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

--Editorial---

AST issue we published an article concerning whether or not Americans should (be allowed to) read foreign propaganda. In it, we questioned a report that the Post Office was sending form cards to people whose foreign magazines and books were being held up pending signature of the card and filling in information which would determine whether or not the publication was ordered or requested. We doubted it seriously. However, we have received a large number of such cards from SEARCH subscribers and readers, and we'll have to admit the magazines and books are being held up, and when cards are not signed and returned, or the book's delivery demanded, the books are destroyed.

Accordingly we wrote Wisconsin Senator William Proxmire to request the specific law under which this was carried out. To date (because it's too early for a reply before we go to press with this issue) we have not received the information requested. However, our next issue will carry a full run-down on the situation. We believe that the law being used is the Foreign Agents

Registration Act, although we won't swear to this at the present writing. If this is so, it would seem, offhand that in admitting over your signature that you subscribed for, purchased, or otherwise requested the so-called foreign propaganda, you are associating yourself with the term "foreign agent" in some way.

We have received quite a few letters, all of them angry. The writers insist that they are perfectly capable of judging for themselves whether or not what they read is truth or propaganda or lie. They further insist that they do not recognize the right of the postal authorities to dictate what they shall or shall not read, no matter what its origination. One letter did express the opinion that the American Public was too stupid to avoid being infected with the propaganda untruths, and therefore should be protected from reading it. But except for this one letter, the replies were those of extreme outrage. Postmaster Summerfield's ears must surely be burning if he is by any psychic ability aware of the comments in these letters. If Postmaster

Summerfield is merely carrying out orders from the government, and is in fact enforcing the Foreign Agents Registration Act, or any other lawful Act, then it would seem that the congress of the United States is responsible; because only the Congress can make laws. This in spite of the fact that a recent Supreme Court law makes it possible for a health officer to enter a private home WITHOUT A SEARCH WARRANT in direct violation of the Constitution and Bill of Rights which guarantees the privacy of the home. All we can say about this Supreme Court decision is that to you, or anybody who possess American Citizenship, actually does allow a health officer to enter your home without a warrant, you are voluntarily relinquishing your freedom and scuttling the Constitution. Instead, you should protest it, and take legal court action to test this unconstitutional decision on the part of the Supreme Court. It is inevitable that this will be so contested. Who is to say that the man at your door is there to inspect for cockroaches, or to invade your privacy? Even credentials can be forged. Even if not forged, is this the TRUE reason for the invasion of your home? Once we let the Constitution be violated in one respect, its total collapse is inevitable. What is to prevent any other Federal or State or Local authority from demanding the *same* right of search and seizure without due process of law?

We are depending on Senator Proxmire to provide us with the facts in this matter of propaganda protection. But even before this is done, we are quite sure that it is a criminal procedure to appropriate, delay the normal delivery of, or destroy the property of any citizen of the United States. Once you have paid for, ordered, or requested that such a bit of private property be placed in the mail addressed to you. it is your property, no matter whether it has arrived at your address or not. Uncle Sam has been paid his legal fee to deliver it to you in the same manner accorded to all other mail of a like category.

Related to this, of course, is the question of whether the great mass of the common citizens of America are actually stupid (as described by one of our readers) and not to be exposed to anything that might influence their weak minds and make them run counter to what is generally accepted as patriotic Americanism. The question arises as to whether laws are actually necessary to keep us from hearing or being otherwise exposed to foreign ideol-

ogy. If we are still a free people, the answer seems obvious even if we aren't too bright, we must risk being confused rather than surrender our right to freedom of action, thought, and expression. If we must be protected by law, then we have already lost our freedom, and are already under a physical and mental slavery that can be no better than the worst of the world's past enslavements. If this is so, we have been betrayed, and by the very men we elected to defend our freedom.

When the income-tax law was enacted into the constitution by the ratification of the Amendment by the States, they were betrayed by false promises. It was promised faithfully that at no time would the income tax levy exceed 11/2 % of net income. Today the lowest tax is 20% and the highest is 95%. Even a stupid man can recognize the existence of a lie here. It is said also that the income tax is the only way our government can be financed. It takes a little more intelligent man to see that this is also a lie, but it is. We won't go into the ramifications of this right here, since we are preparing an article which will cover it at a future time. We merely mention it to bolster our suggestion that perhaps we have already surrendered our freedom.

Another instance is the right given by law to Unions to perform acts

reserved by the Constitution solely to Congress; namely the levy and collection of "taxes" (Union dues), the right to mob assembly to perform violence under the subterfuge of "picketing", the right to secrecy of handling of union (public) funds, the violation of the right not to belong to a union and still be employed wherever your services are of value to an employer, the right to charge an employer for work not done (featherbedding), and numerous other violations of individual American freedoms and rights.

The list of encroachments on our liberties is almost endless today, and is steadily being broadened. By far the darkest side of the picture is that public apathy has reached the stage where protest is not only unthinkable, but considered "un-American" or even traitorous. Not only has the American citizen been led to the water in numerous instances, but he has been MADE to drink and like it!

Today fending for yourself, now and in the future, is frowned upon. Saving for our old age is foolish, and something rather to be undertaken by the government. Thrift is a factor in depressing the economy. To wait until you can pay cash for the things you want is to throw laborers out of work, prevent manufacturers from selling a sufficient volume of their products to stay in

Only by taking on a business. mountain of debt can the position atop the mount of "prosperity" be maintained. The surrender of your independence, your safety from "foreclosure," is the only way to maintain your "standard of living". We must all have all the wonderful things (wonderful in the sense that they are incredibly shoddy and poor in quality compared to what they should be considering the technology and knowhow involved) of our stanard of living by process of "deficit spending", rather than the good old-fashioned honest "cash on the barrel-head". All because time is money. Since when! Time is a phantom, an invention, an unreality and worth nothing. We are entitled only to live, eat, clothe, house and entertain ourselves, "by the sweat of our brow". We are not entitled to be paid any sum of money. Wealth is natural resources: wealth is manufactured products; wealth is construction. Wealth is not money. Money itself is worthless, except as it can be used as a metal or a fibre. Money is merely a facility, a means of aiding the exchange of products between people. The main thing is to obtain the product you need (such as a pair of pants) not the money. We merely use the money to facilitate the obtaining of the pants. It may be difficult to find a pantsmaker who wants the egg-cup which is your production. He may have an egg-cup. But by means of money you can arrange a trade without all the complication that might otherwise be necessary. That is the sole function of money. Or it should be. Instead it is a means of focusing power, a means of enslaving people, a means of imposing one man's will on another's. In our modern civilization it has also become cumbersome and lacking in efficiency in performing the task for which it was invented. There needs to be a complete money reform, to modernize our system of exchange of goods. Today before we can exchange our egg-cup for a pair of pants, we must first construct an atom bomb. a rocket to deliver it, and maintain a force of otherwise idle men to man the rocket, ready to deliver it to anybody who threatens the transaction. The complication of this simple exchange of goods has become far greater than any previous barter system, no matter how achieved by past civilizations.

The answer is simple—we must restore our "values" to the production and distribution for use of exchange to its true valuelessness. We cannot eat money, yet today the lack of it can prevent us from eating, even if food is all about us in abundance. If, lacking money, we eat of that which lies before us, we are enemies of society and punish-

able for the crime of eating without paying.

At long last we have advanced our civilization to the point where it is no longer a problem of how to distribute a high standard of living to every human being. We possess the ability to manufacture an unlimited quantity of everything we wish to manufacture, and we possess the means of delivering it to all those who need or desire these products. The two great problems of civilization are communication and distribution. Today we have the most perfect system of communication the world has ever seen-and we witness it being rendered powerless to bring together on a level of common understanding the peoples it obviously and readily can reach, via a number of means—newspapers, books, radio, television, lectures. public gatherings, motion pictures, plays, etc. All because money stands in the way. It is too expensive to perform the function which is inherent in world - wide television, namely to let all the people meet and get to know each other, and to provide them with contact with the world's best minds in a process of education that cannot but result in complete understanding.

Today we have the greatest system of distribution ever devised by man—and money prevents all but a small amount of needed distribution. With a bulging grainary of food, people starve by millions because there is no way for them (or the would-be donors) to PAY FOR the distribution to them of the stockpiled food. Money is the barrier to a way to their mouths—and they die of starvation.

Originally we aided both communication and distribution by inventing money. Now we find it impossible to distribute the money itself, in order for it to perform as it is intended to perform. Instead of helping distribution, it prevents it in a constantly growing number of instances. Today lack of money stifles creative ideas in inventive minds, by making it impossible to put those inventive ideas into production. Expansion of production is often impossible because capital will not take the large risk of development with the certainty of little or no profit through excessive taxation. No man even tries to make a million dollars a year, when he knows that he will be forced to turn over \$950,000.00 to the tax collector. And as a result, the laborers or technicians he might employ in the process of making that million are denied employment, and in their turn, do not pay taxes, and due to the resulting lack of tax income, the rate of taxation must be increased still farther. Nor do the waiting people, who would find added comfort and happiness in acquiring the product that might have been manufactured, find their standard of living still further advanced. Instead the wonderful thing that this inventor thought of remains a "science fiction dream". Yes, we can have it, provided we agree to give up our liberties, to enslave ourselves still further!

We can let the States perform this service for us, in exchange for complete subjugation, complete regimentation, complete surrender of initiative, enterprise, freedom of expression, and place ourselves at the beck and call of a master who may be a dangerous megalomaniac intent on ruling a world bathed in the blood of his fellow-men.

Now on to another subject. Some of you may remember how we fared with U.S. Customs on the import of Williamson's book SECRET PLACES OF THE LION? Well. we thought that last January all that was finally over. On January 24 we shipped the books back to England and began to sell advertising to the English publishers for delivery through the mail. We expected that the books would arrive in England in three weeks, or at the outside, a month. But no. We weren't through with customs. Before they were finally released in England, it was late in May! More than four whole months to accomplish a journey that originally had taken three weeks! Naturally, the customers whose orders hadn't been filled on the 1500 American imports allowed us (no more for five years), had to wait. Once more the letters began to come in. Altogether, we have answered better than 3500 complaints, and have received more than 600 abusive letters. Here's one example: "Please refund my money. Also remove my name from your mailing list for any and all publications which you may handle in the future." Here's another: "If I do not receive my book in five days, I shall take action with the postal authorities." Another: "Perhaps you don't realize that you are perpetrating a fraud through the mails and obtaining money under false pretenses. If I do not receive my money within 24 hours, I shall swear out a warrant for your arrest." The next letter read: "Never have I encountered such a brazen scoundrel, to openly use the U.S. Mails to defraud!". But the final blow came in this letter: "I have followed vou since 1938 when you were editor of Amazing Stories, and have admired vou. But now I see you in your true colors-a cheat, a liar and a thief! It is two months since I sent in my order, and by now it is obvious that you do not intend to honor it. I have your letters. your advertising circular, and your

card saying the book had been shipped from England. If I do not receive \$4.00 from you within five days, I shall deliver this whole rascally portfolio of your guilt to the Postmaster General. You will go to Federal prison for this, mark my word!"

Here is a letter from Neville Spearman, the British publisher. "At last, thank God, I have received delivery of the books, and have completed shipment to each of our customers! I trust that they will have their books by May 15."

As we write this, it is June 22, and in today's mail alone, there were seven complaining letters. Obviously, the U.S. mails have reverted to pony express. How cansuch slow delivery be possible? Yet, we are waiting patiently for final delivery, and a stoppage of those letters, which have made our wife so ill that she cannot bear to open the mail, and have caused your editor to swear a solemn yow that nothing can ever break-that never again will we even hint that we have a book for sale, until it is stacked right on our editorial desk, so high that even sensational sales will not deplete the supply in less than six months!

However, we must admit that we have received also, thousands of letters from the nicest people on earth, we believe! They are understanding, patient letters, telling us they are firmly behind us, and they'll willingly wait as long as they must, to see us through! To these people, our heartfelt thanks. Further, thanks to those wonderful people who voluntarily sent donations to help cover the losses suffered through this incredible job of botching by Customs. More than \$200.00 was received, and was used to good effect to reduce our bank overdrafts!

However, it is now five months since Customs cleared these books, and was then obligated to return to us the difference in Duty charged us, the amount we paid on the 2000 copies which had to be returned, and on which we received a letter saving the forfeiture had been remitted. To date, we have received no answer from numerous letters requesting refunding of the money due us. More than \$400.00. Even our import agents, in New York, have written to customs authorities, reminding them that no action has been taken to return our money to us.

Several of our readers have gone to lawyers, and written us that we have grounds for suit, and that there is no question that we have been miserably treated, without the slightest legal justification. These readers have suggested that this whole horrible sequence of events cannot be accidental, that it is a clear case of persecution carried on because the book involved is part of the flying saucer subject, which we so completely report to our readers. Our private opinion is that this is not the case, because we just don't believe that this can be so. It couldn't be that our American freedom has been so subverted that we have a secret police state with hired persecuters; It must be nothing more than simple bureaucracy, simple ineptitude, simple official incompetence!

We intend to prove that we are right. We have a half-dozen more books we feel must be published. We are going to go ahead with them.

We will publish at least one every six months. Each one will be far more important than any we have published to this date. None of them will be held up in the slightest by an official agency.

All this has given us an idea. We know that many of you have been with us for many years, some for as many as thirty years. Since the first book we wish to publish in 1959 is the all-important first volume of THE SHAVER MYSTERY, and the second is the photo-copied edition of the 1881 OAHSPE, (censored and destroyed shortly after its publication), we have hit upon the idea of forming

what we'll call the "1881 Club". This will be a club of those of you who are actually backing us up (such as the reader who has already donated \$300.00 toward the cost of publishing THE SHAVER MYS-TERY!). We propose that all of you who want to see this 1881 OAHSPE faithfully photographed and reprinted, exactly as it appeared in 1881, write us and say: "I want to join the 1881 club." Don't do anything else. Don't send any money. Just say you want to join, and that when we notify you we've acquired the necessary number of members, you will send your \$10.00 for your copy. How many members do we need? Well, it will cost approximately \$4000.00 to photograph this tremendous book. will probably cost \$8000.00 print the first 1000 copies. Figure it out for yourself - we need 800 members. And on future books. we will need no more than that membership to ensure immediate publication of any book we want to publish and we feel it is important to publish. Our aim is, and always has been, freedom of speech (secondarily), but most important, the business of urging people to think, to think for themselves, and to provide something to think about. It doesn't matter what they think, only that they do think. It is the only way in which our civilization

can be saved from the unintellectual morass into which it is slowly and hypnotically sinking. Man's ability to think is what makes him different from the animal. Today thinking is being destroyed.

Thinking should be done on what might be termed a philosophical level. We cannot think about comparatively simple things, like recipies for various kinds of soups the scope is limited. We must send our minds out into the vast reaches of time, space, matter, energy and imagination. We must also learn to exercise our thoughts so that they become facile things. Such books as we publish achieve that purpose. Of themselves, they may not be even a partial answer to human problems, human advancement. They are probably only exercises which more deep thought will cause us to discard because we conceive of more satisfactory concepts.

Up to now we've been doing it haphazardly: we have been looking at our checkbook and by its lack of balance deciding that a certain book cannot be published because there is no way to finance it. Now we intend to form a hard core of militant minds whose purpose will be strong, whose number need not be large, and whose small and extremely easy individual financial backing will insure publication of any and all books with no more

delay than is absolutely necessary to perform the actual editorial work. That work we will be delighted to do.

There are many book clubs. Many of you belong to one or more. You agree to buy four books a year, and select from a number of titles offered. Sometimes none of the titles appeal to you, but you buy anyway, because you are a club member. The 1881 Club will send you a letter each time a book is available for publication, tell you what it is, and ask whether or not you want it published. The most pretentious book will require no more than 800 backers. And the backers will get only the books they want to read.

As soon as we have received 800 members, you will receive a letter, and the 1881 OAHSPE will be on the way to the printer. The first SHAVER MYSTERY book is already on the way to the printer, financed as our other books have been (in spite of what the Customs fiasco cost us on SECRET PLACES OF THE LION.)

Perhaps some of you can see what has happened to us in the past six months. Our ire has been thoroughly aroused. For thirty years we've let circumstances kick us around, and our achievements, though gratifying, have been only a fraction of what we desired to do.

Why should as few as 800 people who really want to think, who really want "food for thought" published so that they can avail themselves of it, be continually frustrated by the great masses of people who want only to renounce their Godgiven responsibility to have dominion over the Earth, and to subdue it? Up to now we've had the egotistic notion that nobody else wanted to do what we have been trying to do; publish thoughtful books for thoughtful people. We've not considered that there are most certainly at least 800 friends of ours who have been backing us for thirty years, who would be delighted if we'd admit that all 800 of them are eager and anxious to do the same thing. So we're asking that you step forward and offer to split the job equally. With so many helping hands, how could it be anything but the simplest of tasks to publish any book desired?

The 1881 Club will be to place the complete Shaver Mystery, as we have collected it during the past fifteen years, into comprehensive book form to provide what we know to be wonderful and permanent tool of the future thinkers to use in furthering the advancement of man's dominion over the planet he was commanded to subdue.

Beginning with the next issue of SEARCH, be on the lookout for a

different SIZE magazine. Instead of digest size, as this one is, we are enlarging our page size to conform with FLYING SAUCERS. That is, instead of having a magazine 5 3/8" x 7 1/4", we will have a magazine 6 3/8" x 9 1/4". We will reduce the number of pages, but in the process the larger sheet will give us the same wordage content as before. The reasons for these changes are many. First, it will save us money, by virtue of allowing both magazines to be printed on the same press. Being lighter in weight, it will cost less to ship. Reproduction of photographs will be clearer, and type will be more legible. Cover size will be larger, and easier to find on the newsstands, also giving us more space to display the features contained therein. Covers of both SEARCH and FLYING SAUCERS can be printed at the same time on the same sheet of paper, which will result in still further saving. All in all, we think you'll find it a better magazine. and it will greatly strengthen our position.

So remember, the next issue of SEARCH will show up better on your newsstand, and you should be able to find it much easier — but if you look only at the rack with digest-sized magazines in it, you might easily miss finding your favorite magazine.

SAINT GERMAIN and the NEW AGE

The New Age is termed Permanent because of many new provisions and safe guards among which is one of the most important -the expanded Christ-Agent within each heart. This, of course, is the "Second Coming", how else can an age be permanent unless this transmuting and directive mentor be brought to bear and guide each personality?

In the coming age the organization known as the Great White Brotherhood is to gently incorporate into itself the rest of mankind bringing about true unity, true love, true brotherhood. Speaking of brotherhood it is well to note that the new religion and age has had its fitting inception in the city of Brotherly Love, where stands that other great symbol of freedom; Independence Hall with its "Liberty" Bell.

In past ages and religions nontheism and polytheism were integrated into different eras resulting usually in a golden age, but unfortunately as soon as the seed of decay "took root" and the people left their gods the moral fibre crumbled resulting in degradation. As will be gathered from the above, among the major precepts of this new way, is instruction concerning certain already well known ideas regarding reincarnation. The public already has had a fresh dose of this in having books like "Bridey Murphy" etc., presented before its consciousness.

Belief will now be supplemented with true faith; with knowledge. Dogma may not bring about the necessary transformation unless it is accompanied with personal experience and development which in the case of some present disciples is quite extraordinary verging on sainthood.

The new Religion and Age is to bring about the lowering of the Kingdom of Heaven upon the earth in the form of exquisite architecture (which beginning can already be seen); numerous temples dedicated to the different etheric flames—which will be visible by then, and the many facets of perfection such as clothing the earth in a garden and, of course, the most beautiful part will be the externalization of the Christ within each heart.

The Seventh Age, as pointed out, will be directed by Saint Germain; "the Wonder Man of Europe" (not to be confused with an imposter who used his name). It has been his dream of forming the United States of Europe, which finally culminated in the United States of America. MAGIC

inderella's fairy godmother waved a magic wand and transformed Cinderella from a scullery maid into a princess! To most of us this is a myth - a fairy tale.

That there are practicing magicians with such powers living in our world today, few people realize. By magician, we do not mean a sleight-of-hand artist, but one who has secret knowledge of how to contact night forces, and how to control and use these forces to recreate and control his life and the lives of others, in this world and the next.

Such magicians are unknown, for they keep their art a secret; except for the dedicated few who wish to share their knowledge with the rest of mankind. Yet, according to a most erudite and interesting little book, MAGIC, by W. E. Butler (Aquarian Press, London), magicians who actually wave a magic wand do exist. There are black magicians, also. Aleister Crowley, the poet and author, was reputed to be one of these. Magic can be used for good or for evil.

Real magicians have always exist-

ed. The art goes back to the very beginnings of life on this planet. Primitive man was well acquainted with magic, as we have learned from examination of his cave paintings. These paintings were all made for magical purposes, made in order to control the forces of nature. A painting of a bison with an arrow through its heart was made to insure successful hunting. In conjunction with the painting, the cave man used certain rituals that, in a refined form, are still in use by magicians today. These rituals aroused the necessary emotional energy to print the paintings on the subconscious mind of the hunter and to transfer it to the group-mindto the formative world.

Do people with magical powers really exist today? Yes! Of a famous woman magician, founder of a famous occult school, it was said that she had the power to move articles by her will (as is done in Dr. Rhine's experiments with telekinesis at Duke University), that she had power over the fire elementals (a night art which uses the spiritual force behind fire), that she had

power to influence others with her silent will (telepathy, in its perfected state, which has long been known to adepts), that she had power to link students with their own high self (the spark of God within which has all the powers of God), and that she had power to link students with the western masters, those who have reached perfection, yet stay on the lower planes in order to teach aspiring mankind.

People in the Orient have long practiced these arts. Amazing stories have come out of the East, brought by travellers who were astonished, but firmly convinced that such powers exist. Eastern adepts have been known to teleport an oil painting from one continent to another (from Paris to Calcutta) this fact being proven on the authority of the Paris Surete, who were called in to investigate the matter. Madam David-Neel, who studied with Eastern teachers, tells how she materialized a lama by creating him with her thoughts, and tells also how the lama followed her party, finally turning into such a menacing figure that she was compelled to dematerialize him, after much effort,

That there is a Western form of yoga called magic, which teaches Western people to attain to the accomplishments of Eastern yoga is known only to a few. This Western form of yoga is the only form suit-

able to the Western brain and body, and to the busy life that Western people lead.

Western yoga or magic stems from our earliest civilizations-the Chaldean, the Babylonia, the Assyrian, the Greek and the Roman. It was synthesized by the Jewish peoples, who were able to do so because of their naturally endowed keen minds, and because of their strategic geographical location in Palestine, at the veritable crossroads of civilization. Here they came into contact with all of these cultures, as well as with the cultures of India and the East. Abraham came from Chaldea and brought with him the knowledge of its priests. Moses, as we are told in the Bible, was "learned in all the wisdom of Egypt", and the Bible also gives us a vivid description of his magical powers.

One of the Jewish cults which taught these arts was the Essenes, and tradition tells us that Jesus spent those unaccounted-for eighteen years of his life, training, not only with the Essenes, but with all of the known mystery schools of his day. Legend says he was taken to them by Joseph of Arimathea, a tin merchant. William Blake in his poem "JERUSALEM" refers to the legend that Jesus visited England to be initiated into the Druid Mysteries:

"And did those feet in ancient time

Walk upon England's mountain green?

And was the Holy Lamb of God On England's pleasant pastures seen?"

Magical teachings, because they can be used for good or for evil, and because they are dangerous for anyone to use unless his knowledge and technique are perfect, were kept from the ignorant and the profane. Wise men, who had the tradition passed on to them orally, formed into schools to compare and perfect their wisdom, to experiment with it, and to train pupils who might pass it on to those of mankind ready for it.

For political reasons these schools were forced underground when Christianity was made the state religion in order to strengthen the Roman Empire. In the twelfth century, in Spain, the occult wisdom was gathered together and written down for the first time, but the authors so veiled it in symbolism that it was almost impossible for a layman to interpret it. After this. many Jewish schools of magic revived in Europe. One was the school of Chassidism, in Poland, in the eighteenth century, from which went out wandering rabbis, who travelled about Poland doing magical works, and who were known as "Tsadikim".

In the nineteenth century there was a revival of knowledge of magic due to a mysterious manifesto. which, though issued much earlier, was several hundred years in coming to the attention of certain Englishmen. This manifesto, published by a secret order, explained what could be accomplished by magical workings. Tradition has it that long before the Reformation, a German nobleman, educated by monks, made a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. While at Damascus, he learned of the secret science of magic, and was initiated into a secret order of magicians.

The nobleman monk went on to Fez, in Africa, for he had been told in Damascus that all the wise men (magi) of every country in the world, gathered in Fez once a year, to compare findings to magic and to refine their art. Here the monk was initiated into these mysteries.

After further travel, the monk returned to Germany, and realizing that this priceless information must be passed on to the deserving of mankind, he founded a secret retreat, digested his studies, continued them, accepted a few pupils, and founded the first modern school of occult instruction in the Western world, with the possible exception of the Knight Templars, who also learned these arts from the East.

MAGIC 23

In the middle of the last century, a deacon of the Roman Catholic Church (which retains many pagan magical practices in its rituals), one Alphonse Constant, who wrote under the psuedonym of Eliphas Levi, published certain books on magic. Levi had discovered the teachings of the German monk. His amazing books started a revival of interest in magical things, and a group of English Freemasons started an occult school in England for the purpose of obtaining the ancient wisdom.

One of the leaders of this school, MacGregor Mathers, found in a bookstall on Caledonia Road, in London, a peculiar manuscript, written in code. Code was the hobby of Mathers, and he soon deciphered the manuscript. To his amazement it turned out to be a statement concerning hidden and secret teachings, purporting to come from a group in touch with the true German order which had been founded by the monk. It gave the name and address of a German baroness, an adept, who had been taught all of the knowledge of the true order.

Mathers and his friends, among whom was Aleister Crowley, immediately got in touch with the Baroness, and received authority to establish an occult school of magical teachings in England. Thus was started the famous Order of the Golden Dawn, to which belonged the writers, A. E. Waite and Arthur Machen, as well as the Nobel Prize winning poet, William Butler Yeats. It is also rumored that many other famous men belonged, among them Arnold Bennett.

From this original order of the Golden Dawn stemmed all the authentic occult schools of England and America, some of them established by the initiated who had true access to the secret knowledge, others established by pupils who had broken away before obtaining the teachings in full.

One of the authentic schools in America today is the School of Gnostics, which gives correspondence courses to those found worthy of it. This school was founded by adepts, whose authority traces back to the original order. These adepts brought the ancient secret teachings in line with the modern teachings of science and psychology.

The School of Gnostics derives its authority from the true source of the mysteries, extending back to Enochian, Egyptian and Chaldean schools.

What does the School of Gnostics teach? What are the magical workings? What are these ageless secrets men have offered their very souls to obtain? What are the wonderful powers which magic confers, powers for which the old alchemists

toiled in secrecy over their flaming crucibles, as Jung has explained in his book PSYCHOLOGY AND AL-CHEMY?

The secret wisdom teaches that God manifests in many ways, in different streams of cosmic power. Tesus, for example, was one manifestation of God as love, Buddha was a manifestation of God as wisdom. This idea is expressed in pagan religions by the various gods and goddesses of their pantheons. The pagans, the Jewish Cabbalists, all the old religions, realized that God. or cosmic energy has many aspects. He is wisdom, love, beauty, power, glory, mercy - and many other universals. The School of Gnostics teaches that man is the universe, or God, in miniature, a reflection of God, and that through realization of, and awakening of these powers, man reaches his true goal, harmony with the cosmos. This union with God is called in the East, yoga.

These powers can be contacted and brought forth into manifestation. The Catholic priest in the magical ceremony of the Mass, actually contacts God and is able to transmit to his communicants.

These powers can be contacted and manifested by secret symbols and secret rituals, which have become stabilized in the astral world and are ancient channels through which power is poured. The School of Gnostics teaches that God is more than love, that He is, for example, power and omnipotent wisdom, and that by a system of mind-training and by the performance of certain secret and carefully guarded rituals; rituals used and perfected through countless ages, and by the knowledge of certain secret archetypes and symbols known only to members of the School, these aspects of God can be awakened and dynamized in man, giving man what would be called by the majority of people, supernatural powers.

These powers are latent in all of us-the evolved man of the future will use them as easily as we use our five senses. The teachings are a short cut, a forcing house of evolution. The final goal of evolution is that man become a god. Jesus said this.

The secret wisdom is based on sound psychological and scientific principles, and it conforms to the teachings for the great psychologist, Dr. Carl Jung, of Zurich, who has been called the Darwin of psychology. Jung calls these powers of the mind Archetypes of the Collective Unconscious, and his theory of the integration of the personality, which is the bringing of these archetypes into consciousness, is very similar to what is attempted in occult ritual.

The School of Gnostics takes this idea much further. Certain secret

symbols and thought processes, related to the natural process of creation through countless eons, are given to the pupil in order to enable to use the energy of the cosmos he needs for greater achievement. One can see the advantage of this over many modern concepts of prayer, which tend toward asking and begging. These symbols bring cosmic power into man's subconsciousness, and whatever man is conscious of, he can control and manipulate. The student of psychology will recognize that this is the theory upon which psychoanalysis works. The secret wisdom is a combination of psychoanalytic psychology, with the addition of the means for invocation of healing forces and the awakening in man of the powers of the universe.

The secret wisdom teaches that man's destiny is in his own hands, so far as he is able to control the powers of his own mind. Its basic principles is similar to "positive thinking", but it goes much further than "positive thinking" in its esoteric psychology, on to the positive association of subconscious thoughts, which is one of the secrets of manifestation in the material world the secret of why we and our environment are as they are.

What does the students of magic learn? Some of the secrets are too powerful to be divulged except to

the purest initiate. Some pupils find the philosopher's stone, that magical jewel which turns all it touches into gold. Some find the elixir of life. Some find rejuvenation of mind and body. In the course of his training the student learns the true secret of telepathy. He learns how to project his thoughts into, and to control another mind. There are many examples of people cured of drunkenness and insanity by this method. The student learns how to project his desires into the formative world where all must originate before materialization. He learns to contact spiritual forces by symbols, by rituals and by divination. He learns the psychic arts of clairvoyance and clairaudience. He learns a definite technique of how to project the astral body, to travel on this and other planes of existence. He learns Tattwa vision and of the Tattwa Tides. His powers of concentration, memory, intuition, creative imagination, judgment enormously increased.

He learns how to make his dreams come true, to be transformed from the scullery maid to the Princess, from the beast to the beautiful youth.

He first learns to control his own mind and body and emotions - then to control his environment and all in it. This is truly "waving a magic wand." (Concluded on page 35)

IS IT "ALL IN YOUR MIND"?

rthur Constance, as quoted in the article "A Britisher Predicts the Future" (SEARCH, June 1959), categorically asserts that there will be no landings on other heavenly bodies, even the moon, by so-called "human beings." This assertion is firmly seconded by Ray Palmer in his postscript to the mentioned article.

Enigmas- Hints- Perhaps! If so, let us now remove the wraps and see why there will be no landings anywhere beyond earth's "atmosphere".

Major David G. Simons, of the U.S. Army, made, in August 1957, what was said to be the highest flight in history. He reached 102,000 feet—nineteen miles—in a balloon. This was 6,000 feet higher than attained by Captain Joseph Kittinger in June of the same year. I have temporarily misplaced my clipping of the Kittinger flight, but do have one of the A.P. story issued August 21 from Fargo, N.D., concerning Maj. Simons. Therefore I cannot state with certainty which of the men was questioned, on reaching

earth again following his flight, just what he thought about "God" while up so high and alone; but whichever it was, he replied, "THIS IS GOD!"

A singularly odd remark to make, to say the very least. But come to think of it, why, in the first place, should anyone ever have had the bright idea of asking a flyer, at the termination of such a flight. "What did you think of 'God' while you were up there?" Seems that they would have asked, "Did you get cold?" or "Were you lonely?" or "Could you see anything outof-the-ordinary, which would be interesting to tell about?" But no: "What did you think of 'God'?" And the reply: "THIS IS GOD!" Passing strange, eh? And whatever could the man have meant by that reply?

In his book on scientific and psychic anomalies published in English translation by Harper's in 1920 as L'INCONNU: THE UNKNOWN, Camille Flammarion, the French scientist and philosopher, quotes from an older work, THE

LAST DAYS OF A PHILOSO-PHER by Sir H. Davy. This quote (page x1 footnote) reads as follows:

The great chemist Sir Humphry Davy, the first man who experimented with protoxide of azote (in 1799), during his first experiments breathed too powerful a dose and lost consciousness. During this brief space of apparent annihilation he experienced extraordinary cerebral impressions, which he remembered on awaking, at least so far as concerned their metaphysical consequences. His ideas, recalled with energy, burst forth in this sudden exclamation, which he uttered in the tone of one inspired, "Nothing exists but thoughts. The Universe is composed of impressions, ideas, pleasures, and pains!"

Therefore . . .? Therefore, THERE IS NO MOON and THERE ARE NO PLANF'S, but ALL ARE BUT REFLECTIONS OR PROJECTIONS FROM HU-MAN MIND. The simple, but often devastating Truth, is, that MAN IS GOD and he MOVES A-BOUT, OR SEEMS TO MOVE, WITHIN THE ILLUSIONARY **EXCRETION OR PROJECTION** FROM HIMSELF. NO ONE MAN, AND NO SMALL GROUP OF MEN. COULD POSSIBLY EXIST AT SUCH A DISTANCE FROM THE HUMAN MENTAL- MATRIX OR MASS-MIND-FIELD AS THE MOON AND PLANETS ARE SAID TO BE, FOR A MAN ONLY HAS EX-ISTENCE WITHIN THE COM-MON CONTEXT.

This is a surpassingly simple Truth, yet it is ever one that is complicated when the effort is made to verbalize it. Let us revert to the language of the Vedas and Upanishads, and the teachings of the Hindu and Tibetan (and Jewish Kabbalistic and Hawaiian Huna) Masters of Yoga, and say that ALL EXISTENCE AS WE "KNOW" IT IS MAYA, AN IL-LUSION CONSTRUCTED OF (electro-magnetism-FIRE-MIST mind), AND HAS NO REALITY WHATEVER OUTSIDE OF AND APART FROM THE CONSCI-OUSNESS OF MAN HIMSELF Man will not visit the moon and planets, for the simple reason that they exist only within his own mind ... are hallucinations, no more and no less!

ETHER CONCEPT REINSTATED

"LEGALIZED LYNCHING OF THE 'WORLD-ETHER'!"

(Discovery, Comparative Confrontation, and Protest)

the late Dr. Hermann Fricke, Ph.D.
(Translated, paraphrased and edited by V. M. Waage)

Prologue: This is an unpublished German manuscript titled "Justizmord am Weltaether", dated 1948 and received directly from its author, Hermann Fricke (1876-1949) of Berlin. This momentous rebuke of Science's intellectual coup d'etat sets the record straight for all open-minded readers. Each numbered complex of claims by Orthodox Opinion is given in italics and is followed with the ordinary type-face by Fricke's knowledgeable replies, paraphrased as the original grammatical construction of German text is usually prodigious. The remarks enclosed in brackets are supplied by the translator.

(1) The physicists of the twentieth century have discovered an altogether new world-picture, through which Classical Physics must be overthrown, Planck's Quantum Theory and Einstein's Relativity Theory require a new style of thinking, such that Physics also becomes as unitelligible and abstract as the modern paintings. Thereby the riddles of the spherical Cosmos and the origin of the energy of the Sun are but solved. We must take future leave from Logic' and common sense, in the stately science of Theoretical Physics. (Paul Fechter in the Deutsche Rundschau. Feb. 1934.)

Had the Ether-vortex theory of the 19th century been allowed to evolve into correct extensions, these should have furnished much better explanations. The quantities, for long-familiar atoms, portend no new attitude taken up, nor any new mode of thinking opposed to the philosophical. The Ether-hydromechanics offers much better and thoroughly intelligible explanations for the Sun and stars. Whereas the "world-picture of Modern Physics" is for the most part a phantom illusion that contains monstrous misunderstandings, the Ether hydromechanics can only enlighten the simple common sense.

(2) Einstein has done away with the Ether. The world is, for the most part, an empty space, in electrons and atomic nuclei, etc. as shost-saturated, on account of differential equations representing fields of force.

Already, Descartes had to repuliate the "emptiness" of space. It s absurd to retain the notion that nihility could have extension. In ight, in radio, in electromagnetic fields of force, in gravitation and in nertial resistance, Space is one i.e. the same versatile agent for all phenomena], graspable without nuch ado as perceptible substance, he hydromechanically intelligible Ether. The lines of force are streamshreds [for an electric field, but eddy-filaments in stream-surfaces of shear for the magnetic-flux vector component]; the atoms [are specialy assembled doughnut-like | vorcices in the Ether. (Vortex atom theories from Helmholtz down to Krafft.)

(3) The "world-picture of Modern Physics", as advocated by Kiene, Westphal, Moeglich, Pascal Jordan, Heisenberg, von Weizsaecker, Planck and Einstein, came forth without the Ether. The Ether had been invented in the 17th century by Newton in order to account for its "absolute space". Einstein has done away with that. This is universally recognized, and the Ether

is omitted as superfluous from all textbooks.

[Oh, not quite all "textbooks"; how about Einstein's 1922 book? After having been an opostate one from Etherism for some years. Albert Einstein had actually reconverted himself into a believer in the Ether-whether mobile or stagnant is not peripherally obvious-since in his 55-page book titled "Sidelights on Relativity", Methuen & Co., London, 1922, he himself reinstated the Ether in his chapter "Ether and the Theory of Relativity, space without ether is unthinkable." However, Einstein never to have corrected his opinion that the "concept of motion cannot be applied to it", whereas it would be difficult to see what would be left of an Ether after it had been deprived of internal relative flow -Waage.]

The "doing away" [or frustrational giving-up] of the Ether is by no means recognized by all physicists, e.g. not by Zehnder Nernst. Wiechert, Wiener, Gehrcke Lenard, Tomaschek, Ruckhaber. Hilgenberg and Fricke. The "doing away" fantasy became permitted by separate examples covered in favor of Planck, Westphal, Kienle and von Weizsaecker, and by means of this fantasy there ensued a stampede of suppression [such as crackpot-bating] or pertinent, clear.

open discussions of opinion in scientific literature, which require the basic questions of Physics and Astronomy. In opposition to this "doing away" fantasy, there had been founded a "Society for World-Ether Research and Intelligible Physics". It cooperated with the Ether-Vortex Society contemplated in the U.S.A. by Krafft and Waage [in 1938. Neither of these anti-subversive organizations survived, but it is hoped that they will be revived. —Waage.]

The modern Ether-vortex theory was founded by Descartes. Newton, even as the first, had "done away with" the Ether. Concerning the antithesis of both of them, Voltaire said:

"When a Frenchman comes to London, he finds a great dissimilarity. In Paris he finds the whole world full of matter; in London he finds it completely empty. In Paris he sees the world fulfilled by the vortices of the Ether, during the time that in London invisible forces put in motion its performance."

This antithesis still persists today, and it is time, at last, to elucidate it.

(4 Einstein's "special Relativity theory", with the intelligible Ether repugnant thereto, became suppressed by the Nazis out of race-prejudice (etc), his universal recognition_now standing no longer in their way. Einstein himself said ("Telegraf" for Sept. 25, 1947): "One hundred Nazi professors have written a book against it."

A great press today disseminates Einstein's (hypnotic?) mass-suggestion, "special Relativity theory" as universally demonstrated recognized. The experiments (e.g. by Sagnac) speak against Einstein. Also Hitler was by 1938 "universally recognized". Prior to the Nazi era, Dr. E. Ruckhaber, together with two Jews, had written the excellent book "Hundert Autoren gegen Einstein", v. Voigtlaender. Leipzig 1931, which Einstein became afraid of through his illogic over harm toward Judaism. Surely Einstein must have known that!

(5) Einstein is surely the "Father of the Atom Bomb" ("Kurier" of Sept. 9, 1948), the giant success of "modern physics".

I do not know about that. The atomic bomb depends on the discovery of radioactivity through Becquerel and of radium through the married couple Curie. This case has yet to be clarified anew by a "Society for World-Ether Research", under these circumstances. The transformation of atoms under Etheric irradiation, follows from the self-evident nature of vortexatoms, and has not required to be "discovered" first by Einstein.

It is widely held that nuclear fission was clarified, in 1939 and subsequently, by use of the formula E = Mc². Einstein had published this mass-energy formula in September 1905 in Annalen der Physik, claiming that he had discovered it after the publication of a previous (1005) article of his. If this formula has only an abstract geometric basis for it, then indeed this aspect of it is his innovation. But in July 1904 F. Hasenoehrl published a mathematical paper on Etheric resonators, in which he derived for electro-magnetic mass the formula $M = E/c^2$ and this energy-mass relation is inconspicuously located amid such figuring near the bottom of his paper, which anyone can locate (with the aid of an author index) by reference to Hasenoehrl, Annalen der Physik, vol. 15; p. 363 (1904). For those who realistically prefer "electromagnetic energy-mass" to hypergeometric relativistic mass-energy, Hasenoehrl and not Einstein discovered the formulation first. (Let's hope no Einstein fan would tear that page out!) -Waage.]

(6) The Einsteinian Relativity theory, which Fricke takes for complete nonsense, explains the apparent right of the spiral nebulae from the Earth (a red shift), the expansion of the Universe, and the diameter of the World through the

4th dimension.

These are all highly disputable speculations. The apparency of flight of the piral nebulae is explained much more simply by a fatigue of light, also numerically as figured out in my Urheberschrift No. 2, page 5. Einstein's and Planck's discoveries, so far as they are established as actually true, permit of much simpler intelligibility in 3 dimensions [as in the better relativity theory by G.D. Birkhoc mentioned in an April 1944 Science News Letter | through the Ether hydromechanics and without any "revolt in Physics". Cf. Deutschen optischen Wochenschrift 1948. No. т6.

(7) Toward the close of the 19th century it was known that transverse waves, of the fashion of light, are possible only in solid bodies not fluids. Lorentz, in his theory of electrons, established the Ether as a stationary solid which is equivalent to the coordinate system of Newton's absolute space.

Transverse waves are also possible in fluids having friction. In speaking, we deal with Ether waves as we do with air waves, and explain this analogy in terms of internal motion, which is one million times more rapid in the Ether than in air. Frictional viscosity is resistance on the part of adjacent stream-layers against their relative

shear-displacement. It is also [associable with] continuity and [for high magnitudes] explains its apparent soldity [or rigidity]. On account of its internal vortex movements, the Ether appears, for the most part, solid and stationary, but to some degree it flows [where it is not isotropic] in waves, in streamshreds, magnetic flux lines, or radiations. (Observations of Helm, Lenard and Fricke.) The "contradictions" in the Ether experiments, maintained by Planck and Westphal, are by no means actual.

(8) Space is, according to Einstein, entirely empty and energyless. The energy is confined to the atomic nuclei and electrons.

[Nihilitarian wishful thinking.] Space is even more saturated with radiant energy. This is so highly penetrating, that it avoids provisional measurement. Nernst, who names it "zero-point energy", estimates its order of magnitude in gram-calories per cubic centimeter to be at least the sixteenth power of ten; Wiechert, the twenty-third power. Lodge estimated it at one followed by twenty-nine ciphers. The atom's energy is therefore in reality Ether energy.

(9) The motion of the Earth through absolute space or Ether must, according to Lorentz, raise an Ether "wind". That this is not actual, was demonstrated by Mi-

chelson's experiment. Ether-winds and absolute space are declared to be by no means actual; the Michelson experiment demonstrated that there is no Ether. It is compensated for, through Einstein's "special Relativity theory".

The Ether wind, which is formed by the motion of the Earth, is clearly discernable in the daily barometric fluctuations [i.e. a cyclic rise and fall in atmospheric pressure per quadrant twice every 24 hours, as found at the equator by N. Hann | (Cf. Urheberschrift No. 34: "Entdeckung des Aetherwindes - Widerlegung der Relativitaetstheorie".) The Ether's resistance must be compensated for. through an unknown component in the complete field, and this component is formed by the Sun's rotation in accordance with analogy to magnetism. For that reason the resistance must be by-passed by the Michelson-Morley experiment. which is not fortuitous in the phenomenon. The Ether, without much ado, is perceptible in radio. Einstein's assertion that the velocity of light is constant relative to entirely separate moving observers, is downright madness. Therefore, so is also his "special Relativity theory", which Westphal would dictate to us positively.

(10) Also Lodge found by his experiment no Ether.

The experiment by Lodge was falsely worked out, when he employed an almost massless disk, from which the Ether received no appreciable influence. He was required to employ a great mass.

(II) The effects of electrical force are not to be contemplated as mechanical, but are phenomena's peculiar breed. —Westphal,

An assertion grasping full from the air. The dominant and basic electromagnetic equations by Maxwell are wholly derived from primitive hydromechanical conceptions. (Cf. Ostwald's *Classics* No. 69 and No. 102; also the hydromechanics by Bjerknes.)

(12) Gravitation is not energy radiation, but only a force, which has dimensions other than what heat radiation has.

Wind pressure also has other dimensions than the wind currents, which transport energy. Just so is it possible that an Ether-current is involved in the basic causation of the force of gravitation. Einstein himself wrote to me:

"Your opinion, that the gravitational fields continue to feed gravitating masses energy, is without doubt interesting and original. That one can explain satisfactorily the temperatures of the stars through a pleasing interpretation, as according to earlier hypotheses, seems to be the

ruin of even me."

(13) The celestial bodies by inertia move without friction through empty space, according to Newton, and are guided by universal massattraction. Newton's formulae have established their own truth a thousandfold.

The celestial bodies move, according to Descartes, in vortices of the Ether. Newton's gravitational force-field of mass-attraction permits of comprehensible intepretation as a characteristic Ether-vortex field, by finest internal construction. The false impression as to the "emptiness" of space had its beginning in Astronomy by this trick of Nature, that in intrinsic opposition to the retarding or frictional forces in space there were maintained in balance hitherto-unnoticed accelerating counter-forces. Newton's formulae are merely first approximations and are verifiable to some extent only in the small proportions of our planetary systems with their mass-points. Besides this, within gaseous atmospheres having enormous friction, the rotating giant stars disagree with Newton's mass calculations drastically!

(14) The Ether hydromechanics of the 19th century according to Maxwell and Lord Kelvin conceived of the Ether as a "frictionless" fluid.

This is their radical fault and the cause of incredible misunderstandings. By 1905 I understood that the apparent frictionlessness of the ether restores itself through an equilibrium of forces. Magnetism is friction [rather: adapts the viscidity] of the Ether. (Cf. my paper: "On the Internal Friction of the Optical Ether as the Cause of Magnetic Phenomena", Wolfenbuettel, 1909.)

(15) The equilibrium of radiation of the Sun and stars is explicable only by means of internal atomic energy sources. (Eddington and Kienle.)

It is much simpler than this, explicable by means of hidden energies of radiation contained in the surrounding Ether, whereby the temperature of the atmospheres of stars is determined by the intensity of the gravitational potential field, in proportionality to the force of gravity. (Fricke's Law.) [This proportionality applies not only to subtle quasi-optical energies of the Ether, which atmospheric molecules may not exhibit sufficient velocityresonance for, but also to the energy-density of incident cosmic-ray primaries and secondaries, which is nearly 30 times greater on the Sun than in the Earth's atmospheric hot layer—Waage.]

(16) Geology shows, with its primeval rocks, that the Earth was

at one time glowing liquid, like the Sun yet now.

Geologists reiteratedly take the primeval rocks today for re-circumsmelted sedimentary rocks. Frictional heating by perpetual displacements of continents on the "restless Earth", explains all internal heating of the unconstrained Earth. [See Jules Verne's insertion of this idea-anticipated prior to Fricke-into the novel about a subterranean exploratory journey from Iceland to Sicily. The theory of Kuhn, according to which the interior of the Earth consists largely of "disintegrating matter", I take to be absurd. Why do the "Natural Sciences" propagate such theories. but silence mine as (much too) well-confirmed "dead"?

[NOTE: For lack of space, it is necessary to omit Fricke's material about physical problems of the suns and stars. His closing paragraph winds up the sense of the title of this article.]

atomic bomb, the suggestion by the prevailing opinion is so strong that no astronomer dares to examine or to discuss any other opinion. The representatives of the press speak only in a fanatical style—a mystical trance from Einstein—and are afraid to have to do with anything outstanding, other than something else that they believe in. Thus

Kienle, Westphal, von Weizsaecker and others are able to surround my discovery and solutions to riddles. with an "iron curtain". Only in exceptional cases ("Telegraf" of Jan. 18, 1948 and "Welt" of June 29, 1048) does one risk it, to preserve something. Even Brockhaus's Encyclopedia asserts the Ether to be "obsolete". Goethe's words therefore have value for today:

"In newspapers and encyclopedias, in schools and universities, everywhere Error is on top and it is itself well and comfortable in the

feelings of the majority when it stands on their side."

In the meantime it seems to stay by my words: FOR YEARS AND DECADES, THE RIDDLES OF THE ETHER, OF THE SUN. AND OF GRAVITATIONAL FORCE HAVE BEEN SOLVED. BUT THE PHYSICISTS AND ASTRONOMERS KNOW NOTH-ING [OF MY KEY], AND IT ALSO STANDS NO CHANCE OF SHARING ITSELF WITH THEM.

Many Eastern teachings, some good, some bad, are in circulation today. Careful experiment has taught, however, that what is suitable for one race is not suitable for another, and that the peoples of the West should use a Western form of voga. A Western master, if the pupil wishes to contact a master, is more capable of telling us how to live successfully in the Western world, than one who knows nothing of its problems. The Eastern schools teach retreat from the world. The School of Gnostics teaches how to conquer the material world - that we must first conquer the non-material world. It teaches that, better than trying to escape into the Kingdom of Heaven, it is best to try to

bring the Kingdom of Heaven down into the material world.

Before he finished filling out a check, he gasped, jumped to his feet, and struggled to loosen his collar and tie. Then he gasped . . . "I swear someone was trying to choke me!" I didn't mention my experience.

But this night was different, none of my sharp chess-playing cronies was in sight and I finally started a game with what we called a "woodpusher", i.e. a very weak player. But I made the silliest moves and my partner gleefully gobbled up my pieces; I had a droning voice in my head: "You got to go home, you

got to go home, get up and go home!" I glanced up to the big clock on the wall and said mentally to the voice: "What's eating you up, it's only 8:30 p.m., why should I go home?" That stopped the voice for a while but it started soon again ringing in my head: "Get up and go home, right now!" If you want to play good chess you have to concentrate, but how can you with such a voice in your head? Finally I excused myself to my partner; anyhow he must have thought something went wrong with me: left the casino and walked toward the streetcar stop.

It was a crisp but beautiful night. The voice in my head had quit and I felt wonderful, I even forgot completely what compelled me to go home. One of my favorite pleasures as a young boy was playing on the beach. I always liked the more secluded beaches and would often walk several miles to reach one particular spot called North Beach. STRANGE VISIONS

Just re-reading Nov. '58 Search, I keep them and restudy them every

once in a while. Surprising the difference in viewpoint in one's mind from time to time in studying all sides of the opinions expressed.

The item that prompted this letter was the blind person's "name withheld" letter regarding "seeing", "a head and face as though about a foot in front of his face"—and because such occurrences are common with me, I would like to know the TRUE cause, origin and meaning of such—and other more perplexing experiences.

Nearly every night when I lay down to go to sleep and have relaxed, eyes closed, thoughts almost stopped and while watching the black screen formed by the closed evelids-I am conscious of seeing faintly, then flashes more strongly of numerous scenes which seldom remain long enough to either identiry, describe or remember. The sensation can be likened to looking through a fast moving train window? through successively thinning and thickening fog at landscapes barely distinguishable through it. Occasionally but not too frequently a scene or person will appear clearly enough and pause long enough so I can get a sufficiently clear impression to remember a little of it. Sometimes a seemingly intuitive voice will give the name of the person whose face shows up. Other times well known faces like Will Rogers or Teddy Roosevelt will appear in this black void, remain

a brief second and then disappear. Faces of Indians, Hindus, Negros and of beautiful women frequently appear in this manner.

Sometimes, in slowly coming up out of a deep sleep into realizable consciousness, (that is when I know I'm waking up but all of my brain is not fully awake) I see things and catch the sound of voices. For an example: About three years ago I was alone on a night job and in growing drowsy along about 4 a.m.-I dropped off to sleep with my head on my arms on the desk. Half hour or so later I started to wake up to the sound of voices. One masculine voice was saying, "-and here where you see this huge crater was the city of Chicago." At the same time I seemed to see a huge crater half filled with water and as I stirred more fully to completely awaken, the voice continued in a startled manner, "sh-he is starting to awaken. we had better leave him." Then I came to with a start only to find myself alone in the room. I know I was not dreaming. I had tried to lift my head but could not. One was very old appearing, but still beautiful with long hair that shone with a silvery-gray radiance. The man was around six feet and had closely cropped blond hair with a mustache that drooped down on each side of his smiling mouth. Another time-Also ABSOLUTE-LY TRUE. August 21, 1956 Nome Alaska. Went home from job about 2:30 p.m. feeling groggy and sleepy, lay down on couch on right side facing center of room-curtains and shades pulled-bright sun outside-enough light to clearly distinguish objects in room-children's voices laughing and playing in the street out front. As I dropped off to sleep, a vision of a large purple cross flashed across the black screen of my closed evelids, and wondering what this meant I quickly dozed off

How long I had been asleep I do not know, when I awakened in what seemed to be a sitting position on the couch with my hands stretched out in front of me, but upon turning my head I was puzzled to see these same hands clasped and in front of the face of the other? me still lying on my right side. PRAYER AND BREATHING EXERCISES HEALED MY ASTHMA

Why is it that the medical profession is unable to cure asthma and other respiratory ills, including the common cold? I have been told by doctors that there is

no cure for this debilitating disease, which often ends in early death after years of untold suffering. I am also told by the same authorities that the common cold can be helped by palliatives, but that it will yet run its course.

I am no doctor, but when I read in a medical journal that asthma is caused by hay fever and certain allergies, and that little can be done, in a chronic case, I wonder why? If I were a doctor, there is no doubt but I could give, in long technical terms, the reason why there is no cure for this killer. I am no doctor, but I have had asthma and was healed of it in my own home and by my own efforts, exercises and prayers; and have not had a cold during the last eight years.

It is therefore my opinion that doctors generally are satisfied to not do too much in the line of healing, where asthma and common colds are concerned. Treating these conditions brings in more of the people's money than setting broken arms and legs; for few people know how to evade the colds, and many colds will bring more respiratory ailments, including asthma.

I did not know I had asthma until I moved to Des Moines, Iowa, in 1941. I then had an attack that lasted for three weeks; I went to a doctor and explained how I felt and asked for an examination. He looked me over without seating me, and without even taking my blood pressure. He then said there was nothing he could do for me, but if I got worse to call again in a

week. He did not even tell me that I had asthma.

I went home and the paroxyms ceased after a few days. Some time later I got a job in an industrial plant and lasted just three weeks. I was then so bad that I could barely walk to the streetcar, a half block from the plant. I then realized that I had the same disease that choked my uncle to death. I began looking for some drug that would hold it in check and I found two or three that helped to keep me going. I found no healing in these drugs, only palliatives.

I had heard of breathing exercises and prayer as a cure for many things and decided to give that a trial. In the meantime I had one seizure when I could not breathe for several minutes. I fell to the floor and crawled some fifty feet and through two doors and got the front door open so the cold air would enter my open mouth. I expected to die, but the wintry air revived me.

I then formulated a prayer and made up an exercise to go with the words of that prayer and used it morning and evening and did some extra breathing when on a bus or street car. With that and a drug I was able to keep working, tending machines at an arms plant until it shut down at the end of the war, in 1945. All this time I was improv-

ing slowly but surely.

In March, 1946, I began in deep earnest to treat myself by prayer and exercise, and though I kept drugs handy I did not use them. From that time I spent a half hour every evening and half that in the morning, at the exercise. If I did not have a cough, I induced one by deep breathing, and so I cleared my lungs and throat of all tendency of gathering phlegm. If I at any time feel a cough or a sniffle, I can dis-

sipate it by five minutes of exercise. I have not had a cold during the last nine years.

It is my belief, that anyone with asthma, can heal himself for all time if he goes at it in earnest. I was 62 when I first knew what I had, and was 67 when I began in earnest to exercise. I will be 80 in four months.

Pyramidologists Await It Anxiously!

Ever since the internal passageways of the Great Pyramid of Gizeh were discovered, the idea that their measurements contain a key to prophecy of the future has been held by many. No less than three keys have been postulated. The latest indicates a fateful day to occur in 1959. It is fitting to observe it now, for as the saying goes: "The proof is in the pudding."

Just what are the prophetic hints given us by the mysterious "measurements" of the passages in the Great Pyramid? What do they say about the present, and the near future?

A momentous and fateful day on Nov. 19, 1959.—

Following it a period of great peace and prosperity, a golden age with atomic energy possibly harnessed for man's good.—

And the ending of man's stay on earth on Jan. 28, 2001.—

The latter speculation is one pyramidologists have long agreed on. It measures a span of 6000 years from the assumption that Adam was created in the year 4000 B.C. (The extra year is accounted for

by the fact there was never a year 0.)

What November 19 will bring—catastrophe, cataclysm, a flood or fire or "a second coming of Christ"—cannot be said.

According to Pyramidologists David Davidson, Piazza Smyth, James Eason and J. A. Ferris and an accompanying study of the Old and New Testaments, "The pyramid accurately prophesied the birth and crucifixion of Christ. It is reasonable to suppose it would also predict His second coming."

Study of the Great Pyramid began more than 90 years ago by scientists puzzled by the fact the structure contains no tomb or treasure. They wondered at the signi-

ficance of its construction. Its builders, the people of King Cheops, are believed to have been drowned in the great biblical flood of 2345 BC.

Early precise mathematical and astronomical discoveries (the base, for instance, is exactly 365.24 cubits, a Hebrew measurement, on each side—the number of times the earth turns in a year) convinced Prof. Smyth and other early scientists that some occult power was at work when the structure was built, and that the path of man's destiny is clearly marked out in its corridors.

Prof. Smyth developed the first key to the pyramid's secrets, using a scale of one inch to indicate a year, and beginning with a scored line in a descending passage that by a rare junction of stars at right angles indicated the year 2144 BC. His measurements of the passage gave him the date of the exodus from Egypt, 1486 BC, where an ascending passage joins the first; the birth of Christ and His crucifixion in AD 30, where the passage widens into a great gallery.

This gallery ends in a step and levels to two low passages separated by an antechamber and opens into a king's chamber where stands an empty coffer.

The step gives the date of Aug. 2, 1909, significance of which is not

clear.

Then a second key, developed by a Toronto student named William Reeve, changed the scale to 1 inch equals 1 month. The first low passage then determined (in 1909) the dates Aug. 4, 1914 and Nov. 11, 1918, beginning and end of World War I. The second low passage supplied the dates May 29, 1928 and Sept. 16, 1936, which seemed to be without meaning.

When this latter date passed without significance a search for a third key to the pyramid began.

Wilkins' key (the third) was developed from the study of a great granite leaf which hangs in the antechamber between the two low passages of the entrance to the king's chamber. Below the leaf a change in the material of the flooring indicated, to him, a change in key.

On the leaf there is a knob or boss, 5 inches in diameter and raised 1 inch. He says he found a number of corresponding measurements which gave him the ratio of 1 to 5. He then began measuring the distance from this point using a scale of one-fifth year or 73 days to an inch. This gave him the date of Sept. 2, 1939, the beginning of World War II, at the edge of the second low passage. Even more significant, his measurements in the king's chamber ended with the date

Jan. 28, 2001-agreeing with all previous pyramid indications of the end of man's history.

It also gave him the ominous date of Nov. 19, 1959.

The king's chamber and the empty coffer (indicating man's ascension) Wilkins believes indicate a fred Landon running for President period of a golden age for man on earth—possibly with Christ again

walking the world.

But he thinks it may follow a debacle such as the crucifixion.

The last ominous date pyramidologists prophesied, however, Sept. 16, 1935, passed with-

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A SCIENTIFIC JIG-SAW PUZZLE

By L. Jaylor Hansen

The most bewildering puzzle of the American races is the disposition of their languages over the North Americas

F THE Uto-Aztecan Block of Languages is a scientific jig-saw puzzle, the linguistic map above that block is equally amazing. In some ways they are the very antithesis of one another. As the Mexican Block is composed of strangely different physical types talking related tongues, so the northern group is composed of relatively similar types talking widely - separated tongues. And as the Southern Block is composed of islanded physical types surrounded by another physical type, so the Northern Block is composed of islanded-tongues surrounded by a dissimilar languagestock

Yet, the various cultures of the Americas are so closely connected that we must seek and compare again and again for the illusive key which, when discovered, should go far toward pushing back the portals of history from twenty to fifty thousand years.

That man was in the Americas during the times of the Great Northern Ice is not to be doubted. His bones have been found in South America, mingled with those of the Great Extinct Ground Sloth, and in North America the skeletons of the Great Extinct Bison* have been found in a circle with their tail bones missing. To the Indian this can mean only one thing-the most obvious explanation—that the animals were skinned. And this in spite of the fact that in Europe at this time. Neanderthal Man watched the approach of the mile-high ice as one would look upon the doom of a planet. If the skulls found here had only been of the peculiar skulltype that Neanderthal presented, scientists would have been more prepared to believe in their antiquity. However, the skulls have all been modern—as modern in type as the skull of Cro-Magnon or as the present American himself.

Dr. P. E. Goddard of the Amer. Museum of Nat. Hist., N. Y., writing in the American Anthropologist, calls attention to another find that of an extinct bison lying in un-

disturbed Pleistocene formations with a forked spear-head of flint intermingled with its skeleton, and declares that linguistic evidence has long shown that the recent peopling of America was improbable. At just what particular part of the Great Ice Age this old Texas bison became extinct is not at present known. but, Dr. Goddard continues, in order to have man come after the Ice Age, and yet raise the lost American Civilizations, as well as speak all of the present Amerind tongues, the tribes of one hundred separate language stocks, all differentiated in Asia, would have to hurry across the Aleutians at the break up of the ice, and without waiting to populate North America, would have to rush across Mexico and the Isthmus to South America and there get busy exterminating the Ground Sloth, cultivating maize and a hundred other Amerind plants before drifting again back north. Such a conception is, he says, utterly "fantastic for the time allowed has been much too short."

He substitutes the theory that during the Pre-glacial, man came over with the other animals of Old World origin—the camel, horse, elephant, etc. With the advance of the ice, he retreated before the great white sheet into Mexico and probably into South America where, because of the crush for space, he

cultivated food plants and began his great civilizations. Then, only as the ice retreated, and the animals followed the pendulum of their food zones, did man migrate again into the north of North America. The date when these counter-migrations began, he points out, should be determined by the linguistic difference within the stock. Thus the Athapascan migrations took place before the remote members such as the Canadian Chipewyans and the Arizona Navaho were separate peoples.

With the possible exception of the Athapascans, this theory of Dr. Goddards is the most plausible offered by any scientist as a key to the Amerind Puzzle. The Athapascans may well have been late immigrants from Asia whose entrance into the Americas dates back only some two thousand years.

OTHER scientists, determined to bring man over from Asia within the span of time allowed after the final retreat of the ice, sit down and stare at the linguistic map of North America in dismay. The first great fact to refute this simple theory is that the Eskimo tongue is essentially not Pacific, but Atlantic, and finds its closest ally in the Algonkin Block. Upon these two very ancient tongues as a wash of background, therefore, one must

figure his migrating spearheads of invading languages.

The second great fact to refute this late Asian migration is that hundreds of tiny groups are islanded along the Pacific Coast, Small tongues are always hurled back to the borderlines opposite the point of invasion. In other words, the wreck of the previous population is swept away from the invasion point. This would not mean a steady sweep in from the North West, as much as it would mean many sharp and repeated thrusts from the Southeast, or up the Mississippi River and thence toward the west, pushing tribe against tribe until one battered remnant after another reached a point beyond which there was no retreat.

As for the order of their coming. that is largely guesswork, and fitting together pieces of the Jig-Saw. Islanded thrusts always precede those which surround them. As for the Kiowa tongue, which like the Keresian, has long remained a mystery, the linguists are now inclined to regard it as a link. Perhaps, unlike the Pawnee whose linking of three tribal language stocks (Siouan, Iroquoian and Caddoan)* may explain much, the Kiowa linking only seems to create a deeper mystery. For how can a language be a link from the Athapascan-Apache to the The Pawnee, on the other hand, who seems to be a link between the Iroquois and the Caddoan, oblige us with a far more reasonable legend. They admit that they were once great migrators and lived near the Iroquois for whom they had a deep regard, near the mouth of the Mississippi. They also claim to have named the Ohio, a claim, incidentally, which the Iroquois also make.

Now into this composite picture which legends are slowly helping to clear somewhat, come the Sioux. The correct name for the Sioux Nation is Dacota, but with typical Indian grim humor, they will not deny that they are the "Sioux"—a slanderous name given by an enemy tribe.

This proud nation, the Dacota, told the first whites that they were a grain-raising people living in Virginia. However, when the White Man brought the horse into the Americas, the Dacotas saw in this

Shoshone which is Uto-Aztecan? How indeed, unless they borrowed words from their wild Apache neighbors? Yet the Kiowa themselves say that they once lived in the "Black Hills" of Dacota and left their parent tribe because of a quarrel. Does this mean that the Uto-Aztecans once held that territory before the advent of the Caddoan and the Sioux?

animal the promise of a more abundant life. They packed their last harvest upon their new animal-servants and migrated to the great western plains of the Black Hills where they could find an easy living following the herds of buffalo, and where they gave their euphonious name to two states.

Thus the picture is complete, with the exception of the Musk-hogeans, who should have arrived last, judging by the map, and whose legends upon that subject are the most enlightening of all.

Could it be that these people of the forest who presented such a dark portrait of superstitious ignorance to the newly-arrived white settler, were in reality the scattered splinters from the wreck of perhaps not one but several ancient civilizations?

EXPRESSING this opinion one night before a group of scientists I had one astronomer turn upon me with scorn, holding up for ridicule the fact that the Pawnee Indians say that they were organized by the Evening Star.

"Pure superstition," he sneered.
"What could that tribe of savages know about Venus—merely that it glittered brightly after the sun had gone down!"

And then warming up to his subject, he continued: "Besides, I remember reading in an early history that this was the very tribe which cut off the heads of its captives and used them for a sort of football!"

(Not a pretty picture, and without doubt true. Yet it is a curiously ancient ritual which was repeated after a war by some of the priests of one of the best Mayan civilizations.)*

My revenge came with almost dramatic suddenness when I was browsing the next Sunday afternoon in the Indian section of the Field Museum of Natural History in Chicago. A curious map with tiny crosses made upon an old yellowed bit of tanned elkskin about 15 by 22 inches caught my eye. After studying it with growing bewilderment, I hurried out and dragged my skeptical astronomer back with me.

"Why this is an astronomical map of the heavens!"

"Must be an error," I murmured, nodding to the card which identified it as I read aloud: "Skymap taken from a Pawnee Medicine Bundle, over three hundred years old."

But all he heard was the last phrase.

"Certainly it is over three hundred years old. No modern observer ever saw Lambda Tauri as bright as it is marked here."

WERE THE INCAS CLAIRVOYANT?

e who venerates the sun, venerates his own soul." This was the deep belief of the ancient, sun-worshipping Incas. Did they possess supernatural powers, or were their beliefs primarilv superstitious?

Many of their priests claimed to be able to foretell things to come, and it is an indisputable fact that many of their prophecies did come true. Long before the Spanish Conquest, it was predicted that at the end of the thirteenth age white men would arrive from across the sea, and conquer their race. Before their advent, the Incas had been expecting them daily for years. So strong was their belief that the Spaniards encountered little opposition in their sweep across South America; the Incas believed their subjugation was inevitable.

The uncanny ability of these ancient people to send and receive information over long distances was seemingly supernatural. If a friend or loved one died while away on a long journey, the Incas knew it long before a runner could be dispatched to bring them the sad news. If men and horses were approaching their city, the priests knew exactly how many were coming long before they could be seen or heard. These mysterious feats and predictions were commonplace.

Strangest of all, the Peruvian descendents of these sun-worshippers have inherited much of this weird Their inexplicable ability to tell in which direction a friend or enemy is traveling is a relic of the past. A modern Indian who possesses this gift can tell you, without hesitating, the exact route a fugitive has taken, even in the absence of any track or spoor, and follow him across the deserts, mountains, and rivers, even taking short cuts to overtake the fleeing man exactly where they predicted he would be.

By the same weird power, a descendent of the Incas can detect his pursuers. Without definite knowledge, he can predict the number of men on foot and mounted men following him, even their distance behind him.

Witnesses at an Indian hut at Raco saw the Indian owner place his ear to the floor and announce the exact number of men and horses in a platoon of soldiers who were passing at a distance of more than two miles; the order in which they moved, and the direction in which they were going.

Explorers and archeologists in Peru have repeatedly visited the most remote regions, only to find that they have been expected for days, and arrangements have been made for the entire party. These explorers quote examples of the times they have been informed of events when the Indians could not have learned of them by any ordinary means. Later, the information, no matter how unbelievable at the time, has been found to be true.

When asked how they acquire this unique ability, the average Indian claims that he can understand the barking and howling of dogs, who relay messages rapidly over long distances, but it is believed that this is merely a tale to satisfy the white man's curiosity, since they don't know the solution to their strange powers themselves.

Many of the ancient priests were charletans, of course, but there were those who beyond doubt possessed inexplicable powers, and transmitted those powers to their descendents.

The archaic Inca was superstitious and believed implicity in signs and omens. The priests taught them that trepanning the skull always resulted in the development of a new variety of potato. As a result, trepanning was practiced more widely among the Incas than anywhere else in the ancient world and oddly enough, there are more varieties of potatoes in Peru than any other part of the earth.

Other common beliefs of the Incas remain with us today. They believed that stubbing your toe was a sign that your wife was unfaithful. Many people still believe that stumbling is an evil omen. It was a sure sign of an accident to the owner of an Incan house if a vulture lighted over the door and spread its wings to the sun. day's version of this superstition has two facets; first, that having a bird fly into your house is a sign of incipient death, and second that a vulture following a man or an animal in the desert or the woods shows pre-knowledge of death.

Other firm beliefs that no longer exist today were a part of Incan life. If more cocks than hens were hatched from eggs, it foretold the end of the world to the Incan. As sunworshippers, celestial bodies held a strong place in their superstistitions. During eclipses, they said the moon was suffering the pangs of childbirth, and everybody beat drums and shouted prayers and supplications to help the moon in her agony.

During solar eclipses, frightened

Incas believed that the sun suffered and died, and then was born again.

Though many of the Incas prophecies were obviously erroneous, there is still no explanation for many of their astounding accomplishments. Only a race with powers we do not understand could have completed the incredible feat of building the Incan Road, using nothing more than their primitive technology. Though they never invented the wheel, they built this splendid three thousand mile highway, a fantastic feat of pre-historic road-building. In a direct line it wound over the highest ranges of the Andes, the deepest canyons, the raging rivers, the widest deserts. Suspension bridges spanned wide gorges, their huge cables made of fiber and hair ropes fastened in holes hacked through solid rock. The tunnels they drilled through the mountains are still in use. Much of this Incan Road was surfaced with asphalt, and some of it is used by motorists today. This accomplishment has no logical explanation. The truth concerning their surmounting of almost impossible difficulties is lost in the past. Perhaps the priest-oracles foretold their difficulties, and were granted the second sight to solve their problems as they encountered them.

Descendents of the Incas believe that their forebears had the power

to see and hear things not granted to modern man. For example, there is the story of El Monolitho Abandonado (the abandoned Monolith).

This immense stone, 17'x10'x3', lies deserted by the roadside near Ollantay, Peru, covered by blood-like stains. Archeologists say these markings are a red piroxene oxidation, but they cannot explain how this huge rock came to be deserted here in Peru, when there is no similar rock quarry or rock formation nearer than Ecuador, fifteen hundred miles distant.

Legend has it that this stone was quarried in Quito, Ecuador, and dragged by sheer man-power back into Peru. The stone, saddened by being carried so far from home, began to weep tears of blood. The priest, Urcon, was only one of the Incas in the party to hear a mystical voice issuing from the inanimate stone crying, "Saycunin! I am weary!"

Urcon dropped dead in his tracks with fear. The rest of the terrified Incas stampeded, leaving the monolith where it lies today.

What is this unique ability they have bequeathed their descendents?

DID HE CREATE LIFE?

an has sought to discover the secret of Life for so long as he has been on this Earth and able to ask the question: "How do I come to be here?", but though he has learned much about the mechanism of his daily existence · and can to some degree control and assist the efficient functioning of mind and body, he has not yet discovered what set him going in the first place.

Recent experiments with viruses, especially that of the tobacco mosaic virus, have led scientists to believe that "life as we know it does not come into existence suddenly but is inherent in all matter." In other words there is no sharp dividing liné between living and dead matter. There is just a "pre-life" stage relating to all inorganic matter, which under certain favorable conditions gives way to life.

That is where the question rests

at the moment; but if the problem is solved in the near future, as it may well be, the credit of leading the way in this fascinating field should go to Andrew Crosse, the amateur scientist who created life. His achievement has been forgotten for over a hundred years - perhaps suppressed would be the better word -for his theories, when he first propounded them, were far too startling and revolutionary to be favorably received by his contemporaries. He was denounced as a blasphemer, an heretic, and follower of the Devil because he dared to offer the scientific explanation of auto-genesis as the cause for Man's presence on this earth.

It appears from his "Memorials" that he was engaged in manufacturing silicious crystals with the aid of a sulphuric acid, and a solution of silicate of potash in which a piece of porous stone was immersed; after which an electric current was sent through the highly poisonous mixture. "On the fourteenth day from the commencement of my experiments," he writes, "I observed through a lens several whitish excrescences or nipples, projecting from the middle of the stone. On the eighteenth day these projections enlarged, and struck out seven or eight filaments, each of them longer than the hemisphere in which they grew.

"On the twenty-sixth day these projections assumed the form of a perfect insect, standing erect on a few bristles which formed its tail. Till this period, I had no idea that these objects were other than incipient mineral formations. On the twenty-eighth day these tiny creatures moved their legs! I must say that I was not a little astonished. After a few days they detached themselves from the stone and moved about at pleasure.

"In the course of a few weeks, about a hundred of them made their appearance on the stone. I carefully examined them under a microscope, and observed that the smaller acari or mites, appeared to have only six legs, the larger ones eight. These insects are obviously of the acarus group, but there appears to be a difference of opinion as to whether they are a known species; some assert that they are not.

"I have never ventured to form an opinion as to the cause of their birth, and for a very good reason-I was unable to form one. The simplest solution of the problem which occurred to me was that they arose from the ova deposited by insects floating in the atmosphere and hatched by electric action. Still, I could not imagine that an ovum could shoot out filaments, or that these filaments could become bristles, and moreover, I could not detect on the closest examination, the remains of a shell!

"I next imagined, as others have done, that they might originate from the water, and consequently made a close examination of a number of vessels filled with the same fluid; in none of these was I able to discover any trace of an insect, nor could I see any in any other part of the room."

Crosse then went a step further in his experiments by discarding the stone, with the result that he actually succeeded in breeding a number of mites in another poisonous solution consisting of concentrated copper sulphate, and zinc sulphate, the customary prolonged electrical current having been passed through the mixture. Some of the insects, he records, actually crawled up the electrified wire and escaped from the vessel!

"If, however," he goes on to say,

"any of them were afterwards thrown back into the fluid in which it was produced, it immediately drowned. I have never before heard of acari having been produced under a fluid, or of their ova throwing out filaments; nor have I observed any ova previous to or during electrization."

He went on to produce acari in an airtight glass retort, the silicate solution being put in while hot. The battery was then connected to the retort, with the result that an electric action immediately commenced; oxygen and hydrogen gases were liberated; the volume of atmospheric air was soon expelled. Every care had been taken to avoid atmospheric contact and admittance of extraneous matter; the retort itself having previously been washed in alcohol. This apparatus was placed in a dark cellar.

"I discovered no sign of incipient animal formation until on the hundred and fortieth day, when I plainly distinguished one acarus actively crawling about within the airtight retort.

"I found that I had made a great mistake in this experiment, and I believe that it was in consequence of this error that I not only lost sight of the single insect, but never saw any others in the apparatus. I had omitted to insert with the retort a resting place for these acari (they always die if they fall back into the solution from which they have emerged). It is strange that in a solution eminently caustic and under an atmosphere of oxihydrogen gas one single acarus should have made its appearance at all!"

Crosse was not alone in these experiments. A Mr. Weeks of Sandwich also made several attempts along the lines laid down by Crosse and succeeded in creating innumerable acari, having first taken the precaution of baking all his apparatus in an oven, and only using distilled water in his experiments. He also super-heated his silicate solution, utilizing manufactured oxygen, thus making trebly sure that no animal life of any sort was present at the outset of the experiment: at the conclusion of which he was able to bring an interesting point to light. By varying the carbon contents of his solution, he was able to decrease or increase the number of insects produced in this fashion.

Crosse, as previously stated, was much vilified and persecuted, as was his fellow amateur scientist Weeks, because of these findings and they were eventualy compelled to call a halt in their experiments but not before the eminent Faraday himself had delivered a paper on the subject to the Royal Institution, which, while agreeing with their findings, categorically denied

the possibilities of any form of autogenesis. Like so many of his contemporaries, he put the insects down to some sort of mechanical growth that imitated the properties associated with living matter.

There are many growths of this nature, it must be admitted some which imitate living bodies to a

remarkable degree, as in the case of the "osmostic growths" recently produced by that eminent biologist, Dr. Leduc. Still, it cannot be denied that Crosse "created something out of nothing", and that something is the nearest approach to living matter yet produced artificially.


Ccientific interest in the "uncon-Scious" has been a major development in the twentieth century. Among those exploring it and who are still living, no one is more distinguished than Carl Jung, world renowned psycho-therapist. As Sydnev Omarr states in this fascinating new book, Jung's work had an important influence on him in the development of this new technique for tapping the unconscious. Dear Ray Palmer:

In your June 1959 Search, Clare John Jensen began his article by stating: "The flying saucer phenomena are intricately interwoven with Spiritualism phenomena." For over a decade, as a veteran "psychic searcher", I have felt that flying saucers should be classified as psychic phenomena. Back in 1946 I saw miniature flying saucers in a seance conducted by the late

Frank Decker of New York City, the celebrated test medium of direct voice and physical phenomena.

As proof of these things, motion pictures were taken by a professional cameraman from Hollywood. The guide of Mr. Decker, calling himself Bert Wells, in a previous seance had promised to manifest "etheric cold light" never photographed before. The cameraman was given permission to take pictures

for five minutes, and was advised to use only one camera. He set up two cameras for assurance. But only one camera recorded pictures. The film in the other was blank, for no scientific reason. But one playful spirit said he held his materialized hand over the second camera.

These remarkable pictures now owned by Decker's widow, were demonstrated in 1947 before a large crowd of the New York Psychology Forum in Steinway Hall, New York City. The many flashes of white light emanating from the solar plexus of Decker, and the pulsating balls of cold fire were so brilliant, the entire seance room was illuminated as though lightning had streaked in from an open window revealing the seven sitters and the entranced medium. These "saucers" were like planets in a miniature solar system. One resembled a picture of Mars with its channel lines. Several times I extended my hand to try and touch one, and it darted away, just like flying saucers have been reported running from investigating planes.

The manifestation consumed so much ectoplasmic strength, that Frank Decker was weakened considerably and advised by his guide not to repeat the test. Frankly, I believe this loss of vitality was a contributing factor to Decker's early death a few years later. He never

seemed to have the power that made him internationally famous in his early years. He was a true martyr to Spiritualism, like that other psychic hero, Jack Webber, who died from weakness due to loss of ectoplasmic strength when a light was turned on during a seance in the dark, and shriveled the cord of ectoplasm extending from his solar plexus.

It is a theory among publishers that the newsstand sale remains the same, no matter how many subscribers there are. It seems to work this way: a newsstand has five copies, which he may sell out. So next month four of the five subscribe, and once more he sells out. Why? Because some other person saw the magazine on the stands and bought it, who did not buy it the previous month because somebody else beat him to it! Normally, the biggest newsstand sale is the first two weeks. After that, it isn't on the stands to buy! You can be sure that we'd be happy if every present newsstand buyer would subscribe, because that would mean an equal number of new customers would get a chance to find the magazine on the newsstands, and our circulation would go up.

In the case of a magazine with millions of copies on the news-stands, your theory would hold true, but we are so far from newsstand saturation that no amount of subscribing could make any difference in the newsstand sale. I am not using your exact words of course, but that is the meaning. If God is Love, as you say, can he love by degrees? A pleasant love to an innocent, and a painful love to a sinner? A lot of love to one, and a little, or no, love to another?

When you ask: "why God chooses to cruelly victimize some of his beloved children", do you propose to inform me that you know that a particular act of God is "cruel" and "victimizing"? In the LONG

RANGE of things, may it not be that you are being short-sighted, and that after all, God, more wise than you, actually "wonderfully blessed" rather than "cruelly victimized"? What about that "it'll all come out in the wash" theory? All to a good end?

Take your own case as an instance. It was "cruel" to you, to deprive you of a child in your familv. Yet, did it not cause you to abandon a careless attitude toward God, and to turn instead to an active search for him? Might it not be that God intended exactly that, by his deed in taking the child from you? And in the long run, which is eternity, did God do any injustice to the child? In your eyes, perhaps you say he deprived the child of some less than 70 years of life. This is an assumption, Perhaps God gave the child something even more valuable, in another form of life, in another realm of existence beyond death. He gives this experience to all of us, soon or late. Does it make any difference in the total scheme of things exactly when?

The trouble with all these objections to what happens, on the basis that God wouldn't "be so cruel", is that you are judging the whole elephant by the leg, or the ear, or the trunk, or the tusk. You have no idea of what the whole elephant is like, and perceiving one

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part of him, you insist that he perform completely within the bounds of that single part. You can say that an elephant is all sinuous, snakelike trunk, and it's outrageous that he should presume to walk! You postulate that walking is impossible, unreasonable, because of your inadequate picture of an elephant. It is the same way with saying God is "cruel" because he causes (presumably) an innocent child to be born blind. Like the disciples, who see only the trunk of the elephant, you ask: "Was this man born blind because his parents sinned, or because he himself sinned in a previous existence?" You even invent a previous existence which cannot be proved, to explain your rationalization as to the reason for his incomprehensive, UNJUST blindness.

You ask why doesn't God "strike" evil, greedy, selfish people to "prove his power"? What about "ask and it shall be given unto you"? If we have free will, and decide to be evil, greedy, selfish, isn't it MOST REASONABLE that God will provide exactly as is demanded, and not interfere with any "lightning bolts"? Give a man enough rope, and he will hang himself? Prosper the wicked, until they come a cropper through THEIR OWN efforts. What better way to learn a lesson? And once learned, is the evil man then to be denied his diploma, and told that school "kept for nothing" and it was all a fraud, needlessly imposed?

If you think of God at all, can you not see that He is right when He says: "What I have done, I have done, and I have done well." Okay, I'll admit that exact quote isn't in the Bible-but do you think God doesn't do well? Is He a fumbler, a sinner Himself? Is He ACTUALLY cruel? Or does He only seem to be cruel, because He spanks you for your own good? Your selfish claim that it isn't for your own good, made through ignorance of what it's all about, doesn't whittle any wood. You get the spanking, you cry out. you protest, but years later you see that it was the best thing that could have happened to you. As the twig is bent, so grows the tree-but what does a twig comprehend of a whole tree; or of a forest, or of a planet on which the forest grows, or of a universe in which the planet is but a microcosmic speck? You, a tiny speck of humanity, hardly aware of even the miracle of your own body, propose to define God as "cruel" or as "love". Because you cannot see the whole picture, as He must, you claim the picture does not exist, and invent one of your own.

Why is it that we cannot look upon a fact (such as a man's blindness) and instead of judging the

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reason for it with our limited viewpoint, simply observe, and try to understand, and wait until we find out more about it? Why look at a baby born blind, and shake our fist at the sky and rail at an "unjust" and "cruel" God, who would so senselessly "victimize" an innocent baby? Why not think hard, ask that God grant you the ability to work out an answer, to understand His ways, and to try to conform to them? Why not, if you are a Unitarian, and believe that God is Love. ask Him why, in his love, He made this child blind, and in what wonderful plan the baby is involved which will eventually (and CER-TAINL,Y because God IS Love) become apparent, and approved by all?

Can it be said that you have faith in God when you continually question His every act, and demand that He justify it? Or would you rather the leg was retained, and the child finally

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executed in the electric chair because of a murder that would have been averted by the child's taking a new tack in its thinking because of the "tragedy" of your loss of a leg?

You yourself seem to "preach" that we learn only through "tragedy striking". Is this not then God's method? Why turn it all around, and say it is only a Man reaping his karma, and getting nowhere, because God has been relegated to a position as mere bystander, while Man goes blundering around, through life and after life, doing as he pleases, and the Devil take the hindmost?

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
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
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
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
