## EDITORIAL

 THE COMPREHENSIVE VIEW NEEDED.

In several Magzines lately one has read of folk who like as everywhere expressing themselves thus,.. " We haven't had many sightings lately".... " Do you thinl they have st pped coming for a while. ?". and the like, and if one were to judhe sigiting phenomena by local bursts which seem to occur only in bursts to be followed by apparent lengthy periods of non- observation then it could rightly be said there have not been many around.

This also can apply to a whole country such as one as large as Australia, although we have had our share. The fault lies in having an insular view of things and not taking intoaccount the picture as a whole rather than that which is near at hand.

The collection of data which flows into this H.Q. is sufficient proof to establish beyond doubt that there is hardly a month goes by but that good sightings have been had at least in some country and often in several. thus proving that although the local sightings may be few or only come in bursts, that taken as a whole there are Flying Saucers around this world pretty often and most frequent. and therefore the surmise that engenders the above remarks are not at all well founded, and only limited because of the lack of the comprehensive view.

It has been stated before that the whole of this work and the assessment of the facts from sightings is everywhere the same .. i.e. dependant of the amount of information recieved as in all work of investigation . and in this work we have to admit that we too often are hindered by the general apathy of the public, the lack of co-operation fr m Official bodies as well as the press. who we are well aware recieve much more reports than are made public. or considered by them as worth while giving space to. This and the lack of desire by many observers to be implicated publicly in this matter and often to get treated as suffering from all sorts of mental hallucinations etc. and their evidence deliberately falsified at times.

All these facts go to make up the loss of potential excellent data to enable the true picture to be portayed. hence this lack of information must be taken into account if we are to be correct in our evaluations.

It therefore seems that before we accept the view that sightings appear only at intermittent periods. we must look with the wide open view at the whole arena taking into account that the hindrances we have in our own country through the above mentioned lack of reports being recieved. that in every country the same problem faces the investigator, hence collected all together there may well be much evidence to prove that the sightings are NOT so much coming in bursts, as that theyare much more frequent than is thought to be. and therefore must be assessed in the light of a percentage being added to th se known and reported ones to place the figures in their right perspective.

Fortunately in some countries much more open co-operation is now being recieved than in others. as is instanced in the sighting received fromAustria and reported in this edition. where quite a few governmental departments assisted by co-operating and supplying evidence which they had to hand. and this being very carefully assembled together and reported with all the other factors by the most capable local Flying Saucer group.

Strangely it seems that the European countries are of late giving more open support to the local societies in their work of investigation, and co-operating much more in supplying data, as against the British authorities and the USA who seem to delight in throwing spanners of all sorts in the works. Some of which are too silly for words in their explanations which they expect us to accept and believe. Here in Australia it is probably much our own fault that we do not get the co-operation from official sources, mainly due to the fact that they are well aware that we are very much disunited and almost at times mistrusting each other so much that no true possible picture can be remotely assessed, through this very lack of co-operation among ourselves. How then can we here expect officialdom to be inspired with our behaviour or trust us with documentary evidence. It is only to be expected that they will treat us like a lot of school kids fighting over a ball. Possibly this applies to other countries also, but we cannot sling mud until we clean our own backyard.

This brings us then to the greater necessity of Unity in our own local areas and unity with our world wide workers, and this phase seems to be very much in good working order. Information flowing from all sources quite freely indicate that the trouble is not so much internationally among groups but nationally and local, and it seems about time we took a good look at ourselves in this regard and made some real effort to put these weaknesses in our machinery right. The British folk have taken a good lead already in this and it is to be hoped they will be able to show us that such unity amongst diverse groups as they have is not only possible but indeed workable. In this way can we then gather the ~~collective~~ information necessary, and get the correct comprehensive view of just what and how and why of our visitors from Space, and do a job we might well be proud of and benefit our fellow men in the doing thereof.

## WAS THE JOYITA ANOTHER MARIE CELESTE.?

The mystery of the crew of the Marie Celeste has never been explained- it has become a classic sea mystery of all time.

But I believe that all the circumstances of all the crews disappearance can be explained by a visit from a flying saucer . And the case of the Joyita's crew, which disappeared late in 1955 in the Pacific , has many amazing parallels.

After reading the whole story of how the Celeste was discovered in 1872 off the Portuguese coast under full sail with her entire crew missing and completely unaccounted for, it cannot be denied that a curse enshrouded this unhappy vessel. The dramatic disappearance of her crew is vital to our present theme. And just as vital is the JOYITA case.

These vessels are only two of many spread over a long period of time whose crews have vanished in strange circumstances.

Take the Marie Celeste : There are several facts which I wish to stress. First, the upper rigging of the ship was slightly damaged as if some unusual accident or activity took place there. Then, the compass was damaged.

Aside from these, there was no note of disarray or struggle. Life had departed from the ship instantly, apparently with all the routine activity interrupted and no preparations made : log book on table, clothing in order, sails set, galley undisturbed--but no records in the log or anywhere else.

The present court of enquiry into the disappearance of the Joyita has been hamstrung by similar frustrating features.

There was no sign of disorder or panic on the vessel . The crew was there one minute, gone the next .

Before I supply what I believe to be the solution to this we must consider several other sea mysteries for points of similarity.

Here is another case of recent date .

On a calm fine day, early in Feb. 1948, the Dutch vessel S.S. Ourang Medan was passing through the Straits of Malacca in the East Indies when it sent out a distress call.

Rescue ships from the Dutch Sumatra and British Malaya rushed to the vessel in distress.

When they found her and boarding parties reached the Ourang Medan they found an eerie sight. There wasn't a living creature in the ship.

The Captain lay dead on the bridge. The bodies of the other officers sprawled in the wheelhouse , chartroom and wardroom .. The faithful " Sparks" was slumped in a chair in the radio shack, his hand still on the key.

The bodies of the hapless crew lay everywhere : in their rooms . And on all the dead faces was a look of convulsive horror.

But strangely there was no sign of wounds or injuries on any of the bodies . The would-be rescuers decided to put a towline on to the unlucky vessel and take her into port . But at the very moment smoke and flames belched forth from the No 4 hold . The fire was so immediately hot and so wide spread that it was impossible to subdue it.

From that day to this no one has ever been able to determine what happened to

this unfortunate ship or to her officers and crew.

Damage aloft is a common feature of these events and clearly indicates activity above the ship or at least above its decks.

May I also suggest that there seems to be atendency for selectivity toward sailing vessles?. And don't overlook the fact that some of these ships disappeared in the era of wireless and radio- disappearing so suddenly that it was impossible in most cases to radio for help to announce impending disaster .

Now-- Let's peer into the records a bit closer. First the crew. Do you begin to see a pattern?. Complete and sudden disappearance, with no time to leave records of any kind, from a ship under sail, often in calm weather .

A very high order of selectivity-- so high as to require " purposefulness". There seems a dexterity for segregation beyond the capability of natural forces. But of course! The open seas provide an easy catching place.

One thing stand out above all others. All these disappearances are almost impossible to explain except as upwards.

All disappearances , including that of the Joyita, can be expalined in this way. In some of these disasters the disappearance of the crew is but one phase, and there is evidence of continued application of intelligence-- from above.

As if the force , which abducted the crew , might have some element of compassion for the owners of the cargo . the unfortunate ship was brought carefully to shore, and gently grounded, high on the sand, "miraculously" , as if lifted by giant hands".

What better description can there be of a ship being levitated by an intelligently directed force from above?.

Are we forever to keep on attributing these disasters with their dexterity and selectivity to untutored storms and whirlwinds?.

There is also a suggestion of ruthlessness- sel ctive- ruthlessness. There is something of evasion , or secretiveness.

To attempt to postulate motive for space inhabitants kidnapping crews from ships is pure speculation, but if, as I have suggested . space contrivances originated in an ancient period of our civilization long since destroyed, and that those seen in recent years are survivors of that destruction, it seems reasonable to suppose that our space friends want to know what has happened to us. On the other hand , bearing our two possibilities in mind as to the origin of space contrivances , in either case our space friends would want to know what has happened to us since they left, or what has happened to us since they put us down here.

#### PLANETARY TILT OF THE EARTH ..

Harpers Magazine of Dec. 1963 has an article written by Donald Menzel. ( our old sun-dog explanation friend ) in which is a rejoinder to Eric Larrabee's article of August 1963, discussing Velikovsky's book " WORLDS IN COLLISION" .. It appears that the phenomena of the Earth's slowing down and the sun's chnaging magnetic poles reported some time ago, have brought to the top attention Velikovsky's work written 15 years ago, in this he mentioned that this precise phenomena would precede a planetary tilt.

## Flying Saucer Chases Boy near Mt. Vernon.

The following account is taken from R.J. Gribbles NICAP Magazine of Dec 1963 Vol 2. No 3.

Keenes Boy Chased. Home by UFO. : Police Called. Boy given sedation to quiet his nerves. after incident-----

An 18 year old Keenes boy was chased home Sunday night by a UFO or some other unknown heavenly body ! The whole neighbourhood out his way is talking about it . The lad was so frightened he ran into his home , awakened his father and mother , and when his dad saw it he ran inside for his shotgun .

They wondered if it may be some invading force from Mars...or Russia.

When the father displayed his gun , the object seemed to come closer.

So the family ran back into the house ... gathered in the kitchen and turned out the lights . Quickly they called the police at Mt Vernon. Fairfield police were notified to keep watch . At first the police thought they were joking. Among the officers rushing to the scene was Deputy Sheriff Harry Lee of Fairfield .

" It was different to anything I ever saw, " said Mr. Lee.

" It was up in the sky to the southeast at about 45 deg. angle . I couldn't make any form to it, except that of a big round light, something like a star, although it didn't flicker any," deputy Lee said. " It was moving upward and to the southeast and kept this general direction " When asked what it was, the deputy just shook his head in wonderment .

The boy who first saw the object was Ronnie Austin, son of Mr and Mrs Orville Austin , who lives west of the "Big Store" in Hickory Hill township.

Ronnie and his girl friend , Miss Phyliss Bruce, were returning home about eleven o'clock from the drive -in movie at Mt Vernon when they noticed it through the door window of their car. " It was white and round and about the size of an automobile , " said Ronnie in describing the object to a press reporter. " It just soared along over the tree tops. We could tell it wasn't an airplane . Every once in a while it would swoop over toward our car.

I tried to get away from it," continued Ronnie. " But when I'd speed up, it'd speed up; when I'd slow down , I'd slow down . I drove up to 120 miles an hour but it stayed right with us. We were scared to death ." A Press reporter hastened to the Austin neighbourhood early Monday morning .

A neighbour Mrs ~~Wright~~ Withrow , was excited about the happenings. She was called during the night to view the object. " It was ten times brighter than the moon, she said, " and much bigger than a star." Roxie Austin, Ronnie's sister , was talking about the event. She described the object as " having a white glow with some sort of an object projecting from it."

Ronnie's grandmother, Mrs Ebbie Austin, was also excited about the affair. when interviewed she said " That boy's about to have a nervous breakdown,, There's such a thing as a person being scared to death.. I'm worried about him. I know there was something wrong last night...our dogs yelped and barked all night long. The boy's mother is an inspector at Airtex Products in Fairfield She said she had no idea what the object was, but that it came far too close to their home for comfort. Asked if they discussed the incident at breakfast this morning , she exclaimed, " Breakfast! We were so excited we didn't even have any." Mrs. Austin is a daughter of Curt Tyler of Wayne City.

Ronnie told the reporter that the object at one time turned from white to a yellow glow. He said it seemed to give off a cool feeling once when it passed over his car. A crowd of 25 or more gathered out there around the Austin home to view the object at different times during the night.

Village Marshall George Sexton, of Wayne City, rushed to the scene.

He said when he arrived he saw nothing more than what appeared to him to be the Morning Star. He said Ronnie became so excited while he was there that he had to be carried into the house. State Trooper Richard Gidcumb, of McLeansboro, told the press he saw a strong light flash across the sky on Sunday night, but he seemed to question the flying object story the boy told. Ronnie's girl friend, who viewed the phenomenon with him, is Phyliss Bruce. Police Radio Operator Kenneth Talbot said he watched it in the south-eastern sky until 4:30. "It looked like a cross in the heavens to me," said Mr Talbot.

Mike Hill of Fairfield, told friends he was up at midnight, and noticed an unusually bright and brilliant light in the south-eastern sky.

The boy relates what happened.

Ronnie Austin, gave the Press the following exclusive account of what happened Sunday Night: My girl friend, Phyliss Bruce and I had driven to Mt. Vernon and attended a drive-in movie. We saw the show, "The Escape" an exciting picture of a German prison camp. About eleven o'clock we headed out of Mt. Vernon east on route 15 mile for home. Phyliss had gotten angry at me and as we drove along east past the airport I leaned over to speak to her and when I looked out the car window to the south I saw this big white object moving along just over the tree tops. It looked as big as an automobile. I said to Phyliss, "Look there at that thing, what is it an airplane?"

Phyliss looked out and replied, "No, it's not an airplane.. it doesn't have the flashing red and green lights." Then jokingly, I remarked, "Maybe it's some little red and green men from Mars coming to get us."

When I said that I did not realize the exciting experience that was about to be ours. "When I'd speed up the car the object would speed up also. When I slowed down it slowed down. My car is built for racing and at one point I drove 120 miles an hour and it stayed right with me. At first it was south side of the road and then it passed over in front of me to the north side. One time it came within a hundred feet of the car. I had my radio tuned to WLS.. I thought they'd announce if some foreign attack was underway. When the thing crossed over my car the radio went crazy... it made all kinds of sounds so I turned it off.

When we reached my girl friends place her sister, Forrestine, got up and came outside and looked at it. And all of a sudden it started moving closer so we ran inside, turned the lights out and watched it through the window. Finally, I had to go home so I made a run for the car. That's when the fun really began. Soon as I pulled away from the house the object began to follow. Me or my car seemed to attract it. I really poured the coal to the car and I must have been doing a 120 when I topped the hill on the gravel road not far from our place. I was coming into a dead end spot in the highway and the object seemed to exert

some strange force on my car, otherwise I would have never been able to make the turn . It slowed me down at an unbelieveable rate of speed . The the thing came straight toward me and hovered over my car. My car engine started to miss it wouldn't hardly go.. finally the motor died. I didn't know what was going to happen then . Then the light moved over to the side of the highway, overhead, and my car started. I raced for home. I ran inside and woke up dad and mom. They thought I was drunk or had gone crazy. Dad ran outside and took one look and ran back inside for his gun. He has a 12 guage Remington automatic. When the object saw the gun it moved right toward us. We ran back inside. Dad got us all into the kitchen and turned off the lights. He called the police at Mt. Vernon. First the phone was dead, but on a second try he got through . The police at first, thought we were joking. At this point I was so excited the folks saw I needed medical attention so they called Dr. Konarski at Fairfield and he told them what to give me. When the police arrived they saw the strange object, too. Two of my buddies, Gary Karacher and Tom Kissner stayed there and watched it all night. It was still visible when the sun came up about 4 o'clock this morning. The object was round and moved with the most usgodly speed I ever saw.. I can't imagine waht it was.

The above account is very similar to those which occurred here in South Aust. a few months later , although not perhaps so dramatic, yet in each case the object hovered etc over cars. as the South Aust. incidents occurred in V y - 72. same month there is naturally some question as to whether there was some connection. The dates of the Mt. Gambier incidents were from 17th to 20th May later followed a few days later by another at Sandycreek a few days later. and although there is several hundreda of miles from each point. it appears there was some connection of these. Now with this evidence before us. Is it possible that there was a flap of saucer sightings about that time, each of which behaved similarly in regard to cars. ?.

We leave the above for our readers to ponder and welcome comments.

ANOTHER CAR CHASING INCIDENT IN  
SOUTH AUSTRALIA.

The previous article re the young man in his car being chased by a Saucer had only been stencilled. a few weeks when the following was reported in the Adelaide "Advertiser" and strangely it has occurred again down in the very area mentioned of the incident in this State last year of car chasing. here is the latest. One thing however is we think important to note and would be worth while for comparison is that this area in S. Aust so frequently visited is the site of one large extinct volcano, Mt Gambier being a large volcano which has been filled in by a large Lake known as the Blue lake because of its strange habit of appearing "blue" this phenomena being more particularly noticed at certain times of the year. There are six other extinct volcanoes also in that area of the country.

It appears therefore that the theory held by many and that of your Editor viz that saucers do make their visits in such weak faults of the earths crust This is particularly so as far as South Australia is concerned, and it seems that a general study of this would be worth giving consideration to by the world wide clubs to see how many of these sightings are found along such lines here in Australia your Editor has proved almost that the greatest number of sightings in this country at least have been along and around such weak fault areas. Why not let us get our heads together on this.

Here is the report as given in the "Advertiser"

Adelaide 22/2/64

" MANY SEE OBJECTS "

Flying objects in the Adelaide sky, seen by many people last night, turned out to be a cylindrical weather balloon- but sightings in the morning and a " 200 ft. object" reported from the South-East on Thursday night, have not been explained.

Last night a Croydon ( near Adelaide ) youth spotted a " reddish-brown, football shaped thing" in the sky about 8. p.m. He telephoned the "Advertiser"

Soon afterwards , a primary school teacher of Payneham. phoned to report a dull glowing object hovering in the sky soon after 8.p.m. moving toward the Adelaide Hills . Town men at Blackwood also reported seeing it.

A spokesman for the meteorological station at Adelaide Air port said last night that a white weather balloon 7. ft. by 5 ft. and cylindrical in shape had been released between 8. p.m. and 8. 30. p.m.

" It could have been given a reddish- brown glow by the city lights," he said " It was carried toward the foothills by south-south- west winds of between five and 10 knots below 5,000ft .

Six reports of objects in the sky early yesterday morning varied from " bright flying discs" with dark edges, seen at 6.45. by four men working at the Mile End Railway yards, to a bright light seen at 5.15 by two Elizabeth police men on patrol.

On Thursday evening. a South East grazier--- his voice shaking-- phoned from Salt Creek Post Office to report that a 200 ft. flying saucer had followed his car along a quiet stretch of highway near Tilley Swamp 30 miles north of Kingston .

"I don't know what it was" he said, " I've laughed at stories about flying saucers , but.... I was scared to death ."

" It was at least 3 chains across( 198 ft) and it made a noise similar to a high pitched generator whine.

" At 6.17 exactly I was driving along and I heard this sound, I looked out to the right- hand side of the road and saw this great big shadow. It seemed to be going along with me .

" It seemed to be hanging there like it was on a cord. It seemd to be a sil-very kind of colour . I only saw it for a couple of seconds, and then it moved off and the n took off at an incredible speed.

Through Kind Co-operation of Associate Carl Hoffman the following is translated from "Neue Illustrirte Wochenschau" No 49

Vienna Sunday 8th Dec 1963. U.F.O. OVER AUSTRIA.

On 19th Oct . 1963 an UFO criss-crossed the Federal Territory of Austria in a most peculiar fashion observed by hundreds of people.

Sighting reports were received in great numbers by the Gendarmery, observatories, The Central Institute of meteorology and the Research Centre of the Gesellschaft fur interplanetarik at Vienna.

On the basis of these reports a graphical drawing of the trajectory is shown here.

The Flying Object was generally described by the witnesses as follows.—

" An elongated body Blunt in front and at the back running into a point. Head : a brilliant blue, changing from white to green and at the end orange to red. leaving behind a tail of sparks. The average time of observation was from 3 to 5 seconds. The speed very excessive enabling a good observation.

The Investigation results are:- On 19th Oct 1963 at 19.50 hrs. an unknown flying object crossed the Austrian border near Salzburg coming in from the

west on a level course. No one was able to judge its height correctly, but as this object was observed at the same time at Salzburg and Golling 15 to 10 km. apart, and as in between is the mountain of Hoch Schlenken 1649 km. the object must have had a middle elevation of between 5 to 10 k.m.

If one considers a routine service plane. which has an allotted ceiling of 10 km. and which can be hardly seen with the bare eyes, and as the object has been described as a large rocket-like body, one can assume that it had at least the size of a dirigible. ( Zeppeline) The direction of its flight has now been ascertained, coming from the west( Frankfurt on Maine) over the towns of Ranshofen , Salzburg, Golling, Franenmrkt, Linz/D. Gross Gerings Vienna , Muchendorf , Aspang, Hinteregg, Bad St Leon hard, and then disappeared over the State Border to the south ( Italy ).

The measured route was about 230 km. and the times registered 6 to 8 min, which brings the average speed from 1800 to 2.300km. per hour.

The sky was cloudless.- The object changed during transition several times its luminosity in accordance with its speed, passing through different air layers Temperatures, moisture, electrical charges etc. The visible tail of sparks at the back end was and was most likely caused by electrical discharges. Of noises there was only a swishing noticed and this at one place only, ( in the Waldviertel )" .

By information collected from the Central Institute of Meteorology and Geodynamics in Vienna , the Weather Observatory in Flight Traffic Control Stations, as well as from the University Observatory , this object cannot be compared with any known apparition in our skies, for the following reasons.

1. A Meteor can only ; like a stone thrown, appear in a ballistic curvature and evaporates in seconds in the atmosphere through friction .
2. The same happens to an artificial satellite.
3. A remotely steered test plane or a rocket would have developed a terrific noise with such speed.
4. Weather Balloons, spherical lightning, brilliant stars can be eliminated on account of its appearance and performances.
5. Fata Morganas, mass suggestions, imaginations are not in question- the object not being stationary .

These combinations of proven facts show again how necessary it is to collect exact datas of facts, which is undeniable.

That the trajectory of the object had been followed so closely we have to thank the co-operation between the people, the Authorities, the press and the members of the Gesellschaft fur Interplaneterik.

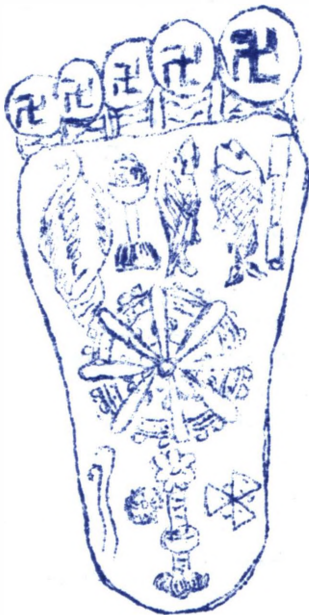

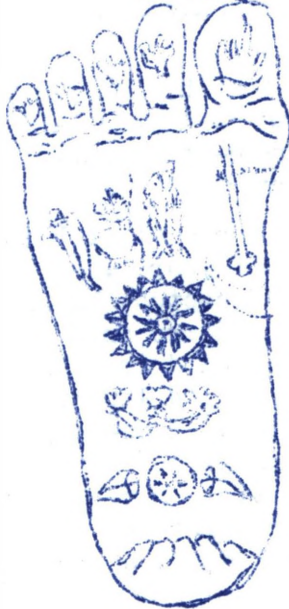

BEAR PAWS OR THE FEET OF BUDDHA?  
AND THE VENUSIAN FOOTPRINTS.

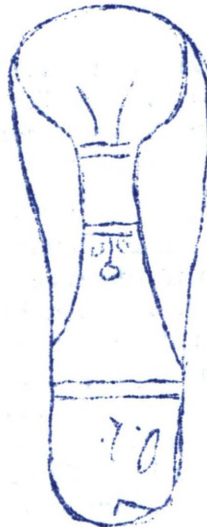
Footprint of Buddha

The following is culled from Fate magazine (English) pp 68-70 . and is to be compared with the footprints of Venusian as left and of which plaster casts were made by G.H. Williamson.

Strangely enough your Editor made reference to the similarity of the Buddha footprints in his unpublished book " The Message of the Saucers" which was written in 1954. and highly commended by G.H. Williamson . He was of course then unaware of the " Bear Paw" rock carvings which have since been discovered and made public. A complete picture of these " Bear Paws" on the rock face is given in the Fate magazine of which the Editor has not the Month as only a few pages were sent him covering the above. This picture reveals at least 19 of them or of similar carvings. and about 10 of them of the feet or paws. Oddly enough George Hunt Williamson offers to the markings in the right hand footprint of the Venusian as " The Lions Paw" see right tophand paw marks. this was as far as is known before the publication of the above " Bear Paws"

The article is by Reber. N. Cheetham .

Along the shore on Lake Pend Orielle, five miles west of Hope Idaho, are curious carvings or petro-glyphs which resemble giant footprints . Locally they are known as " bear paws" but who made them or what they represent is unknown.

They are one point of rock on the Hope peninsula almost opposite Manly island. in the lake. They are incised deeply and obviously very old.

The strange thing is that they resemble closely one of the most sacred symbols of the Buddhist religion--" the Feet of Buddha." They are not of course , as

detailed as the more precise representations of Buddha's feet drawn in the Orient , some of which bear the full 65 sacred symbols of Buddhism. But nonetheless they are very similar and closely resemble the earlier and more primitive representations of Buddha's feet .

Similar groups of petroglyphs have been found on Mamoose Island and Priest Island in the Lake Pend Orielle, along the Alcan Highway in Alaska, and Montana .

Do they represent rock carvings actually left by Asiatic wanderers in America? Perhaps we shall never know . Buddha was born about 2500 years ago . Buddhism was known as a proselyting religion- the first in fact of the great world religions actually to seek new converts.

Furthermore, it is known that there had been contact between Asia and the western coast of North America for thousands of years .

Migrations across the Bering Straits are accepted, but it is not generally known that Chinese junks have been blown ashore on North America within Historical times , and it believed that this happened frequently over the centuries. Only last August , Kenichi Horio, a 23 year old Japanese auto mechanic , completed a solo voyage across the Pacific in 92 days- carrying only a few supplies and a few primitive navigational instruments.

Nonetheless , although occasionally Asiatic - North American contacts can be traced down through the centuries , the existence of the " Feet of Buddha" on a naked rock face in Idaho seems far fetched and serving no purpose. Except there it is.

Compare the drawings and judge for yourself.

In relation to the claims that Asiatics or others had been visiting the North Americas. this is no surprise as recently there appeared an article in "Fate" magazine ( USA) Feb. 1964. dealing with the great possibility that Columbus himself had Charts of the USA in his possession BEFORE he left Spain to Discover the Americas. Hence if this was so then where did he get the charts from? but some people or group that had knowledge of this place .

To return to the similarity of the footprints. it is to be noticed that although the footprints of the "Bear Paws" and Buddha have much in common vide.

The shields, The fish, The central wheel , and the staff ( at the right top hand) which could be taken for a rod. a thing which plays a very important part in ancient glyphs. as the " rod of Power". None of these are present in those of the Venusian, the only similarity being the Swastikas.

Your Editor in his book " Message of the Saucers" stated that he was convinced then , that the footprints were those of an exalted messenger, in fact his identification . ( His seal) and his authority as an ambassador from space. Geo. Hunt Williamson dealt with this also in his book " Other Tongues-Other" as also did Dr and Mrs Loughhead. very early in the piece. and your Editor unknown to the others and as yet having not read either of these peoples conclusions found that he also arrived at the same answer, only to find to his pleasure that his own findings were verified by these other people when their writings came later into his possession .

Whilst there is only a very indirect connection between these ancient symbols some from the Orient and others found in the USA which could have been done by Oriental visitors, and that of the Flying Saucer visitors. ( The Venusian ) It does seem worth giving consideration to. as to what connection there is between these " Footprints" if any. Those left in ancient times and those left by one who said he was from Venus. a few years back in a Californian desert. as identification of his claim .

In the old testament , as a mark of his genuineness to seal a transaction. the one making a covenant with the other " Took off his sandal " and gave it to the other ". a well known symbolism in ritual of many orders today still.

Thus the " sandals" play a very important part in any visit of importance. hence it was no wonder to your Editor to find that the Venusian left his imprint with Adamski( even if Adamski did not understand or know the importance of that act) for in doing so the Venusian had sealed his promise to Adamski to return and fulfill that he which told Adamski was his mission to do .

It will be interesting to know if there are others who have given these "sand- any deep consideration. and if they too feel there is some connection between these other ancient " footprints" and those left in recent times. and if so the Editor would be very grateful to hear from any who would like to give their findings. for or against such a possibility of there being any direct relationship.

## LANDINGS CLAIMED IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA. REMARKABLE REPORTS.

The following incidents are those gathered from investigators and other sources both of which claim to be actual landings of craft. One on the Northern Area of South Aust. and the other adjacent to the city of Adelaide about 4 - 5 miles from the metropolis. and in a well buklit up area.

The First case appears to be very authentic and certainly has factors which can be compared with other insidents in other parts of the world.

Drawings of the various major incidental details are given on pages at end of this account .

For purposes of identification we will call the First account the Northern and the second the Plympton the name of the area where it took place.

The first indident of the Northern story begins some years back.

The account was given by the lady, who was the wife of a farmer . who himself corroborated some of the details.

Their first encounter with the saucer and its occupant brought to their memory the fact that some years previous the husband had seen over his old tool shed a large glowing round object which hovered above it and was clearly visible his attention had been drawn to it by his children ( two sons) who also saw it and gave evidence . After some few minutes it lifted and left disappearing into the sky very swiftly .

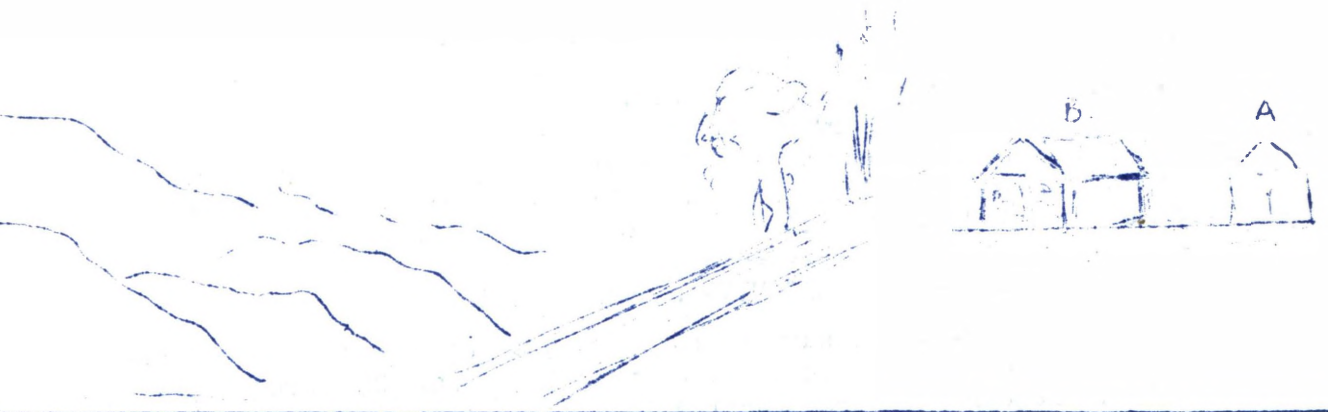
The man reported this to the meteorologicak Dept. who later said that " It was a plane from Broken Hill which had got off course. " an explanation that even a child would find hard to accept.

The ladys initial experience began with her seeing a glow out of the window and looking out saw a man dressed as given in drawing . she said he had a cloak and long gauntlets and was carrying a long rod - like thing at the end of which was a light of some sort . he was moving it aorund the ground and then to the trees at the rear . The decription given abd her drawing of it tallys almost with that of the Italian incident and which is recorded pictorially in the well known Keziah Chart . Notice the resmeblance of the helmet. the cloak. the gauntlets and the long leg boots. to the knees. This lady had no knowledge of any such matters. This incident occurred just prior to Christmas of 1963.

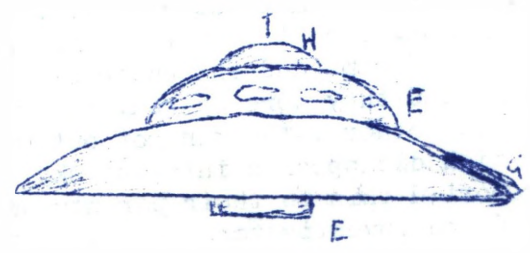
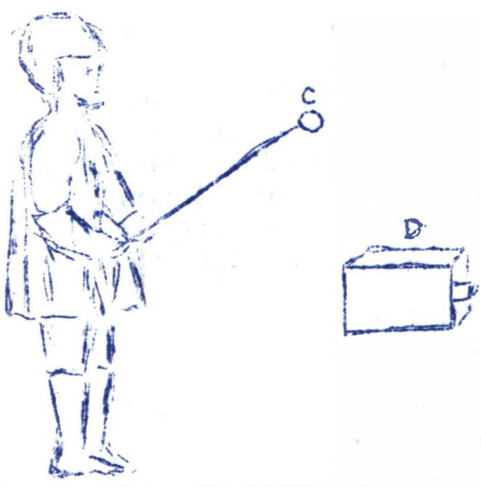
On Wednesday evening of February 19th. The same evening as the Editor was being interviewd on Channel 9 T.V. The lady agin experienced the same Phenomon. in that the glow appeared outside and she looked and saw the man again with this time a box like arrangemnet ( like a large camwra) it had a frontispiece which he pointed toward the house and a form of ray emerged and lit up her room . and upgn the wall she saw the picture of a man with long hair. and a pleasant face encircled around with a halo like glow. surrounding the image.

She became concerned and reported the matter to the police who supplied the details for further investigation to the local Saucer Group.

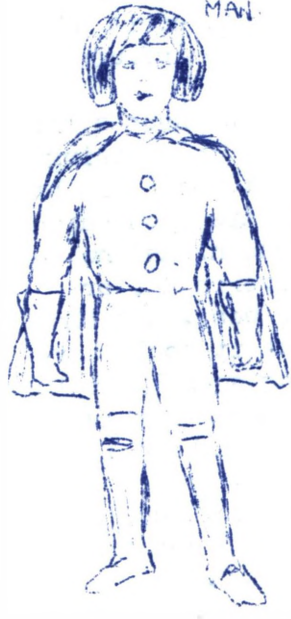

7 Years ago the husband and his sons saw the first object

Last December 1963 . just before Christmas the first " man " was seen.

On Feb 19th . 1964 they recieve another visit.

Following this objects were observed in the sky by the lady .

On Friday March 6th an earth tremour was felt in the vicinity of this area.

THE PLYMPTON SIGHTING . 29th Feb. 1964.

This case does not appear on the surface to be as authentid as that above although it is heard to doubt the sincerity of the witnesses. who were scouts and swore on their honour and were prepared to take an oath that the story they related was true in every detail.

The facts are that they were playing on a sports oval , known as the Wiegall Oval. which lies about 4 miles on the west of Adelaide.

They claim that they saw a saucer land on the oval, as described in drawing given . and that a man got out dressed almost similarly to the one in the Northern Case. except that the gauntlets were smaller , and more like mittens. otherwise the cape and the buttons were the same. duration was about 3 min. They admitted they were scared. but no approach was made by either party to contact the other . the man got out walked around and then got back into the craft which disappeared into the sky . in a flash .

They reported this to their parents on the following Monday and the police were notified and investigators sent down to interogate the lads.

The investigators felt that the lads were telling the truth, by their corroboration of independant evidence , and their obvious sincerity .

There are however facts which should be placed before our readers which should be considered. in that A T.V. interview was given by one of the investogators the night before Friday, in which he related about the above Northern case, and showed the drawing of the " man" as given by the lady . as well as craft of the saucer variety . If the boys saw that T.V. show it could have influenced their story somewhat .

Also the investigators questioned neighbours nearby, some of whose houses faced the oval. One man who claims he was out in his garden and never "saw a thing" Also the time factor which was supposed to be at 2.30 in the afternoon. in broad daylight . As this oval is closely adjacent to two main highways upon which large streams of traffic flow , especially of a Saturday afternoon. and no one reported seeing an object of this kind in the sky . Rising. Hovering? , or crossing the horizon, and as one of the highways runs east and west, and the other north and south it would hardly be possible that at least it would have been able to cross either direction in its ascent without being seen by at least some driver on either road. This does not however prove the lads story as a hoax or even some flight of vivid imagination. for it is hard to make 4 lads tell the same story without tripping up somewhere in detail.

Considering the " mat and demat" behaviour of some saucers the above could well be that the other people did not see anything. although it would beceratinly unusual and hard to convince a very material public. in such a case.

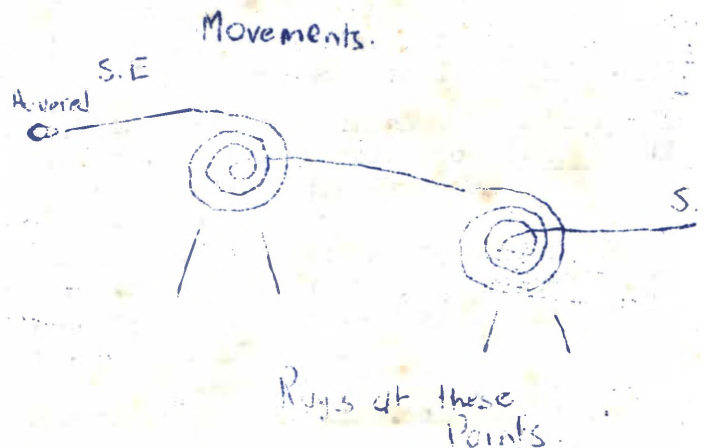
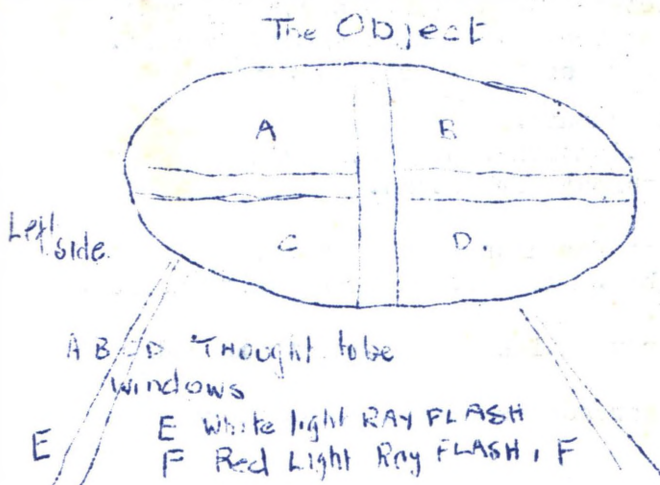
One thing which does make the story weak, is that they waited till Monday to report it . a lapse of two days. . It is not known if the investigators examined the ground of the oval in the particular site of the landing for marks of any kind. so no confirmation can be given on that score. However the Efiotr makes the report and leaves it to the readers to evaluate for themselves. With more detail the case could be possibly proved either way, but until this is possible it is left to you to decide for yourself.

CASE NUMBER THREE. OBJECT OVER SOUTH EAST  
OF ADELAIDE

ON Sunday evening the Editor recieved a report from a very respectable gentle man who lives near to Adelaide, who observed a craft lying stationary early that morning at 1.20 a.m. It appeared to be at about 45 deg. angle and was to his naked eye about 6 in across. he felt it could have been about 40 mile away at the back of the hills near Adelaide.

He first observed it as a large star-like object but realized it was too big for such . its behaviou soon dispeeled any doubts of that. The moon was at the left of the object some distance away and thus ruled out any optical illusion of it being that satellite. The sky was perfectly clear with no clouds No wind, Stars all visible, The object appeared to change its shape as it turned and manouvred and it was self luminous. It appeared to have port holes or windows but this was indistient and therefor vague. It appeared to be in 4 sections (see drawing ) The duration of the sighting was 20 min. in all After hovering itrose a bittle and moved to the S.E. and then moved in 3 to 4 concentric circles then shot forward again and again performed the same circling motions . It first appeared a whitish then red and changed from orange to red as it manouvred round. and emitted a red shaft of light. on one side also it appeared to emit a white ray projecting downwards.asashaft of light . Upon leaving it turned to red and disappeared swiftly into the south . at incredâble speed.

The Edito who interviewed this man was perfectly satisfied of his credentials and integrity . An amusing factor was his wifes annoyance that he not bothered to awaken her. It appears from the evidence and the distance etc. that this object must have been quite a large one. Here are the outlines as given of the craft and its movements.

As a wash it is unequalled for sore eyes, burns, wounds, dandruff. chapped hands, and falling hair. It makes the skin soft as silk . and is good for cuts.

Water in Yellow glass containres( or cellophaned as above ) and left in the sun is also important as a medicine. For nerve animating it reaches the highest source of power. It has cured chronic constipation after well known drugs had failed. It animates the liver, kidneys, bowels and any muscle that is dormant. A case of paralysis is called amaurosis. All paralytic conditions require the Orange- Yellow light . For bad eye sight one should open the eyes and turn the eyes each way several times a day with a yellow lens over the eyes.

The healing principles of water left in Red glass-containers increases the action and warms the blood. The arterial blood seems to increase and the too-much blueness of the veins gets less. The red lens is focussed over rheumatic parts or over ovaries in trouble, or suppressed menstrual action .

If rainwater is not available , distilled water will do. The longer kept in the suns rays the stronger and better. then bring inside , cool and use. if desired pure fruit juice may be added. lightly .

Lie in the sun under a blue glass for inflammation and falling hair. .

Red glass for hard tumours, Yellow glass over liver or stomach, Purple glass over stomach for indigestion . 15 minutes to half hour exposure at one time Best in the morning when rays are strongest . also noon until 2.p.m. daily. Apply blue water directly to burns or bites.

Where accommodation does not allow for privacy for sunbathing above. select the window of your house where the suns rays penetrate though, draw curtains, and lay on floor with sun's rays pouring onto your body with color needed over it.

BLUE WATER . For stomach trouble, Wounds, Fever, Castitis. sore throat.

RED WATER . For Anemia, Blood warming, Hard tumours.

YELLOW WATER For. Kidneys , liver. bile, constipation . bowels, dormant Muscles, nerve animating, Below throat for asthma.

Another helpful thing is to select FRESH fruit for aids to the above. Yellow fruits such as orange, lemon. Vegetable. Marrows. and all yellow gourds. RED fruits as. Apples. plums. red grapes. All of these have recieved from the sun the rays which go to make their medicinal value helpful to mankind. Liver sufferers etc. also should eat as much asparagus as possible, the fresher the better .
