
Death-A Deliverance

THE PICTURE TELLS THE STORY
Silver Belle Mediums Demonstrate Telekinesis

This picture was taken at Camp Silver Belle, Ephrata, Pennsylvania, July 9th, 1946. Left to Right: R. G. Pressing, R. E. Burns (1), Ethel Post-Parrish (2), H. G. Burroughs (3) and Juliette Ewing Pressing.

The purpose was to prove and demonstrate, under strict test conditions, the supernormal power of levitation (telekinesis). Aside from the five pictured above, there were nine persons seated on the opposite side of this scance room—as witnesses. They also vouch for the authenticity of this photograph. Their names are on file at the office of Psychic Observer.

The conditions were absolute darkness (i. e.) to generate the necessary power... and then at a signal by the mediums, given when they sensed the trumpet levitated (above black curtain to the rear) a flash was used by the photographer who "snapped" the camera with the results pictured above.

The editors of Psychic Observer can also wouch for this picture and, inasmuch as they possess no known psychic ability of this nature, it is a foregone conclusion that the power for this demonstration was supplied by a combined force generated through the mediumship of:

Lady Caillard's Graphic Account SPIRITUALISM

I feel I must first say a few words on this subject, if only to a small part of the thinking world, to show how unfair it is that such a serious subject should be treated in so one-sided a manner.

Although the world has become more enlightened during the last few years so that *Spiritualism* has now a much larger and more serious following — according to statistics there are about 3,000,000 Spiritualists in Great Britain alone — the subject is still very much misrepresented and misunderstood by its enemies, and only partially

For their acceptance would as they said of Paul "Turn the world upside down." Yes, they would truly turn the hatred-soaked pride-soaked—greed-pocked world into a harmonious community. For whether we like the idea or not, we are all akin — Jew. Gentile, Black. White, European, Asiatic and the rest.

Too many — far. far, far too many of our Mediums, quite loyalby reason of their sensitiveness "Restores the son to his mother again" but only in a vague way preach the doctrine of "The Immortal Sons of God." The latter was a phrase often on the lips of George III. But his prejudice would not allow him to admit of its illimitable implications.

Are We As Daft?

Mothers, if your sons are immortal, so are all mothers sonsof every creed, race and color. We must actively work according to Spiritual Law that even while on earth they are granted the Right to live as Immortals! Only the George the Thirds say nay.

In the scriptures, mediums were classed under two headings — Good Prophets and False Prophets. He was a splendid Medium for he not only understood Spiritual law, but allowed, unhindered, Spiritual Forces to flow through him, and as a result, to his consciousness, Past, Present, and Future, fused into one ever revealing Panorama. The seeming barrier between earthworld dweller and spirit-world dweller dissolved.

"Are We Doing Likewise?"

At a touch, or a word, aye sometimes at a thought, sluggish bodies rebounded to wholesomeness and saddened minds became glad.

Within His radiation men forgot the superstition and the prejudice of race, caste and color, felt akin in the one family of God.

Yes, He was a splendid Medium

not in the least bit "up stage"—no true prophet is that -.

When praised He merely said "You could do the same your-selves and even more than this."

And the question I would like to ask in this, my first article to the Psychic Observer of America, is this, "Are we doing likewise?" Are we seeking to understand Spiritual Laws? Are we demanding that the Laws of Nations be framed in accordance with them? Are we breaking down our own prejudice and helping to break down the prejudice of our neigh-bor—the barriers of superstition between Black and White between Jew and Gentile, between Nation and Nation?

the office of the S.P.R. it was open to tampering and substitution. It being also likely, in the view of the "Hope apologists," that the abstractor send back the missing plate out of pure mischief.

Immediately after the revelation, *Hope* offered new sittings and declared his willingness to submit himself to stringent tests. The offer was refused.

Harry Price, however, signed a statement to the effect that the test of Feb. 24th, 1922, "does not rule out the possibility that Hope has other than normal means."

Indeed, no less authority than Sir William Crookes bears out the true mediumship of William Hope in an authorized interview published in the Christian Commonwealth on Dec. 4th, 1914.

On his own marked plates, under his own conditions, Crookes obtained a likeness of his wife different from any he possessed. On the other hand Sir Oliver Lodge was emphatic in stating concerning a test of his own with a sealed packet sent to Hope: "I have not the slightest doubt that the envelope containing the plates had been opened."

Again, Sir William Barrett claimed to have received with Hope "indubitable evidence of supernormal photography."

After the Harry Price "exposure," Allerton F. Cushman, of Wash-

ington, also bore witness to having obtained psychic extras on his own plates, similarly marked by the *Imperial Dry Plate Company*, and also on plates purchased previous to the sitting by *Hereward Carrington*.

Surmise and Suspicion-Not Enough

The great number of signed testimonies, with a detailed account of precautions taken, speaks in an impressive manner for the genuine

The charges of fraud, advanced by Fred Barlow and Major W. Rampling Rose, are largely built on surmise and suspicion and not in facts. Barlow, in 1923, associated himself with Sir Arthur Conan Doyle in the publication of The Case for Spirit Photography, a book written in answer to the Hope exposure. At that time he could not "get away from the fact that many of these photographic effects are produced by discarnate intelligences."

Two years previously, in Budget No. 58 of the Society for the Study of Supernormal Pictures, dated January 20, 1921, Doyle said: "I have got results with Mr. Hope in my own home under conditions where fraud was absolutely impossible. I have loaded my dark slides in Birmingham and taken them to Crewe with my own camera and apparatus, had carried out the whole of the operation myself (even to the taking of the photograph) and have secured supernormal results.

In answer, Mr. Barlow replied: "A further ten years of careful, continuous experimenting has enabled me to say quite definitely that I was mistaken.

Hope never commercialized his gift. He charged about one dollar for a dozen prints. This was calculated on the basis of his hourly earnings as a carpenter. He was very devout, almost fanatic and relied blindly on the advice of his spirit guides.

"During all his career as a medium," writes David Gow in Light, March 17, 1933, "he had become so accustomed to accusation and abuse that he had grown case-hardened. His attitude seemed to be that, knowing himself to be honest, it did not matter how many people thought

The Case of

HOPE WILLIAM

Internationally Famous

SPIRIT PHOTOGRAPHER

William Hope, (1863-1933), the best-known modern spirit photographer, a carpenter of Crewe, whose psychic power, was discovered accidentally about 1905.

He a d a comrade photographed each other. The plate which Hope exposed, showed an extra figure—a transparent woman—behind whom the brick wall was visible. It was a sister of Hope's comrade, dead for many years.

With the help of Mr. Buxton, the organist at the Spiritualist hall at Crewe, a circle of six friends was formed to sit for spirit photography. For fear of being accused of being in league with the devil, the circle destroyed all the original negatives until Arch-deacon Colley (*) came on the scene. He tested Hope's powers, endorsed them and gave him his stand camera which Hope refused to give up, long after it had became old-fashioned-its box battered and its leg broken.

The first hubbub about *Hope* and his psychic photographs arose in 1908 in connection with Archdeacon Colley's first sit-ting. He recognized his Mother in the psy-chic extra. Hope thought it was more like a picture he had copied two years earlier. Mrs. Spencer of Nantwich, indeed, recognized her grandmother in it, after Hope took it to her.

Hope informed Archdeacon Colley of his mistake. He said it was madness to think that a man did not know his own Mother and advertised in the Leamington paper asking all who remembered his Mother to meet him at the Rectory.

Eighteen persons selected the photograph from several others and testified in writing, that the picture was a portrait of the late Mrs. Colley who had never been photographed.

Price's Silly Charges of Fraud

The second case of public controversy arose in 1922, and was, on the surface, damning for Hope. In a report published in the Proceedings of the Society for Psychical Research, he was accused of imposture by the conjurer Harry Price. The accusations were made public in a ten cent pamphlet.

The basis of the revelation was that Price, in a sitting at the British College of Psychic Science, is supposed to have caught Hope in the act of substituting the dark slide, holding the exposed plates, by another; further, that he (Hope) handed him two negatives (one of which contained a psychic extra) that did not bear the secret mark which the Imperial Dry Plate Company specially impressed on the packet of films by ex-ray which were different in color and thickness from the original plates

Subsequent investigation proved the counter-accusations raised by Spiritualists. Investigation also proved that an organized conspiracy against Hope deserved examination. The wrapper of the packet was found, and it bore marks of tampering.

Moreover, one of the original marked plates was returned anony mously and undeveloped to the S.P.R. a week after the experiment and three weeks before the revelation. On being developed it showed an image.

As the packet of marked plates was lying about for four weeks in (Continued—See left-hand column)

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The Mystery of

SPIRIT MIND AND BRAIN

In any discussion of mind and matter, remember that spirit is the original, absolute reality, while matter is only the clothing or vehicle. The vehicle of temporary duration — The Spirit Eternal.

Mind is the engineer; Brain is the engine; All creation is the engine; Spirit is always the engineer.

In a recent issue of the Scientific Forum, a noted writer says that the greatest mystery in the world today is the inter-relation-ship between mind and matter (brain). He asks how can a material thing and a non-material thing be in any way connected and then states that this has been the puzzle of the ages.

It is no doubt, true that this subject has been a puzzle to some philosophers in ages past but it is not true of all philosophers and it is not true of our modern scientists.

Dr. Robert Millikan states in his Science and the new Civilization that there is no dividing line where Spirit stops and matter begins. Spirit and mind are synonymous for the purposes of this discussion although technically mind is the first emanation of Spirit.

Dr. Millikan and other modern scientists demonstrate that Spirit and matter are one and identical, being two poles of the same identity, Spirit being the invisible and intangible while matter is the visible and tangible, pole.

Dr. Twinning Says:

Today. chemical engineers tell us that the earth is composed of about 92 chemicals. Water is composed of two gasses, Hydrogen and Oxygen. Air is composed of four molecules of Nitrogen and one of Oxygen.

Now all of these chemicals and

gasses resolve themselves back into one original, primordial cosmic substance which Dr. Harry La Vern Twining calls "pulsons" which are the pulsating waves of the free energy of space.

These pulsons emerge from the *Universal Spirit* or *First Cause* and are the first materializations of Spirit as matter.

This is the real "Maya" or "mother substance" out of which

all creation is formed. In a far fetched and symbolic sort of way it is what one church calls "the mother of God" because Jesus symbolized man—all men, and the bodies of all men are formed of Maya, the universal mother. Christ is the symbol of spiritual man.

Every rock, vegetable, animal and man is constituted of some combination of these pulsons, and they are in a constant state of vibration or change. Electrons are formed of the pulsons. The word also means illusion because it is constantly changing form.

Triangle Symbolizes Spirit

Our body is completely renewed every seven months, that is, the old cells are thrown off and new cells are formed to take their place. The life of a cell is ten days. Activity is life. Stagnation is death, or more correctly, disintegation.

Universal Spirit is One, with two poles, three principles, four qualities, five senses, six planes and seven entities. The two poles are Spirit and matter. Spirit is symbolized by three principles; Intelligence, Energy and Substance.

Matter is composed of four qualities; Mineral in which is life, Vegetable, in which is life, and the beginning of feeling, Animal, in which is life, feeling and the beginning of thought, The Human, in which is life, feeling, thought and the beginning of the spiritual nature.

Spiritual nature.

Spirit is symbolized by the triangle and matter by the square. The marriage and uniting of Spirit and matter is creation. The foregoing reveals a deep fundamental truth; "In the beginning" before creation appeared there was nothing but Universal Spirit. Today there is nothing but invisible Spirit and visible Spirit which we call matter.

J. S. Haldane Said:

The first activity of Spirit was the creating by emergence of cosmic substance or "Maya," Mary, the universal substance which is invisible to our human eyes. Maya is brought into manifestation or materialization by the creative activity of the "word" which is vibration. "And God spoke the word and creation appeared." Vibration is creation.

A materialist is one who believes the existence of the universe is explained by matter alone. No First Cause, just spontaneous generation.

The great astronomer, I. S. Haldane, said, "Materialism, once a plausible theory is now a fatalistic creed, but materialism is nothing better than a superstition on the same level as a belief in witches and devils. The materialistic theory is bankrupt."

Modern scientists accept the inner-relation of Spirit and matter, and mind and brain. Funda-

mentally they are one.

Dr. Millikan says, "Electrons are the building blocks of the universe." In other words all matter such as earth, suns, stars and brains are fabricated out of electrons, and electrons he traces back as emerging from the Spirit.

This point is well illustrated by

the Amoeba, a microscopic nucleated mass of protoplasm, just a single cell of transport jelly, yet it has the intelligence to pursue its food and wrap itself around it and assimilate the energy out of it. It has the power of locomotion, it senses an enemy and wiggles away from it to safety.

The Amoeba developed its brain by emergent evolution, as it developed eyes, legs, heart etc. This is an example of Intelligence evolving and emerging into form. "The word becoming [lesh." Spirit becoming matter. All is One. There is no separation.

Brain Is Matter

The brain, nerves, bones and flesh of man are aggregations of tiny cells. The average human body is an amalgamation of about 200 billion cells. Each cell has an intelligence of its own and the brain has a mass intelligence. The liver cells are liver conscious and they have their duty to perform as also do the cells of the heart, lungs etc.

This all goes to prove that the brain, which is matter, is built up of cells and that these cells are possessed of intelligence, power, the sense of fear and caution, the ability to reproduce themselves, a sense of self preservation the power of assimilation and elimination, and many other qualities. Therefore, the brain and mind are inter-related and have a harmonious relationship.

Brain is matter. Matter is formed of electrons, electrons are composed of pulsons and pulsons are built up of the waves of the free energy of space which in turn is Spirit substance that originally emerged from Universal Spirit or First Cause. Therefore, matter is Spirit in form.

Dr. Gall's Discoveries

Furthermore, the brain is the organ of the mind. The mind is the organ of the soul. The soul is the organ of the Spirit, and the Spirit is the Universal, Indivisible, Eternal "I am." The "am" in "I Am" just denotes continuity.

Dr. Gall, a German physician, discovered that the brain is the organ of the mind, in the year 1800. Dr. Spurzheim, Dr. Comb, and Dr. Fowler made additional discoveries totalling forty-three corresponding faculties of the mind. The science of the mind and brain has been practiced for one hundred forty-six years.

Thinking is the activity of the mind and is creative. Harmonious thoughts create harmonious conditions, and destructive thoughts create disastrous conditions. Plato said the "idea" is the "thing itself" in reality. Ideas are created by thinking.

Thoughts Are Things

For instance, hate thoughts create sharp, cutting, ideas which crystallize in the blood, are deposited in the joints and we call the result rheumatism, etc. Many diseases have been cured by changing hate thoughts to thoughts of love.

understood by most of its friends.

Indeed, in many cases its friends do more harm than its enemies by exaggerated descriptions of their experiences and ignorance of the true conditions which exist.

Those who are genuinely anxious to gain knowledge are seriously handicapped by their inability to procure instructive literature on the subject. Only at various psychic societies and meetings is it possible to obtain their books and newspapers.

Are They Afraid?

It is unfair to prevent books and papers from being sold on bookstalls and to deny subscribers to libraries the right to procure books on this subject; yet such is the case. It almost looks as if the opponents of Spiritualism are afraid of the truth being made known.

The result is that the reading public draw its opinions from intermittent notices in the Press, which usually contain some suggestion of fraud. or reports of lectures denouncing Spiritualism as a false and iniquitous cult. This of course, gives an entirely erroneous impression, and readers have no opportunity of discussing the subject and getting to know the

Spiritualism as a Religion

How many of us have thought of Spiritualism as a Religion? Or if not as a separate religion, as a most important part of the Christian religion? It is based on the teachings of the Great Master and His Apostles, and the world jeers and sneers at it as it did at Christ 2,000 years ago, and might do again if He returned today.

The first claim of Spiritualism is its proof of survival after death, the important effect this knowledge must have on the progress of the world today. Arising this is the comfort knowledge brings to those left to fight their battles alone, and to those who hitherto have feared death.

That we possess two bodies, natural body and a spiritual body. is no new theory; it has been taught for thousands of years, and in speaking of communication with the spirit world we must bear in mind that such communication depends on our possessing in this world a spiritual body, or what may be called a soul.

Our spiritual body is a counterpart of our physical body, but it is made of finer material and is capable of reflecting the senses of

the spiritual body. Our spirit friends when they descend to our sphere do not see our material bodies but only our spiritual bodies. The spiritual body being made of such sensitive substance is influenced by our thoughts and actions, and as we live, so our spirit bodies become either bright and beautiful or dark and ugly.

Our true thoughts and real character cannot be hidden from those in the spirit world. Here on Earth we are able to disguise our thoughts and motives from each other because our material bodies are made of a coarser material which is less sensitive to thought. When we leave our mortal bodies we are therefore seen not as we wish to be seen but as we really are.

St. Paul wrote: Now we see through a glass darkly but then shall I know even as I am known. I. Corinthians v. 12.

Healing Powers

The public is told still less of this important side of Spiritualism or of the claim made by spiritualists to treat the sick and suffering. Few ever hear of the thousands of spirit treatments. Nor is the public told of the consolation its teachings have brought and will continue to bring to those in grief and despair, or of the souls to whom its teachings have brought a higher and nobler faith in Christ.

Instead of denouncing the followers of Spiritualism, the churches of all denominations should be grateful to them as the teachers of the true Christian faith based, as it is, on Love which is the foundation of the teachings of

Mediums

Spiritualism is neither the degraded nor the foolish thing that its opponents would have us believe. It is quite true that some of the so-called mediums have been unscrupulous, and no one is more anxious to expose these parasites than the Spiritualists themselves.

But what profession, or religion for that matter, is free from imperfection? It requires no great skill to extract money from the over-credulous. It is fatally easy to prey upon the minds of the lonely and suffering who seek comfort through the communion with their loved ones in the spirit world. No punishment is severe enough for the medium who makes money by these methods, and the Spiritualists are the first to desire their exposure.

But why should all be con-demned for the dishonesty of the few? I have known a number of mediums and have put them through the severest tests. Without exception, I have proved them to be genuine and honest. All of them are poor, and most of them are in bad health. They are very poorly paid for their work, which is a severe strain on their health; and I know many who get nothing but their fares when they travel long distances to speak in public and give trance lectures and demonstrations of clairvoyance. It quite wrong to suppose that mediumship is a paying business.

No doubt, before long, Science

will discover some mechanical means of communicating with the spirit world, but until this comes about there ought to be some in-stitution for providing mediums who have been tested-some institution in which mediums receive a living wage and are kept in good health.

At present, mediums are martyrs in every sense of the word. They give up everything in life, ruin their health, and even go hungry. All these sufferings they endure to bring help and comfort others. They are almost as much persecuted as were the so-called witches in Middle Ages. I owe a great deal of comfort and happiness to some of these brave men and women, and there must be thousands of others who have had similar experience.

How I Became a Spiritualist

Let me explain how I came to be interested in Spiritualism.

For thirty years there has been between my husband and myself a bond of friendship, love and understanding which nothing can ever alter, and when the parting came it seemed almost unbearable.

A few months after my husband passed over, I was persuaded by a friend to go to a Spiritualist service. Spiritualism at that time meant little to me. I knew nothing about it, nor had I ever discussed the subject with anyone. So I went to this service ignorant and unbelieving.

It was a short but impressive service consisting of some prayers. hymns, a short address, and special prayers for the sick and suf-

son the medium addressed myself. She told me she saw a man standing beside me who said he was my husband and wished to send me a message of love; he wished to say that he was always by my side helping me as he had always helped me during his earth life. She then gave me a very accurate description of my husband and some intimate particulars that no one but he could possibly have known.

After that I became interested in Spiritualism. I went to hear an American preacher, Arthur Ford, who had left Orthodoxy to teach Spiritualism. Mr. Ford was able to see and hear messages given by spirits, and in a crowded

hall I had the most wonderfully convincing evidence that the messages he gave me could only have come from my husband. As I was quite a stranger to him there was no means by which even ordinary

I was so impressed by these messages that I arranged to have a sitting with Mr. Ford, I made no appointment and did not even give my name.

evidence could have been obtained.

At the first sitting, my father, my mother and one of my brothers all gave me intimate messages; then my husband came and begged me to keep on trying to comcunicate with him. He asked me to try automatic writing, promising that he would help me.

After this I had a number of sittings with different mediums, and on each occasion I received the most convincing messages; always my husband begged me to write and promised that he would help. I was now quite convinced of the fact of survival and the possibility of communicating with those who had passed over to the spirit plane.

I would like to give a perfectly true and unexaggerated account of my experiences. I had had so many convincing messages from my husband, and with these messages the constant request that I should write about survival after death.

One day I heard of a wonderful mechanical contrivance called the Reflectograph which had been made under directions from a man who had passed over some years before. The instrument here illustrated (see picture, top column two, this page) and working, similar to a typewriter, has a very sensitive keyboard which when lightly touched registers the corresponding letter on a board on the wall. It took many months of careful preparation to make from orders given through a trance medium.

I was invited to see this instrument, which they told me was manipulated by the hand of a young girl in the spirit world who received her instructions from the inventor, himself a spirit. I went with my sister-in-aw whose husband, my brother, had passed over soon after my own husband. The owners of the Reflectograph knew nothing of me or of my circumstances. I mention this because the reader who is not a spiritualist usually suspects collusion.

I found myself in a small room, one corner of which was screened off by a curtain. Behind this curtain was a chair. There was nothing else behind that curtain, and when the medium entered the room, I and my sister-in-law saw her strapped by both hands and feet and tied by a rope which passed round her waist so that she could not possibly move.

The keyboard lay outside the

curtain, so close to me that I could have touched it. We were very thorough in our inspection of everything, and the room was quite light. The lights were shaded red, but everything in the room was clearly visible.

After the medium had been tied. we sang hymns and said a few prayers, and presently we heard the spirit voice of *Ethel*, the young girl whose hand manipulated the instrument. She greeted us; a hand appeared through the curtain, then two hands.

Ethel asked if we would like to see her, and when we said we would, the face and form of a beautiful young girl appeared. She took a flower from a table outside the curtain and offered it to me; at the same time she asked if I would like to feel the material of her dress. I did so; it felt very much the same as georgette, and was pure white in color.

Mediums Examined

She then said that a gentleman who claimed to be my husband would like to send me a message, and the following letters appeared on the Reflectograph screen while Ethel manipulated the keyboard: "V. XX P. XX." V, of course, stood for by husband's name Vincent: P was for my sister-in-law's. It was not the initial of my brother, whose name was Gerald, but of her first husband, whose name was Percy. The X's were kisses.

"P. and I Tossed for Innings

The message continued: "You have brought so much love with you ,it is easy to come. V.X. This is such a very unique method; I like it immensely. P. and I tossed for first innings; I won. You must go carefully with your health, dear. You do far too much. I am eager to help you. Will you keep paper and pencil by your bed, and I will write. Did you feel startled when I woke you suddenly on Sunday? Get some rosemary, the flour I mean, it will be of great help soon. Our love grows stronger every day. V. XXX."

Then my sister-in-law had a message from her husband and after Ethel had said good-bye to us, the sitting came to an end. I examined the medium and saw that she was still bound and secured just as we had left her, and still in a deep trance.

I heard that on the next evening there was to be a circle to

Last night, Midsummer Day, we held our first big public meeting in Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland, in the Frikirkjunni (the Free Church), a splendid old wool and iron building on the Lake Side.

of appreciation, rose at the end of the lecture at the request of the Rev. Auduns, President of the Icelandic Society for Psychical Research.

People of note in Spiritualism, Psychical Research and Theosophy were present, as well as several leading citizens and business men.

Among the audience were a number of Lutheran clergymen, who foregathered in Reykjavik for their annual Church Congress. They had voted to attend my meeting although there was a special service of their own at the Cathedral.

There is a strong leaning toward Spiritualism among these members of the State Church, and already five or six of them have visited me to express their good wishes for the success of the undertaking.

My interpreter, Rev. Jakob Jonsson, is a leading minister in this city, and made a splendid job of his translation. The fact is: these clergymen know quite a little about spiritualism, practically as well as theoretically.

"Spiritualism In The Bible"

It comes very refreshingly to anyone who has experienced the morbid opposition of the clergy of Britain. The Rev. Auduns preached two weeks ago in the Cathedral, his subject virtually being, Spiritualism in the Bible. His sermon was even broadcasted.

My sponsors are a splendidgroup of men and women representative of the older as well as new school of Spiritualism, if such a term can properly be used. They attended the meeting en masse and as many of them are promin-

Rational Interpretations

I have inserted capital letters because it more effectively suggests the spirit and intention that prevails. My first lecture therefore took the form of presenting a case for the phenomena, without advo-cating any special hypothesis, al-though I made clear the point of view of Spiritualists.

Our interpretation is, of course, far more rational and comprehen-sive than any other. The mere quotation of a few experiences of spirit-return reduces such theories and the subconsciousness (being alone the cause) to an absurdity.

In the end, therefore, the audience had our position placed squarely before them so that a comparison could be made with the opposition.

Audience of Notables

The Chair was occupied by Snoebjorn Jonssen, who keeps The English Bookshop. He is, along with Rev. Kristinn Danielsson, the most informed Spiritualist in Iceland. Mr. Jonsson sat on the platform ready to assist the interpreter if possible.

Mr. Nikulos Fridriksson, a leading municipal official, was also there with his wife.

Mr. Sveinn Sigurdsson, an outstanding character in all matters psychic, was a serious and attentive observer.

The daily press have been very helpful, both in publishing articles written by Spiritualists, or by sending friendly reporters who have done their best to arouse public opinion.

In the face of all this . . . failure is impossible. I have plenty to do.

Up till now I have had seven private seances for test purposes, including a rather large circle of psychometry, one lantern lecture before members of the Committee in addition to the big meeting described above.

Icelanders Scientific

Someone published that I was a psychic healer and that brought in a number of telephone applications for treatment, some coming from the hospital. Later on applications for treatment came in from outlying districts.

Icelanders are very scientifically minded, and this trait shows itself at my circles. Dictaphones have been instituted for the purpose of keeping records of all that is said, because some of the statements are evidential and others, which may not be at the moment, may, and have turned out correct after

common among excited sitters at seances. They are thus given a chance of recalling some incident. This method has proved satisfactory to say the least.

There are to be public meetings for addresses and clairvovance. similar to an ordinary Spiritualist Sunday service.

Natives Are Hospitable

It cannot be said, in view of all this, that the lot of the Spiritualist Missionary is easy. But there is a tremendous amount of pleasure in it all, especially in Iceland, where I have met some of the most understanding and sympathetic people in the world.

The reason for this has been Iceland's isolation, -its scattered population,-its lack of railways, necessitating, until the advent of the motor car, traveling by ponies, for which Iceland is famous.

Even today these charming little animals must be used for country districts through which no decent roadway runs. This often entails journeying over lava beds and across numerous streams which honeycomb this remarkable coun-

Hospitality has been essential under such conditions, and farmers were only too pleased to welcome strangers because of the news of the doings of the outside world they could bring. May this spirit of friendliness never die.

Few Physical Mediums

This afternoon I am invited to meet a party of Icelandic mediums, and I hope to have something interesting to say about them and their work. Mediumship here resembles that of Britain, and automatic writing is popular. I have met a number of cultured people (most Icelanders are well-educated) who, by this means, keep contact with the spirit world in their own homes.

There are few physical mediums which may be owing to the humidity of Reykjavik, indeed, Iceland generally. Humidity is always a drawback because it causes the electrical forces associated with physical mediumship to be dissipated, water being a good con-

SURVIVAL AND IMMORTALITY

Everyone survives death. It is a mistake to allow our minds to be warped by scientific, philosophic and theological prejudices . . . when we approach the subject of Spiritualism. It is a rational movement.

The Basis For Survival Is Scientific But Few Know the Mechanism

W. H. Evans Author of "How To Be A Medium"

It is an opinion commonly held that proof of man's survival of bodily death is also proof of immortality. This is not so. There is no means of proving immortal-ity though we may find many reasons for believing that man is immortal.

Survival of death, however, has been proven many times; there is a vast array of evidence which has accumulated in many books over the years that have gone.

Although more weight is given to evidence of scientific men like Alfred Russell Wallace, O.M. Profs. Robert Hare and James Mapes, Sir William Crookes, Sir Oliver Lodge, and many others who have claims to our attention, we cannot ignore the testimony of the many thousands who have investigated the claims of Spiritualism.

Trivial Messages?

These form a vast army on the positive side and we have no right to ignore them, for though they may not have a scientific train-ing they are as shrewd and common sense in these matters as are many scientists.

After all when it comes to assessing evidence, who is likely to be the most reliable, a scientist or a lawyer?

The latter, for he is specially trained to weigh evidence. I have met some lawyers and barristers who have been convinced of the truth of survival on the evidence presented in many books. With their special training they are able

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to see the value of many things which a scientist might pass over.

In considering evidence one has to realize the evidential value of the trivial utterances; they are often more convincing than reams of philosophy can be. After all, when it is realized that death makes no change in us as human beings, we are not transformed either into angels or devils, the value of the trivial information sometimes conveyed is readily

What Carries Conviction?

Let anyone at the end of a telephone line be asked to offer proof of their identity to a critical in-quirer, and they will find that it is more likely to be the recital of some trivial matter mutually experienced than a lot of argument about who they are. It is such things that carry conviction.

But because of this, we must not fall into the error of supposing that all the communications from the next world are trivial. they are not. One has only to recall such books as Spirit Teachings, by Stainton Moses; the many by Geraldine Cumins, and the Vale Owen scripts to mention only a few, to realize something of the quality of some of the messages that come from over there.'

Rational Progress

We must remember that everyone survives death, the foolish as well as the wise, the mercenary as well as the generous, the evil as well as the good, and the messages from the spirit world reflect every kind of mentality; it is this human character that one finds so convincing in the many messages that come to us from the beyond.

It is a mistake to allow our minds to be warped by scientific, philosophic, or theological preju-dices when we approach the subiect of Spiritualism. It is, in its best aspects, the most rational of the modern movements, many of which it has mothered. For its basis is scientific, it enunciates a doctrine of rational progress in the beyond, and its highest teachings stimulate the loftiest emotions.

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What, then, one may ask, is the mechanism of survival?

Long ago, when writing to the Corinthians, St. Paul said, 'There is a natural body and there is a spiritual body.' Note the present tense, 'there IS a spiritual body.'

Spirit, Soul and Body

This spiritual body is, by us, called the soul. It comes into being at the same time as does our physical body. It should be borne in mind that our physical body has no life of its own. It is but the means by which the spirit comes into touch with its material environment.

Every atom of matter is ensphered by the spirit, and matter is a means by which the energies of the Cosmic Spirit operates. Energy and form are always as-The fertilization of the germ cell by the sperm cell at conception releases the creative energies potential in them so that the process of body building can be-

Thus there comes into being a new individual who is a trinity Spirit, Soul and Body. Spirit is the Creator; Soul the Mediator of its energies, and Body the Formative factor which enables the energies of the Spirit to be focalized so that its laten individuality can be developed and made manifest.

Only Material Consciousness

Now just as a physical body implies a physical world in which it can live and grow, so does a spiritual body imply a spirit world in which it can live and develop its powers.

Thus, although we may not be conscious of it, we live in the spirit world now, for that world in-terpenetrates the material world. While in the material world our consciousness is directed to material things. The body has needs: clothes, food, shelter are primary needs which must be met, and every child born into the world has a right to the supply of what is

necessary to meet these needs.

Over these are other needs; needs of the emotions and the intellect all of which clamor for some satisfaction. Through our senses we become aware of our material surroundings. There may be many things of which we are unaware, but as existence and perception of existence are not the same we must discriminate and not deny existence to that of which we may be unaware.

"As Above, So Below"

The spiritual body is a case in point: How many people are aware that they are spirits now? We cannot say, but we do know that there are some who argue that life, consciousness, and organism are always associated, and who think that when the organism dies life and consciousness also die.

Now this statement about the association of life, consciousness, and organism is true, and I believe always will be upon all planes of Being. Spirit needs organism in order to act. For what reason does the universe exist if not for the Creator to act therein'? Remember that the saying 'as above so below' has its reverse side; the one is complimentary to the other.

e see, then, that the growth development and unfoldment of the physical and spiritual body go on together. Not only so, but the inner body is built up of the sublimated and refined essences of the physical body. There is goon within the physical body ing secret and unknown processes beyond the eyes of science.

There is a constant circulation of forces, an ever moving development of substances expressive of the manifold movements of the Primal Spirit of all. Thus the spirFAMOUS "OLD-TIME" MEDIUM

And in its early stages the differences between earth life and spirit life will not be vastly different. For the processes that go on in the physical body go on in every realm and kingdom of nature. Spirit does not incarnate, it emerges into activity.

What Immortality Means

It may be argued that this line of reasoning cuts across the idea of immortality, and I frankly admit that it does as that idea is usually enunciated. Immortality means without beginning or end, and it is a metaphysical axiom that what begins ends.

That statement is based upon our experiences of this life: we see that everything has its term: birth and death are processes of eternal becoming. Worlds and eternal becoming. Worlds and systems are born, develop, change and die. That is the law of physical being.

But we have seen that man survives death, so though he begins and ends here as a physical being, he does not end as a spiritual being. The axiom breaks down and is seen to be no axiom in the real sense.

But it will be urged; if our individuality begins will it not end? To which one may ask, Why should it? From whence is our individuality derived? . . . from our parents?

We'll go back to the ultimate source and you come to God, the

source of all being and whose individuality is stamped upon every part of the universe. God is immortal and if we derive our individuality from him then we are also immortal. It matters not that at some point in time it becomes the greater and deeper principle of manifest, this is only relative to individuality which is eternal.

A Joyous Existence

Do not the repetitive processes in Nature suggest that they spring from that which is deeper: the repetitive processes of Divine Creative Thought?

Very well, is not every individual a repetition upon a finite scale of Infinite Being who lives and moves and has His being in his creation, as that lives and moves and has its being in Him?

The circle spirals out into ever circling orders of being. We live because God lives; we change in order to become more vividly aware of Him; we enter a finer realm at death so that we may learn of his creative processes from the inside.

And in his wisdom he has prepared for us realms of being wherein we may experience deeper, richer, and more aburdant life. No return to the seed-bed of earth, but an ever expanding joyous existence of perpetual creative endeavor.

In its deepest and finest moments of realization our spirits cry, I am one with God: one with Him in all his works and powers!
