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MORAL AND SPIRITUAL IMPLICATIONS OF SPACE CRAFT

The existence of these craft in our skies, and the fact that they have landed and had communication with earth people, is taken for granted in this article. To those who still have doubts about this, one can only say that this is due either to ignorance or lack of interest. Plenty of material has been made available to the public in the last five years to substantiate this. Part of our trouble lies in the spirit of man who disbelieves his fellow man, if the new truth does not coincide with his preconceived notions. - So, we go on to the moral and spiritual implications of these facts to us Earthians.

1. Scientifically, they are centuries ahead of us, for they have been visiting earth that long -- and we are only now coming to think of space flight as a practical realization. All phases of their science are perhaps correspondingly ahead of ours. We could learn much from them -- if it were not for our pride.

2. Pride stands in our way. Psychologically, a person with an inferiority complex often boasts, and thereby retards his own progress by an unwillingness to learn that which is beyond his present knowledge. As a race of inferior Earthians, we show the same signs. We are so busy boasting about the superiority of democracy or communism, about our atomic stockpiles and our plans to reach the moon, that we are unwilling to accept the fact that another race is 'way ahead of us -- and we thereby retard our own progress. In all phases of knowledge the intelligensia would 'lose face' by an admission of the superior knowledge of others. And they are not spiritually up to such an attitude of humility. The protection of position is more important to them than the advancement of the race.

3. Social revolution. These visiting craft are fused by a method not known on earth (according to analysis at several reputable universities). This means a new chemistry. They do not need to carry fuel. Think of the revolution in the oil industry. They are made of metals or alloys lighter than aluminum, and they have braved all the meteoritic storms we fear. This means a revolution in the steel industry -- and coal and electricity. With this revolution in industries, think what will happen to international banking and money-lenders. One can think of plenty of reasons for attempting to keep space craft information secret.

It would be better to have this revolution come slowly, so that not too many things would be upset. But we have precipitated the crisis ourselves. We have become such a cosmic nuisance with our electronics, atomic explosions and supersonic aircraft, that the revolution cannot

wait. The whole of our solar system, perhaps other systems as well, is at stake. "They" will see to it that the revolution comes - unless we change morally and spiritually, which would be a revolution in itself.

4. Brotherhood. The white man prates about brotherhood, but has hardly the faintest conception of how to practise it. These new visitors have not shown signs of violence except when attacked by our own belligerent militarists. If they had intended to invade for purposes of conquest, they could have done so long ago. They are evidently more benevolent than we are, probably watching over us like a guardian over little children. But the tables will soon be turned. Whites who cannot eat at a table with a negro or a chinese, will soon have to include in their thinking another race even less well-known to them. Only this time, they are the superiors, while the inferiors are ourselves.

5. Concept of Deity: The fatherhood of God and the brotherhood of man are terms understood in relation to each other. The higher the concept of one, the better will be the practical application of the other. A more mature application of "brotherhood" would seem to imply a superior knowledge of the Supreme Being.

Religious leaders are reminded that two world wars were fought largely by "Christian" nations, one of which took the moral initiative in exploding over civilian territory the first atomic bomb, which is now stirring up a cosmic reaction.

There are some 200 denominations of Protestantism, all based upon the same book, not to mention the proud Greek and Roman branches of the Church and the several other world religions. If more mature applications of brotherhood stem from a proper concept of Deity, it would seem we could learn much from a race that is trying to help rather than to conquer.

This is not to say that religion has failed. Who knows what this earth would be like without the Christ consciousness that has been revealed from time to time. It does mean, however, that religion is due for as great a change as science - a fact not realized by religious leaders who as yet are scarcely aware of the existence of space craft in our skies.

OTHER DIRECTIONS OF BORDERLAND RESEARCH

(John A. Hilliard, Regional Director BSRA.)

In addition to what we have been told by Assoc. E.S.Schultz and some others, there are fields beyond those of physical science into which Borderland Science legitimately extends. It also enters into and passes beyond political science, ethics, religion, and even economics and social science.

In the field of ethics or beyond it we may start with the simple idea of harmlessness (which we have in the Huna), and go on from there into regions known only to those who explore beyond the popular pattern of such thinking.

The Founding Fathers of our country were in all respects Borderland researchers. So also was Karl Marx - but what becomes of a researcher's findings after his time is another story. This incident of Communism shows us two things - that a researcher can be wrong, and that a wrong use can be made of his work. That, of course, is true of all fields of research.

A Borderland scientist is essentially a dreamer, a planner, and a creator. Many of his attempts must fail until he has ruled out every misdemeanor of the laws governing his research, and so brings his primary objective to success. He never accepts a successful achievement as an end, but only as one more step toward his further goal and as a widening of his horizons. And his achievements are not deemed failures because they are not generally accepted. The real failure of any project means only that there must exist in the Pattern some force or principle or law yet undetermined. And we must remember that others have explored these ways before us. The postulate of other civilizations greater than ours, such as the Etherian, implies that what is new to us may be primitive in the eyes of others.

Borderland science is concerned with the discovery of truths and not with the setting up of dogmas as a fence around a bit of knowledge. It is a search for better and simpler ways of life, and in this it must pass beyond the borders of established religions. All these have been overlaid by dogmas in the service of selfish interests. No other activity of man has resulted in so much exclusiveness and isolation. Beyond their borders, then, lies a field of research into simple and inclusive religious thought, rich and little explored.

'Orthodox' science does not have as its province the influencing of present political machinery, but Borderland science may well do so, since it is interested in arriving at more rational social and political structures. Here again, the direction is toward simplicity. And both religion and politics require a search beyond the borders of modern psychology - not simply to re-name old knowledge, but to find a better point of view and facts as yet undiscovered or unacceptable to present thinking.

When we find such facts let us put them on record and pass on in the light of them, to further work. The Builders will build right when the stone is cut true.

"CRYPTOGRAMS: WERE THEY BROADCAST? Interesting research covers wide area.

"Information has recently been disclosed concerning a set of cryptograms received in 1937, upon which the research work since carried out over a wide area seems to indicate that they may have been broadcast, at that time or later, to other circles. These cryptograms were received through a table at East Ham and purported to emanate from an entity calling itself "Books", later alleged to be Cardinal Newman.

"Some two years later a London researcher, Mr. H.S.W. Chibbett, was investigating with his colleagues two distinct and apparently unconnected cases - one of haunting at Catford, and the other concerning alleged extra terrestrial radio messages at Nunhead. Subsequent research indicated that both might link up with the original cryptograms, and Mr. Chibbett and his co-researchers have since managed to decipher some of the messages (or so they think).

"The work done up to now appears to have established the likelihood that an intelligent entity was responsible for the East Ham cryptograms, and that this entity may possibly have been the late Cardinal Newman. The cryptograms received are as follows:

Round Robin Release 10-A-51, T-13, p. 4, 2nd para., the Control YADA says ... "these are those who have lived on Mars and who have the "Martian Cross" in their eyes.

This particular sentence is of great interest to my collaborators and myself, because during the course of the above investigation we have had cause to speculate on the "marked eyes" of certain people.

You will remember that in Mr. Bird's article he referred to a New Zealand lady - a Mrs Jaxon. This lady, now deceased, was a most extraordinary person and among other things believed that there were or are living beings on Mars who are the reincarnated descendants of ancient Atlanteans and/or Egyptians. Whether this is so or not I cannot say, but it might be of interest to your readers if I give hereunder some of the data from our records.

For instance, the late Mrs Jaxon told Mr. Bird that the Martians were looking for certain people who were reincarnations of the original experimenters, and who could be known by a mark in their eyes; also that he, Mr. Bird, was one of them. (Altho he has never seen any such mark on himself, Mr. Bird says that occasionally, when out of doors, he has seen a small cross before his eyes, as if reflected from a mark inside the eye).

Mr. Bird asked Mrs. Jaxon whether she had any more information on this subject, and she replied: "With regard to the identification marks on the eye, the following may supply the answer to your question. Finding that I required a new pair of glasses, I consulted an expert oculist. After making a prolonged test of my eyes lasting over 30 minutes, the oculist said in a very abrupt and puzzled manner: "Have your eyes ever been injured in any way - there is something about them that I do not understand." I replied - "Not in this life." Mrs Jaxon further stated that a 'Marked Marzon' would be known on this earth by the marks on the iris, a test that no person could fake; and also by the measurements of his body, blood tests, electrical vibrations etc. All the above marks and tests must correspond with the Marzonic jewel outlined on the Zodiac of the Second Hermes, and also with the same outline on Mars.

On another occasion Mrs. Jaxon said: "The scientists of ancient Egypt and still older England - the word Egypt being merely a corruption of the Lancastrian words CE CHIPPED, meaning 'the marked eye' - took the most drastic and terrible precautions that the sacrificial brand should never be transmitted (?). According to paintings on the walls and ruins of Egypt showing the branding process, the vertebrae were severed and the body slit open from throat to abdomen while the person was still alive. Every scientific test was made and every measurement taken while the scientists watched the passing of the Ego, soul or ghost that dwells in all of us, on its 5000-year journey. As with a comet, they timed its reappearance on this planet and the marks by which it could be identified...."

Mr. Bird adds: "The nature of the mark I have observed (by reflection) in my left eye on several occasions, is a minute cross. It appears as a clear black impression like a rubber stamp. I have noticed it only when conditions of light were suitable."

When commenting on the above, Mr. Birchby mentioned the fact that Mrs Jaxon raised the matter of the 'marked eyes' in the first place, and that since she never met him in person, could not have known of the alleged mark in Mr. Bird's eye.

The symbol itself (the equi-arm vertical cross in a circle) appears to have a number of meanings. It has been known as the "astronomical cross of Egypt" and the "mundane cross". It has been alleged to represent "accomplished creation", while another authority says "the symbol is of the fundamental divine interplanetary language, and has the numerical value of 3. It means an individual creation, such as a planet, a solar system, or galaxy. I do not know any particular name for it. The names probably change with each fundamental language."

An astrologer states: "The symbol is that called the Part of Fortune in astrology, and not much used. It represents the earth, the cross of matter in the circle of spirit. Also known as the cross of sorrow. In FATE magazine, No. 1 p.11 it was stated: The FETE (☉) was a circle and an all light center, with four dark corners cut off. The meaning: there is a central light in man seeing clearly, but the four dark corners of the world - ignorance, lust, selfishness, and anger - beset him on all sides ... Ancient Egypt also knew the FETE, the circle and the true cross. Osiris said to Astoreth: "To thee I bestow the FETE, the circle and the true cross, to be thine forever."

In FORGOTTEN MYSTERIES, by Dewitt Miller, p. 103, the author states: "There was once a gigantic cross on the disc of Mars ... the cross was light colored and was centered in a dark circle whose diameter was approximately 900 miles..."

Finally, this symbol also appears to have some protective significance. I know of a medium who has this sign on her left shoulder, and in hypnotic experiments it has been used to get her out of difficulties.

It seems to us here that you and your readers, plus the Control YADA, may be able to throw further light on the foregoing, which is only one small facet of this absorbing case. I shall look forward with interest to any observations you or your readers may make.

MUMMIFICATION

by AUBER

The Mummies of Egypt are of common knowledge. The methods used for this mummification are also well known (total evisceration, use of aromatic and antiseptic substances, the enveloping of the corpse in a series of bandages, etc.)

This study concerns something different; to wit, the dehydration and prevention of putrefaction (i.e. the mummification) of meat and of fish, by human Vital Force, variously called ODYLE, animal magnetism, etc. Also the same phenomenon achieved by means of various other vibrations, or rays.

Many students of Radiesthesia in France and elsewhere achieve this mummification by holding, say, a piece of meat between their hands; or by subjecting the meat to certain rays--known as "ondes de forme"--derived from a wood or cardboard model of the great Pyramid of Egypt.

The writer knows of at least ten different kinds of rays (vibrations) which cause mummification.

The most simple method is that using ODYLE, the emanation from human hands. Holding a piece of freshly killed beef between the palms of the hands, for 10 minutes, thrice daily, the writer achieved mummification in 14 days. No putrefaction, no smell, the meat became as hard as wood but remains thus indefinitely, probably forever.

The most striking example of this phenomenon is provided in a pamphlet published at Bordeaux (France) in 1921. This concerns an anonymous lady, Madame X, who was not a medium and accepted no remuneration whatsoever. So strong was this lady's ODYLE that she never touched the objects, merely made passes with her hands over them, and thus mummified the meat, fish, fruit, flowers, birds, oysters, small animals, etc.

These extraordinary powers were scientifically investigated by various Bordeaux University professors, two of whom, a medical man and a chemist, carried out a series of tests in their own laboratories taking every possible precaution to eliminate fraud or deception. The gist of their report is:

"We do not understand, we do not explain, we only certify the facts." The report was confirmed by Dr. Gustave Geley, Director of L'institute Metapsychique International, in a lecture at Paris before the "Societe Universelle d'Etudes Psychiques" on 27 October 1912.

Dr. Geley said: "What normally happens when an organism, vegetable or mineral, dies? This organism is the prey of two natural tendencies which, curiously enough, are in opposition to each other.

"A--the first tendency is dehydration, dessication. The corpse, deprived of its usual supplies of water, carried to it by life, should become spontaneously dessicated, and mummified. This happens, sometimes, and would always occur, were it not for the intervention of its second natural tendency.

"B--this second natural tendency is putrefaction. Which is due to the infinitely small, to microbes. These microbes produce in the corpse a special fermentation: its organic matter is liquified, then transformed into gases. After which the putrefied organism disappears completely, except for mineral matter such as the skeleton.

"The normal putrefaction process is accelerated by parasites which thrive on dead matter. Among such parasites are the larvae of flies, and moulds.

"Thus, in nature, two opposed processes dispute, on, so to speak, organisms deprived of life; the one tending to dessicate on, to mummification and relative preservation; the other tending to putrefaction and total destruction.

"You see how difficult it is to preserve a corpse and to achieve the normal process of mummification. Nevertheless there is nothing mysterious about the process of dessication and mummification. It is a natural process, when putrefaction is arrested.

"As regards Madame X two questions arise: 1--what is the intricate process of the phenomenon? 2--what is the agent causing the process?

"In reply to '1': it seems certain that the action of Madame X is a sterilizing action which prevents or paralyzes microbic life and thus permits dessication. As for '2': the nature of the sterilizing agent, we are reduced to pure hypothesis. Is it magnetism? Is it an unknown human radio-activity? We know nothing about it. What is certain, is that Madame X emits an unknown energy, capable nevertheless of a powerful and deep organic action."

To which it is only necessary to add that even if putrefaction has begun, with microbes proliferating, the action of ODYLE will kill all microbes and stop all putrefaction.

So much for direct action, in situ so to speak. More phenomenal still is mummifying at a distance. The writer does this. While a friend, an Englishman then living in the south of France mummifies meat in distant Australia.

As mentioned above, there are many different rays or vibrations which effect mummification. The writer mummified new laid eggs; left them three months or so, in a drawer, not in a refrigerator; then ate them poached, fried, or omelette, all perfectly good and fresh tasting.

Which raises the frequent question; can one eat mummified meat or fish? The answer is yes. The mummified food should be soaked in running water, for 2 days, as with stockfish. Both meat and fish are a bit tough but quite good eating.

The late A. Bows of Nice (France) made some "magnetic plates" with which he effected mummification. These were mainly sold to missionaries working in Africa, which enabled them to preserve, for two or three days meat and fish which would normally stink in a few hours in the tropics.

The writer, in all his studies of vibrations uses pendulum and biometre. The biometre for measuring Wave lengths. Biometre degrees are

converted into angstrom units. The study of mummification by wave lengths reveals an interesting fact, which is here publicly disclosed for the first time.

The wave length of a piece of freshly killed beef is 110° (Biometrical degrees) approximately. During the mummification process, this wave length rises gradually to a maximum, then falls until, at a certain wave length, the process of mummification is complete.

Mummifying with ODYLE the wave length of beef rises from 110° to 700° . With "magnetic plates", from 110° to 3000° . With certain rays, from 110° to 5000° . In every case the wave length falls after reaching a certain maximum. The process necessary for complete mummification varies with the rays employed, from a few hours to several days. Here is the interesting fact: no matter how long the process, no matter how low (700°) or how high (5000°) the maximum wave length reached, the wave length always falls to 145° and stays there. Thus one knows exactly when mummification is complete.

Apart from the above processes of mummification, "artificial" so to speak, there exists in many places on Earth, what may be differentiated as a "natural" process of mummification. An example of this was found in the vaults beneath St. Michan's Church in Dublin (Ireland) where coffins containing corpses at least 150 years old were opened and revealed this:

"The extraordinary feature is the absence of decay; the bodies become mummified, the skin is like leather and the knee and other joints are still pliable. Even the features can be distinguished. There is no satisfactory explanation of this." (thus the explanatory leaflet)

The explanation is quite simple. Those vaults are irradiated by most powerful Ondes Nocives (Noxious rays) emanating from an underground stream of water. Similar Ondes Nocives can be produced "artificially" & are among the methods used by the writer for mummification.

Questions by interested readers of Round Robin addressed to the writer via the Round Robin editor, will be gladly answered. But the one great question is: What is official science doing? Is it studying mummification by ODYLE and by Rays? And if not, why not??

CONFIRMATORY DATA FROM OTHER SOURCES: Vide Nandor Fodor, Encyclopedia of Psychic Science; Art. Emanations, p. 126 ff. 'Certain French physicists published in 1912 the results of seven years investigations, which appear to prove the existence of a 'fluid emanation' from certain persons which prevents the decomposition of organic matter and preserves it in a dessicated state.' (The article runs to six columns and should be studied)

This power to 'mummify' or preserve organic material (food stuffs) might obviously be of great practical importance. Under questioning, the Mark P. Controls asserted (a) that the 'ray' is an actuality (b) it is to be found among the many diverse effects of emanations from the CONES - discussed in the next article in this issue. This opens an almost limitless field for private experiment and investigation.

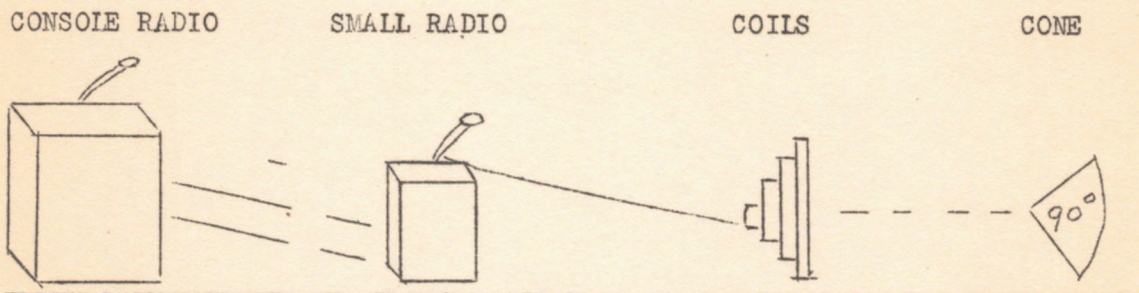
THE MYSTERY OF THE CONES AND COILS

- a) This may properly be called a new field of investigation, though it has many correlations in the expanding studies in radiesthesia. Further data will be found in a booklet now in preparation dealing with the Cameron aurameter. It is, in fact, a direct outcome of aurameter experiments. The summary to follow is doubtless premature in many respects, but it is offered in the hope that Associates using either the Wallace ZNO, the pendulum, or the aurameter will make individual investigations and report the results.
- b) All of these devices indicate, in the hands of experienced operators up to this time, the existence of a ray or beam of energy emanating from the tip of a cone, and also from the center of a flat non-activated coil, having no core but wound upon itself with an interlayer of insulating material. The cone may be of any material, so far as is now known - but it is believed that the nature of the ray is conditioned by the material chosen. The ray also issues, though faintly, from the tip of a solid cone of one material, and more strongly if the solid cone is surfaced with tin or aluminum foil. It can be detected above the tip of either a square or triangular pyramid.
- c) The strongest indications, however, are found above the tip of a hollow metal cone (Al, Zn, Fe); and the size and angle of the cone conditions the shape of the ray. An acute-angle cone tends to disperse the ray, an obtuse angle appears to concentrate it to a point. The right-angle cone (which fits inside a carpenter's square) projects a beam of uniform shape and size which may be followed for a considerable distance. This last shape is the one recommended for these preliminary investigations. A cardboard cone coated with aluminum or tin foil, on the outside, the inside, or on both surfaces, is satisfactory for experimentation. Cones used by Verne Cameron up to date have a spread at the wide end of about 2 ft., but much smaller ones can be used, especially if the 90 deg. angle is maintained.
- d) The phenomenon does not appear to be electrical in the ordinary meaning of that term - partly for the following reason: an all-metal binding post (a short bolt will do) can be inserted into the tip of the cone, so as to be in contact with both the inside and outside metallic surfaces, thus offering a complete electrical connection; nevertheless the ray or energy flow can be led off along a wire, from the tip of one cone to the interior surface of another (i.e., leading into the wide end of the second cone and attached to the binding post on the inside of the second). From the outside end of the binding post another wire can be led to the inside of a third, and so on, in a kind of series arrangement. The energy flow can then be detected at the loose end of the wire from the last cone set up in the series.
- e) No instrument except the aurameter, the ZNO, and the pendulum has yet been found which will register this energy flow. It is true that

Edison used a device, and others now exist, capable of registering very minute fluctuations of "heat", but careful reflection on these indicates that some type of energy other than heat is involved. The best objective demonstration of the existence of the 'cone ray', up to the present, is found in the following experiment, devised by Verne L. Cameron (inventor of the aurameter):

f) (Original experiment):

A console radio was tuned in with a small one-tube regenerative set (about 50 ft. apart), set to hum at about 800 kilocycles, so that a "squeal" set up in the small set would be amplified in the larger. The antenna of the small radio was wired to the center of a set of four non-activated coils, set on edge. A few feet behind the coils, a 90 deg. cone was set on edge, with its tip aimed at the center of the coils.



If the experimenter passes his arm or leg between the cone and the coil, the squeal rises and falls as the cone-ray is intercepted.

If the cone is turned away, at right angles, no effect is produced by passing between it and the coil. If the cone is removed entirely the squeal is not produced or modified by similar motions behind the coil.

In the above, a headphone was used, plugged into the plate circuit of the small radio.

A simplified and preferable set-up is as follows: (1) Eliminate the console, which is used only to amplify the "squeal", and use headphone connected as mentioned. (2) In place of the set of four coils bolted together thru the centers, use either a single coil or (preferably) another cone. In this case, connect the tip of the cone just mentioned to the antenna of the small radio (just as the coil was connected).

(NOTE: The coils shown in the diagram were 20" - 12" - 9" - 6" in diameter, respectively. Since their effect seems identical with that of a cone, and their use introduces various difficulties, the cone is recommended in their place. They are mentioned here "for the record". The simplified set-up contains only the small radio, the headphones, and the two cones. (The question of "body capacity" has been fully considered in this experiment).

g) The experiment described seems to show that some kind of energy flow is given off from the tip of the cone. As has been said, the aurameter reacts strongly to it, and also shows that the ray is reflected by a mirror with the angles of incidence and reflection equal. The reflected beam can be caught by another mirror and redirected upon the originating cone, so that something like a cyclotron effect is obtained. In this case, however, there is a kind of leakage of divergent rays, which may indicate an increase of energy which the cone does not absorb.

h) The phenomenon is believed to be etheric and magnetic, probably very complex, and probably varying according to the material of the cone, its angle, and other obscure conditions.

i) There is reason to believe that the force issuing from the cone has physiological effects and therapeutic values, when rightly selected and applied. Experiments along this line should be conducted cautiously.

j) A wire from a triangle of cones was covered with earth and beans planted above it, with a control row about 10 ft. distant - care being taken to have water, soil and other growing conditions as much alike as possible. The beans above the wire either did not grow at all or were badly delayed and stunted.

The ray from aluminum coated cardboard cones does not inhibit the growth of mucor (bread mould).

It may be that effects upon organic material will give a clue to the study of this force. Experiments should be conducted by focusing rays from obtuse and right-angle cones for fairly long periods, upon infusions of organic stuffs, also upon germinating seeds of various kinds.

k) However valid the evidence of the aurameter, the ZNO and the pendulum may appear to those skilled in their use, it is obvious that we must have valid objective and instrumental evidence of the existence of this ray or energy if it is to receive attention in 'orthodox' scientific quarters - evidence derived from other sources than the devices mentioned.

l) For readers interested in psychic methods of investigation, I shall add that the trance controls of Mark Probert assert that the 'ray' from the cones is a reality. They also say (if I understand them correctly) that the cone itself does not truly generate any energy, but that its shape causes or/and conditions a magnetic or etheric flow. That we can speak of the energy as coming from the air if we wish, but this in turn implies the ethers as originating source. That the "electric eye" device might possibly register the presence of this ray. Professor Twining (Control) asserts that no increase in effect would be obtained by concentrating the rays from several obtuse-angle cones onto a given point, since "such is the nature of the etheric energy involved. This last statement conflicts with what seems to be contrary evidence at the present time.

BSR Associate Joseph J. Dochowski, of 4820 Darrah St., Philadelphia 24, Penna., has recently made inquiries by means of the pendulum and has sent the results to Verne Cameron, discoverer of the cone effect. At Mr. Cameron's request we print a condensed statement of these, along with Assoc. Cameron's own very brief comments:

Comments of Assoc.

"In my more lucid moments I made some tests on the cones and send the results for what they are worth. I made three cones of Aluminum foil, connected with #30 copper wire. They measure 8" across the base with a 5" altitude, and are spaced in an equilateral triangle with 12" sides, con-

nected in a complete circle to which a lead wire is attached near the apex of one of the cones. The presence of the ray was indicated by the pendulum when the end of the lead wire pointed to the pendulum. The ray was picked up when the string length was 5". The following questions were put to the pendulum and the answers were as given below:

ANSWERS: (1) The ray is not collected from the earth, air, planets, or from outside the solar system (2) It is not the cosmic ray as we know it (3) It does not come from the spirit world (4) It is not similar to mana (5) It is not harmful to human beings (6) It is not electric or magnetic (7) The nature of the ray is unknown to us (8) The ray is generated by the cones. This I take to mean that the ray has no objective reality, being brought into existence by the particular arrangement of the cones.

COMMENTS BY V.L.C. on the above answers: Ans.(1) I believe the ray is from the ether, which is everywhere present (2) True - it is a slower wave. (3) True, in my opinion. (4) Not the same as mana, but close. (5) True - so far as we now know. (6) Near (closely resembles) (7) True. (8) No. It is accumulated or converted. The cones do not need to be arranged. Many shapes of metallic surfaces accumulate these rays.

ANSWERS: Con. (9) It is not the di-electric or bio-cosmic energy of Dr. Brunler (10) It has pressure and volume analagous to voltage and amperage (11) Larger cones do not generate greater pressure or volume. (12) A greater number of cones does not generate more pressure or volume. (13) The cones generate the ray from the earth's magnetic current. (14) The ray does not come from heat in the earth (15) The cones thus arranged and connected set in motion some latent energy of the atmosphere. But more so from the energy in the earth itself. (16) Cones moving in rotary motion will not increase pressure or volume. (17) Cones spaced farther apart (in my experiment) will increase volume and pressure (18) Strength or intensity of my cones registered 130 on a scale of 0-300 (19) The ray responds to color vibration ultra-violet (I presume) but is zero negative for red and yellow.

COMMENTS BY V.L.C. (9) Not sure. (10) If so - and I agree - more cones will increase volume. (11) & (12) Wrong. (13) Perhaps (14) right (15) Yes (16) Don't know (17) Yes (18) Yes (19) Yes - also infra-red.

Further statements by J.J.D. - Single cones do not generate the ray (Comment by Ed., ML: this contradicts all experience here). -- Cones colored red are not good -- Copper tubing is better than wire -- Al tubing is better than Cu -- Steel gives a different ray -- Al cones will cure some ailments -- Gold and silver leaf are not too expensive for experiments.

BACK TO THE FUTURE WITH SOLAR POWER

by Mrs. H. M. Graham

Dr. James Conant of Harvard has recently predicted that not atomic power but solar power will be the energy of the future.

Two news items of recent date reveal this trend. One relates to a request made by the Smithsonian for \$102,751 from the present Congress to carry forward the experiments of Dr. Chas. G. Abbot, pioneer in solar radiation. Dr. Abbot has two devices which he says will produce 1,000,000 horsepower per square mile. In our Southwest deserts there is an area of 150,000 square miles where skies are cloudless 70 to 90% of the time, providing the ideal location for giant mirrors to convert sunlight into power, and (says Dr. Abbot) these mirrors could produce twenty times as much power as is now used for all heating and lighting in the United States.

Dr. Conant was also referring to the revolutionary new discovery made by three scientists of the National Institute of Health. Basing their work on that of the German Nobel prize-winner, Dr. Emil Warburg, they have discovered the secret of sunlight and are growing food from light, water, carbon dioxide and one-celled algae. Such growing of food promises the alleviation of starvation in over-populated areas, and could also produce hydrogen gas in unlimited amounts. The great deserts of the world may become great industrial areas.

All this when tied in with Edgar Cayce's trance pronouncements on Atlantis provokes thought as to what the future may hold. On Atlantis progress came step by step, then as now--"first sound, then light,--first radio, then video. The Atlantean used crystals to focus certain sun rays and then transmit this type of power. Atlanteans knew atomic power and had elevations for the overcoming of gravity, also devices for reading inscriptions through walls even at a distance". According to these trance-records many Atlanteans are reincarnated today; hence, the Atlantean pattern is being repeated.

We do not know what Dr. Abbot's giant mirror devices are like but in an article entitled THE LOST CONTINENT OF ATLANTIS (Searchlight, May 1-15, 1951; Association for Research and Enlightenment; Virginia Beach, Va., \$.25) you can read about the great "firestone" of Atlantis. A large glass cylinder cut with facets, housed in a dome that folded back, and that was as heavily insulated as is radioactive material today, the great "firestone" of Atlantis concentrated the energies of sun and star rays and converted them to act on instruments, the vibrations of which were tuned to maneuver various modes of travel by remote control--guiding aircraft, and submarines as well as pleasure vehicles. These vibrations tuned, unintentionally, too high brought on land upheavals--"the mighty, the terrible crystal--for when the facets were prepared for the harnessing of motive forces upon ships and other consumers of electrical forces, these forces when turned upon the earth caused the first upheavals." The "firestone" energies could also destroy or regenerate a human being.

Dr. Abbot of the Smithsonian may be at the fringe of great new discoveries that will open a new era.

"THE PROCESSION OF THE DAMNED"

(Our page title, as all BSR Associates will recognize, is from Charles Fort. By the "Damned" he meant the multitude of facts disregarded, speciously "explained", outlawed and condemned by official and orthodox science - that is, by scientism though never by any true scientist. But this Procession of the Impossible has now become impossible, either to ignore, or to more than hint at in the space here available).

Abstracts from notes of BSRA Regional Director DON GREEN:

- a) 'An engineer from an aircraft plant, personally known to me, and engaged with others in observing aircraft performance over the desert, observed two 'daylight stars' which behaved as no real star should, by moving in slow arcs toward the horizon. He told me this: "I don't pretend to say what these things are or are not - but the boys out here have seen them spiral around a guided missile with ease, till apparently satisfied that it was of no interest to them, then veer off and disappear." Now, just how fast would that be? Will some engineer Associate tell us? And what does he mean, by attributing intelligent action to these "stars" or "spots before his eyes" - or hallucinations that four engineers have at the same moment?
- b) The "Flying Hub Cap" - this object above the skyline and shown in the insert is, according to Guy B. Marquand, Jr., a flying saucer. He and two friends saw the object while on a mountain road near Riverside, Calif. He says the 'thing' flew by once and on its second pass he made the photograph (NEA Telephoto. Ats. Ana Register, 11-23-51).
- c) 'The picture is badly distorted ... but the maddening part of this vocation is, that there is nothing to pick up and carry on with. All we can do is guess and wait... I have written two columnists and four artists. Sent them stuff that would steam up an ordinary moron, self-addressed stamped envelopes - not even the consideration of a reply. What kind of bug has bitten these fellows? . . .
- d) (I think, frater Green, it's the Fear Bug - fear of the derision of fools, of losing jobs and salaries, then of the Thing itself, plus inability to say anything intelligent - fear of admitting even the existence of the unexplainable - sometimes intimidation by certain powers that be. Even stranger than this planetary visitation itself is the tremulous folly, that the thing you refuse to see, to hear, to admit, is therefore abolished, flung back demonwise into the abyss it issued from. Cool heads and understanding minds - not in 5000 years at least has there been an equal need for them. ML)
- e) Unidentified burning object falls into the sea near shore - but others who should have seen it, did not. (There has often been a con-

fusing element about sightings and falls, as well as about aerial concussions. At San Diego recently people on each side of same street said it came from the "other side" - but one woman thought it was in her cellar. We could fill up the rest of RR with a maybeso explanation of this oddity - If - But - ... etc. ML)

f) U.S. weather bureau at Denver says, "fireballs" may be vapor trails of B-36 bombers. Dr. La Paz, University of New Mexico, promptly put a spike in that twaddle. Assoc. Green visited the Arizona-New Mexico area recently, interviewed various people, also puts a spike and several ten-penny nails into the same "explanation". (ML)

g) About the explosions in the San Diego area, night of Jan. 4, '52 -- there were three of these, at 8:30 - 9:44 - 10:40, apparently spaced out within ten miles of each other, but opinions vary widely as to location. Made "a good sharp mark" on the Point Loma seismograph and was described as "a tremendous blast". Many people said the concussion "seemed to have a downward pressure and many said it was the severest explosion they had ever heard" (S.D. Union, 1-5-52). The usual "explanation" about diving jet planes has since been offered - but there is no record of any jets being aloft at that time.

h) It's generally known now that diving jets do produce an atmospheric shock wave on pulling out, and that this wave may bounce, but (1) there have been numerous cases of such concussions where no jets were aloft, at least for a great distance, (2) It is almost certain that what is involved here is not merely atmospheric concussion, but a release of etheric pressures, or a disturbance of them, which in turn produces atmospheric effects. It is also acceptable, even (now) to many 'orthodox' physicists, that earthquakes are primarily ether-quakes (which release interior pressures of the globe) -- and this reminds us that we are doing our little best to raise Nell with the others (atomic fission and super-sonics) -- which reminds us that the Etheric peoples are said to be considerably annoyed -- and that, to quote Nikola Tesla not long since - "When a man is persecuted beyond a certain point, he will take steps, by gad, sir - he will take steps!" (ML)

i) That TUCUMARI (N.M.) water tank business. Something hit it, released 750,000 gallons of water, which demolished 20 buildings, scattered sheet steel in all directions - but the break-line showed a nice clean cut. A solitary sleepless witness says a ball of fire hit it. Others heard "a strong wind with lightning. Assoc. E.S.S. writes us about this:

"If in lieu of an Etherian fireball the tank was hit by a meteor made of contra-terrence matter ("matter inside-out") the wonder would be that the havoc was not greater, as the contact would produce an explosion of atobomb force. A pea-sized chunk of such matter might just about wreck the damage shown in the press clips... There will be more phenomena, explosions and fires etc. The fat over-paid metaphysical simpletons of the Pentagonian wilds would do well to forget some of their sabotage theories and really study what it's all about, or else consult with those who are doing such research."

j) Our own news from the Neant (not infallible but the best we know about) tells us that many of the so-called fireballs are viewing devices, or recording devices under remote control which report all kinds of earth conditions and data to the Etherian observers. They disintegrate at the end of their flight but the information is picked up by some variant of radio-reception. -- Also, that if necessary the Etherians will put on a simulated attack, in a final attempt to wake up dim-witted earthians and teach us some of the "facts of life".

No one can say in just what way such a campaign might develop, but a few preliminary attacks on huge water tanks, dams and power projects might be in order, to give us a taste of their quality and head off the sabotage notion.

k) Recurring to Tucumari-tank business: 'A scientific team from the University of New Mexico, headed by Dr. Lincoln LaPaz, investigated the fireball theory. Dr. La Paz at first inclined toward this, said it was certain some kind of fireball was seen, but that the important question was whether it was a green one or not. But then he gave up the idea, account of not being able to find any meteor fragments. Well, the kind of meteor we have in mind doesn't leave any fragments - and maybe Dr. La Paz knows about them too but is much too smart to admit it. (Credit Assoc. Don Green for data of this paragraph).

Prediction for
Northeast U.S.

This area has been somewhat neglected by merchants of disaster, but now comes Prof. C. Wroe Wolfe, Boston University geologist, warning the N.E. States to prepare for a major earthquake, which may occur "any time." That leaves a good deal of latitude, however - and the reasons he lists are not very convincing. As Assoc. ESS points out in sending us the clip, the writers R. & I. Ingalese made a similar prediction for the "Eastern States" nearly 50 years ago. There's no doubt about disturbed seismic conditions in nearly all parts of the globe, but when it comes to time-and-place predictions I have as much or as little confidence in geophysicists and their ilk as in the prophesying ghosties. If you really want to know who's right or wrong there's only one infallible method - stick around and see - if you can stand it long enough.

**LATEST NEWS ON THE
KOCH TREATMENT**

A Voice from the Gallery, Ralph M. Holland, Editor, Interim Letter #2 (Dec. 1951) prints the following, "Gathered mainly from the recent convention of the Christian Medical League, which controls the distribution of glyoxide."

"Dr Koch is still in Brasil, doing reseacgh work on various jungle diseases, indier the sponsorship of the Brazilian government. Other nations are aware of the value of his work, even if the U.S. is not. In the U.S. however, the treatment is gaining popularity among practising physicianx and new doctors are being added to the list daily. Older ones have set up new standards of practise, and attempts are being made to bring all those who use the treatment up to standard.

"A new medical association has been set up: The American Association of Physicians. It is not directly connected with the Koch treatment, but is composed mainly of doctors who use it when a case indicates its use. It is doing very valuable work in bringing the truth about the treatment to the medical profession on a technical level. Dr. J.S. Schirmer, of Corning, Arkansas, is its first president.

"Twenty-eight cattle projects were carried out in 17 states during the year. Stockmen's associations and farm groups were amazed at the uniform success of the treatment, which is now recognized in many places as the standard cure for mastitis, Bang's Disease, and many other serious bovine diseases."

(NOTE: This same 'amazing success' is a matter of official record more than 20 years back, especially among Canadian stockmen - along with its almost miraculous cures of cancer and various 'allied allergies'.
