

Lawyers, the Best

Many people are of the opinion that in the professional field, lawyers with their natural traits to sift out the evidence and deal only with fact make them the best investigators of Psychic Science.

This must be a matter of opinion but the opinion is based upon a vast amount of observation and contemplation of that which has already been confirmed through the channel that I have chosen to believe is supremely reliable.

The channel is the Rev. Richard Zenor of Los Angeles, and the authority I have indirectly quoted is the spirit teacher who speaks through his deep trance mediumship.

The teacher, Agasha (whose

name is used to distinguish Rev. Zenor's center, known as the Agasha Temple of Wisdom), twice weekly delivers hourlong lectures while the "instrument" (Mr. Zenor) is in the entranced state. These lectures are wonders of lucidity and information about almost every subject under the sun — profound, absorbing, amazingly informative (especially about the afterlife and the origin and development of all life) and practical.

What Agasha says about the

avatar myth is essentially this;

There is a "Golden Age" coming. Its beginning is fixed around the year 1965. But its foundations are being laid right now, even in the midst of the multiplying confusions and disasters already upon us and those yet to come.

Like a boil that is about to break; like a fever that is reaching its peak; like the deepest darkness before a golden dawn — like all the volcanic forces of man and nature that are bursting forth in a mighty, climatic eruption—the way is being drastically cleared for the new age.

Now is the period of what Agasha calls the "process of elimination." Both natural forces of the earth—earthquakes, floods, fires, tornadoes, eruptions of all types — and manmade catastrophes will seem bent upon destroying the earth.

Bound to Come

For it is the end of a 7000year cycle when many great and devastating changes are bound to occur. As the tidal wave of cyclic change and man's struggles are accelerated, religion becomes more scientific and science becomes more religious, and man himself cries out for an understanding of it all.

That understanding is bound to come, says Agasha, for as men seek the basic answers, in the midst of their distress or in the light of renewed inspiration, they will be given those answers in order to prepare them for the Golden Age.

this was from my deceased mother, but again there was no recognizable attempt at identity. I began to wonder. Would it be expected of my father or my mother that some evidence of identity be forthcoming? Would it not be natural for them to expect their own son to "recognize" them? Possibly our loved ones took this for granted-just as they know and recognize us.

It was several years later that I received what seems to have been a bona fide message, through a mediumistic friend, a non-commercial medium. The two messages above referred to were received directly-no medium was present. This purported to come from my bishop, the late Rt. Rev. James E. Freeman, D. D. of Washington, D.C. Here it is: "Tom, do not be so 'scientific' about religious matters. Don't be a 'Doubting Thomas,' Be a 'Loving John.'"

I interpret this as a suggestion that we ought to realize that the approach to God, to Absolute Reality—the whole religious appreach, is not primarily an intelligent approach. That is to say, as Donne expressed it many years ago, "The Heart has reasons which the Reason may not know."

Jesus put it this way, "Become as little children." I think that this has never been sufficiently cleared up by the theologians. But this is not the place for a discussion of such a subtle proposition.

At my first sitting at a regular seance, with professional mediums, my father materialized-a tall, impressive figure. I said to him, "You were my

He replied, "I am still your Kindly Light."

Then my maternal grandfather came through: I saw him-was not two feet from his tall form. To him I said, "You are my grandfather, are you not?"

His answer: "Yes: I am the minister who led you into the Ministry." He was a Presbyterian of the old school in Virginia. Stepping close up to me, vigorously-then my left shoul-

I felt the power of his hands and remarked, "You have great power there."

He replied, "I could shake you up considerably."

Jokingly, I replied, "Then, I guess I would become a Shaker. He was gone,

At this seance an elder-sister appeared. I asked, "Are you conscious of your brothers and sisters on the earth? Do you know what we are doing?

"Yes," she returned-"I am still interested in the members of my own family."

We sing together

When my mother appeared, I stood, at times, with my face not more than ten inches from her beautiful countenance.

I asked, "Are you conscious of having come a long way to get here?"

She said, "No, I am always 'here."

"Do you still sing?" I asked-"Are you still interested in music?" She had been a soprano soloist many years ago, and an accomplished pianist.

She replied, "Yes. I will sing for you tonight."

That evening she returned, in spirit form. I did not see her at first. The cabinet guide, or master of ceremonies, spoke up, "Dr. Opie, your mother is here. She wants you to give her the key to any song you wish her

Not being myself a musician, I was on the spot, as it were. I said that I could not give the

"All right," came the reply, "she says for you to name any song you wish her to sing."

My mother then appeared in physical form, built up from the ectoplasmic substance of the entranced medium and sang one verse of this famous hymn. All present heard the music. She was actually accompanied by the violin. I tried to find out who the violinist was, but the

ist was a former teacher of violin-at the girls' school in Virginia, where my mother had been a distinguished pupil in the music department, some fifty years prior to this teacher's time. The teacher, also an old friend of mine, was a Canadian. She had passed over, several years previous.

At still another seance, while I and another person from the audience were holding high the hands of the medium, on the public platform before a large audience, my mother spoke thus to me, "Tom, I am giving you a purple cross (apport). I have cut away the 'figure'-since I feel that you, with me, regard the cross as a symbol of life and not a symbol of death."

I have this cross and treasure it, a beautifully proportioned little plain cross.

Through "precipitation," which seems to be a rather new departure in phenomena, I received this greeting from my mother, at the Chesterfield Spiritualist Camp ir Indiana: "Tom, we from the angel side of life are proud of you. We too enjoy many indescribable bless_ ings and do share many of our joys with you. Mother Ida."

This message was received in broad daylight, no cabinet, no trance-no possible chance for trickery. I myself held in my hands about a dozen plain white cards, 5 x 3 inches. I examined them for possible tampering, or secret "chemical process' which might afford opportunity for subterfuge. There was not a chance for anything under-

Independent Writing

The cards were in a small pack, with several lead pencils which the medium supplied, all wrapped by a small rubber band.

The medium asked me personally to hold the packet. She placed them on my left shoulder, with my right hand holding them down. Said she, "You should hear a slight sound, as if a pencil were scraping paper. Do you hear anything?"

I did hear a slight but distinguishable sound. In a few moments, she had me remove the cards and open and inspect them. Six of them contained writing and those receiving them were satisfied that they had had messages from loved ones in the spirit world. So was I.

the world of the departed. He wrote: "Greetings, Thomas. You have mastered many problems and will leave marks in the sands of time, Bishop Freeman,"

This was written in bold brown pencilling, while the card from my mother was in a more delicate hand, in purple, I regard them both as bona fide spirit-messages, anybody to the contrary.

I can think of nothing on our earth-level quite to parallel this demonstration. The cards were at no time (while the writing, or precipitation process was going on) separated. How they could have been "handled" or inscribed while tightly bound together baffles me, as there must have been "another dimension" figuring in the proced-

"Guardian Angel"

No human being knows any process by which the cards could have been humanly pencilled while in close and uninterrupted contact each with the other-and I repeat, there was absolutely no previous, during, nor post-tampering with

All my life I have heard about guardian angels. It was only lately that I had occasion to think objectively of these heavenly characters. On two occasions, two of my own spirit Guides or Masters as they are termed in Spiritualist parlance, appeared before me in materialization seances, and addressed me impressively, affectionately -as really as I have ever been addressed in the flesh.

Later on, I spoke to a wellknown medium and mentioned the fact that I did not have the slightest-idea who this was, who was thus miraculously favoring me by a celestial visitationsince there was no attempt at identification on the part of the visitor.

The medium told me that this was my "Guide"-and added, "We all have them-Guardian Angels, you know." Then I knew. This was as real as a visit from home.

At the first seance, where I was a guest, not expecting the slightest participation in what was to come-except as an objective psychic observer, I was flabbergasted when my name, "Thomas," was called. I was new at this-and even at that, I did not have any idea that I myself was intended!

I sat-until the cabinet attendant came to my seat, took me gently by the hand and led me to the prayer-rug, in front of the medium's cabinet. The medium was in complete trance and knew nothing of all this, as I saw and talked to her after the sitting.

I knelt before him

Kneeling, I immediately sensed a Presence. A Voice spoke to me, "The words, 'Suffer little children to come unto me,' were not vain words. You are a child of God. I am your Brother, I place upon your shoulder (putting his hand firmly, unmistakably, sensibly on my shoulder) a Crescentan Anchor, signifying that you are anchored in Light, in Truth, in Love (which is God)-and in Charity. I have long walked with you. I shall walk with you through eternity.'

There he was-a majestic figure, whom all in attendance heard distinctly-speaking as naturally, as unemotionally and as impressively, as did any human figure, in all my life. It was Benediction-extraordinary. I had never before encountered anything like it.

There was no slight chance that this could be "faked." I myself had examined every corner of the seance-room-the walls, the doors, the floors, windows, drapes, wires, furniture and fixtures, all. The whole experience was Honest-to-God. This I say as a reporter of many years' standing-one whose capacity (or integrity if you please) for factual reporting has never been questioned.

Eleven pointed star

One other "Master" favored me at a private seance later on, with the same medium entranced. He stood before me in "physical" form and placed his hand upon my head-just as certainly as did my distinguished Bishop-in - the - Church-of -God many years before at confirmation and at ordination.

These are his exact words. verbatim, so help me God: "I stand before you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost. Amen."

We bow our heads (pushing my head down slightly) not in humility (I had always insisted that my "humility" was in my heart and not in neck and shoulders!-a fact which appears to have been known to this visitant) but in reverence, before the God of Truth, of Mercy and of Love.

"I place upon your shoulder (placing his hand upon my left shoulder, as if inducting me into some Order) the Eleven-Pointed STAR. You have not only proven yourself a Brother to men who walk the earth, but a Brother to the Celestials. Many Masters walk the earth today-and in spite of opposition, they are unafraid. We go forward to Peace and to Love one for another."

That was all. It was terrific. It was staggering. It was factual. Another medium, later on, when I was speaking of this episode, volunteered this: "The 'Eleven-Pointed Star' is the highest award They have been known to present." Be that as it may-here was Something grandly real-superbly impressive-deeply, profoundly moving and sacred to me.

The Will to Compare

It is human to express opinions, it is human to take exception, it is human to be biased, it is human to find fault, it is human to pick things to pieces, it is human to be intolerant and it is human to have favorites. All these trats, singly or in toto, applied to mediums and mediumship, is sometimes classified as constructive criticism. Even so, these traits can be justly classified as such only when expressed without a hammer.

I have said before and I will say again, mediumship in all its phases, is the most dumbfounding, the most startling, the most unique, the most baffling and yet quite simple, because the simplest explanations are usually the least nerve-wracking. There is one point, however, never compare mediumship, one medium with another, by saying: "Well, it happened so and so through one medium, why not the same through another; or if one medium can read ballots so and so, why not the other; or my mother spoke or manifested thus and so through one so why not the same way through the other?"

No two mediums are alike, consequently the manifestations received through two different mediums will differ. When you hear that so and so is the best medium in the world, the chances are that person has not met or sat with one tenth of one percent of all the mediums in the world.

What these people mean is that so and so is the best medium for them and there is nothing wrong with that. We all have our favorites.

What we must not do is to compare one with the other and come to the conclusion that, just because manifestations differ, that the medium, not the favorite, is inferior.

By all means, be tolerant even if someone condemns your own favorite medium, knowing that they, too, may not have the understanding you should hav toward others who bicker and snipe-usually over trivialities, in most instances, have nothing to do with mediumship itself.

Always bear in mind that there are no authorities on mediumship. True, there are those who have had a little more experience, but thos who have been mellowed by this experience have, over a period of years, reorientated their thinking a thousand times so that new facts will dovetail into their pattern of knowledge to the end that out of it all they ultimately reach an inner conviction that this thing called survival is proven and will continue to be proven to those whose vision is not blinded by animosity, jealousy and a mass of preconceived ideas.

Then there are the White Brotherhoods of spirit, the myriad organized groups which are making headway against the demoniac black forces now seeking the upper hand in the misdirection of the world.

Finally, there are the many teachers and followers, not confined to any specially chosen group or sect but representative and active in any number of them, who are working toward the same end-universal understanding.

All are included in the general classification Agasha names as the GREAT WHITE WAY. This Great White Way produces a very real vibrational force, an electric-like field that must eventually dispel the darkness engendered by ages of contamination and replace it with the light of wisdom.

The Etheric Spheres

In this process, many now living will have an essential part. The contaminations of the past - literal polution of the earth's etheric atmosphere. caused by the degraded thoughts and activities over many centuries-will give way before the "beacons of light."

And this must be understood as a physical, as well as a metaphorical, term in reference to the etheric spheres around us, so as to understand how the spiritual light overcomes the vibrational friction and static now enveloping the world.

Every debasing thought, every mean action sets up a disruptive etheric field of its own, and when these are combined, recombined, multiplied and intermingled in the earth's psychic atmosphere over thousands of years, only such an explosion as the earth now faces can clear it all away.

So says Agasha.

The encouraging part of the otherwise dismal picture is that many, many men are also sloughing off the frictionized corrosions of past errors which have encased them in their own psychic atmospheres and a ray of light is entering.

The process is being stimu-· lated in a vast way by the organized White Forces, and as the time of the Latter Days runs out, people will become more and more aware that they are in a true Psychic Age.

Many Avatars

The Psychic of Occult Age is already upon us, according to Agasha, and men are seeking. Their seeking automatically opens a door and attracts to them that which they seek,namely, enlightenment. The spiritual forces, both in and out of the flesh, will not fail to re-

Hence, every man in his own right and in his own way, no matter how limited, may become an avatar, a center of light to end the great gloom.

So it is that there will be many avatars. There will be many leaders. The teachers and particularly the very young will begin to demonstrate great understanding, and while the Golden Age will be a spiritual age, it will also be an age of incredible scientific and mechanical advancement.

Society will be reorganized.

There will be a world state, a universal language and a universal "scientific religion." And all will be practical, workable, feasible, with emphasis upon man's inherent right and need to develop individually: There will be as little interference as possible with his right to grow through experience.

Freedom, says Agasha, is no mere man-made ideal designed by men for their own convenience. It is essential to the spiritual evolution of man, for it is in the order of things that he should understand his place in life. That understanding is limited by unhealthy restrictions.

The displine is best when it is self-discipline, and men in time will learn that it is for their best interests in their own learning to discipline themselves. Meanwhile, guidance, rather than tyranny, must rule the day.

All Are Channels

Thus it is that the Second Advent of Christ will be no mere personal thing, no arrival of a spiritual dictator to separate the sheep from the goats, but a real advent of the Christ Consciousness, a great realization of pattern and plan in the individual, as well as the universal, consciousness.

All those who seek and all who-attain this state, then, are the avatars of the New Age. And the Second Coming takes on a universal, rather than a limited, earthly, meaning.

To the class students of Richard Zenor, studying the portents, meaning and responsibilities of the New Age, Agasha has had this to say:

"We are all channels of the earth. We are all beacons of light - we who recognize the light-and we are serving in our own humble way.

"We become true channels for those whom we contact, and because of the power we bring, they feel that invigorating power flowing through their veins.

"This is the occult age when many millions will turn in this direction for their learning, their salvation and their direction, and we must be prepared to help them, so that in the

Dark Days to follow they will not become disturbed, confused-

The time approaches when enslaved people, suppressed beyond endurance, will produce an explosion "like a great xbomb," he told-one of the Zenor classes, and that is when the White Forces, striving to break through the black cloud of evil which surrounds them, will be able to reach and arouse their souls. Thus will the enemies of freedom produce a revolution they never planned.

Meanwhile, the great awakening throughout the world, practical and sensible in all its manifestations, is likewise at hand. The psychic consciousness is being stimulated, and the world of spirit is winning recognition.

All who are a part of it are deserving of credit, for they have earned the right to show the way by the cleansing of their own psychic atmospheres.

They are the avatars, and their combined force is the GREAT AVATAR.

So says Agasha.

What They Teach?

EARLYNE CHANEY

"There are Teachers in every field of human endeavor. There are those whose chief concern is Religion. Others are interested in the various arts, culture, progression, the seed of aspiration in everything, the goal of attainment in all things.

"But the greatest work of the Master is his interest in his Disciples, and the training of those Disciples to be his assistants in establishing the Divine Hierarchy on earth. Many of us here in the world of spirit are Disciples also of these Great Teachers.

"It was because of our spiritual tie with some of them that a few of us were invited, several years ago, to a meeting which was of considerable import to us and to the establishment of Astara. But before giving you the details of this meeting, I wish to touch on the lives of the leading Disciples, Robert and Earlyne.

Grave Decision

"The early preparation in Robert's life, from the time when he was a youngster, was brought about in part by his parents (ardent Spiritualists), in part by the spirit that existed with his physical vehicle, and in part by those of us who came to him as Guides and Teachers from this side of life.

"One of these influences was Rama. You may remember that Rama has already told you some details of his life; of the fact that he still lives in his physical body in the heart of the Gobi Desert, a location almost inaccessible to man of earth.

"You may remember that Rama also told you that he travels to Astara oftentimes in his astral vehicle in order that he might manifest to you, teach you, counsel with you, through his entranced medium, Robert.

Shortly after Robert became enthused about Spiritualism, he received a message from this side of life, through Rev. John W. Bunker, on one of his visits to Camp Chesterfield. That message came from me, and the message informed him that if he would devote time and effort to it, he had the potentialities of becoming an outstanding me-

"After receiving this message, he was faced with the grave decision of whether or not to continue with his chosen career, or to give it up and turn to spiritual unfoldment. It was while he struggled with this decision that the Master Rama appeared to him in a vision.

They Were Married

"The details of this experience cannot be given here. Suffice to say, after that contact, he turned wholeheartedly toward the spiritual life. He was associated, through the years, with several religious organizations. He was one of the principal founders of one of these organizations. He was directed into many endeavors through which he received invaluable training which is now being used in Astara.

"The Master Rama was not known to Robert by name in all these earlier years of service. He has made known his name only comparatively recently.

"The Disciple Earlyne contacted the Master Kut Hu-Mi in her early childhood. She saw and talked with him many years before ever hearing of Spiritualism, Theosophy, or any of the modern spiritual movements. She entered the acting profession and was keenly aware of

spiritual help in her career on the stage and in the motion pictures.

"Earlyne attached no particular religious significance to this spiritual contact until she met with an experience with death, which took from her the soldier she planned to wed. This experience left such a mark upon her that she turned completely away from her career as an actress and embarked upon

her search into Spiritualism and the Occult.

"It was not until then that she learned the connection between her Master and the Master Kut-Hu-Mi who helped establish Theosophy.

"It was in the fall of 1947 that the two Disciples joined forces through their marriage. They continued their spiritual work with the organization which Robert had helped establish until the year 1951. In January of that year, they resigned the offices they held in that organization, and found themselves with another grave decision to make. Several different paths had opened before them, and they well knew the path they chose would determine how they would spend the rest of their earth lives.

100 Years Ago

"But their decision was to be greatly influenced by those of us from this side of life, even as has every decision in their lives since their birth. For Astara was born on the Astral many years ago and these two were chosen as its earth leaders even before they were born. Every major event in their lives was brought about by influence from us, with the plan of Astara in mind. They were easily led into these decisions, for even before taking on their physical bodies in this present incarnation they were well schooled in the outline of their lives and their connection with Astara.

"I, myself, did not become a part of the plan until after my own transition not so many years ago when, after extensive training, I was allowed to become the principal guide in the Band of spirit workers around the Disciple Robert.

"Astara was established on the Astral well over a hundred years ago. It was known among the Masters in charge of certain new-age religious movements that, for a given time, it was well to have a division among the movements being established on earth. It was also known at what period it would be wise to merge these schools of thought together under one banner. This was to be Astara.

Spiritual Training

"It was planned just what year the two Disciples, Robert and Earlyne, would take new physical bodies. It would not be wise to disclose who these two Disciples were in other lives; this fact is not important. Suf-

fice to say they underwent vigorous spiritual training for their present incarnation, and the work they are to do in Astara.

As I say, I entered the plan not long after my transition from the earth life to the spirit life. I had become a colleague, of the spirit Doctor Teacher who acts as the principal control to the Disciple Earlyne, who is known as Mark Darnell.

"It was just after the marriage of the two Disciples that the Master Rama contacted both Dr. Darnell and myself and invited us to attend this meeting to which I referred before. We were taken for the first time to Astral Astara. The meeting was held in a garden there . . . a garden which defies description. In fact, any effort to describe Astral Astara would fall far short of its true glory. We shall attempt to do so in some future

Ancient Philosophers

were seven which led down into the garden, which is oblong as is this Chapel in which we now find ourselves. The magnificence of the flowers and foliage we found there could only be surpassed by one thing, and that was the presence of the Great Ones we found assembled there. We had never been before in the personal presence of so many, and their majestic radiance left us speechless and awed.

"The Lord Maitreya was there, the Masters Morya, St. Germain, Hilarion, Kut-Hu-Mi, Rama . . . and there among them was the Master Jesus the Christ. The light about this Beleved One was so great He seemed to have spread over His entire aura some sort of a screen in order that we might behold Him without being blinded and overcome. The same was true of the Lord Maitreya.

"Many other Master Teachers were there, and many Doctor Teachers as well. Philosophers of ancient days were there . . . Pythagoras, Plato, Paracelsus, so many of them. Some of your own Doctor Teachers and Masters were there. The Master Rama seemed to be in charge of the meeting. He it was who stood on the raised dais and spoke to all of us.

As If Suspended

"The other Great Ones seated themselves on each side of the dais, except the Master Jesus and the Lord Maitreya. They stood behind and above Rama. They must have been standing upon something, nevertheless it seemed to us as if they were suspended in space.

"Even though Rama did the speaking to us, we were aware of his connection between these two Great Souls. There was a constant interplay of thought between the three of them. We were able to catch only parts

of these waves of mind-power, but we knew when Rama spoke, he was relating, many times, thoughts coming from one of these Leaders,

"He spoke to us of several religious organizations now existing on earth, and other nonsectarian groups. He described their purpose. Then he told us about the plan to establish Astara on the earth plane. He told us of the Mystery Schools of old, and how Astara was to be a new Mystery School. He explained that he and Kut-Hu-Mi would be the guiding influences over this New School, but that they in turn would be guided by their own Teacher, Jesus.

"Dr. Darnell and I were called forth and admonished as to our duties in connection with our young Disciples and their work with Astara. We were told that these Disciples would be ready to take the yoke of Astara upon themselves within a few years' time. There were told to us many things I cannot tell you now.

The Overseer

"But several of the Masters were given instructions as to their work with the earthly Astara. Some of those Masters are here with us tonight, and wish to speak to you. They shall tell you themselves just what part they will play in Astara, its future, and your future with it.

"The first of these to speak is the Master Hilarion. As most of you know, it was this Master who fostered the movement of Spiritualism over a hundred years ago. He it is who in general has been somewhat of an overseer of all the various segments of that great religion. From time to time, he will come to us here at Astara. He will speak to you now."

Hilarion Speaks

Hilarion: Yes, I do have a part; and I hope I may be able to leave a lasting influence in your lives through this earthly Astara. My purpose has been, for many years now, to bring to the minds of men, through the religion of Spiritualism, a greater knowledge of immortality; to prove, chiefly through psychic phenomena, the existence of other worlds around you; to prove that those who have stepped out of their physical bodies and live on in the spirit realms can return to prove the immor-

-As I have said, this Image is connected both to myself and to you, as a Disciple. Because of this connection, I am able to feel your every emotion. Sometimes I must disconnect myself from your Image, because you will, on occasion, lose control of your emotions. You have not yet gained mastery over your Astral body. I keep close observance of your Image and the colors of the aura about it tell me when your emotions are again under control.

If there are many such outbursts, even though you remain a member of Astara, your Image in the Hall will be done away with for a time until you acquire the proper mastery of your emotions.

WILSON'S PROPHECIES

Honor and Principle Must Be Restored

As Reported

By Christine Plantt

I could truthfully say that I came here tonight under more or less protest. I did not want to come. Now I am here, I see the registered influence of those who have been here before. I heard an invocation which convinces me that whatever happens in this little room of yours, whatever is said here or who ever comes here, all things are done and said and moved in the name of Almighty

It would be useless for me to look around these walls and tell you who all has been here. You know-at least you know those who have spoken. There may be others who have not given you addresses, but all in all this room, as I see it, now stands out in a shining glory; stands out with clear, concise and clarion languages and words which bespeak the love of God, which bring in to mankind, that is, brings in to you and you can give out to mankind, those holy, clear and concise thoughts of the spirit world.

And I can see that there will be no interference; there will be no bungling of words and there will be no evil thoughts because those things just do not belong in this room. So now, as I see your room and as I see you and as I sense the vibrations, I know that I was properly guided when I was led here.

We Strive, Too

Friends, you are going to be somewhat astonished when you hear who I am. I do not suppose that it is usual for the spirit forces coming in to talk to you to give their names, but I feel that I should give you mine and I will ask you first to withhold your judgment until you will have heard what I have to say to you.

On earth, I was known as Woodrow Wilson. Yes, I was the president of your country for eight years. I made mistakes during that administration, many of them, and it is probably true that everyone who has occupied that position has made mistakes but we do not all get the chance to come back to talk to the people of the earth; to talk about the mistakes; to talk about the benefits: to talk about the realities and to talk about your nation,

It is not necessary to tell you that your nation engaged in and won a war during that administration. We know that the spirit world is a world of peace. We know the spirit world strives for peace.

But, my friends, there were impositions; there were insults; there were insults upon insults

heaped upon the nation; demands were made which were unreasonable; and, as I saw it at that time, and I since have had it approved in the spirit world, I could see no other way for this nation to maintain its honor but to go to war.

Going to war is a serious business. It is a lamentable business. In warfare, even the winner of the war loses. Nobody can gain in war. Nobody can gain as a result of war. But we did what we thought was right.

Unfortunately, we did not carry on the peace negotiations with the same vigor, with the strength of personalities and language, with the same determination that this should be a better world. Therefore, you have heard the expression and it is very nearly true that: "We won the war but we lost the peace".

I won't talk about the war very long friends. War is not a very pleasant thing to talk about but it is necessary in this case to lead up to some of the other things I wish to touch

We now see that the nation with which we were largely at

war immediately upon the signing of peace began to prepare for another war. And it is a fact that when you are dealing, with people who believe in war, who hold the sacredness of war as they see it, who think it is right and just, you cannot talk to them in gentle terms.

You cannot plead with them in the peaceful, quiet attitude of the Master Jesus. They will listen apparently respectfully, but they do not care anything about that kind of talk. Their whole idea is conquest and acquisition. And when you deal with people of that kind, they must be completely vanquished or you are preparing for an-

Each Claim Holiness

Now friends I will try to get away from war talk. You have had in your country since that time four or five national elections. As you well know you have two large powerful policical parties. Each one claims that it is the holy one. Each one claims that it is the only party which can bring peace and prosperity to the nation.

Since that time, you have tried both of them and you have not yet experienced the peace and prosperity which was promised you by both parties. I belonged to one and I am frank to tell you that I cannot see that the promises made by my party meant any more, were any better upheld, were any better carried out, than were the promises of the other party. Political parties just do not work that way.

Now, you still have those two political parties. You are still firmly held in the grip of those two parties and the question is what are you going to do? The morale, the honesty, the principles of men in both parties have fallen far short of what even their own parties expected of them.

I hope to see in the next few years a building up of moral principle. I hope to see wrong doers, criminals, punished to the full limit of the law, to discourage the dishonesty, to discourage the chicanery and the evils which are now rampant in politics. It should not be,

The men elected—the men or women-should be elected to office who put honor and principle above every phase of human characteristics. Who hold that they have been elected to an honorable office; that it is for them to qualify that honorableness, conduct that office in an honorable manner; and resign if need be rather than take part in any of the questionable and unfavorable conduct which you have seen in public office the last few years.

Good Old Honesty

I know that the party now in power and has been in power for several years, in the name is the same party to which I, myself, belonged, but I do not tell you now that they have conducted an honorable administration. Honor seems to have been lost in politics. These different dishonest actions are taken for granted. They seem to think that they belong by right to the party in power.

Now I have not been over here long enough to influence the spirit world to any great extent. However, I have done a little and it is my firm opinion now that the spirit forces are going to begin working upon the souls and the hearts and the spirits of those elected to office with the idea of instilling in them honesty, just plain honorable honesty. Put the honor of the office above everything else. Conduct their work, their thoughts, with that same spirit of honorableness.

All these offices are of themselves honorable offices, until a dishonorable man occupies the office, then he dishonors the

Now of course it is not possible for me, nor is it possible for any other spirit force to come back in human form to your earth and begin campaigning for honesty. It is out of the question. But we feel that we can at least to some extent influence by impressions, and to some extent by talking through such people as you, but there are not enough of you, but we will do what we can with you. The balance of the work must be done by impressions.

And it is the desire of the spirit world that the public offices, that the public officers of this nation, revert back to the good old honesty of the revolutionary days. They did not all agree, but they were sincere, they were honest. They would rather sacrifice their souls than do a dishonorable act inten-

Chicanery Prevails

We need that same spirit today. I say "we"-I feel that I am as much of a citizen of that nation now as I ever was. Some people will say what right has a man like him to come back and try to tell us what to do. His work was not honorable.

I told you at the beginning of my address, friends, that I made many mistakes. But those mistakes were honestly made. They were honest mistakes. They were not deliberate thievery or chicanery. Now-no, I

I am hoping; I am working; I am praying for an uplifting in all parties, in all office holders, in all seekers for office, that they try to bring themselves back up to the good old principles of such men as Benjamin Franklin-I do not know why I cannot recall the other names ow. There are at least twenty of them, but somehow I cannot recall them, and I should be as familiar with them as I am with my own name, but you know who I mean.

It Must Be Done

Those old familiar names which you will find in the history of your country. Men who would rather disappear from earth if they could than be guilty of a dishonest act towards their government. Those were the men to whom principle meant everything. Those were the men to whom honor meant everything. Those were the men who built the nation, who founded the nation, started it upon a firm foundation until it has become the grandest and the strongest nation upon the

And now, we see it being dragged down to the dust by people who do not see the worthiness of honesty, of prin-

Friends, that is what I wanted to talk to you about tonight. We want, so far as we can, to work through you and to work directly upon the people by impressions. To build up a nation with the honor, with the in- . tegrity, and upon the principles of old. It must be done

What Mothers Should Know

By A. T. Connor, F.S.N.U.

Children are natural psychics and as such should be closely studied. When any of these traits are ascertained, great attention and care should be given them because some children are more sensitive to psychic vibration than others. Being so, such children have a tendency to be nervous. They dream frequently and are occasionally given to "sleep-walking." It follows, therefore, that the greatest care should be given their health, their education and their associates.

These children, when taken in hand, properly treated and understood, have a wonderful life-unfoldment potential. Their possibilities are almost unlimited because their very sensitiveness causes them to be open to streams of knowledge far transcending normal educational routine. They seem to grasp things without being told, without previous effort or study; in fact, these children are sometimes hindered by elementary courses of study.

They should not always be sent to schools and herded together with other children because it could be harmful to them. The so-called modern teacher does not understand, consequently does not know how to cope with this type of child. She has no knowledge whatsoever as to how to unfold certain latent and God-given

There should be trained teachers, set apart for the study of psychic signs in children. Only such instructors should have the job of training these natural psychics. If followed, we would have fewer nervous breakdowns among children of this type. These children should also be taught that the atmosphere @around them is filled with living friends and protectors.

They should be taught never to fear the darkness because darkness should be a thing of pleasure to them. They should be taught that, when night falls over the earth-world, it brings peace and rest; that it is a thing of great beauty; that it is a blanket that falls over thema blanket pierced with many brilliant stars, stars that are the eyes of God, which look down

Love, Not Fear

That is what should be done for children. Fear should have no place in the child's life. Fear should be an unpronounceable word. Love, trust and faiththese are the words which should be familiar to every childish heart.

Children up to the fifth or sixth year of earthly life nearly always have clear, clairvoyant vision. To them it is not strange to see forms which they call: "Children playing with them." They are not only surrounded by many spirit children, but also adult human spirits.

Every little action of theirs will be studied carefully by the wise mother. If wise, she will notice the colors to which they are attracted, as this is a great key to their psychic or inner nature.

Proper Color

Red should not be placed in the rooms of children; it is a color too stimulating to their nerve action. Blue is very helpful, and yellow also. Children should also be surrounded with sunshine, air and birds, flowers and water. This point cannot be emphasized too strongly. There should always be jars of water in the rooms for children, for water is a conductor of powerful psychic forces. Jars of fish are good for there is an elementary force that goes with fish and this force is very beneficial to the psychic growth of a child.

Music for Children

Music is perhaps the greater factor in moulding the psychic character of children. Never should a child be allowed to listen to what is termed "Jazz." The vibrations rising from such music are most destructive to the psychic upbuilding of childish morality because the rhythms that rise from such a vibration do not lend to a healthy atmosphere for children.

The simple folk tunes of the European races, the finer music of the great composers; of Brahms, of Schubert, Beethoven, and of the modern Mac-Dowell, Lehmann (Liza); these are the tones which should be given as food to the childish ear. Proper music is the greatest upbuilder of force, character and morality that the human mind can conceive. In fact, a nation' standard of morality is reflected in the kind of music its children are allowed to hear.



Both mediums have served the Foundation and, during their visits, photographs of the phenomena have been taken. Some of these photographs were published. (See Psychic Observer, October 25th, 1951.)

On this page, there appears four more photographs, all taken during a test demonstration of materialization. Louis Holmes, not a Spiritualist, took the photographs. He is a Jamestown commercial photographer and has no interest in the demonstration other than to see that the mechanical details are not fouled up—a procedure so important because his work, change of plates and so forth have to be carried out in pitch darkness.

Mr. Holmes was engaged to take pictures and follow the directions of the guides who indicated when to take each photograph.

Infra-red film was used, also 22-R bulbs. The photographs on this page are the remaining four from the twelve pictures taken. Three photographs were blurred because of improper timing.

Photograph No. 1: a spirit form entirely covered by ectoplasm although the face is fairly discernable. Madge Hart, cabinet attendant is seated at the left. This is the materialized form of Anna Tarkington Ewing, Juliette Ewing Pressing's mother.

Photograph No. 2: This is Diane, one of the medium's spirit teachers who supervises most of the phenomena during Rev. Herrejon's materialization seances.

Photograph No. 3: Sister Barbara. Note the large cross extending to the waistline.

Photograph No. 4: the materialized form of one of Rev. Herrejon's principal spirit collaborators who, only on rare occasions, has been known to manifest in this way. This spirit and Dolly, whose photograph was published in a previous issue, are the etheric chemists through whose help most of the phenomena is made possible.
