the people with hands extended in supplication, clearly symbolized what entitled you to enter the gate and harvest the ripened grain. All of those hands reaching towards you in supplication were the souls awaiting your help. Yes, you held the key, the key of loving selfless service, which alone admits you into the Kingdom.

NO LACK OR LIMITATION

Then begin to know the truth and see it instead of that other picture that has such a powerful hold on your mind, only because you believe it is so. What is the true picture? God has a place and a work for everyone of His children and they are always working in His Service, seeking only to please Him. Therefore see yourself doing the thing you would most dearly love to do, see yourself happily and successfully doing it with every proper return coming to you continually, knowing that this is God's Work and you are happy, because you are thus serving Him. Do not try to particularize on the work, but just see yourself happily busy in the Father's work and live in such work, holding it in your mind as an actual thing—despite anything that is happening in the outer. By thus building this mental picture perfectly, vitalizing it with your faith and trust and love of God, refusing to see or acknowledge anything else as so—in accordance with the Law—you will soon find that a miracle will happen and you will be lifted away from your present condition into something wonderful.

PROBLEMS

YOUR kind letter received and ready carefully, and we will try to help by explaining just what is causing the trouble you are having.

Trv to realize that when your Higher Self brings to you truths such as those you have been studying in the Impersonal Lessons, it is for one purpose only—first to plant them in your consciousness as seeds, and then when they grow and become living things in your life, to bring you trials and problems in which to apply these truths and exercise the ability He will provide to enable you to master these problems and tests that confront you. That is what you are facing now.

All of these things that cause you to act the way you do and to rebel against these problems are but the forces of your lower nature that are being shown up to you so you can see them for just what they are and you can determinedly take a hold of them and master them. This is putting it about as plain as can be shown.

Therefore, man is perfect now and always will be. But do our minds see and believe this? No. When anything happens to these bodies of ours, we get frightened and our minds become filled with fears and anxieties, and of all kinds of negative and untrue thoughts that clog up the channel through which God is expressing, and for the time being hinders perfect health and harmony from doing its natural healing and correcting work.

In other words, God being ALL that there is, all that is good and perfect now, despite what our eyes may see or our minds may think and fear, and what doctors say. Can anyone hurt God or make Him sick or diseased? No! The disease and the hurt is only in man's mind. God knows always and only perfection.

But remember, the moment you begin to think and build a contrary picture in your mind of yourself and your body, and you see it in your mind as diseased and full of imperfections, and you put life into that picture through your fears, worries and anxieties about it—then such picture beliefs must manifest. Think this over, dear friend, and decide which picture you want to believe and hold in your mind as so, and then trust the Law to bring it into effect.
