LET'S BE FANTASTIC

This is a hit-and-run article, sans literary grace, about aurameters* and etheric objects, and thought-forms and teleportation, and the ethers and the flying Discs and what-have-you. "A" stands for Aurameter, so we begin where it seems proper; but afterward mix everything up as seems most improper. The Aurameter is a lately devised gadget intended primarily for water dowsing, but which turns out to have far more important properties - such as, for example, locating and outlining objects which can't be seen.

"Thoughts are things" is the sleepest of bromides. Every spiritist and occultist is born with that spoon in his mouth whether he knows it or not. But just what, if you please, do you mean by a "thing"? In common use a thing is an object, and an object is objective, visible, and usually tangible. But since thoughts and feelings are not of this sort, how can they be called things? Obviously and QED, such talk is all mystical moonshine.

But now, suppose I visualize a milk bottle on one end of a table, a large cube on the other, and a solid brick wall across one end of the room. Then suppose some one experienced in the use of this gadget comes in and locates these mental images by feeling around with it, somewhat as a dowser does with a forked stick or a pendulum. Has the thought-form, the mental image taken on "thingness", or has it not?

Elaborate and repeated experiments show that this feat can actually be performed. Make a mind image, place it definitely in space, and the Aurameter can find it. Touch one book in a row of 50, and the instrument will pick out the right one. We suggest, there is "something there", just as real and objective as any visible brick or box or bottle could possibly be. We suggest, the burden of explanation is now on the sceptic. Let him explain what is happening, and he had better make it good.

But to go on from there - since we have no space here to battle with straw men.

I put an imaginary milk bottle on the table in front of me, and the aurameter man can find it. But it's just as easy and as quick for me to put it in another room, another house, another block or city distant. I can put it anywhere I want to, provided I can visualize enough of the background, and distance makes no difference at all, per se. If my friend in Calcutta has an Aurameter and can use it, and I steadfastly visualize a black cat or a bronze Buddha in his library, and if he knows where and when to look for the something I am sending, he will be able to find it and describe its outlines.

Now, this is the projection of an image, and an image or thought - is evidently a reality. That is, it has a material existence, although the matter it is made of happens to be invisible, and untouchable by our unaided hands. It is, if you please, what we call an existent in etheric matter. If you poke the positive pole of a magnet into the positive field of another magnet, you feel a strong repulsion, the push-away of like polarities. The magnetic field is an invisible, tangible entity composed of etheric stresses, but no one thinks of denying its existence. The thought form seems to have the same kind of existence, and the resistance it offers to the aurameter bob feels to the hand exactly the same as that exerted by the magnet. But before the invention of the aurameter we had no instrument (except possibly the pendulum) for measuring it.

Otherwise stated, a thought image is an etheric construct made by the operation of mind-energy on the ethers. If you don't believe in the ethers, or in the 'energetic' character of thought, go ahead and make your own interpretation - only, please do not fail to explain just what it is the aurameter finds and how it finds it.

In other words, try to 'save' the phenomena - or, don't throw out the baby along with the bath water.

Our assumption and information and reasonable belief is, that etheric matter exists everywhere, and that there is an infinite series of ethers of increasing density, and that all of them are particulate in structure, and consequently interpenetrate * Our so-called dense matter is really (comparitively) a rarefaction, and the enormously dense ethers pass through it like wind through a mesh with huge interstices. That makes good science and good metaphysics, once you stop to think about it - as most people will not do.

If, as is highly believable, there are etheric beings living in etheric worlds, their bodies and worlds and all that is in them will be far more dense than ours, the component particles will be thousands or millions of times smaller than our atoms and electrons, and consequently the etheric matter will be responsive to the more subtle forms of energy, that is, to thought energy. And if I visualize a pumpkin, I create said pumpkin in etheric matter, but it's out of my plane of visual perception. If I were in an etheric body I would be able to see it, and I could send it by my thought energy to any place I chose. And if I wanted to construct a flying disc, I would first think it into existence and then spot the etheric creation anywhere I wished.

It's our information and belief, that most of our space visitors get here in just that way. It is not a problem of constructing a craft out of materials known to us as matter, and have it capable of flying across space and withstanding the conditions of space flight. The craft

is first built out of enormously dense etheric matter, by thinking it into form; and this etheric form is 'teleported' or 'spotted' along with its crew into the upper regions of the earth's atmosphere - the 'trip' of course taking no time at all. Within the earth's gravitational field the vibratory rates of the etheric matter are converted into the slower rates of our earth matter, and then the craft becomes visible and tangible to us. If it is true that we now have many visitors even from 'beyond the galaxies', hundreds and even thousands of light years distant, it must be plain that they do not get here in any craft made of earth-substances and travelling at any speed we have even conjectured, and that they do not 'cross space' at all in our sense of the words.

All this kind of thinking clicks well enough with both ancient and modern metaphysics, and also with much contemporary speculative science.

It was talking about the aurameter that got us into all this - for the obvious reason that we now have, for the first time, a 'gadget' which will show the material presence of an ether-form, or thought form. Our vasty ignorance of the whole concept of the ethers, is a kind of black hole of Calcutta for the western mind. We're gadget-minded and want to see something move, or hear something click, or read numbers on a scale before we think a 'thing' is 'real'. If the aurameter should be studied enough so that its evidence gets through the first layer of western ignorance and stupidity, it will be rated as 20th century achievement No.1.

It's still bad form, of course, to so much as mention radiesthesia in 'orthodox' and official scientific circles - and the aurameter comes under that classification, as a radi-sensitive device, and so will be rated even lower than the pendule, the former ne plus ultra of childishness. But what is the twaddle of today is often the gospel of tomorrow.

This aurameter also suggests the possibility of mental communication on this plane by etheric images and symbols. It is also revealing many unknown rays, waves, vibrations - for instance, an energy stream given off from the tips of cones. It's going to intrude into the field of psychometry and pendulum analysis generally - and it also tells us more about the human aura than is found in all the books. It is, in short, one fine notable ray of light into the black hole we just spoke about - our western ignorance of the etheric worlds and peoples.

The point is sometimes raised, that if (say) a Venusian Etherian wants to visit Terra (for to see but not to admire) he doesn't need to think up a disc or a mile-long space ship to travel in. His body is made of etheric matter, and it responds to his will, and all he has to do is to think himself even into the most secret places of our world - and there he is. We are informed that this is quite true, leaving aside various if's and but's. But let us suppose that he wants to make observations and records, use instruments, maybe offset bad radiation effects, needs active cooperation by other Etherian scientists. It seems natural that he, or they, should prefer to create discs or other craft, load them with the required apparatus, transfer the whole by teleportation to some region close to the earth, and then convert to our vibration rate and so come into our field of perception.

All this is very crude and sketchy, no doubt, and sounds like amateurish scientifiiction; yet I think that basically it is reasonable and plausible and fits in with the known data.

There has been a good deal of twaddle in the newspapers during the last few months, about a 'revival' of the 'obsolete' ether theory, particularly by an English scientist. But the ether concept has never been discarded. Einstein, Jeans, Eddington and many others have said so explicitly. Consider the following quotations from Eddington:

Thirty years ago there was much debate over the question of ether-drag - whether the earth moving round the sun drags the ether with it. At that time the solidity of the atom was unquestioned, and it was difficult to believe that matter could push its way through the ether without disturbing it. It was surprising and perplexing to find as the result of experiments that no convection of the ether occurred. But we now realize that the ether can slip through the atoms as easily as through the solar system, and our expectation is all the other way . . .

(That velocity through the ether is meaningless) does not mean that the ether is abolished. We need an ether. The physical world is not to be analyzed into isolated particles of matter or electricity with featureless interspace. We have to attribute as much character to the interspace as to the particles, and quite an army of symbols is required to describe what is going on in the interspace. We postulate ether to bear the characters of the interspace as we postulate matter or electricity to bear the characters of the particles ...

In the last century it was widely believed that ether was a kind of matter, having properties such as mass, rigidity, motion, like ordinary matter... This ceased to be the orthodox view some years before the advent of the relativity theory. Logically it was abandoned by the 19th century investigators who regarded matter as vortices, knots, squirts etc., in the ether; for clearly they could not suppose that ether consisted of vortices in the ether. But it may not be safe to assume that the authorities in question were logical.

Nowadays it is agreed that ether is not a kind of matter.* Be-non-material, its properties are sui generis. We must determine them by experiment; and since we have no ground for any preconception the experimental conclusions can be accepted without surprise. Mass and rigidity such as we meet with in matter will naturally be absent in ether; but the ether will have new and definite characters of its own. In a material ocean we can say that a particular particle of water which was here a few moments ago is now over there; there is no corresponding assertion that can be made about the ether. If you have been thinking of the ether in a way which takes for granted this property of permanent identification of its particles, you must revise your conception ... The ether itself is as much to the fore as it ever

was, in our present scheme of the world. But velocity through the ether... (is meaningless). (Nature of the Physical World, pp. 3,30,31,32)

Since the passages quoted were written subsequent to the advent of the relativity theory (and in view of later utterances by Einstein and others), the assertion that the concept of the ether has been discarded is absurd. There is, however, a matter of semantics involved in the last paragraph quoted from Eddington. He is unwilling to describe the ether as matter, since it does not possess the characters of matter as we know it - mass, rigidity etc. This is a question of definitions. If the ethers possess enormous density and consist of extremely small particles in extremely rapid motion, then their mass and rigidity will lie outside the range of our instruments - hence, by definition, we can say they are not "matter". The point is obvious and not worth laboring, except that Eddington takes a needless plunge into mysticism by postulating a necessary but characterless X to equate with the interspaces. Incidentally, it does us no good to merely substitute the term space for ether, unless space be itself a substance or stuff and not mere nothingness - which is a flatus vocis and not a concept at all.

We began by talking about the aurameter because its performances make us realize that etheric bodies are 'real' in a material sense, in the same way that a magnetic field is 'real'; and the quotations from Eddington show that the ether is very much of a 'reality' to the physicist, whether he calls it matter or non-matter or space or an X which can neither be kept out of his equations nor evaluated. The importance of the whole matter, for the 'average man' at least, is that unless he can somehow integrate the reality of the etheric worlds into his own thinking, he will never understand a host of remarkable phenomena now occurring on our own plane of existence. Precisely because of this lack of understanding, we are in grave danger of a period of public panic and world-wide confusion.

This danger is not merely a matter of being scared witless by "fireballs" and "discs" and nameless flaming monsters of the skies. It is a most ancient and rational occult teaching, that all the life of our world, and all 'material' objects, and the whole of Nature as known to us, originated in the etheric worlds - the true homeland of the human race. Furthermore, it is the personal conviction of many of us that probably the only hope for humanity now lies in friendly contact and cooperation with the etheric peoples, many of whom are, we now believe, incarnate humans operating from etheric rather than astral levels.

For the last five years we have been saying things similar to this, and other and wiser folk have been saying it all down the course of human history. We do not keep repeating them in any hope of 'enlightening humanity', but only by way of making a kind of gesture which may call the attention of a few, who may then proceed as they will, each on his own path of understanding.

In view of our reference to Natalli (note to page 2) we may be.

permitted to introduce a quotation from him. Natalli is a 16th century astronomer who has long been communicating through the deep-trance mediumship of Mark Probert. (This medium, by the way, has almost no knowledge of technical and scientific subjects). The Natalli Control stated, early in March 1952 -

"If we look at densities as blending slowly we arrive at a density which will be to all intents homogeneous" (i.e., by successive division of the constituent particles of matter). "But this is not really the case. By basing on the quantum theory each state is periodical - a period behaviour of the atoms. This period state can only be conceived of by thinking in this manner. The action of the atom in each grade of density is not a stable condition, but rather a kind of blinking, in lawful sequence. In each passing fraction of time there is a different form of motion. Action taking place in one density will cause another form of action in another density. It is this action which creates what you call form.

"Now, we wonder where the atom is, in the fraction of time when it is not in action. There is a time vacuum existing between the period states of motion. We have a cause-and-effect in play and spanning the gulf of the time interval. There is a stream of force passing between the two densities. Due to the fact that we cannot ever get to a state of nothingness (by successive divisions) the field between the time intervals we may call a play going on between the two - between the proton and the neutron. They exchange energies until there is a kind of absorption of one of them. Both are sending off energy, and the energy of one is picked up by other bodies. You have a complete breakdown of the atomic body, and it pours itself across this time vacuum into another dimension, where in forming an atomic structure it is moving at a different rate of speed. It may lose or gain electronic bodies in the new dimension and will create a web-like structure with other atoms to form a solid.

"The time vacuum lies in the exchange of neutron and proton in which one of these has absorbed the energy of the other. In that moment you have a time vacuum . . .

"The fractions of time are not really as we perceive them; the motion is so fast that we cannot make any estimate. But there is a pause in this time field that is a complete nothingness. This is basically a heat action and could be thought of according to a dimension of time as a magnetic or electromagnetic field according to the time interval between. We can say that it is magnetic or electrical or electro-magnetic, or that it is pure heat, depending largely on its use in any particular dimension of time. A passing point that is without atomic structure. The atom pours itself out into another dimension of time, across the time field. This is space-time, or a space vacuum between the nucleus and the electron."

* Though somewhat aside from the chief concern of this article, we add a philosophical suggestion of extreme importance. In the application of the quantum theory to psychology, to mind-as-energy, we have for the first time a satisfactory solution of the difficulty known as solipsism. ML.

SPACE SHIPS SEEN BY ME at Cluan Ard, Paso Robles Road & 2nd St., Oceano, California, August 1, 1949 - about 2:00 p.m. -- There passed over my garden, flying low and going slowly, the most beautiful 'airplane' made of a metal whiter and brighter than silver. It has no wings and was thicker near the head than a medium sized plane. It had no engines on either side of its head. Travelling north.

Also at Cluan Ard: On September 9, 1949 -- a similar 'airplane' high up and flying fast, with no wings visible. at 2:30 p.m. Travelling north.

On October 9, 1949, a bright wingless plane passed over my garden, flying south.

On Nov. 3, 1949, a large plane very bright, with big wings, made of the same bright metal, flying north.

In 1950 (no memo of exact date), a plane of dark blue metal, with short square wings and carrying a construction of some kind on its back; the tail was split in two long parts with discs at the ends (Noted for the record only - but most unusual in appearance).

In 1950 - a large globe flying high and southward; it seemed to be made of the same very bright silverlike metal. It made no sound and at times seemed to float like a bubble.

October 19, 1951. Two long silver aircraft, then four, then finally a lone one. They made no sound and seemed to float in the air slowly. They were so bright, it was difficult to see their exact shape, but they were not globe-shaped. They may have been thick-set planes without wings but I think not. They came from the southwest and continued north.

Nov. 24, 1951. A beautiful 'plane' passed overhead going southward. Same silver-bright metal and shaped like a plane but on the under side of the wings there were three structures of equal size across the width of each wing, taking up the entire under-wing space but not projecting before or behind the wing blades. Beautifully proportioned and shining like a jewel in the blue of the sky. Sky clear and sun westerly. This 'plane' approached from the north.

February 20, 1952, over Atascadero, Calif., between 8:00 and 8:30 p.m. There was a high rainy fog. Idly regarding the sky I saw a ball of greenish light travelling at a moderate rate and without sound. I then saw a companion ball and realized that these were twin lights on a craft of some sort. When this object came to a rift in the fog the end of it became visible; this end part was long, narrow and rectangular and was divided into compartments, all of them brilliantly lighted in many colors, rainbow-like and iridescent.

My Impressions of the 'space-ships' and of the planet to which they belong. (The author adds in a note: "I don't know whether these "impressions" have any value. They are the result of an attempt to gain knowledge by intuition and concentration."):

October 21, 1951: A space-ship returning home travels a long distance to reach its planet, which contains many ready places and seems to have plenty of moisture.

October 22. The space-ship is very large and shaped like a cigar-shaped Zeppelin. It contains many smaller craft which on nearing earth are sent out as scouts or patrols. The seven beautiful craft seen on October 19 were such units. (Note: This idea of a 'mother ship' has since been repeatedly affirmed both by investigators on this side and by psychic communications. ML).

October 22, The planet to which these ships belong has a long sea-inlet leading to a city. A ship entering would have on the right-hand side a very pointed mountain rising directly from the sea at the entrance of the inlet.

October 22. The planet H has two luminaries of the same kind, either suns or moons, and one is much larger and brighter than the other. This planet is sending out ships for exploration.

October 23. The large cigar-shaped ships are always accompanied by sister ships. Some of the small craft can land on water and even go under the water. There is an island on the long sea-inlet which consists almost entirely of three hills which on one side seem to come down to the sea.

October 24. The planet has a very large mountain shaped somewhat like Fuji, with snow coming far down. There is a high peaked mountain in the distance. This is a sacred mountain which has a heart of lights and sends out rays beyond the planet, even as far as the earth.

Obviously and explicitly, the author of Flowering Dusk is not offering assertions, arguments or theories, but only her own experiences and impressions - but there is nothing in them which subsequent information can rule out and a good deal with which it fits in.

There is a disposition in some quarters, to restate our supposed scientific data about particular planets, such as Mars, Venus and Uranus, and then point out that no such civilizations as the Discs and other craft imply, could possibly exist there. The argument is almost worthless, since (a) the point of origin may be in the etheric doubles of the visible planets (b) Numerous dark bodies exist in the solar system (c) It is taught in some occult Schools that there are some 64 bodies in our system capable of supporting human or human-like life - but unknown to our science. Also, that there is a dark body behind the moon (d) Our alleged scientific knowledge of conditions on other visible planets is certainly defective and inadequate, with lack of agreement on numerous points. Astronomy has been called the "perfect" science, but the less data available in any science, the nearer it approaches 'perfection' - undisturbed by ignorance.

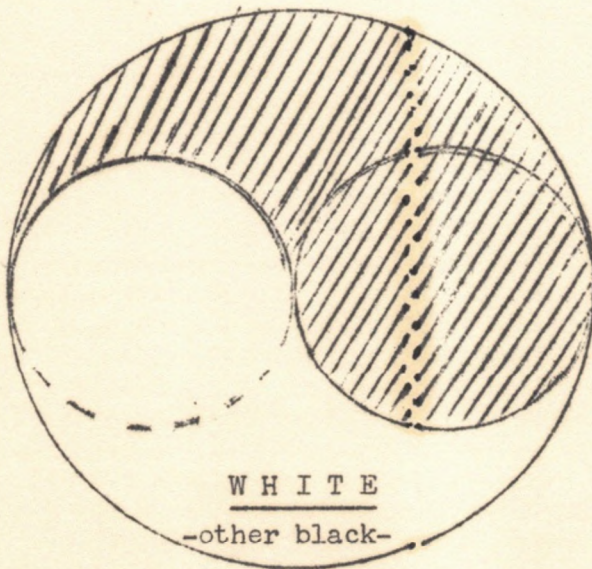
THE MOBILE YING-YANG

Quoted from the Rivista Italiana by the PENDULUM (a monthly review of Radiesthesia, 31 King's Road, London S.W. 3, Eng. No. 19, April 1952). Article by editor of Rivista, Dr. Vinci, describing an experiment with the Ying-Yang traced out on a disc which was suspended by a thread.

Dr. Vinci begins by quoting a letter from a Florentine seismologist, who points out that he and his confreres have for a long time observed the variations in terrestrial magnetism which precede earthquakes. The first disturbance is accompanied by a very powerful electric current, and this is followed sooner or later by the 'quake. The Florentine scientist devised an instrument to register the current and so serve as a warning. What he uses is a magnetized bar, and he says that Dr. Vinci's Ying-Yang represents this. When this mobile Chinese instrument is set up it oscillates more or less in a North-South line; or may remain motionless for weeks and at long intervals undergo slight oscillations. But the turbulent behaviour of Dr. Vinci's instrument last summer began just before the dreadful Italian earthquakes.

On the 16th of May at 1:40 a.m. a very rapid movement of the disc-axis from North to West was recorded. A reverse movement was followed ten minutes later which brought the axis back to its normal position. In the morning news came of the grave earthquake throughout northern Italy. Toward mid-day the ionosphere was shattered by electro-magnetic waves which silenced the radio receivers.

From the 2nd of June the disc kept up its movements; it then took up the direction E.N.E. and later continued until its axis was completely

reversed on the 1st of August. Then on the 15th of September it was N.W. and on the 18th East-West. Without going into details, last summer in Italy was crowded with earthquakes, floods, eruptions, storms, sea movements and shipwrecks on a scale never known before. Whatever the cause, lightning-like changes in the orientation of the mobile Ying-Yang preceded all these disturbances.

A former issue of the I vista quoted a Korean professor now resident in Switzerland, concerning the banner of Korea - which has the Ying-Yang at its center, surrounded by eight Trigrammes. The professor remarked that according to ancient Chinese writing the present civil war was predicted ages ago, and that it would drag on to the spring of 1952 (?), when concord between North and South would be established under the aegis of a concourse of great Powers - the date being established by a peculiar order of symbolism.

With reference to the foregoing: Several years ago the magazine Amazing Stories published a note from a correspondent, to the effect that all seismic disturbances were preceded by fluctuations of the compass needle, and that quakes could easily be predicted at least a short time in advance. This might be of considerable practical importance IF correct. Information requested from Associates.

Experimenters in radiesthesia may find it interesting to try the Yin-Yang form of the Pendule. This is nonsense to the average physicist, but all such operations involve the sub- or unconscious mind of the operator, and the profound and ancient symbolism of the Yin-Yang may have effects beyond ordinary analysis. The RR editor will appreciate quotations or references to occult literature, especially Theosophical and Qabalistic, bearing on the Yin-Yang symbolism.

KILNER'S "HUMAN ATMOSPHERE"

We have frequent inquiries concerning this book, which now seems to be unobtainable. Assoc. Verne Cameron (inventor of the Aurameter) has been reading the copy in the Manly Hall collection at Los Angeles, and sends us notes on some interesting passages:

Dr. Kilner tried glass screens coated with collodion or gelatin but found them useless as the coatings decomposed rapidly. He had better success with glass cells filled with an alcoholic solution of dicyanin, a coal tar dye. These have to be kept in the dark when not in use. Two are needed for ordinary work - one dark, the other light. Then by excluding all other light and looking through the dark screen at the sky or window for a few minutes to a half hour at a time, gradually the eyes are conditioned so that the aura can be seen either with the naked eye or through the screen. The effect of the screen is cumulative, so the ability to see the aura is acquired gradually. The light must not be too bright and the requisite amount must be determined at each observation. "Experience is the only guide". The body of the person examined should be just distinctly visible after the observer has become accustomed to the dimness. The light should be diffused but come from one direction only. Use a dead black background if possible. The observer should stand with his back to a darkened window, while the subject faces it. Hold the screen close to the eyes and peer for 30 seconds at the sky; exclude all light from the eyes except what comes through the screen.

To the above the BSR Director adds: The "screen" is made of two glass plates, sealed together but with a small space between them; this interior space is filled with the dicyanin solution. -- Dicyanin is obtainable from the Eastman Kodak Co. but is very expensive. The solution is somewhat unstable -- These Kilner screens were unsatisfactory and were later replaced by goggles or spectacles made of a specially tinted glass, and it is certain that a considerable number of persons developed auric vision by daily practise with these. -- These are NOT now obtainable, nor can the formula for the glass be obtained. --- Not only Assoc. Cameron, but also Assoc. Joseph H. Lukovich has spent much time in trying to reproduce the right colored glass, and Assoc. Lukovich has made up and is now testing a number of pairs of goggles or spectacles designed by him. His address is 334 Phoenix St., McKees Rocks, Penna. -- Assoc. Verne Cameron can be reached at Elsinore, Calif., Box S-218 Grand Ave. -- We have on good authority that a very large manufacturing and research corporation has now developed a method of photographing the human aura; this may or may not be in connection with medical research; at any rate no detailed information is as yet available.

Assoc. Cameron's notes continue with an unusual experiment. The curator of the Manly Hall collection, Mr. Lark, brought out a human skull, placed it on the table, and asked that it be tested with the

Cameron Aurameter. The instrument revealed a force field, or etheric field around the skull, shaped like a head, and standing out five feet from the center of the skull each way. "In other words there was a 10 ft. human head outlined with the skull as its center. The features were rugged, with a very crooked nose and a prognathous jaw and a peculiar dip in the rear lower part. This dip in the head outline was substantiated by a peculiar knot on the back of the skull, which I had not noticed. Mr. Lark told me it was the skull of a maniac who murdered a little girl in Germany.

This large outer head is probably to be interpreted as a kind of etheric double of the skull. In the hands of a skilled operator the Aurameter has the amazing power of locating and outlining etheric doubles and thought forms, as many tests have shown.



A further test was made with the Aurameter over the picture of a scorpion, contained in a triangular book of the 11th century. "This picture radiated a force upward and outward, which at the height of $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. was about 2 ft. in diameter and still followed the scorpion shape, and there terminated abruptly. I said, 'I imagine this is of evil origin or purpose', and Mr. Lark told me such was the case.' "

DON GREEN'S LANTERN

"Flying Saucers aren't a laughing matter in B.C. any more" says the Vancouver Sun of 4-30-52. "We can't all be mad" say these people, "and we weren't hypnotized."

The Royal Canadian Air Force order a full probe - whatever that will amount to - but somebody's getting keyed up. They're playing up this subject as though it had begun only yesterday. And the hilarity of our hard-boiled brothers is quieting down to a simper. The newspaper referred to above reports four sightings in one issue, another on April 19, another on April 24 - the last being of 8 objects flying in two V's, "out of the south at terrific speed!" And look this one over, for one of the most lucid action pictures you ever read--

Los Angeles Examiner, 5-8-52 - INS - Rio de Janeiro; pictures of a "flying saucer" were published in the Dario da Noite ... two photographers at Barra de Tijuca Beach saw what appeared to be an airplane approaching head-on and shot five pictures. These show an object looking somewhat like a pot lid with a knob-like protuberance in the center. It came in from over the sea losing altitude as it approached and passed several hundred feet overhead, rocking like a slowly falling leaf, then made a slow curve, picked up great speed and headed back to sea. The object was round and wingless and larger than a commercial airplane. *

And here's a dispatch from Berlin, NK News, dated July 3, printed in a U.S. paper**: 'Western Intelligence officers are investigating the claim of the former mayor of an East German town to have seen a flying saucer and two members of its crew on the ground at close range in a forest three miles from the U.S. Zone. The Mayor and his daughter "glimpsed something shimmering white through the trees. We crept up to it and saw

"a huge oval disc about 25 feet across lying on the ground in a clearing. It looked like a huge phosphorescent warming pan without a handle. In the center was a square contraption like a top hat, slightly darker in color ... then two figures appeared who seemed to be wearing metallic overalls. My daughter screamed and the figures hastily entered the object thru a porthole on the top of the upperwork. We noticed that the disc had two rows of circular portholes around its edge. Then the square upperworks began to retract and the whole object started to rise slowly, almost without sound, while the sides of the warming pan glowed dark red and we felt the swish of air."

The Mayor, Oscar Linke, wrote an 8-page report, with diagrams but was afraid to submit it to the police of the Soviet Zone. His 11-year old daughter confirmed the story in detail. Western Intelligence officers refused to comment.

Director M.L. seeing things too: At 10:35 a.m. May 25, a bright green globular object approached from the north at about 1500-2000 ft., then turned east and disappeared gradually. Approximate diameter at nearest approach, about that of zenith full moon. The green color was not fiery but clear and brilliant and giving the impression that the object was translucent. It was travelling at about the ordinary speed of jet planes in the San Diego area. Observed for about 30 seconds. Seen by M.L. & Gladys H. Layne, 3615 Alexia Pl., San Diego.

Report in preparation: The RR editor has lately had a long interview with a person entrusted with preparation of a detailed report, "to be submitted to high governmental authorities in about 4 months", and dealing with eye-witness descriptions, at very close range, of Discs and similar unknown craft which have landed in remote places. The report will be extensively documented and we greatly regret that none of the material is accessible for publication. It will perhaps interest RR readers, that the person preparing this Report is not only a competent physicist but is also well grounded in "occult" and esoteric thinking, and keeps closely in touch with our BSRA publications.

(It is my belief that scores, perhaps hundreds of people have seen the landed discs at close range, but have either been afraid to report them at all - account of ridicule and notoriety - or have described their experience only to intimate friends and under pledge of secrecy. Various magazines of a semi-fiction type have printed such accounts, though BSR publications have refrained from doing so on account of their unverifiable character. ML).

Headlines: Wichita Eagle of June 25, June 28, July 6 reports 'flying saucers' and 'fiery objects' overhead, evidently some four or five separate sightings of different objects. (Cr.H.E. Schmidt, 7-10-52). Same paper prints dispatch from Hugo, Okla., of two 'saucers' over Fort Hood, Tex. -- Also, 4 Florida pilots reported a 'saucer' hovering over the atomic plant at Richlands, Wash. ("Perfectly round, white, almost transparent, with small vapor trails. It backed away, changed shape, was perfectly still, then disappeared at high speed (Cr. H.E.Schmidt; same paper). -- "No one interested". Capt. R.R. Srdoch, draftsman and World War veteran, with wife and relatives, spotted a football shaped object in the sky over East Cleveland, Ohio, 'phoned Civil Defense and various police stations "but no one seemed interested". "It ought to mean something to someone" says Capt. Srdoch. (Cleveland Press, 7-5-52. Credit T.N. Bates).

The Richmond Times-Dispatch of June 16, 17, & 21 published full column accounts of "aerial objects - lighted ball in skies - great balls of fire" etc. If circumstances permit we shall quote these on a separate insert page with this issue of RR. But it is the same old story - hundreds of circumstantial accounts for more than five years past, and many in decades past - and the utter indifference, smugness and ignorance of humanity, especially of the "educated classes" and of pseudo - scientists who will not even listen to such accounts (Not in the text books, par Dieu!) - all this is incredible and unspeakable. (Cr. Assoc. Frances M. Headen for the T-D clips). (ML)

GOBBLEGOOK CORNER - or Revelations to Come - Maybe:

This is not to depreciate or discredit the Committee for Investigation of Aerial and Celestial Phenomena (Civilian Saucer Investigations), lately formed in Los Angeles. It's five years or decades late, of course, and a trifle naive in its announcements, but still is a much needed move and seems to include some very competent technicians. But the pompous publicity given it by columnist Joe MacConkey (Wichita Eagle, June 25, '52) is a liability to any genuine research group.

This CSI has discovered, according to Joe MacC., (a) that similar aerial phenomena have occurred in the past (b) that there is no acceptable explanation (c) that qualified observers are needed (d) that there's actually a chance for "science" to learn something new. And look-it what they're going to do:

"All reports will be evaluated completely... to establish the nature, cause and origin by means of methodical accumulation, analysis and evaluation of data ... with assurance of full cooperation by the Air Force. All information will undergo close scrutiny and the engineers will decide if any reported sighting bears any relation to the eventual solution of the flying saucers ... "

My Gawd!! It's almost all over except the shouting. After five years and more of sightings, thousands of pages of printed stuff, real and faked investigations, but not a single real explanation anywhere, with one exception - which is not known or not acceptable to the CSI, these worthy "pioneers" are all set for a fresh start which will really shed light and show up errors. It's not clear that they even accept the phenomena as genuine (i.e., factual and objective, on occasion). This is what we call delayed reaction, "some handicap", flawless self-confidence, ignorance supreme. And from the fanfare about 'scientific' approach our guess would be, practically all of them are babes in the woods metaphysically speaking - that the variety and complexity of the phenomena are unsuspected by them - and that the existence of etheric worlds and peoples, of the super-physics of contraterrene matter, of magnetic tides and currents and the world-old knowledge concerning them, is as an old wives'tale from Cloud-Cuckoo Land. But so long as they feel learned, entertained, and virtuous, with the Joe Mac.'s of the press to beat drums for them, en avant with the CSI! (ML)

And a scientist from the UCLA proposes to inform us of the "true nature of the flying saucers -- by using 200 specially built cameras.-- He expects the pictures to show the saucers' composition and light source" (Sta.Ana Register). Nothing said so far about origin, purpose, why-when-and-what of this visitation. Meanwhile they travel through our sky lanes as pleases them, irrespective of our wishes or thoughts. Over Los Alamos, the only unidentified objects "allowed" in the sky are - flying saucers. Maybe top brass should issue orders about this!!! Well, we have clips of June sightings from here to Australia and back around the other way. Though we can print only a few we want all we can get. Acknowledgments to Harriet Foster, Ede. S. GREAT TALES OF SNAILS!! - or, are they being teleported (and page the sardonic spirit of Charles Fort on this)?

The Scottish Bulletin of 5-19-52 reports that a downpour of small snails made roads impassable over two square miles near Oran, North Africa. Hundreds of thousands of snails fell from the skies, accompanied by rain, during a freak storm. (cr. Assoc. ESS).

'Orthodox' explanation (if any): pond or lake-full of snails some - where; whirlwind picked out all the snails but nothing else (or with the water maybe - no coffee), spilled them over Oran. But to come closer home --

'Snails invade Central Park, New York ... showers of snails in England -- afield again, in Ceylon, millions of gigantic snails are being shovelled up in piles and burned. The records go back to bible times - locusts, grasshoppers, crickets, worms, frogs, snakes, fish, tadpoles, not to mention slime, blood, "soot", fungus, a full paragraph of other stuff

"It isn't raining rain for me" (us), or "violets" either, or cats and dogs, but God-knows-what and where it comes from. And there was the horse and rider who appeared and disappeared on a quantum wave (we'll say), noise and all, before witnesses who, incidentally, were frightened stiff. Long time ago a train of thirty freight cars disappeared; if it was ever found we haven't heard about it. But whether a teleported freight car is any more mysterious than a snail-from-nowhere is for the reader to decide. Or a cricket - and does spontaneous incubation mean anything?

Reno, Nev. (AP) A horde of Mormon crickets, 25 miles wide and 14 miles deep, was creeping up on the water supply of Austin, Nev. (on June 20, 1952 (Sta.Ana.Register).

That's a little mining town of 500 people, 7-7000 ft. altitude, in semi-barren country with poor sustenance for unpteen-million bugs - but there they are. Is Nature really interested in the preservation of species - or merely adept at covering up her blunders - and are men or bugs more important in her eyes?

Atom-bomb fission products affecting the weather? Well, why not? BSR Associates Schultz and Hilliard long ago pointed out the probable chemistry and physics of this, effects on the ionosphere etc. Everybody (almost) admits the weather is "haywire" in all parts of the world. Droughts and floods, extremes of heat and cold in more than normal intensity. Radioactive rain, Montana and elsewhere. Mutations reported in corn in the mid-West. Our scientists tell us, this small radioactivity not dangerous - but it has occurred to some of them that these effects are cumulative. And if we may 'cross the border' for a moment, one of the Mark Probert Controls remarked that 'most of the men exposed to radiation in Nevada will have no children'. Well, sterilization by various forms of radiation is familiar to scientific workers.

And referring to spontaneous incubation again - if you think "living" and "dead" matter are basically different, or that organic life cannot arise from the 'inorganic', read the Morley-Martin and Dr. Littlefield experiments. The BSRA has a booklet on this.

Indianapolis Times of July 13 headline: "Mystery Aircraft Buzzing City Seen by Thousands!" Observers included five or more pilots of military aircraft and thousands of civilians; nobody thought it was a meteor or a hallucination or reflected lights or fireflies or any other non-sense such as has been fed to the public for five years past. The same issue prints a half-column, "Flying Saucers Sighted Near Atomic Plant" near Hanford, Wash. Two objects "travelling at tremendous speed". Another was over Richmond, Wash. "Large, revolving slowly but moving at tremendous speed." (Cr. Anne L. Losand). Several years ago there was a flight of several hundred "objects" over a town in Virginia; it was headlined by the local papers, but hardly had a paragraph elsewhere. Ignorance, inertia of the human mind, systematic cover-up by authorities can account for a great deal - but there are times when one thinks maybe some incredible hypnotic spell has been laid over the whole western world - or an autohypnosis anyhow. Human reactions, or the lack of them, has been a more astonishing phenomenon than the flying Discs themselves.

In the literature of the Disc Visitation one of the most remarkable incidents has been the publication, in Fantastic Stories for November 1947, of an article entitled SON OF THE SUN, attributed in the by-line to "Alexander Blade" (fictitious), but really written by BSR Associate Millen Cooke. Relying on her own intuition and great occult knowledge, she struck straight and truly at the heart of the mystery. So far as we can ascertain, only the BSR Associates and publications valued this achievement at something near its true worth.

AVE DIDICAS! "Up out of the Pacific an old volcano in three months has reared its black lava shoulders and steaming crown 800 feet above the straits of Luzon like some spectre risen from a wet grave. You look into its fiery mouth and it is like looking into the gates of hell. Acrid yellow fumes, dense and sulphurous, seethe in the crater. Molten lave boils in the pit, spills over the rim, congeals in huge blocks which build the cone ever higher. Explosions wreck the crater. Clouds of steam mount to the skies, Jets of rock particles, some big as an office desk, blast upward. They fall and crash against the cinder slopes, roll and tumble crazily into the sea, disappear in blasts of steam. It is a pit of brimstone and fire. Even the name has a biblical ring. Didicas - after the Didicas rocks which mysteriously appeared nearly a century ago in this same spot 38 miles north of Luzon's northernmost tip - and as mysteriously disappeared beneath the waves after four years.

The U.S. Navy is keeping close watch on this phenomena since the master of the freighter Brightstar discovered a five-acre island of tumbled volcanic rock March 16. Since then it has grown to 600 acres. Its crater, 800 feet above the sea, is almost a mile long and more than half a mile wide. The Island observed in March would fit neatly now into the crater - but it is a minute speck compared with the giant under the waves. Didicas is a vast under-water mountain with its base resting on the ocean floor five miles down.

(Manila dispatch, June 20, '52, to a San Jose paper) - (Cr. Laura Wood).

Nature sometimes moves swiftly at her most timeless tasks. The immemorial mountains, thousands of centuries old - as we often think them- are sometimes creatures of weeks and months only. Paricutin rose out of a corn patch, in a few months was a formidable crater throwing ashes 24,000 feet into the air. If you are interested in "Our Home-town Planet, Earth" and the vast unrest that vexes her, read the article under that title in National Geographic, for January 1952.

At Esher, England, Something shatters windshields of cars along the highway. NOT bullets or pellets or stones, or even 'sound waves', say the experts. There's only a crack and a 'flash' and a hole in the center of the windshield. (Arizona Daily Star, Tucson, June 22, '52).

"Mystery shock" like the roar of a subway train, heard and felt by a million people in the Philadelphia area, June 14, '52 - lasted 4 to 6 seconds. Unexplained.

Heavy quakes in Chile, Argentina, Formosa. Terra has about 2760 quakes a day, nearly all of them very slight. But the quakes that made level ground out of part of the Tibetan "Hump" was one of the heaviest in recorded history. Our info. is, this was caused by subsidence into enormous underground caverns. -- And a crater 12 ft. deep and 200 ft. in diameter was found, about 15 miles from Vancouver, B.C. following a heavy "mysterious explosion".

"3636 Millions Due to People World in 1980". Two years ago the population of the world was about 2 billion 400 million; increase in the next 28 years will be at least 500 million, and may be 1,300,000,000. These figures are from the Population Bulletin of the United Nations, which points out that "the rate depends on Asia" where it is high and may increase. World population has increased more than 50 percent since 1900 and more than five-fold in 300 years... Terra has room enough for 10,000 millions, but Man himself decrees otherwise; all signs point to a most notable liquidation, or planetary house-cleaning - whether by men or Gods, or Etherians, or Powers of Nature or by all combined, will doubtless become clear to us in the processes of time ... **

"As you so painfully realize, it is no fun crying Wolf, Wolf! - but it must be done if anything, anyone is to be salvaged from this incredible inter-planetary debacle. My own mental and physical state is beyond description or analysis in this letter - and I have not experienced more than a preview of the 'coming changes'. What will the real thing be when it arrives! . . . My kindest regards and deep thanks for the constant and courageous efforts you have been making

"Dr Kappa" - whose correct name we hope to release before very long, expects to make headquarters near San Diego and to give a limited amount of instruction there and at nearby points, beginning some time this July.

We invite close attention to the phrases used by Dr. Kappa in the lines quoted above. From any other source we would discount them heavily - but we know Dr. Kappa as a learned occultist, long resident in India, possessing remarkable psychic gifts, and of unquestioned integrity. If he chooses to speak in cold blood of an "incredible inter-planetary debacle" we do NOT take the phrase lightly.

The RR editor has been reproached of late for nearly everything he says or does not say. We are accused of suppressing facts pregnant with disaster, when we should warn everyone openly. "LAST DAYS" AND THE PALMIVARIAN FELLOWSHIP.

The publication of this manuscript seems to have given lively offense in some quarters. William Dudley Pelley, publisher of the Golden Scripts and editor of VALOR, objects to it on numerous counts, all of which are set forth at length in VALOR for June 28, 1952. We recommend the careful reading of this article.

Our long-time friend and collaborator Max Freedom Long, F.H.F., and author of the distinguished Secret Science Behind Miracles, also takes vigorous issue with our policy in publishing the Last Days. The objection seems to be mainly rooted in the alleged personal character and record of persons connected with the origin of the manuscript. He has also suffered from hasty criticism by some members of the Huna Fellowship.

Mr. Long had no slightest responsibility for Last Days and did not know of its proposed publication.

With every copy of Last Days sent out by us, we have included a full-page caveat stating explicitly that "both the abstract and the booklet are offered merely as an interesting psychic or occult document which happens to conform in many respects with information from other sources... We do not recommend the Palmivarian Fellowship, nor do we have any unfavorable information about them ... Last Days is issued as informational ... We do NOT advise anyone to go to Guatemala or anywhere else ... Last Days was issued with the approval of the Mark Probert Control Yada Di Shi'ite, who disagreed with some statements in it but felt that the effect as a whole would be salutary." - The opinion of the Yada was printed in substance at the close of the booklet.

As to the personal character of anyone connected with the Palmivarian Fellowship, we have only hearsay reports, and these are conflicting in nature. As to the psychic origin of Last Days, this should be considered a separate issue, however difficult it may be to avoid confusing the two questions. As to the predictions contained in the booklet, and objected to by Dr. Pelley, any critical handling of them and of his comments would require many pages. We only repeat our suggestion that you obtain, if interested, a copy of VALOR for June 28 and form your own opinions. Address SOULCRAFT, Box 192, Noblesville, Ind.

For our own side of the ledger we may add, that we have had numerous letters expressing lively interest in Last Days and approving its publication, apparently without any signs of panic or impulse to remove at once to Guatemala. Finally, your BSR Director wishes to make plain that he has not altered in any way the impersonal attitude described in the 4th paragraph of this page and in the caveat distributed along with the booklet.
