EDITORIAL

You might say that this issue of *Search* is a "youth protest" issue.

We've got a number of young people who are expressing some firm ideas on a number of subjects. Dawn Krutza, who is 17, has some ideas on abortions that you will find interesting. Kurt Glemser, who is also 17, comes back with pretty strong statements on policemen and Black Panthers. Erich Aggen, who is 23, talks about anarchism.

If you happen to be youthful, and have something to say about this world of ours, or the next world, or anything that occupies your thoughts to a serious degree, *Search* is listening! And our older readers are good listeners too. Nobody has ever had a communications gap in this magazine, and never will. Sure, it gets bloody sometimes, but nobody gets "shut up".

There are several words in the public's lexicon these days which are being used quite frequently. Ecology is one of them, and dissent is the other. The right to dissent has come to mean many things that the dictionary fails to include in its definitions. Somehow it has come to include the right to accompany your "dissent" with a rock or a fist or a club—and even with a rifle, a tommy

gun, a hand grenade or a ton of dynamite! If you indulge in that kind of dissent, you are, in this editor's lexicon, a criminal and you should be summarily punished. Just as one example, the dynamiting of the University of Wisconsin resulted in a death. It should be charged as murder in the first degree. In Wisconsin this carries a life sentence, but in our opinion it ought to be tougher, because as it was carried out the crime includes acts for which the Constitution decrees the death penalty. Because your editor does not countenance killing in any circumstance, he would prefer that for such acts a concentration camp be set up in the central wilds of Alaska, where escape would be impossible, and the criminal spend the rest of his life separated from the society he seeks to destroy.

At the same time, it is true that the right to dissent is in sad state in our country today. It is being frustrated in many ways, from both sides of the social strata. There is a tendency to lean over backward and introduce a police state in which any gathering is regarded as a potentially violent one, and is broken up. There is also the tendency of the "status quo" type of editor to refuse even to listen to any

dissent no matter how reasonable, and to take active steps to either avoid or circumvent it—and worse, vindictively to punish it. A simple example of this would be the instance when you were to stand on your neighbor's lawn and engage in some dissent. He does not deny you the right to dissent, but he will not be deviated from arresting and prosecuting you for trespass, or for "disturbing the peace", or for anything he can think of to convince you never to dissent to him again, because of the trouble he will cause you. You may win the argument, but you will PAY for it! That type of citizen is becoming all too evident in our citizenry today. He is his own policeman, but he is exempt from his policing—it is YOU he will correct (and he thinks it is for your own good, sometimes). One of the outcomes of this sort of citizenship is that even the citizen who is a policeman will act in such a way to dissuade you from "becoming involved". Thus, if you see a girl being raped, you will turn your back and hurry from the scene—for two reasons: the rapist may attack you and even try to kill you, and the law, finding you standing over a raped girl (having successfully scared off her assailant) is just as likely to arrest you as the rapist! Too many police are policemen only because of the sense of power it gives them, and his attitude is that everyone is a potential

criminal, and he will give preference to his suspicions rather than to your testimony. It has happened often enough to convince many citizens that the place to be in any such event is "somewhere else, and fast!".

When we come to the word ecology, we have a new phenomenon. It is a very complex thing, ecology, and even the experts are baffled by it. But to the citizen it is very simple—you are polluting, he is not. It is fashionable now to "go to the law" to prevent pollution wherever you see it. And on the way, you throw your beer cans out the car window. It is positively disgusting to see the trend toward destroying private property rights today in the name of "ecology in the public interest". It has come to mean that "conservation" is a process of regarding such things as water, for example, as "for the use of all". This is simply not true. Yes, we have a social right to expect the farmer to use proper tactics to prevent erosion, and keep fertilizers from entering streams and lakes. But this doesn't extend to denying him access to necessary water for his stock and fields by passing a public law to purchase it from him "in the public interest" and then setting it aside as "recreational" area and opening it to the public who will promptly litter it with beer cans, garbage, destroyed vegetation, fished-out conditions, and cheap commercialization.

We have the spectacle of game wardens watching zealously for illegal hunting eleven months out of the year, then in the interest of "local economy" throw the whole thing open to a million hunters who blast the land clean of wild life in an orgy of senseless bloodshed and pure brutality, meanwhile depositing tons of litter on private land. To these people, who legislate in State legislatures for "recreational use" because of the stimulus to the economy that will result, the word ecology is simply spelled wrong—it is really economy. They are not conservationists—quite the reverse, they are tax collectors, and enemies of the constitutional right to own property and manage it for your own (and the ecological) purpose that responsible ownership entails. They declare that "public waters should be for the use of all the people, not just a few" and at the same time declare that children shall be denied the right to be taught to swim in those waters "because this is a trout stream" and should be reserved for trout fishermen.

Perhaps we haven't made much of a point, and it may be very controversial, but we think that even

the State today isn't interested in ecology and the preservation of our planet for future humans and animal and vegetable life, but in the economy of the state. The word is "selfish", and it is shocking to see the selfish motives of even the public officials who wear the badge of the conservation warden. Until they forget the dollar, and learn true ecology, they will never conserve anything! Quite the reverse, they will turn the individual over to the mob, and he will be overrun even in his own back yard!—Rap.

jenny and barb and abortion laws

Jenny was 16 when she became pregnant. In desperation she tried to abort herself one night with a coat hanger. Jenny lived but she'll never be able to bear children.

Barb should have been a senior in high school. But one day she found out she was pregnant. Two weeks later Barb's body was found bathed in blood in an empty second floor apartment. She had had an illegal abortion.

Every day hundreds of girls and

women like Barb and Jenny face the same problem. An unwanted pregnancy has occurred. Which would be the easiest way out—an illegal abortion in the U.S.? a legal abortion in Mexico, where the medical safety is often questionable? or a self-inflicted abortion? If the woman is lucky she may have another way out. She may live in one of the five states in which abortion is legal when the mother's mental health is in danger. But is that really such great luck? There's always the possibility that the woman's

appeal will be turned down like the appeal of a California woman who was raped and became pregnant. Her appeal was denied on the grounds that there was no proof that her husband was not the father of the child. The child was born and has been resented since his birth.

In May of 1967, Colorado became the first state to legalize abortion. The terms of the newly formed law were that abortion could be legally performed when pregnancy occurred as the result of rape or incest, when the pregnancy threatened serious damage to the mental or physical health of the mother, or when the child was likely to be severely mentally or physically defective. Since Colorado's action, a number of states have taken similar action. That leaves a majority of states in which abortion is only legal when the birth of the child may endanger the physical health of the mother. You'd probably expect these states to have a higher number of illegal abortions than the states with the new liberal laws. But actually the illegal abortion figures in these states haven't lowered to any great extent. According to the New York Times Magazine, California still has over 270 illegal abortions performed each day. The reason is that many women would rather have an illegal abortion than undergo the experience of having to consult a physician and a psychiatrist to

determine her physical and mental health and then have to await the decision of a hospital medical board before she can have her abortion performed. Then there is still the chance that her appeal will be turned down. The abortion laws were liberalized to cut down on the business of back alley abortionists, yet many women are driven directly into the hands of these butchers.

Other women carrying unwanted children are resorting to a newly formed East Coast Service which requires no lengthy procedures. Although illegal, these operations are performed by competent obstetricians for 500 to 700 dollars less than the legal abortions. In view of these facts you may think present abortion laws are of no use, but they have done a lot of good during their short existence. If nothing else, they have at least brought the subject of abortion into a place in our society. It is no longer whispered about and present laws may help form better ideas and laws concerning abortion in the future.

At the present time we can't really say what would be the best type of law to solve the abortion problem in the U.S. It could possibly be a plan similar to Hawaii's in which the decision is left strictly between the mother and her doctor. But whatever the final action may be, something has to be done to save other girls from the fates of Jenny and Barb.

WILL AMERICA BECOME A POLICE STATE?

Liberties such as freedom of speech, the right of dissent and various legal rights no longer exist for many Americans. If you are a peaceful dissenter or a non-violent demonstrator or even just a law-abiding citizen you had better watch out. Read what has happened in the last few years and you will see that America is on its way to being a police state. You may be its next victim!

"A few decades ago the stereotype of the policeman on the beat was that of a friendly and kindly man who knew all the children, housewives and merchants along the way. He was society's staunch champion against evil and only criminals had reason to fear him. Today this warm and agreeable image seems to have tarnished. The policeman has become a fearsome stranger who poses a threat to everybody." This is the way one writer described the alienation of the

police from the average citizen.

Martin Dewey, in an article entitled "Police Turn to 'Blue Power' to Bolster their Self-esteem", stated the Canadian Police Chief's Association is "nothing if not a highly conservative lobby dedicated to strengthening police powers at the expense of citizen control and to fighting everything from civil rights legislation to long hair."

An illustration of what, with validity, may be called police brutality was portrayed by the shocking story carried in the August 15, 1969, issue of "LIFE". It was written by Jesse P. Ritter, Jr., English teacher at San Francisco State College. Mr. Ritter is a law-abiding citizen, father of five and a veteran of the Korean war. On May 22, 1969, a demonstration was planned for Berkeley, California, to protest the use of gas sprayed on a crowd on the campus of the University of

California. The crowd consisted of demonstrators, bystanders, workers and passers-by. Ritter and four other teachers were in downtown Berkeley for the purpose of making purchases. The streets were crawling with National Guard, Berkeley cop and Alameda County deputies.

Ritter was in a crowd of about fifteen people, which was told to "clear the area" by some deputies. However, before they could even do this, members of the crowd found themselves being randomly handcuffed by Berkeley police. They were told by a policeman that they were being arrested for blocking traffic. The official charge, however, was illegal assembly and failure to disperse.

The selection of those to be arrested was made by a sergeant. Those members of the crowd he didn't choose were allowed to continue on their way. Three of the teachers who had accompanied Ritter were also arrested. The people arrested were mostly young with long hair, mustaches and sideburns. The arrested were not allowed to talk, therefore they were unable to state their business or identify themselves. Among the arrested were students (going to and from classes), a long-haired mailman on his route delivering mail, a psychiatrist taking a walk, etc.

All the arrested, some three

hundred, were herded together and bussed to Santa Rita Rehabilitation Center and Prison Farm. Forms were filled out for legal arraignments and many of these were later destroyed by guards. Before the three hundred had even been booked, however, the prisoners were made to lie face down on asphalt and were often beaten by guards for no reason.

Ritter was forced to lie prone for four and a half hours, excepting one very short period after lying for four hours. One youth was made to put his head against a metal post while guards pounded on the post. His nose started to bleed, whereupon the guards forced him to lean against the post so that his neck and head supported his weight. The youth collapsed. The guards then dragged him away and forced him to kneel. A youth who identified himself as a diabetic was severely beaten. The next morning one guard came in the barracks yelling, "I had a good night's sleep and I feel like killing." He then tried to get one of the teachers to fight him.

Eighteen hours after being arrested Ritter and some others were released. Before they were allowed to leave, the guards forced them to yell, "We love the Blue Meanies."

A group that has come under much fire is the Black Panther Party. It is obvious that the government is out to destroy this party.

Wilfred Holiday, party captain, was

charged with robbery and attempted murder. He wasn't given bail reduction on Dec. 5, 1968, even though he met 10 out of 12 of the O.R. points. Ordinarily only five points are required for O.R. On January 31, 1969, bail was reduced to 20,000 dollars, which is still very high, especially for a man with a family.

In a two-week period in April, 1969, 250 Black Panther Party representatives and officials were arrested. The arrests occurred all over the country. This appears to be an attempt to destroy the party.

In New York 21 panthers were charged with conspiracy. They have been in jail since February, 1969, with bail standing at 1.5 million dollars. This destroyed much of the leadership of the BPP in New York. The defendants are kept in different jails throughout the city, thus making it impossible for their lawyers to consult them together. And in a conspiracy case yet!

On August 20, 1969, BPP Chairman Bobby Seale was arrested. Seale was held without bail in San Francisco on a non-existent warrant from Connecticut for a crime allegedly reported by an anonymous informer. The charges are murder, kidnapping and conspiracy.

Despite the fact that no warrant had been received for his arrest and that federal charges on which he had originally been arrested were dropped,

a local municipal court judge ruled that Seale be held without bail.

Seale's charges grew out of the death of Alex Rackley, a New York Panther found murdered near New Haven last May 21. Seale was present in New Haven to speak at Yale University and sources in that city say that local police officials claim to have a tape of a "kangeroo court" in which Panther members sentenced Rackley to death.

There is little chance that sufficient evidence exists to convict Seale with either murder or kidnapping, but the always vague conspiracy charges may prove difficult to defeat.

Bobby Seale was choked and tortured by guards in the San Francisco County Jail. The pretext for the guard's assault was that Seale had in his possession contraband material—the Black Panther newspaper and Seale's legal papers. Seale's lawyer had given the material to him the day before with an officer's permission.

On October 3, 1969, six drunken policemen attacked the Illinois Black Panther Party headquarters. Six Panthers were injured in the shootout. One of the policemen was reportedly shot in the face by his partner. The policemen started fires that burned medical supplies for Panthers' Free Clinic, and the Chicago fire department refused to answer the call.

In the early morning of December

4, 1969, fourteen Chicago policemen, assigned to the DA's office, staged their fourth nighttime raid of the year on the Illinois Black Panther Party.

The police claim they were fired on as they produced a warrant to search a Panther-occupied apartment for illegal weapons. They say they returned the fire and engaged in what they called a "raging gun battle" that ended in the death of two Panthers and the arrest of four others.

Mark Clark, Panther leader from Peoria, was shot and killed as the police entered the front door of the apartment. In the meantime, two policemen broke through a back window into the room where Fred Hampton was sleeping. Hampton was the chairman of the Illinois Party. They shot him four times. An autopsy conducted under the auspices of Chicago alderman Sam Raynor revealed that Hampton was shot at close range and died while sleeping.

The others were ordered out of bed and lined up against a wall. The "raging gun battle" followed as police shot each Panther in the arm, leg or in one case, in the stomach. The apartment wall shows 25 entry holes originating from the direction of the

door. There was no evidence of bullets shot from inside the room toward the door.

Two policemen were injured, one with a cut hand and the other with a leg wound from a shotgun pellet ricochet. The four Panthers who survived the attack were charged with attempted murder.

The Chicago Journalism Review, a coalition of establishment newspaper editors and writers, has launched a private investigation of the shootings. The white mayor and city council of Maywood, Hampton's home town, have begun proceedings for murder charges against the 14 policemen involved in the attack as well as an investigation of D.A. Hanrahen's part of the killings.

On August 15, 1969, two New Orleans women were arrested in Mississippi on the trumped-up charges of "disturbing the peace". The two women, Miss Theresea Ann Jackson and Miss Alexander Mary Reed were conducting an educational survey in the area of Old Brandon Road, just on the outskirts of Jackson. As they were going about their work, an unidentified car drove up. Out stepped a white male. He then told

the two girls to get in his car. Terry (the negro) told him hell no, she wasn't going anywhere with him. Then this "concerned white citizen" pulled out a gun and started shouting obscenities at them. Terry's white companion, Mary, stepped between the two and told the man that she objected to the way he was talking to Terry.

Out of nowhere came a police car. Two policemen known for their hate of Negroes, stepped out and without asking any questions, promptly arrested the two. The policemen refused to tell the girls why they were arrested.

Both Terry and Mary were taken to the Rankin County Jail, placed in separate cells and were not allowed to make phone calls. Mary was told by the policemen that she was lower than low to be found in the company of a nigger. Subsequently, the policemen cursed and beat the two girls unmercifully throughout the night.

After a week of captivity, Terry managed to smuggle out a letter to her mother who lives in New Orleans. Her mother contacted a lawyer in Jackson, and he managed to get them out after paying 350 dollars fines each.

... "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive to these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its power in such forms, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. . . "

A dignified-looking middle-aged gentleman decided to take advantage of a special sale and buy his wife a pair of nylons. After waiting about an hour on the fringe of a screaming, pushing mob of women, he plunged toward the counter with both arms flying. Suddenly a shrill voice hollered out, "Can't you act like a gentleman?"

"I've been acting like a gentleman for over an hour and it got me nowhere," he replied, still plowing toward the counter. "Now I'm going to act like a lady!"

Disgruntled political writers and revolutionists such as Karl Marx, Friedrich Engels and Vladimir Lenin attempted to explain man's oppression of man in economic terms. They blamed capitalism for all of man's woes. They sought to overturn capitalism and reorganize society along socialist lines. The so-called "dictatorship of the proletariat" was to be their panacea, their miraculous "cure" for the manifold inequities

oppresses man. In any given socio-economic system basic human psychology remains unchanged. In every system, no matter how primitive or advanced, there are individuals who oppress and exploit other individuals. This is a fundamental condition of human existence.

Man, the organizer, builder, war-maker, has all but destroyed man, the individual. Only a small handful of the strong survive as genuine

supposedly suffered by man under "wicked" capitalism.

But Marx, Engels and Lenin only succeeded in doing a great disservice to humanity. Their vaunted communist "panacea" has turned into a malicious conspiracy dedicated to the obliteration of every vital manifestation of human individuality and freedom.

Economic systems do not in themselves oppress man—man

individuals capable of original, creative thought. The rest are mere robots parroting the popular and following the herd.'

The German philosopher, Friedrich Nietzsche, although not an anarchist himself, summed up the anarchist conception of the individual:

"It is the business of the very few to be independent; it is the privilege of the strong. And whoever attempts it, even with the best right, but

Hopefully, this article will clear up any possible misconceptions and amplify the new anarchist position.

without being *obliged* to do so, proves that he is probably not only strong, but also daring beyond measure. He enters into a labyrinth, he multiplies a thousandfold the dangers which life in itself already brings with it; not the least of which is that no one can see how and where he loses his way, becomes isolated, and is torn piecemeal by some minotaur of conscience”.

Ubiquitous governments have subdued man and their malignant forces threaten his very existence. They are a cancerous growth on the face of mankind; they must be excised. Man must assert his individuality and proclaim his independence from all extraneous constraints.

Anarchism is not a utopian pipe-dream! It was not conceived as a panacea and it shall not be one. Anarchism is derived from an analysis of the tendencies that have been and are at work in general human society. It is the only philosophy that is entirely compatible with the

inconsistencies of human behavior. It is therefore unique in that it is not based on false or artificial premises. Anarchism is a natural extension of the desires and motivations present in every rational individual.

In its initial stages, anarchism would produce a certain amount of confusion and disorder. This is to be expected; anarchism demands a radical alteration of human society. The tremendous shock of transition from government tyranny and oppression to complete independence and liberty would revolutionize every aspect of man's existence. Equilibrium would gradually be re-established as a result of the natural interactions between the forces and influences in anarchistic society.

The French publicist, Pierre Joseph Proudhon, the father of modern anarchism, indicated what a future anarchist society might be like in his book, “The General Idea of the Revolution in the Nineteenth Century”, published in 1851:

“It is the industrial organization

that we will put in place of government.

"In place of laws, we will put contracts.—no more laws voted by a majority, nor even unanimously; each citizen, each town, each industrial union, makes its own laws.

"In place of political powers, we will put economic forces.

"In place of standing armies, we will put industrial associations.

"In place of political centralization, we will put economic centralization.

"Do you now see how there can be order without functionaries, a profound and wholly intellectual unity?

"I assure you that in the future it will be easier to conceive of society without government, than society with government".

In America, the popular view has associated all anarchism with violence. This prejudice stems from U.S. past history which includes the Haymarket Square riot in Chicago in May, 1886, in which anarchists were falsely implicated, the assassination of President McKinley by the anarchist Leon Czolgosz in September, 1901, and the payroll murders at South Braintree, Massachusetts, in 1920, for which the American anarchists, Nicola Sacco and Bartolomeo Vanzetti were unjustly tried and executed in Boston in 1927.

The Haymarket Square riot and the Sacco and Vanzetti case are prime

examples of the repressive extralegal police-state methods used against American radical by the U.S. Government in the 19th and early 20th century.

Today, largely because of government propaganda, all American anarchists are branded as terrorists and revolutionists. Foreign anarchists have been denied admission to the United States since 1902, by act of Congress.

The United States is rapidly becoming a fascistic state ruled by a capricious new-aristocratic clique. President Kennedy started the trend toward fascism, President Johnson exacerbated the process, and President Nixon has done nothing to reverse it. As a result, the U.S. is in a constant state of turmoil; all forms of social, moral and political decadence run rampant.

History shows that a nation in such an advanced state of upheaval does not long endure. It undergoes a radical transformation of some sort. And the change could be good or bad. We could achieve true freedom or end up

with the most loathsome dictatorship the world has ever known.

The only logical course of action still open to Americans who seriously hope to preserve their freedom, individuality and independence is anarchism. All other schemes of social reorganization can only lead to further slavery and frustration. Socialism, Communism, Fascism and "democracy" all spring from the same statist mold. They can never fulfill the desires and needs of man. They idealize man and rationalize his imperfections. They toy with human

nature and strike out with stygian fury at those who fail to conform.

The evolutionary drift toward fascism and statism can only be checked by anarchism. Direct and immediate response to the machiavellian machinations of the state is a necessary prerequisite for the attainment of anarchism in the United States.

Already the tremors presaging the anarchist insurrection are being felt all over America. Soon they shall be felt in other parts of the world. The age of governments is drawing to an end.

Bonewits' courses were in psychology, anthropology, sociology, various religions, folklore and mythology.




Frederick Fisher—murdered in 1826.

PSYCHIC PETER HURKOS DRAWS MAP TO MISSING PLANE

Shortly after takeoff, without radio word, the six-passenger airplane disappeared in a mountain range between Pima and Tucson.

NEW FOOD FOR STARVING MILLIONS

Bugs!

Microscopic bugs that live on a combination of air, water and methane gas are the subject of intensive research at the Institute of Gas Technology in Chicago.

A fungus has been developed that can be made to taste like steak, veal or chicken.

It's a fungus called A-35 produced by a British firm that spent more than \$3 million and four years' research to come up with a special fermenting process that turns any starchy crop—potatoes, yams, sugar—into pure protein.

The British company plans to build a factory to turn out commercial quantities of the fungus. They'll try to market it on a small scale in England at first.

OAHSPE BEATS THE SCIENTISTS

BY A. CAHILL

The pages of *Oahspe* offer a form of precognition that could and should be of very considerable interest to scientists, once they take a breather from the job of figuring out new ways of blowing the planet to smithereens. Many of the concepts advanced by *Oahspe* in the fields of physics, astronomy, anthropology, archaeology and history have been either completely verified or strongly supported by discoveries and developments made long after the book was first published.

Oahspe did not use the terminology of science, but there is no mistaking the precision of the following statement: “At the time of the quickening of animal life, the Earth made its daily revolution in what would now be twenty-one hours and

forty minutes at well over a thousand million years ago, right inside the archaozoic age when, modern geologists agree, life was beginning on Earth.

Now for the clincher. In 1965, Dr. Gordon Macdonald of the University of California presented evidence based on the structure of corals. The ridges in corals indicate daily periods, just as the rings in the trunk of a tree may indicate yearly seasons. From these coral ridges the number of days in the year can be counted. If in early corals it is found that this differs from the 365-1/4 days of the present year, then either the length of the year or the length of the day was different than what it now is.

Astronomers are satisfied that the length of the year did not materially differ, but as we have seen, have every

reason to suspect that the length of the day did. And from Dr. Macdonald's count of the earliest fossilized corals of the Devonian geological period, close to the start of life on Earth, the year at that time had about 400 days. This gives a length of 21.9 hours to the day. Carry this calculation back to the very start of organic life, and we must surely arrive almost precisely at *Oahspe's* figure, published eighty-five years previously.

The *Oahspean* theory of the nature of light was certainly in advance of the knowledge of the day. Seven years after it was first published, the famous experiments of Michelson and Morley proved that the velocity of light remains constant whatever the relative motion of its source. This seems clearly indicated in the *Oahspean* explanation that light itself does not travel. Its apparent velocity is along a series of sub-atomic "needles", each of which turns upon its own axis proportionately to the apparent wave-length.

Furthermore, radiation from the sun impinges upon a magnifying lens surrounding the Earth, stated *Oahspe*. This lens converts that radiation into light and heat on the Earth's surface. Without the lens, the sun itself would seem on Earth as a pale red star.

When this was written, and right up until the nineteen-sixties, this seemed a preposterous statement. Yet as every

physicist must admit today, it is a fair enough description of the function of the Van Allen radiation belts, discovered only by the satellite probes of the space age.

What is gravity? No scientist can explain, beyond declaring that the force of gravity is a property of matter. On the contrary, said *Oahspe*, matter is a property of the force of gravity. This mysterious force causes matter, suspended throughout the ether in sub-atomic state, like salt in solution in a glass of water, to crystallize into being.

It was Einstein who first cast scientific doubt on the Newtonian laws of gravity, and Eddington who said (in 1920), "Some mechanism seems to be needed, whereby either gravitation creates matter, or all the matter in the world conspires to define a law of gravitation".

Sir James Jeans suggested the possibility of a fourth dimension as the explanation for the creation of physical matter. The centers of spiral galaxies, he observed, "are of the nature of singular points at which matter is poured into our universe from some other, and entirely extraneous, spatial dimension, so that, to a denizen of our universe they appear to be points at which matter is continually being created."

Oahspe's explanation of the condensation of matter out of a sub-atomic state is simpler, but

basically identical.

In the last thirty years it has become plainly apparent that new suns are being created in our galaxy every day. "Whatever her objects," says John Pfeiffer, "nature has not finished...Right now uncoumted births are taking place in the Milky Way and in hundreds of millions of other galaxies. New stars—and probably new planets and new moons as well—are hatching in the nearest stellar breeding site."

Many years before astronomy had discovered that there was more than one galaxy, *Oahspe* being a fifty or eighty year jump ahead of the science of its day, as in its clear statement that the Earth in past ages has turned progressively so that its every part has been successively at the poles or on the equator. This would have been impossible to the Victorian savant as seemingly in conflict with the laws of motion and gravity, but modern geophysics has quite recently come to the same conclusion.

Neanderthal man was once regarded as the obvious ancestor of homo sapiens, but many anthropologists now reject the theory that we are descended from the "caveman", or from any other known primate, man or ape. The missing link is missing still. Teilhard de Chardin observed that "Neanderthal man seems to have left no posterity. He disappeared, replaced by stronger and more

intelligent races, who no doubt had been developing for a long time parallel with him, in some region of the world as yet unknown to us".

Oahspe prophesies that this region will be discovered ere long, it being the sunken continent of Pan now lying beneath the Pacific ocean. Perhaps the American science phantasy project, the Mo-hole—a scheme to bore into the Earth's crust at the very bottom of this ocean—will turn up some interesting discoveries.

In any event we did not evolve by slow process of natural selection. "There is an evident gap separating primitive man from the anthropomorphs," said de Chardin. Modern man is not directly descended from fossil man—or not by the means implicit in the theory of evolution, at least. "Homo sapiens is axial in relation to the Pithecanthropians," is the scientific way of putting it.

Oahspe has a great deal to say about the cavemen or "ground people" and "earth burrowers" (a picture and several descriptions link them clearly with Neanderthal man) and regards them as a degenerate type interbred between homo sapiens and some more primitive species of human, which so became eventually extinct, leaving no heirs amongst extant mankind.

Because the Amerindians are of Mongoloid stock, anthropologists declare that America was first

colonized by their crossing the Behring strait from Asia into Alaska some 20,000 years ago. Unfortunately there is no evidence in the shape of human remains in the Behring Alaska region that would support this not very scientific piece of guesswork, which depends solely upon the present extent of the Pacific ocean separating the two continents at all other points. *Oahspe* speaks of a great civilization spread over the ancient world centered on Persia ten thousand years ago.

Recently the remains of a highly developed culture have been found in Jericho, dating back nine thousand years. Carbon 14 counts show the village of Jarmo in northern Iraq to be 9,000 years old. Its inhabitants in that age grew barley, two kinds of wheat, made flint sickles, milling stones, and ovens, and they kept goats and possibly sheep, pigs, dogs, cattle, and horses.

Historians today are beginning to find proofs of the Sumerian origin of Egyptian civilization. These similarities are so striking as to admit of no possibility of coincidence. Professor Frankfort in "The Birth of Civilizations in the Near East" illustrates a remarkable number of parallels. The most incontrovertible evidence of cultural connection is shown in the architecture of the Early Dynastic tombs of Egypt compared with seal-impressions from

Mesopotamia showing almost exactly similar buildings. Walter B. Emery, Professor of Egyptology at London University, says that many authorities now consider that Egypt owes her civilization to the people of the Euphrates.

This was stated in explicit terms in *Oahspe*, the story being that drought conditions affecting a powerful kingdom on the borders of Phoenicia caused the migration of hundreds of thousands of her people into Egypt, the very name of which country was derived from the oracle who guided them there. The *Oahspean* story of the building of the Great Pyramid, incidentally, is absolutely fascinating—and also seems to explain many puzzling features of its construction.

Scholars have of course for centuries been probing into the myths and legends of the pagan background to the biblical story of Jesus. *Oahspe* separates the man and the legend, placing his lifetime a century or so earlier than the biblical figure and indicating the crystallization of a pagan mythos around this figure in the fourth century. Archaeology began to tend toward the same conclusion—see for instance Arthur Weigall's "The Paganism in Our Christianity"—and the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls has established a Teacher of Righteousness and a pre-Pauline type of Christian belief more than a century B.C.

If *Oahspe* was right about the past,

what does it indicate for the future of mankind on this planet? Well, there are some pretty grim remarks about our Peace Society failing and nations going down into destruction, because they have rejected the Supreme Being. The salvation of mankind however can only be effectuated by initiating a reconstruction of human society in small communities of mutual aid and interdependence. Such a community is described at some length in *Oahspe*, which in every detail except two might apply to a generalized description of life in a kibbutz in Israel. This is the communal organization of a hundred thousand people in that country today, yet the

first kibbutz was founded only in 1906, some thirty years after *Oahspe* was written.

One of those two exceptions is the apparently minor point of diet, but *Oahspe* lays great stress throughout on the absolute necessity for the peaceful future of mankind to change from a carnivorous diet to a vegetarian one.

And the other exception? Obviously, a universal religious outlook uniting all mankind.

Perhaps some controlling Intelligence did have a hand in that miraculous preservation of Israel and the kibbutzim from the onslaughts of the unholy alliance of Communism and racial fanaticism.



WHO IS GOING TO DO THE DISHES?

Before we go into any discussion of "women's rights" and "liberation", let's list a few quotes from published opinions of what they actually are, and to what extent these rights are being violated, and to what extent discrimination is practiced. The quotes follow:

The "Feminists" protest the marriage contract. They say *their aim* is "eliminating sex roles." Said one member, "We reject marriage both in theory and in practice."

The "National Organization for Women" (NOW) wants to end sex discrimination in hiring, promotions and salaries; repeal abortion laws; establish comprehensive child care; and place women in policy-making posts.

"Redstockings", which takes as its theme: "Bitch, sisters, bitch" advocates that "women might write up their own marriage contract that would spell out commitment to fidelity or lack of it, priorities in life, and what division of labor there would be in the home.

"WITCH" (Women's International Terrorist Conspiracy from Hell), a feminist revolutionary group which

sees witches as the first guerrilla fighters against women's oppression. Its members believe that "Witches have always been women who dared to be groovy, courageous, aggressive, intelligent, nonconformist, sexually liberated, revolutionary."

"Female Liberation", is a tight-knit, fiercely committed and clannish group. In their journal, "No More Fun and Games" they urge their members "to leave their husbands and children and to avoid pregnancy. Women should dress plainly, chop their hair short, and begin to 'reclaim themselves' by dropping their husbands' or fathers' names. They should live alone and abstain from sexual relationships." They also give classes in karate.

Some women believe that sex roles should be redefined. They ask, "Why shouldn't men share the responsibility for raising children and keeping house? Why shouldn't a woman, if she's attracted to a man, be able to call and invite him to a movie?"

Still other women's liberation members feel the economic responsibility, the child-care and the drudgery of housework should be

shared.

Miss Betty Fridan, author of "The Feminine Mystique," argues that sex discrimination is part of society's manipulation of women for the good of business and male dominated America.

Local sources agreed. "When you're very young, the girl gets a doll to be a mother to and the boy gets a construction toy to build with." Girls are taught to be passive, meek and dependent on men.

By adulthood, it's pretty hard to challenge the stuff you've grown up with. That's why, even though women instinctively know they are oppressed, they're not oriented to change the situation.

By the time they enter the working world, virtually all the jobs women can get are in the role of serving men—secretaries, waitresses, cleaners, etc. They are not trained for better jobs.

According to sociologist Marlene Dixon, "A woman is first defined by the man to whom she is attached...and secondly by the children she bears and rears."

Although women are brain-washed to feel happy as housewives and mothers, there are no educated women who feel fulfilled with these roles.

Business gets the blame for much of the oppression. Women feel that job advancement is open to women only

where it does not interfere with the traditional prerogatives of men.

Government figures show that:

Full time working women earn only about 60% as much as men in the same job categories.

Women are disproportionately employed in underpaid, menial jobs.

The income gap between men and women increases slightly each year.

Similar statistics abound. Different classes of women—middle, working and college age—see different examples of discrimination.

Mistreatment of females is obvious to working class women, according to "Marsha," a young member of MATC's Student Liberation Union. Citing the lack of equal pay, equal promotions and of day care centers for mothers, she said, "It's an inhuman existence."

End of quotes.

Perhaps the best single item on which to pin our discussion is the very simple one which has been selected as the title of this article: "Who is going to do the dishes?" It is very descriptive of the basic misconception upon which the entire "women's liberation" movement has been based. In actuality, women are undoubtedly discriminated against by reason of sex, and there are certain rights (already guaranteed by the Constitution) which are being violated quite unfairly. In the series of quotes we have just given you, many of these

“violations” and “unfairnesses” are mentioned. Legally speaking, they are merely a matter of application and enforcement in order to eliminate them. There is no doubt that male dominance exists; but there are also other factors, such as economics, which play a part in some of the discrimination. Lower wages for equal work is one of them. Let’s discuss it briefly:

There are two areas in our society which are fundamental. One is the home, where the family exists and where the children are created, developed and protected, and brought to adulthood. The other is the outside world where the means to accomplish this task exist—the raw materials, the food, the money necessary to buy them. In a more primitive society, the man’s job is to go out and secure the raw materials—trees and mud and stones which to build a shelter; the harvesting of naturally growing foods, and the agricultural production of crops; the gathering and/or growing of fibre and furs with which to fashion clothing. In the modern society, these things are procured with money, and in order to secure that money, it is necessary to sell your services for a wage.

While it is true that a woman can do all these things, nature has defined the roles as separate. Men are more ruggedly constructed, better equipped to do the work which, after all, they

did not select, but were hereditarily fashioned to do. Women are the ones selected by nature to bear the children. She did not select this role, but it is biologically thrust upon her. Obviously, during the time of pregnancy, she is more less removed from the outside labor force, and during the helpless period in which the children need to be fed (from her breasts, although in much of the “educated” world, the cow has been drafted to take over that role), carried in her arms, clothed in clothing manufactured by her hands out of the raw materials furnished by the male, she is obviously removed from the outside world by sheer lack of time and physical condition.

We have some “liberationists” who object to this role. They say ‘Why shouldn’t men share the responsibility of raising children and keeping house?’ The answer is, they do! There is more to raising children and keeping house than milk and diapers and dishes. Yes, the tasks could be shared. Perhaps three days a week the woman could hunt the bear, skin it, cure its meat; or build a bridge; or sell life insurance—while the husband washes the dishes; sterilizes the baby bottle (he’s not likely to be able to nurse the baby, although there are medical instances on record of it having occurred); changes the diapers; scrubs the floor; makes a boiled dinner; sews a fine seam. However, the woman may

have a bit of trouble with the tough bear hide; lifting the stone into place on the bridge; or replacing the broken axle in the dump truck. And the man may find out his training in cooking or sewing is inadequate. But mostly, he will find out that when he returns to work, his employer will inform him that he is an economic liability, since his muscular contribution is less for three days of the week, albeit at the same salary. It is just a condition of things that exists that these two roles are basically separate and assigned, *because of sex, and not regardless of it.*

Yet, there are times when the man *should* wash the dishes. When his wife is pregnant, he ought to wait on her hand and foot. At this time she is in God's service, perpetuating the race, and in a sense, is sacred. She must be protected in her task at all costs. The race's continued existence depends upon it. And, while it isn't necessary that she be "babied", motherhood is a matter of love, and the infant, in order to be psychologically secure and healthy, needs that expressed love that only a mother can give—and the mother's happiness depends on knowing that she is herself loved and considered special, particularly at this time. . .if she is to pass this sense of security on to her child.

Those liberationists who advocate the elimination of "fun and games" are no doubt those who resent the

idea that females were created for the purpose of "entertaining" men by submitting their bodies to his physical satisfaction. Quite obviously they consider that the fun and games is all one-sided. And it is true that many women do not enjoy sex to the extent that men do. Perhaps it is their mental attitude, and not their physical attributes which brings this about. There are two historic reasons for such an attitude, both of them stemming from which is called "religion" but which has nothing to do with the God concept at all. Because of the story of Adam and Eve, which at best is pure allegory, a great many women apply the account of the creation of Eve from a man's rib in order that he shall be a "helpmeet" (they prefer to give it the connotation of "playmate"), and that it is "not good that the man should be alone", to their role in life and call it "slavery". They are willing to admit that sexual relationships are biologically necessary to cause a pregnancy and perpetuate the race, but they state that sexual relationships for pure pleasure and enjoyment are one-sided, and it is the man who is "using" them as a sex object. They see themselves as a mere "instrument of masturbation", and feel degraded. It is quite true that a great many men do regard women largely from this standpoint. They see a shapely figure, and instantly

translate it into a supine position in a bed. However, there is reason to suspect that, judging from the feminine reaction to such as Elvis Presley (Elvis the Pelvis) and Tom Jones and his erotic writhings that the image of the bed is not entirely peculiar to the sensuous male. How many women realize the fury that their hysterics over such personalities arouses in those men who regard women as more than objects of sex, but as wives and mates and the mother of their children?

We doubt if the vast majority of women consider this form of "liberation" as the goal they are seeking. The absolutely unreasonable claim that it is workable "to live alone and abstain from sexual relationships" can scarcely be made by any but an illogical and ridiculous minority of "mental cases" whose condition may have come about through lack of normal sexual development.

The "Feminists" say their aim is to eliminate sex rules and that they reject marriage both in theory and practice. This must be rather startling to the "Playboy" as he is pictured in the magazine of that name, and to the wife who burns her husband's copy at the first opportunity. On the one hand the liberationists complain that they are being used as sex objects, and that men will jump into bed with any woman who heaves in sight. They fight to protect their marriage, and

fend off marauding females, then turn around want to "equalize" things by adopting the same standards. Ladies, if you succeed in bringing this about, you are likely to find millions of "playboys" dancing in the streets. But if you do, you will eliminate the family.

Some of these rebel women actually propose that this is what should be done. They want abortion, state care of the children (or at least child care centers where they can leave their children while they pursue a career—or a romance), and even test-tube babies. They want to contribute an ova and ask the male to contribute sperm, to be united in an artificial womb, or even in a hired "carrier", and consider the "family" as simply a matter of contributing an equal share of the financial cost of the baby's production, and maintaining a household on the same equal basis, with the bed a matter of mutual arrangement based on inclination.

A great many men agree with women that there should be equality—but from another viewpoint; they maintain that men have never been equal to women. Women, they say, rule the world, the home, and the man. They say that women use sex, first as the honey that draws the fly, then as the weapon that commands obedience. They point to the divorce laws and say, with perfect accuracy, that the law favors the woman almost

100%. The divorced man is condemned to a mere existence at a pittance while the woman has everything she had before the divorce including the income (or even an increase in that income), the use of the home, the custody of the children (unless she chooses not to take the responsibility) and she may, at any time, remarry without fear that this act will lower her standard of living. At the same time, the man cannot marry again, unless he can solve the problem of how to maintain two households on his income. The law doesn't absolve him from previous responsibility, as it does the woman.

But, ladies, who was it that made these divorce laws? Not women! They have not been in any position to enact them. They have been enacted by *men* who love their wives, love their homes, value them, want to keep any threat away from the destruction of their home and the safe haven for their children who have made it so difficult for a man to abandon his family, and so heavily punished when he does. They have also sought to protect women from the sexual vandal who does use them, and makes slaves of them.

A great many women, traditionally, seek the security of marriage. The frightening prospect of being an "old maid" has brought many a woman into a marriage of barter. She has, in effect, traded her body for a

protector. Perhaps, with added opportunity for a career in the business world developing, as women actually gain equality in this sphere, the concept of the old maid, and the pursuit of a man to convert into a husband, is ending (or has ended).

Whatever we may think of equality of the sexes, it has never been, and never will be, a question of "who washes the dishes". It is a question of fairness and mutual respect, and reasonable, logical, personal, individual arrangement between man and a woman in the pursuit of happiness.

The author of this article can speak only for himself, but he suspects that there are many men like him—we ask nothing for ourselves, all we do, every effort of the day and night, is for one purpose, to provide for the woman and children and home we love.

If sexual freedom is the answer to your "inhuman existence", the real place to secure your liberation is the ghastly imposition placed on us by the ancient priesthood who cast about for a common denominator with which to enforce the collection of money and the perpetuation of dominant authority, and came up with the ideal subject—sex. Make *that* a sin, and you've got it made—because everybody will be a sinner. There are lots of reasons why women have cause for complaint, but it should be among the *educated* that the solutions should

be found, and it is simply amazing that the educated woman seems to think that the very same subject, sex, should be the one to use as her weapon against unfairness. The truth is, we are not equal, we are not the

same. We are men and women, and if we choose to be totally independent of one another, there won't be any dishes to wash. But of course, the majority of women know that, don't they?

TAROT CARD EXPERT

Occult books line the artistic looking shelves and a crystal ball sets on a window ledge next to the table where Ron Warmoth does his readings.

Considered to be one of the nation's foremost authorities on the Tarot cards, Ron has read for dozens of well known movie stars and is in steady demand by business executives who seek his advice on important business deals and coming trends in the stock market.

Although only twenty-eight, Ron Warmoth's reputation in the psychic field is not easily over-shadowed. His clients, some of the wealthiest people in the world, come from everywhere, including India, Australia, England, Japan, Egypt, Greece and Israel.

Ron was born into a rather conventional Southern family, one of his ancestors being Henry Clay Warmoth, governor of Louisiana. However, at an early age he realized that there was more to "see" than just the ordinary things most children content themselves with. "As with many psychics, I had my share of invisible playmates. My grandmother was also a clairvoyant, but my own parents were more or less closed-minded to such things."

Ron's actual entrance into the world of "psychic phenomena" did not happen until 1965, when after spending some time in Hollywood as an actor and dancer, he met Eve Nightingale who had been popular in psychic circles during the lifetime of Harry Houdini. After their first

encounter, Ron felt that he might try his hand at giving readings. He approached the owner of a small coffee house who agreed that he could set up a table in exchange for a small fee should the attraction prove popular.

didn't need it. By simply spreading out the Tarot cards in front of me I felt I could get an accurate glimpse of what was going to come in the future for anyone for whom I wanted to read". Ron explains that the Tarot is symbolic and is the purest of all the occult arts.

Several hours later he gave his first readings at the Bizarre Bazaar. The next day the coffee house was packed as word of Ron's ability spread throughout the hippie underground. Soon the Bizarre Bazaar, which had catered almost exclusively to long-haired youths, was swarming with some of the biggest screen stars in Hollywood who had come to see this amazing young man for themselves.

Five years have passed and Ron Warmoth is in demand as never before. Now living in New York, he is in demand as a lecturer and has made several appearances on radio and television. His recent guest shot on *TO TELL THE TRUTH* was such a success that it has been replayed three times.

Quizzed on other aspects of the occult, Ron reveals that he is a believer in life after death. "It's just as simple as stepping out of your body. The next dimension is quite similar to that which we are now in." Even such things as levitation and walking through walls is possible. According to Ron Warmoth: "all you have to do is

slow down the atoms" in you body. This can be done through constant meditation and thought projection.

When it comes to reading for his clients, he merely tells them what he is able to see in the Tarot cards. He does warn that sometimes even the best of psychics do make mistakes. "Always question what you are told. Question it twice if necessary."

Many of Ron's clients are so pleased with his honesty and straight-forward approach to their problems that they often show their appreciation in unusual and rewarding ways. One woman was so pleased with the advice that she was given that she gave Ron an apple jade hand carved ring which is about three inches in diameter. The ring is several hundred years old and belonged to the imperial family in China.

Despite all of his remarkable psychic abilities, Ron Warmoth does not take his aptitude for granted. "I am very much interested in all forms of psychic research and have people with scientific training and background coming to me all the time. I am as interested as anyone else in finding out why I have this talent. Occultism is my whole life. I am dedicated to this work."

FORTUNE-TELLING MOVES FROM TEA ROOM TO LIVING ROOM

The story goes that a harried stockbroker, arriving home to find his wife working a ouija board, sneered,

"Ask it how I can make enough to retire and waste my time that way." The board's pointer moved quickly and spelled out, "Sell ouija boards."

Not bad advice, when you consider that ouija boards are now selling at the rate of over 2,000,000 a year. The board might also have told the broker to start printing Tarot cards and occult posters, to take up palmistry or to form a partnership with an astrologer. For there's one sure market these days—the sale of what would once have been called fortune-telling books and devices. Now it's called occultism, and while it may have been launched into current popularity as part of the psychedelically-oriented youth interest, it has moved swiftly into an area of respectability that it hasn't enjoyed since the days of court astrologers.

On June 1, 1970, *The New York Times* carried a straight-faced report that the University of California at Berkeley was about to award a bachelor of arts degree in magic to an academically qualified student. Tongue firmly in cheek, *McCall's* magazine devoted its March issue to the "occult explosion". And on June 19, Brentano's, long-established purveyor of books and *objets d'arts*, opened *Mystique*, a department devoted exclusively to occult books and devices, in its Fifth Avenue store.

Brentano's doesn't claim to be in

the *avant-garde*. Mystique became a necessity, says chief operating executive, Robert Luckie. "Customers were running our salespeople ragged, having them look for Sybil Leek's books on witchcraft, for Tarot cards in the fun and games shop, for natural birthstones in the art and nature boutique, and for zodiac writing paper in the stationery department."

Clearly, fortune-telling has moved from behind the tawdry curtains of Gypsy reading rooms into respectable living rooms. The seance is replacing the Thursday afternoon bridge club; scoffing husbands are showing up at work with tales of tables that rise on their hind legs and answer questions that stump the decision-makers; and witchcraft has come out in the open.

Recently at the Fillmore East in New York's hip East Village more than 3500 persons turned out to see a two-hour occult show put on under the talent of psychic Marc Reymont. The program included aspects of witchcraft, mind reading, Tarot cards, prophecy, etc. It was such a success that Reymont has packaged a new program under the title of *Occultism in the 70's* and plans to tour the country in the coming months.

Meanwhile in California, where the current interest actually started, tapes that are now occult classics are being reproduced for mail order by the Northern Chapter of the Kethra E' Da

Foundation in Mountain View. This enterprise offers taped lectures given by discarnate beings speaking through a well-known medium. The idea germinated naturally from the dormant seeds of approximately 3000 original tapes recorded over a period of 23 years. The tapes are clear, replete with wisdom and humor, and turgid with an astounding cosmology.

It all began with that amazing oracle of ancient wisdom, the internationally known, Mark Probert, as the amanuensis. Sixteen discarnate teachers alternately commanded his body and communicated with effortless fluency.

Mark Probert was born in Bayonne, New Jersey on February 5, 1907, and died in San Diego, California, February 22, 1969. From early childhood his psychic gifts were noted as remarkable. But only after his marriage did these latent forces within him really erupt. His wife, Irene, complained of his talking foreign languages in his sleep. After much ado and confusion with neurologists and psychiatrists, a friend by the name of Dr. Meade Layne sat him at a card table where the first of the 16 teachers communicated for 45 minutes. Over the years since 1945 Mark and Irene travelled extensively to reach all the people who clamored to hear these astonishing lectures. At every meeting tapes were made and so accumulated a fantastic library.

Ralph G. Warren, a dedicated psychic researcher from Palo Alto, California was one of four persons who met once a week to listen to a library of about 200 of these tapes. "Often we were so caught up in a cosmogonic form that so brilliantly yoked science to philosophy that we staggered home at a late hour. But we did not care! What we were hearing was almost beyond belief in its perfection. In time the group of listeners grew and we changed our meeting place, the interest in the tapes and the impact of the philosophy became so evident and sincere that we marveled at the power.

"Then we began to feel selfish. Here was the honey and freedom of life; why not share it on a world-wide basis? Since all of us were rather busy people, it developed slowly. Finally the first ads were placed, the electronic recording apparatus assembled, and brochures and general stationery printed. Still we are, as the 'old timer' said, 'just beginning to commence'. But our first orders have arrived and based on our incipient cautious efforts, we are certain the tapes will eventually have a world wide circulation."

The 16 teachers who lectured through Mark call themselves the "Inner Circle". They are led by a personality called E Yada di Shi'ite who lived 500,000 years ago in the Himalaya mountains in a civilization known as Yuga. The most frequent lecturers are Yada, Professor Alfred Luntz, 1812-1893; Ramon Natalli, 1598-1652; Lao-Tse, 550-600 B.C.; and the Maharaji Natcha Tramalaki, 1848-1915. Shortly after beginning his work, Mark was visited clairvoyantly by these teachers whom he painted in oils. He was a talented portrait painter.

The subjects covered in the lectures embrace every function of life and reveal many astonishing secrets. The earthy language from the Moon was a demonstration of a change in attitude. On previous space voyages, Washington public relations planned and rehearsed words made the astronauts sound more likely sky pilots than test pilots and their observations more revelations than scientific observations.

The public attitude was different too. Before, there had been a sense of foreboding, an anxiety that hung on at each launch. There was an overwhelming dread of the unknown.

It disappeared almost entirely when we were assured there were no monsters lurking on the far side of the Moon.

The stark desolation of the lunar landscape produced a challenge. It brought forth a feeling of awe—not fear. The spacemen became men pitted against nature. Instead of the fear filled sailor who lived in terror of monsters or of falling off Earth, they took on the role of the hard bitten pioneer who fought nature on his own terms and the language became that of the scout and the riverboat man.

One of the astronauts summed up the new philosophy—"Man can accomplish anything if he puts his mind to it."

This is the new credo—the belief in the Age of Man, a time in which he has the knowledge and the tools to shape his own destiny.

Life's science editor Albert Rosenfeld grapples with the implications of this belief in his new book, *The Second Genesis—The Coming Control of Life*. . . (Prentice-Hall, Inc. \$6.95).

He states the problem bluntly. "As man's knowledge—and therefore man's power—takes on new dimensions, hardly any human concept or value will remain too sacrosanct to undergo a wrenching reappraisal. Health and disease, youth and age, male and female, good and evil—all these will take on transformed meanings. Life and death will have to be redefined. Family relationships will perforce be quite different, and even individual identity may be hard to ascertain. Nothing can be taken for granted among the trans-humans in the post-civilization of the Psychozoic Kingdom. To preserve any semblance of current human values, the leaders of men will have to think in new categories, and with creative leaps of the imagination."

Our behavior would not be willed but controlled. "The prospect arises, then, that we might learn to control

human behavior by learning to change at will the patterns in our brain cells—by learning, as it were, to untwist the 'twisted molecules.' Untwisting could mean restructuring the cellular molecules in any way—rearranging their constituent atoms, taking away or adding a few ingredients, modifying the chemical or electrical activity. Ultimately chemistry and electricity come down to the same thing—the movements and rearrangements of electrons. Thus it is proper to think of the 'electrochemistry' of the brain as an entity, or as a closely related series of processes and events that take place in the real four-dimensional physical world and which are therefore subject to both observation and manipulation. Manipulating the electrons of the brain, then, would equal manipulating human behavior."

However, this control and manipulation would not be without its dangers. "A real danger inherent in promiscuous drug-taking, of course, is that people might become so enchanted with their drugged states that they have little desire for experience in the real world—a world which does not interest them, perhaps, because it seems both dull and hopeless, a world they were eager in any case to retreat from."

As the author points out, in seeking to control his evolution, man could bring it to a standstill.

As for sex, the Life editor sees this as capable of manipulation and simulation. As proof of the saying that "It's all in your mind", he cites studies made with paraplegics at Johns Hopkins. Although they have no feelings of the lower extremities, they can through fantasy or dreams go through the gamut of sexual sensations. Huxley's "Feelies" are more than science fiction and programmed sex may become a new form of therapy.

He further suggests genetic changes to infuse knowledge. Given the proper amounts of DNA, every man can be his own Einstein, Aristotle or Michelangelo. But given this opportunity, will he want to be?

Perhaps, he would want to be the extension of a constantly growing brain center as envisioned by Arthur C. Clarke, a disembodied consciousness which is not restricted in size by a skull but can expand to encompass the problems of the world.

"One can imagine a time," says Clarke, "when men who still inhabit organic bodies are regarded with pity by those who have passed on to an infinitely richer mode of existence, capable of throwing their

consciousness or sphere of attention instantaneously to any point on land, sea or sky where there is a suitable sensing organ."

Suddenly, even though there are no monsters on the far side of the Moon, some of us are afraid again—very afraid.

Why should we be in such desperate haste to succeed and in such desperate enterprises? If a man does not keep pace with his companions, perhaps it is because he hears a different drummer. Let him step to the music which he hears, however measured or far away.—Thoreau.

I am no story teller,—not good on details although the facts I can give are startling enough. I am a clairvoyant. Sometimes when people (neighbors of mine, that is) are in grave trouble they are attracted to me for some reason unknown to themselves, and I encourage them to tell me their trouble. Then I put myself as much in their shoes as I can, and let the voice within me speak. Nothing I have ever told them was a premeditated message, but came out of nowhere. . .I didn't know what I was going to say until I heard myself say it.

Gene was a slim and blonde young man slightly taller than Penney, but truly I knew very little about him. He

was not a good provider. Penney was a very troubled woman and had been committed to the state hospital for mental illness several times. Doubtless, she was often given tranquilizing pills. They had four beautiful children and were living in a small housing project when I met young Penney. She came to my door and asked to use my phone, to get her mother to come and baby sit for her. . .she was going somewhere.

I knew there were squabbles at home, but never asked about it. As things were coming to a climax and Penney could feel it, she came again and asked to use the phone.

From neighbors I had gathered that her children were not well cared for, one was retarded, and they had been seen eating from garbage cans.

“Penney, I know you have a greater problem than you know how to handle, and I have been through something of the same thing so I know how depressed a person can

get,—believe me, I know it is rough.” She put her arms around me and hugged me,—and I returned it in understanding affection. Then I said “Penney, you will spend some time praying about your problem and ask the Lord to show you how to begin solving it. If you pray hard enough and long enough and with faith, believing the right answer will come, you will receive that blessing and you will become enlarged.”

Many months passed. . . I had not seen Penney. I knew there had been a climax,—that she tried to commit suicide,—was laying on the pills her husband was trying to take away from her, and an ambulance was called and she was taken away. No one could tell me anything beyond that.

Then one day as I was crossing the housing project to the bus stop, Penney and her family came out of their apartment, dressed warmly, and nicely, and if I hadn’t recognised the children I wouldn’t have looked so hard at Penney. She was fully five inches taller and a few inches broader,—but it didn’t occur to me that she had been enlarged, as I had

told her she would be, until much later. The human mind is, indeed, tricky.

This was an unusual case. I am not a strong person and do not try to have a lot of contacts. . . prefer to live quietly. So I will give the editor my real name and address and request that my initials only be used as I do not want letters in response from this story.



WHAT IS A POLICEMAN?

"A policeman is a composition of what all men are, a mingling to saint and sinner, dust and deity . . . Less than one-half of one per cent of policemen misfit that uniform . . . "The policeman must be a minister, a social worker, a diplomat, a tough guy and a gentleman . . . And, of course, he'll have to be a genius—for he'll have to feed and clothe a family on a policeman's salary."

The aura is a kaleidoscope of color, the beauty and brilliance of which are nowhere else to be found. At the top of the aura is the Flowering Lotus, above the ray painted in medieval paintings as a halo around the head of a saint. The halo is a bluish or a yellow color. Telling a lie causes a yellow-green to show in the halo. A saffron-yellow indicates a highly spiritual person. There are psychic rays to be seen across the eye region. These are clairvoyant rays which extend across the side of the face. Psychometric powers can be detected by looking at the eyes. A person with psychometric ability can take up the phone and tell you all about the person at the other end, be he 10,000 miles away; or he can try on a coat and tell you all about that person.

The aura consists of magnetic rays which surround the physical body and extend for one of two feet up to five feet or more. The aura is as fascinating as a study of the person as it presents a full scale color panorama around a

person.

There are four basic colors but there are striations of color on the edges of these colors. These may be yellow, blue, green and red which are good colors to have depending on the shades, or indigo, violet, orange, grey, brown. Yellow is the color of spirituality but it must be a clear yellow. Green is the color of teaching.

and healing. It is present in the aura of a brilliant surgeon or physician. A person with a yellowish-green cannot be trusted. Blue shows intellectual ability. Pale blue shows a person who is not decisive. Red indicates health. A muddy red shows bad temper. Murderers have a muddy or too dark red in their auras. A brownish red over an organ indicates cancer. Scarlet

shows false pride, a person who is too sure of himself. Scarlet shows around the hips of "Scarlet Women". Pink indicates childishness and insecurity. Orange in your aura shows a considerate person. Brownish orange shows a lazy person. It also is indicative of kidney trouble; combined with grey, over the kidney region, it shows kidney stones. Indigo, violet, or purple in the aura indicates heart and stomach disorders. Grey bands in the aura mean an unevolved person. Grey over an organ is a sign of trouble.

It is helpful to know something about your nine bodies when you study the aura. Your physical body is merely a garment by means of which the Soul or Astral Body records the experiences and sufferings of life. Next you have the Etheric which is an exact duplicate of the physical body and takes three days to separate from the physical body after death. If you look in your mirror at night with a low watt bulb, you will see a blue line extending two inches or so from the physical body. The line is narrow if you are tired, and wide if you are rested. You also have a Causal Body and a Mental Body which leave with your Astral Body when you astral travel at night. You can see them leaving if you are psychic; they are white in appearance. You do not have to be asleep to astral travel and can "take off" from your armchair. As a

small child I could astral travel from any position, even in a classroom. That makes five bodies. Your Astral Body is attached to the umbilicus by a silver cord which is blue-grey-white in color. Your other bodies operate various organs.

Low vibrations in the aura give dull muddy colors. The higher one's vibrations, the purer and more brilliant are the colors of the aura. A good deed brightens one's outlook by brightening one's auric colors. A bad deed makes us feel "blue."

Cosmic essence enters the body at the base of the neck at the medulla oblongata and the spark of life which is part of the Astral Body lies at the base of the spine but through certain exercises you can make it rise to the brain and other parts of the body. It is necessary to know a little about this so that when you look at your aura, you realize how your nine bodies are interwoven and fit one into the other with the exception of your Astral Body or Angel. Memory and consciousness are both part of the Soul or Astral Body.

The physical body is made up of carbon molecules. The carbon molecules are fewer and further between in spirit bodies. Our nine separate bodies are each connected to the other by a Silver Cord. The brain takes messages from the Overself and converts these commands into chemical activity or physical activity

which causes muscles to work, and certain mental processes. It also relays back to the Overself messages and impressions of experiences.

The aura reflects your health and personality. By glancing at the aura we can tell whether a surgeon or doctor has a special attraction for the type of work he does, or whether a teacher is meant to do such work. The aura shows incipient or advanced diseases and in this way can be a greater aid to diagnosis than X-Rays or laboratory work which in New York City is 80% inaccurate all the time.

You can influence your health by wearing clothes of certain colors. A color which clashes with your aura will make you ill at ease or self-conscious. Colors are vibrations and the clash provided by wearing the wrong colors reacts on the individual and on those who look at him. In decoration choose colors which are in harmony with your aura. You will have greater relaxation if you do.

You can determine heart disease in the aura as inverted purple, grey or brownish-red lines round the heart area; cancer of the intestines or colon is seen as violet, purple or grey rays over the specific region; mental illness shows as grey lines around the head area. These illnesses show up in handwriting analysis but it is more exciting to see the symptoms before your eyes. When a little instrument

has been developed which, by looking at the person, all the health rays and illness rays are seen in color, one of the greatest aids to medical science will be here.

Persons with dual personality have half of the aura one color, and half of a completely different color. Their aura may have two egg-shapes joined at an angle to each other. Shock treatment for mental illness is designed to shock the two "eggs" into one.

With any perception you can sense the aura, even when you do not actually see it. Often you dislike a person you have met. This means that you sensed his personality through his auric colors and you found something disagreeable. As a child I thought everyone could see the aura as I could see it when extraterrestrials came to visit me. I was as fascinated by the aura as by the people. I always know what people are like just by looking at them. "I've met people like her before," said one executive I worked with. "They know all about you when they look at you."

A Test for Compatibility

Compatibility in marriage relates to the colors and striations of the aura matching one another. The particular wave form of one aura touches the wave form of the partner's aura at certain points where there is complete agreement and compatibility. Two people who are compatible have auric

colors that blend and harmonize. You know that you are compatible with a person of the opposite sex whom you have just met when this feeling of harmony surrounds you both. It means your auric colors are in tune. There is a certain degree of magnetism in true love but this is a spiritual quality. However agreement of auric colors determines compatibility. If the auric colors don't agree and you like other qualities in a person, you will *not* be compatible.

Music is a vibration which reacts on our senses and aesthetic powers. Great musicians are those who have gone to higher realms in astral travel and heard "the music of the spheres". They compose the music they heard in the astral. A cosmic ray column, available to certain people in this country, shows the colors of music. It is attached to a record player of radio and plays your favorite records in color!

Dogs can see your aura and the colors tell them whether you are a good person and they can trust you or not. Many dogs are more spiritual, more psychic and intelligent than people. Perhaps the little Angels to


whom they are attached, being still uncontaminated by the deceit and evil of men, have given to their little charges (who aid them in recording the experiences of life) the spiritual and psychic gifts that men lack. I talk telepathically to my dogs.

An Adept can look at a person and see on the outer covering of the aura some of the things that the person has done during his past two or three lives. Some Adepts can sense this by glancing at a person.

One easy way to see the colors of your aura is to place a glass bowl of water in a low sunny window. When the sun and light shine in, you will see the colors of your aura reflected inside the window. But if you are persevering you can see your aura with your own eyes by looking in a mirror. You can also use aura goggles.

IT RENDS MY HEART

Dear Ray:

My letter is quite late, but I must write, and I hope you will give it your best consideration and help me get a message across, if not to your readers then at least personally to yourself.

It concerns a letter in the May (1970) issue of *Search* under the heading "Trouble With Parents," signed Betty Morton and Jimmy Towers. Their views are nothing new but it rends my heart because it expresses something that is stifling the intuition of so many young people, intuition that makes for individuality, creativity and progress.

Of course, there are many contrasting concepts rampant and in a

matter such as this it is normally impossible for one to see the logic of another. I myself haven't grasped the "Hippie philosophy" as fully as I would like to, but I cannot learn and reach for higher principles by conforming to concepts that were imposed on me by others who might have fallen into a common rut.

I believe I can put the Hippie-type into three general (indistinct, as it normally goes) classes: those who don't know what they are, who find Hippiedom a convenient place to be a sloven (but who are no more a crumb than the good citizens and neighbors who are uptight in a meticulous routine of finery, who bathe daily and go to church on Sunday, comment how "terrible" some human characteristics are and wear perfume that would make a Hippie sick—with variations on both sides); those who truly believe in peace and love, warm and altruistic people who have good ideas about how the order of things should be and perhaps would live in closer harmony with the "laws" of nature, who recognize originality and a need to follow intuition; troublemakers—those who take advantage of a situation and in so doing add to the disillusion of the establishment-minded—but firstly those who are practical minded and wish to assert themselves, perhaps to fight, if necessary, for what they believe in. On the establishment side,

Americans have always fought for what they believe in, but until the establishment was objected to, they called it noble.

Everything is constantly changing. That is evolution out of which progress is formed. This is a particular time of change, of "stress", and we need not be afraid but to live with it in assurance, of evolution, of nature, life, "God", of the goodness and harmony of the universe.

There is often a vast difference between parents and their children and many young people have a vital need to break away. They aren't hostile and would rather be understood, which is impossible, and they may linger a while with sympathy and be mentally imposed upon until they realize they must rebel. Some come to hate their parents because the perspective of love has been destroyed along with the aptitude to express their intuition.

People deserve to be shown more dignity and respect from the time they are born. There is a lot said about "how to bring up a child" but it isn't so much what parents say or contrive to their offsprings as it is what they otherwise express that makes the difference. It is really vibrations that get through to them mostly. They can't hide their vibrations and they aren't apt to change what they are, but nature changes the trends so the wheels of

progress don't become bogged down with the hordes who merely follow the ruts and criticize those who take the lead in a new direction or who follow different ruts. All that is perfectly natural and the wheels go on, bringing new variations, new advent of thought and expression, gradually, even to those who are so reluctant to admit anything outside the scope of their own illusions.

As for the word "regression" in the article: there are, for example, many people, at all levels of intelligence and influence, wearing the pomp and sheen of the establishment and social concepts who are literally poisoning the atmosphere with emanations of what is inside. How about regression from that—but how about looking into it for yourself?

HOLE AT THE POLE, SIR?

Dear Ray;

Thank you for starting my subscription to *Search* with the January issue. I have a lot of catching up to do, but I will stick to one subject per letter.

First, I just had to write you concerning your article in the July issue, "North Pole Hole Photographed". The most surprising thing to me, is, that you could have written it.

More information is needed (on photos) to determine their "truthfulness" in respect to "proof" of the 'hole in the pole theory'. (I am not questioning the theory, only the photographs themselves as proof of same.)

You imply, by omission, that the four photographs are each a single photograph, when in fact they must be composites. As I explained in my letter to *Forum*, which you printed in the April 1970 issue, pg. 19-20, one cannot see 180 degrees of a sphere, only approximately 150 degrees. As the area at the circumference of these photos show the equator, they cannot

have been taken directly over the pole as they appear to have been. Had they been, the North American continent would not be visible below Mexico, and it obviously is, the same goes for Asia (India). They were apparently taken from approximately 50-60 degrees North (South) Latitude. (Even motion pictures are composed of single frames).

The time they were taken. November 23, twenty-eight days prior to the winter solstice (Dec. 21) and January 6, sixteen days after same. (At North Cape, Norway, the sun does not rise above the horizon from approximately Nov. 20 to Jan. 24. See World Almanac.) The Jan. 6 photo has a dark area slightly larger than the Nov. 23 but both are approximately the Arctic Circle. I would guess that your 'hole' is due to the fact that, at that time of year, the sun's rays just do not reach that area at all.

At midnight, when there is no sunlight to be reflected from clouds or ice etc., there will be nothing to see. (Naturally, if there is nothing to reflect the light, nothing will be seen either.) But as the South Pole is brilliantly lit, as it would be at that time of year, and the northern dark area is approximately the Arctic Circle, I am suspicious.

It seems to me, that even ruling out the 'midnight' explanation, the very most that can be said of them, is, that they show some evidence of a huge

atmospheric vortex. similar to the 'eye' of a hurricane. (I cannot distinguish any surface characteristics with the dark area. Perhaps this is due to their being in black and white, if so, and you have them in color, suggest you reprint them on the cover in color.)

Citing Dr. Weber's 'discovery' as 'proof' bothers me also. It too is lacking in facts necessary to make a judgment of its value in this matter. *Exactly* where did he make this discovery? At the very spot the pole is supposed to be? If not, how near? The item as quoted does *not* say in what direction the 'tilt' is. You have assumed it is a downward slant toward the pole. Perhaps it is an incline rising toward the pole (or the lip of the 'hole'.) Maybe the polar area is not 'flattened' as scientists have assumed. Or, if flat, it may refer to its 'slant' confirming what was expected, or the ice pack was formed when the Earth's axial tilt was slightly different, thus showing up in a greater or lesser degree of 'tilt'. There just isn't enough information to understand exactly what Dr. Weber 'discovered' and what the implications are. I am, obviously, no expert on any subject. There are, I'm sure, many errors in my analysis of your 'evidence'. But with such obviously prosaic explanations possible, you can see why I find it difficult to believe that you could have neglected to allow for them in

your examination and presentation of the 'evidence'. I am aware you may have written the article somewhat 'tongue in cheek', or are prepared to overcome such simple explanations. I hope so. I would hate to think that you are capable of being so blinded by desire, so lacking in objectivity, that you overlook, ignore or omit pertinent facts (or the lack of them) to prove a theory. I have always had a very high regard for your mental capabilities which is why this apparent carelessness is so shocking to me.

● It would have been more surprising if I had NOT written anything about those photos of the polar area! I am sure you will realize that if you are a reader of *Flying Saucers* also, because it is really in this magazine that we are pursuing the "hole-in-the-pole" investigation. In the current issue, for example, we have two color photos of the north pole, and each one shows a hole, although not the very large "blacked out" area in the first photo we published.

I have had a lot of experience in publishing things like this. If I had published the photos in the current *Flying Saucers* first, I would have gotten no response at all. Readers would look at the photos, shrug, and forget them. But your reaction was

typical (to a photo that is outrageous!) and your response was one of outrage. All of the points you brought out and attributed to my being "blinded by desire", "lacking in objectivity", "tongue in cheek", etc., would actually be directed at the people who provided the photo!

However, all your objections are invalid, simply because they aren't true. One, I didn't imply the photos were a single photo. I do say that they are either 3 or 6 photos, taken moments apart, from a satellite that orbits the pole. I won't go into what would be involved if the photos were taken from 50-60 degrees north (south) latitude, as you state, except to venture an opinion that it would take literally months, or even years, of composites. And of course, this would hardly be of value in photographing cloud cover for purposes of weather prediction. Two, the "midnight" thing is also invalid, because the camera uses infra-red, and does not depend on sunlight. Three, the computerized "grid" is imposed on the photo, and shows the equator, even though it would not actually be visible (as you have pointed out). Four, the photo is retouched. Five, the reason there are no surface features visible at the pole is that they are blacked out; not by me, but by the people who furnished the photos. This is illogical, because it is important that the polar cloud cover be included, as our weather

really originates there. In about 50 other photos provided to me, this "blackout" does not occur, simply because the real area of a possible hole is covered by clouds in them, which automatically hide any surface features. It is only in photos where we might see something that there is tampering. In the new issue of *Flying Saucers*, we present a photo, together with an enlargement of the same to show the polar area close-up, with evidence that there is date tampering, so as to imply they are separate photos. You talk of "evidence" and you are "suspicious". So are we! Very suspicious of official photographs which show signs of tampering, subterfuge and deception. Why?

Why don't you wait until we present all our evidence before you accuse us of carelessness (or worse)? It might be a good idea for people interested in our "theory" to read *Flying Saucers*, where we intend to cover the thing to the final solution. The page size of *Search* is too small to give the pictorial coverage we need to make many of our points. In *Search*, for instance, we lost a lot of detail through reduction of the photos.—Rap.

HOLE AT THE POLE QUESTIONS

Dear Mr. Palmer,

You have a marvelous magazine. I was especially interested in the July

photos of the poles. I had read Dr. Bernard's book several years ago and have been looking for confirmation or evidence to refute his theory. The photo of No-pole is very convincing.

One question—your discussion about cloud cover leaves me perplexed.

Since the troposphere (where all weather changes occur—clouds, etc.) is a maximum of 4-5 miles thick at the poles (average is about 7 miles around the world and maximum of 10 miles at the equator) it would be impossible to see how more than a thin edge of white would show around the rim of the "hole". Such is the case with the photo taken 11/23/68 by ESSA-7. (pg. 4 July, 1970, *Search*)

I would love to see some photos *showing* the cloud cover over the North pole. If other ESSA photos do show cloud cover over the theoretical North hole I must say that the mystery deepens. I don't see how a North pole photo can show clouds (if the hole is there) since about 1570 miles of the hole diameter would be exosphere, ionosphere and mesosphere where no clouds exist. (If Bernards' configuration is correct.) (I have scaled the photo and it looks as if the "hole" is about 1590 miles in diameter—close to Dr. Bernard's figure.)

Another question—Does it look to you like a "sun" is shining in the center of the south pole region with

rays extending some distance? (1/6/67 ESSA-3) (pg. 10—July, 1970 Search). Would you consider printing several of the cloud cover photos for comparison? (If you have them!)

● Of course the “hole” isn’t as large as the blacked-out area in our original photo. The new photos we are publishing in our companion magazine (in color) both indicate by measurement that the hole is not more than 285 miles in diameter.

Your point on the height of the clouds is well taken. But there is evidence that it isn’t such an impossibility. For example, the Russians long ago made a point that gravity at the pole has some peculiarities that are hard to understand. If, for instance, it did not exist (they implied it didn’t! and even more, that there might be planets you could land on without retro-rockets simply because there was no gravity!) the atmosphere just might fill the hole without any stratum problems. It is also a fact that satellites launched into perfect geographic orbits have a propensity for not going into orbit at all. We wonder why, and so do some of the people at Vandenburg Base.

The trouble is, because we are kept so uninformed, we are subject to drawing assumptions which do not, or

seem not, to make sense. But we can’t refrain from making any suggestion simply because we might look foolish when it is proved to be ridiculous. So let’s accept that eventuality when it comes, with good grace. The points you brought up need answering, don’t they?—Rap.




