Regarding the latter, all those in the U. S. A. who choose to attend the Congress may join a tour now being organized by Rev. Melvin O. Smith, who is America's official delegate to the Congress.

"The next very important step is to find the means to bring the I. S. F. into a more effective operation. There are ever-present problems to solve—financial, personnel, etc., if, by means of the I. # WHAT SPIRITUALISM MEANS TO ME

(Ed. note: The following, written by Leonard Lloyd, president of the International Spiritualist Federation, is an interesting account of one man's entry into Spiritualism and his subsequent acceptance of considerable leadership in the field.)

My first association with things psychic came about in 1903, when my late wife, Margaret Lloyd, and myself tried table rapping with a three-legged table.

At the time, we looked upon this as a sort of game and asked some silly questions and, of course, received similar answers in suitable reply . . . nevertheless, the table did move about from one room to another. After a week our interest flagged.

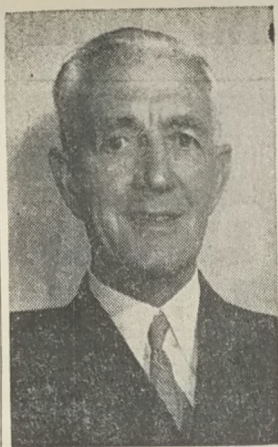
As I look back now, I feel that I was born into this world with more or less an analytical mind. As a child, I asked some very basic questions . . . so much so that one time my Sunday School teacher insisted that I be baptized immediately into the church in order to save me from the obvious "after passing" fate.

## Young Questions

Many times I wondered, when very young, what chance the little Chinese children had of escaping hell, since they seemed to stand little if any chance of being baptized into the church. Such thinking as this earned me some nervous times.

Once upon a time, I was choir boy in the church (of England) but, since I could not then make the teachings "square" themselves, I left. In 1900, I came to South Africa, which came to be my adopted country.

In 1913, much against my own wishes, but to please by brother-in-law, I accompanied him to a

psychometry meeting. My attitude was anything but sympathetic.

When my article was read by the medium, she told me something about a baby brother who had passed away when I was but three years old.

As would be expected of me at that time, I was not prepared to accept this information.

The medium then said my brother requested I submit the message to my parents. This I did in writing and was completely amazed by their subsequent confirmation of the contents of the message my mother had placed in his coffin.

This caused me to think heavily on the situation and the analytical side of my mind then seemed to call for me to furnish an explanation as to how the medium could tell me something that had never been known to me. I discussed this matter at some length with my wife, who, even before we were married, told me she had seen people after they had passed on . . . all this much to my (then) amusement.

## For Six Months

As a result of our discussions, we decided to attend the Spiritualist church for six months just to "see exactly what went on."

During this church attendance period my wife was advised by the medium that she should develop her psychic faculties. She later on joined a developing circle. Though extremely skeptical, even then, I was always eager to hear

of the results of each meeting, and afterwards I always tried to explain away the results . . . a pure attempt at rationalism.

However, one night my wife and her friend returned from the circle to inform me there was a vacancy, said they had asked the medium about my filling the vacancy, to which the medium gave her assent.

They said, my wife and her friend, "You have always tried to explain away things, now come along, have the experience, and then explain away whatever you please."

## The Tight Corner

This placed me in a tight corner, to say the least. Not wishing to lose face, I decided to go, even though skeptical, attended my first developing circle.

The medium, in deep trance and her guide "Doctor," prevailed in this meeting. After the circle was well underway, the guide started speaking to the sitter on the left of the medium and continued around the circle until he came to me.

The guide spoke to me saying, "Good evening my friend." I responded to the obviously cultured voice in like manner. The guide went on to say, "I would like to tell you it will not be long before you will take a prominent part in this movement. You are interested in the scientific aspect of the topic, and you will go on the public speaking platform and sometime write a book of the topic of Spiritualism."

This I considered as just too ridiculous.

## I Said, 'I Won't'

I replied, "My friend, I don't know just who you are, but if you have ever made a mistake before, you assuredly have this evening."

But I went on to say that I was interested for all that, in the scientific aspects of Spiritualism. But also, I have never been on a speaker's platform; have no desire for such activity and have less intention of doing such a thing . . . on any topic. Further, I advised the guide that as for writing a book on the topic of Spiritualism . . . NO!

The guide rejoined my statement with a very polite, "I still tell you that you will." I snapped back a sharp, "I will not."

The guide's composure was equalled by my frustration as he said, "Very well my friend, we will leave it to time."

I was perfectly willing to do just that.

## The Changed Tune

The guide, of course, proved me wrong.

Much against my own judgment, I was persuaded by the medium and leaders of the church to be a candidate for the church presidency. I pointed out the apparent wrong in asking me, a newcomer, to take such an office . . . and I further pointed out that if I found anything not absolutely straight and above-board I should quickly expose the whole thing.

This expounding had no effect except to result in my becoming the church president . . . and with the full endorsement of all concerned.

Thus, within a year of my first circle meeting, I started the first of the chain of many predictions. Seventeen years later, I wrote my booklet, "The Unfolding of the Psychic Faculty in the Home Circle."

How confident we all are when we just don't know!

## The Long Road

Thus started a long, hard but pleasant task of learning all I possibly could of Spiritualism.

# For The Record • Pioneers in the Field of SPIRITUALISM

**FANCHER, MOLLIE**, a Brooklyn girl who, owing to two serious accidents became blind and bed-ridden in 1866 when 17 years of age and lived another 44 years, exhibiting remarkable phenomena of clairvoyance and multiple personality. She took no food for nine years, lay on her right side in a paralyzed state with twisted limbs, all the natural functions of her body ceased, at times no pulse was felt and except for the region of the heart her body became entirely cold.

In this state, she was possessed by a different personality who executed delicate fancy work with her crippled hands, wrote beautifully, read clairvoyantly books under her pillows, saw colors in the dark, discovered lost articles and exhibited astounding travelling clairvoyance. Henry M. Parkhurst, the eminent American astronomer testified to her reading a torn-up letter which was fished out from a waste basket and enclosed in a sealed envelope. The original personality returned after nine years, the bodily rigidity relaxed and she became the prey to frightful fits of convulsions.

Between such states of consciousness, Mollie Fancher was possessed by new invading personalities, called Sunbeam, Idol, Rosebud, Ruby, and Pearl. Her personality changed five times in one night, the invaders keeping up a constant quarrel and fight amongst themselves and she hardly slept at all.

The story of her strange life is narrated by Judge Abram H. Dailey in *Mollie Fancher*, published in Brooklyn in 1894. In Bulletin XI of the Boston S. P. R. the case is reviewed by Dr. Walter Franklin Prince.

## PRIESTS FAIL

Attempts made by Roman Catholic priests in Mandaqui, Brazil, to prevent Spiritualists giving spiritual help to patients in the local hospital have proved abortive.

Despite the fact that the state's governor had issued an order that the Spiritualists were to be allowed to attend the sick, another priest declared that as Spiritualism was a science and not a religion, Spiritualists in the hospital must be debarred from receiving any kind of religious help or administrations.

The Spiritualists appealed to the governor to be allowed to carry on their good work in the hospital without being persecuted. The governor issued a decree to the effect that there must be no kind of religious discrimination in the hospital and that Spiritualists must be permitted to attend the patients without any interference.

The Spiritualist Federation has sent a telegram to the governor congratulating him on his tolerance and thanking him for his support.

Executive Committee of the I. S. F., but of every Spiritualist the world over.

"We can start by sharing our knowledge and our experience with other nations, we can help neighboring nations, where Spiritualism is not as firmly established as in our own country, and we can endeavor to cooperate within the framework of the I. S. F. to reach our goal in God's own time.

"I feel that much greater things could be accomplished even now. I offer no apologies if my work as General Secretary has not been up to your expectations. Certainly I and the members of my Executive Committee could do more for you, but you remember that I, for one, can only devote part of my time (my 'free' time) to the I. S. F. We have no full-time employees. But, my work would be easier if you

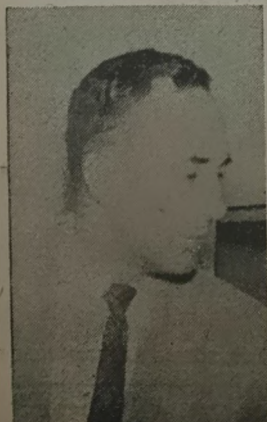

## MANY NOT YET PERSUADED!

**"N**EITHER will they be persuaded even though one rose from the dead." Those were the words which Jesus put into the mouth of Abraham in that wonderful parable of the rich man Dives and the beggar Lazarus (Luke 16, vv. 19-31), in which the after death states of each were contrasted so vividly.

How well Jesus reveals His understanding of human nature, for all through these 2,000 years there have been the great majority who have failed to realize the true reality of spirit life and spirit return after death, even though this was abundantly demonstrated by Jesus Himself.

If we were to ask the question, "And has one ever returned from the dead?" what answer would we get? The orthodox would doubtless say, "Yes, Jesus returned from the dead on Easter Day," and would add—but that is in quite a different category. The Spiritualist would surely say—NO, not one has risen from the dead—but ten thousand million and one, not on one day or one week or in one year, but EVERY DAY of EVERY WEEK of EVERY YEAR.

All through the ages those living souls who are termed "the dead" have been striving to impinge and impress the reality of their presence upon the mortals they have left behind on this earth. They have been trying to tell the good news—there is no death—only life abundant. Often, alas too often, they have been as voices crying in the wilderness of man's ignorance, grief, despair and desolation, and although they have risen from the dead, too few have been persuaded of their continued existence.

One hundred and nine years ago, a new effort was made by the spirit messengers to demonstrate that death, whether it be natural or violent in nature, could not destroy the living soul and spirit of man. They could not make this effort through the channels of religion for religion was more concerned with the letter than with the spirit, so it was decided to make the effort in the New World of America, where new ideas or new thought would more likely find lodgment. We know the result; the attempt succeeded and what we know as Modern Spiritualism was born. Throughout this last century it has steadily fought its way against prejudice, ignorance, bigotry, misrepresentation, ridicule and persecution, and today stands four square to the world on the rock of PROVED SURVIVAL.

The lines of communication which were opened with a trickle have widened, broadened and strengthened and we can say today that at least a million spirits of the dead are regularly communicating every year with those they have left behind.

But still there are many who have not experienced the joys of spirit communion. Still there are many who have not yet been persuaded that the dead are alive and can communicate with us, and just so long as that remains true our work must go on.

## COLORADO LAW

Probably one of the least understood bills that was introduced in our Colorado legislature this session was our own Senate Bill No. 55 to repeal the Clairvoyancy Law; which in every day parlance is termed the old Witchcraft Law.

To many, any progress for the bill was a miracle, and it passes the Senate by an almost two-thirds majority. The newspapers were kinder in their reports this time; which is definitely some progress. The Rock Mountain News headlined the story, but in the final paragraph said: "Don't be too sure this law will be repealed; it still must pass the House and go to the Governor's desk for his signature."

There was more opposition in the House—much greater misunderstanding and almost twice the number of members to work with; requiring more lobbying ("educating" individual representatives to our point of view). We had the backing of those who really made a study of the situation; but the opposition of a minority group, who still believe that it is necessary to limit religious practices. Some of the opposition have no conception of the other laws on the Statute Books having to do with fraud, false pretenses and confidence games, which in our state are sufficient to prosecute fakers in any field of action. The law we asked to have repealed was the one making it a crime to accept money for our work. This law does not make it a crime to "perform," but does make it a crime to accept money for the "performance."

Without a doubt the laws which discriminate against our religion could be taken to the Colorado Supreme Court and proved unconstitutional. It shouldn't be necessary to have to pay for such a fight, but it is.

Then, too, there are those in our ranks who narrow Spiritualism down to technicalities too, as bad as the discrimination that occurred in the "Witchcraft Era" of old.

One senator, who was in favor of repeal, remarked: "We used to burn the witches at the stake; if witches there are, or were, or ever have been! Now we merely throw them in jail and make them suffer other indignities."

We finally got the Bill through the House and to the Governor's desk—and in spite of great numbers of letters from all over the state in its favor, it was vetoed. (Our Governor has definite religious convictions too.) In his explanation of his veto he said he was convinced that there was justification for a change in the law, but he felt it would need more clarification. He also said he was not willing to make allowances just to churches, as he felt educational research along these lines should not be restricted by law, either.

We are no worse off than we were, and we learned enough to know what to do next time—in fact, we already have our new bill written, and have a man in each house we can depend on to carry it to victory for us.

The publicity we created brought both friends and enemies into the open, and the best educated are our friends in almost every instance.

# WHAT GARDNER MURPHY HAS TO SAY about PSYCHIC RESEARCH

Some scientists try to keep an open mind—even though it is a controversial subject.

THERE recently appeared in a magazine section of a newspaper that enjoys extremely wide circulation, a story wherein Dr. Gardner Murphy was interviewed by two able writers on the topic, "Can We (the living) Communicate With The Dead?"

The interviewers were Jhan and June Robbins and in their story were presented not a few case histories on psychic phenomena.

Dr. Gardner Murphy, before going on, is a member of the American Society for Psychical Research; research director for the Menninger Foundation; and one of the country's leading psychologists. This background is regarded, even among the skeptics, sufficient for his being considered what the news world regards as "an unusually reliable source."

He asks, through his writers here, "Is there any good reason to think that some portion of the human personality can and does communicate with the living world after death?"

Dr. Murphy has profound and stable reason to believe that this is true. He is joined in this by numerous responsible scientists, who are convinced that something occasionally does take place which at least strongly resembles communication from the other world.

Dr. Murphy presents another question, "If communication from another world is possible, can whatever it is that remains somehow appear to the living and furnish proof of its existence?"

One well-documented case concerning an R.A.F. flyer, named Jerome Larkin, who was sitting in his barracks writing a letter when he heard the habitually noisy entrance of his exuberant friend, Lt. David McConnell... who had departed on a mission about an hour before. This friend banged his way through the door of Larkin's room and greeted him cheerfully, wearing full flying togs, minus his helmet, but wearing a Navy issue cap on his head.

Larkin asked, "Back so soon?" "Yes, sooner than we expected," McConnell replied, and with that went his noisy way.

A few hours later the flight with which McConnell had departed came back and reported that McConnell's plane had crashed and that McConnell had been killed! This was reported as happening at almost the same moment McConnell had "appeared" to his friend Larkin in the barracks!

Another odd note: At the time of the crash, McConnell had been wearing the cocky Navy cap he had borrowed just before the fatal takeoff.

## Numerous Such Cases

Many such apparitions have appeared at about the moment of death, peaceful or violent. Such cases cause the skeptics to feel that there must, after all, be something within us.

There is the very famous Chaffin Will Case, a story recently carried in great detail in the *Psychic Observer*, which concerned James L. Chaffin, who had passed away six months prior to the time of the phenomena, when a form appeared to one of his sons in a series of vivid dreams... and wherein the son was told that the will about to be probated was not the true last will. A second will did exist and was found, greatly favoring this particular son... and it was, in due course and through regular channels, accepted as valid and subsequently so entered in the records of the state of North Carolina.

This happens time and time again throughout the history of psychic research. This research is entrusted, officially, to only top

men in the field... and for obvious reasons.

## Another Instance

In this case, the form that appeared assumed the initiative and gave startling information.

A traveling salesman returned home following a trip and told his mother that in a vivid dream he had seen the "spirit" of his sister... who had passed away nine years previously. She appeared to him, he said, exactly as when he had last seen her.

There was one notable exception... she carried a large red scratch on her cheek.

To this man's complete dismay, his mother began to weep and finally said, that in preparing her daughter's body for burial, she had accidentally scratched the girl's cheek with a rose thorn... and she further revealed that she had concealed the scratch with some makeup and had never told the instance to anyone!

Now, such instances as these here told are so common through recorded history and in every language, by great people and unknown, as to be beyond the category of the unusual... yet, some people scoff at the obvious!

## Regarding Mediums

As in any form of human activity, there are the completely glib and there are the (just as completely) fraudulent persons who prey on the former.

Very, very fortunately however... there are unnumbered mediums of irreproachable honesty. Dozens of them are found in this country who are both talented in the field and honest in the private and professional lives to the nth is the rule rather than the exception. The imposters and frauds are soon discovered, unmasked and forced to leave off with their terrible ways.

These honest mediums co-operate without hesitation with the researchers... with parapsychologists who are interested in mediumship as an evidence of extrasensory perception. Without exception, these mediums have been found to be habitually pleasant, of obvious good character and good intent and strongly convinced of the reality of their spirit conversations!

Aside from the professional requirements regarding inbred talent, these mediums must without fail carry with them the qualities of "seeking always, learning always, and the golden aura of wanting always at all costs to find out one more thing"... in brief they are practical scientists! There is no other way.

Information mediums can and do, time after time, present, is amazing.

Prof. J. G. Pratt, of Duke University in the Carolinas, has devised a mathematical system for measuring to an astonishing degree to which their "hits" register above the chance of the Laws of Probability.

Still another system calls for checking not only to see whether the information given applies to the sitter, but whether it is so accurate and so personal it cannot possibly be applied to anyone else.

Even under these stringent con-

ditions, mediums time after time turn in information that is precise and specific.

## A Case In Point

In one well-known case, for example, Daisy Armstrong, a woman living abroad, hearing of a friend's interest in psychical research, urged her to try and make contact with Daisy's father, who passed away 25 years before.

The friends did so and was so amazed to receive a message saying: "There are two of us here now... which one does Daisy wish to hear from?"

Hastily she wrote her absent friend about the strange communication. Daisy, equally puzzled, wrote back to say that a clergyman, a family friend, had guarded her welfare as she grew up and had given her much good advice. She sometimes referred to him as her "second father" had died suddenly just before the seance took place!

Now this sort of evidence, presented as it is many times over, is convincing to many, many people and most especially to those involved in the event... but how about the scientists in the field... the parapsychologists who are trying so very hard to find explanations for all the evidences of extrasensory perception?

Dr. Murphy says:

Actually, most of us in the field are confirmed skeptics, and I'll tell you why. Having seen ESP in action and in the laboratory we know what it can do. We think the "evidence" presented by mediums is evidence of extrasensory perception — of communication not with the dead, but with the living.

Various ESP functions such as telepathy seem to be heightened by the onset of death. Under the stress of this most final of human crises, may not the mind cry out telepathically to establish a link with those it loves? Could not mediums who are able to give accurate and specific information actually be getting that information, not from the dead and departed, but directly, by unconsciously reading the minds of those living and present?

Some of us think so, even though we try, as scientists, to keep an open mind about what is to say the least, a controversial subject.

## IN THE FUTURE

Men do not live for the present but for the future. The bulb in the earth grows, not for the present, but for the future. The unborn child develops in a present darkness for life in a future daylight. Whether in household duties or governmental activities, all action is directed to influence the future.

Yet all life leads to death. It is certain man must die. Why then do we tend to worry ourselves silly about the near future and avoid thinking about the distant goal? Who cares for Tomorrow and not for the Day After Tomorrow?

But some people do care—the people who believe in life after death. These are called religious people. Because of our small and restricted mental capacities and the impossibility of fully understanding the ultra-worldly future, disputes and quarrels arise among religious people.

## Lesson Five — PYTHAGORAS

PYTHAGORAS was born on Samos, one of the Grecian islands, approximately 582 B.C. His parents are said to have been very much in love with each other and Pythagoras later claimed that only such an union could place parenthood on the highest plane. We know this to be true, for a child born of love has the advantage, physically and mentally, over one born in hatred or one who comes, undesired, into life.

Pythagoras was a handsome man and, like most good-looking people, was well aware of the fact. His splendid mind taught him, however, that a handsome man cannot always talk as well as he looks, so it is not good for him to talk too much. It is said that Pythagoras was a very silent man. His father was a sea captain and away from home much of the time, leaving him to the almost constant companionship of his mother.

He had an ideal childhood and during his youth, his insatiable desire for knowledge, and his mother's ambition for his future, caused him to build a mental foundation which was of inestimable value to his later psychic unfoldment.

## Objective Clairvoyance

Parthenes, the mother of Pythagoras, was a beautiful woman. She was a believer in the occult religions and, even before his birth, she is said to have dedicated her son's life to the spirits or gods. When he was very young, ancient history tells us that Pythagoras used to converse most profoundly with the priests and wise men.

At the age of twenty, he had what was then called "an illumination." "He clearly saw the mysteries of the universe and understood many things that could not be expressed in human language." Undoubtedly he possessed, as did our Andrew Jackson Davis, the psychic faculty that we call objective clairvoyance.

In Davis's case, this faculty enabled him to peer into the past happenings of the universe and to see, as did Pythagoras, "things that could not be expressed in human language." Davis gave us an outstanding theory of organic evolution and he was able to make some astounding prophecies of astronomical events to come, because of his "illumination."

## Science of God

Parthenes had always been anxious to learn the secrets of the esoteric religions that were hidden away in the temples of Egypt and immediately after her son's vision, she urged Pythagoras to become an initiate in the temple. He found this very difficult to accomplish for at first the Egyptians refused to accept him because he was a Greek. They claimed that the secrets of the temple were for Egyptians only.

Finally, after testing his endurance in a series of terrible ordeals, in which he many times risked his life, he was accepted as an initiate and, for twenty long years, devoted his life to gaining an understanding of the science of God and the development of psychic power.

## Natural Law

Many writers of ancient history deny the fact that the processes of the esoteric religions were kept secret, known only to the initiated, assuming, because of their secrecy, (Continued Page 5, Col. 1)

week, and I felt this phenomenon was accomplished for a purpose.

Through the mediumship of my young nephew, who is 15 years old, Bruce Kessler, who recently developed many phases, we soon contacted his Doctor Smith, who spoke immediately of the levitation we had just witnessed. He told us there was a reason for it, and then stood back for a Franciscan Monk from the Monastery in Washington, D. C., to speak.

"Postpone your trip to Washington," he said, in a deep, impressive voice. As I hadn't been on a vacation this summer, this was a disappointment. This also made us feel very good to think we are able to contact the other plane of life and they could advise us against decisions that could prove disastrous. Without thinking, my husband took the cross and placed it back on the nail, because it didn't look too secure above Washington, D. C.

On Sunday afternoon we were getting ready to go to Camp Chesterfield, and as Bruce was standing in the hall with the bedroom door almost completely closed, I heard him give a gasp of surprise. I opened the door and looked in to see the crucifix resting on the head of the bed on its journey back to the picture of Washington, D. C. There was no doubt now in my mind that our friends on the other

On Monday morning Bruce awoke not feeling well enough for school, decided to rest in bed for awhile. He was lying with his eyes closed and suddenly opened them to see his Crucifix float out the closed window. I wish to add that he had one exactly like the one that had been moved about in my room. He called, saying, "My cross just went out the window."

My immediate thoughts were maybe that boy is sicker than I thought, and maybe a doctor should be called. I was soon convinced

that this wasn't the case, for he was out of bed and soon dressed, saying he felt fine. He had received instant healing. We went from room to room looking for it, and a few minutes later it appeared in a downstairs room above a large picture of Christ. We were all flabbergasted. In a moment, Bruce said, "Go upstairs Glenna, in your living room." I didn't know what to expect. May I say that Bruce always got the message when something was happening.

I opened my living room door cautiously and looked around to see that two of my pictures that had been hanging on the wall were completely rearranged. From then on we didn't know what to expect.

## Unseen Hands

We didn't realize then, but this was surely the beginning of a day of activity in our home.

My sister and I were getting ready to go to Dayton, Ohio, a nearby city, to do some shopping. As we were preparing to leave she said, "I sure could use that \$10" that she had mislaid several weeks ago. A few minutes later Bruce called us to go in the bedroom, saying, "Look Mother." We couldn't believe our eyes, for a ten dollar bill was on top of her trumpet with a red feather holding it. The feather had been given to her in a seance by her Indian chief, Red Feather, several months before.

When she saw this, she decided she wouldn't spend the money, but would leave it in the trumpet for others to see. I had prepared my shoulder bag for the trip, and it was lying in my room. My billfold had been placed in it with money in it for my spending spree. As we were standing there, I glanced over to a wall shelf and there was my billfold.

Unseen hands had placed it there but also drew my attention before I left, as I sure would have been embarrassed after making my purchases. It was almost impossible for us to leave after these happenings, but it was our only day off from the Beauty Shoppe, and too, we needed our supplies, so we left.

Upon our return home, Bruce met us at the door. He informed us that we should enter at our own risk. After glancing around the room, I could see why he made the remark. It is hard to write the things I saw. The rooms completely rearranged. The pictures on the walls had been exchanged just like dancers doing a square dance. Many of these things took place right before Bruce and his grandmother, Minola Klopfer. I asked him if the pictures came suddenly or floated, and he informed me sometimes rapid and sometimes slow.

"This Is Ruthie" blanked in place in the middle of the living room floor, and a candle was burning in a holder nearby. Bruce told me the Indians had been having a powwow. Heavy stand lamps had been brought down from the upstairs living room, also heavy trophies were moved from upstairs. A heavy sweeper was moved into another, two typewriters, one very heavy, the other portable were moved from one room to another.

Our parakeet, Nicky, was moved from between two windows in the dining room and placed on the television upstairs. When we found him there he seemed very disturbed.

During the day the telephone rang, and when Bruce answered it a small voice said, "This is Ruthie. I will see you tomorrow night." Ruthie is his little circle guide, and she knew we had planned a seance for Tuesday evening. We were mystified at all these happenings, but things didn't stop.

In the kitchen a skillet had been placed on the stove and the gas lighted. (We haven't a pilot light that works.) And some artificial flowers placed in the skillet. My mother's little guide, Pansy, said, "Go look, I am cooking pretties for grandmother. The milk was taken from behind a closed refrigerator door and placed on a table."

After Bruce had taken his paper route of 50 papers that evening, we were standing in the kitchen and things too, had quieted down. Just then, one of our trumpets came flying down the stairs. I stopped to pick it up, and \$80, all in \$10 bills, came rolling out. None of the family had that amount in the house.

Immediately, Bruce's Doctor Smith told him this came from the lining of a purse that had been thrown in the Pacific Ocean. It had been stolen, and the thief overlooked all the money it contained. This continued several times also

that many fraudulent practices were carried on under the cloak of religion. Undoubtedly this was true but we should not assume that the occult religions were the only ones which harbored deceit.

Within the fold of every church, there are those who would get rich at the expense of the populace and they care little how those riches are obtained. Even in our churches today, in all denominations, there are many wolves in sheep's clothing.

Today, we are quite well aware that there are no secrets so far as God and Nature are concerned and we, who know psychic power to be a natural demonstration of God's law, deplore all mystery and secrecy regarding it. We must realize, however, that, even in the present day, there are those who prefer their religion to be clothed in miracles and mystery and refuse to accept the plain unvarnished facts of natural law.

## "Bilocation"

Before the initiation of Pythagoras was fully completed, Egypt was conquered by the Persians and he was taken prisoner. Even this turned out to his advantage for he was able to acquire much knowledge from the Persian Magi. For twelve years, he remained a prisoner in Babylon before he was finally permitted to return to Greece.

Among his psychic gifts were objective and subjective clairvoyance; the ability to heal both body and soul; to divine and to prophesy. He also possessed the faculty which F. W. H. Myers called bilocation, or the ability to appear simultaneously in two different places, near to each other or far apart. He was also able to produce brilliant spirit lights and ancient history tells us that a red glow of light permeated the temple when he was demonstrating his psychic power.

In his later years he married, some authorities say at forty, others say at sixty. Whatever his age, the marriage was a very happy one. Two sons and two daughters were born of the union, all of whom were a credit to their parents.

## 250 Years

Pythagoras's wife appears to have inspired him to greater fields of accomplishment for he soon founded a community which was known as the Pythagorean School. It was really an Utopian city. All members worked together and

pooled their earnings. The community was founded on mutual service: everyone worked, everyone from intolerance and unkindness studied and everyone refrained from intolerance and unkindness towards others. It was their desire to find a perfect way of life.

The Pythagorean School grew rapidly and many pilgrims came there to study. To become a member of the colony, one must become an initiate in the temple, strive to unfold psychically and to learn the laws of right living. Some three hundred people lived in peace and harmony in this colony for over thirty years. The demon jealousy finally caused misunderstanding with the citizens of Croton, the little town in which the school was founded, and a mob of drunken soldiers broke into the community and set fire to the buildings.

Pythagoras and most of his followers were destroyed in the conflagration. Although the colony was dispersed, the members reorganized at another place and the Pythagorean Society flourished for some two hundred and fifty years.

## Power of Will

Pythagoras left no writings for posterity but all of his students kept notebooks and it is to them that we owe practically all our information concerning his life and teachings.

Pythagoras, like Socrates, taught that the most essential thing was to know one's self. In his healing, Pythagoras used music to soothe the patient. This has always been deemed a mere incantation but the recent realization of our doctors as to the efficacy of music and color in the healing of mind and body has cast a different light upon the subject.

It is said that Pythagoras is the father of numerology because he studied and believed in the science of numbers while he was going through the schools of the Egyptian temples. He also claimed that all things could be accomplished through the power of will.

Over the door of the Pythagorean College was this instruction: KNOW THYSELF. Over the inner door was inscribed these words: ONLY THE PURE IN HEART MAY ENTER HERE. Truly the teachings of Pythagoras were of a lofty, spiritual nature and they have lived not only in sayings of Socrates, Plato, Aristotle and other philosophers but they have rung down through the channels of spirit communion to the eternal upliftment of all mankind.

the next day, until \$190.00 had come through the trumpet.

The next morning three \$10 bills were found above my step-father's picture in the hallway. We all felt a little leary about the money, but they assured us it would never have been found after being thrown in the ocean. Each bill was printed in 1950. We were promised we would be told what to do with the money. It seemed almost sacred, and we knew it would never be spent for anything, only for spiritual needs of others.

When Tuesday arrived, my sister and I had to open the Beauty Shoppe, but it was hard for us to concentrate on hair-dos with all the phenomena happening in the other part of the dwelling. Candles were placed by unseen hands in ash trays above several doors and burned throughout the day. When a candle would burn down until it would seem to soon go out in a flash another would appear in its place, right before our eyes.

In the broad daylight, the trumpet came from another room where it had been standing and levitated with a loud voice saying, "Hello Mother" to me. I had an eighteen year old boy, Gary, in spirit, who left this world as a premature baby in 1938. Even now as I re-live these happenings, and I was there to witness a lot of them, it is the most amazing series of events that the spirit world did outside a seance room.

## "Bruce Is Gone"

On Tuesday late in the afternoon, Bruce had decided to lie down on his bed to rest for awhile, to feel good for the evening seance. He told me as I left the room, in a joking manner, that he supposed he would be the next one to be worked on. I was a little nervous as I walked out of the room, because I had read about persons being levitated in space.

A few minutes later I went up the stairs to see if he had gone to sleep (he needed it) and I saw he wasn't on his bed. I called to the others saying "Bruce is gone." We went from room to room upstairs, and finally my mother pointed on the top of the davenport. There he lay in a suspended position on the back edge of the davenport, and looked very stiff.

We waited a few minutes without uttering a sound. He said in a moment, "Where am I? I thought I was in my bed." We too, were mystified because I knew that no steps were heard coming down the staircase.

We were told in the seance that evening how they levitated Bruce's body and floated it down the stairs. I know they thought we would (Continued on Page 6, Col. 1)

## THE KEY TO SUCCESS SPIRITUAL Chapter IV The Great Principle—Faith

**I**NOW leave, not knowing when or whether ever I may return, with a task before me greater than that which rested upon Washington. From Lincoln's eloquent farewell to his Springfield neighbors, February 11, 1861. An avowal of a great soul's faith.

## "One Minute Treatments" Soul Of Man Must Be Allowed Freedom

THE IDEA of a "travelling circus" did not originate with Barnum and Bailey, but it was the first show to travel in its own cars to move the "greatest show on earth" on iron rails.

A circus is generally speaking a mixture of fancy and fact, an exhibit of great proficiency and a display of skill of a high order. Before the rise of rival attractions the arrival of the circus was intimately connected with the life of the people, often a city-wide holiday.

But the "greatest" show on earth has never been shown under a tent, never travelled on iron rails and has never moved from the spot it first occupied. It has been running continuously since about a million years ago, in a setting to rival the most stupendous aggregation of acts ever assembled. Its struggles for public acclamation have never been equalled so far.

The greatest show of all times has been staged in the arena of the mind with the entire world an audience to watch the humble attempts of each man to display his strength. It is a sincere try to interpret the universe and to find some way to satisfy his soul.

Multiplying by thousands the instinctive, emotional demands of a human who holds up any way of life as the only right way for him and it adds up to an incalculable influence. But it does not exude a confidence that such a choice is also a good way for others to follow.

By choice some are willing to live like circus animals, allow their souls to be caged, unconscious of being surrounded by the might and power of the world. They fig-

ure that with food, a bed, no work and escape from the problems of ordinary life, naively enough, they can make the sawdust trail a path leading toward complete freedom.

The man who thus betrays his instincts, who expects others to "take care of him" gives up a good portion of his right to exist as a human being and loses a big part of usefulness to himself and others. From behind the bars of a cage his face seems to have no particular expression to suggest an inner balance or some feeling of his own identity; for there can be no inner peace where the outer freedom has been denied.

### Freedom To Speak

Up and down the broad highways of life evil qualities have grown up by degrees. We attract them through ignorance and through self-indulgence. The man who understands realizes nothing will bring HIM pleasure and unity with all that is just unless he is given the wisdom of nature in which to apply his talents and become saturated with its wealth and opportunities.

The slightly piliated mind may be content to let others "take care of him," even destroy his inherent powers, by the twisted process of reasoning that once having accepted his cage nothing more should be expected of him.

But it is one thing to take a stand on a resolute principle and another thing to obtain acceptance of its impact upon the soul and consciousness which feed our emotions. A public display of surrender never settles anything, it only enlarges the areas of bitterness which is sure to follow.

Some day every soul hopes to "arrive," to be something more than a dangling tail on a kite. To watch lilted flues woo squirming reptiles into action may fascinate the eye for a while, but the soul of man must be allowed FREEDOM to speak in its own behalf to unfold to the fullest degree its divine command.

# PSYCHIC HIGHLIGHTS

—by Lt. Col. ARTHUR E. POWELL

## Man Electric

John D. Crehore

EVIDENCE that man—as well as every living creature—is essentially an electrical apparatus, is piling up in such quantity that I think the case may be considered proved. The most illuminative and inclusive book on the subject that I know is a recent one: "Mental Telepathy," by John Davenport Crehore. It may be obtained from the author, Crehore Homestead, Walpole, New Hampshire, for \$5.00. Crehore gathers up a host of miscellaneous phenomena, and welds them into this thesis to form a logical, coherent synthesis.

A cornerstone of his thesis is "A Bi-Polar Theory of the Living Cell," by Dr. George W. Crile, head of the Cleveland Clinic, 1923. After 20 years research, Crile found that every living cell, animal or vegetable, has positive electricity on its nucleus, and negative on the enveloping protoplasm. The distinction between live and dead matter is the ability of the nucleus to generate surplus electricity, which it discharges into the protoplasm in microwaves, thus creating a continuous voltaic cell-discharge of electricity in the body. Professor Edmund Jacobson, M.D., Chicago University, considers that thought itself is, or has, electric current. In the early 1940s, the U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey published data on a celestial rain of negative electrons (not cosmic rays), hitting the earth at a rate of 1½ million per square centimetre per second—of which more anon.

Muscular strength derives from high-voltage current, from nerves to muscles, the latter contracting in proportion to the volume of current.

Confirmation of this electric theory comes from many sources. We have, of course, the electro-encephalograph, which seems conclusive; electrodes to scalp can affect the sense of balance, etc.; mental illness can be treated via electrodes to brain: Bethesda Naval Hospital sends currents into nerves for blindness; movements and emotions are subject to bioelectric signals: animals wearing "receivers" are made to exhibit fear, hunger, etc., automatically. There have been reported cases of individuals able to receive radio programs without any apparatus other than their own bodies. Some years ago, a man in Rahway, New Jersey, complained that he could not turn off these programs: "I hear Bing Crosby now. He's singing such-and-such a song"—which was true.

In addition to cell-generated electricity, Dr. Crile mentions friction of blood-particles along arteries as another source. Normally, the "ground" for the body's positive electricity is the earth itself, which would account for the proven fact that animals, poultry and children thrive better when in contact with the soil than when on artificial flooring. Cases are known where walking on bare feet has enormously benefited health. "Health Culture" tells of a boy who, dying of consumption, went to live in the desert, without shoes, and lived to a great age. Another man, given a few days to live, did the same thing, and regained health and weight. Evidently, contact with Mother Earth is beneficial to life.

That the body's electrical charge is substantial, is illustrated by a person shuffling across a rug in cold dry weather, and giving off a quarter-inch spark—which requires 25,000 volts!

The rain of electrons from space is named by Crehore—"privately in my conceit"—"The Crehore Sea," or "Crehore Electron (ic) Sea." Obviously, it would make possible the reception of countless "waves," or vibrational impulses, through this "sea," such as those of radios, and, *par excellence*, telepathy. Crehore thinks—I suggest with reason—that hypnotic commands are transmitted, not so much by the sound of the voice, as by telepathy.

A confirmatory item of extreme interest is that it has been found that the gray matter, the outer shell of the brain, has fine conducting filaments, like those of early radio sets. From countless minute neurons, specks of nerve tissue grow, it is estimated, 12 to 50 billions of microscopic hairy

filaments (fibrils, fibrillae), called dendrites, in constant waving motion. Owing to brain convulsions, this will facilitate "directional" radio. The tips of dendrites, like that of a lightning rod, produce concentration of electrical charge, needing only the launching push of a thought, to cause it to discharge into space.

In the Crehore Sea we have a plausible explanation of the Astrological importance of the moment of birth. While still a foetus, an entity is shielded from the Crehore Sea waves. The moment it is born, these influences, acting on virgin soil, may well produce deep, often indelible impressions, thus "rubber-stamping" the individual for life.

The reason, Crehore suggests, why we are not more telepathic than we could be, is tenseness and strain of modern life, which puts us out of touch with the Crehore Waves.

Animals, being relaxed, are more telepathically receptive. It is also at least plausible that instincts of a species are due to each individual being in constant telepathic communication with others of its species—living or dead.

Crehore succinctly epitomizes the main elements of his thesis thus: he founds it solely on the findings of orthodox science: the body lives by generating a surplus of positive electricity: the brain has billions of filaments which are ideal radio antennae that send out and take in current: the atmosphere is a sea of negative electricity (electrons): positive and negative electricity attract one another.

Hence he is correct in stating that he brings no new data. But he brings what is worth more. He is one of those rare individuals who can take known data, think about them, and out of them build a grand synthesis. And that is just what we need today. We have too much fragmentation in virtually every science. Our great need is synthesis. So hats off to our Mr. Crehore!

Though small, "Mental Telepathy" contains much other material of value, including techniques for practicing telepathy. Very strongly I advise the scientifically-oriented to procure and study this volume—diligently. I am disposed to think it will prove a landmark in human thought, and in our knowledge of our own selves.

He invites correspondents. I know he has at least one, who is appreciative and grateful.

### South Africa

W. H. LILLY is a famous healer and homoeopath. In Pretoria recently, as reported in "Two Worlds," he was "reluctantly" fined a nominal sum for "practicing medicine," by a magistrate who said: "In cases of this kind . . . one finds that the people who are not medical men have usually done a lot of harm to the persons they healed. In this case, the position is exactly reversed."

This medium is responsible for scores of cases, declared "medically hopeless." He is running a campaign throughout the Union, "representing all other unorthodox healers—osteopaths, homoeopaths, naturopaths, spiritual healers, etc. We will put our case before the people . . . to have the position considered in Parliament. The people are behind us. We have the support of the Press. A great fight lies ahead."

Under South African law, no healer may practice, no matter what his qualifications or type of healing. He may not "diagnose, advise, prescribe or treat." "For gain" covers all gifts or donations, even a packet of cigarettes! Lilley's success evidently has aroused medical jealousy. Judging by letters in the newspapers, his court case has "caused a furore." Patients write of the good he has done, which they have seen. Lame children walk, the blind see, the deaf hear. "If we are prepared to pay him for his wonderful work, why can he not be happy doing the work to which he has devoted his whole life? And why shouldn't we, hundreds of us, be happy with the results? If he did not help people, very soon he would not

have any patients. If medical science is being protected, something ought to be done to change the law." Have not patients the right to choose who shall treat them?

A patient had a son, seriously ill, given up by two eminent specialists. Drugs had deleteriously affected him; the doctor begged her to take the boy elsewhere.

A well-known Johannesburg doctor said: Take my advice; do not make the rounds of doctors . . . you will come away broken-hearted . . . you will be crippled financially. Lilley took over the case, which was critical. "He has not only kept him alive and put color back into his cheeks, but is slowly winning the battle."

"Two Worlds" editorially comments, without pulling punches. The British Medical Association has warned doctors that co-operation with "healers" can lead to their being struck off the register. South Africa also is aiming at medical monopoly—"totalitarian tyranny, a form of fascism by physicians." Doctors tell sufferers: "If we cannot cure you, nobody else will be allowed to do so." Surely "the individual has the inalienable right to choose who shall treat his body." When medicine says a case is hopeless, the sufferer should have a second chance.

The gift of healing has been conferred on thousands of unregistered practitioners. In the National Federation of Healers alone, there are 600 healer-members. In ten years Harry Edwards has received three million letters! In Leeds, tickets for his meetings were sold out months in advance. In three weeks, at least 9,000 people saw healing being given. In 14 years Edwards has given over 300 demonstrations throughout Britain. Even in a full year he could not accept even a small fraction of invitations that pour in from all over the country.

"It may be a long struggle in South Africa, but our healers must triumph." And so say all of us. "Not all the medical Canutes or Mrs. Partingtons can stop this flood of spirit power performing its beneficent work." People have "the right to practice their religion, of which spiritual healing is an integral part."

## Priestly Seances

### Spiritualism Endorsed

"PSYCHIC NEWS," gives us an entertaining story of Spain in 1873, when the Roman Catholic Bishop of Barcelona ordered the Spiritualist books and papers of Allen Kardec, presented to the Lachatri Library, to be burned, to protect his flock from the works of the Devil.

The bonfire so roused the curiosity of the sheep, that the Bishop appointed a committee of priests to unmask the evils of Spiritualism.

After consulting the Bishop the committee decided they should sit in a circle, and try automatic writing. The first message that came through was: "Throw away your scruples, and dedicate yourselves to the defense of the truths taught to you." A later message said: "Dear brothers, close your hearts to the counsels of egoism, and open them to the love of your brothers in spirit and in truth. Fear not!" This sounded more like the teaching of Jesus than of the Devil. So they continued the sittings.

In a few months, so many messages came, some from very advanced spirits, that they called themselves the Christian Spiritualist Circle of Lereda, and became so enthusiastic that the good Bishop began to doubt the value of the procedure.

The next year one of the circle, Dom Jose Amigo y Pellices, published a book: "Rome and the Gospel," summing up the results of the sittings, the preface being endorsed by all the sitters, in these words:

"In place of illogical theories, ridiculous affirmations, and superstitious beliefs, we have been given a philosophy that is robust and reasonable, sanctioned by facts, and confirmed by the teachings of the Lord Jesus Christ."

So displeased was the Minister

of Public Instruction, that he suspended from employment, in the Escola Normal of Lereda, the president of the Circle, and also the author of "Rome and the Gospel," because of their opinions.

In 1893 the above book was translated into Portuguese by Dr. Adolfo Beyerra de Meneses, who says of it:

"It speaks to reason in a mode so vibrant that only those who are obsessed by the spirit of tradition or fanaticism would be able to deny the light and truth which palpitate these sublime pages. The 37 chapters and 35 spirit communications constitute a solemn reply to those who slander Spiritualism."

"If those who oppose it were to examine the subject without sectarian prejudice, as did that group of Catholic priests, before condemning what they do not understand, they must honestly proclaim its Divine origin."

The book of the Lereda Circle sittings contains the testimony of Abbe Abrugnana, corroborated by Alfred Russell Wallace, and Victorien Sardou, member of the French Academy.

The story looks to me almost up to Ripley's standard. It was carried this year by the Portuguese newspaper "Estudos dos Psiquicos," of Lisbon.

## One Too Many

### The Seventh Hand

IN "You Do Take It With You," R. DeWitt Miller tells "The Case of the Seventh Hand," which seems to qualify as one of "cast-iron-proof" phenomena.

A seance was held in New York in 1909, at Dr. Hereward Carrington's instigation, the medium being the famous Mme. Palladino. Carrington, veteran researcher, expert conjuror, highly skeptical, often accused of being unmercifully strict in his seance conditions; chose the room, eliminating the possibility of prepared apparatus, trap doors or concealed confederates. The medium was stripped and searched. The door was locked. Frank Tilford, president of Park & Tilford Company, Daniel Frohman, famous theatrical producer, and Dr. Carrington, were the only sitters. They sat at a heavy wooden table. On one side of the medium sat Tilford, on the other Frohman, each having his foot under one of the medium's, and his knees against hers, and each holding one of her hands. Finally, Dr. Carrington tied the medium's hands to those of her controllers. All six hands were on the table. There was a strong red light. Every hand was clearly visible.

In Dr. Carrington's words: . . . a tiny hand was seen to emerge over the top of the seance table and begin to untie the knots in the ropes binding Eusapia to her controllers . . . when the right wrist was untied, the rope was coiled up and thrown at one of the sitters, striking him on the chest.

"The hand then untied the left wrist, likewise coiling up the rope and throwing it out into the seance room. Bear in mind that all this was done while both hands of the medium were held visibly on the table by two separate controllers . . . who were tracing her arms to the shoulders to make sure these members really belonged to her! . . . her head was visible throughout."

Dr. Carrington sat silent a long time, thinking; finally he said: "Fraud was not possible. There were just too many hands."

## 800 Saved

### Spirit Voice at Sea

"TWO WORLDS" reports that Gibbons Bone, taking his first

night-watch as a young ship's officer, heard a voice telling him to change course. He thought it was imagination. Then he heard the voice again, and also saw a vision of his father. So he obeyed the instructions.

Afterwards, he realized that he

had saved the ship from being wrecked, and possibly the lives of 800 people on board.

You can scarcely blame him for becoming a Spiritualist, and a worker in the cause for more than 30 years.

## Reincarnation

### Julia Oswald

REINCARNATION stories keep cropping up. Here is one, from that thoughtful little philosophical journal "Manas," written by Heinz Kruschutzi, of Berlin.

"I spent an evening in the house of a friend, with 25 others, where I met a girl, Julie Oswald, a typical German name, but her countenance is Indian. She has worn a sari for several years."

"She performed Indian dances with absolute perfection; as I myself have been in India, I can say that the dances were authentic. Several of her dances were accompanied by singing, one in Urdu, one in Bengali, and one in Singha-lesse. Indian music is entirely different from our music . . . there are 12 tones in the 'octave,' instead of 8 . . . I remember very well having heard it in India. It is very difficult for a foreigner to learn Indian music; but Julie Oswald knew it perfectly."

"She has never been in India, in this life. At the age of six she began to learn Urdu; later she studied Hindu, Singha-lesse, Bengali, speaking all these, as well as English, fluently. She knows also a little Mahratti and Gujarati."

"Then she learned the Indian way to dance, and was subsequently examined by a famous Indian dancer, so that she now has a diploma as a temple dancer. The Indian dancer said that a talent such as Julia's is very rare, even in India, only about ten women in India having equal skill."

"Last year, Indian dancers from the Bombay opera performed in East Berlin. Julia fell in love with one of the Indian dancers, is going to marry him, and will perform with him in India."

"Having been in India, and having a keen interest in the Indian way of life, I talked all evening with her and her mother. She knows much more about India than myself, although she has never been there. I said to her mother that the only explanation for all this was that in a former life she had been in India. Her mother replied that she had never doubted it."

## Thought-Camera

### Mental Patterns

According to "Two Worlds," the Society of Metaphysicians, Hastings, Sussex, announce a new type of radionic camera, and photographic process, "whereby patterns appear on the developed films, which correspond to the thoughts of the operator."

They say: "the images gained vary from clear pictures of the object in the mind of the operator, and to which the camera is tuned, to oblique views of things allied with that object—such as a close-up of blades of grass, when a meadow was conceived."

It is further claimed that the process is sufficiently sensitive to permit everyone, who has so far tried the camera, to produce a thought-picture.
