



Editorial

One of Search's readers writes to tell us that back in the early days of the magazine your editor predicted that there would be no landing on the moon. Now that our astronauts have been there twice and returned safely, he reminds us that our efforts in the direction of prophecy were hardly accurate. You might say that his statement is a bit hard to attack in any way, because the facts are so inescapable: we said no landing, and there was. Plain and simple wrong.

But the situation does bring up a very interesting angle for discussion, and one we'd like to go into, not as a defense of our prophetic abilities, but as a sidelight on what prophecy really is. You might begin by asking how it came about that our reasoning induced us to say that no Earthman would land on the moon? Well, there seem to be two kinds of prophecy; the kind where the prophet claims to have some sort of direct inspiration, from an unknown source; and the kind where existing facts are extrapolated, logic and reason are used in projecting them into the future, and a prediction based on these facts is made. It was this latter method that we used.

Early in space exploration a few unusual facts came to light-one: that

objects that had been in orbit for some time, for some unexplained reason, seemed to have lost weight when recovered, although there was no oblation or erosion due to their passage through the atmosphere because of being protected inside something else; two: that, biologically speaking, similar losses occurred in the human body, particularly in the case of the bone structure where there was a loss of calcium. After Apollo 12, one of the visiting Russian cosmonauts remarked that he had been informed that both the Soviet and American space programs now included setting up space stations where groups of men could spend long periods in the weightlessness of space so that effects of being in this environment could be more closely studied before making any attempt to reach the planets, such as Mars and perhaps the moons of Jupiter. It should be understood that when the reference to "weightlessness" is made, it is the same as the concern for "loss of calcium". Out in the weightlessness of space there is a definite loss of calcium from the bones, and this can naturally be a great danger if it is a prolonged process. Is it a process that continues progressively in space? Would an astronaut placed in

weightlessness suffer a continuing loss of calcium until his bones collapsed, or even dissolved? This is one of the things we must know before we send men on a journey that will take as long as a year, or even three years. It would be too late for the astronaut to discover after he was well on his way that he couldn't make it to his destination or return before he died from his bone damage.

When we made our prediction, the meagre evidence we had then was what we used in making prediction. It was true that objects in "weightlessness" did lose some of their substance. Apparently not only do bones lose calcium, but all substances suffer a reduction in mass or density, lose a portion of their elemental substances. Thus, if this is a "condition" that exists in space, causing such loss, it would seem to be reasonable to predict that something placed in space for any considerable length of time would suffer damage, even be destroyed. If the process was continuous, it would mean that a piece of metal, or a bone, would deteriorate to the ultimate point of having vanished altogether, dissolved into its primal elements by this mysterious process.

Apparently, for a journey of eight or ten days in space, the damage is not sufficient to do great harm. Our astronauts did suffer some calcium loss, but nothing that could not be restored by a few weeks back on

Earth with the proper diet. But as the Russian cosmonaut said: going to Mars may be a different matter-we must know more about this calcium loss before we start out on a journey of no return. We have to know if the loss can be tolerated for a journey of a year or more. If the rate of loss is such that it cannot, we would then be safe in predicting that man will not land on Mars. However, here we would make the same mistake, predicting with insufficient evidence. Until the space station is built, and men live in it for several months so that medical and biological experts can observe the actual rate of loss, whether or not it can be circumvented, we would have to be rather indefinite about predicting anything about possibility of landing on Mars.

Just what is it that causes the loss of calcium? Your editor wants to hazard a few guesses, based both on theory and evidence, plus some rather mystic philosophy. First, speaking scientifically, the condition of "weightlessness" is an absense of gravity. Gravity, says Einstein, is one of the results of an electro-magnetic field. He says that gravity and magnetism are not things of themselves, but simply conditions that arise because of the existence of an electro-magnetic field. Because the Earth's mass is contained in such a field, the action of this field upon the mass causes the phenomenon we call gravity. The lines of force of this field

flow inward toward the center of the mass, and this inflow produces the friction upon the atomic structure that keeps the mass integrated. In short, the field is the cause of the Earth, not the Earth the cause of the field.

What does this mean? It should be obvious—if a mass is removed from its electro-magnetic field, its gravity would disappear, and its cohesiveness would suffer—it would begin to lose some of its substance until it eventually returned to the primal matter in finely divided sub-atomic form that fills all space and is what we call "ether".

So, it was natural (and it still is) to postulate that a man who traveled away from the Earth surface, out into space where the electro-magnetic field did not exist, or existed in a weakened form, would lose his elemental structure (perhaps more noticeably his calcium structure, although we believe that further research would reveal that other structures were suffering like losses, just as the metal in the objects recovered from space seem to have lost weight) until it proved fatal. Obviously, this loss is not sufficient to render landing on the impossible, but it is serious enough so

that our scientists realize they must know more about it before sending a man to Mars.

The vortex theory of the formation of stars, planets, universes is being more universally considered by science, and in many quarters, it is being tentatively accepted. The theory that planets can be formed by two stars passing each other, and some of their masses being torn loose to circle each and cool down into satellites, is not damaged by this theory, because the accidental near collision of two stars does not account for their existence in the first place, and the vortex theory does. Also, we can see, in our telescopes, the nebulae and spiral vortex formation, in all its stages from beginning to end, displayed before us. From the tenuous gaseous nebula to the invisible "radio" star which astronomers say is a whole universe collapsed upon itself in the final stages of being coalesced by the electro-magnetic field.

So, even though our extrapolation in saying that man would not land on the moon was literally incorrect, it is only a matter of degree—the astronauts did loose some of their substance, and it is a recognized (continued on page 96)

Ten years of detective work by scientists at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's Ames Research Center, Mountain View, California, has produced major new evidence that

up to 100 million tons of the moon is almost certainly already on Earth.

The last shower of this lunar material, called "tektites", arrived some 700,000 years ago, sprayed from the moon's surface by the impact of a meteorite the size of a small mountain, which formed the 56-mile-wide, nine-mile-deep lunar crater Tycho.

Millions of tons of this lunar splash traveled 240,000 miles through space for about three days and showered down on Earth, mainly over Australia, the Philippines and southeast Asia.

Tektites are chunks of glass that were first fused by the heat of meteorite impact and then reshaped by aerodynamic ablation during entry into Earth's atmosphere from space.

In the process of fusing into glass, the valuable record of what minerals composed this lunar rock was largely obliterated. Although the tektites are not a substitute for the complete minerological record contained in the rock samples brought back by the astronauts, they are providing scientists with much new knowledge about the chemistry of the lunar crust. During the past decade, Dr. Chapman at Ames, has assembled several tons of tektites.

The cosmic event which created the tektites, a collision with the moon by a three-mile-diameter projectile of iron-nickle composition, undoubtedly produced major luminous phenomena bright enough to be visible from

Earth.

Reflection of sunlight from billions of glass objects diffused through space would have presented a light spectacle in the sky for many nights. To this was added a half-day-long rumble of continuous sonic booms as the tektites arrived and entered the atmosphere. Thick-browed Java man, whose fossil bones have been found with tektites, undoubtedly witnessed this extraordinary celestial event.

Scientists have differed concerning the origin of tektites since their discovery over a century ago. However, recent findings appear to clinch the moon as the source.

Dr. Dean R. Chapman, Chief of the Thermo-and Gas-Dynamics Division at Ames Research Center, a world authority on tektites, has been working on them since 1959. Recently he has been able to relate the chemical composition of one family of Australasian tektites to the chemical composition of the rock on Tycho's rim, as determined by Surveyor VII when it landed there in 1968.

Dr. Chapman also has identified the exact lunar source of the Australasian tektite shower. It is a ray of ejected rock, the "Rosse ray", which can easily be seen on the lunar surface, projecting out from the huge crater Tycho for a thousand kilometers in the direction of 19 degrees north of lunar east, and passing over the smaller crater Rosse.

By screening a million tektites, and chemically analyzing a select 600 of them from 200 different discovery sites, he has charted their precise landing pattern as an inclined "S" spread over Earth's surface. Thousands of computer trajectory runs have proved that only a shower of objects originating at Tycho and traveling in the same direction as the Rosse ray could have produced this particular pattern on Earth.

These conclusions throw light on the moon's history and allow dating of certain lunar surface features. Since the Australasian tektites are an estimated 700,000 years old, so is Tycho. Material on the moon that is overlain by rock ejected from Tycho is older.


At least three cosmic impacts have showered Earth with lunar debris: one, 35 million years ago landing in the United States; another 15 million years ago landing in Czechoslovakia; and the 700,000 year-old Australasian tektites.

Dr. Chapman, who saw his first tektites in 1959 in the British museum, recognized that they must have entered Earth's atmosphere from space. He had made nearly identical objects in an Ames wind tunnel during numerous simulations of atmosphere entry.

The tektites cannot have come from a wandering cloud of meteoroids because they lack the isotope aluminum 26 which is produced by cosmic ray bombardment during long times in space. Moreover, a meteorite impact is known to have melted the rock that formed the tektites, since numerous meteorite fragments have been discovered encased in the tektites by Dr. E. Chao of the U.S. Geological Survey. These two bits of evidence established the origin as a large meteorite impact crater, either on Earth or the moon. No crater of sufficient size, and of the proper age and location, is known on Earth. Also, there is no radial wheel-spoke-like pattern of tektite landings, leading back to a specific impact point on Earth.

Ring waves on the tektite, due to atmosphere entry, show that they had the required arrival speed of 25,000 mph for objects coming from the moon.

The inclined-S landing pattern of the Australasian tektites runs from Madagascar to south Tasmania, then northwest Australia, curving north Indonesia, then northeast southeast Asia and the Philippines. As a source of tektites each crater on the moon would produce a different landing pattern on Earth due to the curving trajectories from the moon to Earth, combined with the rotation of Earth about an inclined axis. It was Chapman's research on these curving trajectories that established the Rosse ray from Tycho as the source of the Australasian tektites.



Indian dancing is jumping around and yelling. Between this point of view and that of E. Zimbalist there is a vast difference. The latter, a trained musician, makes the statement that Indian music is the most complicated in the world with its half and quarter tones and complicated changing rhythms.

For those who would like to see authentic dancing, there are two locations. In Gallup, New Mexico every August between the dates of 13 and 16 whichever one takes in a weekend, is the best. The Chamber of

Commerce of Gallup pays the railroad expenses of dancers and furnishes their food while in Gallup. They sleep on the Indian campground. There are usually thirty-six tribes attending the festival from as •far away as the Dakotas. (The Sioux are particularly colorful with their almost priceless ancient costumes of white bearded buckskin and the long eagle feather headdress of the Full-Chief.) The other location is Flagstaff, Arizona on the fourth of July. They have a similar arrangement.

The dances are very different as one who attends a festival will see. The

plains tribes do the wildest types which are true because the pow-wow dancers are usually imitating the victory dance after a war-party-return. Each man is describing his own exploits to the rhythm and chanting. The Pueblos do the best group dancing. The concerted and complicated rhythms done by some twenty-six men in perfect synchronization is unequalled. The women are often pregnant, as that is the fertility symbol, and most dances are either prayers for rain, abundant crops, a prayer to the spirit of hunted animals before a hunt, or thanksgiving dances. These Pueblo dances are very ancient, running from our Pueblos to the center of Mexico, and undoubtedly, as Mexican scientists now believe, stem from Tollan probably long before the advent of the Prophet. It is the personal opinion of the present writer that they are older than that, since they seem to run down the Atlantic into South America, in a mere garbled form. They usually have two clowns and are often masked dances. They have a leader who directs them. The line of Katchinas approaching in the Hopi Pueblo is indeed impressive. (By the way, to digress for a moment, the ancient legend is that the Katchinas are from outer space and they visited the Pueblos once very long ago in a great silver sky ship which landed on the nearby Francisco Peaks, bearing gifts and dancing for the people.) The

most graceful of all dances is the lovely Eagle Dance, while the hoo-dance showing great skill on the part of the solo dancer is usually a wedding dance.

The Navaho also have a group dance in the Yeibetchi. The weird high-pitched chanting in half and quarter tones is like something out of this world. The most amazing dance is the Navaho Fire-Dance. Many-Goats, their most famous fire-dancer, now gone to the Land of Shadows, lent the dance real grace and beauty as he

dusted his too-thin body with sparks of living fire. (Do not get too close to this dance, which is too often done, as it is the final dance at Gallup. It could blind you.)

The humorous dances delightful. The plains tribes do a charming Crow Dance, usually performed by children. One child comes out as the lead crow. He has a watermelon, and the others, dressed as a flock of crows, give him chase. The horse-tail dance is equally amusing. Men dressed with a long horse-tail attached to their bodies imitate horses in a herd with very funny results. The keenest Indian humor is shown by the clowns. Seldom is the performance repeated. One may make violent love to a very fat woman, or imitate Americans in shorts snapping cameras. Once a preacher came out with a dictionary for a bible and began to lecture an audience. The sleepier the audience became the louder he harangued them. The funniest dance the present writer ever saw was at Oraibi, the Hopi reservation Arizona, when the clowns, representing Santa Clause and one of his helpers, gave a thin man a very large corset and a child a can of oil, and other inappropriate gifts.

The one with the greatest antiquity of all the dances, and to the present



writer, the most intriguing, is the Crown-Dance of the Apaches. This is a millenia-old story of migrations which the tribe has combined with a puberty rite for young girls coming of age, or entering womanhood. combination was necessary because, the Apaches tell me, the United States government would only allow them to keep one dance. It is often called the Devil Dance by enemies, which is an insulting term. Archaeologists should first read the Egyptian Book of the Dead before seeing this one. They will be amazed.

I BELIEVE IN

REINCARNATION---- Sometimes

Incarnate is a very interesting word. Its primary meaning, according to the dictionary, is: invested with flesh or bodily nature and form; especially embodiment in human form; hence, personified. Secondarily, it means: of the color flesh or flesh pink; red, rosy.

Reincarnate simply means: to incarnate again; to subject to reincarnation.

Actually, that explains the whole thing; but most of us have never read the dictionary, and most of us don't understand the meaning of words. Anyone who sits down for an hour and reads the dictionary carefully will discover that even the simplest words have meanings totally foreign to his habitual concept of them. He discovers that his understanding is, in the main, grossly in error. In short, it is inevitable that anyone reading the dictionary with no intrusions of preconceptions will find that he

doesn't know what he is talking about most of the time!

Let's take the phrase "especially embodiment in human form" and consider it a moment. If we look at the dictionary further, we will find that the word incarnation applies to a "principle or character"—such as "hate incarnate" or "justice incarnate". So we see that it is not just a "person" that can be incarnated, but a characteristic. The interesting thing is that such a character or principle is incarnated in "flesh or bodily nature".

THE THEOLOGICAL ASPECT

The dictionary also says that in the theological sense, incarnation is: the union of divinity with humanity in Christ. Our dictionary, being written by Christians, prejudically equates divinity with Christ, but naturally, it must also be equated with Brahma, or Buddha, or Mohammed, or Hiawatha.

We must avoid sectarianism and simply state that incarnation is the union of divinity with humanity in the theological sense. Thus, if we consider that we human beings are incarnated, we are "the Word, become flesh". To most theologians, this takes on the egotistical flavor of assuming that we are, ourselves, divinity, God, the Creator. In this sense, it is ridiculous to talk of reincarnation as the road to perfection, because being divinity we are already perfect. What is actually meant by this theological concept of the word incarnate is simply that we are human and we are created by divinity. Certainly not that we are divinity which took on flesh. Christ, it is said, is such divinity which took on flesh for the express purpose of our "salvation". If we accept this, then it is obvious that we are not "divinity incarnated", for then we would not require salvation, no more than Christ required it.

However, in the theological area, we are on such quicksand logic that no matter what our stand, we will sink into it beyond our depth. So, we won't dwell upon it more than to say that the point we have just made renders the whole theological argument invalid in the inescapable ground of illogicality. Rather, let's discuss the matter of incarnation and reincarnation in the sense that we are persons who (initially) take on flesh and who then (repeatedly) take it on for some purpose generally defined as

our "perfection".

WHAT IS A "PERSON"?

First, that which is being incarnated is not something called you and me, our personalities; but whatever it is, it is embodied in flesh, specifically colored pink, red or rosy. Maybe that's the meaning of "rosicrucian" (not the Order); a "cross" between a character or principle and flesh, specifically the rosy sort of flesh. (You should see the implication here that there are other kinds of flesh-but that's surely a different drummer!)

Next, until this incarnation takes place, there is no such thing as the "person". To be incarnated is to be personified. To be incarnated in human form is to become the thing we are discussing here, ourselves, our persons, those of us who have adopted the concept of reincarnation as the road to perfection. It should follow from this that the incarnation itself (the first time it happened) cannot be a matter of personal choice, but was involuntary, an act of "creation" by the divinity, the creator. The creator initially took a character or a principle and embodied it in special flesh from, the rosy human form. That's us. We are human. Our "hue" is rosy red. We are also "man". We are created knowing nothing. We never lived before, except as a character or principle, which could have been incarnated in something other than human form, but wasn't. It conceivable that we might have been

incarnated with equal ease as a dog or

a giraffe or a pig.

It is on the basis of the definition of the word "incarnate" and the logic that accompanies its meaning that this writer accepts our presence here on Earth. However, even while rejecting the concept of reincarnation in the sense that it is generally defined by believers, there are possibilities which must be considered which in a measure qualify that too-rigid rejection.

WHO "INCARNATES"?

The dictionary says reincarnation is to incarnate again. The implication here, as it is grasped by believers in reincarnation, is that they themselves, this personification of a human being which they have become by the process of incarnation, make the decision and perform the act of incarnating once more in that rosy red fleshiness. If we regard ourselves as human, we admit that we are something which does not exist prior to incarnation, and therefore. becoming discarnate, cannot exist except as a character or principle, and therefore incapable of personal incarnation; but necessarily through an act of divinity or the Creator. However, this can be considered quibbling, and we can revert to the Creator as doing the job for us, and taking the very same "principle" and incarnating it once more as the identical "person". But there is a great difference between a person and a

principle. Can you call yourself a principle? No, you can only call yourself a human, which is a principle personified by being embodied in rosy flesh.

Even the reincarnation believer states that when he dies, becomes discarnate, he is defined as a "spirit". Not as a character or a principle, but a spirit which retains its individuality and continues to exist in its "personification". It is this spirit which he says is "reincarnated". He specifies a period in that limbo-land where spirits go when discarnate, there to rest, review the progress and lessons learned during incarnation, and then decide what the next embodiment in rosy flesh will be. We've already mentioned "egotistic" element in such a process, but if reincarnation were true, we might be forgiven for considering ourselves in so important a light. Some reincarnationists even postulate that the spirit selects its father and mother, its time of reincarnation, its life span, its prescribed lessons to be learned, its associates in that embodiment to come, and so on. We even find some reincarnationists describing precisely the process they will use-i.e., waiting beside the pregnant mother until the newly born foetus draws its first breath, then entering into its body and thus becoming reincarnated. There are, of course, a number of interesting methods employed in this deliberate process of reincarnation. The one mentioned does not take into account the fact that the foetus is already "invested with flesh or bodily nature and form" and is therefore a "character or principle" incarnate. Thus, upon drawing that first breath after birth, the "bodily form" finds itself with an initially incarnated "human person" plus a second human person who uses the same body to reincarnate.

However, we must admit that this process is possible, and in fact, your writer fully believes it is possible, largely due to a lifetime of observation and research in which just such conditions exist. We are all aware of "dual personalities". Psychic lore (and medical lore and records also) present many of them. Two or more personalities in one body. There is no argument, even in the Christian bible (and other religion precepts) that there is such a thing as obsession, possession (bodily by other spirits) and other impressions upon the psyche by "outside" influences, demonic, elemental, and otherwise. While this writer freely admits that there are these spirits who have lost their embodiment who manage to regain an embodiment through deliberate "reincarnation", it is strictly illegal and not at all the sort of thing meant by those who postulate reincarnation as the road to perfection-the living of many lives of a person in different bodies for the

purpose of its universal education and experience until it becomes "perfect" and (significantly?) rejoins the godhead or divinity and once more becomes "one", not human, but a character or principle of a special sort, that of divinity itself. Thus, you may be as you claim, those of you who remember past lives, reincarnated; but we call it possession, and personally, we want nothing to do with this sort of piracy.

IS THERE A "LEGAL" WAY?

There is, however, one instance in which your writer believes reincarnation, and that it can also be legal. We believe in spirit, since we equate spirit with personality. We believe that we go on existing after death, and that we exist in some sort of physical world which is as real as this one. It may be that here is one of the "sorts" of flesh that is other than rosy red? Maybe "spirit flesh" is another color? It is an interesting sidelight on our thinking, but not relevant here. What is relevant is that it is quite obvious that the spirit world does have contact and influence with the physical rosy red world. Even the reincarnationist will not deny this, because the very process he uses in reincarnating, in reembodiment, necessitates contact between the two realms, and indeed, definite planning to cause the event to come about. The intricacies are enormous, including the selection of parents, the control of the conception, the growth of the foetus (for instance, in order to gain the lesson needed, say to experience how it is to be born black, you have to control the color of the parents, control the courtship stage to marriage-or institute the simpler rape, if that may be the method employed. Or again, if the desired lesson is to know how it is to live with one foot, or club-footed, the development of the foetus must be so controlled genetically as to produce this deformity). Obviously all this requires an interaction between the two realms of almost incredible complexity, from mental and physical control of the activities of the parents to bring them together, to the geneticist necessary to perform the scientific acts necessary to produce the desired physical result, be it clubfoot or the bone and muscle structure to produce a football star.

It follows that if such capabilities exist in the "science" of that other realm, then there can be deliberate reincarnations for a variety of purposes. Perhaps, for the purpose of causing mankind to develop space travel, an experienced scientist may be placed back into flesh embodiment, armed with superior knowledge, or superior talents, such as great mathematical ability, in order that in the great scheme of things, this advancement for man may be brought about. It seems logical to assume that with all this incarnating of character and principle into rosy red human flesh, there is also a reason for it, and due process by which some sort of plan may be carried out. If that plan is, as the reincarnationists say, education, advancement, experience, perfection, it includes becoming proficient even in space travel—therefore this is reason for sending some person or persons back to the human realm to give a needed push with superior knowledge otherwise impossible to achieve in our limited environment, lifespan and opportunity structure.

POSSIBILITIES

This sort of reincarnation is not only acceptable, but bears up under the application of logic. Also, perhaps it is the basis for our personal opinion that the "person" does not enter the body with the drawing of that first breath of life, or with that first stirring in the womb called the "quickening", but rather in the more practical instant of "conception". We cannot otherwise have "incarnation" or "reincarnation" because of the basic tenet that to incarnate is to "invest with flesh" and from the moment of the uniting of sperm and ovum, rosy red flesh exists, and it is at that instant, incarnate. And if it is human incarnation, the "person" is also present. And in that case, deliberate reincarnation of a perfectly legal nature is possible and logical-and to this writer implies a tremendously exciting and remified scientific realm of existence where

tremendous miracles of human knowledge take place; an environment to which we can look forward with great anticipation. To reach such a realm only to abandon it to return to a purposeless and futile round in which the great mass have completely forgotten all they learned in a previous life or lives, is a travesty on reason. Your writer likes to think he is not that stupid. As a writer, he would laugh at the idea of abandoning all he had learned, including the ability to speak, English or any other language; forget all the books he had read, including the bible (and have to read them all over again in the new incarnation); find himself without even the knowledge of how to hold a pencil and which end does the writing, much less how to operate typewriter; how to plot a story; the mechanics of publishing and printing; etc. He would rather enter into this new, advanced world where there is a better method of printing than cantankerous presses and smelly ink, and nostril-stinging chemicals.

And, it might be that if it was in conformity with the great plan to advance mankind, he might even be persuaded to be put through this process of being reincarnated to restore the knowledge of how to write creatively in a world where books had been burned and knowledge destroyed by some mad militarist. But it would have to be a truly great emergency, considering the fact that "inspiration"

is the widespread and usual way human beings get ideas that they can execute and thus learn the how of it, and to help advance their fellow men. Perhaps there are periods in man's envolvement in that rosy red flesh embodiment of his when his spiritual senses are so deadened that he cannot be reached by that small still voice from that other realm, but must actually be contacted on the flesh level. In that case, I feel sure there is reincarnation. But it is the rare exception rather than the general rule.

Another possibility which revealed in the definition reincarnation is expressed in the words: "to subject to reincarnation". Here we have an involuntary reembodiment in flesh in the sense that we may be "forced" to do it. This implies a condition this writer has long suspected actually exists in the spirit realm, the existence of less well-intentioned persons whose interaction activities with the physical realm include control of an organization which conducts such things as wars that interact in both realms. Such things as a Hitler who, defeated in his fleshly embodiment, discovers he still exists, and his wehrmacht with him, in the spirit world, and that he can operate in both areas. Would it not be possible for the same science that sends a person back to earthly flesh embodiment for good purposes, to send one or more back The strange almost for bad?

worldwide pattern toward evil we see existing today may well be the work of such reincarnated persons. Can we explain the plots of such organizations as those mysterious groups whose machinations cover hundreds of years, in spite of the fact that no individual will live long enough to enjoy the fruits of his plotting, in this manner? Is it because these strangely unified

world-wide plotters are not the real plotters at all, but merely the reincarnated emissaries of the spirit world plotters who know that to cause the tree to grow a certain way, it is the twig that must be bent?

Whatever the reality of reincarnation, be it for good or bad, it is the exception, we repeat, not the rule. All the evidence points that way.

A MAN 12 FEET TALL! ELEPHANT TUSKS 12 FEET LONG!

ANOTHER MAN WEIGHED 1069 POUNDS! READ ON — — —

A lthough it was only in the latter part of the 18th century that science began to keep documented accounts of human anomalies; it may be mentioned that the historian Keysler writes of having seen the famous Hans Brau on Tyrol in 1550, and states that he was nearly 12 feet tall. John Middleton, born in 1752 at Hall, Lancashire, and whose portrait is in Brasenose College, measured 9 feet 8 inches.

In more recent times, the record for height was held by Robert Wadlow (1918-40) of Alton, Illinois, who stood 8 feet 11 inches. Said Muhammad Ghazi (1909-41) of the

United Arab Republic, was 8 feet 10 inches. Don Koehler of Chicago, Illinois, stands 8 feet 2 inches. The tallest woman of all time may have been a Greek girl Wassiliki Calliandji (1882-1904) who measured 7 feet 6½ inches.

Senora Ruiba of Tampico, Mexico, in 1921, and Mrs. Tam Sing of Kwoom Yum Sha, China, in 1934, gave birth to Octuplets. Five septuplet deliveries also were recorded in the present century: Nigeria (1907), East Africa (1920), Portugal (1931), British Guiana (1933), and India (1939). Mrs. Timothy Bradlee of Trumbull County, Ohio, in 1872, gave birth to eight children at one time.

The heaviest human of all time was 6-foot-tall Robert Earl Hughes of Fish Hook, Illinois. Early in 1958 his weight was 1,069 pounds. The

thinnest human on record was the Frenchman Claude Seurat (1797). His biceps measured 4 inches around, and the distance between his back and chest was only 3 inches. The lightest person known to science was Lucia Zarate (1863-89) of Mexico. Standing only 26 inches high, her weight at the age of 17 was registered at 4 pounds 7 ounces.

The Rerum Scoticarum Historia (Aberdeen, 1762) treats of the celebrated "Scottish brothers" who were a sensation at the Court of James III of Scotland. This anomaly consisted of two men, ordinary in appearance in their upper extremities, but whose trunks were fused into a single lower extremity. In other words, they had two heads, two chests, and four arms, but only one pair of legs!

The King took diligent care of their education, and they became proficient in music, language, and other cultural and intellectual accomplishments. They carried on animated debates and conversations, sometimes coming to blows over disputed points. They presented an unbelievable appearance when running on their mutual pair of legs, and were reasonably well skilled in athletics. They died in June 1488.

The only other case on record paralleling the "Scottish brothers" was that of the Tocci brothers born in 1877 at Turin, Italy. Each had a well-formed head, perfect arms, and a perfect thorax to the sixth rib; but below the ribs the two bodies merged into one—a common abdomen and one pair of legs. All their sensations and emotions were distinctly individual and independent, indicating that two egos were present.

Undoubtedly the weirdest case of a Becephalic (two-headed) anomaly in the documented records of medical science was that of Edward Morduke, heir to one of the noblest peerages in England. He never claimed the title, however, and took his own life at the age of twenty-three. He lived in complete seclusion, even discouraging the visits of his own relatives.

He was a person of excellent attainments, a profound and meticulous scholar, and a musician of rare ability. His figure was remarkable for its grace, and his face was strikingly handsome, but upon the back of his head was another face-that of a beautiful woman!

The female face, according to the medical records, was a mask-like countenance occupying a portion of the posterior area of the skull, yet exhibiting an independent and wholly malignant intelligence. It would sneer and mock at the poor young man, and its cruel, unearthly eyes would follow the movements of any visitor present, while its lips would move soundlessly.

No voice was audible, but Morduke told the doctors who attended him that the dreadful "twin-face" disturbed his sleep by whispering of "such things as are spoken of only in hell. No imagination can conceive the diabolical temptations that it sets before me." He begged his physicians, Doctors Manvers and Treadwell, to destroy the terrible face even if the act cost him his own life,

Finally, he obtained poison, and in desperation put an end to his accursed existence, leaving a letter requesting that the "demon face." be destroyed before his funeral "lest it continue its fiendish whisperings in my grave." (The Occult explanation for this phenomenon would probably be fantastic indeed!)

Turning to the Animal Kingdom, we learn that the largest warm-blooded creature ever known to have inhabited our world was the blue whale, specimens of which have been recorded up to the length of 108 feet and a weight of 152 tons. The largest

living land animal is the bull African elephant. One was shot in Angola, Africa measuring 13 feet 2 inches at the shoulder. It is preserved at the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D.C.

The tallest animal is the giraffe, now found only to the south of the Sahara Desert. Some males attain a height of over 19 feet. The largest living member of the Carnivora is the Alaskan brown bear. A specimen standing 10 feet 2 inches tall, and weighing 1,800 lbs., was shot near Colo Bay, Alaska in May 1949.

Among bats (the only flying mammals) the fruit bat of Indonesia has a wing span of 5 feet. The Guano bat can fly 32 m.p.h. The largest antelope is the Derby Eland of Southern Sudan, Africa, which surpasses 2,000 lbs. and has a shoulder height up to 72 inches. The smallest known antelope is the Royal Antelope, measuring only 10 inches at the shoulder, and weighing about 6 lbs.

The largest recorded elephant tusks belonged to a bull killed in Kenya. They weighed 460 lbs. and measured 24 feet when placed end to end. The largest walrus tusks on record are 37½ inches long, and 10¾ inches in circumference. The longest horns grown by any wild animal are those of Marco Polo's Argali of Central Asia, which have measured up to 72 inches. The record for a rhinocerous born is 62½ inches.

The largest primate is the mountain gorilla of the Congo. One specimen shot in 1930 weighed 715 lbs. and stood 7 feet 7 inches tall with a 73-inch chest. The largest seal is the Northern elephant seal which may measure up to 22 feet in length and weigh as much as 6,000 lbs. The largest Marsupials are the Australian kangaroos, one of which weighed 200 lbs. and measured 8 feet 8 inches from nose to tail.

The largest living bird is the ostrich of Africa. Males reach 300 lbs. in weight and stand 8 feet tall. The albatross of the Southern oceans measure up to 11 feet in wing span. The crocodile of Southeast Asia attains a length up to 33 feet and may weigh over 3 tons. Among snakes, the South American Anaconda has reached up to 37½ feet in length.

The largest of the lizards is the Komodo Monitor first discovered on the Indonesian island of Komodo in 1914. This fierce-looking dragon-like creature may attain a length of 11 feet and a weight of 365 lbs. A leatherback turtle captured in 1951 near Sydney, Australia weighed 2,800 lbs. The giant salamander of Japan grows to over 5 feet 7 inches in length and weighs up to 88 lbs. The rare Goliath frog of West Africa measures nearly 24 inches long with legs extended.

Among fishes, the whale-shark, discovered off Cape Town, South Africa, sometimes reaches 45 feet in length and weighs as much as 19 tons.

The largest fresh-water fish is the great Russian sturgeon, found in the Volga River. Some attain to a length of 26 feet and a weight of over 3,000 lbs. The world's largest spider lives in Guianas, South Africa, and is 3½ inches in body length with a leg span of 10 inches. The Scarlet Giant Japanese Spider Crab possesses a body a foot wide and legs capable of spanning up to 12½ feet.

The heaviest of prehistoric animals was the East African swamp-dwelling Brachiosaurus, which is believed to have measured 70 feet long and 40 feet high and to have weighed 56 tons. Judging from its remains found in Wyoming, the largest dinosaur on record measured 87½ feet in length and was 14 feet 6 inches tall. Tyrannosaurus Rex, which stood 18 feet tall, was 47 feet long and weighed about 9 tons. Its teeth were 6 inches


long.

The largest prehistoric crocodile measured around 50 feet in length, and a snake living some 50 million years ago attained a length of over 45 feet. The largest extinct insect was the Melanearp with a wing span of nearly 2 feet 6 inches. The winged reptile Pteranodon had an over-all wing span of 27 feet. The elephant bird of southern Madagascar, which is believed to have survived until 1660, stood 10 feet in height and weighed perhaps 1,000 lbs. One of its eggs, 11 inches long by 8½ inches across, with a capacity of 3 gallons, was found 180

miles from Perth, Western Australia, in 1930. The Great Moa of New Zealand, also extinct, was over 11 feet tall. A condor-type bird, whose remains were discovered in Nevada in 1952, had a wing span of approximately 17 feet.

In regard to the "condor-type bird", a very old settler in the western United States informed the writer that this extraordinary winged creature is not extinct, although its existence is denied by orthodox science. According to him, the Indians have many legends about it, and tell of its appearance even to the present day. Few survivors of this remarkable species are ever seen as they inhabit the high mountain ranges and, like the wolverine, keep out of the sight of man. The old settler claims to have seen one which was shot about half a century ago. Whether they still live is, of course, questionable. However, there is strong evidence that many strange creatures unknown to science still endure in remote parts of the

TRUE EXPERIENCES

JAN WELZL AND THE KUBUYURUK By John D. Buddhue

hether or not I believe in UFOs or not is unimportant, but I do have some information that may or may not have a bearing upon the subject. Here is the story for whatever it may be worth.

About 1930 I was in Dawson City, Yukon, Canada. There I met a fascinating old fellow named Jan Welzl. Although a Czeck he was typical of the fat, jovial and friendly type of German with a large mustache. His English was heavily accented.

He had been an adventurer in the Polar Regions and had many a fascinating tale to tell of his adventures. Among them was a private expedition toward the North Pole. He did not reach it but at about latitude 86 degreesN they found a small colony of little people dressed as Eskimos but of extraordinary facial appearance. He

gave me the accompanying drawing of one of the Kubuyuruk (pronounced juh-buh-YUR-uhk).

I questioned him about them several times but he really didn't seem to know much about them. This was largely because of the language difficulty. None of them spoke any dialect of Eskimo or any other language known to members of the expedition. Communication was limited to signs, but Kubuyuruk seemed to be the name that they gave to themselves. (I know very little of Eskimo, but it sounds to me like an Eskimo word.)

Another reason for his limited knowledge was that they soon departed. His description of this was by no means clear, but I gathered that they got into some sort of vehicle which rose rapidly into the air with a great show of fire and flame that melted a large part of the surrounding snow and ice. That was before the days of flying saucers, and if he told me the shape of the vehicle, I have

forgotten it.

Welzl is by no means an unknown quantity for there are at least three books about him. In the hope of making some money he wrote to a Czech newspaper "enclosing muddled and unintelligible document. In it he described in a disconnected manner, a Polar hunting expedition." A pair of Czech newspapermen, E. Valenta and B. Golombek, visited him many times and put his stories together in the first person. Their published and was translated into English by Sevier under the title 30 Years in the Golden North (Macmillan 1932). It mentions five members of the expedition (pp. 255-61, 332, and their ship which appears to have been the 3000 ton Laura. Neither the Kubuyuruk nor the expedition are mentioned, but I gather that the book ends before 1911. His muddled story to the Czeck press presumably did tell of the expedition, and it may be mentioned in In The Track of Polar Treasures or Welzl the Eskimo which I have not seen and it may not have been translated into English.

One interpretation of Welzl's strange tale is that the Kubuyuruk were extraterrestrials and departed in

a UFO. In 30 Years in the Golden North Welzl is stated to be a completely honest man and that was also my impression of him.

On the other hand, it is possible that he was visionary. He looked past 70 and was a "nut" about perpetual motion. He showed me some beautifully executed drawings of perpetual motion machines which looked as though they ought to work (even though that is impossible). He sent me a letter once in which he said that after I left, he built one of the machines and it really did work.

86 degrees N and 430 miles northwest of the magnetic pole are incompatable statements. The least distance between the 86th parallel and the north magnetic pole is about 880 miles. Perhaps the reason for this discrepancy is that, according to 30 Years in the Golden North Welzl was unable to read maps.

SOUTHWEST RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Disease research, artificial organ research and resulting prosthetic devices will enable man to live to an age of two to three hundred years.

That is a prediction of C.W. Hall, the internationally famed surgeon formerly a member of the DeBakey team in Houston who has recently joined the staff of South-west Research Institute to head the artificial organs program.

Dr. Hall has no doubt that the combinations of medical men, scientists and engineers will be able to produce the miracle spare parts and arrest the disease or combination of disease processes to enable the extension of life in terms of centuries

rather than scores.

However, as he points out, this will cause problems-problems which we

should begin to consider now.

What will be the normal work span? When will you be expected to retire? Will you get a gold watch and your social security at 175? The complications of this productivity at an advanced age will cause a problem of unemployment which will be aggravated even further by technological advancement. The time of confinement in institutions of higher learning to keep the youth out of the job market may have to be extended past what we presently short-lived people call middle age.

The form of government we will have would probably be a patriarchy although in this field, as in all others, there will be a clash between the very young (under 50) and the middle aged and the elders.

And what of their disposition and their outlook on what seems to us to be an almost life without end?

Jonathan Swift in Gulliver's Travels anticipated such a problem and introduced the Stuldbrugs, an unfortunate group which was marked with a red spot on their foreheads (mark of Cain?), a designation that they were immortal.

Gulliver's early feelings were those of great elation at the discovery-"I cried out in rapture: Happy nation where every child hath at least a chance of being immortal! Happy people who so enjoy so many living examples of ancient virtue, and have masters ready to instruct them in the wisdom of former ages! But happiest beyond all comparison are those Struldbrugs, who being born exempt from that universal calamity of human nature, have their minds free and disengaged, without the weight and depression of the spirits caused by the constant apprehension of death."

Swift looked on such an eternal opportunity as a chance for wealth and wisdom which would be compounded with the years and shared by him with the deserving.

However, such was not the case.

"They were not only opinionative,

peevish, covetous, morose, vain, talkative, but uncapable of friendship, and dead to all affection which never descended below their grandchildren. Envy and impotent desires are their prevailing passions. But those objects against which their envy seems principally directed, are the vices of the younger sort and the deaths of the old. By reflecting on the former, they find themselves cut off from all possibility of pleasure; and whenever they see a funeral, they lament and repine that others have gone to a harbor of rest to which themselves can never hope to arrive."

However, the Struldbrugs aged physically in a rapid fashion. By the time they were eighty they had lost their teeth and hair, their memory and their sense of taste and smell.

This is not necessarily true in the coming old age. The remarkable effects of estrogens have already been demonstrated in both the physical and mental areas with middle-aged women. There is promise of similar hormonal age retardants for the male and the research into turning back the atherosclerotic process shows promise of reducing the degenerative effects of aging considerably.

"Look as young as you did when you were 75" may be the slogan for cosmetics.

What will life be like when it spans two or three centuries?

We can be relieved that Dr. Hall says it will not happen in our lifetime.

Contrary to the theories of McLuhan and others who see teaching machines and drugs as a means of speeding up the learning process, the emphasis may be on drugs and unteaching machines which cause forgetting so that the student is not bored and can enjoy many times the discovery of an idea which he does not remember he discovered years before. We will have to invent new things for people to learn to keep them occupied-new languages, mathematical political, psychological and social theories and we can always slow down the teaching process by continuing our present day method of inventing new methods of teaching old subjects. Continuing education will have to continue

But what will this age increase do to insurance? Unless the life insurance companies begin to adjust their actuarial tables they are headed for trouble when this comes about. Everyone will want a sixty year paid-up life policy whose principal the companies will have to invest for as long as two or more centuries. No one will want term insurance. And when should his pension plan go into effect?

All social patterns will change. Supposing even a late starter, a man had his children at 25 and became a grandfather at 50. He would be rocking his great-great-great-great-grandchildren on his knee when he was still at the minimum average of 200 years.

How does a child treat his great to the 6th power grandfather? And how many grandchildren's names would have to be learned?

The current emphasis on youth might not change but the definition of youth certainly would. The generation gap would be chasmed.

And what metallic or mineral designation would you have for a

175th wedding anniversary?

The extremely serious threat of this longevity is in terms of food and space. We are currently worried about the population explosion but we do have some relief in that it is somewhat offset by the deaths of people from old age after a reasonable terrestrial span. Soon the old will be even more of a threat to the young than they are today. Society will have to grope with the problem of deciding whether it is moral to extend life to its fullest extent since this extension is a threat (in terms of food and space) to the younger generations. If there is a subsequent denial of artificial organs (as a sort of post natal birth control), what will the criteria of selection be? Perhaps the humane solution will be villages on the planets where mature adults (150 years and above) may be sent to compulsory retirement supported by payments made to the government by their 100 year old sons and daughters.

What about prisoners? Should longevity be encouraged among those who are serving life sentences?

computer expert Dr. Edward C. Janecki.



"I came here in 1955 with a heart disease that doctors told me couldn't be cured. After a couple of years here the condition completely disappeared. Now I'm as healthy and strong as any of the other young people here. It must be something in the air."

Kramer who was married two years ago to a girl of 19 now has two sons.

"I got married again when I learned that there was still drive in me. When I first came here, I was finished, ready for the grave. Sex was the last thing that I had on my mind. To see me in action now, you'd think I was 22

again and not 88."

Dr. Salvador explained that anyone could be cured of their ills and restored to health and a long life.

"Any heart patient, for example, from any part of the world who goes to live in Vilcabamba would obtain what we in cardiology call 'compensation' or improvement in his condition and in time a complete cure."


Dr. Paulo Cortez, another member of the team, did suggest a hint.

MYSTERY OF FIVE DESERTED YACHTS

Donald Crowhurst's yacht, the Trimaran, was found abondoned Thursday night about 700 miles southeast of the Azores and only 900 miles from his final destination, the southwest England port of Teighmouth. The boat—spotted by a British freighter—was drifting along with absolutely no signs to indicate why Crowhurst was not aboard.

Early speculation suggested that Crowhurst, who reported earlier by radio that he was becalmed, had popped over the side for a quick swim and could not get back aboard—possibly because a gust of

wind wafted the Trimaran out of his reach.

But then authorities in London reported that four other small sailing craft had been found abandoned since the beginning of the month in the same month in the same part of the ocean.

Weather experts in London said they had recorded no weather conditions which could account for the mystery. No gales had been reported.

Crowhurst, a 36-year-old father of four competing in an around-the-world race sponsored by the London Sunday Times, was an experienced yachtsman and stood a good chance to win the newspaper's \$12,000 prize for the fastest nonstop trip around the globe.

The captain of the freighter which found his boat said everything was in perfect order and there was no sign that Crowhurst had fallen ill or become injured.

The Marie Celeste

It was a "Marie Celeste situation", he said. The Marie Celeste was a brigantine famed in sailing lore as the subject of one of the great unsolved mysteries of the sea. The ship was found drifting off the Azores near where Crowhurst disappeared—with no signs of disorder and no trace of the 10 persons aboard.

Sailing experts said the disappearance of Crowhurst alone could be easily explained—perhaps he fell overboard or went swimming—but the mystery of the other boats defied explanation. Pure coincidence was the only theory fitting the facts, one sailor said


Mr. Brown added, "I have been back several times and stared at that particular spot of water. I haven't seen a thing. I think that dog was putting us on."

STRICT SCIENTIFIC EXPERIMENTS PROVE THAT PLANTS THRIVE ON LOVE

CZECHS CHECK UFOs

The newspaper Mlada Fronta reported that Czechoslovakia has established an institute to collect reports and data on unidentified flying objects. The report said the institute plans to issue periodic reports on its findings.

PSYCHIC UPSETS

According to H. Ziolko, director of the student advisory center at the Psychiatric Hospital of the Free University, West Berlin, about 20 per cent of the students in the Federal Republic suffer from psychic disorders.

"The students' complaint," said the German paper, Suddeutsche Zeitung, "used to be called 'monk's disease' and involves difficulties in concentrating and remembering things and a feeling of depression and weariness. Often sexual disturbances occur, as well as headaches and eye complaints.

"Ziolko described one case he had come across: because he got cramp in his hands, a music student changed from the piano to the horn, whereupon he suffered from a lip complaint. When he switched to theory of music, he experienced difficulties in learning.

"In Ziolko's opinion, girls are more likely to be affected by these symptoms than male students, and art students are more prone to them than, for example, agriculturists. (Only 37 per cent of arts students finish their courses whereas virtually 100 per cent of the agriculture students do so.)

"Problems arise in particular, if a student completes more than 15 semesters at a university. The susceptibility of students to psychological disorders has not been fully explained. Ziolko does not think that the pressures of studying provide an adequate explanation for the illnesses."

We suppose there would be considerable disagreement as to what percentage of students in the United States could be said to be suffering from psychic disorders, partly because of different definitions of "disorder." But if the percentage is high could it explain, in part, why there is so much student unrest?

In a speech, Dr. J. Robert Oppenheimer, the internationally known scientist said: "Each of us must cling to what is close to him, to what he knows, to what he can do, to his friends and his traditions and his love, lest he be dissolved in a universal confusion and know nothing and love nothing."



R eports of little men come from all over the world. Many credible witnesses describe these saucer occupants with remarkable similarity. Some of the little men encounters however, are questionable. Stories of little men found dead in crashed saucers have weak foundations. Frank Scully was apparently taken in by one of these stories.

After studying some 200 reliable

cases of UFO occupants Dr. Jacques Vallee found, in connection with the 1954 occupant sightings, that the geographic separation of the landing sites is inversely correlated with population density.

The following are a good sampling

of the little men sightings.

June 15, 1929—This incident occurred on or about this date near Fermeneuve, Quebec. A big disc had

landed on the side of a hill. Four or five small men were outside the craft. The craft flew away at a low altitude.

August, 1947—At 9 p.m. near Carnia, Italy, a round UFO landed. Two small humanoids stood beside the craft. They knocked the observer on his back with a vapour.

July 2, 1950—A married couple saw a large shiny object on the waters of Sawbill Bay, Steep Rock Lake, Ontario. On the surface of the saucer were 10 men—3.5 to 4 feet tall. They wore metal suits and skull caps. The men walked jerkily as if they were robots. Hoses were in the water leading from the saucer.

September, 1951—A group of aborigines in central Australia watched a shiny saucer land beside a similar craft. A small humanoid came from underneath the one saucer and entered the other. The being was wearing a shiny suit. After this transfer had been made both objects flew away.

July 1, 1952-Oskar Linke, ex-mayor of a German city, and his step-daughter observed a 50-foot saucer land in the Soviet zone. Two figures in shimmering clothes were close to the craft. When the beings found that they were being observed, they hurriedly entered their craft, which immediately left the area.

August 23, 1954—Near Thonon, France, an aluminum UFO was seen to land. Nearby two small creatures were observed, making animal noises.

September 10, 1954—The dogs of a metal worker at Quobles, France, barked. When he investigated he found an enormous saucer-like object on the railroad tracks. He also found two small men and when he tried to keep them from leaving a beam was shot at him from the object. He was paralyzed while the beings and the craft left. Marks remained on the tracks.

September 17, 1954—At 10:30 p.m. near Cenon, France, a man got off his bicycle as the road was blocked by a UFO. A little humanoid approached him. The creature spoke in a foreign tongue. After a while the being returned to the craft which then flew off.

September 30, 1954—Laborers close to Marcily-sur-Vienne, France saw a round UFO on the ground with a little humanoid nearby.

October 27, 1954—A farmer from Les-Janquerets-de-Livet, France saw a cigar-shaped craft land. Two creatures three feet tall were seen.

October 28, 1954—A large object was seen on a seldom-used sports field on the outskirts of Milan, France. The field was surrounded by a board fence. Small humanoids were seen near the object. They were wearing transparent helmets and carried a breathing apparatus on their backs. When the creatures found they were being observed they left the scene in their saucer.

November, 1954-Near Florence,

Italy a peasant woman told police that two three-foot tall men snatched a bunch of flowers from her. They left

in a cigar-shaped craft.

November 14, 1954—Near Caracas, Venezuela Jose Ponce and Gustavo Gonzales found their way blocked by a saucer-shaped object which was hovering above the ground. The two men got out of their truck. A hairy dwarf approached them. Gonzales tried to grab the little fellow, but to his amazement was sent flying by the creature. A second dwarf came from the craft and shot Gonzales with a ray. This blinded him and when he could see once more the object was flying out of sight. The dwarfs had webbed fingers and long claws.

December 10, 1954—Two hunters were attacked by four small creatures near the Trans-Andean Highway between Chico and Cerro do las Tres Torres, Venezuela. Their bodies were tough—a shotgun was broken over one of them. They managed to get away from the creatures. When police investigated the incident they found ample evidence at the scene to support the story.

December 16, 1954—Three men were on their way home from San Carlos, Venezuela. They entered the Ministry of Agriculture's Exposition Park. One of the party, Jesus Paz, got out of the car. His friends heard him scream. They found Paz unconscious and saw a small being hurry toward a bright object which hung in the air.

Pas had several long, deep scratches on his right side, for these he needed treatment.

December 19, 1954—Jose Parra of Valencia, Venezuela met six small humanoids near a factory. They were loading boulders into their waiting craft.

May 7, 1955—An engineer saw a round UFO land near the highway in Bahia Blanca, Argentina. The engineer entered the craft and found three small dead men inside. They were less than four feet tall. He left and when he returned the craft and the creatures were gone.

August 21, 1955—A farm near Hopkinsville, Kentucky was invaded by "little green men". The men were about three feet tall, had large eyes, claw-like hands and their bodies appeared to glow. A two-hour battle ensued. The 11 people in the house tried to repel the men. The creatures weren't hurt by shotgun blasts. After two hours the people fled to town.

June 26, 1957:—At Boainai, New Guinea, a minister and several other persons saw a disc-shaped object flying at a low altitude. Working on top of the saucer were several man-like creatures. There were never more than four visible at one time. The minister and his party waved at the creatures, who returned the greeting.

December 16, 1957-Mrs. Mary Starr, a teacher in Old Saybrook, Connecticut was awakened by bright lights. She looked out her window and saw a brightly-lighted cigar-shaped object. It had square portholes. She could see three men in the craft. They were 3 or 4 feet tall. The object rose vertically and vanished.

April 24, 1964—Police Sergeant Lonnie Zamora saw an egg-shaped object in a gully in Socorro, New Mexico. Two small humanoid beings, dressed in coverall clothes stood beside the craft. When they noticed Zamora they entered their craft and flew off.

March 31, 1967-At 10:30 p.m. Carroll Watts saw a saucer land near Locos, Texas. A voice from inside the saucer asked Watts to submit to a physical examination in return for a flight in the craft if he passed the physical. Watts declined the offer. Two weeks later Watts was taken for a ride in a saucer manned by 4-foot tall beings. This saucer took him to a larger ship. Here he remained for two hours.

August 23, 1967—Two Swedish teenagers saw a reddish light with no shape. The light changed color and landed. They were nearing some bushes when a creature, about four feet tall, emerged from them. The creature moved in jerks. In its hands it held an apparatus which the teenagers took to be a weapon. The witnesses fled the scene. Evidence was found to support the story.

August, 1967-Near Joyceville, Ontario a motorist saw a huge craft with two "people" in white uniforms and helmets about 4 feet in height. The pair hurriedly entered the saucer when they realized they were being observed.

August 22, 1967-Two children in Cussac, France saw 4 small creatures dressed in black, silk-like clothes. A large sphere of extreme brilliance was near the figures. When the creatures found they were being watched, they "flew up" vertically and entered the sphere head first. The fourth being did not leave immediately; he first picked something off the ground and then rose 50 feet into the air to where the saucer was. The creatures were 3.5 to 4 feet in height. Their arms were long and slender and the feet of the fourth were webbed. A slight sulphurous odor could be detected after the saucer left.

October, 1967—Donald Marshal saw a landed saucer behind his home in Melfort, Saskatchewan. The object was 50 feet long. A bright spotlight came on and three small creatures emerged from the craft. They were dressed in green uniforms and wore some type of headgear. Their actions were fast. The creatures disappeared somewhere and the object left at a slow speed.

November 2, 1967—Near Ririe, Idaho two men were run off the road by a saucer. Two little green men jumped from the craft. The beings jabbered at the men profusely in a foreign language.

July 4, 1968—At 11:35 a.m. a 15-year-old youth was offered a ride in a saucer by two small people near his home in Olavarria, Argentina. The two spacemen were dressed in shiny clothes and spoke excellent Spanish. The boy refused whereupon the creatures entered their craft. Tripod marks remained and the field was scorched over a large area.

July 31, 1968-Luc Fontaine saw an oval-shaped object hovering a few feet above the ground at Plaine des Capres, Reunion Island. The middle of the craft was transparent and through this he could see two figures. They were three feet tall broad-shouldered. One of the men spotted Fontaine. Suddenly there was a white blinding light. Fontaine had to look away, when it was again possible to see, the object was gone. Ten days later when Fontaine reported the incident radioactivity was found in the area where the object had been and Fontaine's clothes contained radioactivity.

Fall, 1968—Farmer Lonnie Duggan of Idaho caught a small humanoid giving his horse a blood test with a large syringe. The being was covered with fur-like hair and was wearing a transparent helmet. In a voice "like a computer" it told the farmer he came from "a planet of the sun you call Tau Ceti". His purpose for being on Earth was to collect "specimens of the Earth life process". The creature told Duggan to go in his house

immediately. From there Duggan saw a huge glowing object rise from behind his barn.

February 7, 1969-In Pirassununga, Brazil at 7 a.m. a parachute-shaped object was seen by many residents. Tiago Machado and two other persons went to where the saucer was Machado arrived first and saw a lid open from the upper part of the object. Two small men, about 3 feet eight inches tall emerged. Two other men were visible in the saucer. The two beings seemed to fly to the ground. They were dressed in silver clothing. Through their helmets their skin appeared yellowish. The creatures laughed when Machado lit a cigarette. They took his cigarettes with them. Although they tried to communicate by sign language this failed. The two people who had left with Machado could be heard approaching. The creatures drifted to the top of their craft. They entered the craft and left. The two other people arrived in time to see the little men leave.

IS YOUR MEMORY SO INADEQUATE?

Dear Mr. Palmer,

In 1968, I had the pleasure of writing to you, asking for your permission to quote extracts from the Origin of Oahspe which you had circulated, in an article I intended to write for "Kosmon Unity Magazine". You very kindly gave me that permission.

The important point in mymentioning this is that you then knew of the existence, or, rather the continued existence of Kosmon rress, the Publishers of the English Edition of OAHSPE. Yet, in your March 1969 issue of Search on page 56, in answer to an enquirer,—Mr. R. Sexton—you say: "The London Publishing House that issued a British edition of Oahspe is no longer in existence." Is your memory or your filing system so

inadequate that you have issued this statement publicly in error, or are you attempting to mislead? (In that sentence, I am not stating a fact; I am asking a question.) And, Mr. Palmer, I should like a firm reply, please. That copy of Search only came into my hands today. I have written to Mr. Sexton, of course, correcting that mis-statement. I have also told him some facts which he asks for in his published letter, and which you have also answered either (a) incorrectly, or (b) insufficiently, thus leading to what could be termed a misapprehension. For instance: there is a Ministry in which publishes the U.S.A. Hymnal-they have sent me a copy. The Eloist Ministry, of Duxbury. also perform Rites Ceremonies in a very highly organized manner. I have told him of our own and Churches in Kosmon Rites Church, England, of which,

apparently you have not hitherto been made aware. He asked whether there existed other Kosmon literature. I have sent him a copy of the enclosed list, which contains on the reverse side some details of Oahspe Fellowship.

Mr. Sexton has asked for more information in his letter, to which you do not reply in your answer (under the nom-de-plume of "Rap"). I have told him that I am willing to fill in the gaps, if he will write to me and ask for them. For, Mr. Palmer, we of Kosmon Church and Kosmon Press in England are highly organized, both exoterically and esoterically. The Esoteric side, of course, I cannot declaim, but I could fill your magazine with the exoteric information. Not that I would wish to do so, but that remark is made to tell you what information is available.

It seems a pity, therefore, Mr. Palmer, that however you reply, you make no reference to the Angelic World Centre of all Kosmon activities, which is Kosmon Church, England.

It would give me much pleasure to see in a subsequent issue of Search, a contradiction of some of the statements you have made, and an amplification of some others, displayed at least as prominently as you have made that unfortunate remark about our "non-existence".

• The answer to your question is remarkably simple: the date "Anno Kosmon 34" is an assumption, pure and simple, based (by the editors) on the statement that it was the Fox sisters' table-tapping incident that "opened the Kosmon Era, and the door to the spirit world, never to be closed again". There is a GREAT deal of difference between the Kosmon ERA and the Kosmon CYCLE. Oahspe stresses that in considering these era dates, they must be considered "in general" as, in the long scale of things, happening at a specific time although they may vary by quite a number of years, even hundreds.

As we have now proved (much more to be published by us in future issues of both *Search* and *Forum*), the Kosmon Era, which covers a number of cycles, roughly began in 1848; but the Kosmon Cycle begins in 1995, and that therefore, Kosmon 1 should be





linked with that date, not Kosmon 34 with 1882.

John Newbrough, Andrew Howland, and their associates were so anxious to start their "colony", as predicted in Oahspe, that they made dates come out as they wanted them to. It was an understandable error. and as events proved, the failure of the colony which Oahspe assured would be a success was simply because it was not in reality the colony referred to, which is still some centuries away (the exact date is now available, as you'll see when we publish the results of our dating calculations based on the true dates as expressed in Oahspe).

The Fox sisters' phenomena actually was not original in 1848, as every student of psychic phenomena knows—such spirit communications are thousands of years old, as old as man. But the Oahspe reference to the actual communication "face to face" with the dead, for everybody, hasn't happened yet.

This Kosmon 34 date has confused many, but its origination is quite clear now, and the reason for the failure of Newbrough's colony is obvious.—Rap.

DEATH IS A NEW BEGINNING

ost people, lacking real personal conviction of survival, are unprepared for death when it comes to themselves, and lack realism in their approach to it when it happens to others. The average person will agree that the "soul" survives because his religious education has taught him so; but he sees no connection between his "soul" and his own familiar "self". Therefore he

cannot fully comprehend the reality that *he* will survive or that he *is* the soul.

Individual spiritual survival of bodily death happens as part of a continuous process. To comprehend the process, one must, once and for all, get rid of the delusion that the "self" is merely a body, and realize that it is primarily spiritual substance, temporarily paired up with a body

and that these bodies are interpenetrated.

Your ego, personality, animation and memory are of spirit. You can live in the spirit without the body, but a body without a spirit is so much the antithesis of anything useful or alive as to require immediate burial.

Your physical body enables you to function on this physical plane like a boat enables you to travel on water, or a plane in air, and is made of heavy solids, liquids and gases. Your spirit body, which is of finer composition, is coexistent with and interpenetrates your dense one.

There are subdivisions* to your spirit body, one of which has the function of sustaining your vitality by receiving life currents and adapting them for use by your physical body. To the ordinary eye, the spirit body is in visible but under certain circumstances it may be seen, and appears to be the identical twin of the physical envelope in which it spends a lifetime.

The spirit body has been seen projected out of the physical envelope both in life and after death. In life it is done both consciously and unconsciously and is termed astral projection. Clairvoyants often see and recognize spirits.

An interesting experiment by M. Durville, a French investigator, consisted of getting entrance subjects to leave their physical bodies behind and approach large calcium sulphide screens. This caused the screens to glow brilliantly.

How does one leave the body in astral projection? As one description has it, "I was taken from my body as though drawn through a funnel in the center of the forehead and returned to it from the rear" (Landaker, Genevieve, Meet A Guardian Angel, p.14)

Although your bodies remain firmly interpenetrated while you are awake, a separation occurs when you are asleep, anaesthesized, deeply hypnotized or unconscious by any

^{*}These are vehicles through which you may adjust to various successive environments after death which are stages in your future growth. The astral body is the seat of the emotion and the lowest of the non-physical bodies. Higher and finer are the mental and casual bodies. Instinctive thinking arises from the astral body. The casual body is the seat of the ego or the high self.

other means. This is unconsciousness. This makes sleep possible. Thus, when you fall asleep or lapse into unconsciousness, your astral, mental and causal bodies are ejected while the vital body stays with the physical.

During a cat nap when you repeatedly half waken, it is because the spirit is slipping in and out. What "waking up" or "coming to" really means is simply that the astral, mental and causal bodies reenter the physical body. This also explains why you like to wake up in easy degrees. When you wake up slowly, these bodies enter and merge slowly and comfortably. But when you are vigorously aroused, this natural process is speeded and you awaken with a slightly uncomfortable start.

In sound sleep, you, in spirit, float a few feet or so above your body to which you remain connected by a fine cord which is connected to the glabella (between the eyes). That is, you float a few feet above your body if you are an average person. If you are spiritually developed you travel and often remember what transpired. The cord is mentioned in the Bible and is called the Silver Cord. It is bluish gray in color and extremely elastic.

There is a stage of spiritual development in which people begin to learn to function in another dimension during sleep. In dreams in which people happily fly over the tree-tops or over the heads of others

they are, in reality, learning to travel in the astral. For example, a correspondent writes:

"I seldom dream but when I do I am always floating in space—like a dancer who leaps into the air and comes down like a feather only to repeat it all again. Also have dreams occasionally of being in strange places and I seem to float around there."

Many people have had the strange sensation during an operation of being up above it all somewhere, looking down on their bodies, and debating with themselves as to whether to return to them or not.

When you receive merely a local anaesthesia, what happens is that the spiritual counterpart of the particular area is extruded. The feeling of pain (or anything else) is not a part of the physical body. This explains why pain is reported in amputated limbs, temporarily. The spiritual counterpart of an amputated leg is still there.

The reason our bodies are so intricately made is to facilitate our survival after our physical bodies wear out. Death is not the end, but an incident, like birth, and the beginning of a larger life. A realization of your own trust in God may remind you that you will be allowed to pass through and graduate from one school of experience after another. The reason you "die", provided it is a natural death, is that your physical body is no longer a fit vehicle in

which you can learn and progress.

Your physical cells begin degenerate long before you die and you would have nothing to gain by remaining here longer in such a body. Death has further value-if you knew that you had infinite years to live as you now live on Earth, time would lose so much of its value for you that much of it would be frittered away while you marked time. Progress is a rule of nature-you must progress!

There are other spheres of life besides this physical one you know now. And just as the caterpillar has within it the makings of a new winged vehicle in order that he may fly when ready, you have within you all that is required for life in other spheres.

As previously indicated the spirit has been seen leaving the dying body by those spiritually developed enough to see it. One of the best descriptions available appeared in a 1915 issue of Reason magazine in which Andrew Jackson Davis, a famous seer, described, "How The Spirit Leaves The Body."

"I will tell you what I have seen. I will not give descriptions of phenomena from my supposition or imagination. I suppose that I need not repeat that I have had the peri-scopic and clairvoyant ability to see through man's iron coating for the past fifteen years; neither need I again remark, that, within the last twelve years the result of the exercise of this faculty has come to be to me an 'education'. I

have stood by the side of many deathbeds; but a description of manifestations in one case will suffice for the whole.

I found that the physical body grew negative and cold in proportion as the elements of the spiritual body grew warm and positive. Suppose a human being lying in the death-bed before you. Persons present not seeing anything of the beautiful processes of the interior, are grief stricken and weeping. This departing one is a beloved member of the family. But there, in the corner of the room of sorrow, stands one who sees through the outward phenomena presented by the dying one, and what do you suppose is visible? To the outward senses the feet are there; the head on the pillow; and the hands clasped out-stretched, or crossed over the breast. If the person is dying under or upon cotton, there are signs of agony, the head and body changing from side to side. Never allow any soul to pass out of the physical body through the agony of cotton or feathers either beneath or in folds about the sufferer.

Suppose the person is now dying. It is to be a rapid death. The feet first grow cold. The clairvoyant sees right over the head what may be called a magnetic halo-an ethereal emanation, in appearance golden, and throbbing as though conscious. The body is now cold up to the knees and elbows, and the emanation has ascended higher in the air. The legs are cold to the hips, and the arms to the shoulders, and the emanation, although it has not arisen higher in the room, is more expanded. The death-coldness steals over the breast, and around on either side and the emanation has attained a higher position nearer the ceiling. The person has ceased to breathe, and pulse is still, and the emanation is elongated and fashioned in the outline of the human form! Beneath, it is connected with the brain. The head of a person is internally throbbing-a slow, deep throb-not painful, but like the beat of the sea. Hence the thinking faculties are rational while nearby every part of the person is dead! Owing to the brain's momentum, I have seen a dying person, even at the last feeble pulse-beat, rouse impulsively and rise up in bed to converse with a friend, but the next instant he was gone-his brain being the last to yield up the life-principles.

The golden emanation, which extends up midway to the ceiling, is connected with the brain by a very fine life-thread. Now the body of the emanation ascends. Then appears something white and shining, like a human head; next, in a very few moments, a faint outline of the face divine; then the fair neck and beautiful shoulders; then, in rapid succession, come all parts of the new body down to the feet, a bright, shining image, a little smaller than this physical body, but a perfect prototype or reproduction, in all

except its disfigurements. The fine life-thread continues attached to the old brain. The next thing is the withdrawal of the electric principle. When this thread snaps, the spiritual body is free! and prepared to accompany its guardians to the Summer-Land. Yes, there is a spiritual body ... There are persons in the room of mourning; they gather around; they close the sightless eyes, and friendly hands commence those final preparations with which the living consecrate the dead. The clairvoyant sees the newly-arisen spiritual body move off toward a thread of magnetic light which has penetrated the room! There is a golden shaft of celestial light touching this spiritual body near its head. That delicate chain of love-light is sent from above as a guiding power. The spiritual being is asleep—like a just-born happy babe; the eyes are closed; there seems to be no consciousness of existence. It is an unconscious slumber. In many cases this sleep is long; in others not at all. The long-thread now draws the new-born body to the outside door. A thought-shaft descends upon one who is busy about the body. This person is all at once "impressed" to open the door of the dwelling and to leave it open for a few moments. Or, some other door of egress is opened; and the spiritual body is silently removed from the house. The thread of celestial attraction gathers about and

draws it obliquely through the forty-five miles of air. It is surrounded by a beautiful assemblage of guardian friends. They throw their loving arms about the sleeping one, and on they all speed to the world of Light!" (Reason, Vol XII, April, 1915 (7) pp. 15-16)

The spirit body has not only been seen but weighed. It has been claimed by two Dutch physicists, Drs. Matla and Zaalberg van Zelst of the Hague, after extensive experiments, that the spirit body can expand at 1.26 mm, and contract about 8 mm, that its specific weight is about 12.24 mgs lighter than hydrogen and 176.5 times lighter than air.

Countless spirits have been photographed. The November 1958 issue of Chimes, (p. 9) has a series of authentic pictures of a woman dying in which the silver cord was clearly visible and its movement shown. Photographs like this are, understandably rare, and these were reprinted by permission of the Editor of the French, *La Review Spirite*. In order to get these pictures, Jean Labadie increased time exposures from one second, twelve seconds, fifteen, to twenty seconds.

His conclusions regarding the cord (which was not seen with the naked eye) was that it was "finely and regularly striated with transversal black and white lines and that the extreme whiteness of the cord would seem to indicate strong actinic ray impression."

Authentic photographs of spirits taken in seance rooms are not so rare and new ones constantly appear in Psychic Observer, Two Worlds, Chimes, and other British and American newspapers and magazines.

Many more spirits, of course, return to tell about it than are photographed. A correspondent who has had mystic experiences since she was ten years old describes some personal evidences of survival she has had:

"When I was ten, I knew an old lady by the name of Mrs. Shivers. She had a plum orchard, and as you know all children like plums, so one day during the spring, I visited her. We talked about various things and then she spoke about life after death. She said she believed in the hereafter and if I wanted her to do so and she could, she would come back to me and let me know that she had passed on. If she could do so she would rattle my blinds and scratch and wake me up. Later that same year one day in Fall, she did just that, and that same morning my mother received message that Mrs. Shivers died at 7 A.M."

This brings up the question, how did Mrs. Shivers know that she would go during the time the child would normally be in bed? Do people go when they want to go? The writer has often wondered. There seems to be a barrage of evidence that would favor this premise.

But let's listen to the same correspondent's next psychic

experience:

"I was fifteen years old. We were living in a brick lower appartment and I kept hearing noises around the house. One day while looking out the kitchen window I saw a little girl about eight or ten years old playing in the back yard with her toys. I did not mention it to my folks, but one day as the landlady came downstairs, I stopped her and asked if a child had died in the lower apartment where we lived. She said there had been a little girl about ten years old who had died before we moved in. I told her that I had seen the child."

Spirits return for various reasons and in the following case discipline is involved:

"I had a strict father who seldom allowed me out at night and even then I was required to be at home by nine. After his death, I made up for lost time and stayed out whenever I liked, which was quite often. One night when I returned home unusually late, I no sooner entered the house when I felt a terrific slap on the face. I didn't see him but knew it was my father and that he was still keeping tabs on me."

Much more unusual are cases in which these having passed on return to assure grieved loved ones that they are alive and well and to show them that there is no need for continued grief. A typical example follows:

"My young sister died suddenly at the age of five years, after being sick with diphtheria only three days. Well, I cried so, I was almost sick, and couldn't seem to stop crying—until my sister who had just passed on came to the foot of my bed and said, 'You must stop your crying. See, I live! I'm really not dead.'

Do you know, I never cried after that day. It seemed real—and I did not know anything at all then about spirit return."

Sometimes the motive for spirit return is life saving. Such an incident involved the writer:

"I lay close to death in a maternity room of a hospital, after seven futile hours of childbirth contractions that brought only exhaustion, a caesarian section having been necessary but unreceived. Seven hours before, a spirit nurse had come to me and said, 'Your father is here on call if you need him.'

Now I called him and he appeared. He looked wonderful, but concerned. We exchanged thoughts back and forth telepathically as a result of which he fled to the adjoining room to summon the doctor who sat praying for guidance to tell him which to save, mother or child. Only then did the doctor and other hospital staff appear, and steps were taken to save my life. The hydrocephelic infant was lost."

In the telepathic conversation before the doctor was summoned, the

doctor's need for more strength was discussed. Strength then was transfused into the doctor in order that he, a small, exhausted man, could draw with forceps a huge infant lying in transverse position across the pelvis and do it in the few seconds he had remaining.

Afterward he said:

"I don't know how I did it! I'll never understand. That took more strength than I ever had in all my life, more than I'll ever have again. I had it, and I cannot for the life of me understand where it came from!"

Animals often return after death to comfort and assure their owners of their continued well being. Here is an example of such a case:

"Our dog, 'Black Beauty' was put to death and came back later and licked my foot one morning as I was getting out of bed. I reached down to pet her and my hand went right through her."

The fact that people and even animals remember us and are considerate of our feelings shows that the soul which survives death is the very individual himself and not the remote intangible something that so many people think it is.

Individuals remember not only those they love, but all details of the life just lived. Many reports of those who have very nearly drowned would indicate that ones life flashes before ones eyes in a swift panorama before death, with everything having been

seen, heard, and done, passing in review.

Here's why. Your "ego" is a part of you containing the sum total of you—all your thoughts, actions, everything. Therefore in order to be you after you survive death, you must take this ego with you. This is exactly what is done.

Here's how. All your memories are contained in a seed atom within your heart. This atom is visible to the seer; not necessarily to the surgeon. It is a spirit. All during your life the ego works through the blood by carrying impressions to the seed atom so that your entire lifes train of thought and experience is contained there. No image can be lost that has ever been flashed upon the screen of universal mind and no image is lost which is engraved on the seed atom.

At death, the seed atom, which has been fastened to the heart's left ventricle, rises to the brain by way of the pneumogastric nerve, rupturing the silver cord and causing death.

It is before the cord snaps and just after the seed atom containing the ego reaches the brain when the entire panorama of ones life passes in lightening-swift, incredible detail before him. Everything is relived. Then, since the seed atom belongs to the spirit body, he takes it with him.

This present life is merely a school of experience in preparation for the richer experiences of life in the spirit world.


can our brains be used as an energy source?

problem in making plans to go to Mars.

Perhaps our prediction only needs to be modified to say that man as he is constituted, dependent for his physical existence upon living in an electro-magnetic field, can live only on his own world, or upon any other he may be able to reach-but that he will be limited to those nearby, comparatively speaking. However, since the problem is recognized, there should be a solution to it. Perhaps man can devise a way of taking an artificial electro-magnetic field along with him in space. It is certain that when he travels to other worlds, he must duplicate his home environment, his native ecology, and it will be his space ship. Today's space ships do not have electro-magnetic fields. We predict they will have to be added if space travel is to become the extended reality science fiction writers have visualized. The question most immediate now is whether or not we can make the passage to Mars and return before this simple problem of calcium loss reaches an intolerable level. We made it to the moon with little damage, but we might get to Mars a very sick human being. A human in space is like a fish out of water-he needs a "fishbowl" to keep him alive, and he will have to fill it with his environment. He will have to keep that environment, and himself, from "evaporating". Which should remind you-check your fish aquarium and see if it needs more water-the fish can't do it while he is "out in space", in "waterlessness".-Rap.


