NOTES FROM AN AMERICAN TOUR

A contemporary Flying Saucer lecturer, physicist Stanton Friedman, is addressing SRO audiences of thousands of college students across the country on this fascinating and disturbing subject. But before we get too optimistic about any great change in American consciousness, may we remind you that the distinguished English (or Irish) UFO researcher, Desmond Leslie, did the same thing in 1955-56. We believe you'll enjoy re-reading his report to our Founder-Director, N. Meade Layne.

"I toured America lecturing on The Subject from September until December 1955. I was amazed at the interest and the size of the audiences which in some cases exceeded a thousand people at a time. I spoke on thirty radio and TV shows, and on every occasion received a courteous and interesting hearing, whatever the interviewers personal opinions. I also met Dr. Menzel (Harvard astronomer and government propagandist. RHC.).

"Yes, dear friends, my worst fears were realized. The good doctor took pains to put me aright. He has found, you will rejoice to hear 'the common or garden object which Stephen Darbishire and George Adamski have photographed as a flying saucer'. When I politely asked what the object was, he declined to tell me.

"Funny that no one else should have found Menzel's 'common' object; for if it can be found in shops on both sides of the Atlantic; in the California one-horse town of Valley Center, and in a remote Lancashire village like Coniston, it must be an ubiquitous article. Funny though, that Stephen's second photo shows this object to be distorted as if it was made of rubber -- luminous rubber. Has anyone 'round these parts seen luminous soft rubber saucers being sold off cheap in the recent sales? If so, I should like to have one, particularly if it really flies."

Back in the early 1950s, California philosopher Manly Hall and Washington UFO researcher James Hoseney were in violent disagreement with Harvard's Dr. Menzel. They agreed that the Flying Saucers, the real ones that is, were secret craft of the U.S. Air Force!

"I showed Dr. Menzel the excellent and careful reports by astronomers Harold Hill and William Oliver (see vol. I No. 3 of the British 'Flying Saucer Review'. NML.), but after reading a few lines, the sage tossed them back to me, dispelling the mystery forever in a single word -- a word of such lucid genius as to leave me spellbound.

"'Birds!' he said. 'Birds.'

"I could not say very much as I was a guest in the man's house. Nor did I need to. For if he prefers a bird to a fact let him have it. . . before he gets it!

"However, I was purposefully polite. I tossed one more pearl before reaching for my hat. By way of contrast I told him briefly of an amazing demonstration I twice witnessed under test conditions in company with several eminent English editors and a company chairman, during which complete living beings were materialized and a human being of our race was dematerialized and passed through a solid wall, to be reassembled out in the street. I merely spoke of this to watch his reaction.

"A furrow wrinkled the great brow. Then enlightenment dawned once more. 'You were hypnotized!'

"Just think of it, Meade, I had to go all the way to Boston, Massachusetts to be rid of my delusions. Of course, the fact that Dr. Menzel wasn't present on any of these occasions is utterly beside the point. The fact that Hill and Oliver, unlike professors of astrophysics, actually use their telescopes and are probably more familiar with the sky than theoretical teachers, is of no account. The fact that hard-headed business men in cold sobriety saw exactly what I and twelve other people saw at the materialization experiments is quite beside the point. The fact that he had never met nor questioned any of the numerous people who seen or photographed the Adamski-type saucer is barely worth recording. For me to suggest that such an approach on Menzel's part might not be scientific does not even enter into it.

"One begins to wonder if perhaps some of the wrongs of this world are due to its Creator not possessing a Harvard degree in Astrophysics."

FROM NOTES ON TRAVELS IN CALIFORNIA

Mr. Leslie visited George Adamski at his home at Palomar Gardens, several miles below the summit where the great Palomar telescope is located. While there he met and talked to some interested young pilots of the U.S. Air Force.

"I'd better not give names or they might get into trouble. One had just come from a UFO identification course! All very hush-hush and secret. I asked him what classifications they used. Did they call them 'spots before the eyes', 'light inversions', 'lenticular clouds', etc?

"'Heck no!' he replied. 'They had models and actual photographs, and they classified them: Scout ship, Mother ship, Carrier types.'

"'You mean they've used the names from our book?' I gasped.

"'Sure thing!' the Airman laughed. 'And they've got pictures of some Flying Saucers you've never seen. But be careful who you repeat this to. It's all highly secret.'"

So the BSRA readership of Meade Layne's "Clips, Quotes and Comments" in 1956 learned that UFO familiarization was a part of the Air Force training program. At that time Meade Layne's mailing list was only a few hundred names. Last year, 1970, Flying Saucer researcher Earl Neff, Cleveland, Ohio, got on the trail of a new text book being used in cadet training at the Air Force academy in Colorado. The text treated UFOs as very real objects not created nor piloted by any known civilization on earth. Neff's story made the "National Enquirer", a popular weekly read by millions of Americans and Canadians. Maybe there is some progress in UFO awareness at that.

Oh, back in the early 1950s an Air Force general was in violent disagreement with Dr. Menzel, "Swamp Gas" Hynek, Manly Hall and James Moseley as to the origin of Flying Saucers. The late Gen. Toohy Spaatz told the American public that "anyone who is seeing Flying Saucers is seeing spots before their eyes!" Now back to Leslie's letter to Meade.

"A Naval pilot told me that the previous week, early one morning, he had been passing the Howard Hughes Airstrip at the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard in Los Angeles. Suddenly a Saucer left the ground and shot up into the air. He managed to find the place -- on a strip of waste land just outside the airstrip. Here the dust and sand were burned in a dark circle about forty feet across. Quite calmly the pilot told me, 'I figured the UFO was picking someone up.'"

"A Marine officer told me that during the short truce in the Korean War a huge whirling luminous Saucer patrolled up and down the lines. So regular was its progress that they could set watches by it. It was much too high for interception by fighters, but both sides saw it, and wondered. Naturally, the troops were told 'not to talk about this'."

"A professor from Columbia University, New York, also visited us with a strange tale. It appears that an airliner approaching LaGuardia Field had been contacted by a large Saucer which came alongside and called up the pilot by radio (plain language). The captain had the sense to relay this to his passengers through the cabin speakers; so all aboard heard the two-way conversation. The professor did not tell us the text of the talk but said that LaGuardia tower also received it; and when the plane landed it was told to wait in a corner of the field in disgrace. Here no one was allowed to leave until the FBI arrived. What they told the passengers and crew I do not know, but it must have been pretty good as none of them have dared reveal their experience. (Oh, that we or the editor of 'Flying Saucer Review' had been aboard with our British passports!) However, Columbia University has its own radio and it was on this that a recording of the conversation was made. The

professor asked us not to reveal his name or he would be in trouble.

CHARACTER ASSASSINATION BY OUR GOVERNMENT

"No doubt about it. There is a censorship! I even came across it personally the day of my big lecture in Columbus, Ohio, with which we inaugurated the lovely new Veteran's Memorial Hall (a good way to inaugurate a new hall, we thought). That morning a very personal slapdown, accusing me of trading on incredulous fancy to make money, appeared on the front page of the Columbus journals. (Note: I netted 13 cents on that lecture!) The article was written by a Professor Hynek. (Yes, you've guessed it; he was the local professor of Astrophysics -- a devout Menzelian, to boot). However, this article had the reverse effect. Our meeting was packed, and I used Hynek's article as the basis on which to frame my speech. He had made five glaring errors, so easily disprovable, that I almost felt sorry for the angry faces in the front row who I learned afterwards were members of the Savant's atrophy class."

Apparently Mr. Leslie didn't realize it at the time -- or if he did he was too polite to say so -- Professor Hynek was a witch-doctor of authority for the U.S. Air Force. If he wasn't a paid propagandist actually on the government payroll, he was paid indirectly through fat astrophysics research grants to the university. It was Hynek's job to publicly accuse all Flying Saucer believers and contactees of being either liars, frauds or dupes. Ironic, is it not, that in this time of desperate need for money for schools, mass transportation, health programs and a host of other problems, our tax money is wasted on this kind of positive evil.

After 20 years the government propaganda line has shifted because Hynek would make a complete ass of himself if he stuck with the old one of the 1950s and early '60s. In 1969 he put it this way, talking to reporters at a science meeting at Lewis and Clark College in Oregon. "It is important to continue the scientific studies of UFOs," Dr. Hynek pointed out. "It is the duty of scientists to document, observe and examine all data, not shove it under the carpet." In spite of all of his shrewdly directed efforts at debunking Flying Saucers and discrediting witnesses in the preceding 20 years, scientific interest had increased so much that a two-day meeting on the subject was held at the American Academy of Science meeting in Boston, Dec. 26-27. "A year ago this would not have been a respectable topic for discussion at this high caliber meeting," Hynek declared. Please note that Dr. Hynek still has no belief in Flying Saucers; he just wants scientists to evaluate the data and pass their conclusions around among themselves, working on handpicked data supplied by the government, as did the Robertson Panel for the CIA in 1953.

Which reminds us of that high caliber science joke. The bride-to-be of the young astrophysicist went to a drygoods store to purchase material for her nightgown. She ordered seven yards of it.

"Seven yards of material for a nightgown?" asked the clerk.
"Yes, he doesn't want to find anything. He wants to keep looking!"

"Another interesting meeting," continued Leslie, "was for 800 foremen at Eastman Kodak's works in Rochester, N.Y. Here I dealt mainly with the photos, showing on the screen the Adamski and Darbishire photos with Cramp's Orthographic Projections. I invited any expert present to come up and disprove my argument. I also displayed original prints for their examination. No one had any alternate theory to offer. Possibly the Rochester stores don't stock Menzel soft luminous rubber common or garden objects."

We also used 35mm slide copies of the Adamski and Darbishire Flying Saucer photos in our early UFO lectures in Honolulu, and Cramps's orthographic projection drawings, showing the identical configurations of the two machines. The sixty-year old Adamski took his picture at Palomar mountain, California, Dec. 13, 1952. The 13-year old Stephen Darbishire took his photo of a similar type UFO over Lake Coniston, England, Feb. 15, 1954. If it wasn't the same Flying Saucer in both photos, the two ships must have come off the same production line on Venus Etheria!

"A Marine officer back in California also told me that air-to-air radio conversations (with UFOs) are now so common that any pilot having one has immediately to fill in a special red-colored form marked Secret.

"A form! You don't print forms until things are happening pretty often!"

"During all this, Secretary of the Air Force Quarles said, 'There are no Flying Saucers.' I wonder if he has spoken to former Secretary of the Navy Dan Kimble, who when aboard his Fat Cat plane with his personal staff was accosted by a giant, glowing cylinder. The monster flew alongside his plane for a few moments displaying lights and bluish portholes. Then it shot off. Kimble, a most factual unimaginative man, was shaken enough to speak of this on landing. Promptly he was told by the Pentagon that if he wished to remain Navy Secretary, he had not -- repeat not -- seen any such thing. Actually he had seen one of Dr. Menzel's birds."

If memory serves us correctly, Secretary of the Air Force Quarles suffered a sacrificial death of some kind, perhaps because he experienced a change of mind and wanted to tell the public the truth. Anyhow, he was found mysteriously dead in bed one morning, at the age of 49, by his butler, in his Washington D.C. home. Maybe it was a death-ray murder by the Men In Black, Plutoids from the Mafia of the Solar System. Coroner's verdict: heart attack.

"Yes, there's still plenty going on in America," wrote Desmond Leslie in 1956, "and many new developments in Saucery. But it is having to go underground. Why the Government should be so scared of letting the people know the truth is anyone's guess. But the reason is probably a mixture of many things -- fear of panic, fear of losing an election, fear of a slump in Wall Street should it become known that all of our powers sources and vehicles are obsolete. However, it was a fascinating and most worthwhile tour. I found

the ordinary people want to listen, and want to know. It is quite obvious now that if Space People ever land in force, it will be from the ordinary people, and not from the self-exalted, that the visitors will receive cooperation and friendship. 'How long, oh Lord, how long?'"

FORTY-FIVE YEARS IN THE TEMPLE

P.C.T: "Yada, I would like to get some of your ideas on how a person can govern his own life in such a way as to become a more self-controlled organism, more independent of the world in thought. You no doubt have noticed that most of us human beings are like chips on the waves, just going with the current; but I believe we have an individual thought mechanism that should be developed?"

Yada: "Your words take me back not a few years to that period of time in which I lived in a civilization called Yu. I was taken from my parents soon after the weaning period and into the temple, as were all the children that were to become priests.

"After the first seven years, in which we had complete freedom, being permitted to do anything and everything we desired: run, jump, stamp, rage, yell -- whatever we wanted to do until the age of seven. They said that was a good way for us to acquire our own personality. Then, from seven to 14 years came the training, becoming more severe with each passing year. At the end of the second seven years we were permitted to go out into the world again, and we were asked but one thing, to return to the temple at the end of another seven years.

"On our return, we began the real study and discipline that possibly you could not stand up under today unless you had been thoroughly trained from childhood. And I found, in all the years that I studied in the temples until I became the ultimate, the Yada or head of the temple -- I found that there was but one thing that was necessary, and that was self-control. Apart from that, if one does not have that, all other things fall to pieces to the degree that we lack that.

"I was some forty-five years in the temple. Friends, think of that, to learn this one thing, self-control, the most beautiful, the most necessary of all things. For when you have that, all other things will come to you automatically. Without it, you are very liable to build strain, nerve strain in the body that will drive things away from you; tension -- too great expectancy.

"We, as individuals, must have this power of self-control; for we are at one and the same time the individual and the ALL. The question is, sir, what are you seeking and is it worth while to you above everything else? If so, then all you have to do is center your thoughts on that above everything else and keep it there until you have what you seek. . . ." (CCC F-6, May 15, 1956).

JESUS COMES TO THE PORTAL OF MAN

From Dr. Franz Hartmann's "The Life of Jehoshua, the Prophet of Nazareth" 1889, republished by Health Research, California 1966.

(Jesus is an Initiate in the Western Mystery Tradition. The New Testament does not make clear where He took the earlier training in preparation for the Ministry in Palestine, but we are safe in assuming Jesus, Jehoshua, Joshua, Joshu, Jesu, Iesu was "learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians" as was Moses before him. The learned Theosophist, Dr. Hartmann, delving into the Egyptian Mysteries, gives us a stirring picture of one of those initiations.)

After Jehoshua had entered the Egyptian temple, he was led into the presence of the assembled priests. They questioned him in regard to his object in desiring to enter their order, and admonished him to desist; warning him of the dangers he was to incur, if he insisted in pursuing this way to obtain knowledge of the secret sciences and to come in possession of the powers which such a knowledge conveyed.

They told him that if he were once admitted, there would be no possibility of retreat, as he would have to succeed or to lose his freedom and perhaps even his life; for powers of evil which would be aroused would conquer him, unless he were strong enough to conquer them.

Jehoshua Ben-Pandira was not to be intimidated; he desired to obtain knowledge and considered wisdom to be more valuable than life. He insisted upon being admitted. He received the blessings of the Brothers, and as each of these venerable men laid his hands upon his head, he felt an electric thrill pass through his frame, that seemed to invigorate him and to give him a power sufficient to overcome all dangers. After this he was given over to a guide called Thesmophores, who blindfolded him and led him away.

He went with his guide through several long corridors, from whose walls the echoes of their steps resounded, and they descended a flight of stairs until at last they arrived at the place of their destination. When the hood was removed, Jehoshua found himself in a cave hewn in solid rock. It was a high arched vault with massive pillars, cut in a manner to represent figures of men and fabulous animals. The only light which entered into the vault came through a round opening far up in the roof, where a small part of the clear blue sky could be seen. Upon the walls of that prison were written proverbs and mottoes, consisting of extracts from the books of the Egyptian and Indian sages who may have lived in the far-distant

past, perhaps even in pre-historic times, when that which we now call Europe formed the bottom of the sea, and another continent was at the height of its civilization at a place where now the ocean rolls its waves.

The room was furnished in the most primitive fashion, containing merely the most necessary requisites. The Thesmophores told the candidate -- for such he had now become -- that he would have to remain here in solitude for an indefinite period of time. He advised him to occupy himself with thinking of the nature of man and his destiny and to meditate about his own self. He gave him some writing materials and requested him to write down the thoughts that would enter his mind and seem important to him, and after taking leave of the prisoner and wishing him good success, the guide went away.

Thus when the free spirit seeking for knowledge sends its feelers into the tomb of the living clay, blindly following the law of reincarnation, he finds himself alone without a guide, left to his own thoughts, and with only a faint light above coming from his former home, while on the walls of the prison house called the Mind, he may find dim recollections of the teachings of wisdom acquired in previous lives.

Jehoshua was now alone. There is nothing more terrible than isolation and solitude to those who know of no other life but that of external sensation and who cannot create their own thoughts; especially if there is no change in their surroundings, to attract their attention and to stimulate them to think. Thinking is an art, and few can think what they wish or hold on to a thought. Men think only what they must; they feed on ideas that enter their minds without asking. Welcome and unwelcome thoughts enter; they neither come at our bidding nor go away when they are not wanted; they are like disorderly guests that do not obey the rules which the landlord prescribes.

The monotony in which Jehoshua lived remained unchanged. There was no sound of any kind to be heard; he was surrounded by silence; and if it had not been for the small opening in the vault far above his head, he would not have known the changes of day and night. He studied the writings upon the walls, and impressed them upon his memory, analyzing their meaning. The more he thought about them the more his mind seemed to expand and new ideas enter. He could not tell from whence they came, but he wrote them down upon the tablets with which he had been provided. Often when he awoke in the morning from his slumber, these tablets had disappeared from his prison, and he knew not what had become of them. He saw no one enter the room, and yet somebody must have taken them away.

Likewise the food with which he was provided was supplied by invisible means. It was of the most simple kind, consisting of bread, milk, fruit and water. It was daily brought to him in some inexplicable manner; how or by what means he could not tell; for it was put into his prison during his sleep. However, he soon

ceased to be astonished at such strange occurrences and he began seriously the study of self. As he became accustomed to look within his own soul, a new world seemed to open before him; his imagination grew stronger, and the pictures presented before his inner eye became as objective and real to him as the objects of the external world, only more beautiful, more ethereal, and yet far more substantial than the latter.

Visions of things which he had formerly seen, but which had apparently been lost to his memory, appeared again, vivid and real with all their living details; desires entering his heart immediately took objective forms in his mind, representing in seemingly living forms the objects of which he thought. Thus he saw many beautiful things in his visions, but also many horrible sights, for no man is without evil, and evil thoughts that came to him were likewise represented in seemingly real but horrible forms.

What is this plastic power of the imagination, and what do men mean by calling subjective images "merely works of imagination"? Can we imagine anything that does not exist? Are the creations of our thoughts less real to us than the things which the imagination of others created for us? Is not the universe a product of the imagination of God, and are we not gods in our own inner world, able to create forms from the substance called the Astral Light?

Gradually Jehoshua began to love this inner life, where he found a world as large as the outer world, with a space as infinite as that of the latter, with mountains and plains, with oceans and rivers, and people with beings of various kinds that looked up to him as their god, their creator, drawing life from his Will, and nourishment from his Thought, in the same sense as Man receives his will-power and ideas from the God in the universe, appearing to him in his dreams while asleep, and in visions while awake. Thus Jehoshua lived in the world of the Elemental Powers of Nature, and began to know the constituent parts of that organism called the human soul.

Weeks, perhaps months, thus passed away. Who knows how long he remained in that tomb? He kept no record of the days and nights since he had entered there, and what is time and space after all, but merely mental conceptions by which we attempt to measure the Infinite? But one day steps were heard to approach; the door which had been closed so long opened. The Thesmophores entered, congratulating him on his success and inviting him to come to the Portal of Man, to enter as a Neophyte into the first degree of the Holy Brotherhood. They entered a large park, through which they passed, until they arrived at an entrance called the Door of the Profane. There they found a great many people assembled who had been attracted by curiosity to see the new candidate for initiation; for such a rare event was not kept secret; as it was desired that the people should know that there were still men to be found ready to dare all dangers in search of the Truth. They thronged the place in front of the door through which Jehoshua passed with his guide on his way to the Temple of Wisdom. . .

"THE SURFACE OF VENUS IS LIVABLE!"

"What is the main color of the earth as seen from Venus?"
Question submitted to W. Hall, Denver Colorado.

It is well known by your modern scientists in astronomy that when Venus is in full phase it is some 134,000,000 miles from the earth, and when in conjunction with the earth it drops that figure down to 28,000,000 miles. This planet, that appears so brilliant most of the time to you on the earth, is enveloped in a vast cloud of gas of considerable density so that the light you see coming from it is not reflected from the planet proper but from the upper surface of the gas cloud.

Your scientists have taken note of the fact that there are some darker spots that appear from time to time in this cloud bank and they undoubtedly want to know the nature of those spots; From my observation of them they are eddies or whirlpools formed by the pressure of light from the sun that strikes certain portions of the cloud in a more continuous manner than it does other portions and in time most if not all of the Venus cloud will reduce itself to a ring of comparatively small satellites.

Now as for what the colors of the earth are in viewing it from Venus, I think it goes without saying that Venus cannot see the earth at all with the naked eye except on very rare occasions which is during a rift in the cloud bank. While I do not like to start useless controversies, the facts are that though the upper surface of the gas cloud of Venus is largely carbon-dioxide in highly concentrated form, nevertheless the surface of the planet is very livable and is very much like the earth and is but a few hundred miles smaller than the earth in size. Being smaller than the earth its mass density is greater than that of the earth. Its core is made up of fluidic metals that due to the tremendous internal pressures weigh into the billions of tons per cubic inch, and contain heat little short of that of the sun. The central climate of Venus is hotter than the Christian hell and much too humid for earth men to breathe.

The terrain is a vast dense jungle growth and very swampy. There is an abundance of water, but heavily carbonated, and the poles are sheeted by vast fields of carbonated ice. Great sub-zero wind storms are constantly raging. However, between these two hells is a temperate zone that is very livable and humans do live there. In fact a highly advanced race of people live there. They have what may be called electronic scanning machines with which they have been studying the skies for years and can see

right through the dense clouds and rings as though they were not there.

THE BEAUTIFUL EARTH

"No, there is no planet beyond Neptune belonging to this solar system. There is the Great Void of some 86 trillion miles, then another solar system. Yes, as far as I know, another and another without end. Yes, the perturbations of Neptune are partly due to comets. (No direct reference to Pluto, apparently. RHC.)

"Vulcan, to me, is a dark star (Natalli would not or could not make further statements about Vulcan). There is a vast difference in the age of planets in your solar system. The earth is one of the oldest, and the sun oldest of all. But planets are born in different ways, some almost spontaneously by aggregation of etheric matter. . . ." (BSRA No. 8-B, 90 pages, \$2.00)

These few remarks by Natalli only 17 years after Pluto's existence was verified by astronomer Clyde Tombaugh in 1930, have tremendous significance in this age of Flying Saucers! For here is an indication that Pluto, the so-called farthest out planet of our solar system, is an invader, an intruder from Zodiacal space, trying to make a home for itself in this system. Couple with this the astrological significance of Pluto as the planet of violence and inspiration for underworld activity, and we may have a clue to the origin of the elemental Men In Black and their Controls. Shall we call them Plutoids, the sinister guiding influence behind all subversive activities? They would choose earth for a new home. It is in a stable orbit well inside the giant planets, Jupiter and Saturn; while Pluto is oscillating wildly on the fringe of the system, easily shaken off in the next big system change. A wild guess, maybe, but here we have the motivation, a Mafia of the solar system, behind all of the gangster elements trying to destroy civilization.

RADIATIONS AND WAVES -- SOURCE OF OUR LIFE

By Georges Lakhovsky -- 1941

(One of the best summaries we know of, of a dozen advanced and non-medical therapeutic techniques, is Associate Mark Gallert's "New Light On Therapeutic Energies", published by James Clarke & Co. Ltd., 31 Queen Anne's Gate, London SW1, England, for 30 Shillings. The 256-page, hard cover book includes sections on the work of Drs. White, Reich, Hahnemann, Schussler, Littlefield, Wilson, Kee-sey, Samuels, and of Dinshah Ghadiali, L.E. Eeman, and of the electronic developments of Georges Lakhovsky and S.S. Knight. Here are some of the ideas of Georges Lakhovsky, especially concerned with the cure of cancer.)

"Certain natural radiations are particularly toxic, especially those originating in earth programs. Many cancer cases have been attributed to these toxic (poisonous) radiations and proven experimentally, notably in Germany by Dr. Rambeau of Marburg. Therefore, earth radiations sometimes cause disturbance of the cellular oscillatory equilibrium of the organism.

"Under these varied circumstances cellular oscillations may cease; the cell is then dead. But within the dead cell, the chondromes (central coils) continue to oscillate electrically on their own natural frequencies. Fortunately, this phenomenon occurs rarely or all mankind would already have perished from cancer. The chondromes then envelope themselves in a membrane and continue to oscillate and multiply independently of the cell. They then become neoplastic (cancer) cells.

"To re-establish this equilibrium I thought of creating in 1923 a constant compensating field of very short radiations (2 to 10 metres in wave lengths) to neutralize the action of the disturbing rays and give the living cell the necessary stimulation for a return to its normal oscillation.

"To this end in 1923 I constructed my short-wave oscillator, using two triode tubes for very short waves made especially for this apparatus. . . Finally I adopted the oscillator with symmetrical cross leakage comprising two triodes. The oscillating circuit formed a single spiral, branched between the two grilles and the two anodes. It was fed directly by alternating current from the local supply circuit.

"With this short-wave apparatus I was able to cure plants inoculated with cancer. For six years at the Salpetriere I observed and checked the effects of these short waves. Using very low power, from 10 to 12 watts, and a limited duration of treatment, I succeeded in curing cancer in human beings, but also had to record some failures.

"The news of the success of my experiments became widespread. In many countries, as early as 1928, they began to build short wave oscillators of considerable power producing thermal effects. But there was great danger that the chromosomes and chondromes, which are barely a ten-thousandth or twenty-thousandth of a millimeter in thickness, might not survive under a high frequency current. They offer much resistance, even to a low current which is sufficient to dissolve and destroy them.

PROOF WITH A BURNT OUT BULB

"It is simple to prove this by bringing a small bulb of from 2 to 5 watts with a filament of several hundredths of a millimeter, inserted between metal rods forming an antennae, within the radius of a short wave transmitter. The bulb will light up and sometimes burn out, if it is brought too near the apparatus.

"Moreover, the chondromes and chromosomes of all living cells, which are infinitely finer than the filaments of bulbs, are sensitive centers of thermal phenomena, which may provoke their fusion. Undoubtedly this method is effective in killing microbes in the organism and in neoplastic cells. But it can also destroy millions of cells of healthy tissue in every irradiation.

"On the other hand, I thought it possible to obtain better results by administering an oscillatory shock to all the cells in the organism simultaneously. Such a shock, very brief, produced by damped or weakened electrostatic waves, does not provoke thermal and prolonged effects and involves no risk of burning living cells! I therefore sought to produce an artificial oscillatory shock causing a periodic oscillation of the weak or dead cells.

"At first glance this problem seems physically insoluble as there are approximately 200 quintillion cells in our bodies, each oscillating on its own natural wave length. Theoretically, therefore, we would have to have a different wave length for each cell; so that every cell in the organism would oscillate in resonance on its own wave length.

"After much research I was able to construct an apparatus creating an electro-static field covering all frequencies from three metres to the infra-red, so that every cell can find its natural frequency and vibrate in resonance. We know that in physics a circuit fed by damped or weakened high frequency currents creates many harmonics. Consequently, I conceived an oscillator of multiple wave lengths with a broad scale in which every organ, every gland, every tissue, every nerve, could find its natural frequency.

"To obtain this result I set up a transmitter (antenna) composed of a series of circular concentric oscillating circuits linked by a silk cord but not contiguous. These circuits are stimulated by damped high frequency currents from a spark gap. Thus each circuit of the transmitter vibrates not only on its natural frequency, but also on numerous harmonics.

"Thus I built an oscillator with all the basic wave lengths from 10 centimetres to 400 metres, that is, all frequencies from 750,000 per second to 3 billion. But each circuit also emits many harmonics which, with their vasic waves, their interferences and their effluvia can reach the scale of infra-red and even that of visible light (1 to 300 trillion vibrations per second). Since all the cells as well as the chondromes oscillate precisely at frequencies on these gamuts, they can therefore find on the scale of such an oscillator the frequencies which cause them to vibrate in resonance.

REINFORCING THE VITALITY

"As early as 1931 I began using this multiple wave oscillator in various Paris hospitals: the Saint Louis, Val-de-Grace, Calvary, Necker, etc. . . Among the many cures with this treatment I will mention especially those of various cases of cancer which X-ray and radium treatments failed to improve. These patients cured six years ago have had no recurrence and are in perfect health at this date. In all pathogenic cases this treatment gives very good results. As it does not attack the microbes directly, it does not destroy live tissue, but reinforces the vitality of the organism by accelerating cellular oscillation. It is therefore the reinforced organism that successfully resists the microbes and all pathogenic causes.

"So, while X-rays and radium destroy microbes, neoplastic cells and healthy tissues at the same time -- which accounts for the serious accidents which occur during and after such treatments -- high frequency radiation (short waves) applied at a distance and without thermal effect cure diseases of all kinds, even those of the prostate to a considerable degree. Whatever the pathogenic cause, the multiple wave oscillator (MWO) reproduces the frequencies necessary to re-establish the cellular oscillatory equilibrium.

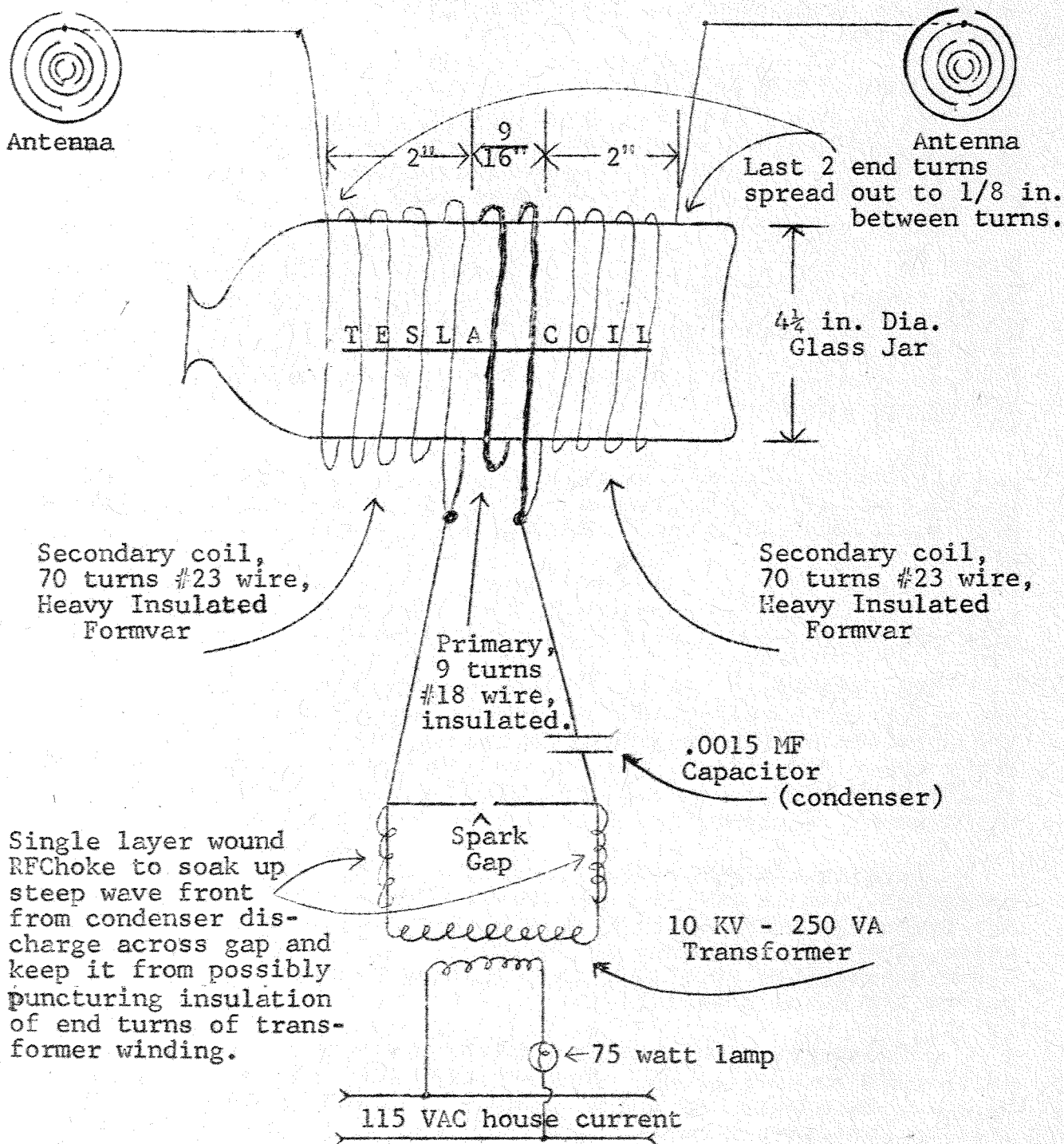
"In general, it is sufficient to seat the patient, or to have him stand in the radius of the apparatus (between the two antennas). The duration of the treatment is usually from five to ten minutes, every other day. These figures are purely arbitrary since these radiations reinforcing cellular oscillation do not produce organic disturbance, whatever the duration of the treatment may be.

"Despite the many cases successfully treated, almost without exception, yet it must be understood that my oscillator cannot cure all types of cancer in all its stages of development. In many cases, when the cancerous tumour has already destroyed important blood vessels, my apparatus is powerless to rebuild that tissue before the fatal haemorrhage."

BSR Associates with extra-sensory perception (ESP) have watched the MWO in operation. They say they can see clouds of ectoplasm building up around the antenna but this takes several minutes. This mechanically generated vitality, mana, prana, is then absorbed by the subject, along with the radiations; but this takes time;

so, to get the full benefit of this electronic showerbath, the subject should stay in it at least 10 minutes -- or until he feels the polarity change in his body. This is if he is experimenting with the Bob Beck miniaturized Multi-Wave Oscillator described in BSRA brochure #29, \$2.00, which uses only one powered antenna.

A HIGH-POWER MULTI-WAVE OSCILLATOR



"Your brochure article stating that Georges Lakhovsky's original MWO had a separate Tesla coil driving each Antenna is most interesting. This is in line with my experience here in Manila. I find that when livening up both antennas to full voltage, to spark each antenna down to the 3rd ring with an occasional slop-over to the 4th ring, it is much more effective than when keeping one antenna (or resonator) down to near ground potential; and it is least effective when actually grounding this antenna -- as Mr. Beck does -- through a 1/10 MF capacitor!

"One five minute treatment a week is enough for me and the equivalent of two 15 minute treatments with only one antenna up to full voltage. However, I drive both antennas up to full voltage with only one Tesla coil. It has rather tightly coupled primary and secondary windings, wound as an auto-transformer, on a 4 1/4 in. diameter glass jar, as per enclosed sketch.

"The present spark gap is 1/8 inch, a fixed, constant gap, needs no tuning with variable distances between antennas, subject or no subject. The sparking is much the same and the gap is not at all critical, 1/32nd, plus or minus, works just as well. Gap electrodes are 1/4 inch tungsten. The present primary circuit capacitor is .0015 Micro Farads, but this also is not at all critical, can be varied up to .0025 and still give much the same sparking and effect on subject.

"I tried using #28 Formvar wire, heavy insulated, 70 turns each on the secondaries, to shorten coil and get tighter coupling, primary to secondary, but coil was too short and flashed over from end to end.

"Just plug it in and use it, no tuning manipulation of any kind required. The input of 115 VAC to the 10,000 volt oil burner ignition transformer is only 17 VA through the 75 watt lamp as a limiting resistor. Never use more than a 100 watt lamp. This is all I can take. More power becomes rapidly depressing. And the full 250 VA out put of the transformer I once used, with a 5/8 inch spark gap, was nearly fatal. It took me four months to get over the effects of it. Pass this info on to your Associates."

Associates can benefit from this dedicated borderlander's experience, which confirms Lakhovsky's warning that healthy cells can be over-stimulated and killed by powerful high-frequency waves -- as well as by X-ray and radium waves. It may be easier to locate Neon Sign transformers of 5,000 to 7,500 volts output as power supplies for this MWO, at a cost of \$15 to \$20. In this case the wattage of the "limiting resistor" electric light could be increased to 150 or 200 watts, or eliminated altogether, if it is necessary to get enough power to cause random arcing down to the third and fourth rings on both antennas. The good doctor says nothing about shielding but care should be taken to prevent radio interference from this powerful spark.

BIOPHYSICIST CONFIRMS LAKHOVSKY'S THEORIES!

LA "Times", March 28, 1971: "The 'magnetic resonance' of the nuclei of atoms (in living cells) has been used to tell the difference between cancer and normal tissues. This resonance is the reaction of the nuclei to electromagnetic energy -- first its absorption and then its emission. The process can be timed.

"Raymond Damadian, a biophysicist at the State University of New York's Manhattan Medical Center, said his achievement may open the way to major advances in the diagnosis of cancer in humans. . . Like other attempts to find a way of making early diagnoses of cancer, Damadian's research began with a hunt for significant differences between cancer and normal cells.

"He relied on a law of physics on which nuclear magnetic resonance is based -- that the atoms in each element in the periodic table absorb and then emit electromagnetic energy on an individual wavelength that is different from that absorbed and emitted by the atoms of any other element. In his system, radio waves are aimed at atoms in strong magnetic fields. If the wavelength is the right one for that atom, the atom will absorb the energy and then emit it, returning to a 'resting' state afterwards.

"The reactions differ according to the kind of molecule the various atoms are incorporated in. They also differ when very subtle changes have taken place in the molecules. The measure Damadian uses is what is called the 'relaxation time' of hydrogen atoms in water molecules within the (body) cells. . . He found that it takes longer for protons (nuclei) in cancerous tissue to 'relax' than it does for protons in normal tissue. . . The relaxation time of protons in normal liver tissue, as one example, was .25 of a second, compared with .86 of a second for cancerous tissue.

"Damadian's findings confirm the theory proposed by several scientists that water molecules in a normal cell are held in a fairly well organized structure by electromagnetic attraction exerted by the molecules in the cell. But, it was theorized, when a cell begins the uncontrolled growth of cancer, the structure begins to collapse because of the cell's increasing disorganization. .

"Damadian thinks the device for detecting cancer in humans (his experiments were conducted on mice and mouse tissue) that may come out of his work would be a radio frequency coil to emit the electromagnetic waves to be aimed at the atoms in the water molecules under study. The device also would include a magnet to create the field required for measurement.

"The coil would be wrapped around the patient while the magnet

would be moved back and forth over his body. The reading of how long it takes the atomic nuclei to relax would be made and then computers would do the matching up and make the diagnoses."

Interesting, isn't it, how the 1970s researches of biophysicist Damadian parallel the pioneering work of electrical engineer Georges Lakhovsky in the 1920s? The goals are quite different, of course, in that Damadian only wants to prove the existence of cancer so the victim can go on to be drugged, operated or radiated with destructive X-rays or Cobalt rays, at fancy prices, a procedure inspired by the soulless monsters who guide the American Medical Association from the Lower Astral plane.

The irony of Damadian's proposed diagnostic technique is that it combines two electro-magnetic healing procedures. If it is used on sick people, sooner or later someone is going to be healed of cancer while being diagnosed! Can you imagine the disagreeable shock this would cause in orthodox medical circles? Extensive surgery would have to be canceled. The sale of drugs would be lost. Under these circumstances it isn't likely that his diagnostic technique will ever receive the approval of the AMA.

So, borderland science will have to continue to carry the torch of research on electro-magnetics in this area, as George Van Tassel is doing with his Integratron up at Giant Rock, California. In his latest "Proceedings" he gives more details of his research program there. We learn that in addition to creating a field of soft, high frequency radio waves, and a magnetic field, the Integratron will also bathe the subject in an atmosphere charged with negative ions.

HOPPING UP THE HIGHER FREQUENCIES

"There is one thing you may wish to try on the MWO. Close the center hole in the driven antenna with a washer and screw. Connect this to the driven ring (second ring from the outside) with a 500 mmf condenser, 10,000 volt rating. This increases the power of the higher frequencies. I think you will be pleased with the results. Mount the condenser at the back of the antenna. Mankind has been saturated with the lower frequencies for years; 60 cycles and their first few harmonics are almost everywhere in more than adequate power. "Two British industrialists, Pardoe of Hawker-Siddeley and O'Hagan of Standard Telephone & Cable, told a Conservative Party seminar that the U.S. employed satellites for economic espionage. The French journal 'Air et Cosmos', in noting these statements declared, 'According to these two specialists 'There is absolutely no doubt that the Americans are utilizing photographs taken from satellites in order to delimit the terrestrial zones which would justify prospecting for minerals and oils.' To support this thesis Mr. Pardoe cites the surprising success achieved by the American prospecting company in North Africa and the Middle East in zones which no one had thought of prospecting up until then.

"Mr. O'Hagan goes even further since he declares, 'Americans have purchased in foreign countries, lands containing mineral riches based on information furnished by photographs from satellites for the study of terrestrial resources.' Mr. Pardoe, for his part, affirmed that only 13 photos of the 8000 taken during the flight of Apollo 7 have been published as of now, the others having been classified (secret) because of their too great resolution."

"Air et Cosmos continues, 'One certain fact is that up until now satellites for the study of terrestrial resources fly over -- or have flown over -- a great part of the globe, but that they are not controlled in any way by the countries flown over. The only controlling authority is the one who puts them in orbit; and it's only that one which decides to communicate to the third country, information received of interest on a national scale. . . .'"

THE JAPANESE READ US, LOUD AND CLEAR

LA "Times", Feb. 25, 1971: "Tokyo -- Japanese space scientists, delighted by the successful orbiting of a test satellite, are already looking forward to having their own communications, navigation, (observation?) and weather satellites. After a long series of embarrassing failures, Japan's first space payload was put in earth orbit a year ago. Another attempted launch failed last September when the rocket's fourth and final stage failed to ignite. But on Feb. 16 a 138-pound satellite was faultlessly launched into space by a four-stage solid fuel rocket fired from the Uchinoura Space Center in southern Japan. It will transmit data on its own performance until its batteries die in about a week. The present space program is administered by the University of Tokyo but in the mid-1970s it is due to be replaced by a government-sponsored program that will send aloft research and communications with American technical assistance. . . . Tokyo University, which successfully launched Japan's first satellite on Feb. 11, 1970, is specializing in scientific surveying of the earth's environment. (It) will launch six other scientific satellites by 1976 to observe plasma waves, plasma density, electron particle rays, solar soft rays. etc. . . ."

Injury and disease are outward manifestations of an invisible cause, which may involve three or four levels of consciousness and extend back two or three lives. Magnetic Treatment Device of Liquids), and this blood coursing through the body presents good effects. The magnitude of the electromotive forces occurring in the blood is greater, the faster the blood flows (Principle of Fleming's Law). Therefore the medical effect of the magnet is greater when the human body is active rather than stationary."

VIETNAM IS NOT ARMAGEDDON!

Yup, we have it right out of the mouth, or pen, of George "Bullshit" Ball, writing in "Newsweek" magazine, May 3, 1971: "Recently, on three college campuses, not only students but even some young faculty members have confronted me with a startling assertion. America has embroiled itself in Vitenam not from misconceived purposes of strategy and politics but from motives as ugly and elemental as greed. South Vietnam, they say, should better be named Golconda. . . our adventure in that wretched terrain of paddy and jungle. . . is not a misguided effort of containment, but instead a textbook example of economic imperialism, gunboat diplomacy and nineteenth-century-style filibustering.

"When I have countered this thesis by declaring that in more than six years' involvement at the highest level of our government I never heard even a whisper that America had a significant economic interest in Southeast Asia, my student interlocutors have regarded me with incredulity, implying that I was either gullible or a tool of the interests. . ."

THE BILLION DOLLAR OPIUM BUSINESS

No need to bore you with the rest of Ball's propaganda -- telepathically channeled into his brain from Agharta, no doubt -- but aside from the huge oilfields as now being openly acknowledged, offshore from South Vietnam but not in production yet -- there is the highly profitable opium traffic from the mountains of Laos and Thailand, through South Vietnam to the United States. It would appear that our major interest in Southeast Asia now is to keep this multi-billion dollar business from falling into the hands of the Communists! 500,000 addicts in the United States -- not to mention thousands of our boys in Vietnam getting hooked on heroin -- is big business, so big and so threatening to our national survival that Senator Vance Hartke, Indiana, spoke up on the floor of the Senate in Washington, March 2nd: "Mr. President, the specter of heroin addiction is haunting nearly every community in the nation!"

So what's new? The "interests" referred to by former Under-Secretary of State George Ball have expected every president since Eisenhower to protect the sources of opium supply in the mountains of Indo-China, even as we also protect them in Turkey. As long ago as 1954 Vice-President Richard Nixon was prodding his boss to have us get in there and fight. In his speech to the American Society of Newspaper editors, April 16, 1954, he said: "If to avoid further Communist expansion in Asia and Indochina, we must take the risk now by putting our boys in, I think the Executive has to take the politically unpopular decision and do it."

One of the most prominent of the "interests" in Saigon at that time was a devout Roman Catholic named Madame Ngo Dinh Nhu. Her husband became head of the dreaded Saigon secret police in 1955. Six years later, in August 1960, an obscure American named Edgar "Pop" Buell was accidentally given the opportunity to observe Madame Nhu deeply engaged in her major interest. Pop was an Indiana farmer who

went to Laos to help the Neo hillpeople with their agricultural practices. One time he was at the air strip on the Plain of Jars at Phong Savan, talking to a local restaurant man, Albert Faure. The two watched "as a modern twin-engined plane took on a huge load of opium. Beneath the wing, talking heatedly with the plane's Corsican pilot, was a slender woman dressed in long white silk pants and ao d'ai, the side-slit, high-necked gown of Tietnam. Her body was exquisitely formed, and her darkly beautiful face wore a clear expression of authority. Even Duell could see that she was Vietnamese, not Lao.

"'Zat,' said Foure, 'is ze grande madame of opium from Saigon.' Edgar never learned her name, but he recognized the unforgettable face and figure when the picture of an important South Vietnamese politician appeared months later in an American news magazine."

Yes, in the early '60s the Tiger Lady got VIP treatment in "Time" magazine, with her portrait on the cover and a feature article inside, extolling her virtues as the leader of the Women's Lib movement in Vietnam! If Pop Buel was interviewed by the Times writers, Madame Nhu's supervision of the billion dollar opium traffic was not mentioned. The above quote about the Plain of Jars incident is from Don Schanche's book, "Mr. Pop".

A PAUSE BETWEEN TWO OPINIONS

Let's give Jack Kennedy the benefit of the doubt and say that he wasn't aware of this earthly manifestation of Plutonic evil when he took office in 1960, nor even when he enthusiastically authorized the creation of such elite counter-insurgency outfits as the Green Berets for Vietnam a couple of years later. But some time during 1963 the horrible realization must have swept over our president that Vietnam was an even greater moral disaster than Cuba and the Bay of Pigs. He withdrew his support of Diem, leading to the assassination of that oriental Catholic dictator, and also planned the withdrawal of thousands of the military "advisers" he had sent to Vietnam.

This action brought the Tiger Lady raging to America in the fall of 1963. The "interests" arranged a lecture tour for Madame Nhu across the country. Your editor well remembers her fiery statements to the press, against President Kennedy, here in Southern California in November 1963. She vowed to stay here and fight until her fellow Roman Catholic was out of the White House. This was speedily taken care of in Dallas, November 22nd. When Los Angeles reporters sought out Madame Nhu to congratulate her on her good fortune she was no where to be found! Then they learned that she had suddenly flown to Rome several days earlier. Do you suppose she had gotten in touch with Jeane Dixon?

Anyhow, the chief obstacle to the increased and highly profitable flow of opium-derived heroin to the United States was conveniently out of the way. Madame Nhu herself was persona non grata with the new gang in Saigon, but the hard drug situation is now so

serious that U.S. Customs Service has ordered complete inspection of all military mail parcels from Vietnam to seize drugs being imported. A package seized at the military post office at Ft. Monmouth, N.J. had enough heroin in it to net \$1.75 million when sold on the street!

Drug use among returning soldiers is so bad now that Rep. Paul G. Rogers, Florida Democrat and head of the House public health subcommittee, is asking Congress for another \$10 million to set up a special rehabilitation program for drug-addicted GIs. He accuses the Defense Dept. of "grossly underestimating the extent of drug abuse in the military" and that the Dept. was "turning veterans back to society with a habit instead of help".

NO END IN SIGHT

On May 11, 1971, Senator Thomas Eagleton briefed the Senate Foreign Relations Committee on his findings in Vietnam. He was there April 7-14 for a first-hand view of the continuing war for control of the poppy-growing hill country of Laos, Thailand and Burma. He mentioned specifically Gen. Frederick Weyand, Deputy U. S. commander in Vietnam, and Maj. Gen. Albert Milloy, deputy commander of the 1st Corps. Said Eagleton, "unanimously, these military men told me that the plans under which they were operating called for a protracted period of massive American air power, including helicopters, based in Thailand and Okinawa and various places in Indochina."

For years, patriotic fathers and mothers have been sending their sons to Vietnam to fight an old man's war, fearful that their sons might never return. Now, the parents are fearful that if the boy does return he will be a drug addict -- not to mention what other vices and diseases he might have picked up there. Is that nationwide fear likely to turn into a collective rage against the present administration, whose leader was pleading for us to get into this mess back in 1954! If so, this may be the scandal which will blow the President out of the White House before the end of his term, as predicted by Witch-Astrologer Sybil Leeke about a year ago in the "National Enquirer".

The May 1971 issue of "Ramparts" magazine in which some of the above information appears, naming names and places in Vietnam and Laos, is a sellout on the national newsstands. If you didn't get one, send 75¢ to the editorial offices, 2054 University Ave., Berkeley, California 94704, and get a copy.

As a long-time student of the Flying Saucer phenomenon I believe we have revealed here a massive attempt by certain subversive forces to destroy the moral fibre of this nation. This is a brazen attempt prepare us for an eventual takeover of the entire planet. This was dramatized with bone-chilling reality in the "Invaders" series on television several years ago. The most shocking episode in the series, to your editor and his wife, was the one in which the Mafia was ready, willing and able to "make a deal" with the In-

vaders to keep their soul-destroying opium flowing into the United States. I'll never forget the offhand remark of the Mafia leader when he was faced with the undeniable reality of the Flying Saucers and the malevolent program of the Men In Black:

"So they want to take over the earth, do they? Well, they'll have to deal with us. We run it!"

REPORTS FROM NEW ZEALAND

"A reprint edition of Capt. Bruce Cathie's book "Harmonic 33" is in the book shops here, reprinted in Hong Kong. I've been surprised by the number of enquiries since the first edition sold out nearly two years ago. The price is now \$4.50 plus 30¢ postage. It can be ordered from the A.B.C. Bookshop, Trafalgar St., Nelson, New Zealand. It is hoped that Capt. Cathie's next book, "Harmonic 695A", will be ready in September. Recently I met Harold Fulton, mentioned in Gray Barker's book, "They Knew Too Much About Flying Saucers". He is still very much interested in UFOs but is not much in the news these days.

"We still have the private creation of money by banks here in New Zealand but the government owns the biggest, really, and controls the Reserve Bank to which all other banks have to look to for money policy actions. Our present government is a Bankers Party but the skids are under it and we expect a change back to Socialist government in about 18 months. However, our main policies are still those set up by the original Socialist Govt. in the years 1935-1949 and no party has since been game to radically change them. We had very little of the usual profiteering during World War II as the govt of the time, Socialist, put a complete price freeze on practically everything, much to the disappointment of the speculators who love wars.

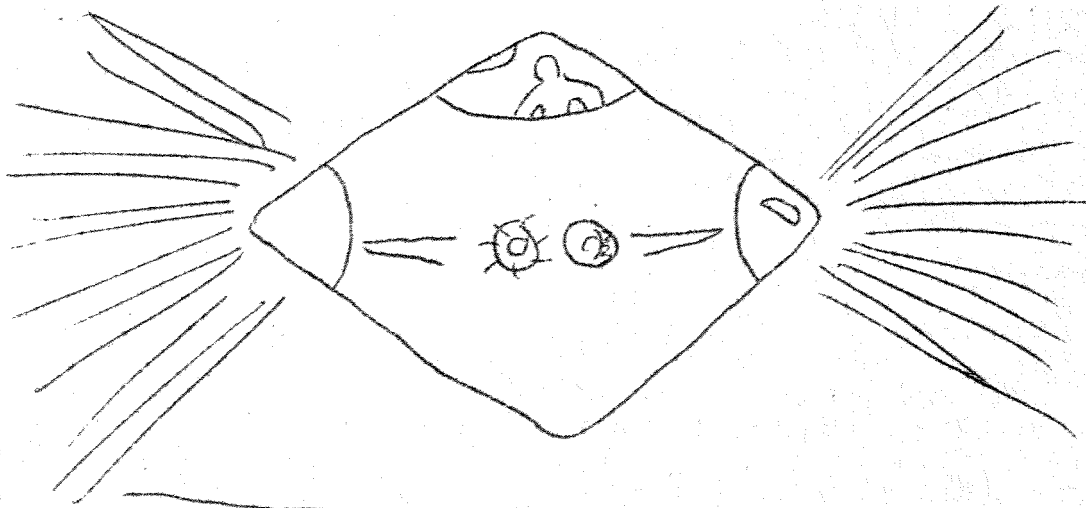

FLYING SAUCER "LOOKED LIKE A BAT"

"Richard Williams, 18, a resident of rural Greenwich, employed as a welder for Durable Mat Co. in Norwalk, said he and his wife and their four month old son were driving on Old Niver Road toward Willard (Ohio) about 9:05 p.m. Friday (Jan. 22, 1971) when they saw a low flying object coming toward their car. 'I saw the object approaching me,' reported Williams. 'I saw one light on each side of the wing span. It looked like a bat. The wings were wider than the plane or whatever it was. On the middle of each wing there seemed to be an exhaust rocket engine or jet engine. It had red and white lights on each of the wings and on the tails. After blinking my car lights at it, it stopped and hovered down a little closer. I could just about see the outline as my lights were on bright. From the front the object looked like an airplane, except



it was really huge. It was bigger than an Army hover craft.'

"He estimated the UFO to be 25 to 30 feet in diameter. It hovered close to his car, about 100 feet off the ground. The front was all glass and the rear tapered to a rounded end. He could see some kind of movement within, like someone moving back and forth in front of a light, giving an erratic flashing effect. He discounted the idea of it being a foreign plane. He watched the object fly east and then south around Willard. Other eye witnesses, able to describe the UFO in detail or draw sketches of the object, all agreed on the UFOs appearance. Willard police, Huron County Sheriff's Department and the State Highway Patrol received calls concerning the mysterious sight and a sheriff's deputy and state highway patrolman reported sighting the object twice in southern portions of the county."
