Petroleum Springs in Germany.

If reports from Germany prove true, the Standard Oil Company may meet competition from an unexpected quarter. Rumors have been circulating for years of petroleum springs existing in the north of Germany and experimental borings have now proved their existence. It is said that the oil is now being pumped up in large quantities near Falze, in Hanover; a new well has been struck near Oelheim, in springing up, new companies are forming, and the sachages of the Fatherland are afflicted by a new "petroleum" disease. The locality of discovery is the district known as the Lonsberg Heide, a sterile moorland. The same has naturally caused, in a short time, the sensation all over Germany. It is already hoped that in the future the latter will be able not only to provide for her own wants from the Hanover springs, but also to export a good deal of petroleum. Germany has always been a large importer of American petroleum.
