"Do you know." he commenced, "that I have ridden on horseback forty miles through the snow today to be present at this meeting, because my old mother sent me a message that she would meet me here! I don't believe in it, you know. I've never been to a seance before, and I feel as if I was making a great fool of myself now, but I couldn't neglect my poor old mother's message, whatever came of it."

"Of course not," I answered, "and I hope your trouble will be rewarded.'

I had not much faith in my own words though, because I had seen people disappointed again and again over their first seance, from either the spirits of their friends being too weak to materialize, or from too many trying to draw power at once, and so neutralizing the effect on all . . .

## My Observations At **Brady Lake Spiritualist Camp** During Summer, 1944

CAMP OFFICIALS OVERCOME GREAT DIFFICULTIES

Fidell, Kingsbury and Russell Were Featured

In the last three issues of Psychic Observer. I have recorded my observations at the summer Spiritualist camps, Silver Belle, Lilv Dale and Chesterfield. This article describes the activities, as I found them, during my visit to Brady Lake Spiritualist Camp at Lake Brady, Ohio,

The Brady Lake camp is one of America's smaller Spiritualist centers. It is located 12 miles from Akron and less than 50 miles south of Cleveland. It is situated on Brady Lake which tends to create a cool, pleasant atmosphere especially during the hot summer months.

#### Plan New Auditorium

There are a number of cottages. 25 or 30, many of which are occupied the year round by local residents. For over 10 years, all public services were held in a large auditorium but early last season the building was completely ruined by fire which necessitated the temporary use of the large dining room in the camp's hotel for that purpose. Plans are under way for the erection of a new auditor-

On the camp grounds proper. two cottages are reserved for visiting mediums and regularly scheduled summer speakers. There is a pienic pavilion and a building provided for private and semipublic seances with facilities for occasional demonstrations of various phases of physical medium-

### Trustees Resourceful

During the month of July, 1911. one of this countries outstanding mediums. Theodor C. Russell of Buffalo, was featured. Mr. Russell, is known as "America's Premier Psychie, He is leader of the Cosmic Science Foundation. Inc. and conducts regular Sunday services at Hotel Statler in the city of Buffalo.

Inasmuch as the auditorium was completely demolished one week before my scheduled Sunday engagement late in August, I was told by phone that the camp would carry on and that services would be held in the dining room of the hotel. I kept my engage-



ment and, upon my arrival, was in pressed by the enthusiasm and sincerity of "The Kingsburys" who manage the camp. Rev. Della Kingsbury is a mental medium and chairman at all meetings. William Kingsbury, who manages a store in the village of Lake Brady, is the camp secretary.

Almost overnight, the dining room was rearranged to serve as an auditorium. There was an improvised rostrum and chairs were placed to accommodate 100 visitors and strange to say, after the service, I was informed that exactly 100 persons were in at-

#### Pittsburgh Medium

Della Kingsbury presided at the Sunday afternoon service. My lecture was followed by messages. The first medium to be presented was Rev. Katherine Fidell of Pittsburgh. Pa. Her demonstration of clairvoyance was well received.

Owing to the fact that my visit on this occasion was short. I did not have the opportunity to interview other camp mediums but for me the most interesting part of my trip were the demonstrations given by Rev. Albert E. Vaughn Strode of Enid, Oklahoma and Rev. Bertha Marx of Springfield, Ohio.

The evening before we left Lily Dale, it occurred to Mr. Pressing that perhaps there were two mediums who would enjoy the recreation of a little week-end trip to Brady Lake and about 11 P. M. that night, he went to their Hotel and extended an invitation to them to accompany us on the trip the following day.

### Marx and Vaughn Strode

Both mediums had been serving Lily Dale Assembly during the entire summer 1911 season and were pleased to accept our invitation. Accordingly all four of us made the trip from Lily Dale early next morning (Saturday) arriving at Brady Lake late the same afternoon. Brady Lake is about 150 miles from Lily Dale.

Rev. Kingsbury called upon Rev. Marx and Rev. Vaughn Strode to assist at the Sunday afternoon message service and before a crowd of perfect strangers. these two mediums demonstrated brilliant clairvoyance. Full names and a great deal of additional evidence was given with each and every message.

Whilst I know that many topnotch mediums can tap the invisible and give evidence under all sorts of conditions, yet many people labor under the delusion that messages either come from the subconscious minds of the people in the audience or that the mediums, through collusion, are able to gain all their information. All kinds of far-fetched claims are made by an uninformed and skeptical public. These claims are made in an effort to discount proof of spirit communication.

### Radiate Confidence

I trust that this article will help clear away some of these false notions and establish a little more faith in the ever-present power of spirit. Little does the general public realize how much of a barrier they build when the balance of power is held by those who are literally steeped in skepticism and unbelief.

If only for selfish reasons (the

fact that you would like a message for yourself) it is best for you to keep an open mind when you attend Spiritualist meetings. If you radiate confidence, the results will more than compensate you. If you cannot do that then I am afraid that you are wasting your time to attend at all.

So that I will not be misunderstood, I think it best to clarify my previous statement by saving that. even though my views of proper approach must stand, yet I do not approve of accepting wholeheartedly every word that a medium utters. However, I do know. from personal experience, that loving kindness expressed and radiated toward the message bearer pays big dividends in results possibly not directly to yourself but to others in the audience who may need an encouraging word a great deal more than you at that particular time.



Then, too. some think that God is pitilessly punishing all who do not kowtow to him and praise him as a fine fellow and believe in a lot of incredible chimeras invented by ignorant men.

Like an earthly monarch, he is pictured as sitting on a throne. eternally delivering judgments on those who do not follow the barbarous ideas he is supposed to deliver through his priestly underlings.

#### Washington Said:

These same underlings invented these vague traditions, superstitions and profitable (to them) forms and ceremonies surviving from the past. INEFFABLE SPIRIT, and is infinitely beyond the compass of man's understanding, as a whole, But all have some atom of truth and the sane way is to explore and recover all these minute fragments and endeavor to apply them to a CORRECT WAY OF LIFE in our relationship to God and our fel-

Fortunately in this country we have the right to do as George Hushington once wrote:

\*The liberty enjoyed by the people of these states, of worshipping Almighty God agreeable to their consciences, is NOT ONLY among their choicest of BLESSINGS. but also of their RIGHTS."

### Old Ideas Vanish

In our first letter (Psychic Obserier. Ipril 25, 1915) we saw that God is Ineffable, beyond man's power to express. The universe, known and unknown, is the manifestation of God and our only means of realizing, by experience and participation, the Spirit of God in man, who is an imperfect manifestation, though the highest we yet know.


#### No Finer Book

## DREAM

What Are They? Why Do We Have Them?

A very interesting question is involved in the subject of dreams. What and why are dreams?

A dream is a semi-conscious state of mind between sleep and wakefulness. It occurs at a time when mental impressions are imperfectly impinged upon the brain cells but, with sufficient force to create memory after full consciousness has been attained.

Probably every one has dreams. Whenever we are able to recall the series of events, facts and fancies connected with the train of events involved in a dream, we find a strange combination of sense and nonsense, truth and falsehoods all interwoven in a chain of events more or less connected one with

that has actually existed. Facts that are remembered may be mingled with imaginary creations that never have existed.

Thus we find in dreams evidence of memory of truth mingled with mental creations of untruth. But they all bear evidence of mental force impinged upon the physical

There is another phase of the same phenomenon when persons receive answers to different questions, solutions of difficult problems and accomplish during sleep that which they have been unable otherwise to accomplish.

Yet another phase of related truth is shown when persons become intoxicated or delirious through fever or other causes which interfere with mental action through impairment of the nervous

#### Psychic Science Proves

All of this data points to the fact that there must be harmonious co-operation between the mental and the physical organism before the mind can function in a normal and orderly way. These facts also prove that, when there is not normal co-ordination between the mental and the physical organisms, distorted thoughts are certain to follow as a result.

These facts present very interesting questions concerning (1) the relations of the physical body to the astral body during sleep; (2) the relation of the physical body to the astral body in waking moments: (3) the relation of the physical body to the astral body under normal conditions during wakeful hours.

Psychic science has proved that man has two bodies through which the spirit functions. We know that the physical body, without the contact with the astral body, has neither life nor intelligence: nor can it long endure. It is created by and through chemical elements hence to chemical elements it must

### An Interesting Question

We know that the astral body is a counterpart of the physical, composed of finer substance through which life, intelligence and spirit manifests in conjunction with the physical.

We know that, when the astral entirely leaves the body of flesh. physical death results but that the astral and the spirit lives on.

We know that, during sleep, the astral partially leaves the physical to the end that consciousness is suspended, memory is inactive.

During this period of suspended consciousness the subconscious restores the vitality of weary flesh while we are enjoying a restful sleep. This period should be eight of each twenty-four hours of the

What and why are dreams? During sleep there is not normal co-ordination between the astral and the physical. During complete wakefulness there is full coordination between the astral and the physical.

It is not, therefore, reasonable to assume that the distorted, disconnected, imaginary thought forms that are impinged upon the brain. ....d remembered as dreams, are due to imperfect co-ordination between the astral and the physical in waking moments?

If the dream state should continue for hours, days, months or even years from the same cause, why should not such a dreamer be considered unbalanced?

Here is an interesting question. Here is a contribution that psychic science may yet make to aid the medical profession . . . when trying to solve a difficult problem about which they know very little, at least at the present time.

PROFESSOR CESARE LOM-BROSO, the distinguished Italian scientist:-

There can be no doubt that genuine Spiritualistic phenomena are produced by intelligences totally independent of the medium and the parties present at the seances. ## More About the APPENDECTOMY at PINDAMONHANGABA

## Operation performed by materialized spirit of Or. Amaral

For the past several months, the entire world has been astounded by reports and positive evidence received from Brazil about this seance room operation, when a spirit doctor removed an appendix from ANDRE DI BERNARDI. The editor of PSYCHIC OBSERVER wrote to the American Embassy at Rio de Janeiro, asking for complete data and pictures. A prompt reply was received from Wm. A. Wieland,

The above, a reproduction of a Brazilian newspaper clipping, shows one section of the 12-ft. square seance room where the operation was performed by the materialized spirit of DR. AMARAL. To the right is the cot upon which the patient, ANDRE BENARDI, submitted to the operation. The black cloth at the head of the cot separated the patient's head from his body (note narrow oblong slip.) The bottles, etc. were asked for and placed upon the table before the seance-operation began. Note the sign on the wall "Maximo Silence." meaning strict silence.



The picture above was published by "AMERICAN WEEKLY" over two months ago. It shows Andre Di Bernardi, after the operation. being interviewed by (left) star newspaper reporter for "Diario Da Noite." He is telling the reporter that X-rays revealed his appendix had been inflamed and that X-rays taken after the operation proved the appendix had been removed.

special assistant to the American Ambassador who stated that all data and pictures would be sent by Centro Espirita Santa Terezinha, in Pindamonhangaba, Sao Paulo, Brazil. The pictures below appeared in "DIARIO DA NOITE." one of the largest newspapers in Brazil. The text was translated for the editor of this journal by the Brazilian Consul, 60 East 42nd St., New York City.



The picture (upper left) shows another view of the service room where the operation was performed. The window in center is blacked out. The door to the right (the only one to the room) is covered with a black cloth. The four witnesses sat in front of this door so no one could enter or leave during the operation. Barely visible at the left is the edge of the foot of the cot.

Reproduced (above right) are two pages of the book, used by the spirit doctor, while he was performing the operation.

In the picture (lower left) a Brazilian Spiritualist and a reporter are examining the red light, which appears as a round black spot, on the upper center of the wall.

In the picture, (lower center) the appendix taken from the patient can be seen in the bottle. This object and contents has been examined by five astonished Brazilian surgeons.

In the picture (lower right) a reporter, back to the camera, is interviewing Andre Di Bernardi and his wife after the successful operation.


