A scientist said yesterday he can tune in brain cells with weak microwaves, changing nerve chemistry and possibly altering behavior.

The results, the researcher said, may help lead to important new techniques for studying intimate details of body chemistry. They may also help show how much and what kinds of microwave radiation — a high-frequency form of radio waves — are safe.

In tests on both living cats and brain cells of chickens, using microwaves far below the intensity usually considered effective or potentially harmful to living organisms, the ability of vital calcium ions to bind to nerve cell membranes was dramatically altered, said Dr. W. Ross Adey.

He described his research at a session on microwaves during the meeting of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

The phenomenon could lead to a way to delicately alter brain chemistry, without drugs or surgery, using a technique whose effects appear to disappear soon after the microwaves are turned off, he said.

Adey, chief of research at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Loma Linda, San Bernardino County, said the relatively faint microwaves also seemed to change the mental state of cats, leaving them more wakeful and alert.

Whether the new findings reveal a public health hazard at microwave levels below those now considered safe, he said, will require more research to discover.

He found the effects only at certain combinations, or "windows," of microwave characteristics. He said the impact on brain cells — and some other body tissues — occurs only when specific ranges of microwave frequencies are combined with certain rates of variation in intensity, a process called amplitude modulation.

Do you recognise this syndicated Shaver Feature?? If you do, why not drop us a line and let us all know about it? Right now, the thing is shrouded in a fog, for not all of the material we receive here at Shavertron comes with a handy instruction sheet. We have a total of six "Record of Rocks" features to run for you. Apparently, they were meant to rival the likes of Ripley's "Believe it or not"....a la Shaver. So---we will start with the first installment, "Ancient Ufos" and work our way up to number six: "Ufo Traffic", until someone recognises it and lets us in on the story.

However, he said, powerful new military radars designed to detect missiles and aircraft over the horizon sometimes produce, within one half mile of the radar, radiation of the sort he used in his laboratory. Such radars include two mammoth Air Force "Pave Paws" devices, one now nearing completion at Beale Air Force Base near Marysville and another constructed at Otis Air Force Base in Massachusetts.

The giant radars, he said, are probably safe, "but we don't really know the effect of exposing nearby populations to very faint microwaves for extended periods, many years or more."

His research on chicken brain cells, he said, is well-known to the Air Force, which he said dismissed the results "in a very self-serving way," by arguing it doesn't apply to living mammals. Subsequent research on cats, he said, confirms the effect.

Adey's work seems to mean that profound biological effects may occur under some special circumstances, even when the electric fields created by microwaves are far smaller than natural electrical activity in the body.

Adey described the surfaces of nerve cells as covered with flexible, hair-like molecules, each carrying a negatively charged atom at its tip.

The effect, he said, is like a "field of corn, waving in an electric breeze."

"If we impose a field from the outside," he said, "we are really competing with the signals the brain makes in its own cells."

The organizer of the session, Dr. Don R. Justeson of the Kansas City Veterans Administration Medical Center, said Adey's work may mean "we are on the threshold of communicating directly with the cell."

S.M. CLUB LETTERZINE REPRINTS »»

(From time to time, we will be reprinting excerpts from the old Shaver Mystery Club Letterzine, which appeared circa 1950-1954. Based in Chicago, this zine was meant to help ISS get out from under the load of mail from fans).

1. Where is an entrance?

"There are hundreds of entrances traceable by the names of places and towns in the far past--such as the town in Italy called 'Intramend', which meant in the elder tongue-'train going in the termina.' This town has been renamed several times in the past centuries, but the ancient name was Intramend. It was a railroad town, thousands of years ago, where people took a train into the depths from the surface. Today, the entrance would require a lot of money and excavation to uncover, but it could be done at less expense than to drill an oil well. ...If the mysterious obstacles that rise before all such efforts did not defeat you. There is the well-known Mt. Shasta, the several quite well-known polished shafts going into the depths in South America (on government records, but now boarded up and forbidden)--there is the entrance described in the book 'Etidorpha' in Virginia. There are a great number of Indian place names which label spots where entrance to the lower world was once possible. All you need is to know the Elder Tongue Words such as IN, TRAM, and the fact that 'entrance' also means 'to go into a state of rapture', to 'carry away with ecstasy', is not an accident of coincidence but comes from the fact that an entrance into the caverns was to be carried into the rapture of the use of the elder machines for producing pleasure. The Indian names can be decoded by a study of the elder phonetic meanings and will reveal a number of possible entrances to any sincere and intelligent person who really goes about the problem industriously and inductively. Yes, they are closed over with earth and rock, many of them impossible to all but titanic excavating efforts, or they have been walled up, by those who conceal the caverns from us, and would be uncovered by the judicious use of a few sticks of dynamite.

Rich Shaver was wise in the ways of the world, and through his vast amount of experience and research into various topics, had gathered a large body of information. He used this info to help out many of the people who came to him for advice. This column aims to pass on some of that info, in the hope that it will prove to be of use to others.

[GETTING RID OF BRAIN FEVER]

"Remember what I said about brain fever...the right remedy is a long, long cold shower ... I have seen this often.. and so have you in the bughouse they cold pack you for it..doused with ice water and wrapped in blankets to keep cold.

"When you get so wound up on something..take your temp. and a good cold shower and see if it seems so reasonable.

"Just soaking your head in a bowl of cold water helps. This is a common ailment in the Pentagon, u no.

"They should all go soak their heads before they get us into some more impossible wars.

"this sounds funny but it really aint... it is a common ailment like the common cold but people dont happen to know it.

"Hotheads... are just exactly that if you took their temp."

2. How can I get in?

"You can't without a lot of effort, and if you did the chances are a thousand to one you would not come out alive. This is understood by anyone who reads Shaver."

3. What equipment do I need for such an attempt?

"Foolhardy courage, suicidal tendencies, alot of money, several hard-headed frinds who have worked in mines and black damp, and no delusions about bringing back anything, even if you're lucky. L. Tayler Hansen found a polished shaft in Arizona but black damp kept him out. He got equipment, helmet and oxygen flasks, etc...and that was two years ago. If he came back he hasn't mentioned the fact yet. But this is the second time he has disappeared for long periods. It is two years now.

4. How do you hear voices?

"Subject yourself to variant high frequency currents-- the magnetic fields surrounding high voltage--I think that what happens is the concentrated flows of electrons (or are they magnetrons in the fields around a wire) strips off the natural insulation around the nerves connecting the brains thought centers. The brain is able to receive from its parts the natural thought waves and actual electric flows which make up all thought. It is a natural receiver of all thought energies, able to read and interpret the most abstract thought...and it has been protected from outside disruptive energies by a natural sheathing of highly effective insulation. This is perforated by high velocity particles, so that the energies around, such as those that are borne upon the natural conducting medium like that surrounding all current-bearing electric wires brings you to recognisable thought messages from outside your mind. Normally these would be screened out, kept out by the normal insulative sheathing of the mind, but after subjection to certain kinds of powerful magnetic fields, such as those encountered in welding work, other electric work, one becomes sensitized by the destruction of this protection, and one hears voices. This

first sensitivity is the greatest, the confused mind, receiving from everywhere all kinds of alien energies and unfamiliar thought, soon erects other greater barriers (just as scar tissue forms around a wound) and one becomes impervious to telepathic communication. But once having experienced the astounding phenomena of telepathy in all its complexity, one never again doubts the existence of powerful groups who have mastered the use of mechanical and/or electrical telepathy and use it for their own purposes. (Such devices do not operate with ordinary electricity but with a flow skin to the neural electric generated by the human body.)"

5. How do you know you're not crazy if you hear voices??

"The idea that 'hearing voices is an insene thing' entirely

Very few rocks have large, plain pictures in or on them. Maybe they are just plain worn out from extreme old age. And yet, because of the sheer number of rocks all over the world, there are still thousands upon thousands of rockfogs images one can find. Most are weak or difficult to perceive.

One way to restore some contrast is to look at rocks reflected in a common magnifying glass-negative magnification. A fairly bright light is needed and a dim or dark background. If some rocks are held so that the surface has shadows cast across them, many images become plain.

EASY WAYS TO SEE ROCK IMAGES / BY BILL BLISS

Making rubbings with carbon paper and thin paper will coax images out of the most uncooperative rock. Remember, the majority of rock images are small, so a hand-held magnifier with a power of 10X to 40X (or a low power microscope) will make a large number of images visible.

If you have luck with prospecting, you might find some excellent examples--like the common fine grain conglomerates. The best of those have dark blue or black or dark brown inclusions and crystals in a light-colored matrix.

If you find small, colored dots, (usually blue, green or yellow) those are index marks for the picture frames. Since almost all (the exceptions are rare) rock book images are actually SYSTEMS of images, once you have zeroed in on one, give it 1/4 turns and more images will appear. Viewing the image at different angles from the line of sight often brings out an uncanny 3 dimensional effect. And sometimes the scene changes to an aerial view.

sourcing in self deception due to disordered mind arose when electricity itself was not discovered, and is today exploded except for those who still believe the modern age is the only time when people knew anything worth knowing. Such acts as Dunninger's are public demonstrations of the 'natural ability' to read others thought. Telepathy is another word for 'hearing voices'.
6. What connection do flying saucers have with the Caverns???

"Every connection. They transport earth goods, bring other goods from other planets, trade with the caverns, are the flying force of the cavern people, and also the ships from other planets. We will hear alot more of the flying saucers before we hear less. They are the conveyances of our actual rulers, who prefer to keep their ex-

istance a kind of open secret. Most of our reel big shots have some contact with the power behind the flying saucers."

7. How have the alleged machines of the Caverns work???

"Most of the cavern machines have been wrecked in the past by ignorant mishandling, which still occurs too widely today. They are used to manipulating earth surfacemen's affairs to the advantage of groups of people in whom we 'do not believe'."

Rock images also have what is known as the "consolidating image effect". In other words, at different viewing distances, different images are seen. This usually works well with rocks over two inches wide. The distance where the images change is commonly based on a factor of 2.

Framing can be vital in perceiving an image, so try masking off various areas, as Shaver discovered early on. Also, slow vision is very useful in perceiving dim, obscure images. It works best when there are few or no distractions. Medium or dim light helps. Slow vision also requires long minutes of concentration, repeatedly looking back on your work.

Rock images also come in extra large sizes, so photos of various mountain terrains are a good place to look for them. There is an exceptionally good one of these on page 514 of the October, 1979 issue of the National Geographic Magazine. The images are small, so looking at them through a 1/16" hole in a piece of cardboard, scanning small areas, brings them out alot plainer.

Large rock images also turn up in photos of Mars or the moon. Shaver regarded the moon as the handiest large rock pic. Both Shaver and the author have taken many rock photos, but they are not generally available except through the book, The Secret World. In a future issue of SHAVERTON there will be an article on taking rock pix yourself. It will include common close-up techniques used on a few dozen common rocks (conglomerates are preferable).

He wants to send Earth into new orbit

William E. Peterson has a bizarre plan for preventing the super cold winters we've been getting.

A 48-year-old engineer from Seattle, Wash., he wants to turn Earth into a spaceship and blast it into orbit nearer the sun.

To get a rocket engine powerful enough, Peterson has designed a "nuclear cannon" to be built in the Mojave Desert of the southwest.

As fantastic as all this sounds, Peterson says there will be incredible benefits. For example:

- Temperatures will average 5 degrees warmer all over Earth.
- The ozone layer which pro-

TECTS Earth from harmful sun rays will be increased as a result of the "cloud canopy" effect of the cannon.

• Deserts will be transformed into gardens due to increased rainfall from the "cloud canopy."

The nuclear cannon is patterned after the Great Pyramid of Egypt. (Peterson believes the pyramids were originally nuclear cannons built in ancient times by an advanced race.)

It will be 450 feet tall and have an eight-foot-diameter shaft aimed at the North Star. A nuclear fission explosion of one megaton will be shot through the cannon each day for a year.

One megaton is equal to the explosion of one million tons of dynamite.

Those daily blasts should be enough, Peterson believes, to change the Earth's orbit and rotation and offset the ice age some scientists predict.

The heat from the explosion will be absorbed by the stone cannon. Peterson then plans to shower tremendous amounts of water onto the cannon. The water will evaporate filling the skies with a canopy of clouds.

The clouds will pour rain onto deserts and will add to the protective ozone layer because ozone is formed when sun rays hit clouds: 12-4-79

Mystery Man Flies in Box To Seattle

It looked like just another air-freight shipment until a man popped out of a box, saying, "Let me out of here," and ran away before he could be questioned, Port of Seattle police said.

According to Jim Whittom, a spokesman for the Port of Seattle police, Northwest Airlines employees were unloading a large metal container yesterday that had arrived on a DC-10 from Anchorage, Alaska.

A man carrying a small canvas bag emerged from a four-foot square plywood box inside the container and ran out of the building before the workers could stop him, Whittom said.

The man would have had to spend at least 11 hours in the box, including 4½ hours in the pressurized cargo plane, said Whittom.

"The reason for the man's actions are unknown, since the cost of the heavy box, plus the man's weight and personal possessions, ran almost double what a comfortable seat in the coach area of the aircraft would have cost," he said.

"Incredible as it sounds, there are a number of cases of people simply vanishing into thin air," British author Paul Begg told The ENQUIRER.

Begg, who has documented dozens of these mysterious disappearances in his book "Into Thin Air," says dozens of people "simply puff out of existence" every year — and have done so for centuries.

"One of the best-known cases happened in England in the last century," he said. "One day in 1873 a health fanatic named James Worson accepted a wager from three of his friends that he could not run to the town of Coventry and back, a distance of 16 miles.

"Worson set out to win his bet and his friends climbed into a cart and followed him to make sure he kept the terms of the wager.

"For several miles, Worson jogged ahead of the cart when all of a sudden he appeared to stumble over some unseen object.

"He tripped, cried out and vanished."

Worson's friends could not believe their eyes, but an exhaustive search of the area confirmed what seemed impossible.

Worson had vanished into thin air.

In another baffling case, an early 19th-century British diplomat, Benjamin Bath-

urst, disappeared while on a mission abroad.

"He stopped at an inn, rested for a while and shortly before 9 p.m. made preparations to continue his journey," said Begg.

"In front of witnesses he looked over his horses and walked behind his carriage. Then he vanished."

A more recent case involved Jackson Wright, who stopped his car in New York's Lincoln Tunnel one winter day in 1975 to clear snow from the windshield. His wife Martha began clearing the rear window but seconds later, when Jackson looked up, she had disappeared.

A series of unexplainable disappearances which occurred between 1945 and 1950 continue to baffle authorities. During that period, seven people vanished while hiking along an eight-mile stretch of a well-known Vermont trail.

Bloodhounds traced one small boy's scent for miles, then lost it in exactly the same spot where another vanishing hiker was last seen.

Only one of the hikers was ever found. Her body was located in a spot that search parties had combed thoroughly when she'd disappeared months earlier. The woman, Frieda Langer, was an experienced hiker and was familiar with the trail. No evidence of murder was ever uncovered in any of the Vermont disappearances.

"It gives rise to the chilling thought that some mysterious force took Frieda, then returned her body when it had no further need of it," Begg said.

Begg doubts that the several dozen unexplainable disappearances which occur each year involve people who are purposely hiding.

"You will be found eventually if somebody loves you or hates you enough to persist with the search," he said.

"These cases are evidence that some force is at work which defies a rational explanation."
