Since the beginning of modern psychical research, some sixty or seventy years ago, all types of in-vestigators entered into the study of spirit phenomena. Learned men and women and some not so learned: serious investigators of physical mediumship and intellect-ual "die-hards" . . . all were members of the numerous Psychic Research Societies that sprung up all over the world.

Today the work of these societies, or groups calling them-selves researchers, has to a marked degree crystalized . . . owing to the fact that the better physical mediums in the country refuse to be tested by those who lack sufficient knowledge to know what they are witnessing or because there has been an inclination on the part of entrusted with passing judgment—to either procrastinate or disagree among themselves.

The real service to be rendered by these societies is to ascertain the degree of mediumship possessed by reputable physical mediums and NOT to try to prove communication to be a FACT. This has already been proven as much as it is possible to prove anything.

Proper Attitude

All any intelligent person has to do is to examine the thousands of records, proceedings, etc., on file at The American Society for Psy-chical Research or the British College of Psychic Science.

This, added to the data found in thousands of books written by persons of impeccable honesty, makes it reasonable for the researcher to start on the premise that personal conscious survival is at least a possibility.

With this start, and with this attitude any recruit or neophyte of average intelligence can cope with the subject of psychic research. However, persons must not become self-conscious and carried away with the idea that they are blazing a new trail and must find flaws.

It is all very simple or can be made difficult. What is needed, aside from a mild critical attitude, tolerance, discrimination and kindness toward the well-being and physical endurance of the medium.

Appointment Made

Honesty of Purpose

As a rule, mediums featured at any camp, are continually being asked to sit for certain types of psychic researchers and in most instances all mediums welcome such assignments, provided they are entered into with honesty of purpose and a desire to really learn something of the "modusoperandi" of mediumship.

However, generally just the opposite happens because some per-sons present themselves as researchers who have never even read a book on the subject and wouldn't understand or appreciate a genuine demonstration if they saw one.

Mr. Bach was not in any of these categories. He was kind, appreciative of my efforts to have him well received and had the good judgment to mentally catalog the phenomena he could not under stand and to not condemn some-thing he knew very little about.

A Rare Résearcher

For two days, Mr. Bach and I attended seances at Chesterfield; witnessed clairvoyance at public meetings and rehashed for hours the demonstrations we witnessed.

All through the winter months, Mr. Bach has been studying psy chic science and even lecturing to groups on the subject. He has or-dered, for the University library, hundreds of books on Spiritualism and Psychic Science and super-vised "Open-forum" discussions at the classes sponsored by their School of Religion.

This is a sequel to "The Valley of the Sacred Little Children,' of my psychic experiences which was recently published in the PSYCHIC OBSERVER. (October 25th, 1945).

That narrative dealt with the educational work in progress in one of the countless centers of the astral world. There the spiritual, artistic, philanthropic and Universal Brotherhood Principles to be inculcated are given an opportunity to express the Divine Precepts through enlightened teachers, into the minds and souls of little chil-

Those who have passed over to the spirit side of life prematurely, and those who are still living on the earth plane, are under the instructions of advanced souls who live on this earth and in the spirit The Art World, unlike the Sphere of the Children is actively engaged in the more mature task of perfecting every kind of artistic ability conceivable to mankind.

Why Red Indians??

During one of my astral visits to the Art Plane, I pressed with the work progressive American Indians are doing in their colleges, which are dedicated almost exclusively to the higher education of the formerly under-privileged people. The Teachers and Nature Guides of this plane concentrate their wholehearted attention upon the rehabilitation of the Indian race, but they have exalted their purpose to such an extent that their power extends far beyond the confine of their various

Their service to Spiritualists is unique, inasmuch as it is closely allied with nature forces; for the Indians, having lived so long up-

on the earth in close proximity to elementary conditions; possessing instinctive understanding which closely parallels the Godlike intuiintelligence of birds and beasts, have developed magnetic power which is of u most impor-tance to mediums, who depend largely upon the magnetic connecting link between this world and the astral plane.

I have seen massive reproductions of adobe huts, surrounding the art colleges, and little Indian weaving artistic specimens of inexpressible beauty.

Thin Veil Between

They, like the children in the advanced spiritual schools of the Sacred Valley, project these original exquisite images of color and beauty into the cosmic ethers where they are transmitted to the earth plane.

Persons upon our material earth frequently receive these images in dreams, also in waking consciousness, when they are in tune with these Infinite Realities.

These art planes are affiliated with the Divine and Earth life and represent both phases of aspiration and concentrated constructive visualization.

Our artistic desires and comprehension of the beauty of Nature contributes vitally to the repro-duction of natural beauty in all planes of mortal consciousness. There is no division line between the other world and this earth except our own materially limited consciousness

What Infinite Beauty could be manifest in our visible world if we would tune in upon the realms of Light and join the Divine Hierachy in its Creative Sphere! The development of our own ability would be assured, and our chances for useful service enhanced.

Nature's Fury

The Indians, even on the Astral Plane, adhere closely to nature which is the material portrait and composite living picture of the Creator in His various aspects.

They are especially interested in the products of the earth, the gems, quartz, beautiful white marble, rocks, seashells and forestry products, being among the many chief interests that occupy their time and thought.

They revel in color, and paint their images of Sacred Beauty in spectacular hues, expressing an in-ner power and majesty unsurpassed by many great painters who belong to the White race. The exquisite messages found in grained wood fascinate them.

They are a people who read God's Love in every leaf, shrub, and flower, in the sands along the ocean's shores, in temples far up on mountain tops; for they see glory in the receding of the waters, and the new mountains which are born. There, in the undercurrents of nature's fury, they translate civilization's enduring history. Whether the stone they chisel in their art academies be white, pink, green, brown, black, or any known color they decipher God's message in the product which shall shortly be transformed into the image which occupies their own minds and souls.

Etheric Beauty

Many of these priceless objects d'Art occupy a prominent place in one of the museums I visited. This art museum is enormous. It occupies several blocks of beautiful grounds. Flowers, shrubbery, gigantic trees, surround this particular art center, lending it an added enchantment and a fairy like ethereal beauty like none I have seen on earth.

Upon one occasion, after having mounted the broad marble steps, and entered the vast corridors of the colossal building. I became confused and awe-stricken. covered my equilibrium, however, when I saw a dear, familiar figure, close beside me. It was my colored mammy, who attended me all through my earliest childhood, down south in Kentucky.

Mental Sphere of Existence

This struck me as most unusual at the time, for I had expected to find my artistic teachers in the art world. It had never occurred to me to look for this kind, good soul among such cold formidable surroundings. I have always associated her with a warm domestic atmosphere

During these astral journeys one can always depend upon the unexpected happening. companied me throughout this visit. There was a chilly tomb like atmosphere about the place. It reminded me of an artistic maus-seleum. I was truly thankful for the presence of the old black woman, for I became conscious of the

Present day psychic researchers, both genuine and pscudo, should be willing to undergo this simple test. At least the medium would be guaranteed an equal status with the sitter, thus preventing interference from any sitter as well as the medium, in the event phenomena occurred.

fact that I was in the center of mortally created objects of thought of all human and totally lacking in Divine Inspiration.

However, no vulgarity was indicated, so I concluded that this was a strictly mental sphere of material mortal creation, modern, and devoid of even sensous warmth. This sphere was coldly creative, with a definite trend to ward contemptuous heartlessness.

Valley of Sacred Children

I found nothing in the vast section of this gigantic building that remotely resembled the happy, glowingly alive atmosphere of the Indian Village, or the Valley of the Sacred Little Children.

Upon another occasion, I traveled through another magnificent building, containing many rooms of spectacular size. I was accompanied by my brother Harvey who is now in the spirit world, and several other friends. My brother was alive at the time and we frequently took astral trips together. He was a confirmed Spiritualist. problems and we solved many problems through our united understanding of psychic laws.

I resolved to remember the peculiar pattern of the black and white mosaic floor in a certain large room, and the arrangement of the doors which opened into and out of this room. A special design of diamond shaped flowers, a rectangular pattern, unusual and therefore memorable, captured my attention.

When I Awoke . . .

This spot, where I stood, was on the left hand side of the room. up the extreme side toward the center, and a door opened direct-ly beside the tiled, flowerlike de-Everywhere about me were specimens of Grecian, Egyptian, and Oriental art. I marveled at the size of the doors, some of which opened outward into the massive hall. It wearied me to contemplate traveling through this structure. However, I resolved to

take my training by degrees and return frequently at brief intervals the inscriptions, survey placques, sarcophagi and hemetically sealed treasures.

When I awoke next morning, the scene in the Art Museum was firmly implanted upon my mind, remembered vividly that my brother Harvey had stood near the mosaic flowered floor design and that he had laughingly poised himself in the left hand doorway and leaned against a door which opened outward.

At breakfast, I asked him casu-..., weu, Harvey, what did you think of that place we were in last night?"

He looked at me quizzically "That sure was some big place, wasn't it, Sis? I was especially intrigued with that tile floor

"Pretty design," he continued smilingly, "I go there often."

"Where were you standing last night when you were admiring that pattern?" I asked.

A Marine Investigates

He responded immediately: "On the left hand side of the room, in the doorway which opened into the

My brother and I made similar tests for several years. He was young, slender, boyish, and a corporal in the United States Marine Corps, but in these occult matters. he was deeply interested. He took our investigations seriously, although he never lost his sense of humor when the occasion arose. Having served honorably in the first World War, he came home from the battle fronts only to be killed in an automobile accident.

At a later date, when I relate further psychic experiences, shall mention the warning I received of his death, and the events which transpired before and after his transition.

How It Happened

I recently visited this same mu-seum in the art plane of the Astral World and discussed the weird experiences with Sheldon Lewis, my former husband, one of the stage and screen's most famous character actors, who also is interested in certain phases of psychic development. When we compared written notes, our data was almost identical.

This is exactly how it happened; One night astrally, I travelled with Mr. Lewis and Harvey, my brother to the same places we had psychically visited years ago. This time, however, I found myself suddenly in a mansion which resembled a



It is simply the story of an exceptionally intelligent and able man who is generous enough to share with fellow seekers his own findings, to pass on the great things he has uncovered in his own search.

to every human passing through it.

To the newcomer to Spiritualism, the main thought it will leave will be, "Well. it's true, after all.

A man like that couldn't be fooled." To the convinced Spiritualist, or believer in the immortality of the human soul, it gives further and more definite news of that coming dawn of a new age of which there have been many rumors in the last few years.

There are so many things of interest in it that it is impossible to do justice to this book in a short review. That the mysterious and lovely island of Iona off the west coast of Scotland, and the great Abbey ruins of Glastonbury in Somerset, England, are occult power centers, will not be new to students. We hope to hear more of this from Lord Dowding later.

There is one point that cannot be omitted, in even the sketchiest review, and that is a tribute to the unselfish courage of the author. The British are reticent upon matters of religion and personal beliefs, to speak of them is "bad form" to a degree. It simply isn't done: However, when — in the words of one of his own Guides— Lord Dowding was asked "To go into the market place and testify," without a thought of self, HE DID JUST THAT.

"She answered my questions satisfactorily. Then I asked her if she remembered the catechism we studied together. When she said she did, I asked for the first question and answer, which she gave and then said, 'Here where we are there is a bigger meaning to serving and glorifying God'. Before she left, the lips of her mask - like, ectoplasmic face brushed my forehead in a kiss."

Dr. Bach, who has spent many years in research among unusual years in research among unusual religions, described himself as a skeptic who never before had seen anything in spiritualistic seances which could not be ex-plained. He went to Chesterfield, Ind., last summer, however, and there met people who he said are among the leading Spiritualists of the United States and England.

Tells of Incidents

Others in the room, which he examined beforehand, met and conversed with dead members of their families, he stated. Describing a previous experience at Chesterfield, Dr. Bach told how two trumpets floated around a room and how the voice of a girl named SYLVIA spoke from one and SIR WILLIAM JAMES from

"William James wrote books on the psychology of religion and the voice said to be his answered my questions satisfactorily," the speaker said. "I held one of the floating trumpets in my hands and could find no strings."

Dr. Bach said he believes in life after death but that Spiritualists want us to believe that it is possible to communicate with those who live after death. Whether he believes that to be possible after his experiences, he would not say, but he concluded:

"I told my mother, who had always warned me to stay away from Spiritualists, about how I had seen Paula, and my mother answered: 'Well, who knows? In this day of radio and the atomic bomb anything seems possible'.'

Ben D. Farrar introduced the speaker and Harvey D. Matteson expressed the club's thanks for the talk.

Now to analyze the article. Mr. Bach first heard from his "dead' sister, Paula, through the mediumship of Clifford Bias. It was at a private clairvovant and billet seance. I sat in the next room.

Later that day Paula materialized through the mediumship of Fanchion Harwood as did some of Bach's other relatives.

The following day, Charles Swann and Clifford Bias held a special direct-voice seance for Mr. Bach and myself. At this seance, held in a pitch-dark room, Paula and Dr. William James spoke.

Although Mr. Bach did not know it at the time, at this seance he witnessed one of the rarest phases of phenomena I have ever It was what could be described as a partial materializa-

Physical Impossibility

The form, a life-sized bust and head, was self-illuminated. It appeared, on an angle, and this is important, directly in front but above us so that we had to look up, so to speak, to get a good view. The form persisted about a minute and then disappeared.

It would have been a physical

impossibility (if you have that type of mind) for the medium to stand up in that position unless a chair was used to stand upon. And even so, it would necessitate standing and balancing on one foot and chinning oneself on the ceiling. But, you see, there was nothing attached to the ceiling to use to do "chinning-up".

I expect to arrange additional seances for Mr. Bach this summer and know that we stand a good chance of witnessing some marvelous demonstrations.

"agnostic" or "not proven" school, the members of which are willing to continue their investigations; (3) Those who believe survival is proved, including such names as the late Dr. Alexis Carrel, of the Rockefeller Foundation and one of the world's first biologists; Sir Oliver Lodge (ex-President of the British Association, perhaps the world's leading scientific body); Dr. William Brown, perhaps the leading psycho-analyst in England and Director of Psychology at Oxford University; and a score of others.

Crisis in Science

Faith is not enough. Yet without faith, no progress can be made in anything. The trouble with many of the Christian churches is that they are all "faith" in name and skeptic in fact as regards survival of the grave, a survival to which they pay flatulent lip-serv-

That is at least, absolutely true of such churches in Great Britain -perhaps not in America am I bound to say that in the 250,000 miles I traveled in the six lecture tours on my novels and sociologic-religious books on the American continent, I found much more affirmation than actual belief amongst my churchy friends.

Not only Science but Churches are at last beginning to believe that faith and mechanical affirmation are not enough but that demonstration of survival through a sane mediumship must be provided by the Churches in the Churches.

My own communication to "Picture Post" — the "Saturday "Picture Post" — the "Saturday Evening Post of Britain and read by many millions each week—ask-ing that the now emptying churches and cathedrals should be emptying used for sacred concerts and serious theater presentations, with the implication that such subjects as survival of death might also be taught and demonstrated, brought in a big correspondence.

Man Not Deterred

We shall yet see Westminster
Abbey and the Roman Catholic Byzantine cathedral at the other end of Victoria Street, London, used for educationally spiritual purposes. Why should not America follow suit or, perhaps, even lead the way?

One other thing is now being believed and stated by all sorts and conditions of men and women, including those scientifically trained—and millions are under going such training today. This is, that only demonstration that man survives death, that he is an immortal spirit, and that only the love-teaching of the world's First Spiritualist — Jesus of Nazareth, can save that world from another world-war.

Already the signs leading to such a war are ominous. Nor will Man, the Murderer, fear to use



Turning now to the great field of world literature, we find that Spiritualistic inspiration has been, in large measure, the "genius" of many of the great writers. Millon, Coleridge. William Blake. Keats, Victor Hugo, Sir Walter Scott, Thackeray. Tennyson. George Thackeray. Tennyson. George Eliot. Bulwer-Lytton are a few of the names that spring to mind as legitimately to be mentioned in this connection.

In particular, Sir Walter Scott details at length how at times, in the composition of his novels and poems, a spirit force actually took control of his hand and wrote en-tire sections of his story, sometimes changing the plot radically, even to the point of killing off, in an early or middle chapter, a character whom he had in his own mind intended to bring to a tragic end in the final denouncement. If our memory of early reading serve us aright, he states that practically the whole of the poem, The Lay of the Last Minstrel was composed under this sort of control.

Davis' Harmonial Series

Coleridge awoke one morning with hundreds of lines of a long poem vividly pictured on the screen of his mind. He quickly arose and had written down some seventyfive lines when he was interrupted by the visit of a boresome neighbor, whose untimely intrusion caused the world the loss of the rest of the fairy-like composition, Kubla Khan. I believe also that he claimed that the most of his lovely poem, Christabel, was com-posed under similar spirit dicta-

More than one person has composed high-grade poetry under inspiration, but an exceptional case was that of Thomas L. Harris, an outstanding figure in the Spirit-ualist movement in the last cen-Hundreds of lines of firstquality poetry often poured forth from his lips entirely extempore.

The Harmonial Series of the youthful and uneducated Andrew Jackson Davis is literature, philosophy and wisdom of no mean rating.

Madame Blavatsky's two great works, one of which at least, *The Secret Doctrine*, is perhaps the greatest output of clarifying knowledge given to the world in modern times, were copied practically in their entirety from visual materializations projected from the minds of her overshadowing mentors in the etheric substance of the air in front of her eyes.

Clergymen Being Attracted

Col. Olcott testifies to sitting opposite Blavatsky at the big writing table, night after night, watching her copy from the invisible scroll flashed before her vision in the air. She quoted hundreds of passages from books which she had never seen, some of them almost unknown to the librarians at the London Atheneum, even giving the pages on which the citations would be found.

Ministers of the Gospel would be reticent about personal visita-tions, to them, of spiritual entities, but the writer is in position to recount that he was one of two close friends of perhaps the most highly regarded clergyman New York City ever had to whom the minister related one Easter eve the story of how when he was a lad of thirteen he was visited by an august figure of a remarkable personage, which materialized before him and addressing him, foretold for him a career of exceptionally high service in the cause of modern liberation from religious superstition.

Criticism Feared

The thousands who were blessed with a knowledge of the work, the heart and soul of this princely character, Robert W. Norwood, would not hesitate to say that his life had amply fulfilled the prediction of the materialized spirit.

In a still different field of human activity Spiritualistic com-munications have come in at critical moments to determine the course of human affairs. This is the realm of statesmanship. Much that undoubtedly has occurred in statecraft, but remained hidden because of "diplomatic secrety" and the undesirable reaction of a scoffing public to spiritistic phenomena, has been the direct result of guiding messages from on high.

Many prominent statesmen have been led to fateful decisions and humanitarian policies through their contact with mediums and psychics. Presidents of the United States, cabinet members, Senators, Judges and high officials have been vitally influenced by messages.

Judge Edmonds Convinced

The data substantiating President Lincoln's interest in and connection with Spiritualism have been published more than once in this journal. He is said to have freed the slaves at the behest of the spirit of Daniel Webster.

Another President, William Mc-Kinley, was largely guided by the communications that he received through a Mrs. Gutekunst, who for a time was given a residence in the home of McKinley's campaign manager, Senator Mark Hanna, of Ohio, in order to be available for frequent consultation. One later President, it has recently become known, attended seances in company with other high government officials

Readers may be surprised to learn that in the opinion of one of the country's most eminent jurists preceding the Civil War period, Judge Edmonds of Vermont, it was the Spiritualist vote in the election of 1860 that swung the victory for Abraham Lincoln.

Washington's Vision

Well known perhaps to most is the legend of the appearance of an unknown delegate in the Colonial Convention that in 1776 adopted the Declaration of Independence, who, when the resolution of the assembly seemed to weaken, took the floor and made a ringing speech that brought the courage of the Convention to the point of passing the Declaration, and thereafter immediately disappeared.

Often, too, has been published the remarkable vision seen by General Washington at Valley Forge, in which he was shown the three great internal conflicts which the republic would have to fight through.

Religion thus owes a vast subsidiary corroboration of its inherent spiritual character to such substantive evidence in the secu-lar world. But far more directly on its own premises it owes its high status and its character of a divine interest and concern to Spiritualistic factors. We have noticed its derivation from the great ancient Bibles. The religions arose and were accreted about the sacred Scriptures. Holy Writ has been the perennial corner-stone of religion. Especially is this true of Chris-

Who were the "holy men of old" who received God's dicare the "prophets, priests and kings" of ancient religious history, including the patriarchs of the Old Testament. A Review of the Book THINGS I CAN'T EXPLAIN

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

first of all most important to examine one of his three titles, that "Prophet."

This word, be it known for its vast general correction of a most unfortunate misconception. means, from the Greek word pro-. "forth," "out." and phe. "to speak." who speaks out or gives forth the truth with no reference whatever in its original signification to prediction of future objective events!

Scriptures Misunderstood

A "Prophet of God" was, therefore, simply a speaker, preacher, giver forth or utterer of God's vital wisdom to man on earth. And in the New Testament, and some other old books, this speaker utters his words of truth and light to humanity "on the mount."

Here again it is our privilege to bring a bit of scholarship to bear concisely upon a mistaken com-mon notion, which has made a freak caricature of sane Bible meanings. It is the true meaning of the word "mount" in the ancient symbolical language in which the Bibles were written.

The Scriptures were not written to be easily comprehended by average minds. They were books compiled to preserve that "wisdom hidden in a mystery" spoken of by St. Paul from the desecration of vulgar miscomprehension, and

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were thus couched in a deeply cryptic cipher language, for the clear interpretation of which a whole set of cipher "keys" was needed.

Christ's Career

Initiates in the Mystery Brotherhoods were furnished with and trained in the use of that secret key code. In this ancient language of symbols, as it is now being re-integrated in most astonishing fashion, the word "mount" did NOT connote a hill or eminence of land on the earth at all!

Readers may be taken almost off their feet to be told that it meant "the earth" itself! The evidence in support of this discovery is too voluminous to be presented in this article. But a strong presumptive bit of support for it is the fact that in old books there is often encountered the phrase "the mount of earth." (As well also as "the mount of the moon.")

It is, at any rate, significant that in the dramatic career of the Christ character in the Gospels, his temptation, his sermon (where he is the typical "Speaker," giving truth to mankind), his transfiguration and finally his crucifixion all occurred "on the mount."

Kingdom of Heaven

In the Old Testament, Moses (i.e., man's) communion with God was always on Mount Sinai. "Thy holy mountain" and "the hill of the Lord" were the places where man met to hold communion with God-

As the ancient Scripture writers were continually speaking of the Christly soul of man as descending from God's upper garden into the world to bring the kingdom of heaven down to earth, so that God's divine will might "be done on earth as it is in heaven," what can be the significance of this word "mount' other than just the earth

The application of this connota-The application of this connota-tion to the word brings to light a profounder and more luminous meaning to the body of *Bible* teaching than has ever been seen in it for centuries.

Therefore, the character in the old Bibles called the Prophet, the Preacher. the Speaker. is the dramatization of God's angel in the Book of Revelation, who says that he opens the Book of Life for all mankind to read the words of golden truth.

Inspired Writers

A fine statement from the Overlord of the world in the Hindu book is as follows: "As often as religion and piety decay in the world I send my Messenger to revive them."

The writers of the ancient Bibles were such Messengers and they either wrote the volumes directly or inspired their composition from the higher planes of consciousness. They came here to stand on "the mount of earth" to proclam to its humanity God's everlasting truth

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This is the time of the year when the thoughts of all Spiritualists, interested in the truth of spiritual communication and the study of psychic phenomena, turn to summer camps. In reality, they are not camps but centers or assemblies where regular meetings are held, some beginning as early as June and others as late as July. Few continue services after Labor Day with the exception of America's only winter camp, Southern Cassadaga Spiritualist Association, with meetings in Florida each year during January. February and March

In United States, these camps unique institutions. Many have been in existence over sixty years: starting in some instances with simple grove meetings or small home circles in some isolated spot. Today, they have grown into mammoth summer propaganda meetings-comparable in a way with similar gatherings of this type held in London's Royal Albert Hall. Aeolian Hall or Queen's Hall.

The great number of summer camps in this country, and there are at least thirty, differ one from the other in many ways but their general set-up is about the same. All have a governing body, the board of directors; a religious charter, granted by a duly authorized Spiritualist Association; a site, well away from the hustle and bustle of any great city; and a printed program of activities, listing speakers and mediums, special days, time of services, featured se-ances, classes for spiritual unfoldment and philosophical discus-

All camps in the country, during scheduled season, usually have three services on Sunday; afternoon or evening week-day services and sometimes both; a few have 4:30 and 6:30 meetings in addition to a regular 9:30 A. M. service.

At some of the camps, the speakers and mediums are chosen, at least in part, from local talent or nearby cities where churches are prepared to send, with the regular minister, a delegation of staff workers. Other camps specialize in more elaborate schedules, listing mediums from all parts of the United States and Canada.

Some camps specialize in mental mediumship only because the leaders believe the philosophical teachings of Spiritualism should be stressed — especially to the new comer; others see the need of both mental and physical mediums in addition to lectures and classes; still others are aware of the need for all phases of mediumship, realizing that it is through the demonstrations of physical mediumship that hundreds of persons have received their conviction.

All are doing their best to present the science, philosophy and religion of Spiritualism to an eager but critical public.

Many camps are either under-staffed or under-financed. This is due to the fact that all non-profit religious organizations depend up on uncertain revenue - free-will offerings and donations with an occasional charge for evening seances and services. However, all have been able to carry on their work, improving each year until today they have well-groomed grounds and presentable buildings in which activities are being held.

A motorist can drive to any of

the camps and usually find reasonable hotel accommodations and cafeteria service. Upon arrival, a roster of mediums is provided from which a selection can be made in the event a private seance or clair-

voyant reading is desired. Public lectures, classes and seances are also available for those who follow this type of schedule.

The beauty and restfulness of every camp can be taken as a certainty. A visit to any of them will insure complete mental and physical relaxation.

With the exception of the Cassadaga, Florida, camp, all are only in session during - the summer months. Usually the first to open is Camp Silver Belle, around the middle of June and continuing through Labor Day. About the first of July, meetings begin at Snowlake Camp, Parkland Heights, Ashley, Sherwood, Lily Dale, Chesterfield and Freeville.

Early in July, sessions begin at Brady Lake. Lake Pleasant, Wone-Lake Sunapee, Mt. Pleasant Park, Chain Lakes and Escondido.

It is impossible at this time to specify every camp and outline complete programs of each but by writing care of the camp secretary in charge, full information can be obtained. Here is a fairly complete list which should be helpful to Psychic Observer readers:

luxurious hotel of prodigious proportions. The verdant lawns. extensive fields of vegetation, indicated that a horticultural genius had occupied much love and time upon the glorious landscape.

However, there was a worldly, material atmosphere about the building and this impression increased as I entered the huge. heavily paneled rooms. Each room represented the art products of a special nation.

Art Wonders of Every Age

The Renaissance chamber contained relics of priceless value. many treasures never having had a chance to meet the eyes of the art connoisseurs upon the earth plane, for their human creators, through lack of opportunity or because their wonderful genius was not appreciated, passed on, retaining only a sacred memory of the spiritual talents, whereby they had fashioned their masterpieces.

Abraham" and other patriarchs has miscarried from its true meaning into some hing quite too literal and objective. Nothing has caused such wreckage of spiritual sense in the Bible as the literal interpretation of the language. Common sense should tell us tha' God does not in person bend down and speak into any mortal's car.

God's Laws-UNIVERSAL

People still incline to think that 'in Bible times' —less than two thousand years ago!--miraculous and supernatural things were the common vogue. It is still believed that things could happen then in violation of the ordinary laws of nature that can not occur nowadays. But this is folly.

God's laws are universal and e'ernally sacred and inviolable. The dictation of the holy books came by a process of transmission that is as natural now as then. God has never ceased speaking to men of holy life and lofty piety in any age. He speaks to us all through inner dictation, through flashes of insight, through the still small voice of reason, conscience, intelligence, perception.

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This report of a rather thrilling evening should be of interest. It took place at a small house in the fashionable Rutland Gate district, London, and there were present myself and my cousin, Mrs. Ven-ner. the owner of the house, her husband, another man friend, Mr. White, Mr. Young (the medium), Mr. Bromet and Mrs. Garland An-

The house (into which Mrs. Venner had only just moved) is a charming small building in a mews, and the group was gathered together originally for the purpose holding a private direct-voice sitting to talk to several friends on the Other Side—especially hoping to contact Mrs. Venner's mother. who passed over a year ago and who frequently talks to her daughter.

Something Strange

We sat at one end of the livingroom — a charming room large enough for one end to serve as a dining-room while the other is used as the lounge room. This was the end used for the sitting, and one of the ladies, Mrs. Anderson, was sitting on the right of the medium with her back almost against a bookcase.

I myself sat at one end of the Knole settee, facing the medium, with Mrs. Venner at the other and Mr. White between us both; Mr. Venner sat in a chair on my right, and finally Mr. Bromet on the me-

Directly Mr. Strong was entranced, Mrs. Anderson, who is a seasoned sitter and takes some scaring, declared that there was "something strange" forming behind her, she could hear breathing and moving about, and she called to the guide, Red Eagle, either to bring the entity into the middle of the Circle or to remove it altogether, she disliked it!

Proper Technique

Then one end of the Knole settee (the one beyond Mrs. Venner) fell down with a clatter-this must have been deliberately unhooked, as the ends were both held up, after the fashion on such settees, by heavy velvet hooks hooked

Then heavy shuffling sounds were heard moving about the room, and the back of the settee was violently pushed or bumped into two or three times, and then again Mrs. Anderson called on the Guide to take the entity, whatever it was, away. It had come behind her again and was breathing down her neck!

Red Eagle said (with a detached interest that was rather trying to us, as we were getting distinctly scared) "Dear me, this is remarkably interesting! My child (to Mrs. Venner) do you know you have a poltergeist in the house?"

Needless to say Mrs. Venner assured him that she did not know, and that, moreover, she certainly did not want one-would he kindly take it away! Upon which the Guide told us it was quite useless trying to get any spirit voices through till the poltergeist was removed. He said that our sitting has aroused the entity and brought it out, so to speak, which was the first stage towards clearing it away. He would, he said, now bring his medium out of trance, after which we had better have some food, and later we could sit again.

Careful Observation

Mr. Strong duly came out of trance—and when the lights went up we saw that the middle of the circle was piled high with books! They had been brought out of the bookcase behind Mrs. Anderson by the creature, whatever it was— no wonder she felt creepy!—and deposited in the circle without a sound being made and without anybody being touched, though we were sitting so close together that nobody could possibly have passed unfelt between any two of us. Neither could the books have been thrown or dropped into the circle over Mrs. Anderson's head without making a loud thud as they

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hit the floor—yet there they were! We duly sat round the table and began dinner, and at once the table began to tilt and rock so violently that we had to snatch up and re-

move from it such spillable things as soup, stewed fruit and so on!

Spirit Admonished

It was, incidentally, a very heavy ound Napoleonic table which round took three people all their time to lift, as we tried afterwards. Yet it danced and shock so that eating was most trying, and continued to behave spasmodically like this all through dinner until Mrs. Venner, exasperated, shouted to it "Keep still, can't you, till we've finished eating!" . . . upon which it stopped until the exact moment when he had finished, and then began again rocking and tilting until we all quitted the table!

We then sat again. And this time, on the medium's coming out of trance, four large and heavy vases of flowers were found standing in a row on the floor, having been silently removed from their places on various tables, the sideboard, desk and so on.

Not a drop of water had been spilt nora flower disturbed—though one of the vases was a heavy pottery jar as large as the average waste-paper basket, filled with spreading branches that would tax the strength of a man to lift when filled with water.

Cleared Through a Medium

Mrs. Venner's handbag had been removed from her lap and taken to a table at the far end of the room, an inkstand and a pair of paper weights had been moved and several other things.

We rested again, on Eagle's instructions, and then sat again, and continued to do this five times in all, until Red Eagle said the entity had left the room and gone right up to the bedroom overhead. He said "We will hold the next sitting there. I think one more trance will clear it entirely."

So after another rest (Mr. Strong, by this time having been in and out of trance five times, looking rather in need of one) and then all went up to the bedroom overhead which had been, as usual, neatly prepared by the maid for its occupant-and we found it completely upside down.

The bedclothes were strewn all over the room, books and photoframes were piled in the wildest confusion in the middle of the bed, chairs overturned . . . everything looking as though a tornado had hit it.

Earth Elementals

We straightened it out as well as we could and once again Mr. Strong was entranced, and in a few minutes Red Eagle said "that is all right, it is cleared now, you will have no more trouble," and our amazing evening was over.

The house is now perfectly free from any sort of unpleasant haunting, though before Mrs. venues said she always sensed something about it, and she never slept well in this release of whatthough before Mrs. Venner ever was causing the haunting she has slept perfectly and the atmosphere of the house is clear.

Precisely what was causing it all it was impossible to say. But I understand from Red Eagle that there had been a murder committed there a very long time ago, in some old stables that existed there before the house was built.

Later, I learned that any place where horses have been kept is apt to be haunted by earth-elementals —in other words, poltergeists. And so it was in this case. The complication of the murder vibragave the haunting strength but rest assured the clearing of the house was thorough!

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
