

My Life Transformed



At once. I heard his familiar voice clearly: "Look behind you, little girl," he said. "They're all there, everyone! Look right behind you! Turn around!"

I whirled around, my arm shot out, and landed on the knob of a little drawer I had already examined and had found to contain only two or three packets of letters. Without volition I seized one of these bundles of letters. Feverishly I pulled away the rubber bands holding it, and began peeling off the envelopes as they came. get for me five wonderful letters from my husband. Still more surprising was the fact that, before the fifth letter came, I received a letter from the Other Side without her aid, and through my own hand. And it was not from my husband, but from his father, Rev. Dr. Edward Payson Terhune, who died in 1908.

From then on I was able to take my husband's dictation through my own hand. He told me that Mrs. S. had been sent to me to open the way for us. Her part was done. I have never seen her since.

Bledsoe Speaks!

You Cannot Sensationalize Jhat Which Is Sensational THOUSANDS HEAR HER SPIRIT VOICE

The Real Purpose of These Demonstrations

By

JULIETTE EWING PRESSING

When a DEAD woman delivers a lecture it is news. When a "dead" woman carries on an entire Spiritualist church service it is sensational news.

This remarkable demonstration has taken place each year at Camp Chesterfield. Chesterfield, Indiana; always the first Sunday in August . . . and this has been going on for the past three years.

Etta S. Bledsoe, one of America's outstanding lecturers and mediums passed away to the higher life July, 1940. One month later during that same summer, she communicated with hundreds of friends.

August 9th, 1940, Mr. Pressing and I had a trumpet and independent voice seance at Chesterfield through the mediumship of James Laughton, Detroit, Michigan. Actually, Mrs. Bledsoe's voice sounded as natural as when she lived upon earth; and she had only been in spirit a few weeks.

Bledsoe's Voice Recorded

We recognized the value of her remarkably evidential voice intonations with all its peculiar qualities, so we arranged to have recordings made of a seance--with Laughton as the medium.

We wanted the records to be as mechanically perfect as possible so we engaged a studio in Buffalo

where professional recordings are made for radio.

Since that time, these records have been used in many Spiritualist churches and have seldom failed to positively prove that the "dead" can communicate with the earth people.

Through Laughton

Mrs. Bledsoe was widely known. Her spiritual work from the other side has been most important. It has helped to establish proof of pirit communication, more so in fact than when she served in the physical as an intermediary for

the spirit-world. The recordings proved to be so lawless, that Mrs. Bledsoe decided he could deliver a public lecture in independentvoice through Laughton. The following summer, at Camp Chesterfield, Mrs. Bledsoe was able to fulfill. from spirit, her usual

ngagement. During her earth-J. Laughton life. for many.

many years, Mrs. Bledsoe opened her arnual lecture course at Chesterfield on the first Sunday in August. On her first return from pirit for a public lecture, I shall never forget the trepidation of the young medium, Mr. Laughton. He realized that so very much depended upon his power.

No Records On Her Day

This first lecture of Mrs. Bledsoe's in 1911 was splendid. Considerable publicity had been given the recordings, so some people were confused. They thought it was the record that was being played instead of the actual spirit voice speaking directly through Mr. Laughton's mediumship. NO TIME HAVE THE AΤ RECORDS BEEN PLAYED IN THE AUDITORIUM ON ETTA S. BLEDSOE DAY.

"None Shall Escape

This is the lecture, delivered by ETTA S. BLEDSOE, August 6th, 1944, at Chesterfield Spiritualist Camp, Chesterfield, Indiana, through the mediumship of JAMES LAUGHTON.

This is Etta S. Bledsoe. Beloved friends, how glorious once more to manifest to you from out of this country of the spirit. My mission this afternoon is to assure you of the immortality of the soul; that the spirit of man truly survives the change called death.

I come singing that song, "Oh Grave, where is thy victory, Oh Death, where is thy sting?"—but these words many of you have not been able to speak — truly believing.

The sting of death and the mystery of the grave has left your obstructed world truly a vale of tears. In spite of the destruction of war, the emotions of man are feeling and responding to the influx of the spirit.

It is as Jesus said, "Come unto me all ye that are heavy laden and I will give thee rest."

And so, I say like the angel with outstretched arms to a world filled with smoke and gunfire, "Come unto this dispensation known as MODERN SPIRITUALISM that is filled with compassion—as was Jesus."

Oh yes, they are marching, these invisible legions of angels that were once flesh clad as you. They have not died in vain, but have

brought new glory to old glory. And so, those of you in the flesh stretch forth thy hand in understanding and in love. Work in the night that is upon you for the dawn of peace will come.

Yes, there will be a transfiguration in the world of earth to come. The true meaning of a change to something glorious not only from the horrors of war, but from the mystery and gnorance of death. For it shall be burned out of the understanding and affections of man by the fires of truth. *None* escape from the shadows of death except those who are spiritually discerned and know the power of an endless life. None I say!

Material science and religion are preparing to cancel the death warrant that has been read through the centuries. Even when this victory over death has been won; and not a shred is left of death, yet the sad impress made upon humanity will remain for some and the grave looked upon as a dark portal all must enter-either to pass on or halt forever.

Furthermore, beloved, our marvelous message of survival will permeate all religions; our mediums shall be in all the pulpits and on all the rostrums. When that day comes, their presence will create a new heaven and a new earth. Furthermore, their presence shall be so luminous with spirituality that the hearts of the hopeful and mournful souls, who listen, shall pulse with immortal yearnings.

And so, let each one prepare himself in his pilgrimage toward the spirit land. For the soul of man feels not the sting of death of the earthly body, nor does he know anything but the victory over the grave.

Earth to earth, ashes to ashes and the immortal soul to the great infinite source from whence it came, holds good now . . . and it will hold good forever as long as man shall dwell on the foot stool of the great spirit-THE RULER OF THIS UNI-VERSE OF WORLDS.



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The procedure is quite simple. Mr. Laughton enters a small cabinet which is placed in the center of the rostrum. In this cabinet there is a plain chair and the microphone that is connected to the loud speakers to increase the volume of the independent spirit voice so that it can be heard in the large auditorium.

Cabinet Is Examined

The purpose of the cabinet is to provide darkness so that ectoplasm can be withdrawn from the entranced medium. For a spirit voice to be heard in the physical realm by physical senses, there must be a voice-box created out of this ectoplasm.

A spirit can speak until doomsday and no one can hear them, unless such conditions exist.

Each successive year since 1941, Mrs. Bledsoe has either grown stronger or has gained confidence because each year she has manifested more naturally and has given a longer talk.

In 1943, she delivered a lecture followed with spirit messages. This past August, 1944, several thousand people assembled in Chesterfield auditorium to hear this re-

"OPEN THE GATES"

Religious Liberties of American Spiritualists Periled by Antiquated British Witchcraft Laws

Eminent Lawyer Reviews the Case

The Real Truth About **Persecution** of Mediums and the Religion of Spiritualism.

WHERE WE STAND

A notable victory for religious freedom and for the cause of Spiritualism in the case of The People vs. Rev. Marion Miller was recently reported by The Psychic Observer.

This report may be useful to all who are interested enough to review the facts and the law relating to the issues in not only this case, but all other cases arising under Section 899 of the criminal code of the state of New York.

This is the law against fortunetelling that has, for many years, been used as an instrument of persecution by sensation hunting detectives, sectarian opponents of Spir ualism and others of unworthy design.

We recall that Paul boldly stated to the court that he had been a persecutor of the Christians until, while on the road to Damascus, he heard the voice of Jesus speaking to him from the invisible saying: "Paul why persecutest thou me"?

"Learning Hath Made . . .'

Then Paul boldly related how from this spirit message, his life and efforts had been entirely changed and how, from then on he had been a friend of Jesus and been striving to carry on his unfinished work by teaching and preaching the spiritual precepts for which Jesus had been killed.

We recall too that after Paul had finished his statement to the court the judge said to him: "Paul thou are beside thyself. Much learning hath made thee mad." Judges have been saying the same ever since!

We have but to review history of the past to see how intolerance. ignorance, vengeance and reactionary influences have followed on the trail of Christianity and Spiritualism alike. Jesus was "put to death" by authority of the court. Paul and every one of the twelve apostles who followed Jesus were persecuted and eventually slain by the mob.

<u>Science</u> — An Enemy

Joan of Arc was burned to death in the market place by authority of the Court at the instigation of a disgraceful sectarian mob.

So if we follow along the history of many progressive reforms we find the hand of the oppressor lurking in the background reinforced by ignorance and intolerance.

With respect to the law against foretelling we find that its origin was grounded in the ignorance of three hundred years ago in a time when the king and his followers believed in witchcraft, signs, miracles and other nonsense of like mental delinquency.

At that time many scientific discoveries, now known, were entirely unknown. A scientist was considered an enemy of the church if

Notwithstanding all advancement in science, this antiquated remnant of ignorance still remains as it was three hundred years ago. Efforts to change it have largely failed. Efforts to get a truthful interpretation of this law from courts have been largely unsuccessful because many judges are no farther advanced than were the law makers of three hundred vears ago.

These "modern" judges know nothing about psychic science or its discoveries. They are guided by the wisdom of the cave men rather than by the findings of great scientists like Sir Oliver Lodge. Sir William James and many others of world wide reputation and fame.

Also the Worthy

So long as the law against foretelling remains on the books it is a problem with which Spiritualists and Spiritualism will have to reckon. Worthy mediums will be hauled into court and judges will find them guilty without regard to the high nurnose and honest inten.

ignorant, hateful mob.

Judges found scores of innocent men and women guilty of witchcraft during the Salem frenzy and turned them over to be hung on Gallows Hill. Thousands of innocent men and women were convicted of witchcraft and sentenced to be killed by the judges of European countries even as Jesus of Nazareth was condemned and crucified on a cross.

Religious Liberties?

All down the years of struggle for religious and political freedom there has always been the ignorant, non-progressive reactionary forces resisting all spiritual advancement. There is no way of escaping reactionary influences from the Bench.

If the court assumes that the legislature assumed and they both assume that which is not true, what hope has truth to find its way to justice and understanding as long as such a law remains?

We should all have respect for many great judges for they have been the bulwark of American Liberty. But no one should have respect for any judge who takes his ignorance, his politics, his religious prejudice or his mental inertia on the bench with him and paints, warps or distorts his decisions in defiance of the truth.

This is a danger that always confronts mediums accused of foretelling. This is a menace to religious liberty which some day will be destroyed by legislative enactment.

A Worthy Judge

Until then all mediums who foretell events should see to it that their foretelling if of the character that adds to the dignity of spiritual endowments rather than to answering many questions which should only be answered in a business office or a detective agency.

No credentials conferred can suffice nor can any name over the door make a religion of any thing. Courts can not be expected to find religious sincerity in palpable pretenses and insincerity. Those who seriously expect to avail themselves of religious immunity must live within the limits of their professions and faith.

Fortune telling is not the goal of Spiritualism nor should it be considered by any one. Prophecy is a high spiritual gift of God.

Among the spiritual gifts enumerated by the Apostle Paul is the gift of prophecy. Every one informed and experienced in psychic investigation knows that the power of foretelling events also exists today. We know it can be done because we have had many

Furthermore, this judge writes into his decisions ignorance and lies, and makes his own mistakes the law for other judges to fol low.

In such decisions, the Court as sumes to know that which it does not know. It ignores the teachings of Paul and casts at naugh: the findings of science and the experienced opinions of countless thousands.

If we analyze the opinion of the court in the Ashley case we find that the judges found that the legislature found that foretelling events is impossible and approves of that error.

England's Ignorance

They thus decide a case and make laws which all informed investigators know is not of truth.

If we follow this law back to its origin we find it a remnant of ignorance that existed in England three hundred years ago. It is a relic of witchcraft days which has no place under our constitution.

If citizens are to have religious liberty they should at least be permitted to believe and practice the teachings of the New Testament without being brought into court and punished as cheats and frauds

country in the Salem witch craft cases beginning about 1665. The English law was made a part of colonial law of New York and later it was made a part of

the penal law of this state where it has remained unto this day.

an attorney in defending mediums accused of violating this law. I have argued their cases before judges in trial courts and in the Appellate Courts in an effort to get some judge to write an opinion worthy of the importance of the issues involved. I write this article with knowledge of both sides.

Several attempts have been made to repeal this relic of the old witely craft days. Once we succeeded in getting a bill evenpting mediums from its provisions passed by the Senate and the 1ssembly of New York but this bill was vetoed by a biased Governor.

There are influences opposed to Spiritualism that come to light whenever legislative action is sought in the interest of religious liberty for all spiritualist mediums.

"The Ashley Case"

The most notable case in the annals of New York court reports is known as the Ashley Case. This case arose in New York City in 1917 and was referred to in the above mentioned Miller case. The Ashley Case is reported in 181 N. Y., A. D. 520.

This case is always cited as authority for the arrest and conviction of mediums for foretelling events. The judge, who wrote the opinion, in substance said: because they teach and practice that which great and holy men have believed and taught before them.

Paul Arraigned

It would seem that the disgraceful slaughter committed in Salem under direction of the courts of that time, should cause the presentday judges to think:

We recall that when Paul of Tarsus was arraigned before the Roman court at the complaint of the elders and High Priests of the Hebrew church, he was accused of

At that time, furthermore, the telephone. telegraph. steam engine. radio and a thousand discoveries and inventions had never been dreamed of. Today these new discoveries are a part of our daily life.

We in America have respect for our courts. We instinctively surround our judges with a halo of confidence and honor because law is supposed to represent and safe guard our liberties and the judge is supposed to represent the law. The judge has power to punish us for contempt of his court and send us to jail even though he may scarcely know enough to make out the commitment papers. He is king on his judicial throne but citizens are but surfs in his dock. He is presumed to be always right.

Joan of Arc - GUILTY!

Judges may decide the world is flat and render decision upon such findings. The citizen may be in danger of contempt of court if he argues with the judge or questions the wisdom of an ignorant fool on the bench.

We have profound respect for some judges because they are qualified to represent and administer the law. Other judges may be unworthy but nevertheless they have been elevated to judicial honors by voters who don't know any better. A judge found Jesus of Nazar. eth guilty and turned him over to his enemies to be killed. Judges found Joan of Arc guilty of heresy and turned her over to be burned to death in the market place by an

In conclusion may I say that

the opinion of Judge Ciaccano in the Miller case before referred to. is an opinion as far as it goes that marks him as a judge well worthy of the name. His judicial analysis of facts and discerning applications of existing law together with his fair and impartial application of both law and fact renders this decision a notable victory for religious freedom and a notable achievement by the judge who wrote the opinion ..

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

faculty to enquire and to doubt that we must question. We know that if the doors of discovery are to be opened, we must knock. And who shall say that the knocking is trivial?

Too often faith has been used by the Church as a stopping-block instead of a stepping-stone. One wonders how long it will be used to keep the conception of a spiritual world up in the clouds as a beautiful unreality - to cherish imagery but to challenge established facts of enquiry.

Evidence Strengthens Faith

Surely the man who really possesses faith is he who is prepared to venture in it. And a faith in the survival of our loved ones calls us to venture on their being alive — bids us seek fellowship with them and not to deny our belief by acting as though they were dead.

The true believer will be like Columbus of old, who believed there was another land across the great ocean divide, and who ventured his barque with as motley a company as ever risked the unknown.

And Columbus sailed outward and beyond with his faith and fears and doubts; but to his faith he added virtue --- the virtue of venturing in it, and finally to virtue knowledge-the knowledge of a new land.

Evidence of an after-life such as enquiry affords is not a substitute for faith in God. It only strengthens that faith with a wider vision of His goodness. Man lives on when the flesh he wore has turned to dust: therefore the flesh cannot be the man.

Lives Are Altered

Only a full realization, by those who mourn, of the truth that it never was the calling of flesh to flesh (as is clear when time turns vandal), but the communion of spirit with spirit that really mattered, will bring the full and glorious consolation to be found in the knowledge that such communion cannot be obliterated by the shadow of death.

If people could be made to realize that a future life is something which need not be believed or disbelieved at will, but something the reality of which has been scientifically proved; if they would but examine the evidence available, then assuredly might our individual lives be renovated in accordance with this knowledge, and even our social relationships adjusted more in conformity with the Golden Rule.

All Satisfied With Evidence Received

Several months ago, I had one of the most amazing experiences in spirit demonstration it has ever been my good fortune to witness.

As a member of the development class conducted by the Rev. Edward Lester Thorne of the United Spiritualists' Church, Columbus Ave. & 72nd St., New York City, it has been my privilege to attend direct-voice seances, when several trumpets would be in the air at one time: each one with individual spirit voices emerging to talk to their various loved ones. Apports appeared "from out of nowhere.'

Sunbeam Tells Us

I have seen materializations, and, on one occasion, an unfinished crochet article of mine, that had been in a bag in the next room, with the door locked between, was deposited in the lap of a new class member!

We of the class are accustomed to the trance work of Rev. Thorne and to the various speaking voices of those spirits who usually use his vocal chords for direct-voice communication. On this particular occasion. we were told by the medium's spirit collaborator "Sunbeam," that a great treat was in store for us.

Dora Barnes Present

Hitherto, all of the trance work had been done in the darkness and we were unable to see the medium.



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Now, "Sunbeam" instructed Miss Dora Barnes to turn on the blue light, so that we could see Rev. Thorne in trance.

I had expected to see him slumped over in his chair, apparently asleep. Instead, he was sitting upright, eyes closed, making gestures with his hands, turning his head in the direction of the various members as "Sunbeam" addressed them, mouth and lips opening for articulation.

"Myrtle From Brooklyn"

The gestures were quite natural for a child; a finger shyly placed to a corner of the mouth when some compliment was given, hand placed over the mouth when trying to suppress merriment, hands folded naturally in the lap when listening, head a little to the side.

I. unfortunately, have not yet developed enough to "see' her, but other members noted transfiguration of the mediums features.

Then "Myrtle from Brooklyn," came through with her characteristic slow, husky, drawling "Hello". One could fill a book about "Myrtle" who is loved by all of us. Her ready wit and down-to-earth humor have raised the vibrations of many a session.

When she controlled the medium, he assumed a slouching position, head thrust forward. hands on hips. "Myrtle's" accent is strictly "Brooklynese" and I am not enough of a writer to translate it on paper. Here again, transfiguration was visible to some of the class members.

Transfiguration Observed

After Myrtle left, the medium slumped forward, every muscle seemingly relaxed, and then suddenly straightened up, erect, shoulders back, head up so as to seem much taller than he is, and then the deep, measured tones of voice of "Dr. Montague" issued from his lips. The gestures were characteristic of the spirit individual; a grave nod of the head, graceful but controlled hand gestures.

It is because we possess the

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

Spiritualists May Also Be Christians

The New Religion will not be a religion of any kind but a beautiful pattern of life as taught by the Nazarene.

Wherein a letter directed to Juliette Ewing Pressing is answered in detail.

That which blocks the progress of mankind is not *true*. And that which is untrue should never be permitted to obstruct the passage. Truth does not hold back the sons ard daughters of men, but only beliefs as to what men think is true do this, keeping men and

races in bondage. Messages purporting to come from Radiant Ones tell us there are mortals in Etheria who have clung to their false beliefs for thousands of years and make no progress. They make no progress because of false beliefs.

Then You Are!

Beliefs do not make the manthey more often impair, nor is it possible to gain immortality by the manner of your belief, but only by living that which is good and true.

You are not a Christian by reason of your beliefs in the divinity of Christ but only when you *live* the Christ life—then you are a Christian. That which you believe about your religion is immaterial. That which you are living is making for you a little room in heaven.

Far be from me any desire to dissect or expunge any part of the New or Old Testaments—to say what is false or true therein. Personally I prefer to let that which may or may not have happened thousands of years ago alone even as I do not explain away or add to history.

Among Spiritualists

Neither shall I try to dissuade those persons whom I assume entertain false beliefs regarding religion, whether Christian or heathen; for why should I attempt to reform others when I am told that Radiant Ones have sought in vain for ages to extirpate false beliefs in others? Who am I to attempt such a vain errand? For I know from wide experience in running counter to human nature that men and women will rarely change and only on their own volition. There is nothing so adamant as a fixed idea. Those dark ideas about religion are not confined to members of the orthodox churches. I have known atheists with such fixed beliefs

about religion that probably thousands of years may be required to remove. You will find false opinions in every department of life. You will find these among Spiritualists.

These men and women of the new religion tell you they have found a true way of life. But often their spiritual auras are colored by false beliefs harking back into childhood. Those beliefs of all are of terrible power. They set the direction of nearly every life to make or mar.

The New No Better

Very few persons are great enough to exist without some sort of belief. If they change from the so-called orthodox they find some other belief as a substitute; it is merely a matter of exchange and the new belief is often as orthodox as the original belief.

The woman comes troubled to Juliette Ewing Pressing, editor of *The Psychic Observer* — troubled because the religious belief she grew up with is troubled by a newer faith coming into her life. Old beliefs rarely ever give way without much travail, renting the spiritual nature when they are being cast out.

"Work of The Devil"

The woman revealed in her letter to Mrs. Pressing that for ten years since her father passed away Spiritualism has intrigued her. She gives serious thought and study to the subject. She reads books on Spiritualism and *The Psychic Observer*. During the last year she has had very definite psychical experiences. Consequently, the reality of psychical phenomena she does not question.

"But," she writes Mrs. Pressing, ' there are religious aspects which disturb me very much. I still find myself on the fence . . . Like many others who were brought up in the strict teaching of Christ as a personal savior . . . I simply can not reconcile the scriptural teachings with those of Spiritualism. I do not say this in a spirit of criticism. but simply because I am carnestly sourching for the Truth . . . Just when I think I am a confirmed Spiritualist, I find these sayings bearing in upon me and am greatly distressed . . . I have to conceal my studies from relatives who very definitely state that Spiritualism is the work of the devil."

think this is what The Master had in mind when he said, "Get thee behind me. Satan!"

That which ails this fine and splendid woman seeking so earnestly for Truth is that which ails nearly all—they cling to mental rather than spiritual beliefs.

Scientific Understanding

Let me say I *feel* — I do not merely believe—that The Christ was and is divine. I also *feel* rather than believe that Spiri ualism is pointing to the Way, the Truth and the Life. Christ knew about those other worlds that surround us. He said so. Then one might say he also was a Spiritualist. For Spiritualism is not—or should not be—*merely a religion*.

Religions of any sort are only beliefs. True Christianity — and true Spiritualism for that matter is a *scientific understanding* of life. Let our understanding rise to that and we can become a Christian or we can become a Spiritualist or we can become both Christian and Spiritualist.

My spiritual perception tells me that Christ was a savior of mankind. But because 1 believe that I do not have to believe the false and garbled stories of his life, most of which were written hundreds of years after he trod this earth and made to conform to the erroneous beliefs of the Council of Nicaea. Christ's mission has been falsely explained and his message grossly garbled to suit the fancies of deceitful men.

consequence. After all. didn't those Spiritualist folks "have something"? Was not the life hereafter a cardinal principle of my own Christian training? Had not contact with spirits or argels been described in the Divine Scriptures?

I knew of St. Paul's conversion: I read about the transfiguration. Never before did I search the Scriptures so eagerly nor appreciate the Book so much as after my contact with Spiritualism.

Had there not been prophets and prophetesses mentioned time and again in the Bible? Yes, and the promise therein that "your sons and your daughters shall prophesy and your young men shall see visions."

"For He Shall . . .

I enjoy the Spiritualist meetings tremendously and visit the various ones in the locality, so that I've gotten to know the forms of service, their unbounded faith in the "good and perfect gift that is from above." the comfort derived from messages from beyond. The knowledge too. that they have God's promise mentioned by David in the Psalms "For He shall give His angels charge over thee' is very real. It is true that churches of all denominations, being run by human beings, have their weaknesses, squabbles and petty jealousies and the Spiritualist churches are not excepted. I believe I can see the reason.

another the gifts of healing, by the same spirit (God) to another, the working of miracles, to another, prophecy. to another, the discerning of spirits."

What Has Happened?

Then in chapter fourteen (XIV) "desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy ... he that prophesieth, speaketh unto men to edification and comfort . . . but if all prophecy. and there come in one that believeth not. he is con. vinced of all. and thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest ... he will worship God and re. port that God is in you of a truth ... for ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn . . . and the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets . . . covet to prophesy."

Well what has happened to the Spiritualist churches? It seems to me that they have somewhat overlooked the chapter in between —the thirteenth (13) Paul's masterpiece in which he states that all gifts, all knowledge, all faith are nothing unless charity, that is love, exists in the human heart.

He tells what it is and what it means and the advice if followed, would undoubtedly do great good for the cause of Spiritualism.

Then there would be less friction. no jealousy and a friendly greeting to a visitor—not that a newcomer is looking for human kindness but that he doesn't like to be badly treated.

Yes, there is improvement to be made in the Spiri'ualist's attitude to one ano her and it *can* come about.

Gives Other Reasons

One of the most remarkable readings I ever had was by a *Hindu* in the Far East who at first, started off on the wrong foot by telling me things I did not wish to hear but was excellent when I set him straight along that line. That is one thing noticeable among Spiritualists here in America, they aim to comfort without being told.

On Easter Sunday, the weather rear my home town was bad—it really did rain! Yet, Saturday's paper had on the front page admonished the fair sex to have no fears—wear the new Easter hat and venture forth.

How many ladies were disappointed and dampened is impossible to say, but THAT is the scientific (so called) prophesying and yet many scoff at the mediums who can and do hit the mark far more accurately, than the weather

Had I time and opportunity I might with consummate accuracy prove this by presenting historical facts. But I would not do this in any event because the picture The Christ presented is too beautiful and cublime to be even dissected. fruit or flowers. and care is needed all the time if these are to be excellent.

Parents on Earth usually want their children to grow up in a way which will be best in a commercialized state. The real ambition of the child is then a secondary thing.

Here we do not make this mistake: we look for the thing native to the mind and we nurse that more than anything else, and so, contentedly doing that which it loves best to do, the little mind unfolds happily and contentedly.

Spirit Vurseries

Growth prospers as it develops mentally and if a baby we had cared for in this way could reappear in the Earth-plane you would be astonished at the way it had grown and improved.

When Your Baby "Dies"

None grows so old here that they will not find an excuse for studying; inclination decides where one shall linger to learn, and one soon learns to linger, for knowledge is the spice of life in Spirit. The Human Atmosphere

The Discoveries of Franz Anton MESMER, Baron von REICHENBACH and Dr. W. J. KILNER.

Everyone knows the common magnet. Not everyone knows that man himself is a magnet. That he, too, has his positive and negative poles at the head and feet respectively.

Has also his individual magnetic field, the forces playing through which are equally mysterious in their functions and operations to the manifestations of our terrestrial atmosphere.

Every object, every cell, and indeed every single atom has this magnetic field. In the case of the atom it is simply in the form of an attraction and repulsion as regards other atoms.

The human being, however, is a highly complex group of atoms and hence the human atmosphere or aura is a very complicated affair.

Mesmeric Hand-waving

In the city of *Vienna*, in 1760. one Franz Anton Mesmer discovcred that the property of healing was inherent in a magnet and that if a disease organ was stroked, or if passes were made over it, the magnet radiated a power which cured.

Then one day Mesmer accidentally found that the passes were often effective when a magnet was not used. He concluded that man bimself was a magnet and that the finger tips radiated a force which he called animal magnetism or Mesmeric Fluid.

The early Hypnotists who followed Mesmer derided his theory of the invisible fluid and maintained that the real cure took place in the patient's subconscious and that the mesmeric hand-waving was merely to gain control of the sufferer's complete attention.

In 1845, however, another scientist, Baron Von Reichenbach. announced to the world that animal

ceived precisely similar emanations proceeding from the human finger tips.

Many people possess special sensitivity of sight and see cloudy effects or colors around persons or objects which they wrongly put down to faulty vision, or fear to mention to others in case of ridicule.

Ultra-violet Light

No further findings along this by-way of science then came to light until the years of the Great War when Dr. W. J. Kilner, House Surgeon at St. Thomas's Hospital, London, stumbled across the big truth that made him the real Professor of the Human Aura.

He conceived the idea that if these magnetic radiations were really perceptible to specially sensitive sight they probably belonged to that order of phenomena which we term the ultra-violet.

Ultra-violet light, as most people know, is normally invisible, being of a wave length too short or a vibratory rate too high, for ordinary vision.

Research Discloses

Dr. Kilner argued. therefrom, that if his premise was true and the Aura was a reality it might be possible to construct some sort of screen to exclude certain light rays and make the ultra-violet visible.

With this end in view he commenced research work and after several years succeeded in evolving such a screen which consisted of glass cells filled with an alcoholic solution of dicyanin. a coal tar dye. Examination of a human being through this screen revealed a faint greyish mist around the hands and head.

Will This Help Cancer?

It is unfortunate that Dr. Kilner was an old man at the time of his discovery and did not carry his researches as far as a younger man might have done. Others, however, both contemporaries and successors, carried on and the story can be continued through them.

Before leaving Kilner. however, I would like to stress the immense value of his work to medical science.

Not only is Auric diagnosis an invaluable check on other methods of detecting a suspected disease, but the symptoms show in the aura long before any complaint is manifest in the slightest degree





Statement Made by Photographer


