Camp Chesterfield, located four miles from Anderson. Indiana on the New York Central Railroad, is a mecca for Spiritualists from all over the world. As one enters the gates, there can be seen hundreds of automobiles, bearing license plates from every state Union-trailers are also quite in evidence.

In this year of 1947, there was new hotel opened for visitors. This hotel, The Western, contains some thirty very modern and well furnished rooms. Each room contains a Hollywood bed, chest of drawers, mirrors, rugs, over-stuffed chairs, straight chairs, large roomy closets and a private bath room with shower.

# For Chosen Few

Inasmuch as few people realize just what the word Camp means, I deem it advisable to explain the word. Nowadays most spiritualist camps have hotels, some with all modern conveniences, many others have cafeterias and all of things that make life comfortable such as one would find in any summer resort.

Back in the early days, Spiritualist Camps were rather for the chosen few-that is, the few people who had come into the understanding of communication with the spirit world and they would meet in these groups. Ins'ead of hotels or houses they lived in the tents. Consequently word Camp came into being. But now-adays, with the dawn of a new cycle of Spiritual awareness, the teachings of Spiritualsm are welcome by eager thousands of people who make an annual pilgrim-

age to the Camps, such as Camp Chester field.

To enter the Western Hotel, one climbs twelve concrete steps to a spacious porch (veranda, I should say) and the first thing one sees is groups of people stretched out on their deck chairs, chatting and discussing the happenings in the seances and it is particularly noticeable that the guests at Camp Chesterfield are very happy and very friendly. Why? Because they have found their loved ones and know they still live.

### 7th Consecutive Year

Each year for the last seven years, since the passing into the world of spirit of Etta S. Bledsoe, Camp Chesterfield Association has dedicated to her memory a day, the first Sunday in August, which is called Etta S. Bledsoe Day.

On this day, Mrs. Bledsoe, from spirit, returns to address the audience through the mediumship of James M. Laughton, 9116 Martindale Ave., North, Detroit, Michigan. Mr. Laughton was a student of Mrs. Bledsoe during her earthlife and apparently the vibrations of this young man are especially suitable for Mrs. Bledsoe's return to earth.

# Cabinet On Rostrum

Prior to the demonstration of physical phenomena -- independent voice-I addressed the people assembled and invited a number of them (most particularly those who have never witnessed a demonstration of this character) to come to the rostrum and make a complete examination of the cabinet to be used. A statement was signed by these persons who came (See Col. 3-4 Page 4.)

On this day, a cabinet built without windows (the idea is to create darkness, thus making it possible to build up the necessary psychic structure for independentvoice production) is placed in the center of the wide rostrum, in the Chesterfield auditorium. There is a microphone in this cabinet. It is used merely to magnify the voice of the spirit which is then conveyed to the listening au-dience by the way of loud-speak-ers, a part of the public address system.

# Gate Fee - 10c

After Mr. Laughton enters the cabinet, his spirit collaborators entrance him and draw from his body sufficient ectoplasm to build up the voice-box which Mrs. Bledsoe must use in order to express orally on the earth-plane vibra-

On this particular Etta Bledsoe Day, a small fee of 25 cents was charged for admission into the Auditorium. The gate fee of Camp Chesterfield is 10 cents a day. It is thoroughly understandable that a small additional charge must be exacted in order to carry on the expenses and so on that are neces sary in order to handle the business affairs. Money is also neces sary for making improvements and offering comforts for guests visiting this great camp, which they feel to be their spiritual home on earth.

# R-re Physical Phenomena


To relate all the remarkable things which transpired during this wonderful seance would consume too much valuable space, but I would like to record two or three short occurrences which undoubtedly would help somebody.



# We Do Well To Prove That Americans Are **Humanitarians**

When you think of Thanksgiv

ing, think of simplicity!

Let us never cease to love Thanksgiving because it is so quaint and so simple. The day came from hearts and minds of plain people who lived simple lives. Because of its quaintness it is the most praiseworthy of all our holidays.

New Englanders of all people were best fitted to create it. The beauty and power of such an obscrvance appealed to them. intuitively understood its deeper meaning because their days were filled with unassuming praise.

The human soul will never outgrow its exaltation. For to give thanks is as natural as prayerindeed, to be thankful is prayer, the highest form of prayer, the soliloguy of a jubilant soul. Unwearied by time, uncrushed by disappointments, rising in their hearts to its finest form and use, those noble souls could do naught else but express gratitude that God had enabled them to live above adversity and lacks and disappointments.

We hunger for food and drink; we hunger for air; we hunger for love; there is also a hunger in the heart to praise God for his bountiful gifts: and so the minds and souls of the Pilgrim Fathers awakened spontaneously and they rejoiced at the conclusion of that year's harvests for the abundant products of the soil that hard work and simple living had earned for them. This feeling of thanksgiving was ingrained in them.

# Thanksgiving—Sincere Worship

Other colonies saw the beauty of that love: other states in the fullness of time began to understand that heart-hunger. In time the custom was universally adopted and the national holiday was established. Those who made such a day possible builded greater than they knew.

Thanksgiving is sincere ship; it is a vital religion. Many things may be added to prayer, to worship, but forms and dogmas, even miracles, are as nothing, and, fundamentally, none is aught but praise—that feeling of gratitude that arises in the heart like a song.

The faculty of thanksgiving is little but seldom by those who have much. It is a rejoicing of the heart for the little that we

Thanksgiving is so beautiful that I think most of us can say with James Whitcomb Riley of simple things, of which the observance is a symbol, "O, it sets my heart a-clickin' like the ticking of a clock, When the frost is on the pumpkin and the fodder's in the shock." They go together-thanksgiving and simplicity.

I would to God that in this age we lived the simple lives of New Englanders. They got such joy from plain things—a great open fireplace in the log cabin; popcorn, cider, cookies, pumpkin pies, eaten with the relish hard work

provides; the joy and the mystery of gathering around the great fire when the days work was done. They needed none of the prodigious inventions to make them happy. Ah! That we might bring back some of their simple pleasures and joy!

Now, the times are so different. Like the ancient mariner, we are surrounded by oceans of things without one cup of joy to drink. We are living too fast. Our lives are complex and artificial: there is confusion throughout the world. Our races are hastening headlong into chaos.

# Simplicity of Solution

As is so beautifully expressed by Charles Wagner, the Alsatian philosopher of long ago, "As the fevered patient devoured by thirst dreums in his sleep of cool brooks to bathe in, of clear fountains to drink long draughts from; so, in the complicated agitations of modern existence, our fevered souls dream of simplicity."

That was written many decades ago, and how much more so has modern life become agitated, complex and confused!

If we only could-if we only could move back our lives to such a setting! Simplicity might solve all the problems wherewith we agitate our souls.

My contention is that too many people meddle with the problems of the age. The extravagance of ideas is a private misfortune and a world danger. We are going to war not because Russia has failed us; not because Europe is starvirg. We shall war again because we have failed in the simplicities.

# Beauty of Individual Life

It is not a matter of indifference whether we give attention to those trivial conditions of life the great and the near great regard as superfluous. It is a matter of greatest moment. We propose to greatest moment. shower Europe in the era of our thanksgiving with a portion of the abundance of our harvests. We do well to prove that Americans are humanitarians.

But until we renew our simple ways and give of that we shall not restore but the world will con-tinue to reap sorrow where it





Undoubtedly psychical research is the lustiest child Spiritualism has given birth to, and it is a pity it has so often tried to destroy its mother. Had there been no Mediumship there would have been neither a British College of Psychic Science nor an American Society for Psychical Research; just as there would have been no Spiritualist National Union nor a National Spiritualist Association. One would imagine that since they all of the same family, they would have been on better terms.

In this case, alas, charity did not start at home. Not that this has been the fault of Spiritualism. This offspring of Mediumship has certainly offered the hand of friendship to its brother; but has been so often ignored that there is little cause for wonder that it finally refrained from attempting to maintain good relationship, de-ciding to leave the unfriendly brother severely alone.

# No Science of Mind

Nothing is more clear than that, without the aid of mediums, psychical research could not have survived, and it might die if mediums altogether refuse to assist it. Whatever be said to the contrary, the question that has given real vitality and meaning to psy chical research has been that of survival of bodily death, and this is intimately associated with Spirit-control.

That is the all important matter n philosophy; and psychical research, whatever it may say regarding its scientific claims must. like psychology in general, belong to the arts.

There is a vast difference between science and the scientific me hod. That method has long That method has long been applied to the study of the human mind, but since there are no known laws of mind there can no science of the mind.

Up till now, all that has been discovered are rules; but since no two persons act alike, even under the same conditions, if there are mental laws they have yet to be discovered. This is an important fact too often overlooked

# The Chief Defect

Professor C. E. M. Joad, at the conclusion of a three-year course of philosophy in connection with London University, concluded by lamenting that notwithstanding all its magnificent weaving of ideas and systems of ideas, philosophy had done nothing really effective in discovering whether man survives death.

Largely because of this philosophy has fallen into some discredit. and today one can discern its best advoca es aspiring to settle this important question.

The fundamental difference between Spiritualism and psychical research is, that whereas the formhas accepted survival as an established fact, the latter in form. corporate excludes this aspect of the subject.

Plans Extensive Lecture Tour



There is a great deal to be said in favor of psychical research; but there is also much to be said against it.

Its chief defect is that, after more than sixty years, it is still passing the same water through the mill, and as a consequence bids fair to become nothing more important than a branch of normal psychology. There is actual danger of it passing entirely out There is actual of the higher metaphysical field into a purely planetary one.

Spiritualists, on the whole, would deplore this, for they see in psychical research, if more sympathetically conducted, an immense force for man's spiritual regeneration; but it must take a more impartial and logical standpoint.

# Cooperation Unlikely

The insistence of so many psychical researchers that any theory is better than the survival theory, is not only exasperating, but decidedly illogical.

Many of the phenomena of mediumship can be better explained by the Spiritualist hypothesis than by any of the assumptions so dear to the heart of those sticklebacks who prefer to swallow anything rather than a sound dose of spirit.

With this in mind, on September 30th, R. G. Pressing held conference with two members of the New York Section of the A. S. P. R., at their headquarters in New York City. The results were on the whole unsatisfactory.

Last summer, he visited Iceland at the invitation of the Spiritualists and Psychical Researchers of that country, being sponsored by the Icelandic Legation

and Foreign Minister. The six weeks, for which he was engaged, extended to In 1922-3, he followed in the footsteps of Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, the creator

of Sherlock Holmes, at the special request of the famous author. This took him to Australia, New Zealand and Tasmania. In 1919, he had the unusual honor of being invited to lecture before the students and faculty of the State Hospital, Copenhagen on, "The Power of the Mind over the Body in the Light of Psychic Science.

1928 saw him lecture on "Materializations" to an overflowing audience in 1928 saw him lecture on "Materializations" to an overflowing audience in the auditorium of Dartmouth College, New Hampshire. The lecture was illustrated by stereopticon views, among them being all that remain of the photographs taken by Sir William Crookes, F.R.S., of the materialized form known as "Katie King." In three views, the famous scientist is seen in his own home . . . standing arm-in-arm with the materialized form of Katie King. Mr. Leaf carries

this remarkable lecture with him on this visit.

The 1928 lecture led to a further invitation to visit the College, this time to lecture on Extra-sensory Perception and to conduct experiments in psychometry, Mr. Leaf acting as the demonstrator or subject, with positive results.
Mr. Leaf is highly recognized as a gifted psychometrist. In a

In addition he is an effective clairvoyant, and was selected a few years ago to give a special test seance before the English Society for Psychical Research in Glasgow, Scotland.

Previous to coming to the United States on the present visit, he received in-

vitations to lecture and demonstrate his mediumship in Greece. This visit being interrupted by the unsettled state of that country, and the death of the King of Greece, who was very much interested. In addition, calls came from South Greece, who was very much interested.

Mr. Leaf holds the distinction of being also a writer of repute, not only on Spiritualism, but also on travel. well as to benefit by his undoubted psychic powers.

Mr. Leaf has long been regarded as an outstanding psychic scientist, particularly on the subject of Mediumship and its Development, in fact he was a staff lecturer on that subject for the British College of Psychic Science. A few years ago the substance of those lectures were, at the request of the Principal of the college, published under the title, "The Psychology and Development of Medium-

Later he wrote the popular "first seller," "What Mediumship Is." doubtful if any book on this subject has made a more popular appeal all over the world. even if they are often insufficiently skeptical. Experience has shown clearly that a reasonably cred-ulous state of mind results in producing highly favorable results where the best and most valuable mediumistic phenomena are con-

Mr. Pressing urged this by suggesting that when conducting experiments, reasonable regard should be paid to the medium's personal equation; by which I mean, the methods by which he gets his best results. The history of psychical research has often proved this.

Take for example the case of Mlle. Eva C., the materializing medium with whom Baron Schrenck-Notzing conducted his most effective experiments. had been brought up in a Spiritualistic atmosphere, and when in them her powers were considereffective than when she ably more subjected herself to the stern condi ions prescribed by the Baron and his scientific friends. Such instances could be multiplied.

# Old Worn-out Methods

It was obvious during the conference that these psychical researchers were more interested in the test conditions prescribed for experiments in extra-sensory perception than in anything else.

Extra sensory perceptions have been explored for more than a quarter of a century, and the subject stands today very much where it stood during the first ten years. Its aim is not to find out whether

man has a spirit which survives the shock of death; but whether he has more special senses than the wellknown five.

It has been found that he has presumably three other such senses: telepathy, clairvoyance and psychometry. But none of these are experimented in a way which relates them to a supersensible world, but merely to this planet. If the super-sensible aspect of the subject has been dealt with, it has been in a subsidiary way.

Having discovered these senses, the questions arise whether they vestigial, i.e., dying ou'; or rudimentary. i.e., growing; and what type of persons or temperaments they are related to. Miss Dale believes that some serious headway has been made.

### Truth Known To Many

Mr. Pressing and I had to admit on leaving the conference, which had been carried on in a perfectfriendly spirit, that the possibility of a close association between Spiritualism and Psychical Research was much more remote than we had thought.

This must not be read as meaning that members of the Society for Psychical Research are ALL antagonistic to the Spiritualist hypothesis; but that its line of enquiry is for the moment practically useless to those of us who are anxious to convert the world to the fact that man is a spiritual being who survives death, and that life on earth should be made to comport with that important truth.

Mr. Pressing and I claim to be in the happy position of knowing that truth as far as any truth can be known. In this, we join an immense body of equally fortunate believers, most of whom have sufficient commonsense to judge, after a fair trial, whether their belief is justified or not.

As Editor of The Psychic Ob-server, Mr. Pressing, has en-deavored to render a real service to genuine mediumship, Spiritualism, and Psychic Research; and if the situation is not as favorable as we would like it to be, he still deserves our thanks.


