"Philosophy of Life"

WHAT IS LIFE? This question has interested and baffled mankind ever since they reached the point of evolution in which reason manifested itself. By this sensing or reasoning power, he became conscious of the knowledge of something vaster and greater beyond his own powers. He tried to solve the question by delving into what caused life and how it originated. We find coming down through the ages that this subject has made and broken many religions and will continue to do so until the question is

Among the many religions of the past stands out the Phallic religion. This religion seems to us to be very crude and somewhat idiotic on account of the knowledge now reached and attained by mankind. Those people who practiced and followed this religion considered it very sacred and mysterious. When we consider the evolution or progress in which they vibrated or functioned, we are not surprised at the understanding they had reached as being the highest conception they held of life. [The last knowledge we have is only a remnant of the Phallic religion which can be found in the twenty-second verse, second chapter of first Samuel. How long it continued after this time is little known. Perhaps this customary action of the women or virgins was responsible for the many so-called immaculate conceptions in the past. There is no reason to show why God would cast a slur upon heredity, as it was His own handiwork.] Man in the physical has not the power of giving life of his own accord and does not know he has that ability until revealed; and even then he is not the creator of a human life or being, but merely the carrier of the seed of life. The bee carries the pollen of one flower or blossom to another, which impregnates the kind after its kind and the fruit, the apple or berry is the outcome. Now if man is father of the child, then the bee must be the father of the apple. This life which we find in the blossom and mankind was never born and will never die. [You will find in the fourth Genesis and first verse that Eve when she bore Cain said, "I have gotten a man from the Lord." We also find in twenty-fourth verse of the fifth chapter, "And Enoch walked with God and he was not for God took him." This will show clearly that it was not necessary to be of an immaculate conception to become one with God. In other words, Enoch had reached the Christ consciousness (which consciousness is in everybody to be developed) and by so doing realized, "The Father and I are One."] As it was in the past so is it today. The creation or emanation of life is the base to which all religions are anchored and it will continue to make and destroy religions until mankind realizes and

is centered.

When we ask ourselves, "What is Life?" we could truthfully answer that life as we know it in the physical body is an illusion. The first question we would ask ourselves: Who is or what is that looking out or through our eyes. It is not this body. It is not what you have been calling you. Whatever it is, it seems to control and operate the body as it will. It is an entity which seems to function as if it were unlimited and established forever; a something that in your body, your feeling, your senses, gives you the thought and belief that it was never born and will never die. The next illusion we may consider is the voice. We have no such thing as a voice. There is no sound between the speaker and the audience; everything is as silent as the proverbial grave. The speaker inhales or fills his lungs with ether or air and by releasing it gradually just as he wishes to do so and then manipulating certain organs in his throat causes vibrations; and when these vibrations reach the velocity of 32,000 per second or the number in which your ears are tuned, you can then experience the sensation of sound. A bell does not produce sound; all that a bell does is to start vibrations in the air. We will now consider the eye. What is it that causes sight? In delving into the matter, we are surprised to find that we do not actually see any object. There are what are called light bulbs. These bulbs can be seen with the physical eye by anyone who understands how to look for them. There are billions of quintillions of them. These bulbs throw light or reflect light or vibrations from the sun onto the object on which your eye is focused and the object refracts or throws back the light ray. These light rays impinge or fall against or dash upon your eye. Your eye is situated in a bony socket with a small opening at the back. This opening is called the well, at this point a connection through nerves with the brain is made; and through this connection a picture of the object is made through vibrations upon your brain. You now understand that seeing is merely an act of opening the shutter of the camera of the eye, which makes a picture of the object by vibrations. As with the sight, so it is with the hearing. For instance, this room is full of vibrations which we cannot interpret; but put a radio in here and turn it on, and you will find there are numerous vibrations of which we would never dream. There are not only vibrations of sounds, but of colors and thoughts. All these sounds and colors work in octaves; which give us the mystical number seven. Your ears are tuned; that is to say you have a tone or note which predominates all other sound or tone. This accounts for

understands the truth upon which life the reason we like certain tunes, because our tone occurs in them oftener than in others. The mental, or thought, vibrations are swiftest and these vibrations carry thoughts as in telepathy. These thoughts and sounds and colors can be seen by those who can see the ether. There are certain flashes in the ether which can be interpreted by some people, and the ether can be seen by anyone who knows how to look for it. The seeing of the light bulbs and the ether can be taught to anyone. The sun does not give light. All the sun does is to send out vibrations through energy which it produces in the ether at the rate of some trillions per second. When you look into the sun, you first see what is called the corona. This corona has nothing to do with the sun, as it is caused by the sun's vibrations on the light bulbs around the sun. The sun is dark and can be seen by the naked physical eye very plainly and the speed can be seen as it revolves. It revolves right to left when facing it. Should it revolve 300 times per minute, this would be 432,000 per day. Our next step will be to investigate what causes life in the body. We will now examine the position and the functioning of that small particle of the anatomy known as a cell. This cell is embedded in a sponge-like substance called lymph. This lymph is always filled with blood and bathes the cell into it. It also takes away any wornout material or offal and renews the cell with good blood. This lymph can be squeezed and then relaxed when new blood will then rush in and take the place of the old blood which may, through the inaction of the body, become stagnant. 
The line of life is clear and long, with an inner line coming from it showing strong vitality and robustness of constitution.

The type hand bespeaks one sympathetic and sensitive to influences around her, but one able to adapt herself to the moods of those with whom she comes in contact.





The New Prosperity

The Problems of Today Are World-Wide and International

THE DEEPER thinkers in every community view with increasing anxiety the unprecedented and baffling problems that have arisen in recent years, involving all classes and grades of society and every phase and department of life and work.

For statesmen and men of action, political leaders, private citizens and the great rank and file of workers in all lands find themselves struggling helplessly in the turgid waters of the tidal wave of economic depression that has engulfed the whole civilized world. All kinds and conditions of people are at present hopelessly enmeshed in a baffling network of problems and perplexities, caused by the wholesale deflation of values and the consequent economic crisis.

These adverse circumstances throttling business and paralyzing commercial activities everywhere through the destruction of confidence in the minds of moneyed investors and the buying public generally. The resultant stagnation in trade and commerce is destroying initiative and that confident enthusiasm that is the first essential of success in any field of endeavor. It is also rendering individual effort towards a satisfactory readjustment of existing conditions utterly futile and void of the good that is becoming so increasingly necessary to the public welfare. This is because the problems that must be solved before this happy end can be accomplished are too involved and too deep and far-reaching to be dealt with by individuals-no matter how gifted or powerful these may be—or by any isolated group of people in any particular locality. For no matter how wide their field of activity, or how deep their influence in human affairs, small sections of the community in any land can no longer coerce and control the many and diverse factors that now play their part in the destruction or maintenance of sound economic conditions.

For it is only reasonable to conclude that as the most pressing problems of the day are international in scope, or world-wide in their implication, they can only be satisfactorily dealt with through means of wise and concerted action on the part of all concerned. Hence the most imperative need of the world today is for the widespread cultivation of the international mind. People possessing this wide range of vision come to see themselves as citizens of the world and to look upon their own dearly loved country not as a mere isolated unit and sufficient unto itself, but as an indispensable, integral part of the great whole.

Out of this more rational attitude of mind towards world affairs, which is rapidly gaining ground in all lands, will presently emerge some heartening developments which will have deep and

far-reaching results in the stabilizing of business and commerce and in the bettering of social and economic conditions everywhere.

It does not require deeply prophetic vision to foresee these more favorable eventualities even in the midst of the chaotic conditions now prevailing. For they are the obvious outcome of changing and broadening viewpoints which must necessarily result in greatly improved methods of procedure in the conduct of world affairs.

The very scope and severity of the present crisis is sufficient indication of the imperative need for the revision of old ways and means of dealing with grave national and international problems and difficulties. For it is becoming increasingly apparent that unless drastic changes are speedily inaugurated in the conduct of world affairs our present civilization must perish as miserably as earlier civilizations have done, but for dissimilar reasons.

For in the world we live in, though there is widespread poverty and destitution, there is no actual shortage of either necessities or luxuries. In this machine age, production can so readily out-distance demand that there need never be any fear of an insufficiency of any worthwhile commodity. In fact, many people attribute much of our present slackness of trade and commercial stagnation to over-production, but this erroneous conclusion is due to short-sightedness on their part. For until the needs and requirements of the millions now hampered by totally inadequate incomes, or immersed in the direst pover-

ty, are properly filled there can be no question of over-production. It merely resolves itself into a lack of proper distribution due to the insufficient purchasing power of the masses. For it is certainly a distressing commentary on present-day happenings that while our storehouses are bursting with foodstuffs and our shops and warehouses are filled to overflowing with every kind and variety of good and useful products of man's ingenuity and skill, millions upon millions of erstwhile selfrespecting and self-supporting citizens are forced to subsist on the barest necessities of life, bereft of all the pleasant creature comforts that industry so lavishly provides.

These unhappy victims of a lack of foresight and co-operation on the part of political leaders and captains of industry are doomed to dependence upon the charity of their more fortunate fellows, or on a fund obtained by imposing a special levy upon over-burdened taxpayers and under-paid workers.

Thus their bodily needs are provided for in a niggardly fashion, while their spirit of independence is crushed and broken on the wheel of adverse circumstance, hence the self-respect and self-reliance of these unhappy folks gradually perish for lack of proper sustenance.

This wholesale pauperization of intelligent, able-bodied men and women is the inevitable outcome of the prevalence of irrational ideas and the persistence of false concepts with the consequent widespread use of obsolete methods in the conduct of world affairs.

This is due to the fact that the mind and the imagination of the average person have not kept pace with the immense changes of recent times, brought about by the numerous wonderful inventions that make our age unique in history. The indisputable fact that narrow, traditional methods of conducting business and controlling national and international affairs are no longer adequate to meet present-day requirements, has now been too widely demonstrated and too tragically proven to be longer ignored. Hence the recent formation, in all parts of the world, of numerous investigating committees composed of trained and experienced men, experts in each particular branch of industry or governmental control. Thus for the first time in history a definite, concerted attempt is being made to view existing conditions as a whole, rather than in part, as formerly.

Through the free exchange of ideas among the various groups studying different phases of the economic situation will presently emerge new and more efficient methods of controlling world markets and stabilizing industry.

A Quake Is Born

A ND she poses the Moon watery and the fiery Mars, all placed deep in the earth. Venus is a moist planet; she is in a watery Sign, and she opposes Neptune, ruler of the sea. The Moon, ruler of waters, and Mars, the God


of fire: here indeed is a significant combination. The waters of the sea in the depths of the earth in contact with fiery elements, causing abundant Jupiter disturbances in the Earth.

And, as if this were not enough, we find Jupiter in Virgo, in almost direct opposition to the Sun; here we have two powerful influences in the Solar System in direct antagonism with the greater force in the house of the people. The Sun, working from the Scorpio or death Decanate of Pisces in House VII, and Jupiter working from the Saturn Decanate of Virgo on the Cusp of House I. The two forces are in deadly antagonism. Saturn is out of orb to Jupiter. It is separating, however from a quintile aspect, having probably some influence in the agitation of the Earth; the quintile, means agitation.

HOUSE II-Libra, ruled by Venus, at the Second Decanate subruled by Uranus. This is the Aquarius Decanate and refers to man. Uranus is placed in the Sagittarius Decanate of Aries in House VIII, in the twenty-first degree, which, according to Alan Leo, refers to sextons and undertakers. It is further noteworthy that the Sign Sagittarius holds the Cusp of House IV, which is the house of the foundation. The earthquake came as an abundance of good luck to undertakers. Uranus in the eighth, or death house in the grave Decanate of this Horoscope: we also note that these deaths were sudden (Uranus) and that they were caused by injuries to the head (Aries).

But the main influence having rule over the Second House, is Venus, which indicates that the accumulation of this earthquake (Second House) was one of sadness and sorrow (Pisces) through the action of the (Neptune Decanate), on a pliable portion of the earth, (Virgo, a Common Sign).

HOUSE III—Scorpio, ruled by Mars; the Pisces Decanate, subruled by Neptune, holds the Cusp; both in House XII. Bewilderment (Neptune) and (Mars) destruction because of secret

enemies, (House XII) were the associated factors in this catastrophe.

HOUSE IV-Sagittarius, ruled by Jupiter at the Aries Decanate, ruled by Mars. The Fourth House, is the house of the foundation, as well as the end. It is also the house of the Father. From him arises the initiatory impulse, that takes form in the house of the mother. Jupiter lies at the foundation of this problem and he works on a Martian wave length. We find him in the Capricorn Decanate of Virgo. Mars is in the same Sign. Sagittarius is in a Fiery Sign, Mars is a Fiery Planet, while Jupiter in the eighteenth degree of Virgo, thinks slightingly of his best friends; he is on a sick degree in the Sign of sickness, in the decanate of heavy labor (Hercules), and through the ray that he casts to the Martian Decanate of his home Sign Sagittarius, and to his own Decanate in the house of death (House VIII) and to the sudden and explosive Uranus: we have a picture of Cosmic force in action.

HOUSE V—Capricorn ruled by Saturn. The Cusp is held by the Taurus or Venus Decanate. Saturn is in House V, in the Gemini Decanate of Aquarius which is subruled by Mercury, in the Mars Decanate of Aries.

Saturn in the Libra Decanate is connected with the Libra Decanate at the Midheaven and on the Second House; and we find Venus the subruler of these

decanates in the Sign of hospitals (Pisces) in the Decanate of Mystery (Neptune) and in the house of sickness (House VI). Venus is most terribly afflicted, being opposed by an entire group of Planets in House XII. While Saturn, the ruler of the Cusp of House V, is almost entirely unaspected and therefore weak. The earthquake itself was not a Saturnine affair. But as we have seen in our study of House I, the offspring of the earthquake was decidedly Saturnine.

I anticipate questions concerning my analysis of House V in the Horoscope. I will therefore, at the risk of boring, restate the steps upon which I base my conclusions. If House IV represents the Father or the initiating force, then House X represents the Mother, or forming matrix. If Jupiter, through the Mars Decanate of Sagittarius, Fathers the Quake, then, Mercury, through the Venus Decanate of Gemini, Mothers it. The Ascendant then, pictures what the Nader and the Midheaven have brought forth. And I wish to note that the Ascendant is almost exactly square to both the Nader and the M. C. The earthquake is a birth or a manifestation of Fire (Sagittarius) and Air (Gemini) expressed in Earth, (Virgo). Considering the earthquake as an entity, its results are its offspring and these we find in House V (House of children).

The Phantom Arms

I FIRST MET Fred Wilson in South Africa, in the hotel at a place called Crooked Stream, not far from Kimberley. I had for some months been trying to find gold or diamonds by digging holes in the veldt. But since this has little or nothing to do with the story, I pass by my mining adventures and come back to the hotel. I came to it very readily that afternoon, for I was very thirsty.

A tall man standing at the bar turned his head as I entered and said "Goodday" to me. I returned the compliment, but took no particular notice of him at first. Suddenly I heard the man say to the barman: "I'm ready for another drink."

That surprised me, because his glass was still three-quarters full. But I was still more amazed by the action of the barman who lifted up the glass and held it while the man drank. Then I saw the reason. The man had no arms.

You know the easy way in which men chum together anywhere out of their native land? I made some remark to Wilson which led to another from him, and in five minutes' time we were chatting on all sorts of topics. I learned that Wilson, bound for England, had come to Crooked Stream to catch the train from Kimberley, and, having a few hours to wait, had strolled up to the collection of corrugated iron shacks calling itself a town. I was going down to Kimberley, too, so of course we went together, and we were quite old friends by the time we reached that city.

We had a wash and something to eat, and then we walked around to the post office. I found several letters, one of which altered the whole course of my life. It informed me that a wealthy uncle had died, leaving the bulk of his wealth to me.

The first thing I did was to send two cablegrams to say that I was returning to England immediately, one to the lawyers who had notified me of the windfall, the other to my fiancee, Peggy Dorman.

Wilson and I arranged to come home together and eventually reached Cape Town. There we had considerable trouble at the shipping office. It was just about the time of year when people who live in Africa to make money come over to England to spend it, and in consequence the boats were very crowded. Wilson demanded a cabin to himself, a luxury which was not to be had, though there was one that he and I could share. He made a tremendous fuss doing this, and I thought it very strange, because I had assisted him in many ways which his mutilation rendered necessary. However, he had to give way in the end, and we embarked on the liner.

You see, I could only eat plants and
leaves and such fruit as I came across;
but I had learned as much as I could of
the local botany in the intervals."

"Was it worth while?" I asked. "I think the first failure and its results would have satisfied me." "Yes," he said slowly, "it was worth while. You see, my wife was waiting for me at home, and I wanted to see her again very badly—you don't know how badly."

"I think I can imagine," I said, "because there is a girl waiting for me, too, at home."

A Quake Is Born—(Continued from page 11)

The offspring of the earthquake is marked by the Taurus, or money Decanate of the Sign Capricorn. The keyword of the Decanate is "martyrdom." It is the Fixed Decanate of the Goat. It is an outstanding fact that the earthquake knocked down chiefly places of business. But the analysis of House V goes still further, for Satan (Saturn) is there also. Saturn is placed in the Gemini Decanate of Aquarius. Aquarius means man and Gemini rules buildings and Cities. We may therefore read the entire ensemble, as, the child of the quake is the sudden destruction (Uranus, ruler of Aquarius, in the Mars Sign Aries, and in the Jupiter Decanate) of the business and wealth, (Capricorn and Taurus Decanate) of cities (Saturn the builder, in the Gemini Decanate of Aquarius) because of the sick condition of the Cosmic Mother (Venus in the house of sickness and in the Sign of sorrow), causing her to give birth to a daughter (Taurus Decanate of Virgo on the Ascendant) whose offspring is marked by House V.

Before leaving this subject I wish to call attention to a few subsidiary factors with reference to House X. It is significant that Pluto is there, in the Pisces Decanate of the Sign Cancer. Cancer is ruled by the Moon, and Pluto is as yet a vagrant in the Solar System. As Cancer is the natural ruler of House IV and refers to the waters in and under the earth; and as Pluto is the God of the underworld, it seems to me that in the birth of this earthquake we may consider Pluto as the doctor attending the Mother, while we may look upon the moon as the nurse at her sickbed (Virgo) in the hospital (House XII).

HOUSE VI-Aquarius, ruled by Uranus in House VIII. The Libra or Venus Decanate holds the Cusp. Venus is afflicted in Pisces, in the house of sickness and Uranus, the chief ruler of the Cusp, is in the Morgue of the Zodiac (House VIII). As already indicated, Uranus is in the Sagittarius Decanate of the Sign Aries, throwing a ray to the Cusp of the Fourth House. He is on the Twenty-second Degree, which calls attention to the human (Aquarius) folly (twenty-second degree) in matters of propaganda (Third Decanate of Aries) concerning public money, (House VII), which caused mental (Aquarius) suffering (House VI) of a depressive (Third Decanate of Aquarius) nature, eventuating in the illness of the human race (Aquarius on the Cusp of House VI) separating them from their bread, (Venus in opposition to Mars, Moon and Neptune) on the house of bread (House XII) and enveloping them in sorrow (Neptune the ruler of Pisces, opposing Venus from House XII), this resulted in the sudden death of man (Aquarius ruled by Uranus) through injuries to the head (Uranus in Aries, in the House of death, House VIII).

HOUSE VII—Pisces ruled by Neptune in House XII. The Scorpio Decanate ruled by Mars also in House XII, holds the Cusp. The Sun is placed almost exactly on the Cusp. He is just

setting and is in powerful position, but in a weak Sign.

As the Sun is the heart of any matter, the basic principle underlying all phenomena, we are surprised to find him at the foundation of the People's House. This would suggest that the ultimate cause of suffering wrought by the earthquake was in Man and not in Earth. The Sun, as well as the Cusp of the Seventh House is in Scorpio or death Decanate of the prison Sign Pisces. Neptune, the ruler of Pisces, is in conjunction with Mars, the ruler of the Decanate in the House of Secret Enmity. Pisces is a psychic Sign, while Scorpio deals with the denizens in the realm of the dead. Pisces is emotional; Scorpio is desirous, the Sun is power. It would seem that death resulted from the powerful emotional desires on the part of mentally (Virgo) imprisoned (House XII) forces of anger (Mars) worry (Moon) and astral obsession (Neptune), ending in (Dragons Tail, conjunct Mars) the work of death (Scorpio Decanate).

I fully realize that this analysis is not according to geologists. I realize that they maintain that our thoughts are so weak as to have no influence upon anything; but I am not practicing geology, I am observing planetary positions and I am giving expression to what I see and to the natural conclusions that follow from what I see, as I study the map before me.

Not only is the Sun in the House of the Public, but he is in direct opposition to Jupiter, the Father of the Quake. The Sun rules Will, and Jupiter Authority. The Sun is the King and Jupiter the Priest. At the time of the earthquake there was a powerful antagonism between the forces of Will and Desire, involving death (Scorpio) and sorrow (Pisces) because of antagonism between man and the Earth Spirit (Ascendant) giving rise to an abundance (Jupiter) of motion (Movable or Capricorn Decanate of Virgo) in the Earth (Ascendant).

Another important if not outstanding fact, is that the ruler of the chart (Mercury) is also in the House of the Public. This would indicate that man was his own enemy (House VII). Mercury is in Aries, in the Mars Decanate, and is in quintile, or agitation aspect to Mars. There is Mutual Reception between these two planets which strengthens the aspect. There was much mental and nervous agitation, resulting in affliction to the people (Moon) and in vague and unreasoned fear (Neptune), all of which adversely aspect Mercury, the ruling Planet. The Horoscope says that we are mentally responsible for our afflictions.

HOUSE VIII—Aries ruled by Mars, in House XII. The Leo Decanate holds the Cusp and Leo is on the Cusp of House XII. House XII governs losses. House VIII, death and public money, while Uranus in this house in adverse aspect to Jupiter and Pluto indicates sudden loss of life and property.

HOUSE IX-Taurus ruled by Venus,

in House VI, the Second or Virgo Decanate holds the Cusp. This Decanate is subruled by Mercury, and House IX is sensitive to Sagittarius. Here we find the higher aspect of the matter. Taurus rules Money. Virgo rules Business. The mind (Mercury) is angry (Aries). The emotions (Venus) are sorrowful (Pisces) and sick (House VI). Religion (Jupiter) has lost its power (opposition to the Sun). It has sold out (Capricorn Decanate of Virgo) to business (Taurus Decanate of Virgo at the Ascendant). The higher mind of the Cosmos reflects the bewilderment of man. Or, is it that the bewilderment of man, mirrors a battle in the Soul of the Cosmos—I wonder?

House X—Gemini, ruled by Mercury in House VII. The Cusp is supported by the Fixed Stars Cappella and Rigel. The Second or Libra Decanate holds the Cusp. Pluto is just leaving the House. Every Astrologer knows that the Midheaven is an important point. It is the point of business, as well as the house of the Mother. Business is the plan side of work, creative preparation. In this case we are dealing with divided forces. Gemini is a Human Sign and rules the lower mind. It refers to the objective reasoning of the animal soul. "Simeon and Levi are brethren. Instruments of cruelty are in their habitation." Mercury, the ruler of the Sign, agitates Mars, in the House of Poverty (House XII). War talk was rampant throughout the world and the banks were closed. There was a mighty mental strain, and love (Venus) the modifier of mind (Mercury) was sick-a-bed (House VI) and in the hospital (Sign Pisces) making faces at the War God (Mars), tangled up in the Stock Exchange, (Virgo in the House XII). At the same time the Sun (Power) formed an obstacle (Square aspect to the midheaven) cutting off the inner light from the objective mind (Gemini) throwing the balance of power to Jupiter, who, as we have seen, is hopelessly afflicted.

We have already considered House X as the Mother, so that it is not necessary to carry this thought further. At this time I wish to call attention to the fact that the business of this quake was Mental and Human. The only reason the quake did damage was because of what we see at the Cusp of House II, which governs money. Here we find, Love (Venus) of Wealth (House II) on the part of men (Aquarius Decanate), and it is a well-known fact that faulty and cheap construction was man's selfcreated enemy, under the earthquake. We also find that the sickness, or labor of this earthquake is marked by the Sign of man (Aquarius) and the Libra Decanate holds the Cusp of House II. The earthquake in itself was inoffensive, but as we have said, man's ignorance and greed caused all the trouble. It was the dominance of the lower mind (Sign Gemini, at the Midheaven) in matters of construction of cities (ruled by Gemini) and not necessarily the

This was the great event in the age of Cancer, leading up to the movement of this great body of souls to another planet. In Thessalonians first book and fourth chapter, gives us the picture of our future transmutation, when we shall follow them. Noah and his family escaped to carry on and no souls were lost by the Flood, for it says Noah was a just man and perfect in his generation, and Noah walked with God. There were no souls living upon the continent Atlantis at the time it was lowered into the ocean bed.

GEMINI AGE

This age dates back to between 6000 and 4000 B. C., the point where the Bible is dated. Gemini—Air—symbolized by two pillars—the twins—duality. The ruler of this 2160-year period or age is Mercury and its sub-ruler or opposite pole is Sagittarius—Fire—and the great animal sign manifesting in the outer world. Jupiter, that planet of wisdom and religion and philosophy, appears here as the ruler of this opposite sign which is fire. Here the serpent appeared. Genesis, third chapter, first verse and on. The earliest monument dealing with the subject of these pillars of Gemini is a Babylonian cylinder of chlorite in the British Museum. In this is shown a tree with horizontal branches hanging with two round bunches of fruit, a date palm with dates. Upon either side of the trunk a man and a woman, as the twins of Gemini, are extending their hands for the fruit. Behind the woman a serpent stands erect upon its tail. This serpent is symbolic of Mercury, the winged messenger of the gods, carrying this wisdom of religious Jupiter in the undulating movements of the serpent. These two pillars of Gemini and the male and female principal are the portals of the temple of Humanity, through which we all have passed and will pass again and again as we progress to the end of our pilgrimage. These twin warriors are the symbols of the ever-contending forces of creation and destruction, attraction and repulsion, decay and renewal of Life and Death. This serpent, undulating wisdom to Adam and Eve, is telling Eve that to partake of this wisdom, or apples of knowledge she would not surely die, but that through much knowledge their eyes should be opened.

Astrology teaches us that in this Gemini period mentioned here, Gemini being a literary and educational sign with Mercury as a messenger of the gods undulating wisdom through the serpent, the race would make great intellectual advancement and become religious through its co-worker Sagittarius and Jupiter. 

firm as if in a cateleptic state. This cat is only squeezing the lymph and causing new blood to course through her veins and thereby giving new life to the cells. Try this method yourself. It will renew the blood cells because when you stretch you contract the lymph and cells and squeeze them together like you would a sponge, and when you relax you open them all up again and cause new blood to flow through them. There is no reason known to mankind for a body to die, neither psychological or chemical. You do not die for the want of life; you die because you fail to get rid of impurities and waste matter. Eliminate the waste from your body and cleanse the cells by stretching and other methods physical and mental and you will live forever. It is the cells that are doing the work of living and they are the first visible life given out from the Creator of all. The birds shed their feathers, the animals their furs, the snakes their skins and the shell fish their shells, and your body is renewed every eleven months or so. We grow old not because we wear out, but because we rust out. The blood is coursing through our veins and penetrating every particle of the body, carrying oxygen and power to every cell, thereby renewing each cell and taking away the discarded matter as the cell duplicates itself. When the blood is pure and operated systematically the cells are then in a state of vibrant health and under these circumstances would live forever, provided the blood removed and took away all impurities. In this case the cell is depending on the blood for its life-giving energy. This makes the blood as important as the cell, if not more so. In speaking of the blood coursing through the body, we find it is depending on the effort or action of the heart and without this action the circulation of the blood would cease. The heart takes the blood and forces it into channels whereby oxygen is taken in and by so doing renews it. This action of the heart is all-important to the circulation of the blood as there is no possibility of the blood energizing the body only by this process. This being the case makes the heart supreme and consequently is a greater and higher power than the blood. One would be led to think that the heart was the ruler and giver of life to the body. We find the heart has to depend on the action of the lungs and receives its fuel or energy from them. This makes the heart depend upon the lungs for its life and thereby gives the lungs a higher position than the heart, making the lungs the most important organs of the body.

This brings the situation to the point of investigating the action of the lungs. We find they are depending upon something from this power which we know is air or ether. What is air or ether? Do we see it? Yes, some people see it. It is not so very hard to see when one knows how to look for it. Can you feel it? Yes, you can feel it. There is a way in which you can charge your body, and so fill it, that you can feel it passing through different points which will heat or cool your body according to your will. You can feel this power coming out of your hand so much so that it is not unusual to hear it rushing through. There is always a power or fluid or gas going out of the tops of your fingers; as a rule, it extends onehalf to three-quarters of an inch. It can be felt passing through any time and is seen by some people. This air or ether is a wonderful force, and is made up of so-called electrons. Why it is called electrons I do not know, because it has nothing to do with electricity. It is a vibration very subtle, ever moving and elusive. It is that, in which we breathe, in which we live, in which we move and have our being. The lungs depend upon this air or ether and without it would not and could not function. This places the ether or electron master of the body, because the lungs are useless without it. It makes the lungs operate. It starts the heart going, which circulates the blood with its life-given properties; it bathes the cells without which they cannot function. Science has resolved electrons the base of all material, but has failed to define the intelligence possessed by each electron. This electron is forever moving. If you take away or stop this movement then there is no electron. If an electron moves it must have intelligence or be operated by intelligence from another force. Nothing can move without intelligence. In that case the electron is but a movement or intelligence. In speaking of intelligence we are speaking of something which is not complete in itself and is an action or force which flows from some center. That being so, intelligence can only flow or emanate from a mind. Every electron possesses this intelligence, also it exists in every combination of electrons. From a material standpoint we have electrons as the base of all manifestation. From the metaphysical standpoint we have mind. The two are one and indivisible. No matter to what part of the universe we may go, we see the electronic movement which claims it a universal force. This intelligence or life force since it is the base of all matter of which everything is made must emanate from a universal mind, as it fills all space in the universe.
