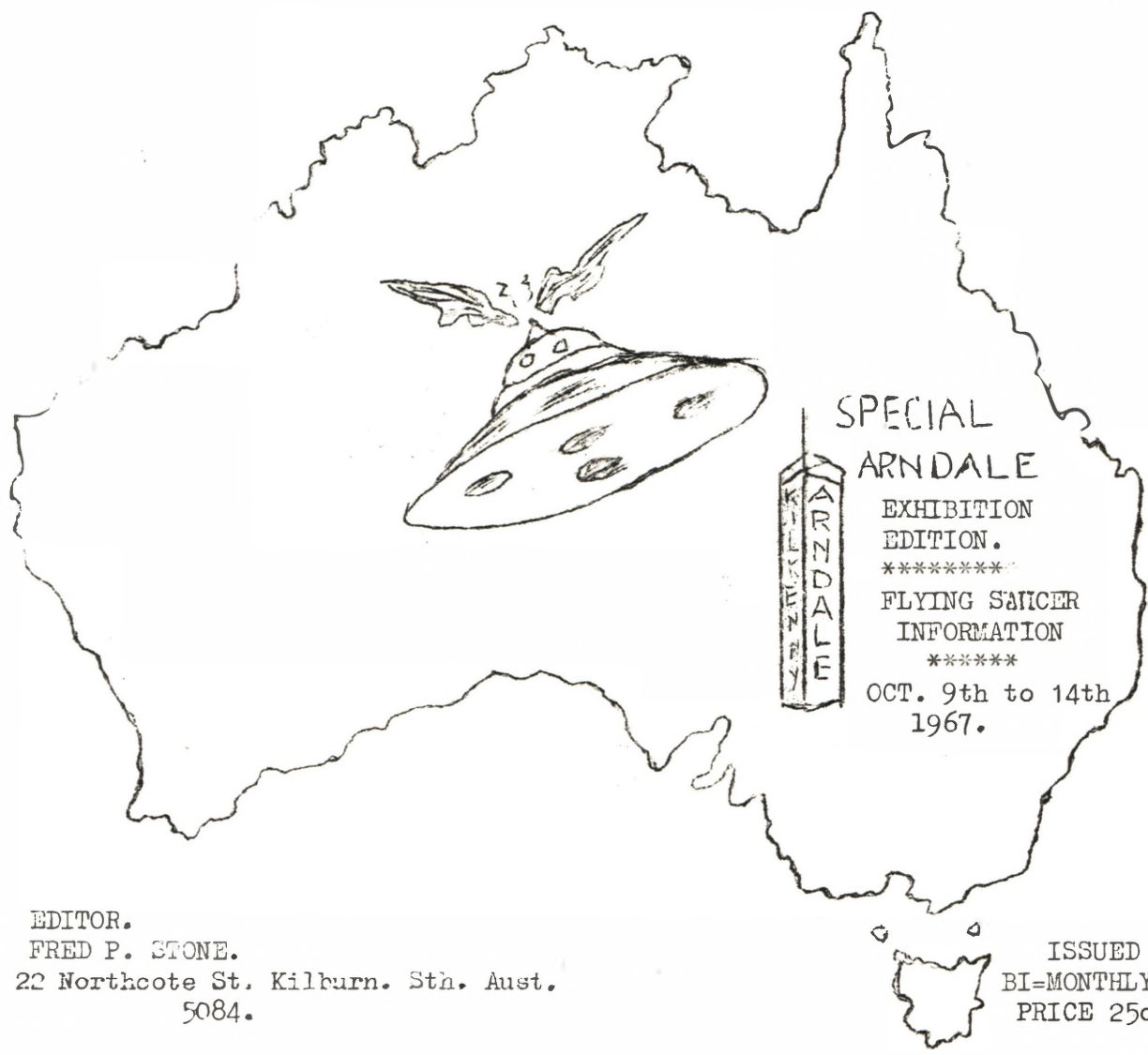

TRENCH TALKING.

This time I am really going out on a limb. However, I do so from conviction. I think it is time that we should stop sitting on the fence and stand up "to be counted".

Some of you who perhaps read other flying-saucer magazines as well as the excellent ORBIT, may have noticed a tendency to label the visitors as "hostile", or something approaching that classification. Now, let us take a look at the record. Saucer researchers know that there are reports of flying saucers visiting us all through history. What is the result? You and I are still breathing God's fresh air, or at least, what remains of it after humans have polluted it!

"That is all very well," those that support the "hostile" saucer theory protest, "but what about the intensive observations of this planet now going on? That surely indicates an invasion from outer-space is about to take place!

It is true the visitors have concentrated their observations systematically over every country, taking one part of the globe at a time/ They have studied our fault lines, reservoirs and lakes, ancient sites, and indeed, our missile and atomic bases have had their full attention. They have hovered over airports and observed our astronauts in flights. If the truth were really known, they have observed everything. Nothing has been missed. Everything and everyone has been studied in detail.

When you come to think of it in one sense this is all quite a natural procedure. The very fact that after thousands of years we had got ourselves a nice little technology leading to our present admirable attempt to venture into outer space was surely sufficient to catch their interest. Secondly, we have been letting off nuclear weapons. These may well have had some effect on the magnetic balance of the solar system, let alone the galaxy. Everything in the galaxy is held in magnetic balance. There is order in God's Universe. However, balance can be upset and earthman is inclined, as we know only too well, to get a little offbeam.

Now, as the saucers have been hovering over our missile and atomic bases, and other military installations, some writers on the subject of flying saucers have used these facts as proof that an invasion is imminent.

I would like to point out that this intensive survey of our planet has now been going on for twenty one long years (if we include the Scandinavian "flap" of 1946). Let us look at this situation with a little thought. That would be refreshing because it seems to me that is just what is needed to blow away the cobwebs of fear and rash conclusions.

If you were going to invade another country on Earth or even another planet, would you spend twenty one long years carrying out a military reconnaissance of the territory? No, of course not, especially if you already had sufficient advanced technology to wipe out a planet in the twinkling of an eye!

The whole idea is quite absurd when you look at it in this light. I submit that the flying saucers do not have any hostile attitude towards the planet Earth.

I would suggest that they know only too well about coming physical changes on this planet, including a possible axis tilt, and that they have been undertaking considerable scientific research into weak spots in the earth's crust and into fault lines. They have also kept an eye on our military activities in case we aggravate a critical situation with a nuclear war. They probably know that this existing civilisation is going to end before long and may be submerged beneath the oceans like those of Atlantis and Lemuria thousands of years ago.

You will recall the great blackout of November 9, 1965, in the northeast United States when there ^{was} a power failure that plunged millions of New Yorkers and other U.S. citizens into total darkness, and two smaller but similar unexplained power failures in the eastern United States and Mexico at about the same time. Observers witnessed flying saucers overhead and cruising along the power lines.

My speculation is that these blackouts were deliberately caused by the saucers for at least two reasons (1) As a test of human behaviour in an emergency of that nature and as an indication of how humans might behave if the sun was to be completely blacked out for a period of some days, and, (2) As a warning to humanity not to rely too much on material things. Those that adhere towards the "hostile" saucer theory have also made much of the fact that there have been some instances where entities from elsewhere who have landed and being surprised by a human being coming on the scene unexpectedly, have used some sort of ray gun to temporarily stun or paralyse him. For example we have now learnt that this happened to Monsieur Masse, the French farmer who came across a landed oval-shaped craft in his lavender field on his farm in the South of France. There have been cases of other visitors hurriedly removing themselves on being seen by human beings. On reflection, can we be surprised by this reaction? We must realise that the visitors probably come from many areas judging by the different reports of landings, and those that have been encountered. The more evolved ones and those that really have the interests of this planet very much at heart and are more involved with us would probably not behave in this fashion. There are examples in history where visitors have actually been ill-treated by humans. Word has probably got around the galaxy that the natives (on this planet) are dangerous. After all, we are always fighting among ourselves. I don't have to rub that point home, do I?. We have just had two terrible world wars and now we have another horrible conflagration in Vietnam, quite apart from racial strife, crime and skulduggery. I wonder why anyone from out there would want to put us a visit at all!

How about looking at the overall picture a little from their vantage point? Let us forget for a moment (if we can) our own horrible human way of thinking about it.

It seems a natural inborn tendency for a human to always think the other person is going to attack him. Why not for once take "an out of this world" look at the situation? We might learn something.

I have always maintained that the Sky People put us here originally and that this would naturally explain their interest in us all through history. I also think that they were probably in open contact with us long ago in some era long since forgotten and all (nearly all) vestiges of that particular civilisation have long since been obliterated by physical catastrophe. Ever since they have kept an eye on us and watched us evolve to our present civilisation.

Now, we are attempting to venture into outer space ourselves. Let us prove worthy of joining them in galactic fellowship and drop our warlike tendencies. For a start it might be a good idea to stop talking about 'conquering' space and, instead, substitute the concept of 'making contact' with other civilisations in space. After all, we have some basis for going ahead with such an idea. Recently, the dozen of American astronomers, Dr. Harlow Shapley, Sir Bernard Lovell, Director of the Jodrell Bank Radio Telescope, and Professor Fred Hoyle, Plumian Professor of Astronomy at Cambridge University have all given it as their opinion that millions of planets in our galaxy may be inhabited.

I have often written that the human race on this planet has to evolve and grow on its own and that there is an unwritten cosmic law that a more evolved civilisation does not interfere unduly with a lesser evolved one. However, in an emergency beyond our control it is possible the visitors might intervene. I say might, because the decision would be of their making. Nevertheless, I think it highly probable that the Sky People know we are rubbing into critical days ahead and this I submit, does to a certain extent explain their intensive observations of the planet during the last two decades.

If coming physical changes prove really rough or should the much discussed asteroid Icarus hit us in June, 1968, then they may be planning a gigantic air lift - a cosmic rescue operation - to take off some of the population. I just don't really know, but it could happen.

Meanwhile, if we keep in tune with our source then we need have no fear. If we talk in the light the dark will not effect us. It has long been prophesised that after the changes of golden age will dawn and once again we will be in open contact with our friends from the skies. So, let us all take 'Higher Ground' and realise that.

1947 - AND ALL THAT!

I read with interest an item which appeared in the Adelaide "Advertiser" 6/9/67 pertaining to a students' "prank" in England wherein several "Flying Saucers" had been discovered scattered across the country. The two students, whose names are Christopher Southall and Roger Palmer, both 22, have been accused of perpetrating a hoax, by making a number of fibre-glass containers, filling them with electronic equipment, and a foul-smelling liquid and dumping them at various places across the country in a straight line giving the impression that a flight of "Saucers" had landed.

The so-called "Saucers" emitted a low beep-beep, and upon being opened, were found to contain, as well as the electronic equipment, small radio transmitters as well! The cost of making these "things", according to the authorities, would be approximately £25 each.

Something about this affair "hath a strange and wondrous smell" quite apart from the liquid in the containers!

(For the benefit of "Panorama" readers the above-mentioned newspaper item is reproduced at the end of this article. - ED.)

Firstly, both these young fellows are apprentices at the R.A.F. Aircraft Establishment, Farnborough, and as such, would be subject to strict governmental supervision.

Secondly, how would they obtain the varied and complex equipment needed for their project, and store the finished product without arousing official suspicion?

Assuming that they constructed the "Saucers" from their own resources the following thought arises.

How many students of my readers' acquaintance would have the ready capital to outlay on these contrivances? Quite apart from the cost of the equipment, there is the cost of labor in manufacturing the "Saucers" and then the carting of them to various parts, plus the time spent away from studies!

I must seem a cynical type of individual, but the niggling thought occurs to me, that the "students" in question are not alone in this hoax. Is it possible that they are merely figure-heads fronting for officialdom, in yet another classic example of debunking?

If such is the case, perhaps this article will, in some small way, show the general public that serious-minded UFO researchers are fully awake to the implications of the current debunking program by various world governments.

Remember the old saying "Where there is smoke, there also is fire", and it's quite obvious that officialdom considers the whole aspect of ufology to be much more serious than they would have the populace believe!

STUDENT "SAUCERS" OVER ENGLAND.

London, September 5. - Some of Britain's chief scientific brains, and police, Army, Air Force and Air Ministry officials were called out yesterday after the finding of six strange, grey, saucer-shaped objects in a line across south-eastern England.

The objects, about four feet long, three feet wide, and four feet six inches deep, emitted a constant bleep.

Several hours of methodical checking confirmed that the objects were made in Britain - and were a university rag week hoax.

The RAF flew a helicopter to one saucer and airlifted it back to its main research base.

Air Ministry specialists rushed a portable X-ray machine to another.

An engineering plant manager chiselled and hacksawed his way into one and found two car batteries, a British-made radio transmitter, and a six-inch loudspeaker immersed in a gooey, white liquid with a smell "like bad eggs."

The liquid - a sample of which had been rushed to a laboratory for analysis - was found to be flour and water paste.

Later Christopher Southall and Roger Palmer, both 22, apprentices from the Royal Aircraft Establishment at Farnborough, claimed to be the originators of the objects - estimated by experts to have cost £25 each.

Southall said, "We didn't mean to cause chaos - in fact we were rather surprised that it caused all this fuss."

The saucers had been spread out to add to the impression that a flotilla of flying saucers had landed in line astern.

VISITORS FROM SPACE.

Anyone who cares to examine the numerous reports of UFOs must surely realise that these machines cannot originate on our planet. Two main reasons for saying this should be sufficient here. Firstly, the manoeuvres of these craft defy all our technological developments, and furthermore, if such craft were possessed by any nation they would surely be in general use today, especially in warfare. A multitude of sizes and shapes has been seen, and this fact by itself may suggest visits from different races of extra-terrestrials, although not necessarily, as we on earth have many different types of aircraft and we are all members of the one earth race of homo sapiens. However, there is more convincing evidence than this, a small portion of which we shall examine in this article.

The question which comes to mind first is: Who are these space people and what are they doing here? Unfortunately, we don't have a definite answer to this question. Possibly some could be from our own solar system, contrary to the statements of scientists that animal or human life as we know it could not exist on any other planet in our solar system than the earth. But why should we limit the existence of life to conditions as we know them on the earth? It is being narrow-minded to limit intelligent life to the same physiological form as ours. Others must surely be from planets revolving around distant stars, many light years away. Judging from the tremendous speeds at which these flying saucers have been seen travelling, it would not at all be far-fetched to suppose that numerous civilisations far out in space have attained the speed of light in their space craft, or even have discovered a method of transportation which we don't yet know about. The science-fiction idea of teletransportation by thought process may not be so strange after all. Whatever the method, it is obvious that they are coming here.

As to their reasons for visiting the earth: again we have nothing

definite. It appears that we have had visitors from space for thousands of years, so all these visits cannot be simply reconnaissance flights. Witnesses who have seen these space beings have noticed that some of them seem to be more interested in our plant life than in us. Others seem to be helping us, both by practical means and by messages.

I intend now to relate some instances of sightings of and encounters with beings from space. You may wish to draw your own conclusions as to who they are and where they come from, but there is no getting away from the fact that they have been seen. Because we know so little about them, we can only refer to them as "beings", as we have no other word in the English language which would adequately describe them. So I would ask you to bear this in mind if you think this word is being over-used in the following reports.

Our space visitors appear to be using robots in some aspects of their exploration and not personally landing in every instance. The following two reports are apparently of this nature. The first incident, in Premanon, France, was reported in "Ici Paris Hebdo" of 11-17 Nov., 1964, and a translation of it says:

"On the doorstep, before crossing the threshold, he (i.e., young Raymond) stopped. What he caught sight of was truly "a thing from another world"! A strange object, rectangular in shape, like an upright parallelepiped (rectangular pipe), was moving about in the darkness with a sound hardly perceptible. It was high as a door and was shining like plate-glass cupboard, the lad said later.....The parallelepiped form advanced and gently encircled the youngster's shoulders..(To be capable of encircling young Raymond's arms, this form must have had something resembling arms!). Then, what served as its head - and which was not discernible in the darkness - came near the child's cheek. Raymond Romand felt something cold. He fell to the ground. He got up and attempted to cry out....Raymond, emboldened by the presence of his little sister (who had come to join him), threw some pebbles in the direction of the object - he touched it and one of the stones produced the sound characteristic of a sheet of iron being struck. The strange apparition then took flight..." What an experience!

In the U.S.A., at Long Prairie, Minnesota, on 23 October, 1965, 3 very small beings were seen, and were described as resembling "tin cans on tripods." I think we can safely say that these were also robots.

From robots we go to living beings, which is a much more interesting aspect. They have been seen leaving, or in the vicinity of, space craft, as well as when there was no machine in sight. Judging by the great differences in appearance of these beings, they must have come from various planets, if not in our own solar system, then in another. Numerous observations have shown that their height varies from 80 cm. (2'6") to 3 metres (10'), most often in human or humanoid form, but with unusual characteristics: beings with only one eye, without eyes or mouth, with pointed chin or enormous head, even little beings only a few cm. high. A few reports from around the world will serve to illustrate some differences.

19 Jan., 1965. Lynchburg, Virginia, U.S.A. - Observation of three humanoids 90 cm. (3') tall, producing unintelligible sounds.

25 Feb., 1965. Near Brooksville, Florida, U.S.A. - A being with transparent helmet, well set apart eyes and pointed chin.

About 13 Aug., 1965. Near Renton, Washington, D.C., U.S.A. - 3 beings 1m50cm. (5') high with transparent helmets and protuberant eyes.

19 Sept., 1965. Mexico. - Near the National Polytechnic Institute, tracks and liquid on the ground, and observation of two beings of 90 cm. (3') with "gas masks"; message left on a small metal plate.

September, 1965. Near Lima, Peru. - Vehicle lifted up from the ground with its occupants (one being a well-known musician) who heard a short extra-terrestrial message (?).

1 Aug., 1965. - On the terrace of a house situated in a central position in a suburb of Lima, with observation a being 90-105 cm., wrinkled and having luminous green spots on its skin; tracks on the ground.

10 May, 1964. - 23-year-old truck driver, Alberto Kalbermatter, declared at Resistencia, Chaco province, Argentina, that while driving his truck at night he saw an "unusual being" about 3 metres high and uttering guttural sounds, crossing his path. Kalbermatter accelerated and fled in panic. He said that a few nights earlier he had seen a luminous object suspended among the trees.

One of the best encounters took place in Valensole, France, 1 July, 1965. The observer, Mr. Maurice Masse, saw two beings on the ground alongside a space craft. He was able to walk up to within 25 feet of them, but before he could get any closer one of them pointed an instrument at him which paralysed him until they took off. Further details can be found in "Flying Saucer Review" of Nov.-Dec. 1965, March-April 1966, and May-June 1966. Mr Masse believes that these visitors are well-meaning. He said that they had very intelligent eyes; that their expression, slightly menacing, was without malice, and even kind, when they looked at him after having immobilised him.

Other people in the same town have also seen strange beings. For example, Mr. Masse says that one evening many inhabitants of Valensole saw an object, like the one he himself had observed, stop at the foot of a hill on the side of the Greoux-les-Bains road near some chestnut trees and 4 or 5 metres from the ground. Some little men descended from the machine and went back up again "just like that", without any visible material support. "For them," Masse says, "completely landing or remaining a few metres from the ground makes no difference."

Yet another incident in Valensole is found in issue no. 9, September 1966, of "Phénomènes Spatiaux." A translation goes as follows:

"A peasant who lives in Valensole, or on the outskirts of Valensole, and who has a little farm and a hen-house, heard his hens and roosters squawking one evening. He thought that a fox had gotten into his poultry-yard and, for fear that his animals would be carried off, he went to look.

"And what did he see in his hen-house? A very strange little being amid the panic-stricken animals.

"When the intruder saw the peasant, he fled from the hen-house, got into a machine, and a red sphere took off from the meadow. Strangely, the frightened animals would not go back into the hen-house again.

"It seems that nothing had been stolen, but it is probably the arrival of the peasant which prevented the strange visitor from taking away any birds."

Another incident, this time in Argentina, is especially interesting, and is self-explanatory. I quote from the "Australian Flying Saucer Review" no. 9 of November, 1966.

"One of the most impressive reports from Argentina in 1964 was the one of the landing of a flying disc near the international airport of Pajas

Elancas (Cordoba province). On 5th June at 4 a.m., a noted Buenos Aires physician and his wife were returning by car from Rio Ceballos, where they had visited relatives. About 30 kilometres from the airport, the doctor saw a flying object approaching him at great speed. It dropped out of sight and he thought at first that it was a plane coming in to land. Then the brightly illuminated object suddenly re-appeared at the border of the road. The doctor slowed down because the light blinded him and, wishing what "the other driver would dim his headlights", he subsequently stopped to let the other "driver" pass. The lights came as close as one metre from the car and then changed to violet. The doctor noticed that the vehicle was unusually long.

"For a long time nobody moved, and the doctor's wife became very nervous, especially because the car refused to start. Suddenly, a man walked up to the car, and the doctor, who was reaching for his gun in the glove box, heard a pleasant voice saying, "What's happened, friend?" He answered that his car wouldn't start. "Why don't you try again?" the stranger said. The doctor tried again and the engine started. With his headlights on the other vehicle, he saw a large object the likes of which he had never seen before.

The stranger, still close to the car, smiled and said: "Don't be afraid. I am terrestrial and I have returned to earth on a mission. Tell humanity about this meeting in your own way." He slowly walked away. Two men, dressed in grey, were waiting for him. The doctor and his wife drove off and saw the vehicle leave the ground swiftly in a haze of violet light."

Since there are so many UFO sightings in South America, it naturally follows that there must be some saucer bases on the continent. As you have just read, there are earth men involved in some of these saucer reports. Evidently they are working with extra-terrestrials on some kind of project or mission, the nature of which we can only guess at. Maybe we'll learn in the not too distant future just what is going on. One more report from South America proves, almost beyond a doubt, that we are being visited by extra-terrestrials. This one is also found in the November, 1966, edition of "Australian Flying Saucer Review" and is reprinted in full.

"On the night of 26 July, 1965, Adison Batista Asevedo, 14, and his friends, Nilson Vietita, 14, and Joas Feresta, 17, went out to the "Cinero" movie-house, a few blocks away. After walking half a block, they noticed an intense white light shining from behind a cloud, which seemed to be 1,500 feet above and slightly to their right. Although aeroplanes occasionally pass over this northern town of Rio Grande do Sul, Carazinha, they knew that this object was something extraordinary.

"As it began to descend slowly, it beamed a core of light which illuminated a 30 foot circle on the grass. When nearer the ground, a sound like the humming from a bee-hive could be heard emanating from the object.

"Since they were already late for the pictures, Nilson and Joas walked away, leaving a rather curious Adison behind to investigate. Hidden in the darkness, he stumbled closer through the bushes in excitement until he was about 150 feet from where the object would land. There he saw a dark, egg-shaped form about 8 feet long and 5 feet high float down and hover about 3 feet above the ground.

A nearby street-lamp illuminated the round ends of the object, a rectangular door became apparent, and a beam shining from underneath lit

Prejudices, confusion and incredulity will not unnaturally arise with advent of new, inexplicable, and strange phenomena but let us see if we can rightly and profitably treat this mystery that now confronts the world and which we can no longer ignore.

We may well ask, Are these "Unidentified Flying Objects" the astral "chariots of God", mentioned in Scripture? Are they some of the "signs in the heavens" that our Lord gave, and which would indicate His very near return? We should also ask, Are they instruments of a Satanically inspired person on Earth, who will "make fire come down from heaven on the Earth in the sight of men" in his attempt to dominate the world? This, and other ideas for using space to conduct a warfare on Earth have not escaped the attention of the military profession in the nations of the so-called "nuclear club".

The secular world is coming to the conclusion that we must try to solve the mystery of the U.F.O.'s. The past can be briefly summed up in the words of Dr. J. Allen Hynek, Scientific Consultant to the United States Air Force on U.F.O.'s, who said (17.12.66) "For years the Air Force has dismissed them as hoaxes, hallucinations, or misidentifications". He says they have been sighted in seventy countries, and that "After a delay of 18 years the Air Force and American Science are about to try for the first time to discover what, if anything, we can believe about "Flying Saucers".

The Flying Saucer Review states that "this official action," backed by the U.S. Air Force, and to the tune of a million dollars is for a team of civilian scientists at an American University to investigate this matter. I learn also from the Daily Telegraph that the University in question is that of Colorado. Apart from what I have read, my personal experience in these matters has been limited to interviewing people who have sighted U.F.O.'s. in this neighbourhood. Their general reaction has been to feel somewhat awed. It has been enough to change their minds completely from being unbelievers in these things to being firmly convinced of their reality, and that they are objects that do not belong to this Earth.

U.F.O.'s. have been sighted all over the world by all types of people from the highly trained scientist to the most primitive, and there are many cases where sightings have been well substantiated by scientific instruments. They have been photographed in colour, plotted on radar screens, detected by geiger counters, and the U.S. Air Force has taken motion pictures of them. Many such facts as these have been deposited in Government top-secret files and not made public hitherto.

Believe it or not.

The above is not the whole story. For many years serious literature has been published upon this subject and which has been entirely ignored by the general public. Whether statements made are true or false, it is right that we should consider some of them because they have a bearing upon what the Scriptures tell us. It is alleged that physical contact has been made with the occupants of these space vehicles and that Earth men have been taken up by these space men into outer space and brought back. Space men have claimed to be servants of God.

They say that their present job is to monitor the Earth continually and that this has to do with their future work in the judgment that is shortly to come upon the world. There is going to be a great space-lift of all God's true followers by the saucers and other space craft touter space. Some of those left behind will have to undergo horrifying remedial experiences and be reincarnated on another planet, and the remainder, the worst of mankind, together with the Earth, will be burnt up, after which the true followers of Christ will be brought back to the Earth. The spacemen treat this as a repeat of recorded history because God has acted this way previously in outer space.

The Christian's Reaction.

Christians need to react rightly to this, and our Lord has shown us how. We must bear in mind the fearful Satanic deception that will deceive the whole world in these last days, and, as our Lord has told us, it will operate also in connection with His return. But He has promised us the "Holy Ghost" to lead us into all truth and to show us things to come". God has told us also through His prophet that "the Lord will do nothing but He revealeth His secret unto His servants the prophets". To know who are the true prophets and servants of God, the Old Testament warns us "To the law and the Testimony: if they speak not according to this word (the Scriptures) it is because there is no light in them!" St. John in the New Testament similarly exhorts us. "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God, because-as we know-many false prophets are gone out into the world". So while we should not necessarily believe, nor disbelieve, what the space men are reputed to have said, we should do exactly what we are told to do. That is, we should check up on everything and see whether it passes the test of the Scriptures, and seek the guidance of the Holy Ghost to lead us to a right judgment in all things.

What we should believe.

In our ideas upon the "space-age" we have departed very far from the plain statements of the Scriptures. Far from our arrogant ideas of invading space, it is we who are to be invaded and completely taken over by people from outer space. Science has no knowledge of extra-terrestrial life, but Jesus has shown us that the heavens are inhabited by His angels and His "elect", and that when He returns, His angels will "gather together His elect from the four winds and from one end of heaven to the other" and whom He will bring with Him. So when He comes to judge the world, we do not know what vast armies He will bring with Him from the immensities of outer-space where, to our knowledge, there are well over a hundred million stars. As St. Jude says He will come "with ten thousands of His saints to execute judgement upon all!"

St. Paul says of this "the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout and with the voice of the archangel and the trump of God" and that He will bring with him all those who "sleep in Jesus" and that we (the faithful living at that time) will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air!"

A prophecy in Psalms speaks of the space vehicles in this event, "The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels; the Lord is among them". In the passage in Isaiah concerning the joy that will be experienced on Earth when Christ will have cleansed of it all the evil, we have these words "For behold the Lord will come with fire, and with His chariots like a whirlwind to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire.

For by fire and by sword will the Lord plead with all flesh: and the slain of the Lord will be many".

IN His interpretation of His parable of the wheat and the tares, Jesus confirmed this destruction by fire. "As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world. The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and those which do iniquity: And shall cast them into a furnace of fire; there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth".

St. Peter also confirms this. In "The day of the Lord" he says, "the heavens and the Earth are reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men" and in which he says "the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up". He goes on to add that we should be "hasting unto" this fearful destruction, which is a selective destruction of the wicked only, because "according to his promise we look for a new heaven and a new earth wherein dwelleth righteousness. The faithful ones being "caught up," as St. Paul says, or removed by space craft, would well accord with this. We are next told in the figurative language of Revelation that when He who is called "Faithful and True" (Jesus Christ) comes on a white horse with his armies to effect this "the kings of the earth and their armies will gather together to make war against Him and against His army." This results in the leader of this evil earthly confederacy being cast into the "lake of fire" and all the remnant slain by "the word of Him that sat upon the horse!" In this connection, I was interested to hear that the Russians who have seen the saucers all over their country, are far more ready than we are to believe they are invaders from outer-space, and are prepared to fight them. Then there will be the return of those of whom the LORD spoke, who attain to "the resurrection of life", Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, whom He mentioned by name, and the twelve apostles who will rule over the twelve tribes of Israel, the final scene is of "the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven". This, one might think, would require a fleet of astral "chariots" but we are not told.

At this point, Scripture runs down the curtain upon this stupendous drama of the cosmic universe in which earth man of all ages comes to judgment before the King and His heavenly armies. Only such a drastic cleansing as is foreordained of God, would make possible the fulfilment of conditions on earth for which our Lord taught us to pray "Thy Kingdom come. ..on earth "as it is in heaven!" Nothing less would suffice if Jesus Christ who dwelleth in light which no man can approach unto" is to have His tabernacle here among men. This is not all that the Scriptures have to say upon astral transportation, but if the saucers should cause us to believe in God and his Word: to repent of our national and individual sins, and to turn to Him with all our heart in view of what must surely come to pass they will have served a very great purpose, in addition to any role they may have to play in the days to come.

THE LITTLE GREEN MEN FROM SPACE. DO THEY EXIST ?

No one associated with the subject of Flying Saucers has not at some time or other been asked the above question , in fact maybe in their original research they may have asked themselves the very same puzzling question .

The reason of course for all this hullabaloo, is the trend taken so often by science fiction writers , thank goodness only some of them, and more perniciously used in the same kind of films to create the weird and horror sensations in the thrill seeking public.

True Flying Saucer writers and literature do not give much credence to this sort of gimmick, and evidence in regard to any form of "little men" be they from Mars or elsewhere , occurs so very rarely in evidence which is given in accounts of people who claim to have seen these strange small creatures that one has a very small field to set a standard of beliefs on, and like even the more prolific evidence of people averaging approximately to the same as ourselves, it still to be honest with ourselves all remains very much a matter of theories, some of which however have a very good background for believing they are pretty well near to the actual truth .

Lest consider for a moment the few bits of evidence of "small people" in this case we are not entering the field of the past, such as the little people of Ireland , the Beprechauns, be they real or not. or of many other bits of evidence from many countries of similar types of little folk. England. The Continent, have many such records of these in past history. and whilst just touching on this, we have just read of a case in England of a little " Blue man " who appeared to a number of schoolboys in the village of Chilton, near the Whipsnade Zoo. making his appearance 4 or 5 times and disappearing each time in a puff of a kind of smoke. (For the full account of this read the English " Flying Saucer Review" latest edition Vol 13. No 4) .

Now all this is very interesting reading and most fascinating to those who like to read the unusual sort of literature. but no reference is made in this case or many of the past with a relationship to coming in any form of space craft , and certainly not Flying Saucers as we know them.

Nevertheless, here and there , there has cropped accounts from observers who have been vouched for by the investigators as being most honest and reliable, of encountering small men and in most cases associated with a space machine of varying sorts nearby. most of them escaping back to the machine after the encounter with the human witnesses.

In Europe they have been a few cases, in the U.S.A. also. several such. In the South Americas. a few accounts also have cropped up.

mostly the average height of these little space men have been about almost 4 ft. high. differing here and there in the accounts. But NEVER have they been ever described as being GREEN men or anything like it. in fact the first account of a coloured little man in my records is the one mentioned above , and in this case there is no evidence of a space craft handy.

Assuming that the evidence given by the various accounts of the observers is

true , and the honest investigators have said they believe them to be telling the truth. It appears that among the many accounts of persons from space ships being observed by humans. there IS a small percentage of " little men" from time to time cropping up among the accounts.

In view of this we cannot just brush it all aside as nonsense without at least giving the matter some consideration . we would be indeed foolish if we allowed ourselves to become so arrogant, that we thought we knew everything there was and is to know, especially about the subject of space craft and people. in fact the writer feels we know too darn little and need to take a very humble attitude of seeking out all the evidence before we cast aside any evidence which may give us even a small clue to the answers of the greatest riddle of our time.

Without probing into the pros and cons of what they looked like and did. first let us ask ourselves the question . Is it illogical and unreasonable that such small men could come from another planet or solar system.?

Before we can brush that aside as crackpotism. let us consider our own planet have we not a vast variety of beings on this home planet of ours whose height reaches from about 4 feet. (the pygmies of South Africa and in that same continent, men of the Matusi tribe whose height is far above the average of the general run of mankind. some even ranging near to 8ft.)

Any student of the human races is well aware of the vast differences existing between people in the many parts of the world. enough to know that height is not a criterion of assessing the possibility of existence simply because one differs from another .

The same can be said also of the physical make up of such beings. as in the case of the accounts rendered. some were very agile people, whilst others appeared to be very stunted and squat, moving with seeming difficulty in gait and general postures. Well we differ too like that so why raise that as a point of evidence to ridicule the possibility of such people.

The thing which the writer feels has been overlooked too much in those odd scraps of evidence of these " little men" has been what in nearly all cases they were doing. at the time they were observed.

If one scans through the accounts they will find that in nearly every case they have been observed doing some form of mild labour tasks. i.e. gathering , stones, metal rocks, vegetation . water. as though they were like little schoolboys on a project of nature study or some such thing.

Never once has the accounts related expressed that these little men seen piloting or navigating the craft which they in most cases quickly returned to when they had been observed.

Surely there is a clue here to indicate that probably they were not the navigators or pilots of the craft, and they were merely some form of labour corp. sent under instructions by those INSIDE the craft to obtain the samples which were desired by them of our Earth .

Of course many will say this is sheer assumption. of course it is. but so is the evidence that these people come from Mars or Venus, or even further out- or space. for whilst it cannot be denied they do come from beyond this Earth so far we have not been able to prove conclusively WHERE they come from .

The writer feels however that this little piece of the jigsaw puzzle could be one that will fit into the hundreds of others we are trying to piece together to obtain the complete picture of what all the flying saucers are about .

There is no reason why these little men couldnot be small creatures of a planet from which the more human like ones come. and that they have been especially trained, maybe because of some particular aptitude for this work, in acting as the student botanists etc etc.

Wild dreams. crackpotism, maybe , but before you rush in to name one so, do not forget that the very subject of flying saucers as a whole years ago was dubbed that. nowadays it has become respectable, and the thing to believe it is losing the smear of such nicknames. but those who have stuck to their guns throughout know only too well that many things scoffed at and regarded as a crackpotism. are now fully being accepted by even scientific minds.

The above ideas of the little men or people are not illogical , they are in fact the most probable answer to the puzzling question of just who and what are these little people from space.

Surely they are more logical claims than that they are little hideous monsters , or mutants , or even worse some form of vegetable creatures. as the corrupt Hollywood gang would feed our young folk with in the money making schemes. for like the usual trend of muck that is dished up to the public they are a well planned intentioned means of fogging the public mind with false ideas , conceptions. standards . hence any idea that can confuse the mind from the real truth is used. and the little green men have played their part in their wild imaginations to keep us from knowing who and what the little people really are .

The writer feels the true answer lies in the above theory, if not wholly some where near to it. and maybe soon we shall find out if it is all crackpot or truth.

Little GREEN Men from Space?NO. Little men intelligently carrying out some designed task probably under orders?YES.

After all which would you prefer to believe they are?

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN SIGHTING.

August 14, 1967. 7-7:45 p.m.

A prominent South Australian grazier family has joined the ranks of "scancerians"!

The report, received on August 15 via the Adelaide Police, is as follows.

Between 7 p.m. and 7:45 p.m. on the evening of August 14, 1967, the grazier's wife (whom we shall designate Mrs. A) observed a bright star-like object above a low range of hills W.N.W. of the property. The evening was fine and cool with little wind, a few small clouds were present in an otherwise clear sky, and the stars shone brightly against a velvety, blue-black backdrop.

Her husband, Mr. A, also sighted the object whilst finishing his chores, and, hurrying home, joined his wife at their kitchen window. The object appeared to be about the size of a 10-cent coin when held at arm's length, and seemed to pulsate slightly, changing its color from blue-white to pink, green, red, and back to white again. It stayed in the same position approximately 30 minutes and then slowly moved away over the horizon. At times it passed in front of clouds, according to Mrs. A's account, and so convinced them that what they had seen was definitely not a star.

Readers will appreciate that the above account is not couched in the cold precise terms of an official police report; we have used our own phraseology to color the report and give it more human interest, whilst not deviating from the truth.

A police inspector phoned me a few days after the incident, and reported that he had spoken to Professor Horton of the Department of Physics at Adelaide University, who stated that, in his opinion, what Mr. and Mrs. A had seen was undoubtedly Venus, which had been visible in South Australian skies for some weeks and would possibly have been in the north-west quarter at that particular time.

Hogwash and more hogwash!!!

Who ever heard of Venus staying motionless in the sky for over half an hour and then moving majestically away over the horizon?

Has anyone ever seen Venus change its color, or pass in front of clouds?

Of course not! Mr. John Williams of Heath St . , said he saw the object in the north -east. It burnt for about 20 seconds before disappearing.

" I think it was either a satellite or a meteor," he said.

A spokesman for the Weather Bureau said there had been no other reports received about the flaming object .

He said a light aircraft landed on Connor Park about 6.02. p.m. and the rotating beacon search- light had been operating at the time.

" That's the only explanation we can offer at this time," he said.
Sept 11th .

Confirmation of the sighting of a burning object in the sky over Rockhampton soon after sunset last Friday has come from several people .

One of the, Mrs C. Cronin, of Earl St. , said she and her neighbour saw " a very bright light overhead."

It seemed to come from nowhere, she said.

She was inclined to the theory that it was a meteorite.

Mr. Ken Johnson, of Henderson St . was at the North Rockhampton Post Office when he saw the " white hot flare" in the horizontal flight, falling slightly. His thoughts were on satellites.

Sept. 12th SIGHTED AT MT MORGAN TOO.

The light in the sky seen by many Rockhampton people at dusk last Friday also was sighted in Mt. Morgan where Mr Colin Heberlein, of Crown St. described it as a burning ball of flame with a tail.

The light was in the direction of Rockhamptom and appeared to be travelling north west .

From the facts given above it appears the object was one of the known variety and possibly as described either a meteorite or a satellite falling , however we feel we are grateful to our reader Mr Con Ryan for sending in the report for it helps to show we do not tab all sightings as UFO but give a logical and sensible screening to the evidence before coming to any conclusions.
