#### **EDITORIAL**

VOUR EDITOR has just fin-I ished a very big job - the editing and make-up of the actual pages of L. Taylor Hansen's tremendous book THE ANCIENT ATLANTIC. For the first time, we know exactly how many pages this book will contain. It will be 423 pages, plus an index. At the last minute we decided to do the tremendous job of including an index. because it would be unthinkable for a scholarly work of this magnitude to be without one. And if any book deserves the top treatment, this is it. We also know that we were much too conservative in predicting that it would be "over 300 pages" and would sell for \$17.50. It will be nearly 450 pages and will sell for \$22.50! It would seem that many of you who bought it on our pre-publication offer got a bargain!

However, it isn't the commercial angle that prompts us to write an editorial about THE ANCIENT

ATLANTIC, it is the tremendous sense of wonder and awe and excitement that has filled us as we read proof on the final pages, in their proper order. What a wonderful book this is! We say that to give L. Taylor Hansen the credit due her. She has written a book that will be a monument to her She has also written a book that is like the capstone of the pyramid of all the vast assembly of mysteries we (you and I) have dealt with in the past years in our various publications and researches. For instance, the legend of ancient Atlantis has always fascinated all of us. Did that ancient continent really exist? We've had many books on it, but they come under fictional or mystic or psychic headings, and do not impress the scientists. However, in THE ANCIENT ATLANTIC (note it is Atlantic, not Atlantis) there is no fiction - only a FACT. Yes, there was an Atlantis, and we now know exactly where it was!

We know when it was. We know who it was. We know a great deal of its history. We know where to look for the ruins of the ancient cities we have come to regard as legendary, and fictional. Ancient Ys. for example, or Lyonesse, or Hel (Hellas). The day is not far off when we will actually explore them in their underwater graves. Even today, American and Russian oceanographic expeditions (using million-dollar floating laboratories) are sonar-mapping the entire ocean bottom, concentrating on the Atlantic, particularly the north Atlantic, and have established beyond all doubt that there IS a sunken continent there. They are dredging up artifacts which, pending study (such as carbondating), will prove to the world that the great civilization of legend, the ancient Atlantean, did exist. Further that it still exists, in the form of its cast-off colonies. and descended peoples, much mixed, as they exist today.

It is in L. Taylor Hansen's THE ANCIENT ATLANTIC that the wonderfully fascinating and excitingly related story of these ancient peoples, and ancient continents, is told. You will find, as your editor has, the greatest adventure of your life in reading this book. As you look about you, such as witnessing an Indian dance at a festival, and see the dance through new eyes, because in the

costumes worn, the headdresses, the motions of the dance, no longer just an interesting dance, but history being reenacted before your eyes - ancient memories recorded in a form that has proved to be the best possible way to preserve the old history. Cro Magnon is not extinct - he exists today!

Some of you will remember when L. Taylor Hansen dropped out of Amazing Stories, where her wonderful series "Scientific Mysteries" was published for years. You will remember she said she had discovered one of the caves Shaver talked about, and intended entering. She said it was filled with gas, and she needed oxygen equipment and ropes. Then your editor searched for ten years for her. We couldn't find her. Not until she finally turned up with the beginnings of the manuscript for THE ANCIENT ATLANTIC and the manuscript for HE WALKED THE AMERICAS. This latter book is no collection of fairy-tales, but true history. It has been acclaimed by everyone who has read it. Its fame will be nothing beside THE AN-CIENT ATLANTIC. But hidden within the manuscript are innumerable hints. For example, do these caves really exist? Are they like Shaver says? No, not full of dero and tero, but yes, full of ancient records. For one, there IS an underground city in the Sahara. It is guarded, as it has been for thousands of years, by the Tauraks, a tribe where the men never show their faces, but whose fierceness is unequalled anywhere. No white man has ever seen the city they guard, which is under the bottom of an ancient dried up ocean called by science, the Triton sea. No Arab has ever seen it, and their terror at sight of a Taurak is undeniable.

In Peru, in the mountains near Machu Picchu, there is an underground city, and tunnels that Indians say go all the way to the American southwest. Legend has it that the Incas hid their vast treasures of gold and jewels and artifacts and books from the Spanish in these underground places. Someday they will be found. This book offers so much evidence that they must exist that we deem it incontestible.

Today they are scanning the interior of the Great Pyramid of Gizeh with cosmic rays (at great expense!) to determine if there actually are secret chambers within that vast stone pile that may contain the records which would prove all that legend has told us, and all that L. Taylor Hansen has related in the book that has so excited your editor.

Who were the serpent people? Did they really exist? No, they weren't people who looked like serpents - the serpent was their totem. They were ancient and almost forgotten when the pharaohs

of Egypt wore (in memory of them) a serpent upon their headdress. Why did they wear it? Because in it they remembered their origins on a lost continent now below the Atlantic. And who were the people whose totem was the bird (specifically, the condor)? Who were the people of the wolf? And what war was it that was fought between the serpent and the wolf; between the wolf and the turtle? When Fenir lost his hand to the wolf, what actually happened? Where was that battle fought? Not in the Norse Asgaard, which we know today as the Norse heaven where the ancient warriors went, to be waited up by the Valkyrie. No, it was in a land now sunken, a real land, a real battle. Not a battle between an animal and a Norse god, but between two civilizations whose partial remnants today are the Norse and the Irish and the Egyptians.

It is very exciting to your editor to find all the legends of the past reconstructed in fact at last, with a tremendous history that makes sense of the mystery that ancient man's beginnings have always been. When we find an ancient "fort" in Ireland, its stones fused by some tremendous heat that rivals the atom bomb (if it was not actually the heat of such bombs), we wonder at the inconsistency of a science which says there were not even people on Earth at that time, and that if there were, they fought only with clubs and stones. We read of the Greek fire of the ancient Greeks (the ANCIENT Greeks, not the "modern" Greeks of the ruins we visit today, such as the temple of Athena, etc.) and we wonder what it was? Our scientific "experts" have told us it was a compound soaked in crude oil, fired with a catapult. We look at the ancient ruins, and we cannot accept this simple explanation of Greek fire, because no amount of such assault will produce the results we have before our eyes.

All about us we have the records of civilizations incredibly ancient such as 25,000 years, or a hundred thousand years, and we are told that what is before our eyes does not really exist, because it cannot. Yet, it is there, and now we know what it represents.

Recently an expedition in the Mediterranean announced the discovery of ancient Atlantis, in a ruined city under the sea, and on the shore. Excavations are going forward. This is an authentic discovery, but it is in error in only one claim - it is not Atlantis, merely a colony, and not the original colony, but a colony formed of survivors of the great destruction that sank Atlantis into the ocean. Yet, it is, as the book is being printed, already a bit more added to the scientific proof that THE ANCIENT ATLANTIC is the real answer to all the mysteries we have tried to pursue in SEARCH, and in all our other magazines and books over a period of forty years!

Do you wonder that the editors of SEARCH are excited over the new book? ### WEREWOLVES IN INDIANA

#### A MODERN DAY "HORROR" STORY

WHEN I WAS stationed at Fort Riley, Kansas, in the summer of 1966, several of the men in my unit used to get together in their spare time and tell stories of ghosts and strange happenings.

During one such "bull session", I was told the following story about a werewolf living in the region of Muncie and Anderson, Indiana. The essential facts of the story were later corroborated by two other men who, although they hadn't known each other prior to entering the Army, had known this werewolf at different times during their lives.

The man who first told me the story, whom I shall call Mr. John-

son, had been the friend of an Amerind for sometime. One day as they were out driving, the Indian said, "I'll tell you something that I know you won't believe".

"Go ahead."

"I'm a werewolf, and sometime I'll prove it to you."

Sometime later they met at the Indian's house. Present also was the Indian's girl friend, a white girl.

The Indian cautioned Johnson that, when he saw the results of the transformation, he was not to attemp to flee. Any attempt at fright, or even movement, would break his restraint and he would feel compelled to attack.

The Indian then proceeded to go into a trance or perhaps deep concentration.

Soon his hands and face began

to grow hairy, the fingers taking on the appearance of claws. Fangs seemed to sprout in his mouth.

His hands and face took on a reddish cast and his countenance took on an expression of evil. The Indian, having a normal height of about 5' 6'', was now a werewolf about seven feet tall!

Seeing this frightening transformation, Johnson started to flee towards the door.

Immediately the werewolf pounced upon him, his hands grasping Johnson's throat as though to strangle him.

Had it not been for the werewolf's girlfriend, who began stroking his arm, he probably would have killed Johnson. This stroking of the werewolf's arm, strangely enough, seemed to soothe him.

A BOUT 20 MILES northwest of Neosho, Missouri lies the mysterious "ghost light" area where, according to old-timers, the strange, baffling phenomenon has been witnessed as far back as the late 1880's.

The eerie "lights" are suggestive of floating spheres of luminous semi-material substance - a sort of globular phosphorescence, animated, apparently, by a life of its own and directed by what appears to be a certain degree of intelligent control.

Motorists have reported the ''lights'' on innumerable occasions, and lonely walkers in the Ozark country have seen them in a

hundred different places. (After dark, of course, - no respectable "ghost light" or ghost, for that matter, ever makes an appearance in the light of day.)

The mystery - and surely a mystery it is - has been approached from many angles, and theories have been offered based upon many premises - except the astrological.

We present our argument with the conviction that it will stand up better than any other, but it is for the reader to judge if it is reasonable and convincing.

In the first place, not every motorist or walker after dark has enjoyed the privilege of observing the phenomenon. In fact, as with many similar manifestations, certain members in a group will "see" what other members are unaware of.

That the "ghost lights" are a reality, no one - at any rate, the Neosho observers - will deny. Too many honest, responsible persons have testified in the affirmative for us to doubt that the mystery is there, and has been for over 80 years.

The puzzling thing is: why do some see it, and why is it non-existent to others? Here is where astrology comes in, and with a very interesting argument.

Everyone knows about, or at least talks about, clairvoyance. Almost everyone, at sometime or another in his life, either has "seen" something, "heard" something, or "felt" something that refused to be explained away by everyday logic and common sense.

#### - YOU ARE PSYCHIC -

Some time ago a book called "You Are Psychic", made a great hit. It showed that everyone has within him the potentialities of a seer - of one who "sees clearly" into the inner worlds around us.

This is precisely what astrology says - that each individual is a microcosm in the boundless reality we call the macrocosm, the universe, the frontierless expanse of infinitude. What the All contains and represents, man also has and is.

According to astrology - esoteric astrology, that is - the higher E.S.P. is ruled by the planet Uranus, while the other kind comes under Neptune. That brilliant researcher, the late Grant Lewi, pointed out that Uranus ruled what he called the "neuromentality" our intuitive faculty which is responsible for direct revelation, mystical illumination, and universal understanding, while Neptune has dominion over the subconscious mind, which often is cluttered with horoscopes substantiates Grant Lewi's claim. The sign and house positions of Uranus, together with its aspects, provide an excellent key to understanding "third eye quotient" or degree of cerebro-spinal clairvoyance. And the same with Neptune, shows where one stands in respect to the psychic awareness made possible by the sympathetic nervous system.

#### FOUR FAMOUS SEERS

Manly Palmer Hall (March 18,

1901), the brilliant occult author and lecturer, is an ideal example of both kinds of E.S.P. In his birth horoscope, Uranus is conjunction the Midheaven (the most important single point in a chart); and the sign Pisces, which Neptune rules, is on the Ascendant, with Sun, Mercury, and Venus also in Pisces. Neptune itself is within minutes of an exact square with the Sun, completing an extraordinary pattern of inner plane involvement. It is no wonder that his clairyovance is crystal clear and virtually infallible.

In the horoscope of H.P. Blavatsky (August 12, 1831), the world-renowned seeress of the 19th century, Pisces is on the Midheaven, and Uranus is focal by a conjunction with Jupiter in Aquarius (which Uranus rules) in the 8th house of magic and the astral plane. Madame Blavatsky's fabulous feats of E.S.P. were attested to by many world figures of her time, and have passed into history. Many believe her to have been the greatest clairvoyant to appear on the occult scene in several hundred years.

Edgar Cayce, the celebrated seer and diagnostic wizard of Virginia Beach (March 18, 1877), was born with Uranus within minutes of a conjunction with his Leo Ascendant. The Sun, ruler of Leo, was in Pisces (Neptune's sign) with Mercury, Venus, Saturn, and

Jeanne Dixon (January 5, 1918), whose many startling predictions have-made the headlines during the past several years, was born with Uranus in close conjunction with Venus and within minutes of the mysterious 165 degree aspect to Neptune. The 165 degree contact has been mentioned by America's illustrious astrology-researcher and also England's Johndro, Charles Carter. It is 15 degrees past the 150 degree quincunx configuration, and 15 degrees before the 180 degree opposition, thus partaking of the the strange influence of both major aspects. It is believed to exert a profoundly occult effect upon all who have it close to exactness, and in Mrs. Dixon's case undoubtedly has much to do with her almost unbelievable gift of seership.

#### THE ANIMAL WORLD

Animals are indeed a mystery to man. We use the word "animal" loosely to include any living creature other than human, i.e. birds, etc. The following six stories are about exceptional creatures, and because they are "out of the ordinary" their stories may give you a glimpse of the workings of the animal mind.

#### WHITEY TALKS (The Talking Cat)

It was June 7th, 1963 when Mrs. Deem and her husband rescued a bedraggled, crying, wet kitten from the tall grass in a field, where apparently it had been abandoned. The kitten was very ill. Mrs. Deem sat up with it for two nights, and then she and her husband decided to take it to a veterinarian who saved its life

The Deems now have nineteen cats, but at the time they found the kitten, they had only one other cat, a black one called "Blackie".

The kitten was pure white, so was named "Whitey".

According to Mrs. Deem, Whitey began talking at about the age of six months. One of the earliest words it said was "trailer", apparently with reference to its former home. (It was thought that the kitten's former owners had lived in a trailer and had moved away.)

The first time the cat talked was when it jumped up on the bed where Mrs. Deem was lying and said, "I'm hungry". Mrs. Deem could not believe what she heard. She did not tell her husband about the incident, until he too, heard it

talk. The cat jumped up on Mr. Deem's lap. Mr. Deem said to the kitten, "You are a bad cat." The cat replied, "I am not a bad cat. I want out." Mr. Deem shouted to his wife, "Did you hear that?" Mrs. Deem was much reassured now that her husband had also heard the cat talk.

In the early days of the cat's talking it seemed that almost any one might have heard the cat talk if they were willing and able to spend a little time at the home of the owners. Also, at that time the cat could be inducted to talk by withholding its food until it "said something". However, after a long

seige of accidents, illness and an operation, the cat's talking diminished. The last report as to the frequency with which the cat says human words was on the average of not less than once a week.

As Whitey and Blackie are both tomcats, they are not friends, but quite the reverse. Mr. and Mrs. Deem try to arrange it so that one would always be out of the house while the other was in. Also for quite a time, it seems that all that was necessary to get Whitey to "say something" was to bring Blackie into his presence. He would often respond, "He's bad", referring to Blackie, or "He's mean."

As a very young cat, Whitey was said to have watched for the Deems to return from the shopping center with cat food. It is said that Whitey would nose the cans of cat food and say, "Open." Also Whitey liked chocolate candy, and the Deems learned to know that he was asking for chocolate candy whenever he would say, "What have you got for me!"

Mr. Deem found that he could get a response from Whitey by teasing him. Sometimes with this in mind and especially if he wanted some other person to hear him talk he would say "Whitey, you are a bad cat." Whitey would frequently respond with an indignant, "I am not."

Whitey likes television and the owners of Florida's talking cat often leave the television on for the cat's benefit and pleasure.

Once on television there was the picture of a dog which seemed to have excited Whitey. To reassure himself, or for some other reason Whitey remarked, "He is not real." Another time there was a show on in which a man was shot. Whitey said to Mrs. Deem, "Was he hurt?" Mrs. Deem replied, "No." The cat automatically responded with, "Don't tell a lie, mama."

One of the most common incidents of talking is the request to be let out. However, it is not often that a neighbor happens to

be present when Whitey makes this request. Mrs. Sharon, a neighbor, was in the room with Mrs. Deem when the cat said quite plainly, "Mama, I want out."

Shortly after the newspaper articles had started, a reporter the Lakeland (Florida) Ledger went to the Deem home to get a story about the cat, and hoped to hear the cat talk. At that time it was frequently possible to induce the cat to talk by coaxing him. The efforts of the Deems were in vain. and the reporter left. However. before he left he took a flashbulb picture of the cat. The reporter had been gone only a short time when the cat said one word, apparently referring to the flashbulb picture. The cat said. "Light."

Mrs. Deem told that on one occasion the cat had been to a veterinarian, as he had been many times before and after. When he returned home he said, rightly or wrongly of a helper, "The helper was mean."

A tomcat sometimes finds life and people frustrating. In his early days of talking Whitey sometimes said, "I'm mad." Also, on occasions he has complained, "Nobody loves me!" He must know in his heart, however, that this is not the case. Often he says, "I love mama," meaning Mrs. Deem, and it is obvious also, that he loves Mr. Deem.

In the days of early publicity bout the talking cat, a minister isited the Deems to inquire about he story. The minister, Mr. and Ars. Deem and the cat were all athered in the front room when he cat stated, "Why don't you go ome?" Mrs. Deem said to Whitey, "Aren't you ashamed of yourelf?" Whitey replied, "Iam not!" whitey added another insult in tating, "He's a stinker!"

About this time, or probably little earlier the cat had been eft with a veterinarian. The veterinarian and his helper told the ollowing story to Mr. and Mrs. Deem.

The veterinarian's helper was ear the cat's cage, when to his mazement he heard the cat say, 'I want to go home.' He rushed to the veterinarian and told him that he had heard. The veterinarian accused his helper of trying the 'fool somebody'. Nevertheless, the went to the cage. He heard othing, but as he turned to leave, the heard the words, 'I want to go ome.' He looked accusingly at is helper, who stated, 'I didn't ay that. The cat did!'

At one time after the cat had pparently been stolen, and had eturned after many days in a eplorable condition, it was thought e had lost the ability to talk. Mr. beem often walked the cat. He tarted as usual for a walk, but or some reason was delayed. He

was delighted to hear Whitey say, "Come on."

When the Deems travelled and only had Whitey and Blackie, they often took the cats with them in their car. It was difficult to get motel accommodations with cats. so settled for sleeping in their car. In a small town in North Carolina the Deems were parked alongside a curb, sleeping with Whitey in the car. A passing policeman heard a voice coming from the parked car. He heard the words, "Help! Help!" He rushed up to the Deem car and flashed his light to investigate. He saw the Deems awakening and a beautiful white cat. He heard the cat say, "I want out." "No one loves me." The policeman had what must have been his most unique experience.

All of these incidents occurred while the Deems were residents of Hillside Acres, a housing development near Lake Hamilton, Florida. A year or two ago, they moved from Hillside Acres to another house in Lake Hamilton about four miles from their previous home.

After moving they had trouble with Whitey's going back to his old home, or to that area and staying for days at a time, returning sick and bedraggled.

Mr. and Mrs. Joe Rhodes, friends and previous neighbors of the Deems, were skeptical about the stories of the talking cat.

One time Whitey had been gone

an unusually long time, and was thought to be dead. While the cat was absent from its home, Mr. Rhodes caught a glimpse of him in a nearby vacant lot. He recognized Whitey and knew how the Deems were probably anxious for his return. He decided to try to catch the cat. It was about 4:30 p.m. and a clear day. As he approached the cat, Whitey ran from him. Mr. Rhodes was shocked when he distinctly heard the cat say, "You can't catch me."

Another time Mrs. Deem and Whitey were both out in the yard, when she noticed the cat looking intently under the house. She heard Whitey say, "Come! Come!" When she got near him, he said, "He is a big one." Mrs. Deem started to look under the house when a big black snake began to move from its hiding place. Mrs. Deem screamed. Whitey said, "Mama is a coward."

Because of a death, Mr. and Mrs. Deem were called to West Virginia. They left their two cats, Whitey and Blackie in the charge of a nearby neighbor. He made daily trips to the Deem home to care for the cats. The neighbor, Mr. Marshall Furgesen had heard reports of the cat's remarkable talent, but was politely skeptical. As he approached the home on one of his trips he saw Whitey being pursued by Blackie. He was very much astonished to hear Whitey

say, "Where's mama?" This was the first time he had actually heard the cat talk.

In approximately a week or so the Deems returned from the trip. They were in their home with Mr. Furgesen when Whitey approached Mrs. Deem in the bedroom. "He hit me!" he stated. "Who hit you?" "Him," the cat replied, Mr. Furgesen's voice could be heard coming from the kitchen. Mrs. Deem questioned the cat further. "What did he hit you with?" The cat said, "Newspaper." Deem immediately confronted Mr. Furgesen and asked him if he had hit the cat. He was amazed, and described an incident in which he had hit the cat with a newspaper.

Mr. and Mrs. Neville Mainguy, Orange City, Florida read the newspaper and magazine articles about Florida's talking cat and arranged through a writer to visit the Deems. They hoped to hear the famous cat talk.

Their visit was pleasant, but they were disappointed when Whitey remained silent. They have had many cats and were cat lovers, so naturally the main topic of their conversation was cats. The next day Mrs. Deem phoned the writer and asked him if he knew whether or not the Mainguys had a cat named "Pal". She said that shortly after they left Whitey said, "Pal." Mrs. Deem contacted the Mainguys and asked them if the name "Pal"

had any meaning to them. Mrs. Mainguy said that it certainly did. It was the name of a cat which had disappeared mysteriously. She said that its name had been mentioned in the conversations between them and their hosts. Mrs. Deem had not noted the name or had forgotten it, but apparently it made an impression on Whitey. Simple as this story is, it is one of the most impressive of the stories because it suggests that Whitey must have understood the conversation about the lost cat, and seemed to have picked out the name of the cat.

The cat apparently understands more of the human drama going on around it, than its responses would suggest. Sometimes a word he uses will be a word which it could not have heard recently, but when he speaks it, he uses the word appropriately.

Also, Mrs. Deem says that sometimes she will say to Whitey, "Come and flirt with me," and will wink at the cat and the cat will wink back.

On one occasion Whitey threatened to leave, but apparently recognized that his threat was an ungrateful thing and condemned himself for it.

Another instance occurred when Whitey was quite young. He jumped up on the bed where Mrs. Deem was lying and said, "Hungry. Leave you. Mad. I want to go home. I bad."

I think it was March 10, 1966 that I saw Mrs. Deem in a shopping center. It had been many months since I had seen either Mr. or Mrs. Deem, and since that meeting she had been seriously ill and in the hospital. The following is in substance the story told me by Mr. and Mrs. Deem.

Mrs. Deem was away from home in the hospital for a considerable time. All of the cats seemed to have missed her, but Whitey especially. When she returned, Whitey hugged her with his front feet, or speaking more humanly, with his "arms", and would not let her go. When she would start to leave he would say, not the words, "No! No!", but the human equivalent which might


be spelled "Eugh! Eugh!" Also, when he first saw her, he not only hugged her but said "Mama home! Mama home!"

Questions have been asked as to the kind of voice in which the cat speaks. This writer has heard Mrs. Deem relate a story in which she said that the cat talked so loudly that she was afraid its talking would awaken her sleeping husband.

However, Mrs. Deem said that it was usually a "quiet voice". Mr. Deem in describing the cat's talking has frequently mentioned that the cat speaks "distinctly" and "clearly".

We have now presented the reader with the most complete story about Florida's talking cat, which has not yet been published. Fortunately, the story is not yet ended, and it is impossible to say what may be added to it.

We believe this story to be the most remarkable of cat stories, and to be as reliable as human testimony can make it. We also believe that it will still be so regarded a hundred years from now.


The story of Shep is well known. He was a sheep dog who maintained an unbroken watch

Shep's story was featured in Ripley's "Believe It or Not". His loyalty and devotion to his departed master has now become a legend.


#### THE CROW AND THE PUPPY


the way. For these star pupils there is a list of buyers.

CHRISTMAS, of course, is the time of year to renew sagging friendships. So it was that the Christmas of 1966 found me entertaining three old friends, Paul, Fred and Howard. And this infrequent get-together turned out immensely enjoyable, as they invariably do.

So many subjects were discussed in the several hours we four sat in my house. Subjects of mutual interest, like flying saucers, astronomy, spiritualism, philosophy, etc.

One of the subjects raised by Fred was the question: Is man essentially different from all other animals? I remember him turning to Howard (whom we have always kidded as being the "intellect" of our group) and saying:

"Howard, I know you are extremely well read, and I would like to ask your opinion on a highly con**ALEX SAUNDERS** 

troversial matter. Do philosophers recognize a basic difference between man and animals? One which could not have come about in the normal evolutionary process?

"Oh, I know, one may say that only man has thinking ability, creative powers, and a conscience. But don't forget, scientists have demonstrated that animals not only reason, but also create things. Nests and dams, for example."

Howard pointed out that until comparatively recent times, few philosophers doubted that man was essentially different from all other animals, and that in the great tradition of western thought, from Plato right down to the 19th century, it was almost universally held that man and man alone is a rational animal.

Paul entered the conversation with the words:

"This philosophical view of man's distinctive nature accords with the biblical view that man - and only man - is created in the image of God. That he is a person - not a thing."

"Since the time of Darwin," I offered, "The opposite view has come to prevail. Not only among scientists, but among the educated classes generally."

After these utterances from Paul and I, we were content to sit back, wine glasses in hand, and just listen to the exchange between Fred and Howard.

From the latter: As you know, when <u>Darwin's Origin of Species</u> first came out, it clearly formulated and elaborated the theory of evolution. His first work in 1837 described a five years' cruise in the <u>Beagle</u>, sponsored by the British government for scientific purposes.

Origin of Species appeared in 1859, and though defended and supported by the scientific thought of the time, it was understandably attacked by theologians. A still further elaboration of the evolutionary theory was issued by Darwin in 1871, called Descent of Man. Other principal works came from this British scientist also.

<u>Fred</u>: "Naturally I am aware that the Darwinian theory of man's origin is that man and the anthropoid apes have descended from a common ancestral form. And along with this view of man's evolutionary origin goes the view that man and the higher mammals differ only in degree. Therefore, instead of regarding man alone as rational, what do the evolutionists conclude? One thing - the same kind of intelligence in man and other animals."

Howard: "The traditional arguments for man's distinctive nature are, to my mind, far from weak. Others, such as you, Fred, disagree, saying that animals as well as men can reason, make things, and so on. Well, this is a challenge, and I most certainly will defend the traditional point of view about man as a very special creature.

"One such indication is his power of making things. Of course we all know that hives are made by bees, nests by birds, and dams by beavers. But such productions are entirely instinctive on their part.

"When a given species of birds unfailingly makes its nests in the same way, for untold generations, we realize that the nest is a product of instinct. Instinct, Fred, not art, which involves reason and free will.

"In making houses, bridges, or any other of their artifacts, men invent and select. They are truly artists, which does not hold true for animals. Remember, too, only men build machines which are themselves productive."

Fred: "But other animals can reason and ..."

Howard: "No. I believe it would be more correct to say that other animals can solve problems when they are confronted with the biological urgency of finding a way of satisfying their needs. All the socalled "thinking" by animals is on this level."

<u>Fred</u>: "I'm beginning to get your point, Howard. No animal, for example, ever sits down to think and ponder."

Howard: "Exactly. They don't think the way a philosopher or a mathematician does when he has no biological need to do so. Animal problem-solving and human thinking is widely different in another way. Simply put, human thinking is discursive and involves language.

"Granted, Fred, animals make sounds and communicate their emotions, or impulses, to one another. But no animal communicates thought. Nor is a sentence ever uttered which asserts a truth or falsehood. Only a rational animal - man! - can accomplish that.

"What other creature than man has a historical development? None. Other animals, true, may change in their biological constitution over the course of hundreds of thousands of generations, but such changes result entirely from changes in the germ plasm, which is the only thing that is transmitted from one generation to another.

"However, when it comes to man, you get transmitted ideas and institutions, a whole tradition of culture, from one generation to another. And it is this which accounts for the history of the human race.

"I hold to the firm conviction that the empirical evidence is overwhelmingly in favor of the view that men are essentially different in kind from the brutes. Like them, men are also animals. But, unlike the brutes, men alone are rational.

"Now, if this conviction of mine (and many others) is true, it would require us to reject Darwin's theory of man's evolutionary origin. After all, theories must be made to fit the facts, not facts fit the theories."

So Howard had had his say. Fred was voiceless, obviously thinking over the other's words.

Shortly afterward, our rare get-together broke up and my three old friends Paul, Fred and Howard left my house on that Christmas of 1966. A roar of car engines disturbed the cold outside air for a minute or two. Then, with their departure, all was quiet, and I, like Fred, was left alone with my thoughts.

in the lower worlds.

Scattered among his daily mail are such letters as, the man in Ceylon who claims that he appears to him daily between the hours of two and five for spiritual discussions; a woman who says he comes nightly to give her a lecture on spiritual subjects. Another woman says he saved her life when her car went out of control on a mountain road. There is a letter stating that he cured the writer of an incurable disease. Another writes that he

takes care of her family problems personally. A man says he travels with Sri Paul Twitchell nightly in the higher worlds, and a woman said he was with her, protecting her when the ship she was on rode safely through a heavy hurricane.

Others verify that he teaches by the dream method, and out-ofthe-body projection awareness method.

It is said that he reads the soul's records of anyone at a distance, escorts the souls of departed ones across the border of death to their proper place in the spiritual lands, and that he halted a major earthquake last year in Southern California.

Some students claim he pulled a high spiritual master out of a deadly illness last September, when that teacher was near death in the latter's ashram in India. Many very high teachers and masters seek him out to gain spiritual wisdom and advice, and learn how to make greater progress in the other worlds. Mainly, how to do soul travel at which he is a perfect master.

He is protected by an armor of light and anyone who tries to do him the least injustice will have it fly back on themselves almost at once.

Many people seem to believe that he is a living master of this age, but nobody knows much about this enigma of the twentieth century. It is said that he was born on a Mississippi riverboat over a hundred years ago, but others deny this, and make a fantastic claim that he first saw light in the Caucasus mountains in the late seventeenth century. ## AMERICA'S FIRST DOCTOR

#### The Indian Medicine Man

#### ABOUT THE AUTHOR

For the past twenty-five years I have been "researching" everything written on man and his relationship to God; function of spirit, soul, mind and body.

1958-59 was spent in Europe (living in Switzerland), researching "Education Abroad", which made for some interesting writing on this subject. My two girls were with me, and went to a Swiss school in Clarens, Switzerland.

My career as a newspaper woman began only 12 years ago, when I found myself in need of a job after working at being a homemaker and mother for 18 years.

About two years ago, I discovered the teachings and writings of EOM, Ida Mingle, teacher and founder of the School of Liveable Christianity, Chicago, Illinois. I began collecting as many of her teachings as I could find, because I am convinced that it is that "truth" so many are searching for these days.

RADITIONALLY, many American Indians continue to look to the medicine man when disturbed or in physical pain. He is doctor, father confessor, and a recognized spiritual authority. His approach is not unlike that of the medical doctor or the priest of today. The mental and emotional state of the one to be helped is his first consideration, before his remedy is applied.

Semu Huaute (pronounced WHO AT OOT TAY), a practicing inner tribal medicine man serving In-



dians in California, Nevada, New Mexico and Arizona, told a group interested in the American Indian's use of herbs, "The medicine man first attempts to determine the cause of an illness, which often can be traced to some uneasiness of mind.

"One must agree with his thoughts and actions, or understand why he does not, if he hopes to avoid conflict within himself that usually results in some form of physical discomfort," he explained, pointing out that the American Indian knew the importance of

this "long before psychiatry was known to the white man, or psychology applied even unconsciously."

Like today's doctor, the medicine man's time is in demand and his patients many. The problems that confront his people are very much like those of most Americans: family disagreement, delinquent children, broken homes and troubled minds. Whatever the condition, however, his people believe in his ability to improve it.

"To say that we can cure all illness would be wrong," Semu said, "and when there are symptoms of a serious ailment we are quick to recommend a white man doctor."

It is understood that the medicine man will not jeopardize the good he does accomplish by using poor judgment in his practice. He does not break the law of the white man even when it lessens his religious freedom of "spiritually" treating the sick. He avoids anything that might reflect upon his people unfavorably. Often the problem is nothing more than wanting to discuss inner conflict with someone who understands. someone they can trust, in which case the medicine man is a good listener and a proven friend.

If a wrong has been committed, which, according to Semu, disturbs the Indian in a way little understood by other people, it must be rectified, and ways to right the

wrong are recommended without delay.

For example, if something has been stolen, it must, when possible, be returned to its owner, if this can be done gracefully and in good faith. In some cases, it is returned by the medicine man who alone knows the taker.

When an article is not available for return, it is replaced with an equivalent, often demanding great hardship of the guilty person. In instances where this is impossible, the confessor is obligated to perform a task, a good deed. This is often in a service to the one offended. Whatever the plan, however, it remains with the medicine man and the one making amends. A stolen article returned becomes a "treasure" to the Indian - the symbol of a wrong made right.

According to the medicine man, quarrels between lovers are easy to mend, even serious ones. He is both father and grandfather image who, through the centuries, has represented wisdom and law in such matters - now gone but not forgotten.

Delinquent teenagers are becoming a problem to Indian parents, which "was unheard of until the white man attempted to 'educate' the Indians," Semu said smiling, and with a more serious note added, "Respect for parents and elders and love for family members was once the most

beautiful part of the Indian's way of life, but forced association has changed that. The young Indians of today are all but convinced that the wisdom of their elders, respect for their parents, or even common courtesy for their fellowman, is not for this 'hep' generation.'

These are but a few of the social difficulties that confront the medicine man today, but his effort to recapture the once "contented heart" of the American Indian does not cease. His problems, however, like those of the white man, are mounting daily.

Often his appearance alone is all that is needed to change the total environment of a hogan on an isolated reservation or a crowded room in a busy city; for, indeed, his presence does have a magic quality. And whether he chants his prayer songs, performs a ritual, or administers a bitter herb, his visit is impressive and effective.

Faith in his ability to "make things right" began with his practice and has not changed with time. When he prescribes a medicine, it is taken from the earth, and his people rely upon his ancient formulas.

"The Great Spirit has endowed Mother Earth with a natural medicine for the ills of man," Semu states authoritatively, "as any pharmaceutical laboratory could verify." And the medicine man has

used effectively certain combinations of them yet to be discovered. For centuries, we have used them to relieve physical pain and ease mental tensions.

"We also know that, even natural herbs with medical properties

can promote health or produce an illness and must therefore be used wisely." he warned his listeners.

How does a medicine man apply his knowledges?

He begins with respect for the thoughts and feelings of the person he is to help. He knows suffering and understands problems. He has a keen and sensitive feeling nature which is helpful in establishing for him the necessary rapport for the desired results. He listens carefully and sympathetically. Before he speaks, to begin the application of his "power", his subject is aware of a strange silence permeating the atmosphere. This is always attained before he attempts to proceed.

"The Great Spirit speaks to man in the silence," the medicine man will tell you convincingly, "and its voice is clearly understood by those who can enter this silence within themselves."

It is in this silence he perceives his direction before beginning his "treatment". The application he employs varies with the individual and their particular problem, but his objective is always the same - a healing by the Great Spirit. He lays no claim to any personal power, however, nor does he take credit for any miracle that may possibly result. His medicine kit includes feathers, a clay image, and a variety of stones. The feathers may be those of an eagle,

owl, or other birds, depending upon the tribe he represents.

The clay image is a symbol of man in whom the Great Spirit dwells. The stones he carries also depends upon his tribal background. A piece of turquoise is usually found in every medicine kit, for it is considered to be sacred among many tribes. This is also true of the eagle's feathers - a significant and sacred bird to all Indians.

He carries a drum and a rattle, which have a special meaning for him. The drum, used in his ceremonies, tends to attract the attention of his listener, which sometimes brings temporary relief to a troubled state before the ritual is begun.

Is this a form of hypnosis?

"Perhaps," he says agreeably, but we do not think of it as such."

To successfully treat anyone, the medicine man believes he must have their undivided attention for he works with the senses, which "is the source of distress," he tells you, "and one must control his senses before he can hope to control (and therefore change) his environment."

He considers himself to be only an instrument, used by the Great Spirit to prepare the way for a new level of consciousness, which "in itself will change the thinking, and consequently the condition," he confides. He is quick to admit that he of himself can do nothing; but, waiting upon the Great Spirit for direction, and serving accordingly, thoughtto-be miracles are sometimes accomplished.

There is another kind of "medicine man," called the witch man, or witch doctor, but he is not to be mistaken for the medicine man written about here. His power is also known to the Indians who seek his services.

He is called upon to bring back a lover, render a man (or woman) impotent, or even produce a heart attack or paralysis. And, according to the medicine man, he does the will of man, which is responsible for the trouble in the first place, and pays no heed to the will of the Great Spirit.

"Knowledge of the use of Mother Nature's medicine is a great responsibility, just as it is with medicine synthetically produced in the laboratory," Semu cautions, "for it is possible with certain combinations of herbs to permanently damage the body.

"For example, one not knowing what to administer could paralyze an optic nerve and cause blindness, or stop the function of the kidneys. And it is true that a heart attack can be produced which could not be proved to be murder," he said knowingly.

How does one come to be a medicine man?

A medicine man is born - not made. He must show signs of wisdom at an early age. The Indians call it being "born old". He communicates with people that he alone can see, almost as soon as he begins to talk. This is never discouraged by the parents, who believe it to be a sign of his ability to communicate with the Great Spirit in a very special way. A medicine man 'in-the-making' also proves early that he can recognize one in distress, and sometimes knows what can be done to help them.

It is said that Semu at the age of three would climb upon the lap of one suffering a headache. Putting his lips to their forhead, he would inhale - turn away - and blow out the breath, which would promptly relieve the pain. He also used this gift to relieve the pain of his playmates when burned while playing with fire.

Extra sensory perception is another outstanding ability of the medicine man, highly developed and utilized. Though this sensitivity is considered to be natural for the Indian, its lack of use with their changing way of life has minimized its application.

When these talents are demonstrated by a young Indian boy, he is taken by the elders (medicine men), who train him for his life's mission, and add to his knowledge all that they have ac-

quired. They believe his life to be spiritually significant - his presence thought to invoke divine favor.

The first lesson to be learned, if he has not already mastered it, is absolute control of his senses. He must be in command of his emotion and desire, and provethis to be so under the most severe conditions. Then, after many difficult trials and forbidding test, he is accepted as a full-fledged medicine man - a qualified messenger and helper of the Great Spirit.

High moral standards and ethics are a must for him, and he must be incapable of hate. This is to assure the continued love and respect of his people, lest faith in the medicine man be lessened by doubt in the goodness he represents. He must serve when called upon to do so, regardless of the hour or the distance involved. His people depend upon his selfless service, and he becomes a symbol of strength, courage, love, and Divine Principle to many.

There exists on the west coast of the United States a closed group of thirteen inner tribal medicine men who have proved themselves worthy of their title. Their function, it is said, is more than healing the bodies and mending the broken hearts of their people; for they are known to engage themselves in a ceremony of never-

ending prayer for the destiny of America.

They meet at unexpected intervals, in a remote kiva (underground ceremonial chamber) situated in an isolated area where the sound of their drums cannot be heard by man. There is always one or more in attendance of the perpetual flame burning as a reminder of the ever-present spirit of love within man. Some travel many hundreds of miles under great hardship to attend, but they all arrive. Here in the wilderness these dedicated men. with their hearts extended to God and their hand to their fellowman. hope for a brighter tomorrow.

The only notice given of their meeting, or a "call to the kiva", it announced telepathically, one to the other; their only form of communication when not together.

When Semu was asked about the history of his race not written in history books and the possibility of the American Indian being completely absorbed by society, his only reply was:

"We, as a unique race of people, have a place in the future of America, as we have had in her past. And while it would be foolish to say that we have not been beaten, let it be known that we have not been conquered. Our spirit is an expression of the One Great Spirit; patient, forgiving and unconquerable!"

WHAT CAN WE LOOK FORWARD TO IN THIS NEW AGE?





#### NOT CIVILIZED YET

Dear Editor:

I am very much interested in and impressed by your editorial in the July, 1967 issue of SEARCH. In it, you express your belief "that we have too much civilization!" In that statement you come close to understanding the basic law of history; you are only off the track by a hair's breadth.

The fact is that civilization itself is by its very nature decadent! Civilization is the last stage in the organic development of any racial, religious, or ethnic community. The decadent Rome of Nero and Heliogalbus was truly a "civilization"; the noble Roman republic, which existed much earlier (especially before the Punic Wars) had been a "culture". We are today in the United States in transition from a culture (healthy) to a civilization (unhealthy).

National communities are, in fact, living organisms, being made up of millions of individual living human beings. Communities have periods of infancy, childhood, adolescence, maturity, and senility, just as human beings. European

history as we know it began about 800 A.D., and can be shown to have passed through all the periods and ages of life; the Crusades, for example, represent the heady adventurous spirit of adolescence. Europe's approaching old age was first hinted by Napoleon; its senility was proven beyond a doubt by both Stalin and Hitler.

But America should be in no danger! Our heritage is only two hundred years old - we should be a culture, as far from civilization as Europe was in 1066 A.D. Yet we are disintegrating with Europe!

This view of history is the one presented by the great philosopher. historian. mathematician. political theorist, Oswald Spengler, in his master-work THE DECLINE OF THE WEST. This is a deep work, perhaps the deepest and most hard-to-understand book that you will have ever read: I know. for I have been struggling with the book for years. • America is a young country in an "old" world. What happens to that old world will happen to America. But we don't mean to say that there is no solution. We do say the solution may not be entirely to our individual liking - but those of us who think about the

problem (and studying Spengler is a good way to get some factors to deal with!) may come up with answers that did not occur to previous civilizations. We don't Spengler decrees the "decline" will inevitably culminate in the "fall", but surely he intimates that it is highly possible. The problem is what "civilization" really is. Do we really want, and can we really use, the "culture" toward which we are heading? What we said was that our real danger is TOO MUCH civilization. And if we are clever enough to realize our limitations. we might wind up carrying out our destiny in success (at our proper level) rather than disaster. If our destiny is to learn to walk, we should do our practicing on level ground, not off the edge of a cliff. It is a matter of the proper order logically, flying comes after walking. We believe this is "walking" planet, and "walking" life, and the "high flying" comes later, in a different environment. You can't evolve from an amoeba to a man in a glass of water! At the very least the glass will shatter, and the over-ambitious "man" will be cut to pieces by broken glass. He will certainly die "out of his element" (the glass). - Editor.
