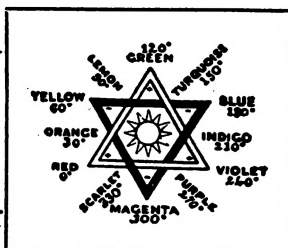

A Federal Court Jury awarded \$75,000 damages against Dr. Alfred L. La Ferte of Detroit, Michigan, because, he removed the wrong bone from the wrist of a football player, Ken Strong.

It would be better to award similar damages for each Tonsil, Ovary, Appendix, Adenoid, removed wrongly from the human body; a few such cases in succession would stop merciless butchery.

## SPECTRO-CHROME IS PAR- ULTRA-SUPER-HOMEOPATHY

Among one of the early Graduates of Spectro-Chrome Institute, I have the honor to enumerate Robert R. Logan, President of the American Anti-Vivisection Society, a gentleman of experience and learning and having the highest repugnance against the systems of organized butchery, foisted on the suffering public under the name of Medicine. In *The Starry Cross* of September 1933, he wrote an editorial under the heading of "Homeopathy," which portrays so many matters dear to our heart that I take the liberty of republishing it, to show how others with intelligent and thinking minds are drifting into the field of "No Drugs." He says:

"There is an interesting article in *Progress Today*, April-July, 1933, issue, entitled "Homeopathy and Vivisection," by E. Petrie Hoyle, M. D., in which the author asserts that modern orthodox medicine—vivisectional medicine — in its reliance upon surgery, vaccines and serums has lost all knowledge of curative drugs or medicines and so really has nothing with which to heal the sick.

Dr. Hoyle begins by pointing out that the orthodox medicine has had a succession of fads and fashions: "bloodletting (which has killed even kings), mercury (pushed to the limit, until teeth fell out and joints were filled with mercury globules, visible to the eye—see Royal College of Surgeons Museum), Listerism (with many more victims overdosed with carbolic), then the reign of Microbes (when it was tried chemically to reach them *in vivo*, to be slain *in situ*—they often died with their hosts). This was antiseptics with a vengeance, and if the host did not die, who

can compute the extent of the bodily injury sustained? Then came Salvarsan (which was to make venery a safe sin, but untoward events rapidly following, the famous '606' soon became '909,' and now one is ashamed, or afraid, of even this experiment on the sick). After this came the fashion of 'breaking-the-fever,' when the reign of antipyretics was merged into hypnotics (which simply masked the pain and danger symptoms until the patients could not tell what ailed them most.)"

"These two aids were soon put on the 'poisons list.' Why? Because 'breaking-the-fever' often spelt a funeral. I will tell you another time what the microscope has demonstrated in this connection. Break-the-fever, indeed! What unscientific nonsense, as phagocytosis is quickened in a fever-raised temperature. (See Professor Bakody's work at Budapest.) After this came the fashion of Serum-Therapy, hypodermically given — **another most unsurgical procedure**, which had a most unscientific origin. **What did God give us mouths for?** Serum-Therapy merged into colloids, with spectacular vivisection into gaining ground and endowments. I wish Rockefeller could be told how his millions are being used. If he realized how animals were being treated, I can't think he would stand for it. His special doctor (now dead) used to be Dr. Hamilton F. Biggar, a homeopath whom I knew very well."

"And now, 1920 to 1932, as another phase of bewildered groping, orthodoxy comes right back to bloodletting, discarded when Grandmamma was young! Such is a brief outline of a wobbling pseudo-science, and a vicious circle of some seven or eight decades, though there are scores of other forgotten

fashions. Change is not always advance."

Dr. Hoyle then goes on to state that Homeopathy has not changed in 130 years because it is founded on absolutely scientific principles, each drug in the homeopathic pharmacopeia having been selected to cure certain specific symptoms because it invariably produces those symptoms when tested not upon animals without their consent but upon human beings voluntarily. Hahnemann began this work with some ninety-seven drugs and

"The results were more than astonishing. The drug symptoms produced were faithful portrayals or 'pictures' of every day illnesses. His 'provers,' expressing their departures from normal, made use of exact phrases met with daily when questioning the sick today, and these phrases are still on record. Moreover, he found that nine-tenths of the symptoms produced were subjective, that is, requiring human speech to make them known. These he classified and recorded and they are of classic import today. Thus nine-tenths of those thousands of drug symptoms would have been lost to posterity had he employed animals. Have the vivisectionists anything with which to beat this work?"

"Please note," says Dr. Hoyle, further on, "that Homeopathy has not any 'specifics' for this or that disease, nor has it ever had any. A specific drug for any specific disease may lead to all sorts of complications. What if the disease has been wrongly diagnosed? I have drawn your attention to the percentages of error in diagnosis. Any prescription based on a mere diagnosis, which may be wrong, at once makes the prescribed drug void, deleterious and even stupid. Homeopaths never evade a diag-

nosis, but we go beyond the mere classifying of a disease under a technical nomenclature. It is seldom that two people are affected in an exactly similar manner in any disease as broadly diagnosed. With Homeopathy it is always the precise and peculiar personal deviations from the normal that are noted, and these individual differences point to a demand for one drug only in a manner totally unknown to vivisectionists."

Under the use of anti-toxin diphtheria, says Dr. Hoyle, quoting the *British Medical Journal* of September 28, 1931, has been showing a death rate of 20 per cent. lately:

"This looks as if another fashion of orthodoxy was in the process of being discarded in spite of much vivisection. The homeopathic death rate in this disease, using chiefly our high dilutions of *Mercurius cyanide* (a terrible poison if not employed in the minute homeopathic doses), which should never be used in a lower potency than the tenth decimal or the twelfth decimal strength (ten or twelve noughts) runs about one to five per cent. Yet homeopathy has never called on vivisection."

Lastly Dr. Hoyle points out that after ridiculing for generations the minute or infinitesimal doses of homeopathy as having no possible potency, orthodox medicine has now discovered that infection could be transmitted with a dilution requiring fifteen noughts to express it:

"Orthodoxy finds that work with a dilution of 1/1,000,000,000,000 was strong enough to inoculate two out of every three men and give them a common cold after they had filtered out every microbe. The *Lancet* calls this a 'brilliant piece of work,' so why sneer when we employ our infinitesimals? Is this another discard for orthodox

bacteriology and vivisection? Here they had filtered out all the bacteria, and yet there remained the infectious something — infinitesimal, without a doubt."

THE STARRY CROSS does not hold a brief for Homeopathy or any other cult or school of medicine, but it does protest against the domination of the one school which bases its "science" of human healing on cruel and misleading tests made upon animals, and which steadily ignores all the facts and observations recorded through the centuries by all other seekers after truth.

It may be that in the very nature of things there never can be a "science" of medicine, that it will always remain an art whose secret shall lie in the individual ability of each physician to reconcile his patient to a conformity with nature's laws. If, however, there is to be something approaching a science of medicine it will come only when state protection is withdrawn from one favored school and the monopoly and arrogance of vivisection broken forever. Then and only then will the knowledge gained by homeopathy and osteopathy and the other schools of healing be shared and correlated and made of practical value."

The remarks of Dr. E. Petrie Hoyle about the "Orthodoxy" are very pertinent, but, where that Orthodoxy and even Homeopathy with its "Twelfth Decimal Potency" ends, Spectro-Chrome with its most precise yet ultra-superattenuated potency begins.

There is nothing new to me in the dilution of the One Quadrillionth strength. The chemical and physiological properties of the Spectro-Chrome Attuned Color Waves which have now proven merits of invaluable character, are nothing but inconceivably superior

"dilutions" and triturations hurled from the furnace of Nature with the highest speed possible in physical matter.

The moment one will realize that Light and Color are not mere "decorations," but, terrible engines of chemical projection of physical particles, he will become a person imbued with the same views as I have and a new history will be written in Healing Arts.

#### DEATH OF ANNIE BESANT

Annie Besant, the President of the Theosophical Society, died at the age of 86.

Dinshah was introduced to her in London, England, in 1893, just prior to her first visit to India. She was then a meek student of Oriental Philosophy, but, step by step she rose into power in the Theosophical Society, until she became its esoteric as well as exoteric head. How she attained that position is known well to the writer, although he does not think it essential to republish the events leading to it. He took active part in her controversy about Charles W. Leadbeater and also about the Krishnamurti incident. His lengthy and caustic articles on both matters created quite a stir at the time. The Leadbeater articles were published in his weekly newspaper Apakshapata (The Impartial). Prior to that, Dinshah had numerous clashes about his life and lectures with her and the climax was reached when one day in Bombay, Annie Besant threatened him that unless he stopped his sledge-hammer tactics "The Masters will not keep you in the work." Dinshah promptly retorted that "The Benign Masters never interfered with individual

Karmas" and told her his reply would reach her next morning.

The next day, he resigned his Fellowship and voluntarily surrendered all his esoteric papers. Three years later, after much altercation, his old Diploma was restored and he resumed his activities.

However, since the Krishnamurti and the Messiah affair, Dinshah stopped taking part in the activities of the Theosophical Society, in as much as its separation into the different factions and divisions was not his idea of Universal Brotherhood.

Annie Besant was a great soul. A powerful orator and masterful discourses she won many hearts. However, her autocratic temperament frequently produced awkward situations.

She is gone to Planes about which she wrote in life; may she advance!

### SLOW APPROACH TO SPECTRO-CHROME

How cunningly are chemical products advertised may be gathered from the new noise of "Heavy Water," which is being made in the American Chemical Society's meeting in Chicago, Illinois. In a report published in the Wilmington Morning News, of Wilmington, Delaware, of Tuesday, September 12, 1933, Howard W. Blakeslee, Associate Press Science Editor writes about this "Heavy Water":—

"This liquid is not different in appearance from ordinary water, yet plants do not grow in it. Although perfectly pure and made of the same "H<sub>2</sub>-O" as all other water, chemists suspect that it may prove to be either poisonous to animals and man, or show medicinal effects.

Heavy water is made of the re-

cently discovered double-weight hydrogen atoms and the heaviest of oxygen atoms. The hydrogen atoms are obtained from ordinary hydrogen, of which they form a small fraction. Electricity is used in separating the two kinds of hydrogen.

The resulting extra weight water is only slightly heavier than the ordinary liquid, because the heavy hydrogen atoms are very light compared with the single oxygen atom in a water molecule. Ordinary hydrogen has a mass, of weight of one; heavy hydrogen, two; and oxygen atoms have masses of 16, 17 and 18."

It were so much simpler and better for the World, if instead of constantly groping in the dark, the chemists would throw into discard for all times the Atomic Theory and interpret all chemistry in Spectro-Chrome terms. There is no such thing as an indivisible "Atom." I have been speaking for dozens of years and emphatically teaching my students that the so-called "Elements" of the chemists are, spectroscopically speaking, all "compounds." Were they true Elements, Radium could not as an Element throw off Niton and Helium and later become Lead; Uranium would not decay into Radium and many other phenomena of Radio-Emanation be impossible.

Spectro-Chrome Metry only can open that door, through the correct comprehension of Occult Chemistry; our students should form Classes for that purpose and ask me to give a Post-Graduate Course; when they will be ready, they will find me at their service, but perhaps the Spectro-Chrome Metry Encyclopaedia may avoid such necessity.

### REPLACEMENT OF SLIDES

Spectro-Chrome Genuine Attuned Color Wave Slides as supplied with each Spectro-Chrome Equipment, are the very life of the system and the rules pertaining to their replacement are still the same as installed 13 years ago.

Here are the Rules:

1. Each Spectro-Chrome has only a single Set of Five Dinshah Attuned Color Wave Slides. The Graduate has Two Red Slides in the Slide-Carrier.

2. No SPARE Set is ever supplied.

3. When needing replacement of broken Slides, the complete Set including the broken pieces MUST be returned.

4. The Seal on the Slide-Carrier should not be broken.

5. All Slides MUST belong to the same Set.

6. A Set sent with mixed Slides, even though each be genuine, will NOT be replaced.

7. Each Set of Slides is registered for ownership with us and will be entitled to replacement only through change of ownership by registration of the Assignment of Bill Of Sale.

There are no exceptions and the rules apply to all equally.

### NEW FAVORSCOPE SYSTEM

Beginning with this issue, our students will notice our new method in recording the Favorscope, so as to meet the demands and requirements of the most untrained laymen. All the frills of science are removed, without deteriorating its scientific character. The Sunrise and Sunset times with the Sunrise and Sunset corrections are abolished and the Chronos or Time Table is simplified by adding those corrections beforehand. The Sunrise column is changed to Day First Favor and the Sunset column is made into Night First Favor. It is a Ready Reckoner.

The Standard Time is used throughout and the Chronos is built to the Longitude (Meridian) and Latitude (Parallel) of Spectro-Chrome Institute, which is taken as our Observatory Standard. All the user of the Favorscope has to do, is to join to this Standard Time, the Correction in Minutes of Addition or Subtraction for his locality and the First Favor is fixed. Thereafter, each 2 Hours and 56 Minutes the next Favor will appear. This alteration was made in conformity with the suggestion of our Distributor General Edward A. Ernest and noticing its utility, we were glad to make the necessary changes. We are sure it will meet with unanimous approval.
