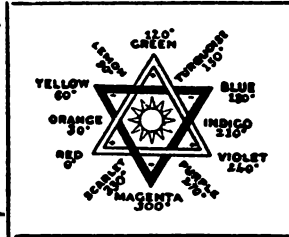

Spectro-Chrome Institute Fights For Its Life

Dear Doctor Copeland:

1. Knowing you to be the sponsor of THE TUGWELL COPELAND BILL, I desire to register my most emphatic protest against the injustice and gross absurdity of one special clause in that Bill.
2. I allude to the inclusion of "Devices for the treatment or prevention of diseases" within the meaning of the word "Drug".
3. Fifteen years ago, when you were the Honorary President of the Allied Medical Associations Of America, I had the honor to be the Vice-President and I knew of you as a high minded Homeopath.
4. However, it appears that during the last few years, your attitude toward medicine has been such as to give an exclusive monopoly of the art of healing to the Allopathic School, about which the less I say the better.
5. Inclosed please find the views of my Corporation in regard to the TUGWELL BILL, at Page 1056.

6. For and behalf of my Corporation, as the Originator and Manufacturer of Spectro-Chrome, I hereby register an emphatic protest against the gross injustice of the specific inclusion of a "Device" for health within the meaning of "Drug."

Dear Doctor Copeland:

1. I thank you for your kind communication of January 27, 1934 in which you state that you are "interested to learn your point of view".
2. My point of view about the Tugwell-Copeland Bill is clearly indicated on Pages 1056, 1057, and 1058 of the February 1934 issue of Spectro-Chrome, a copy of which you already have.
3. Whatever the aim of the Bill may be, it is plain that a Food and Drug Bill should be restricted technically to the giving to the people pure and unadulterated Foods and if they wish to have Drugs, to give them unadulterated Drugs.
4. It is well known that food, as now sold all over the Country, is a concoction of so many admixtures that the consumer does not know what he is buying.
5. In the same manner the buyer of Drugs, whether Medical Doctor or otherwise, who is interested in buying Drugs, expects the Drugs he prescribes and from which he expects certain definite results, should reach the sufferer in exactly the form in which they are prescribed.

6. I practised Medicine for a long number of years in India, but since settling in this Country 23 years ago, left the Medical line as notoriously empirical. However, that is not the point at issue.

7. The Medical Doctor and the Public must get whatever they want in exactly the form they want and not adulterated with undesirable material. Thus far you may take your Tugwell-Copeland Bill; it would be legal.

8. However, when you endeavor to put into the definition of Drugs "Devices intended for use in the cure, mitigation, treatment or prevention of disease", it certainly is a perversion of the Lexicon and a mockery of paraphrasing. The reason for this is self-evident.

9. A Device is a contrivance, mechanical, electrical or otherwise and to call it a Drug is enough to bring a loud laughter on the face of even a brass monkey.

10. You enjoy great respect among the Public and are noted for your intelligent views on medical subjects; therefore, I believe you should clarify the Bill by applying it to where it belongs, viz. Food and Drugs and not produce a mockery of Law by having a "Device" dragged therein as a "Drug".

11. There is another phase of this Bill of yours which defines Advertisement.

12. I am the owner of numerous Patents on a number of Devices used for "the mitigation, treatment or prevention of disease." These Patents issued by the Government of the United States of America are valid for 17 years from the date of issue. These patents give me the exclusive right to make and vend these inventions; as such these Patents are contracts between the People of the United States of America and myself.

13. Now, Mr. Rexford Tugwell and you come forward with this Bill, as protectors of the purity of Foods and Drugs and therein insert an advertisement clause which would prevent me from advertising my Equipments.

14. As this would invalidate either my Patent or the Bill, whichever way it operates, I request and appeal to your intelligence to remove such a nonsensical restriction from your otherwise well aimed Bill.

15. Surely you do not intend that the brain of the inventor should be deadlocked by stopping the sale of his brain-children—his inventions upon which the welfare of the World depends.

16. I enclose some literature about my activities and inventions, a glance at which will show to you that you will be ruining the welfare of many a sick person, if your Bill be passed without due purgation.

17. I have a fully equipped research laboratory and manufacturing Plant standing on an estate of over 23 acres, giving free service to suffering mankind through the use of my System—Spectro-Chrome Metry.

18. I wrote and published some time ago a Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia, giving complete details of this new and original Healing Science for the use of those who would like to study it.

19. I shall be delighted to present you with a copy of it, so you may look deeper into the subject, if you so care.

20. I submit that the Tugwell-Copeland Bill will only benefit the Allopathic School, which always aimed at maiming or killing its opponents of all other schools of Healing.

21. Surely as a prominent Homeopath, whose name at one time graced the Flower Hospital of New York, New York, you will not be an involuntary tool in the hands of the Allopaths, who at one time persecuted even the great Hahnemann.

That letter too was not acknowledged. It went at the time the President was celebrating his birthday, so it is likely his numerous secretaries might not have thought it wise to disturb his mental quietude. Furthermore, we are not Democrats and are opponents of intoxicating drinks, therefore, naturally not entitled to voice under Democrat regime. We may say that we are not even Republicans, because, whether it be one party or another, politics ever has the same earmarks. Our President inaugurated new political theories of Constitutional Government and because of the Depression, everybody sits still and watches. They have a long watch!

But, we are concerned only in the ultimate result of this Tugwell Bill. A recent Associated Press dispatch says thus:—

Copeland To Push His Food-Drug Bill

WASHINGTON, FEB. 9 (AP).—The Copeland-Tugwell food, drugs and cosmetics bill was approved in a modified form today by the Senate Commerce subcommittee which has been studying it several months.

Senator Copeland (D., N. Y.), physician-author of the bill, said it now was satisfactory to President Roosevelt and has been approved by the Agriculture Department. He announced he would ask for action on it by the full committee next week in order to get Senate approval this session.

“We took some of the controversial issues on which Professor Tugwell and I did not agree to the President and made him referee,” Copeland said.

* * *

It were better if the Honorable Senator had published what were the “controversial issues” on which the Tug-Of-War existed. The President would be a good referee with his level head, yet, why should this oldtime, clumsy procedure of Committees, Subcommittees and similar Shuttlecock and Battledore methods still continue in our politics instead of open handed business-like systems? Politics, as it goes all over the World, is abominably corrupt and our noble ideals mentioned in the Constitution—Liberty, Property, Security, Right Of Contract and similar wonders as look good on paper and in talk, are slowly becoming completely scattered.

We are steadily and surely heading toward either a new Monarchy, Anarchy, Economical Revolution or it seems clearly for a minimum, an imperious, autocratic dictatorship.

We are for the Constitution as laid down in the basis of our Government—we are opposed to what is made today, a gutta-percha interpretation of that Magna Carta; our bulwark of Liberty is broken by the judicial decisions so frequently handed to litigants within the meaning of our Constitution, suitable to the views of some party or other wire puller. The public is hoodwinked and bamboozled at every step and suffers and groans. While the people howl, the politician grins; boss rule rules the land.

Such a Bill as this Tugwell Bill, if it should pass unexpurgated, would be a mockery of our Constitution. The idiocy of including "Devices" within the meaning of "Drugs" is so glaring, that we are aghast at the brazen attempt made by the sponsors to palm off such an absurdity on a confiding public. We should like to know what relation even "Foods" have with "Drugs" and what earthly, heavenly or reverse relation is there with "Devices." To try and grab power and means of throat-squeezing at every step, so as to convert a Free Nation again into serfdom and to reduce a Republic to autocratic, dictatorial subjugation is unthinkable to our all-American mind, trained to consider humanity from the broadest standpoint of service, equity, fairness and justice.

We say—we openly say—our mind revolts at the very idea of foisting upon a helpless suffering public the rotten allopathic system of so-called Medicine. We resent, as nothing else can make us, the very conception of forcing us—Free-Born Humans—to accept what our education, training, study and knowledge directs as the wrong path—the placing us under the domination of a fraternity whose methods are notoriously crafty, grafty, in fact utterly cruel and worthless. We refuse as students of Spectro-Chrome Metry, to submit our homes, our children, our lives into the hands of this accursed hierarchy of pox-punchers, toxin-makers, serum-pokers, at best the nihilists of what we gained as purity of our blood by years of consecration to clean life.

What knowledge does a Secretary Of Agriculture have about health matters? What will he do with the Bill as proposed, if he were clothed with all those powers? He could do nothing without extraneous advice; that advice he will get solely from the Medical Octopus, that Gorgonic Hydra, whose ramificatory activities he never will comprehend, until he goes through the mill as we went.

We appeal to the highminded American—the real honest-to-goodness American who values the purity of his blood, babies and home, to present an ironclad front to the Tugwell Bill by sending protests to the authorities, with the view of showing them your opinion of their crack-minded activities. Under the assumption of our Constitution, our appointed congressmen were supposed to be acting for us, but, it would appear as if our own appointees became our oppressors. The Congress which once was supposed to be the controller of the country's policy, became just an automaton, a robot, a mere mechanical party tool and instead of being our servant became nothing more than a buckpasser. Its power of determining the issues is in abey-

ance, its independence is paralyzed, its movements are languid and crippled, its real authority is gradually seeping into the hands of a self-willed President, who dictates the tune to which these Marionettes dance. O what a degradation is being brought upon us who are striving at all sacrifices, to serve suffering mankind whose hands are outstretched for help which the poison-vending Medical Doctors never could give!

We must join efforts to quench this terrible Tugwell Bill. If that clause of "Devices" are "Drugs" stays in it, we must **never** submit to it; we claim our right—our birthright—as thinking souls and Servants Of Mankind, to serve the suffering as best our conscience dictates, Congress, Tugwell-Copeland Bill, President or the whole Medical Deviltry joined together to the contrary. It strikes at the Fundamentals of our national freedom—our liberty to choose our own healing system. The day of dictation for the American Medical Association is passed; its power and prestige is crumbling by the momentum of its own ghoulish and tyrannical acts. The public must learn that the Medical Doctor of today, is nothing but an individual operating under the garb of humanity and mercy, yet really a professional money-maker, who from the beginning of his career is under the supervision and domination of that most nefarious Trust the human brain ever created.

Hold up the banner of the American Constitution! Voice for upholding our human birthrights and down with the Medical Interference, Autocracy and Imperialistic Dictation. Stand firm for your rights and bow not to these insidious Medical Charlatans, who for 6,000 years have been poisoning the human race with worthless, unscientific, empirical concoctions just the same as in those days they were using the witch cauldron.

Albert Greenham was called upon next and he read from one of the past SPECTRO-CHROME magazines, Volume 4, No. 5, May 1925, an article entitled "Advantages of Healing by Spectro-Chrome Therapy." During the course of discussion he laid great emphasis on the strict adherence to the Rational Food Of Man System, as outlined by Dinshah. All the members enjoyed his remarks.

This, she refused to have done. She heard about Spectro-Chrome through Arnold and after tonations for one month, she experienced greater relief from pain than she had in the past 10 years.

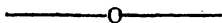

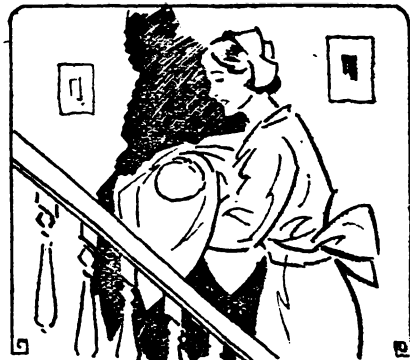

Dear Colonel:

I received your letter of February 14th and I hope you will be successful in fighting your case in the Supreme Court. You remember the long and nice conversation we had in your place a few weeks ago, and at which time we were talking about the big business men trying to suppress the small business people under the cover of the NRA. You were right and here's what happened to us: A bunch of large manufacturers got together about six months ago—went to Washington and with the help of good lawyers, etc. worked out a scheme by which under the flag of NRA they would just eventually eliminate the dealers—so they will have the road free to sell the printers new machinery at their high prices. Never mind the printer who, like you, was satisfied to buy good used machines for about half price and could not afford to buy new machines. Never mind the dealers as long as they can live and prosper and make the millions again, as before the depression set in. Well people with money and influence always find ways and they actually succeeded. They worked hard and put up a Code and had it cooked up nicely and well done. And it was finally adopted and signed by General Johnson.

Without even consulting us dealers, we suddenly find that we are in it and that the signed Code not only covers the manufacturers but also all of us dealers. No questions asked. The Code Authority to which we have to submit consists of seven members and mind you,

all manufacturers, not one dealer. According to such Code they are establishing their own Clearance Corporation for the disposal of used machinery and they expect us to sign that—our own death warrant. In other words, we should be put out of business, which by and by they will take over and they have even the kindness in providing the undertaker and flowers, by establishing the Clearance Corporation. Besides that, we are to send lists of all the used machinery we have for sale, giving prices and all other data—so they would have a guide and know all about how to sell used machinery. Of course, it is set forth in different words, but that is the essence of its meaning.

Well I could tell you more about it, but I shall talk to you when I see you, which I hope will be soon. One thing is sure, that scarcely any dealer will sign such a Code—unless forced to do so under valuable pressure. That is how things go and that is how the well-meant NRA is being shamefully abused.

I am only glad that I sold you the Linotype Machine and Dexter Folder at a time when I could meet your own reasonable terms and it was at a time when my selling was not directed by hypocrites.
