My Visit With FLORENCE S. BECKER CALIFORNIA'S VERSATILE MEDIUM

San Francisco's Noted Direct-voice Medium Holds Special Seance for the Editors of Psychic Observer.

Florence S. Becker, one of Spiritualism's greatest mediums, was endowed from her earliest days, with not only the ability to commune with spirits but also the gift of prophecy.

Her parents were strict orthodox Christians. The astounding yarns, told by young Florence, were considered by some to be absolute falsehoods, and she was oftentimes punished for repeating messages and relating communion she had with spirit people. As just punishment, she would sometimes be sent to a dark attic where she was obliged to spend hours in isolation from her playmates.

This procedure failed to correct the "scandalous" tale-telling. Materialized spirits would actually sit beside her on an old trunk in the darkness of the attic,—psychic scientists know that ectoplasmic formations can build up in semi-darkness—these spirits would teach and tell her many truths. Also, messages about future events, concerning the family and neighbors, would be included in the attic communications.

Her Early Life

Naturally, the young child would be filled with enthusiasm about her spirit friends. At the time she did not understand, nor did she realize these people were actually spirits. Again and again she would repeat the unbelievable yarns told her in the attic. In almost every instance, she would be justly punished by whippings, extra household duties or any hardship the good parents could conjure up to meet the strict requirements for upbringing a Christian daughter.

Florence's early home life was one of great problems and difficulties. While still quite young, she married. From this union, she had two fine sons, who are now grown men in the service of the United States.

Florence Becker has always been under the *Guidance of Angels*. One outstanding example of the Bible promise "He will give His Angels Charge Over Thee" was when a goitre appeared on her throat. The doctors decided to operate.

Operation Avoided

In due course, the young mother was placed on the operating table. As an anaesthetic was being administered, a spirit voice spoke aloud: "Don't operate on that girl." The doctors heard the voice and at about the same time,

a large red rose suddenly appeared—as if painted on the white wall of the surgery.

The doctors were astounded. They were frightened. All plans for the operation abruptly stopped and Florence thenceforth returned to her little prairie home on the plains of Kansas. The bulge or apparent goitre remained on her throat.

One day, an old spirit friend, who had frequently talked with her during her attic days, came to her home. He was an Indian and seemed to be perfectly human.

Possibly a strange statement for me to make but follow closely. This Indian then told her a trip to San Francisco was absolutely necessary and so saying, packed her bags for the trip and helped the young children prepare for the journey.

Accompanied by this very same red-man, Florence and the two children traveled to the City of the Golden Gate. They went to an apothecary shop and, to the clerk, the Indian gave explicit instructions for an unusual mixture of herbs, et cetera, for a poultice.

This poultice was applied to the goitre which in a few days completely disappeared.

Shortly before taking his departure, this good old Indian cut one of his long black braids, gave it to the girl Florence, and said: "Call my name, I will always respond. I will guard, guide and protect you." It was like a benediction—then the Indian disappeared.

From that day on, this very same Indian, although now he al-

I have just read in a London paper of an empty Irish Mansion which has been left entirely unguarded since its owner's death, though it is known to contain thousands of dollars worth of jewelry and other valuables. Naturally in these days of constant burglaries, one asks oneself how it is possible these treasures remain untouched? The answer sounds startling—they are guarded by spirits!

This large house in County Monaghan has such a haunted reputation that it protects itself and requires no caretaker. The local inhabitants dare not approach the hundred acre estate after dark. Stories are told of cabinets and china hurled to the ground by invisible hands and poachers say they have seen unearthly animals prowling about the grounds at night, creatures with blazing eyes and crimson tongues—like fire—hanging from open mouths, ready to devour any human intruder.

A "Haunted House"

It would seem a hardened robber would not have been scared away by such stories, but the Irish are very superstitious and afraid of the "supernatural." This account of a haunted mansion reminded me of an incident which happened at the time of the *Sien Fien Insurrection*. It was told me by the owner of a house which was veritably saved by a spirit.

This ancestral mansion had been marked down for destruction by the rebels while the master was away. His wife and daughter were in residence and when in the dead of night a loud knocking was heard outside, the brave daughter rushed down before their staff or her mother realized the rebels were outside. She flung open the door, faced them and demanded to know their business.

"We have come," they said, "to burn this place down and we give you and the rest of the swine five minutes to clear out!"

She told me she had no idea her answer was to prove the salvation of their home, for she gasped in very real concern: "Oh! dear—where will the spirit go!"

You see, they had a family spectre which materialized so frequently that they looked on it as a friend and were perfectly famil-

During our stay in Los Angeles, a reporter from the Los Angeles Herald Examiner interviewed both of us at the Biltmore Hotel. According to the article that appeared the following day, we were referred to as "authorities" on psychic science. No one could possibly be an authority on so vast a subject but the fact that so large a newspaper would be interested in what the Spiritualists were doing is, in itself, fairly encouraging. When asked about spirit communication, we were careful to use the words *spirit people* but the city editors seem only to think of them as *ghosts*.

The article about us was headed *Ghost Films: the subheading was Psychic Experts claim Spirits here to stay*. The text of the article reads:

"Ghosts are good box office. That's why moviegoers are seeing more of them on the screen these days, according to two of the nation's leading authorities on ghosts and ghostly goings-on.

"The authorities are Juliette Ewing Pressing and her husband, Ralph G. Pressing, lecturers and writers on psychic research subjects and publishers of the *Psychic Observer*, leading American publication devoted to such subjects.

"They declared that the current cycle of fantasy-type movies, particularly those with psychic themes, indicate a growing trend in troubled times to search for satisfying answers concerning the mysteries of life.

"The time has arrived when serious investigators and writers on these matters no longer can be regarded as just nuts. Mr. Pressing stated. There are too many intelligent and important people who are interested.

"Mr. and Mrs. Pressing asserted that the evidence of personal survival after death is now so voluminous and complete that any person can satisfy himself merely by reading the literature available in a public library."

P.S.S.A. Convention

The annual convention of the Pennsylvania State Spiritualist Association was held May 12-15 at The First Association of Spiritualists Church, Master and Carlisle Sts., Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, according to *Augusta Taylor*, Pastor. Listed on the official program as featured lecturers and message bearers for the convention: Rev. Mamie B. Schulz, Chesterfield, Indiana; Rev. Hugh Gordon Burroughs, Washington, D. C. and Rev. Anna K. Rose, Philadelphia.

Great Spiritualist Rally

Four thousand persons attended a Spiritualist rally at The Royal Albert Hall April 12th last. This meeting, sponsored by *Psychic News*, was under the direction of C. S. Taylor and J. Arthur Findlay. A special program, printed on expensive glossy paper, names the following speakers and mediums: J. Arthur Findlay, Chairman; Rev. C.

Drayton Thomas, noted writer and author; George Daisley, outstanding London clairvoyant; Miss Lind-of-Hageby, eminent Swiss lecturer and Ronald Strong, popular clairvoyant and direct-voice medium. It was a four-hour program.

The preface of the rally program is headed *Historic Spiritualist Meetings*. It reads: "Round about the mid-twenties Sir Arthur Conan Doyle conducted the first Spiritualist Service ever to be held in Albert Hall.

"Today over twenty years later, the Albert Hall is again the scene of a great Spiritualist gathering. It is the All Spiritualists' Rally organized by *Psychic News*. In those intervening years, Spiritualism has not remained at a standstill; on the contrary its message has been proclaimed from platforms all over the country.

"For many years dating from 1927, the *Marylebone Spiritualist Association* held annual services of reunion and remembrance at the Albert Hall. It is interesting to note that when the hall was first booked for a Spiritualist Service, the organizers wondered if they could fill it. Practically every *London Spiritualist Church* curtailed its services for that evening, and asked the congregation to go to the Albert Hall. Soon, however, it became customary for the Albert Hall to be filled once or twice a year, whilst other Spiritualist meetings had their normal attendances.

"In 1938, Spiritualism reached a peak hitherto unscathed. In less than six weeks, five propaganda meetings, arranged by the *Sunday Pictorial*, in conjunction with the *House of Red Cloud*,

were held: These enabled 25,000 people to hear the case for Spiritualism.

"Before the war there were at least three large propaganda meetings every Sunday, at the *Queen's Hall*, *Grottrian Hall* and *Acolitan Hall*, but with the outbreak of hostilities these had to close down. *Ronald Strong*, in keeping open the *Wigmore Hall*, became practically our only champion in the Metropolis.

"The war over, Spiritualist meetings on a large scale are held frequently. The *London District Council* of the S.N.U. hold Spring and Autumn Rallies, while the M.S.A. conduct a service at the *Victoria Hall*, Bloomsbury, every Sunday. The *Kingsway Hall*, Holborn, has been the scene of several large propaganda meetings of late. The *Link and Universal Brotherhood Federation* have organized several meetings in that hall, and at the *Scala Theatre*."

What's Wrong With It?

Some think the name "Spiritualism" should be changed into something new and happier. A recent letter states . . . "it seems that Spiritual Science" might be appropriate. "Psychic Science," I do not like, as it does not appertain to the highest. To quote from "Counsel from the Heavenly Spheres," by H. B., "many people seem to confound the psychical with the spiritual. Psychical development is by no means synonymous with spiritual unfoldment, but when both are combined in a perfect balance, and sympathetically evolved and trained, then the individual becomes a great force for good, both in this world and the next."

Now all these suggestions are meant well but in the first place, there are many organizations — all out-and-out Spiritualist organizations—that already use the two above suggested names, but the general opinion—and I have heard some opinions expressed in public, also to private groups and from Spiritualist platforms—is to LEAVE IT ALONE.

It is true, the name *Spiritualism* has been dragged through the mire by public prejudice but in spite of the stigma which has apparently become attached to it — as some believe — it will yet emerge from the fires of ignorant superstition and opposition to its rightful place as a Philosophy of Life.

Frankly, I cannot understand why the term "Spiritualism" so often arouses such strong animosity and condemnation. Every religion must have some "Spiritualism" in it. Possibly this animosity is because it is often inden-

tified with mere fortune-telling or some of the so-called lowest forms of psychic phenomena.

To me, however, the term signifies a belief in things spiritual, in the existence of spiritual beings, in a spirit-world governed by spiritual laws and conditions, and in a spiritual basis to all things material and visible.

What They Thought In 1852

Gaylord M. Uptegraff, Lewiston, N. Y., a stamp collector, received a letter from a friend. The letter was written on a piece of paper that was folded, sealed and addressed . . . The Postmaster at Malden Bridge, N. Y. certified that 3c postage had been paid and that no stamp was used. The stamp certification was dated Feb. 22, 1852.

"Now Mr. Uptegraff is interested in *Spiritualism* . . . just as much as he is interested in stamps. Upon reading the folded paper in the letter, he was amazed to find the following communication:

Malden Bridge, Feb. 22-52

Dear Brother:

"Since I wrote I have been so fortunate as to gain a considerable information with regard to the principles and philosophy of Spiritual Communications and unless I receive some very substantial evidence to the contrary shall consider myself a believer.

"I have obtained a large pamphlet published at Auburn I don't now recollect the title, which gives a particular account of the origin and progress of the (so called) Spiritual rapping. I have also two pamphlets and a volume entitled the *Great Harmonia*, published by Andrew Jackson Davis recently, on the subject of philosophy of Spiritual Communications. He mentions the pamphlet published at Auburn and agrees with the ideas therein contained.

"His ideas and opinions conflict somewhat with some passages in the Bible but I think not materially to detract from the merits of the scriptures. The Bible may, and no doubt does, contain some error, and as this is an age of

improvement. I think we should not object to a better light but go for a progression in knowledge in this as we are led to believe we shall in another sphere of existence.

"As I have had some experience in Magnetism, I profess to have some knowledge of its principles and its effects and I know there is something in it which is wonderful and somewhat inaccountable and especially to a misinformed person, but since reading the above mentioned works it appears more plain and rational.

"It will be generally admitted that there is, or is to be, a future state of existence that these mortal bodies are to be exchanged for Spiritual bodies, but the idea of our having communication with the Spiritual beings is something new and of course disbelieved because the principle is not understood.

"If a man twenty years ago had prophesied that at this day a man in Albany could converse with another individual in New Orleans by means of electricity he would have been hooted at as a visionary, an enthusiastic, or an insane person, but now who doubts the reality—no one, and reasoning from facts developed we may, I think, reasonably conclude that in a short space of time the principles of Spiritual Communications may be as well understood and as universally believed.

"I am, for my part, anxious to gain more light and any suggestions or instructions you may think proper to impart will be thankfully received.

The Poughkeepsie Seer, Andrew Jackson Davis, seemed to fore-see storm clouds ahead for the Spiritualists—and this was over 60 years ago when the following article appeared in "Reason" magazine over his signature. The article, headed "Davis' Warning To Spiritualists," reads:

"Yes, this is my irresistible impression. Men must make an intelligent use of their manifestations; else they will go down into history as the tricks of itinerant boys and girls. Look within for that principle which causes all effects in the external. When you find an internal conviction that you are immortal, which no sophistry can invalidate or disturb, then you have found a treasure; the beauty of which is greatly enhanced by Spiritual manifestation. Secure this internal conviction first, then add the illustration.

"In a few brief years more — when Clairvoyant, healing Impressional, and writing mediums only will be known—men will have reaped a harvest of evidence. The testimonials of hundreds of thousands could then be secured. Persons, considered skeptics, will read with earnestness. The churches will gradually become powerless. Skeptical minds will get their questions answered outside of churches.

"Then the Churches will come to you.

Be careful, my friends, lest you forget and go to the Churches. Do not be absorbed by them. There is danger in becoming too popular!

"Beware, when the churches begin to consider it profitable to invite you to take a seat in their beautiful compartment. Accept this and you are on the road to annihilation. Yea, when the churches consider *Spiritualism* reputable enough to endorse you, then consider that you are all on the broad road to certain mischievous prosperity; an easy thriftiness which will turn into conservatism, like all the past, and build up institutions against another dispensation.

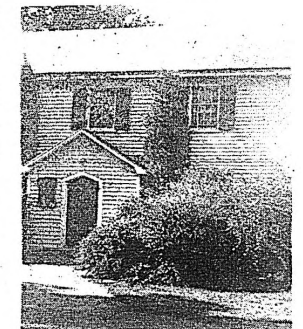

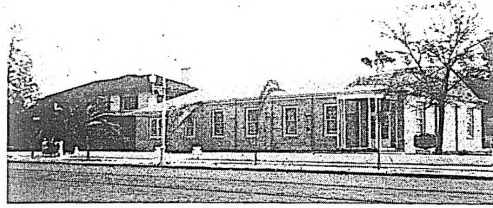

lar with its appearances. The fact of its being burnt out and driven from the home it loved, was her first concern. This involuntary exclamation had a surprising and utterly unexpected effect. The seditious crowd of villainous looking men, well trained in the burning of landowners' property, stood speechless for a moment. Looting, shooting and murder was the order of the day, but to tackle a spirit and offend a visitant from the unseen world was something different. The whole crowd just turned tail and fled.

"That Reminds Me"

The family felt forever grateful to the kindly spirit which had so wormed its personality round the girl's heart that it came first to her mind in the hour of peril.

Not all spirits are unpleasant, though human beings generally have an inborn dread of living in a haunted house. A friendly and quite unalarming spectre is no less a person than the foster mother of Edward VI, *Mistress Sibel Penn*, who has appeared in recent years—always gowned in her long grey dress.

In my Autobiography "THAT REMINDS ME," I described how she was mistaken for the housekeeper by a guest in an Apartment at *Hampton Court Palace*, but since writing that incident I have heard she appeared to a child in a house at Hampton-on-Thames, called "*Penn's Place*." This residence was given her in order that she might end her days in leisure and peace. Friends of mine who own it now say their little girl at the age of three described the lady in grey who came and stood by her bed at night.

Deitalizing Color

I also learned just recently that *Mistress Penn* was seen in the same grey gown in Hampton Church by our late *Verger*. He was familiar with her features as her life sized recumbent figure, in marble, lies just inside the South door, under a stone canopy, supported by Corinthian pillars. She died of smallpox in 1562. I have not heard before of an authentic spirit making several appearances always dressed in the same color and I think few living people realize how color affects their temperament and has a psychic bearing on health and well being.

It is not "*faddy*," as many

might think, to refuse to live surrounded by devitalizing color vibrations. The peace of our minds and souls may be affected by the various shades surrounding us in our homes and the very garments we wear.

Kilner's Experiments

We should fly from colors that depress or repel us as from a disease. People known as "*sensitives*" are specially influenced by the magnetism or malignity of color, which depresses or exhilarates as the case may be. Psychics say the love of yellow indicates a controlled and practical mind. I glow in the company of yellow, yet I know a woman who is leaving her furnished flat simply because it has yellow walls.

The science of color is worthy of deep study. If you look into the matter you will find each of the seven colors of the spectrum—violet, indigo, blue, green, yellow, orange and red, has something to say to your spiritual side, which can disturb or stimulate the life-force.

Clairvoyants who see curas tell us that flame color quivers round highly developed individuals. *Dr. Walter Kilner*, a notable man, proved scientifically that when humans were looked at through a *Kilnerscope*, they fell into different color groups, so it is feasible that if you detach yourself from your right group, you suffer accordingly.

"Observations"

For instance, if you find you definitely prefer wearing a certain shade, it shows the inner man is craving for that color, which calms and satisfies the consciousness, so why not try a color-cure as a change from chemist's drugs? Have you ever noted how color comes into general conversation?

Expressions in England such as these are constantly used:

He is "in a brown study," or "in the blues." We are "green with envy," we "see red." Another—"put a false color on the matter," or possibly you saw a "culprit in his true colors," while some brave hero "nailed his colors to the mast."

In my latest book "OBSERVATIONS," I mentioned how admirably light colors suit *Queen Mary*. Last summer she was seen gowned and hatted entirely in pink of a delicate shade. I added: "*If she selected that color it can be taken for granted it was the 'pink of perfection'*," since she always dresses in excellent taste.

Many think their lives are governed by the stars, but I firmly believe our destiny is mingled with the color influences surrounding us. We look up at the midnight blue of a sky, spangled with

My Visit With Florence BECKER

ways manifests definitely as a spirit, is foremost in the life of Mrs. Becker. From the spirit side of life, he now helps her over many rough places and unflinching responds to her every call.

Now, some will ask these questions. In the beginning was this Indian a spirit who had the power to materialize himself? Was this Indian able to build a human body whenever such was needed? Do these manifestations occur for the evolution and help of humanity?

If these questions are not answered in the affirmative then how could this Indian hold a body together for such a length of time?

These manifestations will probably never be fully understood by those in the mortal body. But then, can we explain exactly how the wind blows? Can we explain exactly just how we eat and assimilate our food? "Can we explain how life can remain in a seed that has been entombed for centuries?"

Precipitated Painting

Records show that seeds, buried with Egyptian mummies for centuries, have been brought out of tombs—planted and developed into great fields of grain.

Oh, Great Mystery of Life—we mortals ask for light and wisdom—we are but children in the eyes of God.

The story about the Indian and many more were told me in California by Florence Becker during my recent visit to her residence in San Francisco.

Throughout her career as a medium, Mrs. Becker has conducted developing classes for spiritual unfoldment. I was told that during class, Mrs. Becker's teacher, Dr. Briggs, announced he would like to try to produce some unusual phenomena. He requested that canvas be purchased such as used by artists for oil paintings—and that they prepare a frame and tack the canvas to it.

They followed these instructions and the canvas, tacked to a frame as directed, was brought to the class room. After a thorough examination, the students securely pinned it in black sateen. There were no paints of any description in the room.

Rare Phenomena

The lights were extinguished, the medium was entranced, and the class work continued as usual. At the conclusion, when the spirit teacher was about to dismiss the students, he told them to be very careful of the paint as it would have to dry. Dr. Briggs also in-

structed them to keep it, as much as possible, in a dim light at least for several days.

After the shaded lights were turned on, you can imagine the amazement and delight of the students as well as the medium, when they found a beautiful picture had been precipitated on the canvas whilst beneath these black cloths.

I met several people who were present when some of these remarkable paintings were produced. In the home of many students in San Francisco, these precipitated paintings are their most treasured possessions. This phase of Mrs. Becker's mediumship is truly remarkable but, owing to her extreme modesty, comparatively few people, on "the outside," have ever seen or heard about it.

Lollie's Symbolology

Another impressive feature I noticed, in Mrs. Becker's home, was her valuable collection of elephants that have come to her from all parts of the world. This immense collection includes specimens made of jade, ivory, crystal, china and other materials. The elephants vary in size. Some are so tiny a magnifying glass must be used to see them. Amazing, but true. Others are quite large, probably two to three feet in height.

Famous men and women who have sat in seances with Mrs. Becker have contributed to the collection which now numbers into thousands.

Lollie, her beloved spirit child-guide, is particularly fond of these elephants, and the entire collection really belongs to her. In Lollie's symbolology, the elephant means peace, exemplified when the elephant's trunk is upturned—and she will not have a single elephant whose trunk is not flung high.

The Children "Have A Time"

To reach Mrs. Becker's sanctuary, we went downstairs to the first floor level. Incidentally, practically all of the San Francisco homes are so built that the first floor level is the basement, so if one is entering from the street, the door would, therefore, open directly into a foyer.

Mrs. Becker has two seance rooms. One is very large and will seat about thirty or forty people, whilst the other room is quite small. Both are entered from the foyer. It was in the smaller room that we sat for our private seance.

From time to time, throughout the entire day, whenever conditions made it possible, Lollie would speak a few words to us in independent-voice. Evidently she

was eager and ready to chat, because, immediately after the lights were turned off, we heard independent voices in gleeful conversation. These proved to be my little spirit child-guide Pink Flower and Lollie.

Independent Voice

The characteristic greeting from Lollie is a jolly, cheerful "Hoo! Hoo!" for everybody. During the greater part of this seance, Mrs. Becker was not entranced hence she, too, could enjoy and participate in the conversations with the spirits.

These manifestations are natural and especially convincing for the uninitiated. There is not a shadow of a doubt that the voice is that of a spirit and not the medium. In some instances, as additional evidence several voices were heard at the same time. At this point, I was intrigued by a spirit who was able to produce a unique sound . . . sawing wood. This continued for several minutes, then a rasping noise—denoting that the sawer, had struck a knot in the wood.

My Mama, Annie E. Ewing was one of the first spirits to communicate and express her joy for the opportunity to speak. She was able to create beautiful spirit lights which radiated sufficiently for us to distinguish outlines of the three of us—Mr. Pressing, Mrs. Becker and myself. We were actually able to discern each other in the pitch-dark room.

Startling Evidence

After others had expressed their greetings, a most dramatic entree was made which proved to be a most powerful spirit. The room—walls—chairs—floor, vibrated as though a slight earthquake might be taking place. Then, a strong resonant Indian voice spoke saying: "I am White Feather. I posed for my portrait with an artist in England. I am well satisfied with the results. I have come to bring power and peace. There is great work to be done." This was most evidential, see article page 12.

Several days before we left for California, we received from S. A. MacDonald, London, England, a number of beautiful pastel paintings of various guides. Amongst these pictures was one of White Feather.

During the winter months, from time to time, while in meditation,

I saw a certain Indian. This Indian wore a magnificent white headdress, and gave his name, White Feather. Naturally, I was pleased to have this corroborated and I was doubly blessed to have been given such evidence. To be sure this was the same White Feather. (See Picture, Page 12).

Not one word concerning these pastels had been mentioned to Mrs. Becker and as a matter of fact, we had not discussed the pictures with anyone outside our office staff in Lily Dale, several thousand miles from California. For the skeptic, this data should have remarkable evidential value.

Dr. Peebles Speaks!

A gentleman (see Page 1) well known amongst Spiritualists the world over, spoke to us. He was Dr. J. M. Peebles. The fact that Dr. Peebles spoke bears no particular significance, as he has manifested to us many times, but the conversation was extremely important. His message promised great hope for mankind.

Dr. Peebles said: "My good friends, I am delighted to greet you, and especially pleased that Marion gave you the bas-relief of me. When I lived on earth, I was interested, and my time was completely absorbed, in preaching the truth that the dead live and communicate to the earth people.

"From my vantage point, here in this vast world of spirit, I really, even more, recognize and know, the great importance that this age old question has for the people of earth. My friends, I will help you and lend my power and strength from this side of life, to carry the torch of truth onward.

"At this time, though the din of battle has ceased, the cry of the hearts of suffering, ignorant humanity, bound by the shackles of ignorance, is greater and more far reaching into our realms than ever before in the history of the world.

"The message of man's immortality—the message of truth that man is indestructible spirit must be heralded to every nation of the earth. Man is Spirit—God is Spirit—All are one. One in essence—one in reality—all working toward the goal of perfection which one day must be achieved by all races, all creeds and all men. I will help you."

The plaque or bas-relief to which Dr. Peebles referred was given to us several nights previously by Marion Carpenter-Vail, when we visited her home in Los Angeles, 1814 Wellington Road.

What She Teaches

Dr. Briggs, the principal spirit collaborator of Mrs. Becker spoke to us, as did my own Dr. Harry Corbin, W. J. Colville, Mr. Pressing's Red Feather (See picture, Page 12) and a host of others, interested in our work with PSYCHIC OBSERVER, also spoke to us.

As a child, Florence Becker communed with spirit. She lived with Spirit. Her life is devoted to helping others find their way into an understanding of God's eternal laws.

She has taught and demonstrated that man is indestructible—that man is a Spirit—that man is one with God—that it is perfectly natural to walk with Spirit when one follows The Laws of God—and that his eternal promise "I will give my Angels charge over thee" is true today, tomorrow and forever.

In the next issue of PSYCHIC OBSERVER, Mrs. Pressing will give a detailed account of her visit with California mediums and Spiritualist Churches. She will also describe other interesting contacts made during her recent trip to the West Coast.

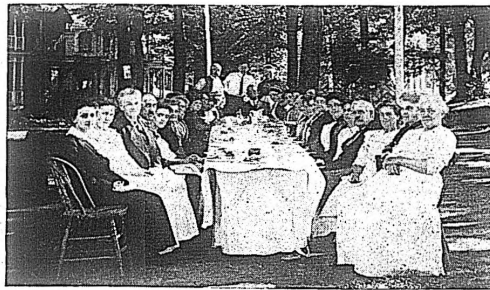
Faith That Heals

who were kneeling, they were made whole.

So it matters not what was in the casket; it was the faith that produced the so-called miracle.

Real Purpose of Faith

Once upon a mountainside, in a camp, I was giving a healing service. There was not time to reach the vast number who needed help. A man who had been far back in the line came up to me after the service and said, "Oh, Mr. Burroughs, if I could just have come forward, if you could just have placed your hands on me! I know that I could have been made well!"

I said, "Do you still believe that?" He replied that he did; so after some friends lifted the man to a stump nearby, I passed my hands gently down his body to his ankles; and that man was made well. He threw away his canes, got down from the stump, and hopped around for joy.

These things are done by the power of *God* working through you; but you can not become the demonstrator of this power if you hold one unkind thought or if you are one of those human beings constantly criticizing and seeing the mediocre things in life. Unless you become so big that your vision does not see these things, unless you accept only the broad, beautiful things, unless you can accept the divine within every human being you meet and see him as a spark of the individual manifestation of *God*, you cannot do these things. Faith must be established, and that is one of the fundamental principles of *Modern Spiritualism*.

Why Can We Believe?

Now why do we have faith? Because we know that we are in direct touch with *God*. I do not believe in *God*; I know *God*. And you, too, may know *God* and be in direct touch with Him constantly, enjoying the beautiful things of life more fully and more spiritually, finding the worth-while things that make for real and lasting happiness, and freeing yourself from those things which are merely objective and which in every sense of the word keep you tied down. This can be your inheritance.

Why can we believe? Because we know that from time immemorial, *God* has never closed the gates to the children of the earth, and that He has always spoken to them. He has spoken to the human family, through various sources, one of the chief of which is ministering angels who are sensitive to vibrations and can convey messages to the earth plane.

Just as the radio today picks up voices wherever they may be upon wave lengths of vibration,

just so the human mind may be attuned to catch the vibration of these angel voices. Both *Paul* and *Christ* were the recipients of the visitation of angels in a far-off day. The very birth of *Christ* was foretold, guarded over, and directed by ministering angels.

All Are Guided

It was through the care of ministering angels that the life of *Jesus* was protected. *Joseph* in dreams heard the voices, others heard the voices, *Mary* heard the voices, and they were directed what to do and when to bring the *Christ-child* back to his own country. That is why in the early days we were told to pray to our guardian angels. That is why today some of us pray to the saints and those who have gone to the higher realms of spirituality. The church has already given us this knowledge, but it has not perfected the knowledge which it gave. *God never said that we could not have this knowledge*.

At birth, each one of us was certainly given into the charge of an angelic being. Though we may not be conscious of it today, each one of us, if we could see clairvoyantly, would know that near us is a saintly, spiritual being who has ever been our help. SPIRITUALISM AT CASSADAGA

Cassadaga Camp, located at Cassadaga, Florida, amid the pines and lakes, proved of interest to hundreds of guests this past season. (January, February, March, 1947).

The hotel, overlooking *Spirit Lake*, was capably managed by J. M. McGill and wife, Margaret.

Around this modern, comfortable hotel revolves a story of Spiritual upliftment; perhaps forming the basis of warmth and good fellowship which seemed to prevail throughout the camp.

On February 6th, the Cassadaga Woman's Club celebrated their 23rd birthday with a *George P. Colby Memorial* program, in honor of the founder of *Cassadaga Camp*, who was born at Pike, Alleghany County, New York, in 1848.

How It Came About

As a child in *Minnesota*, Mr. Colby followed the path of the truth of Spiritualism. At the age of twelve, it was prophesied he would someday found a center of psychic faith in the south.

Early development soon led to outstanding mediumship, and to seances conducted by the youth throughout America, from the eastern shores, as far west as Oakland, Calif.

At the age of twenty-seven, Colby's remarkable demonstrations of mediumship were brought to an abrupt halt, as the ravages of tuberculosis took their toll of his strength.

Retiring to Florida for his health, he arrived by boat at *Blue Springs*, then only a wood yard, and, with the *Gidding* family who had accompanied him, occupied a deserted house near what is now known as *Orange City*; *Deland*, *Lake Helen*, and the former city not having been in existence at that time.

Cassadaga Is Born

Wandering through the wilderness, he climbed a low hill, staring at the scene below, the shimmering lake surrounded by towering pine trees heavy with needles and moss. *And Cassadaga Camp was born.*

Discovering a deserted storage crib, he placed logs across one corner, moss formed his mattress and the sky was his covering. An open fire on the ground was his fireplace.

Other than a narrow gauge from *St. Augustine* to *Tato*, there

were no railroads south of *Jacksonville*, Florida's gateway city, and *George Colby's* only means of obtaining food and mail were from *Enterprise* or *Beresford*, the distance being traveled by foot, a tiring chore for an ill man.

Regaining his strength and recalling the medium's prophecy, Mr. Colby renewed his fight for Spiritual survival, and in 1893 held a three-day meeting in a tent borrowed from the *East Coast Railway*, acting as lecturer, singer and message bearer.

Featured Mediums

Capturing the interest of the *Lily Dale*, New York, Spiritualist Assembly, which was then the *Cassadaga Lake Free Association*, he was assisted by members of this great organization in creating the *Southern Cassadaga Spiritualist Assembly*. With his donation of thirty-four acres of his homestead land to be used as the site of the assembly, the camp was completed in 1895.

Following a full recovery, which he attributed to the drinking of the Cassadaga spring water, *George P. Colby* lived to the ripe old age of eighty-five, crossing to the Spirit side of life in July of 1933. His home was purchased by Mr. and Mrs. V. M. Alderman, and can still be seen, as well as where his storage crib was located. Like the waters of the spring which continue to flow, the spirit and courage of this magnificent medium lives on in all who enter his haven of truth.

Outstanding demonstrations of psychic phenomena were displayed at this southern camp during the months of January, February and March, by the noted mediums, *T. John Kelly*, *Arthur Ford* and *M. McBride Panton*.

Mr. Kelly performed an unprecedented feat with his delivery of over eighty messages during a single evening in January. The *Welch* medium proved equally interesting in a personal seance which I attended with my aunt, *Mrs. Henrietta Ford Thomas*; disproving the theory that spectacular platform demonstrations and inspirational private seances are to be found in one physical agent.

Ford's Accuracy

The appearance of the celebrated *Arthur Ford* marked the month of February at Cassadaga. Ford's opening lecture was attended by over five hundred persons who had driven from all points in America to the camp for this occasion. Many familiar faces

from *Camp Silver Belle* were in evidence.

Following a new sermon rendered by Ford for the first time in any center, demonstrations of Spiritual contact were given at three separate meetings that day, each of which were conducted by the well known medium with the aid of his guide, *Fletcher*.

A particularly outstanding message was received by *Mrs. Philomena Taylor* of Jacksonville. During one of the afternoon bazaar seances, the Miami minister described a young man who gave the symbolic impression of a snow storm as evidence in connection with his passing. This entity, despite Ford's minute description, was unclaimed and forgotten, until *Mrs. Taylor* approached the medium shortly before his evening service.

Panton's Demonstration

Although the elderly lady was accompanied by Mr. and Mrs. *Herbert Brown* who head one of Jacksonville's most progressive development classes, she was unaccustomed to Spiritualism and had therefore been unaware of the necessity of claiming a message through the sound of her voice.

The young man had been her nephew who passed over several years ago, after a boat in which he and two companions had been riding capsized near Mandarin, Florida, during the middle of the winter season. Swimming to the nearest shore, the youth's companions had gone for help, leaving him to rest on the river bank. Upon their return, they found the lad had frozen to death in their absence.

Many of February's guests remained, other departing in order to allow new reservations to be filled, for the appearance of the Rev. *M. McBride Panton* of Stamford, Connecticut, whose opening was heralded with an attendance comparable to that of his predecessor.

Evidence Galore

After delivering a splendid lecture based on the ever increasing recognition of Spiritual truth as proving the teachings of ordinary orthodox religion, one of the medium's controls, *Pedro*, came through for almost two hours with his usual jovial messages. The medium's eyes were heavily bandaged at all times.

This Gypsy spirit, defying the

word of God, His promise of eternal life brought into being.

Pedro then greeted me with six words. "I will always be 'Careless minded.'" So simple, yet presenting a wealth of tangible evidence. *Edwin Grady* of Hollywood, Calif., had been an entertainer and one of my dearest friends. His parody of the song, "Careless," had always proved my chief source of amusement. Having never before contacted me, what could be more evidential than his greeting of assurance, "I will always be 'Careless minded,'" since I alone understood the so-called code words of this spirit who had passed over shortly after my return to the east?

At a small direct-voice seance, at which only Prof. *George Halford* of Hartford, Connecticut, Mrs. *Barton Cross* of Lilac Hedges, Eatontown, N. J., my mother, Mrs. *Maude M. Winter*, and I were present, *Chief White Cloud* and *Maisie*, two of Mr. *Panton's* other teachers, brought through *Barton Cross, Jr.*, and *Annie Lynch*, Mrs. *Cross's* mother, who had died when her daughter was at the age of three.

No one, Mrs. *Cross* stated firmly, knew of her mother's maiden name, which was *Lynch*. Nor did anyone know *Annie Lynch Chamberlain*, since she herself had no recollections of her. This was indisputable evidence of survival.

The *Stamford* minister also succeeded in giving me direct contact with a great grandfather who carried the tongue-twisting name of *Count Marcy de Fontaines*, as well as another forefather, *Captain Titus Saller*, who lived during the Revolutionary days, which was revolutionary, to say the least.

contact of rejection, reached out to contact two small children, a brother and sister, within the large audience. The little girl's eyes brimmed with tears as he recalled her playmate by name, who she had been forced to leave in Ohio, and described her brother's actions regarding a sleigh which he had actually owned several years ago. Both children displayed respect for the entity, their faces becoming sorrowful and joyous by turns, although they were early students of grammar school.

Their reactions were a heart-warming tribute to a great truth. Instead of trembling at ghosts and goblins, those small children talked at will with their loved ones, and with a freedom of spirit found only in the homes of Spiritualists. For Spiritualism is the

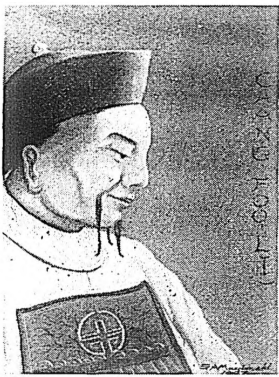

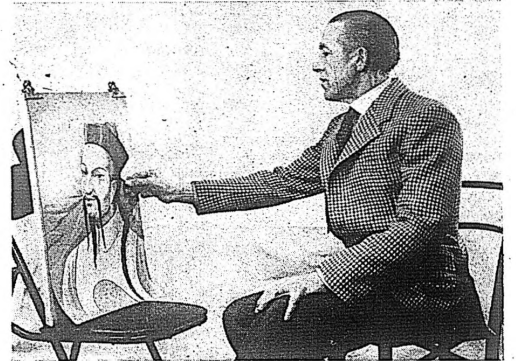

SPIRIT PICTURES PRODUCED BY PSYCHOMETRY

The six pictures appearing on this page were done by means of psychometry, an unusual gift possessed by MACDONALD, in addition to his artistic talents. Either by handling a letter, envelope or handkerchief, or all three, he is able to pick up certain psychic flashes . . . not unlike objective clairvoyance. This help, coupled with his intuitive gifts make it possible to sketch likenesses of spirit guides and teachers of those from whom he receives certain tangible objects.

According to communications received from Macdonald, "quick sketches" are usually made in profile. Front view sketches, taking considerable time, are called "time studies". All pictures are liable to smudge but, if framed immediately, will last up to 100 years.

Macdonald is a popular London psychic artist. He conducts tours through the British Isles and at these appearances, exhibits pastels, lectures and demonstrates his psychic gift.

Before the editors of PSYCHIC OBSERVER deemed it wise to accept advertising from Macdonald, they asked for a sample of his work and were told to follow instructions. JULIETTE EWING PRESSING then mailed a personal letter—enclosing a handkerchief. The results are shown on this page.

Since publishing Macdonald's pastels in PSYCHIC OBSERVER, the artist has received numerous replies from readers. No price was mentioned and, not knowing the actual worth of pastels, he was reimbursed with various small sums. This was no fault of the reader.

In London, Macdonald's fee for sketches varies. Twenty-five to fifty dollars for the "time studies" on French or Italian "Ingres" paper, size 24 in. x 19 in. Those preferring smaller sketches on paper 15 in. x 20 in., the fee is from ten to twenty dollars. The difference in price is accountable because the twenty-five dollar portrait in full color is without the astral background. It is far more difficult to do the sketches at a distance than it is when sitting for a group of five to eight people, says Macdonald.

The six pictures, printed above, are reproduced from photographs of the original pastel drawings, sent to the editors of *Psychic Observer* by S. A. Macdonald, psychic artist, 27a Addison Gardens, London, W. 14, England.

No. 1 — RED FEATHER, according to Macdonald's description attached to the original, was sketched after contact had been made with this Indian—immediately following his (the artist's) reading of an article in *Psychic Observer*. This contact was verified during a sitting in his own seance room. During the manifestation, Mr. Macdonald explains how he was shown an enormous red light—similar to a hand torch. Two and one-half days was the time required to paint this pastel.

No. 2—PINK FLOWER is a difficult time-study with an astral background. It was made possible only after Macdonald's clairvoyant vision. Time required, 2 days.

No. 3—SISTER MARIE of the WHITE SISTERS required only twenty minutes. The artist calls this a "quick sketch."

No. 4—CHANG FOO LI is a quick sketch but required 1½ hours time. This Chinese Philosopher was

Painted as a result of a clairvoyant vision which appeared after Mr. Macdonald read a letter received from Juliette Ewing Pressing. It was this Chinaman who manifested through the trance instrumentality of Rev. Richard Zenor, (See *Psychic Observer*, May 10th, 1947) pastor of the Agasha Temple of Wisdom, 353 North Western Ave., Los Angeles, California. Rev. Zenor could not possibly have known about the picture. The Chinaman gave his name and described his own picture in detail—one of the most evidential messages ever received by the editors.

No. 5—WHITE FEATHER, the Indian spirit who manifested through the direct-voice mediumship of Rev. Florence S. Becker. This pastel required three days. It is a time study . . . done as a result of a clairvoyant vision after contact was made with a letter received from Juliette Ewing Pressing (See article starting page 1).

No. 6—BLUE BELL, a quick sketch. Time 30 minutes. She was seen by the psychic artist during a seance, at which time she conveyed the message that she came with PINK FLOWER and loved to help her medium, Mrs. Pressing, with the colors . . . meaning that in her selection of color combinations around the home, she was always there and likes to "impress" her.
