After attending hundreds of materialization seances, the wonder of it all is undimmed. Kings xix. 5-8; protected the three Hebrew children from fire, Dan. iii. An angel appeared to Joseph in a dream, Matt. i.; Moses and Elias appeared on the Mount, Luke ix.; an angel appeared to the two Marys at the sepulchre; to Zacharias, Luke i.; to Mary, Luke i.; to the shepherds, Luke ii.; to Mary Magdalene. John xx.; opened the prison doors, Acts v.; to Cornelius, Acts x.; to Peter in prison, Acts xii.

"Samuel appeared 'covered with a mantle.' I. Sam. xxviii. 14. A spirit ap-peared to Daniel 'clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold.'

Dan. x. Feeding the multitude of
5,000 on five loaves and two fishes. Luke ix. 12-17. Making wine at the marriage feast. St. John ii. 1-9. And, lastly, the several materializations of Christ after the crucifixion."

Probably scores of records exist even before Bible times where materializations took place, be-cause God's Law is a natural law, no beginning and no ending.

The particular seance, about am going to tell you, took place in a most significant and apropo environment.

Seance In Connecticut

Out from New York City, the medium, Rev. Bertie Lilly Candler and her husband, drove me in their motor car to Connecticut. Up a winding hill, to the very top, we finally stopped at the beautiful residence of Mrs. Sue Brewster. This old Colonial mansion was built in 1740 and has been in the Brewster family down through the years.

The wide fireplace in the im-

mense living room extends a hearty welcome to all who come to the Brewster home. I remarked: "The fireplace and its fire extend a hearty welcome"... because this is just the way I was impressed

General Conditions

One of the requirements of the seeker for truth is that he share with others the light that has been given to him. A horseshoe cir-

cle of chairs was arranged in the large living room. Diagonallyacross one corner of this room there had been stretched a plain black sateen curtain which formed a

cabinet in which the medium sat on a plain wooden chair. At the opposite end of this room there was the usual red lantern-type light used for materialization

Medium Searched

A couple of ladies accompanied Rev. Candler to the room above stairs where she disrobed com-pletely and donned a plain dress-ing gown which had NO pockets. She did NOT carry a purse into the cabinet with her.

I thoroughly examined the curtain, the corner of the room, the chair and the floor where the medium was to sit, before the seance began. I personally do not feel that such precautions are necessary in the case of a well established and authentic medium such as Candler, but for the benefit of the sitters and for those who

are to read the record of this seance, I deem it wise and imperative that I pass along facts as I see them.

When the final verse of the hymn we chose to sing had died away, the front of the black curtain moved a bit and out of the cabinet stepped Silver Leaf, a charming Indian girl of about sixteen years. A long braid hung down each side of her pretty dark face, her shoulders were covered with her beaded Indian jacket and a flowing white skirt billowed down from her belt.

"Unto the Heavens"

She rushed from the cabinet ith a delighted cry: "Well, with a delighted cry: "Well, friends, here I am! Hello, Aunt Julie, I am happy to see you away up here in the New England States. We are going to have a fine seance tonight. The conditions are good on this hill-top. It is sometimes difficult for all of us to build up fine vibrations. You know, always you are told—go to the hill-top and lift your eyes unto the heavens when you seek God. Well, here we are. I will do my very best."

Most of the people were friends of Silver Leaf, having met her at previous seances that had been held in this historic mansion. chorus of greetings were extended to her. The room was silent. Every one was expectant and eager to welcome any of their own loved ones who might come forth. A deep enchanting fragrance heavy perfume - not unlike tube roses-lotus or some perfume that belonged to the far East, was released in the room.

Message of Healing

Out from the cabinet appeared a beautifully clad White Sister. Her garments were exquisite. A large luminous crucifix hung about her As she came forward she gave a blessing to those present, "If you are ill or not feelsaving: ing up to par tonight, please come forward and I will give to you the healing rays. It is a part of my duty to visit the earth time to time and minister unto God's children who come to the fount of love and truth.

"It is with great pleasure that I greet you as children and it is with joy in my heart that I gaze upon your beautiful auras that are co-ordinated in the loving quest for more of God's knowl-

edge.
"Before departing, I again bless each of you present and leave you with the promise that the teachings of the Master Jesus are true and that His promise—that He will send a Comforter—is true.

The Mediumship of Edward Mackey

It had become apparent to me in my observations at *Psychists*, *Inc.*. (*) that the immortality of his survival after death, as demonstrated by mediumship, had far reaching implications.

There followed more than a year of investigation at that center of psychic interest. He said his name was Emil and that he was a Himalyan teacher. He expressed deep gratitude for this meeting of earth children because such a vibration as is developed in a meeting where loving hearts reach out to the high spheres, creates a mighty force and contact point for those on the unseen side to send help and to answer prayers from the human family.
In his discourse he said: "All

children of the Light, ever remember that God is One. Regardless. of race, creed or color, this great power, this life force animates all upon the physical plane of life and extends into the highest of the most high realms. Remember the promises of God are true, and in his own ineffable glory, he is shining out to all whose hearts and minds are open to receive his glories.

"The people who are striving to follow Him are now undergoing a sort of crucifixion. The strong vibrations of selfishness, hate and envy, now rampant in the world, are thorns that pierce to the very heart of those who are sensitives susceptible to vibratory thoughts that have been projected into the ether.

"If faith can be kept in His love, and if the seekers of truth can remain steadfast and strong in their knowledge of truth, a great blessing and spiritual power will be given unto them.



It was rather interesting to note that in each instance the spirit who was coming to a loved one would walk directly toward that person with outstretched arms and call name. Mr. Kimmie, who attended the cabinet, stood along side, but apparently the spirit had great strength and realized that all present were there in the interest of truth, were not skeptical and would not in any way interfere with the phenomena.

For this reason, Mr. Kimmie stood aside and allowed the spirits to handle their own identifica-

tion by going directly to the person they desired to contact.

There was extraordinary evidence of intelligence on the part of all spirit communicators. instance, a Mother came out to greet her son. In the intimate conversation that took place between them, she recalled to his mind the fact that he had spilled coffee all over the table the other morning and that she was there to see it. urthermore, she said she noticed his consternation over spoiling the table cloth.

The son laughed and told his mother that this was quite true.

They Call Them "Angels"

Another instance, a spirit Mother told her daughter that she had attempted to relieve the severe pain in her sore foot which hurt her when touching the covers. The daughter thanked her mother and said she certainly had had a sore foot but it was some better now.

A spirit father came to his daughter and apparently caused her to have great joy. It was the first time he had ever manifested in a materialization seance though she had attended others. He remarked that he was near her very great deal and told that it was


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Later the daughter related that the crystal from her watch mysterdisappeared, though she knew it was not broken.

A hush fell on the room, as though something was about to happen. The curtains parted and seemed to be held back by arms outstretched . . . causing the robes to create the appearance of wings. When attending a materialization seance, one well understands why certain writers frequently refer to the spirit people as angels with wings, because as they hold these robes outstretched they certainly do look like great white, ethereal wings.

The little girl, of about twenty, dropped to her knees as Jean Harlow danced about the room billowing as she pioretted about. Jean covered the little girl momentarily with her ectoplasmic robes which appeared to be diaphanous and made of chiffon.

At a later interview, I asked the young Aberdeen girl if she knew Jean Harlow in earth life or just how she happened to come to her.

She told me that since a child of seven she had been able to see spirits and had been aware of etheric presences. Several years ago, Jean Harlow appeared to her and, at a later date, came to her another materialization seance of Mrs. Candler's and offered to guide and help her with dramatic development.

True Value of Prayer

Prior to this suggestion of Jean Harlow's, it had not occurred to her to attend a dramatic school. The very thought and suggestion seemed to awaken a keen interest within her so she went into New York City and attended the Harrison-Lewis Dramatic School last winter and is now working in his Experimental Theatre.

Jean Harlow was interested in psychic subjects while she lived upon earth and naturally, as a spirit, she is very happy to help any person interested in the theatre

A spirit retains its earth interest. That which is possessed to any degree of development, that which is worthwhile is carried over and extended after they go through transition.

And then the evidence. mentioned the flowers and spoke particularly of the one large spray of yellow blossoms, tied with the blue and yellow ribbons that were placed on her casket.

This was true. I had particularly selected this arrangement of flowers and ribbon because I knew of Carol's fondness for blue and yellow. I also knew of her appreciation of artistic floral arrangements. Carol spoke of her husband, "Mitch," and whispered to me a complete explanation of the physical manifestation which had so bewildered all of us in the office.

Must Tell the Truth

Now, there had been nothing in PSYCHIC OBSERVER about the passing of Carol Schutt at this time. Bertie Lilly Candler, the medium, was unacquainted with her. The fact that she explained, in detail, this unique phenomena, was for me, one of the finest proofs of the continuation of physical consciousness after death that I recall ever having had.

This was an evening of surprises. A stately, tall man emerged from the cabinet. He was dressed in ministerial garb, wore a surplice about his neck and said that he was an Episcopal minister. His conversation follows:

"I am Rev. John Colburn. I was head of the Worcester School at Danbury, Connecticut. Whilst I was in the earth body I knew the truth that is taught and demonstrated by the Spiritualists. For many reasons, I did not teach this truth, the true religion of spirit, to my people.

Both Natacha and her mother, Mrs. Hudnut were devoted students of the Occult. Strangely enough between Rudy and Mrs. Hudnut an unusually deep bonds of affection grew up. It was through her and Natacha that he first became acquainted with Spiritualism.

Rudy Deeply Interested

Adela Rogers St. Johns, writing in the October 5th, 1929 issue of "Liberty Magazine," speaks of Rudy's interest in Spiritualism. She says:

"That was the first time he told me how deeply interested he had become in Spiritualism. He had come, through Natacha, to believe absolutely in guidance from those who had gone before."

Early in their psychic develop-ment, both Rudy and Natacha acquired Indian guides in the Spirit World. Rudy's guide was Black

On the title page of his book, "Day Dreams," (MacFadden Publications, Inc., 1923), there is a black feather drawn in ink. At Rudy's request this feather appears before anything else in the book. Looking at it today you realize how deeply he desired to honor Black Feather as the inspired guide of his writings. Underneath this token of his appreciation are these words:

Lives forever in the glass of today
Wherein we see the reflection of it

Both Believed In Reincarnation

To them, reincarnation was an inspiring symbol. It was an ideal close to their hearts. They felt that a love like theirs lives through the ages. They firmly be-lieved they had known and loved each other before.

With intimate friends, Rudy loved to discuss the deeper mean-

ings of life. In one of his books

but you were the shaft that held the wagon of Life. Your strength held together the vehicle until God called and the Soul answered.

Rudy Was a Medium

After Rudy passed into The Great Beyond, Natacha published a book on his life, entitled, "Rudolph Valentino," (Jacobson-Hodgkinson Corp., N. Y. 1927). In the foreword she says:

"Of one side of his life you have heard but little—the side which had to do with psychic things. Few people knew that Rudy was himself a medium and clairvoyant and had many wonderful experiences on the 'borderland'."

Surprising Events

Rudy was intensely interested in all forms of the Occult. He delved into everything. He had several phases of psychic power superbly developed. Very often he felt and actually saw the spirits of souls who had long since departed this In time, however, automatic writing became his chief interest. Before making any move he always consulted this power first.

Surprising events, things which often astonished others, passed unnoticed by Rudy. Through their Guides in Spiritland, he and Natacha, knew weeks in advance how things would develop. Sometimes it was Rudy, who would foretell just how things would work out. Again Natacha would reveal the course that should be followed.

Once with unerring accuracy Natacha predicted the exact date when *Rudy* would return to work. Their Indian Guides always directed every important detail of their business affairs. Friends of the Valentinos at the height of their career were astounded at the uncanny insight of their Guides. It was superb!

Once in a New York bank, Rudy refused to accept \$7,500 a week and return to work unless certain other conditions in his contract were promptly met. His manager was horrified.

"As I Knew Him"



Through eyes of deep devotion they viewed the wonders of past ages, guided each day by that unseen force in which they both so firmly believed. Guardian Angels were always close to Rudy and Natacha. In them they both held unlimited faith.

On moonlight nights they loved to linger in the Palace Gardens of the Alhambra. In the entrancing charm of that loveliest work of all Moslem art, Rudy's keenly developed psychic senses enabled him

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In Italy, his boyhood home, Rudy was deeply moved by the influence of his Guardian Angels. In that land he spent many gazing out over the endless blue of the Mediterranean. He seemed to live again in the life of centuries long past.

"Tried as he was, Rudy took his pencil and paper to talk to his mother, whose welcoming presence he had felt for some time. Many were the messages of love comfort that flew across those pages between this mother and her son. Such true adoration the veil does not lessen or divide - and Rudy was comforted."

Rudy Saw Phantom Figures

Rudy and Natacha loved ancient castles. Beneath the great towers of masonry Rudy many times distinctly saw and heard in the glorious colors of astral light phantom figures moving about in the costumes of centuries ago.

Secret passageways, staircases and underground dun-geons fascinated Rudy. Deeply psychic he sensed and often described the terrible agonies of those imprisoned there.

In Natacha's book, Mrs. Hudnut described Rudy and Natacha's first visit to lovely old Chaumont. She says:

"This castle, with its moat and drawbridge, while not one of the largest, we found to be one of the most interesting, as it is still in its original state. The room of Catherine de Medici and Ruggieri her astrologer-medium are furnished and arranged exactly as they were when occupied by them."

"These apartments of the Queen Mother especially fascinated Rudy and Natacha because of their interest in psychic matters. We were all thrilled to stand in the bedroom of Ruggieri, the very room in which, one day, history tells us, he gave a seance to the Queen, during which she saw the departed Kings of France."

Rudy had one of his most startling psychic experiences at the ancient ruins of Locke. Wandering alone through the ground floor rooms he entered one where great iron rings, hooks and broken chains hung from the walls. For a moment even his deeply psychic nature was stunned!

Directly before him, held up on the wall, he saw the ghastly bones of a human skeleton! Around its neck there was a heavy chain. Its bony toes barely touched the floor. Suddenly it vanished! And only the heavy chain was left hanging on the wall.

Monday morning, August 23rd, as the first rays of the morning sun appeared over New York Rudy slipped away into The Next World.

At the end, though he was ghastly weak and deathly pale, he did manage to say to his friend and manager, George Ullman, "Don't pull down the shades. I feel fine." Then, quietly turning his head, his spirit passed into *The Great Be-*

World Was Deeply Shocked

When news of his death reached the newspapers people in all walks of life were stunned! RudolphValentino dead!

In New York immense crowds gathered in the streets for blocks around the establishment where his body lay. Thousands stormed the doors hoping to gain entrance. Plate glass windows were smashed. reinforcements failed to hold the surging mob.

Mounted police were at last forced to ride head on into the crowd. Angry members quickly rubbed quantities of soap on the pavements. Horses slipped fell, bones, skulls and a sticks cracked on all sides. and night-York had never experienced such a disorder since the draft riots of Lincoln's time.

On August 30th, when the funeral took place in Actor's Chapel on West 49th Street in New York only five hundred were allowed to Outside, in front of the chapel, grief stricken mourners flung themselves onto the pave-ment in reckless abandon.

All over the world there were remarkable instances whelming grief during the actual hour of Rudy's funeral.

In Hollywood when Rudy reached his final resting place, airplanes were circling above the mausoleum dropping wreaths of flowers. From one of these planes a close friend of Rudy's dropped a beautiful pillow of roses, so close to the casket, it seemed as if the angels had place it there.

Rudy's Passing Not Unexpected

Describing events which took place three days before Rudy's death, his mother-in-law, Mrs. Hudnut says in Natacha's book:

"That evening we were impressed to have a sitting Meseolpe the Egyptian Brother, from whom Rudy and I together had so often received lessons in the past, now took control. He talked to me for a long while, gently and with much compassion. speaking as I had never heard him speak before, of personal things, of Rudy's life, his character and his career.

"He made me realize the serious-

ness and purpose of this earth-life, this schoolroom to which we are sent back again and again, until all the lessons necessary for this stage of our development are

"Meselope explained to us that Rudy's present term in this earthschoolroom was completed and that within the next few days he would pass to another plane of consciousness of this ever-continu-

ing life.
"Monday morning I awoke to find the atmosphere of my room heavy with the perfume of tube-roses—and then I knew that Rudy had passed on."

Rudy Contacts Natacha

Immedately following Rudy's passing on Natacha Rambova re ported herself to be in touch with him On the Other Side of Life. His first messages to her were most pathetic. Later, as he learned to adjust himself, they began to show that he was finding real happiness once more.

Little by little, Over There, he contacted others who had passed on from the entertainment world of this earth. Among them were Henry Irving, Sarah Bernhardt, Wallace Reid and his own dear friend, little Olive Thomas, whose suicide in London had been such a recent tragedy.

O. O. McIntyre's Last Meeting

Our late O. O. McIntyre of the Hearst newspapers was one of Valentinos closest friends. When Mc-Intyre last saw him it was spring-time in Paris. Describing that occasion he says:

"I last saw Valentino a few months before he died. He called on me at the apartment in which I was living on Avenue Henri Martin. Gray dusk was sifting through the delightful pink of Paris twilight. We went for a walk out beyond the Trocadero and sat on a bench. In the distance Eiffel Tower was scissoring its network of starry squares against the plush of night.
"We talked of many things. I do

not recall them now but I do remember walking on later to the Arc de Triomphe where I bade him good-bye and saw him swing down the brilliantly-lighted Champs Elysees, his head held

high.
"And it has pleased me that Valentino justified my faith in him in that adventure called death just as he had in the adventure of life. Not once did he falter."

This device, properly used, may even surpass the already widely used "micro-phone-method" previously used with great success in churches throughout England and the U.S.A. for recording direct-voice seances. Its use relieves the operator of record change, enabling definite continuity without interruption or loss of words.



Y. She was long an associate with Sarah ("Aunt Sadíe") Hubell McIntyre in the Harmony Center at Freeville and an active officer in both organizations for many years.

When Mrs. Myers was twelve, the remarkable mediumship demonstrated throughout her life, developed and it was only a few years before that her father visited the Fox Cottage at Hydesville, N. Y.

After returning home, he formed a message circle even before Eliza was born. Any serious investigator was welcome and it is only natural that, with such earnestness of purpose,

excellent results were obtained. These classes continued, twice weekly, until his passing in 1898.

About the same time the child Eliza developed mediumship, Central New York was startled with one of the first demonstrations of materialization by a Mary Andrews of Moravia, N. Y.
