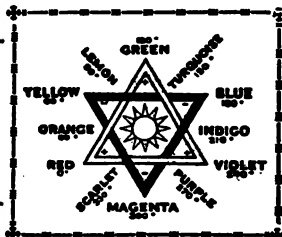

Meeting Of Thursday, September 5, 1935

Successful Use Of Spectro-Chrome In:—Hip Stiffness, Skin Disorder, Fever, Cold.

Martha S. told of how her hip had been stiff and black and blue, from moving some furniture. She tonated with Blue and the following day used Red and was entirely normalated.

Robert H. told of normalating a Skin Disorder in the form of an eruption over the eye. The Sufferer had consulted a Medical Doctor who said he did not know what it was, but on his advice the Tonsils were removed! This did not give results and on learning of Spectro-Chrome, she came to Robert H. Green, Lemon, Orange and Magenta were used and later Turquoise.

L. Roy D. told of a child who developed a Temperature. A Medical Doctor was called, but, she did not improve. Her Kardoscil was 160, Spiroscil 140 (?), Temperature 104.6. After the first Tonation of Blue, the Temperature dropped to 103 Degrees. After the second Tonation of Blue, it went below normal. Red was then given for 2 Tonations and the child was entirely normalated.

Otto H. told of a baby who had been cross, irritable and sleepless for some time. It fell asleep during the Tonation and was all right afterwards. The mother who had a very bad Cold also felt very much better after one Tonation of Turquoise.

Henry S. was again present in his wheelchair. He is gaining steadily and now weighs 152 pounds, a gain of 7 pounds in 1 month. From being a helpless cripple 4 months ago, he is now able to feed himself and do many things with greater ease than a month ago.

A Member asked for discussion on Hay Fever. Her husband had not the results he had hoped for in this trouble, although he was much improved in other respects.

John W. asked for a discussion on Kardoscil and Spiroscil Ratio.

Philip M. read the first two chapters of the Third Volume of Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia, on "Intricate Motion Mechanism" and Purgation, Pills, Potions And Pumps". Discussion followed.

Albert E. Greenham told of his visit to Malaga, New Jersey and of the perfecting of an unbreakable Slide which will be a boon to Spectro-Chrome. He advised all the Members to read the Constitution And Rules and to adhere strictly to them.



That report about Kardoscil being 160, Spiroscil 140, seems erroneous. A Ratio of practically 1 to 1 is not possible to normalate in 2 Tonations of Blue, even if Life should hold.

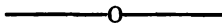
Sleep is the best normalator in cases of such character. During Tonation, if a Sufferer should slumber, there should be no attempt made at awakening.

The Affiliate whose husband has Hay Fever, should ask for the Free Guidance. Wherever there is an apparent failure, there is some reason and the General Advice Chart promptly will disclose it.

For Kardoscil and Spiroscil Ratio information, refer to Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia, Volume 3, Chapter 109, Page 1135, Paragraph 9.

Meeting Of Thursday, October 3, 1935

Successful Use Of Spectro-Chrome In:—Eye Tumor, Pneumonia, Cold, Intestinal Disorder, Nasal Growth.

Deputy Greeta O. Peck affirmed the new Officers of the First Detroit Michigan Planet—Sub-Deputy Stella Harter and Recorder Edwin W. Lemke. The Planet Commission is now complete.

Albert G. told of tonating a Tumor on the Retina of the Eye. Before Spectro-Chrome was used, the Medical Doctor, the Eye Specialist and Drugs were employed. Within 8 days of Tonation the

Kardoscil was raised from 50 to 70, with Scarlet on Area 4. A dark ball appeared in front of the Sufferer's Eye and now it has become light in color and greatly reduced. He again stressed the importance of the Kardoscil-Spiroscil Ratio and used this man's case to clear his point.

Ervin F. B. reported the case of his wife who was deathly sick with Pneumonia. Ratio was $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 1. Kardoscil reached 120, Spiroscil in the 30's. Constipation also was present, for which Yellow was used. Fever responded to Blue with Magenta on Area 4. Blue produced Sweat, day after Low Critical Period and improvement soon followed. Imbalance is being rapidly removed.

Henry S., once referred as the "Helpless Wheel Chair Cripple", is not so helpless any longer. He has developed quite a vicious kick. Says he, "Two Tonations a day, with the Rational Food Of Man and I will walk by Christmas."

Aquila M. then stated, that for the past three years he adhered strictly to the Rational Food Of Man and should he miss, he soon feels the effects. He did not lose a day's work in three years, which could not be said of the preceding years.

This caused a discussion on Foods. Spectro-Chrome Home Guide was then read to show what quantity and in what combinations of Foods, the Rational Food Of Man consists. A lively discussion followed on whether Rice and Peas should be cooked separately. It was agreed that no more than enough was to be cooked for each meal. Raw Foods have higher Food Value than cooked.

Albert E. Greenham then described a typical "Colonel Dinshah table", as he experienced during his recent visit to the Central Office.

L. Roy D. explained that the Aura of different Foods is different and the mixing of chemicals is not proper.

E. W. L. spoke of his wife's Head Cold and the correction of the Imbalance. Turquoise Systemic followed 2 Hours 56 Minutes by Magenta on Area 4. Redness around Eyes and Nose was practically gone by morning and the Nasal Discharges also ceased. She is now convinced that Spectro-Chrome is an exact Science and will soon be with us.

Stella H. reported Intestinal Disorder in the case of a Sufferer with a nervous condition. Red helped.

Albert Greenham explained how the female Kardoscil responds to the Scarlet, expelling Dizziness.

L. Roy D. contended that Dizziness may be due to Low or High Blood Pressure.

The Recorder read Chapter 81 on "Paralysis And Motor Disorders" and Chapter 82 on "Spectro-Chrome In Paralysis", from Volume 3 of Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia.

Our new Affiliate Rose C. told of Pus Sores around the Chin and Cheeks of her nephew. Three Tonations of Green normalated them.

Otto H. removed a Nasal Growth with Turquoise; both Nostrils are now open.



There is more in the connection of the Kardoscil with the Spiroscil than most students imagine. It is the key to the Vital Vehicle, the Third Vehicle upon which rests the activities of the Prana. As long as that is correct, the Sufferer has every opportunity for recovery. Please, pay attention to this essential point during Tonation.

Ervin F. B. ought to be more explicit in asking for the Free Guidance. He telegraphed one night and as the Western Union offices were closed in Malaga, Newfield and Vineland, New Jersey, the Camden New Jersey office telephoned us from 30 miles away, asking our Central Office to pay for the telephone charge, which we declined, because, all such expenses must be prepaid by the sender. The telegraph operator in Camden insisted that it was important, but, our switchboard operator refused to receive the message saying it should come to us next morning through the usual channel. Then, the telephonic message was delivered us after asking the other end. The message merely said the "wife was low, Kardoscil 128, Spiroscil 46, Frontelim Good, Back Bad!" The signature was Mister B," with an address quite different from what was on the Register. We wired that the case was dangerous and requested him to talk on the Long Distance Telephone for full information. Close to midnight B. telephoned, but, could give no complete history of the case, so we asked him to mail a General Advice Chart. He agreed to do so, but never did and this is the first inkling we received from him about the recovery of the said Sufferer.

We appeal to the intelligence of our Affiliates in regard to such negligence. "Mr. B.", is not the full identification of the Registered Purchaser especially when even the address is different. Again, consider our situation of giving Free Guidance in a dying case, where the Kardoscil and Spiroscil indicate "Danger". On what grounds may

we be enabled to know what is happening to the Sufferer at a distance and how does the seeker of the Free Guidance believe we could satisfy his requirement, unless he expected us to perform "Psychical Phenomena"? It is clearly stated in Spectro-Chrome Home Guide, page 89, that we MUST have certain information in detail, without which we can not give Free Guidance. Though we receive blame after blame for our hard Rules and severe methods, it is plain that our worthy Affiliates do not realize that with all what they say, it is nothing short of a marvel that WITHOUT SEEING OR PERSONALLY EXAMINING A SUFFERER, the Originator made it possible for them to obtain FREE GUIDANCE FOR LIFE and produce the precise results for which Spectro-Chrome is so justly famed.

Henry S. is to be congratulated. With his persistence, he should recover his equilibrium.

Discussion on Food always is very amusing. The tastes of people are so perverted by thousands of years of wrong living, that it is difficult to make them comprehend what constitutes genuine Food. The Medical Doctors classify even Alcohol as a "Food"! Rice and Peas cook at different temperatures, hence, unless a person is a cooking expert, there will be a "gruel" instead of an appetizing meal, if cooked together.

E. M. L. was right in attending to the Favorscope.

Dizziness essentially is the result of Cerebral Circulatory defect and may be produced either way—by more Blood or less Blood. Refer to Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia, Volume 2, Page 652, under "Hot And Cold Sunstrokes". The same principle applies and the Kardoscil will show what is in progress.

You will have ample opportunity for solving your questions, when the Originator visits your city and holds two meetings on the 14th and 15th current, respectively.

EXPULSION OF LUCILLE J. McGRAW

Lucille J. McGraw, a Provisional Member of First Milwaukee Wisconsin Planet, Secretary to E. A. Ernest, was requested by the Board Of Trustees on August 27, 1935, to resign voluntarily, which she declined by a letter of August 29, 1935.

On August 31, 1935, the President ordered her name to be placed on the List Of Suspended Affiliates and she was again requested to resign voluntarily and surrender her Affiliation Card.

tees, on September 11, 1935, in a **Final Warning**, that she being affiliated with an Expelled Member whose Company was declared under Rule 42, Section 3, as an "Antagonistic Organization," unless she acted promptly by tendering a Voluntary Resignation, she was liable to be cited for Summary Investigation under Rule 87, Section 1.

To this she replied on September 12, 1935, asserting her alleged "rights" to sell Spectro-Chrome after "Graduation" and the like.

A Final Supplementary Warning was issued by the Board Of Trustees, on September 14, 1935, explaining fully the Rules and again requesting her Voluntary Resignation to save a situation that might be very unpleasant for her.

After due waiting, she was cited for Summary Investigation because of non-compliance, on September 25, 1935. The Charges against her were as follows:—

(1) Violation of Rule 42, Section 3, because of her affiliation with Ernest Distributing Company, adjudged by the Board Of Trustees as an "Antagonistic Organization".

(2) Violation of Rule 43, Section 7, for refusing to surrender the Affiliation Card, on demand after Suspension.

(3) Violation of Code Of Honor, Rule 22, by knowing of the Violations of Edward A. Ernest, conniving at them and not reporting him to the Principal Office.

(4) Violation of Rule 88, by conspiring to sell a Used Equipment, previously sold to Charles Follett, later repossessed by Ernest Distributing Company and resold to Walter Sutter, her signature appearing in connection therewith as the person receiving the money, \$21.25 to account, on March 29, 1935.

(5) Violation of Rule 81, Section 17, in holding the Full Power Of Attorney for Edward A. Ernest, knowing that he was defrauding the public by selling repossessed Spectro-Chromes and then allowing the unused Registration Of Purchaser Blanks to go to the Central Office of Spectro-Chrome Institute, for issue of Bills Of Sale as new.

She replied to the Charges as follows:—

(1) That she "performed menial services for the company in the way of typing" and the like.

(2) That she did not know "why a Suspension should exist at all", so she refused to surrender the Affiliation Card.

(3) That she did not connive at any Violation, because she did "not know of any Violations committed by him".

(4) That she denied any Conspiracy, as "There was no such Conspiracy nor was there any deceit in any sale, that I was aware of."

(5) That she denied "any knowledge that Mr. Ernest was guilty of defrauding anybody as you set forth in paragraph No. 5."

She asked for a hearing before the First Milwaukee Wisconsin Planet, challenged the right of the President about the Summary Investigation and the like in depriving her of her "rights" and finally stated that her letter was "written in a perfectly friendly way."

To this, the Secretary replied by "Order Of The President", on October 4, 1935, that in a Summary Investigation, the President was the sole Judge under the Rules, that she was not working for E. A. Ernest in "menial services", but as "Private Secretary", according to his own Bulletin of September 16, 1935, that she was aware of his transactions, because all his letters bore her identification initials, that his transactions being fully published, were known to her, that she was adjudged as involved with him by "activities interlocked". Again under Rule 15, she was written that "we INVITE YOU TO RESIGN VOLUNTARILY," otherwise further action would be taken "in accordance with the Rules regulating such refusal of silence."

On October 7, 1935, she declared the procedure "not legal", asked for hearing before the First Milwaukee Wisconsin Planet, stating further that all was "an infringement on my rights which I propose to protect promptly and speedily."

On Wednesday, October 9, 1935, the President Dinshah P. Ghadiali ordered her Expulsion with forfeiture of all rights, titles and privileges, under Rule 87 and the Secretary Irene Grace Dinshah informed her about it, adding that she could under Rule 87, Section 3, appeal within 28 days to the Board Of Trustees against the Decision of the President.

Upto the time of going to the Press, no such Appeal was filed.

REVOCATION OF FREE STUDENTSHIP

Spectro-Chrome Institute having adjudged Lucille J. McGraw, "an undesirable student in Spectro-Chrome Metry", revoked on Wednesday, October 9, 1935, the Free Studentship, which was granted to her as a courtesy.

Her name is struck off from the List Of Students.

It was decided that the room was sufficiently large.

The Recorder read Chapter 66 of Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia, on "Red Corpuscles And Anemia". The Deputy read

some of the list of the various kinds of Anemia as known to the Medical Profession.

Frank Burns volunteered to read two following Chapters at the next meeting.

Pauline W. is taking care of a woman with Cataract. The Medical Doctor said an operation was necessary. She has had 5 Tonations so far and notices a change already. Green Systemic was used. She is building up her own condition with Orange and is improving nicely.

Bertha L. normalated a case of Burn which was very severe. It resulted from a "Permanent Wave". The woman went to a Medical Doctor 4 times and became worse instead of better. The Doctor was afraid of Erysipelas. Her head was a running mass. The first Tonation of Spectro-Chrome seemed to help her. In 3 weeks, her head healed very nicely and there was no more trouble. Turquoise Local was used entirely. This seemed to dry more than with the Blue alone.

Bertha L. has also a case of Arthritis which she is tonating for the past 9 weeks and the Sufferer is improving nicely. Changes in the weather, however, have a great deal to do with the effect of the Spectro-Chrome and the condition of the person. She can not seem to overcome the Pain the person has, however. Indigo does not seem to help much, otherwise the Infra-Green Division is being used. This is a case of long standing, being brought on by "poison from a Goitre". This seemed to appear in the legs. Green, Lemon, Yellow and Orange are being used in their proper order. Constipation was relieved and the Red was used for the Liver with good results. Magenta is being used once a week on Area 4 and now it is being used for the Area 18 once a week.

Ida B. is tonating a woman with Paralysis in the arm and for Heart Disorder. The Medical Doctor said the arm would shrink from a Diathermy. When the Sufferer wanted to take Spectro-Chrome Tonations, the Medical Doctor told her not to take them, as that would burn her! Instead, the arm became well and her Heart was normalated. For the Arm, she used Indigo for the Pain first and the Sufferer slept after that night without Pain. Then Yellow was used for the Paralysis and a few Green. Only 17 Tonations were used altogether.

She also tonated a woman with Sinus Disorder. After a few Tonations, she got a Pain in one Tooth. After examination, the Dentist found Pus and pulled it. The woman continued her Tonations and is much better. Green, Lemon and Orange were used.

Ida B. also had a case of "Nervous Disorder" in a woman; she could not sleep. Now, after using Spectro-Chrome, she feels better and can rest. Magenta and Turquoise were used.

Arthur G. had a case of a person who could not sleep and whose Heart was so bad that she could not walk upstairs without panting. She had also a Pain in her back. Now, her Heart is normal, she sleeps well and has plenty of pep. Her back still bothers her, however. One week of Green and two weeks of Lemon were given and now she is taking Orange for her back.

Frances B.'s husband broke out with Boils. He used Orange to draw the Boils to head, Yellow to open them, Green to cleanse, Indigo to close. They all cleared without a scar. Her son rose one day with Headache, but, after 1 hour of Blue was all right. Another child had Fever; 1 hour of Blue normalated the condition.

The Deputy said that his two grand-daughters were "just like dead" about 2 weeks ago. They had no pep and were burning with Fever. Two Tonations, Blue and Turquoise normalated them.

Olive B. is still tonating her mother for Liver and Stomach Disorders. She is coming along finely. It is a case of long standing. Infra-Green Colors are being used and Magenta with an occasional Scarlet. She is repeating the Infra-Green now. She is using the Equipment to keep the rest of the family in health. Her husband had a Backache which came on very suddenly; a case of Lumbago. After 1 Turquoise Tonation, he went back to work feeling well. Area 18 was tonated.

Emily M. had been ailing for 13 years. She had bad Colds continuously and it cost her about \$1,000.00 with a Medical Doctor. She became so affected that she could not stand or sleep. She had an operation and doctored for Sinus Disorder. Her Lungs were full of Pus and badly scarred. She lost a great deal of weight and in a general way was more dead than alive. She was burnt to a blister with Ultra-Violet Rays for treatment. Frank B. one day told her about Spectro-Chrome, so she bought one. In one month she had no more pains and in 2½ months she felt fine. She gained 20 pounds in weight. Even her hair, she says, is turning back to normal dark color. Green and Lemon were used; Orange for the Lungs. She followed the Irradiation Free Guidance to the letter and had wonderful results. A short time ago, she developed Athlete's Foot. Three Turquoise Tonations righted her.

Jacob S. is keeping on with the Yellow and is improving right along.

Carrie M. normalated an Abscessed Toe in 2 Orange Tonations. She asked if anyone could tell her how to normalate an Acid Stomach. Bertha L. answered the inquiry with the information that she normalated a case of 25 years' standing. Not only the Acid Stomach, but Constipation was removed by the use of Lemon.

Elsie L. had a case of Rheumatism in the shoulder which was very painful. After 3 Tonations, the Sufferer was able to sleep and in 1 week went back to work. Gave first Orange. This was "too severe". Green was then given for 4 days and then Orange again. She had a case of a bad Head Cold which responded to Turquoise and Orange.

Rose M. never received instructions in using her Spectro-Chrome. She read her book, however and found where to start—at the Green. Her daughter has Tuberculosis and had been in bed for 9 months. She seemed to be getting along all right, but, there was still a cavity in the Lung. For this reason, she bought Spectro-Chrome. Green was used for a month and the pain in the side left her entirely; also the Constipation was corrected. For the past few days, she has been using Lemon and finds now that a great deal of Phlegm is being loosened. Her daughter is making good progress, she feels. As for her own case, which she thinks is one of "Nerves," she has not been able to get any Guidance from Spectro-Chrome Institute. She says she answered the questions as fully as possible, but, does not seem to have been able to give enough information.

Joseph W. says he is not pothered with a Numbness in his fingers. His Guidance told him to use Yellow now and that is what he is doing.

Bernard K. got a Spectro-Chrome for his son who is 6 years old and is suffering from Diabetes. Upon getting Spectro-Chrome, he placed the child on the Rational Food Of Man and stopped Insulin. The child went into a Coma, so Insulin was resumed. Also, he is on a restricted "Carbo-Hydrate Diet." Green, Lemon and Yellow were used without results. The Members in the Planet Meeting were very united in telling B. K. to stop use of Insulin in tonating his son and place him once more on the proper system of eating, giving Starches and Sugars. An interesting discussion on Diabetes took place. Carrie M. said that the Sufferer should be given Orange Juice to bring him out of the Coma. Her husband, having Diabetes, always found great relief in using the Blue. Also, from the use of Spectro-Chrome, he

threw off so much waste matter through the Bowels, that it was almost unbelievable. Bernard K. however had results in a case of Ringworm, which responded to 3 Turquoise Tonations.

Marie Z. said she had Diabetes very badly and using Spectro-Chrome for 8 weeks, made her feel very well. It was of 10 years standing. She used Magenta and Green and 6 weeks of Lemon. Spectro-Chrome also helped her when her neck was swollen from a very bad Cold.

Frank B. reported that his 13 year old son, born paralyzed was improving steadily.

Belle K. reported about her mother's Heart. She stopped the medicines immediately upon beginning with Spectro-Chrome and within about a month she was feeling well. She herself had a Mastoid Disorder for which she was to have an operation, having had one nine years ago. This has been draining all these years and she began having dizzy spells. After using Spectro-Chrome a short while, the Dizziness vanished and the Pain also, but the Ear continues to drain. She wanted to know if this was all right. The Deputy told her it would continue to drain until it was clean, that she should use Spectro-Chrome to cleanse it and when it was ready to stop draining, to close it with Indigo.

Nina M. said she has trouble with poor Circulation. Her fingers become cold and white. She used Green, Lemon, Yellow and Orange and repeated these several times, but did not seem to help. She gets the best results for Constipation, by using Orange.

Hedwig N. said she had almost the same troubles and found Scarlet on Areas 4 and 18 very beneficial.

The meeting was very orderly and interesting.

An error was made in the last report. Edna B. was reported to have had good results in her son, in Bed Wetting. This was erroneous; she had no results.

Elsie L. should consider the idea of not starting Persistent Disorders with Orange. It is like starting an automobile on High

Gear uphill. Follow from the Green down, thus letting the Inertia of the Auric Vehicle to pick momentum gradually.

Rose M. sent Spectro-Chrome Institute numerous Charts about her several young daughters—all Charts **Incomplete**. A two page explanatory request was made and yet she did **not** write them correctly, but, started to argue. Another long set of explanations followed, but, she wrote about article 14 in the General Advice Chart that it was "this way and that way", without giving the information needed about the Habits of the girls. About herself, she said she had "this and that", but did **NOT** give any information about certain questions asked in Article 14. She has absolutely **NO** reason or right to complain. Spectro-Chrome Institute shoulders a tremendous moral responsibility (if not legal responsibility) in giving Free Guidance to Purchasers, from a distance; it shoulders a grave moral responsibility with powerful occult consequences and if Rose M. will **NOT** send her General Advice Chart entirely complete in **EVERY DETAIL ASKED**, she will never receive Free Guidance. Spectro-Chrome Institute service is impersonal and rigidly uniform and anyone not following the established Rules And Regulations will receive no attention; no matter who they may be. We certainly **are able** to guide her about herself and her tuberculous daughter and the other members, so her investment may fructify and she may bless Spectro-Chrome, but, she will have to answer that Article 14, in completion to receive reply. We know her troubles, but, she **MUST** conform to the Rules And Regulations, whether they suit her views or not. Older Affiliates, are requested to make her acquainted about the inflexible methods of the Originator of Spectro-Chrome. We are very anxious to serve her, for her children's sake. FACTS REGARDING FALSE CHARGES MADE AGAINST E. A. ERNEST BY THE SPECTRO-CHROME INSTITUTE

This Bulletin is addressed to all Members and Provisional Members of the Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists, and to all who may purchase, or have purchased, Spectro-Chrome Equipments through me.

My reason for forwarding this Bulletin to you is to give you the exact facts and information concerning certain articles appearing in the August issue of the Spectro-Chrome magazine, and other articles which, I understand, are to appear in future issues, regarding me. In my estimation, the object of the Spectro-Chrome Institute in charging me with certain violations was for the purpose of securing technical reasons to cancel my agreement as exclusive Distributor for the State of Wisconsin, solely for their financial gain, at a great loss to me.

All of my dealings with customers, and with the Institute, have been fair, equitable, open and above board and, therefore, I am pleased to submit the following for your consideration. Further information will be furnished at your request, thereby making it possible for you to judge for yourself.

1. Under date of August 9, 1935 I received a communication from the Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists, being in the form of a charge lodged against me by the Spectro-Chrome Institute for violations of good faith and conspiracy because I sold two Cabinet Equipments to my Agent, Mr. Walter Sutter. These Equipments were shipped direct to this purchaser by the Institute. The purchaser, in turn, delivered one of the Equipments, taken directly from the carton in which it had been received, to some poor sufferer in great need of Spectro-Chrome, advising the Institute accordingly. Certainly there was no violation of good faith or conspiracy in connection with such a deal and I leave it to you to judge for yourself. I pleaded guilty to having sold the two Equipments to Walter Sutter, as it was a fact and I had the signed orders in my possession. These documents were submitted in evidence and are now in the hands of the Scientific Order. However, I did not plead guilty to conspiracy and the like.
2. Another letter was received from the Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists on the same day, informing me that the Spectro-Chrome Institute had placed certain charges against me for having accepted an order for a Cabinet Equipment from a certain purchaser on the time payment plan in accordance with my regular terms. However, due to the fact that this purchaser was very skeptical, he wanted to give Spectro-Chrome a trial for five weeks and, therefore, I obliged him by putting a notation on the order to the effect

that, if after he had used the Equipment for five weeks, he was not satisfied, I would call for it and cancel his obligation in connection with the balance due me. For my great faith in Spectro-Chrome and this promise to the purchaser, I was charged with violating the Code of Honor and endangering the reputation of the Institute. In this instance, I pleaded guilty to having accepted the order on the basis mentioned but did not admit violating any rules or regular trade practices. A copy of this order was mailed to the Institute but they refused to make shipment. I am sure that you, nor any one else, could possibly construe such action as a violation.

3. Under date of August 11, I received a letter from the Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists, advising that the Spectro-Chrome Institute had placed charges against me for having violated certain rules and consorting with one of my Agents to commit dishonesty and conspiracy, due to the fact that I sold an Equipment to a certain purchaser who called for it here in Milwaukee, strictly in accordance with the contract entered into on July 7, and July 9, 1935, respectively, at which time I was exclusive United States Distributor for Spectro-Chrome. This purchaser called for the Equipment on July 23 and, after paying a certain amount of cash, took it with him to Cicero, Illinois. The Institute claims I violated certain rules because this particular Equipment had originally been purchased by another party who refused to use it. However, the last purchaser was so informed and was perfectly satisfied to accept the Equipment with that understanding, due to the fact that his invalid boy was in urgent need of Spectro-Chrome and, further, because there was a saving of the express charges, in the amount of \$3.90, which had been paid by the original purchaser.

I admitted that I was guilty of selling this Equipment on the basis mentioned and a copy of the order was submitted in evidence. I did not plead guilty to the charges mentioned. Certainly this cannot be construed as a violation of any rules, regulations or regular trade practices.

4. The Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists informed me on August 11 that the Institute had also placed charges against me to the effect that I had given certain definite information, or advice, to a purchaser residing in Stevens Point, Wisconsin as to the specific colors to be used. This was called a violation of Breach of Faith with the Institute. I did give the purchaser information regarding the operation of the Equipment, and also referred him to various pages of the Home Guide, so he would be familiar with the instructions issued therein. I also requested this purchaser to prepare an Advice Request Blank immediately and forward it to the Institute. How can any one construe this to be a violation? I did not plead guilty to this charge.
5. Under date of August 12 I received a letter from the same organization, informing me that I was charged with violation of certain rules of the Order by being unfair to the Agents, due to the fact that the Institute claimed I instructed and sent one certain Agent to a purchaser of a Spectro-Chrome Equipment to offer said purchaser a certain portion of her commission if names of prospects were furnished. This charge is absolutely false. By what authority could I prevent my Agents, or any other person, from spending their money as they saw fit? Such a charge certainly cannot be construed as a violation on my part in any way, shape, or manner. I did not plead guilty to any part of this charge. Furthermore, what right has the Institute to dictate as to how I should conduct my business?
6. In another communication of the same day I was further charged with paying commission to an Agent who was not the owner of an Equipment and, therefore, guilty of violation of the Constitution and Rules. This charge is also false. I did sell an Equipment to one certain woman and, after it was received, she decided to have it registered in the name of her son which was certainly her privilege. However, this purchaser was a duly qualified Agent and made a sale, or recommended Spectro-Chrome to another person. After the sale was completed, I mailed this Agent a check covering the commission due her. Would you call this a violation? I did not plead guilty to this charge.
7. I was informed on August 13 that I had been charged with violation of the rules and regulations of the Constitution because I re-sold an Equipment originally purchased by a person living in Illinois. For some unknown reason, this man had never opened the carton and, consequently, had never registered the Equipment, having absolutely refused to use it. Therefore, after corresponding with this purchaser, I agreed to pay him a certain amount for the Equipment. The offer was accepted and the Equipment shipped to Milwaukee. After some weeks, one of my Agents wanted to purchase an additional Equipment. This particular Equipment was sold to him as a brand new model, which it was, but, due to

the fact that it had been originally purchased by another person, it was sold to the Agent at a discount. The Agent, knowing this was a brand new Equipment, even though it had been shipped to another purchaser, sold it to one of his prospects. How could anybody call this a violation of regular trade practices, unfairness, fraud or the like? I pleaded guilty to having accepted the Equipment from the original purchaser and selling it to my Agent. How ridiculous to charge me with violation! I did not plead guilty to the charge.

8. In a second letter of the 13, I was charged with further violations because I acted as an Agent for a certain party and assisted her in disposing of her Equipment, having paid her the sum of \$35.00 for the Equipment. This Equipment was brand new, and had never been used but had been registered. After having the Equipment, together with Bill of Sale and Assignment in Blank, in my possession for some little time, I decided to present it to a Sister, representing a Catholic organization in the State of Kansas, and shipped it to her with my compliments. For doing this, I was charged with violating the Code of Honor, the Agreement with the Institute, and Interstate Commerce Rules. I disclaim violations of any kind. This shipment was made on July 17, 1935 at which time I was acting as exclusive Distributor for the entire United States. I pleaded guilty to having donated the Equipment, as it was a fact, but did not plead guilty to the charge mentioned.

I regret to inform you that the person to whom this Equipment was donated has received such threatening communications from the Institute that she returned the Equipment to them. It is now in their possession and they have requested information from the original purchaser here in Milwaukee as to disposition of it. This, of course, is the most unethical, unreasonable and unbusinesslike course of procedure I have ever heard of. The original purchaser has instructed the Institute to return the Equipment to the rightful owner in Kansas immediately, as it has been assigned to her.

Differences of opinion and many disagreements, have existed for some time between Colonel Dinshah, the Spectro-Chrome Institute, myself and my organization. I have requested a personal conference, on numerous occasions, for the purpose of having a mutual understanding whereby suffering humanity might be served in a greater capacity, and in a more efficient manner. Notwithstanding my many requests, the President of the Spectro-Chrome Institute absolutely refused to grant me the courtesy of such a conference, without giving any reasonable excuse. Who ever heard of a manufacturer refusing to see the exclusive Distributor of his products.

It might interest you to know that Colonel Dinshah offered to come to Milwaukee and present all his evidence before the entire First Milwaukee Wisconsin Planet at any time. I immediately accepted his offer but, for some unknown reason, he refused to come.

The charges made against me, as printed in the Spectro-Chrome magazine, and mentioned in the letters referred to above, are all unjustified and have been the direct cause of great embarrassment to me, as well as much damage and financial loss.

I am informed that Members, and Provisional Members of the Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists were instructed in a letter from Headquarters, read at the last Planet Meeting, to refrain from associating, in any way, with me or my company, whether in connection with Spectro-Chrome or otherwise. This has also greatly embarrassed me and caused further damage and financial loss.

I am very sorry that I am compelled to take immediate action, through authoritative sources, to clear my name and reputation. My sympathy goes out to the Originator of Spectro-Chrome for allowing himself to get into such an agitated frame of mind, standing in his own light, and actually making it impossible to reach his goal—Spectro-Chrome in Every Home—and serve suffering humanity.

My faith in the Spectro-Chrome System has not been changed, but I have lost all faith and confidence in the Originator of the System and his immediate organizations.

I AM CONTINUING TO SELL SPECTRO-CHROME EQUIPMENTS IN THE STATE OF WISCONSIN. PLACE YOUR ORDERS THROUGH ME AND RELIEVE YOURSELF OF ALL RESPONSIBILITIES.

My attention has been drawn to the fact that threatening letters, containing charges of violations, have been received by other Members from the Scientific Order of Spectro-Chrome Metrists. All of these, in my estimation are most ridiculous, unreasonable and without

grounds. For instance, my private secretary, Miss Lucille McGraw, has received several threatening letters, accusing her of certain violations which I know are false, as she is absolutely innocent. Everything Miss McGraw has done in connection with Spectro-Chrome, while acting as my secretary, has been done with full authority from me.

I again wish to thank you for the assistance you have given me, and for your continued cooperation.

We can not pass by such a letter of nonsense and falsehood, without giving an open reply. The figures refer to his paragraphs. The pages are in September 1935 Spectro-Chrome.

1. Read page 1649. He misled Walter Sutter and the Equipment 4C-4344 was rented without title.

2. He had no right to make any conditions to take back Spectro-Chromes after being used. This was an open Violation of the Spectro-Chrome Understanding For The Bill Of Sale. Refer pages 1649 and 1650.

3. That sale to the farmer of Daggett, Michigan, analyzed at pages 1650 and 1651 was nothing short of want of honesty, fraud and capitalistic money-grabbing. A human service like Spectro-Chrome, never could tolerate such flagrant practices.

4. Not only in this one case, but, in many such cases, E. A. Ernest injected himself in regard to Guidance and we admonished him against it.

5—6. We let him go free in these matters as they would have wasted too much of our time and space and would have involved many innocent ones.

7. Refer to pages 1662 and 1663. That Spectro-Chrome, we further found, went through many more hands as a hired Equipment. It is yet unregistered. E. A. Ernest made a clean profit of **\$73.24 NET** on this one Spectro-Chrome. If the American public would think such methods were honest, America would not be worth its name!

8. That Spectro-Chrome is in our hands and shows plenty of use. For this man, put in authority by Spectro-Chrome Institute as Distributor, to repossess a Spectro-Chrome (never used as he says) for \$35.00 and gift it to another organization without sanction of his employers was inexcusable. Refer to pages 1663 and 1664. The as-

never appeared thereon during the transaction.

We sent no threats to anybody, but, merely placed the facts. E. A. Ernest, in his dealings, always was found to evade issues and we are not accustomed to taking prevarications. That Equipment will stay here until the false date matter and the like is cleared.

The so-called "differences of opinion" were sufficient for the Originator to keep E. A. Ernest out of his sight, because Dinshah had **no intention of allowing** E. A. Ernest to stay longer with Spectro-Chrome. E. A. Ernest may be a good business man for his "ultra-smartness", but, no person who will not walk on the straight lines laid, can stay in Spectro-Chrome Service. Dinshah did not refuse to interview E. A. Ernest as a "manufacturer", but, if the Truth be told, he refused the interview because he **did not want** E. A. Ernest connected with Spectro-Chrome any longer. Dinshah deemed him unsuited and unfit for the work and that ended the story. He still refuses to interview E. A. Ernest and as time passes, more reasons manifest to maintain the barrier permanently.

Does the public want more reasons? E. A. Ernest sold an Equipment on **Time Payment to a girl of 13!** Another to a boy of 17! That man was going with his unbusiness-like and unlawful pranks so fast, that had Spectro-Chrome Institute not put him out, in a short time E. A. Ernest would have become the owner of the entire Spectro-Chrome organization and Dinshah would be sunk!

E. A. Ernest still maintains his false colors, by stating he will "continue to sell Spectro-Chrome." **He will not.** All he can do is to unload the few he had on order **before** the forfeiture of his Agreement. **After that**, the name of E. A. Ernest will to us be a thing of the past. We have no desire to waste our valuable time and space on him and we are extremely happy that he has "lost all faith and confidence in the Originator" because to the Originator, the faith and confidence of E. A. Ernest would be a blot on Dinshah's honesty. He is out—let him stay out.

EXPULSION OF WALTER SUTTER

Walter Sutter, the Agent who was involved and investigated in connection with the activities of E. A. Ernest, was finally adjudged "Guilty" after mature deliberation and was ordered expelled from the Scientific Order Of Spectro-Chrome Metrists, with forfeiture of all rights, titles and privileges pertaining thereto.

However, he has the privilege under Rule 90, of applying for

Reinstatement at the discretion of the Board Of Trustees; the President recommended Clemency in his case.

DINSHAH VISITED DETROIT, MICHIGAN

Two public meetings were held at 8 P. M. Monday, October 14, 1935 and Tuesday, October 15, 1935, in the Small Ball Room, Hotel Tuller, Detroit, Michigan. The room was filled to capacity to hear the Originator of Spectro-Chrome, who answered questions in regard to Spectro-Chrome Metry.

It was then urged by numerous Members and Visitors—friends of the Affiliates, that this year's Annual Convention be held in Detroit, Michigan. The enthusiasm expressed was so overwhelming that the Originator bowed to their wishes and reserved the Ball Room for the same dates as formerly intended for Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Some time ago, Dinshah was notified that the Medical Doctors of Milwaukee County would be pleased if this year's Convention be held elsewhere. Well, who can now say that Dinshah dislikes to oblige them?!
