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EXCURSION IN PHILOSOPHY

I once inquired of a well-known critic and philosopher, Dr. E. S. Bates, as to the philosophical definition of a mistake. He replied that he did not know what a mistake is, although he was sure that he made a great many.

When I put the same question to that one-time citizen of YU, the trance Control Yada di Shi'ite, and quoted Professor Bates' reply, the Yada remarked that he did not know a good definition either, and that E.S.B. was a very smart man. He amplified this by adding: "Sometimes I think the whole thing is a mistake" - presumably meaning the Cosmos, or Omniverse. Allowing for the obvious levity of these remarks, it is still true that the question itself is about as serious as anything can be.

If I insist that two plus two makes five, you tell me that I am mistaken - and on reflection you will find your reason to be, that 'everyone else' agrees with you. You feel that you are in the majority party and that there is no appeal from their verdict. But if like Galileo (*eppur se muove*) I mutter to myself "it is five just the same", and then can get a few supporters organized, and bring up a formidable left wing, soon 'the seed of doubt begins to sprout' even among the ultra-orthodox. If you insist that the sum of the angles of a triangle is 180 degrees, and I retort smugly, 'not on the surface of a sphere', you at least have to revise your form of statement. Well, the point of all this is simply, that what we call truth and fact is only agreement, consensus of opinion. Since on reflection you are certain to agree with me on that last statement, that makes it truth for us, anyway.

But the one word in the next to last sentence which really gruels many of us, philosophers, scientists, and even Round Robin readers, is our word only. For we are all hypnotized, from cradle days onward, by the fallacy of Absolutes. Not only do we firmly believe that 'objects' in the 'external' world are what we call 'real' things, miraculously stuck 'out there' in something called space and time, with an independent existence of their own (all of which is 'naive materialism', otherwise known as low-grade eye-wash); but we also think that good and bad, right and wrong, are independent existents in nature, or are qualities or properties of acts and things and ideas. It doesn't seem to occur to us that there are no signs of moral qualities in Nature. Electricity, gravity, chemical forces will kill or cure according to use and circumstances - but the characters of good and bad which we attach to them originate in our own minds. And whatever a man does is his good, to his mind, at the moment - or he wouldn't do it. And of course the most horrendous 'sins' have been rated virtues and religious duties - incest, for example, and murder, and diabolical cruelties ('for the greater glory of God' quoth Torquemada). But all this is too familiar and obvious to expand upon here.

The all-important matter, it seems to me, is that we shall never have any true freedom of thought, or make any real progress in both

thinking and acting, until we get rid of the tyranny of Absolutes. Until we free ourselves of the notion that somewhere, somehow, there is a Good and True and Beautiful which is that way all by Itself, whether any human exist in the Omniverse or not. But truth and beauty and goodness are values, and values exist in human thinking. We manufacture them daily and hourly, change and distort and replace them, set them up as ideals (and then abandon them), make taboos and idols and Gods and devils out of them, abuse and torture and kill other people who do not accept them. But the Cosmos, the Omniverse knows nothing about such values, such ideas and aspirations and murderous stupidity. Though we may perhaps - using almost meaningless words - speak of it as the Great Mind, or even the Great Consciousness, it certainly cannot be measured by our own, or by the tea-spoons and pint cups of our pseudo-religionism.

If we must have some amplification of the word God, let us consider the three-word sentence familiar to occultists: God is Pressure. This means in part, if anything more can be said, the X-Power moving into manifestation. To the scientist the wrd God, if he uses it at all, may mean a primary universal magnetic field, equating with Force or Energy. The religionist will perhaps find some vague connotation for whatever word symbol he uses - whatever one of the thousand God-Names human languages employ. But all these Gods are man-made, and all Revelations have exactly the value and meaning we put into them, and hence are able to extract from them. Hence our small verbal onslaught against Absolutes - which merely express the relativity of all human thinking.

This brings us straight enough back to our first question, about the nature and meaning of a mistake. If there are no absolute values, or no knowledge of them, then no one can sin against them. What do you 'sin' against when you make a 'mistake'? Obviously, only against received opinion, accepted facts - which may not be accepted tomorrow, next year, next century. There is no other validity in them, than this matter of being in temporary favor. ("A truth, to science, is simply a convenient form of statement" - says J.W.N. Sullivan). Majority opinions, or opinions in power make laws, prosecute offenders, persecute dissidents, confer fame and martyrdom. If you insist publicly and noisily that two and two make five, you may at worst only be certified for psychiatric examination. If your disagreement is with dogmas of religion or politics, or your neighbors' habits, the results may be more serious. The point is only, that both sides are 'right' - you in your opinion, others in theirs. Because rightness is not absolute; it is man-made. Your opponents are wrong, and so are you. The mistake is not such with regard to any final, superior and transcendent truth, on any subject whatsoever.. Such truths do not exist. Where there are two opinions there are two truths and two mistakes - both relative, because there is no other kind. This is not a denial of ethical and moral values, but only an attempt to express their true origin and nature.

If this elementary insight were applied in practise, it would cut at the roots of all dogmatisms, fanaticisms, and religious bigotry. It would destroy the age-old supremacy of priestcraft, which is rooted in a lying pretense to an absolute knowledge possessed by none. It would de-

stroy the age-old supremacy of priestcraft, which is rooted in a lying pretense to an absolute knowledge possessed by none. It would destroy all finalities, which are fatal to all growth and change. Man is the eternal Questioner - the animal which asks questions. Since there is no court of appeal except in his own consciousness, he gets his own answers. Since his consciousness shifts, expands, changes, his answers of tomorrow are not those of yesterday. Since he cannot understand this, but erects his opinions into dogmas, he is destroyed by them. All finalities inhibit growth, and the possession of an 'absolute' truth would bring our man-made Omniverse about our ears.

I believe that the two philosophers I mentioned would agree with the substance of all this, but neither of them would consider that we have 'really' defined a mistake. That is because to really define anything would imply absolute knowledge - which is non-existent. But can philosophic reasoning exist without an Absolute - at least without the Symbolic "X" ? I do not think so.

THE NATURE OF THE COSMOS

Shortly after the two hundred inch telescope had been in operation at Palomar, I, unbeknownst to the astronomers there, studied the heavens through its complicated mechanism. To say that this new astronomical eye is one of the greatest bits of scientific art achievement of your twentieth century would be expressing my thoughts mildly. Nevertheless, it is not a thing-in-itself, but is the product of the minds of those who made it. Therefore, let us not stand in awe of it, but let us bow our heads and give thanks to the Great Mind who, working through the machine called the "brain" of these individuals, made this monumental piece of work possible.

While this "eye" can see a billion, two hundred million light years away from your Earth, and your astronomers were astounded to discover that the universe showed no signs of coming to an end, even at that staggering distance, this fact should not frighten you nor make you feel insecure, but should make you glow with joy and sincere inward pride to realize how truly great you are! I mean, of course, you as a consciousness.

A billion light years! That, my friends, is no more than a mile in consciousness, and but a breath in the measurement of mind-time.

In my present state I have no use for your great telescope. I can tell you that the universe stretches out from everlasting to everlasting. There can be no end to it, simply because it is all Mind, and there is no end to Mind.

Now let us look at the Universe from your materialistic standpoint. That is, from the belief that it is something in itself, apart from your individual consciousness. To begin with, it is but foolishness to even try to give in figures the number of bodies in the cosmos, for the consciousness of material man cannot comprehend such figures. But, as numerous as they are, each and every one of them is arranged in a very precise geometrical order in relation to one another, and each has its own work to do.

While it is true that many of these bodies are constantly running into one another and being destroyed, all such destruction is brought about the instant any form of unbalance starts to take place. Indeed, wherever we may look in Nature, destruction comes in the wake of inharmony.

The old wives' tale that "Nature abhors a vacuum" is nothing more than just that -- an old wives' tale -- for while both Man and Nature

can create vacuums of a kind, there is really no such thing as an absolute vacuum. It is true that both atmospheric and etheric pressures are considerably less in outer space, and therefore a body can be made to travel at speeds far exceeding that of light, but that body is not moving in a complete vacuum, for the existing void is but relative in density to the body moving in it.

Whether a vacuum is created artificially by Man or by Nature makes little difference, for in both cases only the grossest matter is removed. That which is left is so dense in its parts that it is out of the reach of any action that may be brought to bear upon it from the three dimensional world.

While Man may by his inquisitive nature do certain things merely to see what the outcome will be, Nature acts with a very definite purpose, and has a foregone conclusion as to what the results will be.

As far as vacuums go, I would say the only complete ones I have ever found were in the heads of those who failed to think for themselves.

Now I would like to make reference to the suns and the appearance of what are called sunspots.

Galileo, who was my idol as a child and whom I deeply admired throughout my adult life, thought sunspots were dust clouds on the face of the sun, or vapors. Other astronomers have thought them to be everything from mountains to satellites. From my own observation, I believe them to be huge tunnel-like formations penetrating from the surface inward, sometimes to the depths of 93 thousand miles, their diameters anything from a few hundred to many thousands of miles. The interiors of these tunnels or tubes are considerably cooler than the rest of the sun.

These spots are formed after the sun has reached its highest level of attraction of waste matter or stellar debris. The point of saturation of waste matter is not a constant, but varies considerably, depending on the amount of matter it has discharged from itself during its period of repulsion.

These "tunnels" are atom-smashing tubes. Sometimes several of these tubes form relatively close together; at other times, hundreds of thousands of miles apart -- and they appear on different parts of the sun's surface or photosphere from time to time, depending on the strongest point of magnetic attraction.

This feeding of the suns from stellar debris by the trillions of tons has kept these suns from burning out billions of years ago, and will keep them going for billions of years longer, unless some body of

greater size, or equal size but greater mass weight, gets off its orbit and crashes into one of them.

I say this despite the fact that many of your modern astronomers do not believe it will last longer than from twenty to thirty million more years -- which is a paltry number of years in cosmic time. They seem not to reckon with the fact that both destruction and construction of vast bodies are going on constantly in the starry realm, and that, more often than not, when destruction takes place a new supply of waste matter for the suns is created. And more -- the nature of the action of the particles that go to make up the suns is entirely different from the matter that goes to make up a flaming body that will later cool off and form a planet.

The particles that go to make up the photosphere are not burning, but are condensations of such gases as hydrogen and helium, and due to the tremendous gravitational pressures, they are compressed into solids and are of extreme weight. These heavy globules of matter are floating in a sea made up of the same kind of substance as that found in an extreme vacuum. The mass pressure it exerts on the globules is so great as to hold them in their places, so that their only escape is by radiation.

During the period of the sun's magnetic attraction, the corona's field is approximately three hundred and forty-six thousand miles, but in repulsion it goes into violent action, shooting great streams of energy for millions of miles out into space. Space itself, throughout the whole starry system, while appearing to be a void, is made up of matter many times denser than any bodies in form.

The question will arise, no doubt, as to how these atom-smashing tubes are formed and how they work. Let us picture, if we can, a large hollow glass globe, filled to capacity with highly polished but somewhat irregularly cut diamonds. The diamonds will represent the globules of matter that send off photons, or light ray particles. The space in between the diamonds we will fill with a heavy grade of oil. This we will call the unbra, or substance in which the diamonds float around. This substance, being much heavier, has a greater pull of gravity than the globules (or diamonds) and causes all matter that the suns attract to themselves to fall into it. . . .

MY EXPERIMENTS WITH THE PYRAMIDS

by Verne L. Cameron, Inventor of the Aurameter

For about two years, prior to 1952, I had been reading about experiments conducted in Europe concerning the strange properties possessed by small cardboard replicas of the Great Pyramid; how articles placed under them refused to deteriorate. I read how one man had obtained 57 shaves with one blade without sharpening it, and of how meat was mummified without spoiling, simply by placing these objects under the tiny paper replicas. Eventually these ideas caught fire with me and I decided to try my hand at a few experiments.

Accordingly I made some small cardboard pyramids, 3 1/8" along each side of the base and 3" along the corners to the apex, corresponding to the dimensions recommended. Under one I placed a new Gillette razor blade after using it once. I usually get not more than three shaves from one blade. Under another I placed about two ounces of raw pork, half fat. The little pyramids were placed in a bathroom where it was hot, steamy or draughty by spells - not conducive to preservation of foods, certainly. One side of each pyramid faced the north - but I am NOT convinced that this is necessary.

In about three days the pork had a faint odor, but it lost this, and in ~~not~~ nine days was completely mummified. It is still perfectly edible after several months. A large chunk of watermelon dried down to the texture of a dried apricot but is still sweet and good.

The razor blade experiment started April 4, '53 and the original blade is still in use (Sept. 1, '53). Most of the time I shave every day; but if I skip a day there is an extra demand on the razor since my beard gets filled with dust from the buffing wheels in my shop. I have kept a day-by-day record of the performance of the blade, and this reads: good - fine - excellent, with three or four exceptions of "poor" where I skipped a day and the tin oxide got onto my face. Even in these cases the blade recovered its original cutting edge.

In order to find whether there were any rays, radiations or lines of force from the pyramids I tested with an aurameter, and found that when the pyramid is upright there is a rod of force extending from the apex to the ceiling; and from the bottom, continuing the flare downward to the ground is an invisible pyramid of force, of which the small one is the apex or capstone. The size of the invisible pyramid is only limited by the elevation of the small visible one above the ground. Further, where the model has sat for some time, the charge or invisible pyramid remains after the model is removed, even for days and weeks. This force does not seem to penetrate the ground, though if the pyramid is made from metal, say aluminum, and is connected point to point to a metal cone, 30 degree angle, with closed base, by a conducting wire, within a few minutes the energy normally reflecting from underground water ceases to register on the aurameter. After 30 minutes or so reflections from oil also cease to register, for a distance of several hundred feet from the pyramid in all directions.

One cannot by any stretch of imagination say that it is "natural" for a razor blade to give forty-four times as many shaves just because it is kept under a tiny cardboard pyramid. Or, if it were natural, why does not a small cardboard box do just as well?

I have been much gratified to learn of the interest shown, both in the pyramid phenomena and in the operations of the Aurameter, by the Associates and publications of the BSRA, by the Huna Research Associates (Max Freedom Long, Director), by Chimes Magazine (La Brea, Calif.), by Valor magazine (William Dudley Pelley, Ed.), and by many correspondents and inquirers. Our present experiments may well seem trivial, but no one can tell where even the most trifling novelty may lead.

The Aurameter is an example of this. It was originally intended only as a highly sensitive water dowsing instrument, but it has turned out to be the most advanced means known for outlining thought pictures (mental images projected in space), the human aura and several little known features of it, the invisible bodies over our heads, and a long series of rays, beams or emanations from both living and inanimate objects. In addition it has shown itself, in competent hands, capable of locating diseased spots and infections in the human body - as has been attested by many physicians.

For those interested in some possible relationship to the Great Pyramid of Gizeh, the following data may be useful: This pyramid is 760 feet 11 inches square, 484 ft. high if apex were restored. If the perimeter were in form of a circle, the height would bear the same ratio as that of a radius to a circle. The perimeter is 36,524 inches, exactly the number of days in 100 years. The base of natural bedrock was planed off to exactly the curvature of the earth's crust, or eight inches to the mile. It was not until about 800 A.D. that it became known that the pyramid contained rooms. It is built of granite blocks in steps 26" high; the blocks 25" or one cubit, plus one inch for cement, and weighing many tons each. The apex lacks 14 courses, leaving a flat top with a square altar block of granite with 49 holes in it, and flanked by four stones making a cross.

To make a paper pyramid, hold to the proportions of 25 to 24; e.g., $3\frac{1}{8}$ " for each side of base, 3" slope line at corners: also $4\frac{1}{4}$ x 6, $12\frac{1}{2}$ x 12 etc. for larger sizes. Cut out one triangle of the size desired, lay it down flat and pivot it around the center apex point (wide side away from center) and mark around it four times. Cut this out and crease the bends; fasten together with tape.

Pyramids & Razor Blades

(Excerpts from letter, Assoc. George S. Heppner, to BSR Director).

"Herewith a report of three brief razor-blade pyramid experiments:

- Experiment (1): one shave per day for 12 successive days -
 (2): one shave per day for 9 successive days -
 (3): one shave per day for 12 successive days -

These might have gone on indefinitely were it not for the fact that (1) & (2) were accidentally disrupted and (3) by my own switching of the original set-up.

In (1) the blade was left exposed 6 or 7 hours and dulling took place.

In (2) the blade was borrowed and not returned (9th day).

In (3) a thin-sheet plastic pyramid was substituted on the 12th day and dulling occurred the day following. In two further trials with a new blade under the plastic pyramid I got only one shave per blade. Obviously the plastic will not give the desired results.

I go on record to confirm that "it works", and since I am not trying to set a record (Mr. Cameron has done that - up to August 15 more than 100 shaves with a single blade) I may now vary the experiments to get trial and error data on the conditions.

Paper with a metallic backing gave good results. It would be useful to find out if the material of the pyramid is important, or what substance, if any, acts as an insulator. So too, re effects of actinic light.

What is it? I consider that the force involved is extraneous and not subjective. My first experiment began with a sceptical attitude and I was quite surprised to get a week's smooth shaving. Some days the blade seemed sharper than when new.

I figured that any blade has a limited potentiality; some are very good and some comparatively poor to begin with. Assuming that this limitation is extended by the pyramid excluding bacteria etc., one would expect a 'reasonable' deferment of the ultimate dulling. But Mr. Cameron's 105th shave detracts even from this reasonable assumption. It is incongruous and 'contrary to', to even suppose that the blade can get sharper instead of inappreciably duller. This is beginning to have the ear-marks of metaphysical caprice.

My intuitional reaction is that we are dealing with a new force akin to, but not identical with electricity and magnetism. We are apprehending a rudimentary manifestation - like the first rubbing of amber. Indications are maturing that neither the orientation nor the proportions of the models is critical. I believe the pyramid of Gizeh is slightly distorted from its original blueprint concept and is more of a scientific enigma than a chronological standard . . . Why not experiment with equilateral pyramids, undercut pyramidoids, cones - even dixie cups . . . "

INSIDE A FLYING SAUCER

SAUCERS magazine, Vol. I No.2, contains a copyrighted article by Truman Bethurum, of 519 No. Gertruda Ave., Redondo Beach, Calif., entitled "I Was Inside a Flying Saucer". Mr. Bethurum is employed as a mechanic on heavy construction equipment, and explains that in July 1952 he was in charge of the water supply trucks on Highway 91, then under construction, about 70 miles out of Las Vegas toward Salt Lake. He was awakened one night, not long before daylight, by the sound of conversation, and saw about eight small men in a semisircle about his truck, and one of the men advanced and spoke to him in English.

Mr. Bethurum also saw, about 75 yards distant, a large Disc, which he later estimated to be about 18 ft. in thickness and 300 ft. or more in diameter. He asked the man who had spoken to him if he could meet the Captain of the Disc, and was promptly conducted inside, down a corridor past several doors and into a room "fitted up like a combination office and lounge". The Captain turned out to be a woman, shorter than the men, and (like them) somewhat Latin in appearance. A friendly and rather lengthy interview followed, but the woman Captain did not at this time give much information about herself and the crew.

According to Mr. Bethurum, this turned out to be only the first of eleven different contacts made by him with the people of this same craft, all in the same general area. Copyright restrictions prevent a more elaborate summary of the SAUCERS magazine article; however, our BSR Associate Mr. Julius Becker, a U.S. Construction Inspector near San Diego, obtained an interview with Mr. Bethurum, the substance of which is reproduced below under his written permission. We will also supply on request, without charge, a more complete (two-page) mimeo. summary of the SAUCERS article mentioned. It is the opinion of the Round Robin editor that every item of authentic information concerning the visitation of the Discs or Space People should be considered in the public domain, as a matter of urgent public policy. During the eight years of publication of RR and other BSR material, only one item (The Magic Bag) has been protected by copyright.- and this runs in favor of the intermediary, Mark Probert.

'Concerning the place of origin of this Disc - which the crew members called a "scow" - the woman Captain told me that they came from a plan-

et named Clarion, and that this planet is directly behind the moon. She said that the round trip took about two days - and that the people there lived much as we do, but without wars or strife. She suggested that we direct our own efforts toward mental and spiritual progress, instead of toward material gain and destructivness.

'All the men whom I saw were dressed in the same way, in a kind of uniform of blue-gray material. The woman wore a black skirt and a reddish blouse. She was about 4'6" tall and the men were about 5 ft.

The language these people used among themselves was entirely strange to me. The woman's English was a little odd. She seemed to be putting much of what she said into rhyme, and her choice of words seemed to me to be unusually good and above the average of our common use here.

Speaking of clothing reminds me to say, that on one occasion I leaned against or brushed against the outside of the Disc. The clothing I had on was later sent to the laundry, and when it came back it showed large holes that looked as if eaten out by acid, just at the places where it came into contact with the Disc.

About the Disc itself: it was circular and about 18 ft. in thickness, and more than 300 ft. in diameter. I believe, but have no proof or evidence, that it carried or at least could carry one or more smaller Discs inside. The woman Captain said they had many such Discs, and that all of them had women Captains, with a crew of about 32 men. I myself never saw more than seven or eight of the men at one time, but each time some of the faces were different. The woman Captain, by the way, told me she was a grandmother, but that her two grandchildren were not on board the Disc.

I have made contact with these people on eleven different occasions. The last time they promised to come again but I have not seen or heard anything of them.

About the meeting in the cafe. It was the waitress who first called my attention to the people in the room. This was not the last time I saw them - I have seen them since. The waitress was badly confused so that she could hardly remember what food they ordered, but thought they had orange juice and sandwiches.

While in the cafe the woman captain wore dark glasses, but the same dress as when on the Disc, and was of the same height and general appearance. But she would not admit to me that she was from the Disc at all. My boss was in the cafe also, and he went outside to watch these people when they left, while I stayed inside. He saw them start for the door but did not see anyone come out; they simply vanished as they stepped across the doorway. All of their movements had a kind of military precision about them.

I hope to go back to the desert in about three months and am trying to arrange my affairs so I can do so. Perhaps I shall be able to contact them again.

NOTES TO THE FOREGOING: (M.L.)

Assoc. Becker describes Mr. Bethurum as being well-informed, factual, and conservative, and in general making a good impression.

Mr. Bethurum says that he will try to reply to all inquiries, provided they are accompanied by stamped and addressed envelopes. He has had many visitors, including several scientists and representative of the Government and the armed services. His story may be available in printed form within a few months, and 'just curious' inquirers should perhaps wait for its appearance.

Why was Mr. Bethurum 'chosen' for this experience? He himself put

this question to the woman captain and was told: "You were not chosen in any special sense; circumstances just worked out that way."... It is highly probable that this answer will apply to a number of other persons who have had close contact with the space craft and their occupants.

Concerning the shape of the Disc: note that the surface was not convex; the form was that of a round pill box or a silver dollar. Such a form while in flight might easily appear oval or even cigar-shaped according to the angle of vision.

The disappearance of the cafe visitors: The YADA DI SHI'ITE has repeatedly stated that these visitors can make themselves visible or invisible at will. This is one strong indication that they are (as the MP Controls insist) truly an etheric people - since a body composed of etheric matter is subject to mental control and its vibration rate can be altered at will. "They do not have bodies like yours, no matter how they may appear to you, and they can vanish into another time-space frame at will."

At almost all contacts Mr. Bethurum was taken inside the Disc and the Captain did almost all of the talking - just as the Commander of any craft or group would do among us.

About the word scow: one of the crew said they called the Disc by that name because it had no motor or power generator. This reminds us of the remark by the Natalli control: "These craft move along lines of magnetic force by a kind of continual falling-off and falling back on again" - which corresponds to "step-flight" motion reported by many observers.

The woman captain of the Disc offered to take "four or five persons" on a flight to Clarion and return, as her guests and for a short inspection of that planet - but since his last Nevada contact there has been no communication with the visitors. This request is not needed for our BSR Associates - but please do NOT write to Mr. Bethurum - or the BSR Hdqrs - for reserve seats and round-trip tickets. For the large number of Associates who are deeply interested in the statements of the Probert Controls, we add here that Natalli and the Yada have both asserted that Mr. Bethurum's account of his experiences is authentic.

QUESTION, to the Mark Probert Controls: (Do some of the discs carry a crew?). The large ones, yes; the small ones, no. The small ones run under very high energy power. (Q). Yes, they are controlled from the ship which carries the crew. Some break loose. They then become limp like paper and vanish. (Q). No, they do not return to another vibration rate in such case. They disintegrate, lose identity. The energy goes back whence it came... This explains what happens to some which appear to land. If there are beings in a Disc which disintegrates, they simply go back into the etheric world from which they emerged... The Discs will probably carry on until all the 'explanations' run out . . .

(Given by the Control Lingford in 1947 -- and in agreement with all subsequent data).

THE FOHAT CONSTANT

For once I do not feel apologetic for burdening the language with a new phrase. "Fohat Constant" will be useful until some better term is found.

Sir Hubert Wilkins, explorer and scientist, has a Midas touch in the world of ideas, and his questions are deep-rooted in the practical needs of mankind. It was he who asked us, in effect: Since every body, every organic being seems to have its own frequency or vibration rate, is it not possible that this special and characteristic frequency is imparted to contact objects - e.g., to clothing worn by a person, or to objects handled by him?

'And would it not be possible', he suggested, 'to isolate this constant by some means now known in radiesthesia - perhaps the Aura-meter or the pendule - and then translate the motion of the instrument into other terms by electronic devices? If so, an invaluable means of identification might be developed.'

The immense importance of such a finding (once it was taken out of the field of the esoteric and 'mystical') needs no elaboration. Consider its application in criminology, in amnesia cases, and in identifying the unknown dead in times of disaster and of war.

Is there any evidence for the existence of such a 'constant'? Here we have to address those who are familiar with the data of radiesthesia and of Psychometry. It is a fact, that if an object is touched by any person "AB", a competent psychometrist will sense, often 'see' & describe this same person (NOT "CD" or "EF") even after the lapse of many years - when he holds the object in his hands.

This is, in fact, a commonplace of occult knowledge. Every person, in fact every thing is (in Osty's words) 'a psycho-dynamic focus of energies'. Whatever we touch is marked by us with indelible traces. The AKA CORD of the HUNA lore binds it to us. Time and distance, being themselves mental forms, action-forms of our minds and of the Great Mind, are no obstacle. They are as if they did not exist. Better still, for the purpose of our argument, users of the Aurameter and of the many forms of the Pendule know very well how to pick up the 'signatures' (impressions, frequency rates) of the user or owner of any object. It is true that the hunt along these back-trails of Time may lose the scent, get onto false leads or faint and partial ones. Nevertheless it may again be swift and accurate - and the point is that we do have already 'instruments' of a sort which register frequencies and can trace (say) a garment or a scrap of paper to its owner.

There is thus a really large mass of data which point to the existence of the Constant we are looking for. Why do we call it the Fohat Constant? This esoteric term, in use for millenia, is the name for the "the principle which gives differentiation and life to cosmic matter. It is the essence of substance, out of which form is created." It should not be too hard to translate this into terms of atoms and electrons and frequencies - though still a bit caviare, no doubt, to the modest nibblings of the physicists..

But this is, obviously, not simply a matter of recognizing an auric field or magnetic field about the human body. The size, shape, condition and general appearance of this field are continually changing in harmony with varying states of mind and body. It will be necessary to find a frequency, a wave-length if you like, which belongs to "AB" as a special characteristic and which remains practically unaltered. It will also be essential that this frequency be findable in the trace which "AB" leaves on anything and everything touched by him. Whether the empty purse belonged to the victim, whether the accused seized it, whether these disfigured bodies are indeed those of "X" and "Y", whether "Z" was in this place or that as believed or doubted - these and innumerable similar questions then be answered swiftly and with finality.

Referring again to psychometry, let us recall that these mysterious operations of the human mind are as natural, as much a matter of physics, chemistry, electricity, electronics as is tuning in a wave length on your radio. Like the seer, the prophet, the clairaudient, the telepathist, the water-dowser, like any kind of 'psychic sensitive', the psychometrist 'tunes in'. There is something selective in the process - and since everything is, in a sense, electronic in nature, this rapport is expressible in terms used by the physical sciences. All these operations and phenomena imply the existence of "constants" - or the selectivity would be impossible. This is the manifestation of the FOHAT, which gives differentiation to matter and produces Form.

When we questioned one of the Mark Probert Controls about the search for a constant and characteristic frequency, he pointed out that there is one feature of the human aura which does not seem to change. This is the Corona, or ring-shaped formation above the head. It moves with the head as if fixed to it, and the Aurameter shows its shape. There is one instance on record where no Corona could be detected; thus it may not be a truly universal character. But 99 per cent (or even far less) would serve endless purposes. There are people who are, quite literally, without brains - where the brain has been destroyed by disease, and some of them lead near-normal lives.

This seemingly stable character of the Corona may be a hint worth following up. Does it have a special frequency which can be distinguished in its own area, and also in contact-objects? An a-priori answer to the first would be almost certainly, "Yes". This alone should encourage us to try to isolate it.

And Sir Hubert also inquires about signatures (in the usual meaning). A written name emanates an "auric" form; there is an invisible and characteristic shape attached to it. This may be true of any writing. If the signature of "AB" has a frequency "X...n", perhaps X...n will be findable on his latch-key, his dinner jacket or his blackjack also. . . In terms of such trivia, even of 'common' sense the question seems hardly worth while. In terms of uncommon sense and of a multitude of established facts, Sir Hubert's inquiry is as 'ingoing' and deeply important as any that can be formulated. We propose the FOHAT CONSTANT as an object for critical research - in the unified fields of electronics and radiesthesia.

FABLE OF THE LEARNED ANT

Some one, somewhere, has written the fable of the learned ant. Whether this ant was a professor in some ant-university and honored by learned societies of his kind, we do not know. He may have been only an isolated thinker and not at all representative of ant-opinion in general; we are told only that he was very modern, sceptical, intellectual and scientific in temper - and that he did not believe in the existence of men.

"Why should I believe in men" said he. "To do that I must either have some direct experience with them, or find some good reason to infer that they exist. But certainly I have never seen one, nor do I know of any facts which require the man-hypothesis. Why should I drag in ideas of men, or super-ants, or whatever they are, when natural laws of our ant world will explain everything?"

"I believe in the existence of other ants, of course; and of sticks and stones and leaves, of earth and water. I can feel heat and cold, and the movement of the air and of other ants and various objects, and at times the trembling of the earth, and I am even aware of light and darkness, and of certain odours and qualities of things about me. And I know how ants are born, and how they live and die. I know that some ants and ant-communities are fortunate and others meet with disaster, and there is even some evidence for a belief in ant-eaters.

"But for the existence of unseen and superior beings called men I can find no evidence whatever -- nor, for that matter, of other legendary creatures, such as cows, birds and fish.

"It is very easy to understand how these ideas arose. Primitive ants lived in the midst of forces they could not understand, such as wind and water, and the mysterious destruction of anthills, and to explain these they invented super-ants. Once started on this, and driven on by fears and fancies and imagination, they elaborated their inventions endlessly, and made up religions and mythologies. All of these however can be explained as natural reactions of the ant mind.

"I do not say, mind you, that ant-science has explained everything, so that there are no mysteries anywhere; but only that we go on explaining them little by little, and that there is no need to bring in fantastic ideas about super-ants or men or cows

"And that the proper study of antkind is the ant, and that the ant's whole business is to understand the life of the anthill and adjust himself to it.....

"And I do not say that ours is the best of all possible anthills, though many ants lacking in vision believe that is the case. On the contrary, the whole business of ant-science is to improve ant-hill conditions. One way to do this, is to get rid of fantastic notions

about cows, men, and fish, and to concentrate on the best methods of moving sticks and pebbles and protecting ant eggs

How long the learned ant might have continued with this discourse -- which, by the way, was much applauded by his hearers -- it is impossible to say; for at the very height of it a wandering cow put her hoof in the center of the anthep and so made an end of everything, in spite of the fact that she was only a worthless ant-hypothesis.

We want to increase this number - not quite for the usual reason, but because important events are in the making and we believe we have important information about them, NOT obtainable elsewhere. "WHERE IS THE PROOF"

Many people who are at long last beginning to awaken to the phenomena of the aeroforms, write to us asking for "proof" that the "saucers" are "real" and that our explanation of them is correct.

It would help a great deal if each inquirer would define what he means by proof, and just what kind of evidence would constitute proof to him.

"Proof" means one thing in formal logic, something else in mathematics, a third something in chemistry, a fourth something in law. The dictionary defines proof as 'evidence to convince beyond reasonable doubt.' This is the legalistic definition, and leaves open the questions: What is evidence, when is it sufficient, and when is a doubt 'reasonable'? Under this concept, proof is a highly personal and individual matter and is likely to be cumulative. We use the word in this sense in the BSRA publications, except where otherwise indicated.

As to the actuality or 'reality' of the aeroforms (discs etc.), doubt about this can arise only from ignorance of the data - thousands of sightings, in all parts of the world, past and present, thousands of printed pages about them, a half-dozen or more books and endless newspaper and magazine articles. This question is not worth answering, except by each person for himself.

Evidence of a different nature was published by us years ago, when fallen metallic fragments were analyzed at the University of Chicago. The material was not of a kind known to us in combination, though the separate metals were recognizable.

Many accounts of close-up firsthand observations of landed or hovering Discs have been printed. We cannot keep on summarizing this data.

No one can conduct you personally to a landed Disc - if that is what you mean by proof.

The November ('52) issue of TRUE magazine printed a long article on radar evidence of the discs, which should be sufficient to allay lingering doubt. But we discontinued our share in this controversy in the fall of 1946, and certainly do not think it worth while to reopen it. Many "experts" and "authorities" have ceased to argue this point, and the Air Force now openly accepts about 20% of the sightings as factual and not yet explainable - after seven years of denials and pseudo-explanations.

Concerning the "etheric explanation" - we have printed hundreds of pages on this, and have a short summary available on request. At present I only point out:

1. This interpretation meets all the demands of all the varied phenomena.
2. It was advanced by us (we did not originate it) in 1946, and nothing in the whole mass of subsequent data has invalidated it.
3. There is NO alternative explanation which covers all aspects - and it is good science and sound metaphysics. It includes the long series of historical phenomena - which we cannot summarize.

The "etheric theory" is firmly rooted and alone in its field. Examine the subject carefully for yourself and do not expect us to do all the thinking for you and to repeat facts and arguments indefinitely.

Atmospherean Photography:

For years past our Associate, the Rev. Horace A. Cronk has been collecting photographs - if that's the right word for them - of a most unusual sort. Perhaps psychographs or even skotographs would be more accurate. No camera or lens is used and - as we understand it - no effort is made to get any particular image on the plates or films. What actually appears, for the most part, is a multitude of grotesque partly formed humans and animals, whether thought-forms or low-astral entities - or probably both.

Now, the photography of thought-forms is fairly well known (as "spirit photography" is also), and almost any small group of persons experimenting in the correct way can get inchoate images on the plates. But the Rev. Cronk has made very instructive advances over such amateur results. The images received by him are in effect a path of exploration into unknown worlds - of elemental forms, prototypes or archetypes, the emergence of the forms of Netsach, probably through the unconscious mind of the experimenter (but who can say?). . . And Assoc. Cronk feels, quite justly in our opinion, that this whole subject demands and deserves serious attention by research departments in psychology, psychiatry, medicine - as also from metaphysicians and philosophers. There is plenty of material and its inchoate condition should be an incentive to research, not a deterrent.
