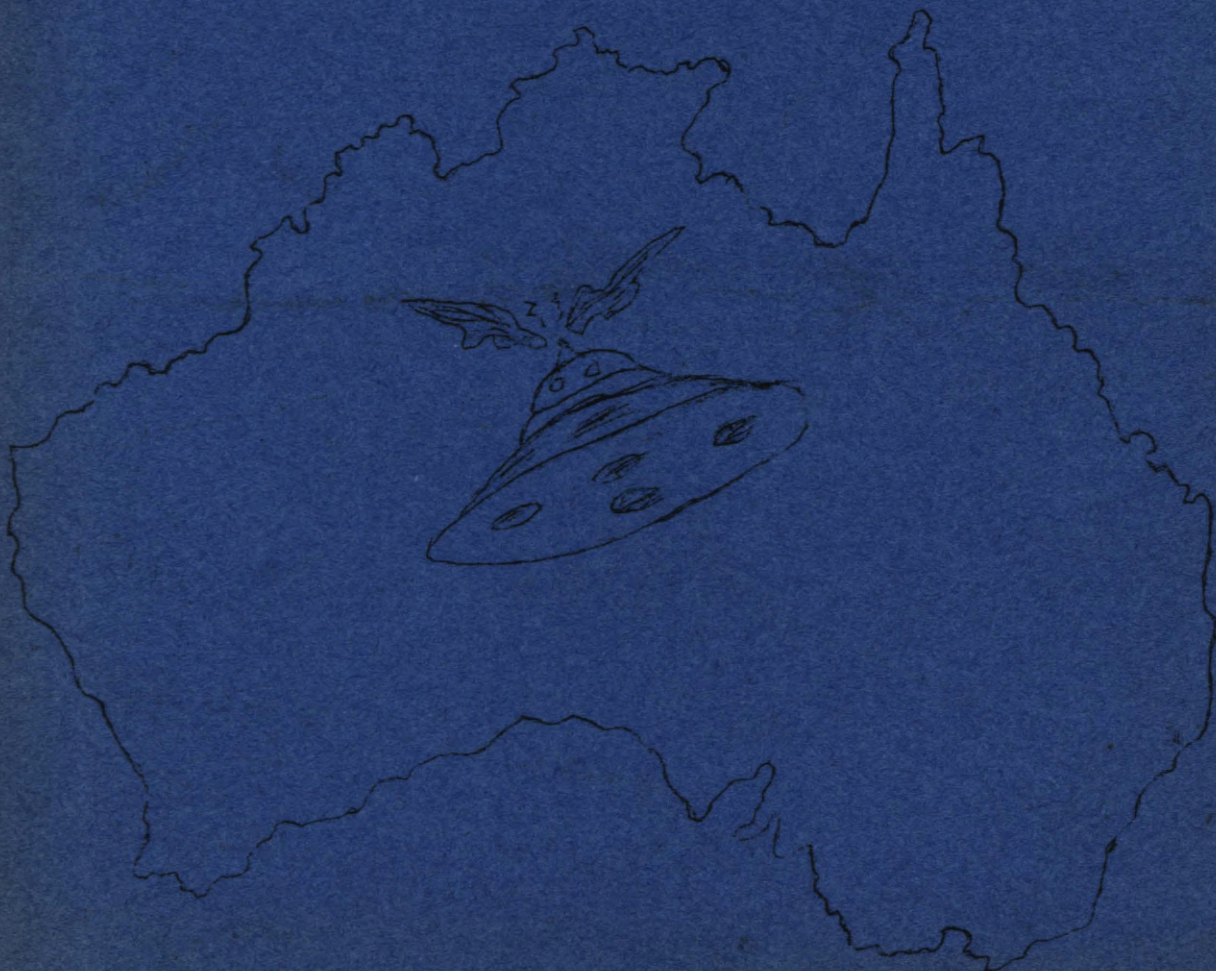

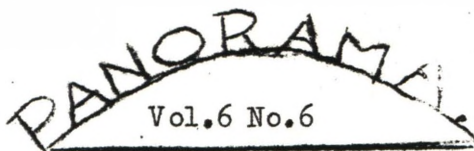

EDITORIAL .

"OF GOOD REPORT."

For some time now your Editor, has noticed a number of sighting reports cited in one or two of the latest books of the Ufo subject, which has caused him some concern. in that , the authors in all good faith possibly have taken the story secondhand from someone who has reported a particular sighting to them , and put it into print believing it to be exactly as the informer has stated.

However in two cases in particular. the stories of the sightings as given to them have been either grossly exaggerated , or in some cases. completely distorted facts added to the incident.

As he feels, brings up a point which more than ever seems to require a set standard of not only investigation but of the reports received, and in some cases of these giving or investigating the reports.

We are well aware of the necessity to be cautious of hoax and deception. but on the other hand , it is also just as necessary to be sure, we as UFO Reporters do not exaggerate or blow up the story to fit our own ideas, or conceptions, eitherway .

First let us consider the matter which aroused your Editor's concern . Two accounts given as written in the books were not as the actual incident occurred, in fact they were greatly distorted. Now this distortion may have been the fault of the one who relayed the story to the authors. or it could have been the initial investigators. but one can hardly think that this is so, when comparing the story of that in the book and that of the original tape recording made by the investigator, although it must be admitted he did make leading questions to the observers. A thing which we feel is not good reporting. The claim made in the book was that there were 20 other witnesses. when there was nothing of the sort. even the only other single witness of the incident , according to the taperecording evidence. WAS NOT THERE WHEN THE ACTUAL LANDING TOOK PLACE ETC. but came up after ! So that the story is only based on the evidence of one and not 20 others as stated.

Further to this case, nothing is said of a T.V. show given a few days before, in which a similar " space man " was shown to the public, and surely had the young observer seen this, or his pal, this could have greatly influenced his imagination of the story. This same story cites another witness who lived nearby, and who was supposed to have had an urge to go inside at the precise time of the incident. Your Editor spoke to this man , and he said he was OUTSIDE all the time and "SAW NOTHING " .

In the light of such evidence we would like to know who is fooling who. ?. Certainly we do not blame the authors, except for not checking their evidence before putting it into print . We leave it to our readers to judge who and why such misleading evidence was given, NOT BY THE OBSERVERS BUT BY PEOPLE CLAIMING TO BE UFO INVESTIGATORS.

We do not have to go far afield in Australia to find equal bad reporting, or exaggerated accounts. and all this goes back to the selection of those assigned as investigators. which raises my point. that not only must the observers be " of good report" , but the men who investigate should have qualifications which place them beyond the doubts of those who are ever ready to find loopholes in our work.

Lets take a man, who is say, highly emotional, tending to great excitement, whose words and phrases of sightings are full. of " fantastic" , Marvellous" etc etc. and one whose outlook is to get all the limelight he can. How can such a man be well balanced in reporting an incident. Does not his very temperament cause him to color everything with the exuberance, his own emotionalism and psychotic traits, so vividly display.

On the other hand. lets take a man who is very determined to remain scientific. Here th case goes to the other extreme. Possible he may be in a position which makes it very necessary for him to be not merely cautious , but OVER CAUTIOUS. His investigation will be restricted by this very over scientific attitude, and he may be so anxious to see the mote in the other fellows evidence that he cannot see the weakness in his own approach of lack of open minded approach.

There are obviously so many things to take into account when investigating a sighting report, too much is placed often on the object, weather, and none rarely is taken into account of the observer , which may more than ever account for what may appear to be a most sincere report. but when the personal matters are taken into account. may cause a great deal of doubt to fall on the observers report.

Let me quote an instance from our own experience in UFOPIA.

A woman gives an account of having seen a saucer land . and a space man land, etc etc with all the trimmings of a real classic landing. Adamski style. Now no one could doubt the sincerity of that woman , or the evidence which she put forward to prove her claim. But on investigation . although she said she had never read anything about Flying Saucers. It was later dound out that she had borrowed Adamski's first book from a library. This was the first flaw in her story. The second was that she was at the age of life when hallucinations can be common to women. The menopause period . and from people who knew her, it was found she was " fond of romancing".

Now who in the light of such evidence would give this story front line billing or place it in the first class incident category . ???.

Another case. A Seaman produces a photo which he claims he took from a ship he was on. On the surface this seemed a real good case and a real good photo. The T.V. gave it head lines and the papers. and so did some other UFO investigators, but let me relate some evidence we found in this case which made us withhold from claiming it as genuine, and judge for yourse lves.

With another investigator. we went to the ship to interview him we found him very co-operative, he claimed he was not after money, Note this, yet later he told us he was arranging to sell the rights of his story to a paper combine. But that is not all.

In the story he told to us and the press, he said that he was on board when he was taking the photo of the moon, and saw the object, he called to his mates who were DOWN, Note that, in the T.V room to come and take a look. at it.

Now when he took us to the actual place where he took the photos, which was on the side of the ship , on the UPPER DeCk. he pinted out the actual position he was in , and the degree of angle of the sighting from the side of the ship , at the rear of him were several cabins for the ships personal.

The one directly BEHIND HIM and a mere width of approx 4 ft. from him was the door which he admitted was OPEN on that night due to warm weather , WAS THE T.V. ROOM OF THE CREW, which he had termed previously as being DOWN!

In no sense whatever could this room or cabin be called DOWN. as it was on the upper deck. it was directly behind him and the men inside could see him from where they sat. This was tested out by my assistant and myself. IN fact he would not have to move to call them merely turn around. and yet he had emphatically stated he " went down and called th crew from the T.V. Room Also he admitted there was an officer on duty on the steering deck above. Who he never thought to draw the attention to of the object.

It is to assume the sighting was genuine, and the photo as genuine also.

Why the necessity to confuse the whole issue with a pack of misleading and confusing statements. ?

He claimed he did not want publicity. yet he hogged every minute he could of both radio and T.V. as well as write ups of the press.

One other thing which made us wonder was. that on the first visit he said his salary was a certain amount. and therefor he had no heed to make money out of the photo which was a pure hobby of his. The next visit he said his salary was another £10 more than he stated the day before. Now why the necessity to give two figures, ? in either case it had no bearing on the genuiness of the photo, EXCEPT his statement he was not out ot make money, which he kept repeating yet later he said he was negotiating for such .

The above cases will show that any investigator must not be overruled by mere enthusiasm, or emotion, but got down to hard facts and weigh the evidence but it appears from even the above case that what was wanted , was a good sighting story and any evidence which may cloud such a story as being " fantastic" would not be taken into consideration. this is natural to any investigator who wants limelight and the expense of TRUTH .

Of course the reverse side of the over zealous scientific investigator can do just as much damage to a GOOD report, in the reverse, by being so objective that they blind themselves with objectiveness and cannot see the TRUTH because of their unwillingness to see something which does not fit their pattern of ideas.

All this brings us to the conclusion. that more and more we need to have investigators who not only sift out the sightings of GOOD REPORT, but also they, themselves can stand the test of examination if they be of GOOD REPORT or not.

God save us from the highly strung emotional reporters whose only aim is to get some " fantastic " report to make themselves good publicity in the eyes of the silly women , many of whom are frustrated, and wanting thrills, or the investigator who se puts the questions to the observer that he puts into his mouth what he the investigator WANTS him to say .

OR just as dangerous is the investigator who crushes the spirit of some observer, and even makes him feel a fool. because he is so scientific???? that he refuses to face evidence simply because he cannot find it fits into HIS text book, or worse, maybe it may interfere with his job, or his chances of promotion if he was to face the TRUTH!

Now having said our piece we hasten to make something clear in that we are not belittling the genuine investigator of whom there are many, who are very pains taking in the jobs of enquiry, and who try to keep a middle road of balance. All honor to them .

Now do we try to belittle the evidence of so many genuine people of GOOD REPORTS who have given us such remarkable evidence to base our claims on.

WE want saucer reports. we need them, we want genuine people to come forward and tell us their experiences. and they can be assured they will get a good hearing. But we must insist we keep our feet on the ground and be willing to weigh all the evidence. not only in the light of known science today , but also of the science which we are just beginning to find ourselves in the kindergarten stage. the science of the mind. and other dimensions. of which could reverse many of our present theories, as much as has our own weeny attempts into the space world of our astronauts. for we have not even touched the fringe of what possibilities lie ahead there.

Who then would be so egotistical as to claim we know how to judge every sighting report. if we limit ourselves to the kindergarten of space knowledge.

None of us are perfect. but at least we can strive that we shall at least avoid the pitfalls outlined above as investigators. and may it be said of us indeed that we and our work is of GOOD REPORT . "

RUSSIANS TO STUDY FLYING SAUCERS.

MOSCOW. Nov 12. Now the Russians seem to be taking flying saucers seriously.

Gen. Anatoly Gulyayev, of the Soviet Air Force, has been named to head anew commission to study reports of flying saucers.

The new commission had only a few cases under review, the General told reporters in a brief interview yesterday. " But we expect thousands in the future" he added.

Saucers have generally been regarded here as either optical illusions or the inventions of newspapers in the West . No Soviet sightings have ever been published. But a report in Moscow last spring was that scores of sightings had been reported in central Asia and the Caucasus, among them a huge fiery ball in the sky .

An essay on UFOs by Dr. F.Y. Zigel that appeared here in April, however discussed the question seriously for the first time. the Doctor rejected the outright dismissal of UFOs as fiction.

" This view is very convenient," he said, " as it demands no intellectual effort and kills off the problem at birth . "

In view of the above it helps to answer the question so often posed to us. Are Saucers of Russian origin. i.e some secret craft.?

The fact that the very serious minded Soviet government have at last decided to make an official investigation of such. surely is an answer in itself and an admittance that they at least do not come from there.

One can hardly imagine the very scientific Russians bothering to use the present means of propulsion of the rocket projects into space, if they knew already the power and secret of the incredible means of movement the saucers have so often displayed and which has been registered on scientific instruments, In either case they or the USA would have quickly used this knowledge long ago IF THEY HAD IT .

The following article is culled from Geo. Van Tassell's " PROCEEDINGS" Vol 8. Sept. - Nov No. 4. and in view that this is a Christmas Issue the Editor felt it had a timely reference in its theme. What ever the views of the reader , it is an interesting viewpoint expressing some ideas which at least warrant consideration .

PLEA TO U.N. ON SAUCERS.

Bonn. Tues. Nov 7th 1967

Flying Saucer enthusiasts from 24 countries have called on the United Nations to establish " official contact" with people from outer space and their governments.

The call came in the form of a resolution passed unanimously by the 7th International Congress of U.F.O. Researchers who met at Mains.

The resolution was tabled by Mr. Colman Von Kewicski, director of the inter-continental UFO research and analytical network, of New York .

The resolution called on the U.N. to establish " unofficial contact with extr-terrestrial beings."

Also receiving the resolution, said Mr. Kewicski, were " 121 legal world governments."

U.F.O. and their occupants were seeking contact with the world's population but avoided facing armed forces, Mr Kewicski said.

FARMER'S CLAIM OF A SAUCER LANDING.

PERTH. WEST AUST . NOV 16. 1967

A Farmer calimed today that a flying saucer landed in his paddock beside his Land Rover last night and took off again as he stepped out to examine it.

Farm manager Alan Pool ,43, told police that it was circular, about 15 to 20 ft. across and about the saem height as his vehicle.

It stopped so close to his vehicle that he barely had room to open the door. Mr. Pool who had been working at the farm for about 10 years, which is 99 miles north of Perth. said that at the same time about 6.30 p.m. - his wife inside the house noticed a rolling-off of the picture on the T.V. set .

Once over the initial amazement he telephoned the local police. Perth C.I.B H.Q. at Perth and the R.A.A.F. station at Pearce to report the saucer .

" I was near enough to touch it before it took off in a flash" Mr Pool said.

" I called out to it and despite blusery winds my own words came back to me, it was not an echo " Mr Pool was in the paddock about 1/2 mile from the farmhouse and was driving slowly looking for sheep. (Cont. Page)

U.F.O.s THROUGH THE AGES.

People often ask me, "How long have flying saucers been coming to our planet?" or "Has anyone ever met a space-man face to face?"

To the best of my knowledge, flying saucers, or UFOs to use the more acceptable term, have been visiting our planetary shores for thousands of years! There are also many accounts in history where unusual and "God-like" beings have appeared in various places and made contact with the indigenous population.

Desmond Leslie, in his book "Flying Saucers Have Landed", written in conjunction with the late George Adanski, tells us of many such occurrences thru early recorded history. Mr. Leslie, who incidentally is related to British royalty, has delved deeply into old historical documents, and studied the ancient relics and folk-lore of various countries and peoples whom he has met on his extensive travels.

He writes that UFOs were not unknown to the Red Indians of North America, certain of the native population of South America, inhabitants of the Himalayan region of India, and various other ancient civilisations!

North American Indian folk-lore contains references to blonde-haired blue-eyed "God-like" men of peace who appeared to them in the dawn of time, and taught them certain crafts and aspects of agriculture, then, after staying with them for a while, sailed into the skies in their "Golden Canoes" and were not seen again. Some people assert that these strangers may possibly have been early Nordic explorers, but I personally have to be convinced that early Northmen devoted much of their time to peaceful pursuits such as agriculture and the promotion of culture!

Inference may be found regarding UFOs in the "Popul Vuh", the South American Quiché "bible" which says "....They (the first race of men) were able to know all, and they examined the four corners, the four points of the arch of the sky and the ROUND face of the earth!...." The origins of the above-mentioned "bible" are lost in antiquity, but are thought to be several thousand years old.

A legend, which also comes to us from South America, says: "In the olden days everyone could fly....Everything was so light, great stones could be moved..."

"In the old days men could fly by singing a song, and striking a plate...."

Here we have a reference to levitation and the possible use of ultra-sonics.

The ancient Sanskrit record, the "Samarangana Sutradhara", states that flying machines were manufactured at that time, (approx. 3,000 - 4,000 years ago) of a light material with a strong, well-shaped body. Iron, copper and lead were used in their construction. They could fly for great distances and were propelled by air. A hint is given of the propulsion motive, in that they had "fire and mercury at the bottom."

Let us leave the dawn of history and move on through the early Christian era, where some references may be found in the Bible regarding our subject. A case in point is the account of the "fiery wheel of Ezekiel."

On to the time of Charlemagne, where old records inform us that, "flying craft landed, and the occupants therein persuaded certain peasants to accompany them whither they went..."

"Upon their return amongst their brethren, after a lapse of weeks, they preached a great story of brotherly love, of great and wondrous

things they had seen.." Needless to say, the ignorant and priest-ridden population of that time were deathly afraid of their "returned" brothers, and promptly branded them sorcerers, burning most of them at the stake!

Now, let us move along to the 13th century, to medieval England. The year - 1290. Plantaganets ruled a land of pleasant vale and gurgling streams, of lush woods, and mist-shrouded mountains. The serfs minded their flocks and tilled the soil, merchants in the cities traded with far-off places like Cadiz, Venice, Genoa and Greece. Lords and itinerant knights jostled, hunted, warred, and fought duels of honor, and troubadours composed odes and sonnets to the "ladyes fayre."

Amidst all this bucolic simplicity, in the Duchy of Yorkshire stood lovely old Byland Abbey, ruled by a pious martinet by the name of Henry the Abbot. Here is a description of something very strange, that happened on the feast day of Saints Simon and Jude, an account of which was discovered at Ampleforth Abbey during January, 1953, The reference was in Latin and the translation is as follows:

"....took the sheep from Wilfrid and roasted them, on the feast of Saints Simon and Jude. But when Henry the Abbot was about to say Grace, John, one of the brethren, came in and said there was a great portent outside. Then they all ran out, and lo! a large, round silver thing like a disc, flew slowly over them and excited the greatest terror. Whereat Henry the Abbot immediately cried that Wilfrid was an adulterer, wherefore it was impious to" The rest is undecipherable, and makes me wonder what became of the poor monk so accused!

Onwards now to the 17th and 18th centuries.

- 1619. Fldlen, Switzerland, where Prefect Christopher Schere saw a long fiery cylinder-shaped object fly along above a lake.
- 1661. Huge flaming things, seen over Worcester, England.
- 1731. December 9. Florence. Strange glows of light seen in the sky.
- 1752. April 15. Stavanger, Norway. Strange bright octagonal object seen.
- 1762. August 9. Basle, Switzerland. Astronomers de Rostan at Basle, and Croste at Sole see an enormous, dark, spindle-shaped object surrounded by a glowing outer ring, slowly crossing the sun's disc.
- 1779. June 6. Boulogne, France. Flight of numerous glowing discs passes over city.

Now we come to some highlights of many reports of strange sightings during the 19th century.

- 1802. February 7. Magdeburg, Germany. Astronomer Fritsch observed a large dark disc crossing the sun.
- 1816. Autumn. Edinburgh, Scotland. Large luminous, crescent or heel-shaped craft crossing the horizon.
- 1818. January 16. Ipswich Observatory, England. Astronomer Loft observed strange object near the sun for nearly $3\frac{1}{2}$ hours!
- 1820. September 7. Embrun, France. Wonderfully even formations of flying objects cross the town in a straight line, then abruptly turn a 90 degree angle and fly away again.
- 1833. November 13. Niagara Falls, North America. A large, square luminous craft was observed in the sky for over one hour.
- 1845. June 18. $36^{\circ}40'$ N latitude, $13^{\circ}44'$ E longitude. Three luminous discs rise from the sea $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile from the ship "Victoria". They are described as being "5 times as big as the moon" and appear to be connected by glowing streamers. They are seen simultaneously by

many different observers, as far apart as 900 miles!

Space will not permit me to enumerate all the sightings of merit during the 1800s; sufficient to say that almost every year during that century one or more sightings took place at various places on earth, and by reputable people.

Now we come to our present century. I shall skip the many and varied sightings which were made prior to 1947, and concentrate mainly on the past 20 years, picking out those items which I feel will prove of special interest.

1947. July 10. 4:47 p.m. A top U.S. astronomer was driving from Clovis to Clines in New Mexico with his wife and teenage daughters when they all noticed a curious, bright object almost motionless amidst the clouds. From long habit, he took calculations with such tools as he had with him, and his family did likewise.

"The object", says the scientist, "showed a sharp and firm regular outline, of a smooth elliptical character..."

"The hue of the object was somewhat less white than the light of Jupiter in a dark sky, not aluminium or silver-colored..."

"The object clearly exhibited a sort of wobbling motion..."

"The size of the object would be between 150' and 250' in length and 65' to 100' in depth."

1951. January 20. 8:30 p.m. Captain Lawrence W. Vinther of Mid-Continent Airlines was ordered by the control tower at Sioux City Airport to investigate a bright light over the field. He followed the light in his DC3 with his co-pilot James F. Bachmeier accompanying him. All at once the light dived head-on at them, then passed silently about 200' above their heads at terrific speed. Wrenching their heads around, the pilots were amazed to see that the craft had abruptly changed direction, and was flying parallel to the plane about 200' away. They were able to have a good look at the craft; it was as big as, if not bigger than, a B29, had a cigar-shaped fuselage, with glider-type wings set well forward, and without any discernible means of propulsion. After a few moments the strange craft increased its speed, dived under the DC3, and disappeared.

The above accounts are but two of many hundreds seen in the U.S.A. that were unable to be positively identified by the U.S. government.

Combine these accounts with thousands from all over the world and you will indeed formulate a very formidable picture. Our own Australia has had many, many visits from these extra-terrestrial craft. Hardly a week goes by without reports arriving at various investigation centres describing strange and curious objects, lights, etc., in our skies. Swirling clouds, writhed and contorted themselves, driven mercilessly by temperate cyclonic winds. The sun glowed a strange blood-red, caused by dust clouds miles thick, and suffusing the torn and pain wracked world beneath, with an un-earthly orange aura. Huge trees, parts of buildings, the torn and bleeding flesh of what had once been living beings, formed a part of wind-wrack tossed hither and yon as though by giant pitch forks. Piles of this wind torn debris which collected in pockets of neighbouring hills, suddenly disappeared into the ground as huge fissures opened, caused by tectonic upheavals in the earth's crust.

Gigantic avalanches thundered down from former stately mountains into deep valleys. The mountains shuddered, and sank down, down into the earth. The plains heaved and rolled like a stormy ocean, and new mountains thrust up from the depths only to sink again in an ever changing pattern...

The sea, disturbed by the same tectonic upheavals arose in monstrous tidal waves and irrupted upon the fire swept, wind-torn land, carrying everything before it, and inundating vast areas of previously dry land. Whole continents disappeared beneath the waves, and new lands thrust themselves up from the depths. The holocaust which lasted for several days, gradually subsided, the winds died down to murmuring breezes, and the seas abated to an uneasy oily swell. The temperature which had fallen sharply during the tempest assumed an arctic coldness which rapidly formed ice over the wet ground. Then snow began to fall, not the gentle snow-fall of an English winter but the blinding white blizzard of the arctic regions.

The cold was so intense that in a matter of hours snow and ice had formed, feet thick, covering everything in a deep white blanket. The peculiar thing about this latter phenomenon, was that the land, at present snow bound, before the holocaust was in a tropical and sub-tropical area. Other regions in the sorely wounded world, previously under arctic winter, found themselves thrust under a blazing equatorial sun, with a subsequent rapid thaw of billion of tons of snow and ice. Great glaciers broke loose from the ice fields and splintered into ice floes on the warm sea, to melt and raise the ocean level still further. Evaporation caused huge clouds to envelope the earth sending down warm rain in the new tropical areas and snow to the arctic regions.....

Well, what do you think of my description of a tortured world? A dramatic piece of fiction perhaps?

Do not delude yourselves. Something very much like the above account has already happened to our * world several times according to my information*. The last time was, only a few hundred years before the birth of Christ! Perhaps not quite on the scale I have previously described but nevertheless enough to change the face of the world. The Great Deluge is a case, in point, and I would refer, I feel, to the latter incident. (Vide. Velikowsky "World in Upheaval").

All this brings me to the point that I am endeavouring to force home. What has happened before, could conceivably happen again. So much for our smug, ostrich-like attitude that these things only concern other people and other worlds. Let us examine the possible cause of such catastrophes. It is quite obvious from available evidence, that the reason for the abrupt and violent changes in the earth's temperature pattern could only be occasioned by one thing, violent pressure must have been applied to one part of the earth's surface, causing it to wobble and so shift from its axis. The degree of shift would depend entirely on the force or pressure applied; thus, a force which could cause the world to move its axis by approximately 90°, would need to equal the thrust potential of an impact, or near impact, of a planet approximately the size of the Moon!

Icarus, should it come into contact with earth, would cause a pressure equivalent to the explosion of 10,000 H.bombs, this possibly would not create such devastation as previously described, but could, nevertheless cause a catastrophe quite beyond our capabilities to imagine. Even if the planetoid did not actually collide with this planet, but only "grazed" our atmosphere, the consequence disruption caused by the its magnetic fields and air pressures built up in front of its passage, could cause havoc to our electrical fields and also trigger off immense earthquakes and tidal waves.

Now, I must state, in all fairness, a strong possibility exists that Icarus will not approach Earth near enough to cause such a calamity, but we all have to be on the alert and ready for all eventualities.

Use good plain common-sense, do not overcapitalise on investments where possible, build up stocks of non-perishable food stuffs against shortages caused by world-wide disruption of services; also warm clothes, blankets, and stocks of fuel for heat and light. Should you also be in a position to move quietly to more elevated positions, do so by all means. Above all, do everything in your power to engender calm among your associates, advise them that we all will be warned before the happening eventuates, and that ample provisions will be made to transfer the peoples of faith to safe and unassailable sanctuary.

"I don't know what it was, but we watched it for about a half an hour," said Al Mc Clean.

Mc Clean referred to the UFO. He, his family, and neighbors phoned in and had witnessed about 9 O'clock Tuesday evening.

He said his mother Mrs Jean Mc Clean had noticed the unusual light in the western sky. It was just above the horizon and too low for a planet or a star.

"When I first looked at it, it was red, then seemed to turn to green and back to reddish color. It was a bit larger in size than the planet Venus, and looked like a blob of light, Mr. Mc Clean explained.

The UFO did not hold a stationary position while they watched it but appeared to recede then come back. It travelled in an eastward direction and seemed to hover at times.

"I've read about these things, I saw it, and as far as I am concerned it had to be an unidentified object, but what it was I don't know," was how Mr Mc Clean summed up his experience.

The Mc Cleans live in Stryker township north of Blind River and the phenomenon was seen towards the western horizon.

GROUPS BACK THE ABOVE UFO SIGHTING.

Editor, Sault Star.

We the undersigned wish to substantiate the reports from different parts of the community, recently sighting UFOs. In spite of the news media advising that they were light aircraft, airplanes, helicopters, and the bright lights reported were reflections through falling snow. We viewed something to the contrary Friday Feb. 17th from 7.30.p.m. to 8.15p.m.

It was first sighted coming from the west to a point just above Cody School. There it remained stationary for approximately 5 minutes. Then it came over North St. ball park and stopped in mid air for approximately one minute. Very low, it went over Bloor St. and then manoeuvred in a zig zag fashion crossing North and Bush Streets, picking up great speed it went over to Cathart and Huron and on to the canal area.

At times it was silent as it hovered and in motion its only sound was an intermittent hum. There were great sized brilliantly flashing red, white, green and blue lights and one huge long red light.

These lights seemed to project downwards rather than forwards. Beneath the lights it appeared a glowing cone shape. The air was clear and no falling snow. Through night binoculars which were trained on it when it was over the canal, it appeared to have large circular wings and the lights were most exotic.

It is true there was an airplane in the sky at approximately 8.15.p.m. but it was in the far westerly direction of the sky at the same time as the UFO was in the North St area.

Certainly this object we viewed could be the same one as the young lads and the other people reported seeing on the same night.. (Cont. next page)

FLYING OBJECTS IDENTIFIED AS REFLECTIONS OFF CLOUDS.....

The sighting of an UFO over Sault and surrounding area Wednesday evening has been solved.... It's all done with mirrors. ..

Well, not exactly. Would you believe reflections off sulphur fumes from the Algoma Steel Corp. and Mc Fadden Lumber Co. in Blind River .

This is the opinion of a radio operator at the Sault Federal airport .

He told the Star this morning that such clouds form layers above the city during certain atmospheric conditions.

It's his belief that the red and green lights on aircraft in the area reflect off these clouds giving the appearance of some strange object in the sky .

" It works on the same principle as when you point a flashlight into the sky at night and the light reflects the clouds he said.

" You have only to move your hand a couple of inches to have the light move 50 to 60 feet . "

The radio operator feels that the red and green lights on the aircraft and the landing lights on an airfield have caused the optical illusion spotted Wednesday night by people from Blind River to the Sault.

" The aircraft itself could be below the horizon so that you couldn't see it but it would still cast a reflection. " he said.

The operator said he had noticed sulphur clouds over the city last night and again this morning.

Local police were swamped with calls Wednesday night from 8.30 to 10p.m. by people who had spotted a strange object in the sky .

Blind River police Chief James Collins also reported seeing a light in the sky but it was moving away from him at the time, so he was unable to get a good look at it.

He said however, that his next door neighbor had watched an object with red and green lights on either side of it and a long fluorescent light in the middle for some time.

" He and his family first spotted it sometime around 8.30 last night and watched it for awhile before it began moving west towards Sault St. Marie," he said.

City police received eight calls reporting a round object which, according to the police spokesman, had red, green, yellow or blue lights on it.

8th July 1967/ LAST NIGHT FLYING SAUCERS SIGHTED

Paris/Weisbaden. (UPI?AFP.) Over wide parts of western Europe, in France, Italy, Germany, the Neth^oFlands and Switzerland, UFOs were sighted during the night from Monday to Tuesday. Witnesses say they moved over the sky showing various colors.

Crews of eight French planes flying wide apart from each other over France reported to the control tower at Orly near Paris, that they had sighted UFOs Monday Tuesday, also Headquarters of USAF for Europe in Wiesbaden reported that US soldiers in Germany had seen brightly lighted UFOs in the sky .

All these peculiar and curious flying saucers caused a stir and are probably parts of staellites entering the earth's atmosphere. This was reported from the French Observation Station at Basancon, which belongs to the French satellite observation network .

French scientists assume, that sowjetic " Kosmo-168" satellite is concerned which was started on the 4th July. These phenomenons may be repeated shortly. since other satellite circles at present at the edge of the atmosphere.

" Express" of Vienna, also reports the same observations.

Brightly radiating objects moving from w.sw. direction towards n/ne. The UFOs wereseen in Strassburg as well as Nantes.

Reports from the Netherlands coastgaurd stations doubt, that they could be delusions. Paris reports further that each of the eight pilots made the same observations independant from each other. At great heights flow an UFO which radiated brightly, followed by two others with the brightness of stars.

At 2.a.m. similar reports came in from Belgium and Luxembourg.

The objects did not appear on the radar.

Bunbury. Tues. An U.F.O. was sighted on the Mayanup-Konjonup road last night by a man who refuses to give his name because of possible public ridicule.

The sighting which was made about ten miles from Mayanup about 9.30p.m. was reported to Constable . L. Johnson , of the Boyup Brook police Station .

Constable Johnson said. " The man was travelling about 60 m.p.h. when suddenly his car stopped. the engine and the lights were off, but he had no sensation of stopping .

EIGHT PICTURES TAKEN OF SAUCER IN BRISBANE.

Brisbane. Monday. A young man has taken eight pictures of a "flying saucer" object over a dehsely- populated Brisbane suburb.

The man , aged 24, was taking photographs of his girlfriend when he saw the object .

Photographic experts said the pictures, which were taken in daylight were very clear . So far their tests had not found anything to suggest the pictures were not genuine.

The man told Brisbane's respected Flying Saucer Burea about the sightings. He said, he noticed the " saucer" come into view as he was taking photographs

of his girlfriend beside his car two weeks ago.

He called out to his girlfriend, who also confirms seeing the object.

The man said he took eight photographs of the object as it manoeuvred over the houses.

A Bureau official has shown "The Sun" a set of eight prints.

He asked that details be kept secret in case Brisbane residents confirm seeing the object.

The Bureau authorises the "Sun" to say the photos show;

The man's girlfriend standing by a car facing the camera. The object has just appeared in the top left hand corner.

The girl with back to camera looking up at the object, which has come in close.

The object at varying distances from the camera.

" DAMN SORRY NOW HE SAW A FLYING SAUCER

HERALD" SYDNEY Nov 12 1967

The young Brisbane insurance consultant is now "Damn sorry" he took pictures of a flying saucer object last week end.

"People think I'm some sort of nut," he said.

The consultant, Mr James Wallace, 24, says he saw the flying saucer in the view finder of his camera when taking pictures of his girl friend in the back yard of his West End (Brisbane) home last night.

Since then life hasn't been the same for the Scottish-born Mr Wallace.

Some doubts as to the authenticity of the photographs have been cast, and Mr Wallace says he's being labelled "a crank".

"I am not a nut or a crank, I am a respectable insurance consultant who would never see that UFO."

"But I saw it all right— and photographed it."

Mr Stan Seers, the Queensland Flying Saucer Bureau president, who saw the photographs last Monday, told "The Sun Herald" he believed there were some discrepancies.

Mr Seers, a laboratory assistant at the Queensland University, said shadows indicated the pictures could have been taken over a long period.

In addition, a car which appeared parked in a lane in the earlier frames was missing from picture No. 5, but was back again in No.6.

When asked about the doubts cast on his photographs Mr Wallace said.

"How could I fake them. I bought the film from a chemist at noon on Saturday, took the pictures on Sunday, and had them developed in the same chemists shop on Monday morning.

"Why would I want to fake them? I am a fair dinkum sorry man I ever took those damn photos."

In the light of the above statements made by the president of the Queensland Bureau, whom we have never met, and the alternate sincerity of the photographer, who after all was the one who claims he saw and photographed the saucer. One wonders if this is not a case of persecution. Not from outside official bodies to belittle saucers and those who claim to have seen them, but from within the own ranks of saucerdom itself. WE just sit and ponder over this.
