THE TEMPLE

PRIMARILY. The Temple is a cosmic organic centre, the constitutent parts of which are the units of collective humanity.

Coincident with the original impulse, the first emanation from the Central Spiritual Sun—the Universal Heart—came into manifestation, the Father-Mother-Son, the triangular corner stone of The Temple, upon which is rising age by age, a geometrically perfect edifice. The cap stones to the pillars of the porch, and outer walls are now being laid preliminary to the work of the roof-builders—the humanity of the sixth great root race.

The place of each stone is determined by the law of selection, and the same law determines the different Degrees and Orders which lead to and from the great Stone of Sacrifice which rests upon the pavement of the Central Square.

The development of outer conditions, planes and personalities must keep pace with and correspond to the development of the interior man, or evolutionary force would be diverted from its proper channels.

When the Craftsman or Apprentice to any Degree has finished his term of service, and has mastered all the details of the work, he is "recognized" by the Master Builder, and raised to a higher Degree, although he may never be conscious of the presence of that Master, until his apprenticeship is completed, and he in turn becomes a Master of a lower Degree.

The organization of The Temple, the members of which belong by evolutionary right to a certain Degree of Cosmic Life, which Degree is subdivided into seven Orders, is the continuation and expansion of the work of the Masters revivified in this country a quarter of a century ago by certain chelas or disciples.

To the efforts of the Masters is due the impulse which has caused the great advance in scientific, philosophical and social endeavor; for they are the guardians of Ancient Wisdom and Knowledge, in which lies the root of all progress; and the work of The Temple is to cultivate and embody the highest principles of all such endeavor in one stupendous living organic whole.

It is a common belief that the fires of the altars of the Ancient Temples have been permitted to die out; but "those who know" say this is not true; that they are but hidden from the view of the masses, awaiting the time when the veil of ignorance and corruption hanging before the hearts of the humanity of this transitory period, shall be rent asunder, and the light of the ages becomes manifest to all. The time is comparatively close at hand when the doors of "The Temple of the Mysteries" shall once more swing outward. The Site of that once wonderful structure has been rediscovered, and when the Lord, the Saviour, the Elder Brother of the human race once more appears to claim his own, He will find a place prepared for him by those who, having heard his call, "Come over and help us," have faithfully responded, and have taken up their share of the burden of responsibility. 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

THE LAMP

Out from the Eternal—the ever living Heart of God—the Central Spiritual Sun—in ever increasing, widening waves of fire, serenely rides the Bearer of the Torch Celestial, the Torch which is to light afresh the flickering, dying Lamp within the hardened heart of man, the Lamp which burns without the aid of wick or oil through aeons long and sheds its beams of light in seven distinct

cyclic rounds—the Lamp of consciousness.

Man enmeshed in matter stands now within the focus of that Light, the focus fixed within the last cyclic round of a wave. If this Lamp has been kept alight and trimmed, his vision or line of life will plunge diagonally through each one of these seven waves, from the circumference of the last wave to the center; and at each juncture of a life line and wave he will find new worlds, new beings, new forms of life confronting him, forms both like and unlike his own, replicas of his own form and forms of others far beyond his present power of visioning. And one day, when his purification is complete, his resurrection from gross matter accomplished, his inner eyes will be opened to the mysteries unveiled in the countless ripples set in action by the powers of those diagonal lines, and he will learn that despite the findings of his outer consciousness, there has never been but one world, one universe, nor can there ever be more than one at any future time.

All the matter in which man has been enmeshed is illusion from the standpoint of the spiritual plane. His belief in all seeming differentiation was, for the time being, necessary for his development, and such differentiation of matter was entirely dependent upon his angle of vision at different eras of his cycle of manifestation. Also he will learn that these angles were formed by the direction given the beams of light—his spiritual illumination—which came directly from the Central Spiritual Sun and were radiated by means of the Lamp when the individual soul had gained sufficient power to receive and transmit the cyclic influx of power set free by the

THREE WEAPONS OF THE BLACK LODGE

The three principal weapons used by the ruling powers—of the Black Lodge to destroy the foundations of the Temple of Humanity and render abortive the age-long efforts of the Initiates of the White

Lodge are Disobedience, Ambition, and Jealousy.

SHADOWS

Commenting upon shadows, one of our daily newspapers refers to a singular fact relative to the persistence of shadowy forms cast upon an oily surface for an appreciable length of time after the material form which cast the shadow has vanished. This appears to be a link in the chain indicated in the Master's instruction, the oily

sheaths, page 24 in book, Teachings of the Temple.

If, as is believed by the orientalists and taught by our own philosophy, the shadow is a definite, semi-intelligent form—the lower astral form—which can only become visible on the material plane under certain conditions, but which has an independent existence after the soul has departed, until the body is disintegrated, the oily substance of the combined sheaths of all the cells in existence would seem to furnish a medium upon or within which all the shadows astral bodies—of all manifested forms could find life and expression for a definite length of time after physical life has departed from those forms. If such a state of homogeneous substance exists within space, which is drawn upon by each growing body and which an absolute necessity to each cell or molecule of matter, and if any shadow or astral body cast upon or within that substance may main there indefinitely, that substance (which), dependent certain conditions of the universal light rays for independent expression, would appear to be one phase at least of that plane or state of existence we term the astral plane, (and) the continued existence of the astral body after death would seem to be a demonstrable fact to most people, when the real nature of the shadow has once been scientifically proven. —В. S.

Queer Shadows You Can Leave Behind. (From an old newspaper.)

There are many superstitions about shadows, but a freak of nature has produced something in that line that quite outdoes the product of Oriental imagination—real shadows of your figure that will remain after you have walked away from the spot. For a short time the sun can actually shine on this freak shadow without obliterating it.

To many Orientals one's shadow is a sacred thing. It must not be stepped on or treated with any sort of indignity; it can be "stolen", and that is a crime to be wiped out in blood; to say "May your shadow never grow less" is a civil and much appreciated salutation.

But no Oriental ever pretended ability to leave his shadow behind him. This feat, however, is easily accomplished under certain natural conditions which science has lately explained.

The Phenomenon was first observed in the oil producing regions of California, where there are many large ponds of crude petroleum. The strange property of the surfaces of these ponds of retaining for a few seconds any shadow cast upon them was for a long time a

mystery even to the natives. Incredulous visitors were astonished to observe that their shadows remained on the surface of a petroleum pond for ten or fifteen seconds after their bodies had been withdrawn from between them and the sun.

They could walk along the margin of a pond, stopping for a few seconds between steps, and leave a row of their "freak shadows" on the oily surface. It was uncanny; nobody could explain it.

Then the logically inquiring mind of science came along and observed that the longer an object obscured the sun from a certain spot on the petroleum surface the longer the shadow remained after the object had been withdrawn. This was the only clue required. It was plainly a case of change of temperature of the oil from which the direct rays of the sun were shut off, and a consequent physical change in the oil surface, which is reached constantly by millions of minute gas bubbles from below.

With the sun shining on the surface these gas bubbles meet the air and burst more quickly than when a shadow intervenes. Wherever the shadow rests, with a cooling effect, the little gas bubbles accumulate and defer their bursting till the sun again warms them. Consequently the exact "print" of the shadow is fixed for a few seconds on the oil surface even after the object that cast it has

moved away.

The whole phenomenon—an uncanny one indeed, when first observed—is due to the supersensitiveness of the rising gas bubbles, which accumulate without bursting when subjected to a slight lowering of the temperature—which a momentary obscuration of the sun is enough to produce.

Question.—How does the teaching that the Avatar is to appear in 1928, co-relate with the statement in the "Secret Doctrine" that he would appear in the latter part of this century?

Answer.—There seems to be some confusion here between the coming of the Avatar and the incarnation of lesser entities or World Teachers. We are told that during the last 25 years of each century there is an effort on the part of the Lodge to impress certain great truths and teachings upon Humanity, and for this purpose a great world teacher is incarnated. In the last century this teacher was undoubtedly H. P. B. herself, her mission being to upset and break up the old or crystallized dogmatic creeds and hide-bound superstitions which had taken the place of pure live religion, and to substitute in their place the teachings of the Ancient Wisdom ligion: The seeds she planted in the minds of the race are now deeply rooted and growing apace and sending forth here and there in the world a beautiful growth which will ere long blossom out into the flowers of Love, and Truth and Brotherhood. No doubt, in the latter part of the present century another World Teacher will come to us, and help, by his or her efforts, to lift Humanity still another step along the path of evolution which it is travelling. These great teachers are not Avatars in the sense that the word Avatar usually denotes. In the "Key to Theosophy" we read as follows:--"During the last quarter of every hundred years an attempt is made by these "Masters" of whom I have spoken, to help on the spiritual progress of Humanity in a marked and definite way. Towards the close of every century you will invariably find that an outpouring or upheaval of spiritual force—or call it mysticism if you prefer,—has taken place. Some one or more persons have appeared in the world as their agents, and a greater or lesser amount of occult knowledge and teachings has been given out. If you care to do so you can trace these movements back century by century, as far as our detaled historical records extend."

Now an Avatar, as defined by H. P. B. in the Theosophical Glossary is "Divine Incarnation. The descent of a God or some exalted Being who has progressed beyond the necessity of Rebirths into the hadren for simple mental."

into the body of a simple mortal."

These incarnations of Celestial Being occur at periodic intervals, and there are greater and lesser incarnations, but the incarnation referred to as that of the Avatar is that of a very high celestial being, He who will usher in and give the Key-note, so to speak, of the new age, the Aquarian Age. This incarnation occurs at intervals of about 2000 years, and it is the time for influx of a great

wave of uplifting spiritual force and enlightenment.

In the Temple Teachings, page 508, we read: "Whenever the subject of 'The Coming Avatar' comes up for discussion in a mixed audience, there invariably arise the questions, when, where and how will the expected Avatar appear? Will it be at some designated time or place? Will he come in some super-human body, accompanied by wonderful exhibitions of supernatural phenomena? Will he be born of woman and grow to maturity in circumstances similar to those which environ each one of the children of the present race, only to meet with similar affirmations and denials to those which met the last Avatar when he announced his mission to man?

Strong assertions have been made as to the reincarnation of the last Avatar in the body of some child born in the present century. In a number of such instances, the assertion is conscientiously made, and has been based on some apparently supernatural phenomena which were believed to have preceded the birth of the child, thus fixing the belief in the mind of the mother and her immediate friends, if they have forgotten or ignored the fact that many other mothers have had similar experiences and are even now

Those who believe in a literal translation of the statement accredited to the Master Jesus by His disciples, after His crucifixion, to the effect that His Second Coming would be "in a cloud with power and great glory" find it difficult to accept the claims above

mentioned

making similar assertions.

The student of Occultism who has accepted the teachings of the Masters of Wisdom anent the illusory character and the impermanence of all matter on the physical plane, and the reality and endurance of the three higher of the seven states of manifested life, namely, Atma, Buddhi and Manas, is prepared to accept the statement that the Christos, or Buddhi, "the first born son of God", is in fact a state of energy, although far beyond the investigation or even the imagination, of man in his present state of existence. It is taught that this state of energy is actually Spiritual Light, the original source of all Light, and that it is reflected within the mentality of man, and also in that of every living creature in varying degrees; therefore every man is a potential Christ.

The brighter the illumination of mind resulting from the reflected light of the Christos, the more rapidly does the mentality of the normal human being absorb, or assimilate and generate that energy and approach the state or evolution which makes possible his admission to one of the highest orders of manifested life, The Avataral Order, in which he is prepared for open avowal of his mission to the world. A fully prepared Avatar has gained full power over physical life and death and over all matter which constitutes form in the lower orders of life. He has passed through myriads of lives in those lower orders, as well as through many of the higher orders of Adeptship ere he reaches the Buddhistic State from which he enters the state of perfection—wherein he becomes an individual Christ, a "Saviour" of the race to which he belongs by evolutionary right.

At the beginning of every great age in the earlier stages of a Manvantara, the Avatar karmically connected with the units of a previously great race, reincarnates in the body of a child, grows to maturity and eventually proclaims his mission as teacher and therefore Saviour, of all those who may accept him."

Much has been and is being written on this subject. It is uppermost in the minds of very many people today: "When is he coming?" How will he come?" "Will he appear in the clouds", "or incarnate as a child?" One learned writer enters into a long and tedious discussion, or rather argument, as to the kind of clothes he will wear!!. Could anything be more ridiculous? A God is to incarnate among us, and we are interested, not so much in the spiritual uplift he will bring us, as in what he will wear and eat. No doubt if he fails to conform to our accepted standards and prejudices and fit into the little moulds we with our little minds have created, will crucify him, as we have always done. And there are "false Prophets" aplenty-blatant rogues and frauds, some of them; selling Mahatmaship at so much per capita, loud mouthed orators proclaiming and advertising their wares in the marketplace,—fortunately only a few of these; but of the self-deluded ones there are many, and it would seem as though the only requisites for the gaining of a following were an inflated ego and a chronic verbal diarrhoea.

But there are also many who are "preparing the way of the Lord", who have caught a faint foretaste of His uplifting vibrations and are and have been sowing the seeds in the hearts of man which will develop into a fitting resting place for Him.

THE SPIRIT OF NEPTUNE

The miraculous birth of Krishna in a cow-shed, of Jesus in a stable, symbolize Light born where lower mental conditions held sway. Mortals are yet far away from the spiritual tide of these truths. Such teachers speak from direct cognition, direct Light. This Light, difficult to explain or even hint at its meaning, is that of Neptune's vibrations in the Logos manifest. It is the Light that

reveals the Eternal in freshness and beauty.

Notice the soul born with Neptune well placed in the horoscope, placid in the silence of profound insight; he feeds himself while on earth as if he were in the kingdom of heaven. He is a reflector, flashing back the holy Light like a jeweled prism. He is a brother unto all.

The Four Great schools on earth have known of this spiritual liberation, a liberation which gives the right use of memory. The law of the Neptunian is that of loving action; so his words, full of truth, command all nature to respond to his wish. He is the essence of power. He is at once the Prophet who sees into the Past and the future, the Priest who can readily use a symbol to veil or unveil an eternal truth. He is the King who has one will, noble and Divine—Prophet, Priest, and King.

The spiritual centers of the body vibrate in a new life—full—of virtue and new power. You will notice when Neptune is afflicted in a nativity there is a peculiar absentmindedness with vagaries and ill-balanced thought. These conditions prevail only when the soul for a time is divorced from the objective mind' in action. When Neptune is exalted and supported by other major planets the meaning of Nirvana, Rasa, Bliss is experienced in the functioning of the higher manas.

Neptune's vibration is of the spirit, beautiful and glorious, with the power to reflect that beauty and glory in nature. Its energy bestows in the world of changing forms, prevision, fore-knowledge, unity. He can supply food from the "one loaf" to the great multitude, and yet there are baskets of fragments left. He lives the life of heaven on earth, the kingdom of heaven being within, knowing that in giving life to others he has more abundant life himself.

The pouring out of the life blood on the Cross is the joy of the Initiate, for blood represents only a conveyance of the spirit. To pour out the blood means to shed forth the spirit of new life and thus bring about redemption, nearness, an altered condition uniting all forms of life with no separateness. He lives in all forms of life at the same time, time and space being annihilated. He can at will see and know what is transpiring in any part of our planet. Having received the three great gifts, the gold, frankincense and myrrh, at the birth of this new life, or we might say, having a true will (gold), having the knowledge of the priest (frankincense), and the intuition of the prophet (myrrh) he goes forth as the teacher.

Sometimes this exaltation is referred to as a "white soul," as an "old soul," or again, as in the Gnostic Fragments states a "first-class soul." Such a soul is a forerunner of a new cycle, for he wears the seamless coat of Truth undiminished. Let me give a quotation: "The meaning is that when the soul receives the Divine Seed, the first births are spotlessly white like unto the light of utmost purity, to radiance of the greatest brilliance, as though it were a shadowless light of the sun's beams from a cloudless sky at noon."

We can join in this seraphic vision the glory of the prophet who said, "Out of Egypt (spiritual darkness) have I called my Son," or another tragment from the mystic Luke, "And he shall reign over the house of Jacob (an arch or dome of the sky) forever." The soul is no longer wrapped in swaddling clothes, but fully become, having attained the spiritual majority.

Spiritual truths are not a little misleading when historicized. The spiritual birth of the Light-Christ is a perpetual event, and discovered we can affirm like Simeon (perception) in the Past, who rapturously exclaimed when he saw the Embodied Light in form, "Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace according to thy word: for mine eyes have seen thy salvation."

Neptune is the eighth planet, and the eighth mansion of the heavens esoterically denotes death, change, and a new cycle, a cutting off, or circumcision of the flesh. It also means "the gateway of eternity." The vibration hides in its fineness supernormal knowledge. Neptune rises out of the foam of the ocean, we read, out of states in which mankind were ages unconscious of Divine knowledge.

A soul under Neptune's vibrations is in communion—with—the soul of man as well as the soul of the universe, possessing the supra-

sensual or power and knowledge beyond forms, enjoying powers of pre-vision. It gives the rapture of a forward view of life, an unfettered spiritual knowledge. The soul in this exalted state is filled with the breath of God, an incarnation of holy Brahma, possessing reminiscence, not of one life but all the lives up and through all organic forms.

All true memories of the soul are memories of pleasure, beauty, of spiritual conquests and victory. Pleasure memories of the ordinary mind are easily retained, but more so of the soul, for the pleasure

sure memories are never lost or forgotten.

The child of Neptune is early aware of the awakened centers not physical, through which he recovers memories of the beginnings of a cycle of manifestation, the very history of the macrocosm. Through these perfected soul-centers he feels the very Source of life. Nature's secrets are revealed, for such a soul is a perfect lover of truth, and all his spoken words—being truth—become effective.

The macrocosm is faithful to the Divine direction, and in like manner the microcosm or cosmic man is Divinely directed, bringing forth a gem-producing idealism, a Divine body which ascends unto

the Father.

Reviewing the life of the soul, we see it ever an atomic part of the Divine Soul with powers like God's power, spiritual in essence. While the soul is enthralled in matter it seems for a time to forget it is a servant of Deity, and so, believes and enjoys its physical powers only, forgetting it enjoys these powers and will through God.

While in such form it has material desires and believes matter real, and so, is termed an "idolator," worshiping images, gripping to material things as of great value, and trouble indeed follows. But it cannot always act like a child, for the child must grow to maturity, therefore, the soul must, while in flesh, succumb to a rotative principle of matter in measured action like unto the Logos-form seen in the Solar-system. This rotative principle is the Solar-Logos, told many times in many ages in myth and mystery plays.

Matter is only a reflected power initiating the soul for a cycle of time, teaching the soul to unfold its vision, its power in Divine action. We have ignorantly thought of the laws of matter in terms of punishment, correctives administered by an angry God. We have perhaps wondered why we should be born in matter. It is to acquire knowledge and use of the soul's creative, god-like powers, and under the finer rhythm of Neptune, it loves to correct or modify all its desires and wills, that it may partake more of the Will and

Divine attributes of its Real Self.

This finer rhythm corresponds to the different hidden centers in the body, namely: the creative centers, also the psychic, phrenic, noetic, sympathetic, the whole of the cerebro-spinal system, and the aura. The virginal spiritual powers are awakened in these centers in silence. It is the winepress of the seven harvesters spoken of in

Revelation, also the glory aura and the glory authority.

Neptune acquaints us with the seven cities in the human body, Ephesos, Smyrna, Pergamos, Thyateira, Sardeis, Philadelphia, Laodikeia, which are but the names hiding the sealed vital powers and spiritual processes in the living consecrated temple, the body of man.

P. B. Therefore, the purposes of the Temple of the People are essentially the same as those given forth by the Theosophical Society when started in 1875 in New York City, the first of these objects being "to form a nucleus of a universal brotherhood of humanity without distinction of race, color, or creed." The

other objects, namely, to study and understand the psychic and latent powers in man and to study all of the religions of the world with a view of finding the thread of truth running through them all, have been constantly observed in the work and through the teachings sent out by the Temple of the People in its official magazine. The Vernal Equinox.

Much is being said today about the approach of the Vernal Equinox. What is meant by the Vernal Equinox and why is there so much talk about it this year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty Seven? THE GREAT PYRAMID

The Great Pyramid; Its Divine Message. By D. Davidson, M. C. M., Inst. Struct. E. and H. Aldersmith, M. B. (Lond.) F. R. G. S. London, \$8.00 postpaid. Halcyon Book Concern, Halcyon, Calif.

In this book the authors undertake, by a sifting of previous works and some contributions of their own, to bring the question of the nature and purpose of the pyramids, especially the Great Pyramid, to the most final scientific conclusions to date. But when the occultist opens the book and reads on the reverse of the title page that, "Jesus Christ by HIS DISPLACEMENT paid the purchase price of mankind's Redemption and effected the salvation of all who

truly believe on Him," he is prepared for shortcoming and shortcomings there are.

The book is an extensive work of nearly six hundred pages with many elaborate plates and tables together with mathematical and astronomical reckonings based on pyramidal dimensions and movements of the heavens affording valuable data for an advanced student. But it should have been written by an occultist; for there was, as every occultist knows, a vast body of occult knowledge possessed by the ancients which gave them an approach to life utterly at variance with that of modern science and certainly with that of Christian theology. Until researchers into the ancient world free themselves from the fetters now holding them, they never will rightly understand the works of the ancients. But be it said in this connection that his work and other recent books by the orthodox go far beyond the first bounds of even a few years ago, which is hopeful.

There is little doubt that the Great Pyramid stands as a "monument of measures", carrying the "Plans of the stars and historical and prophetic records". At many points the book comes near to the great truths recorded by the Pyramid but misses many because of its basic lack. At no point is the failure more evident than in the case of the Egyptian King Lists whose chronology the authors declare to be "entirely fictitious", unless, perhaps, it is in connection with the Biblical Deluge which is placed at 2345 B. C.

If the Pyramid stands as a divine instrument, measuring the precessional and the annual ages and cycles of the earth's history it must record more than one deluge. Seeing that the Pyramid was erected by the Atlantean Race and remembering Plato's story of Atlantis as told him by the Egyptian priests it is inescapable that record of this last, or Poseidonis deluge should appear in the geometry of the Great Pyramid. The priests told Solon that this del-

uge occurred 9600 B. C.

We can expect the Pyramid to record the cycles of human and terrestrial history from the dawn of things because every ancient people begins its story by telling the story of the race; and the story of the race is its own story. This is so because the divine pattern fits alike a universe of an atom; as above so below. And also because there is passage from the macrocosm into the microcosm by the law of correspondences. These correspondences are the bridges which preserve the unity of the Cosmos in the midst of its diversity. To illustrate: the year divides itself into four parts; the two equinoxes and the two solstices, and to these the day of twenty-four hours corresponds. Midnight corresponds to the winter solstice, morning to the vernal equinox, noon to the summer solstice, and evening to the autumnal equinox; as in the great so in the small.

Did the writers of this book know such as this they would know, when they turn to the early Biblical characters, that Adam is the name of an age and a stage of human evolution, and that the parallels they try to draw between the early Biblical characters and the Egyptian King Lists are cyclic parallels of time that mark off thousands of precessional years. They would know also that at the dawn of each age there is a Progenitor, a Father or Founder which fact validates the Egyptian King Lists and combines both myth and history, making the Kings of these Lists not mere monarchs who might have reigned three-score and ten, but the founders of ages; and the ages themselves. It is out of such knowledge as this that the Lists were made.

Furthermore, history, to them, did not exist as a mere—succession of events. In such a monument as the Pyramid history—was recorded, but it was soul history, history—from the viewpoint—of the inner life of man. From this we see that—the—ancients—were concerned with those epical events which fell upon the revolutions of cycles, many of which occur in the history of—men—and nations without being recorded by the historians of surface events—at—all; they are inner happenings. Or, perhaps they are recorded as purely astronomical or geological occurances when as a matter of occult fact they enter into the soul history of the race.

When we look at these matters from this point of view we see how futile are the efforts made by the orthodox to figure out the chronology of the Bible by what they find between its two covers and to discover the story of the Pyramid by the modus operandi of modern science. There is a dawning realization of the fact that to understand Bible dates aright, that is, to make them work reliable chronological way another key must be sought. in the Encyclopoedia Brittanica under the caption of Number pects that this key was held by the priests, and it is noted by the writers of this book that the priests of Egypt had a way of figuring pyramidal dates by a sort of theosophical reduction. But they discard this as being impossible. It is such as this, however, that will furnish the lost key by which the interpretations of the cyclical pyramidal records can be achieved. It is such as this that forms the "basic Principles" of Pythagoras which appear as foolishness the scientific mind; which scientific mind might do well to ask itself that if Pythagoras erected, above his "basic Principles," such magnificent superstructure of mathematics which they do understand isn't it possible that what they are looking on as foolishness is after all the depth of wisdom, carrying within it the true answer to the questions they are seeking to solve?

This book endeavors to make a final fixing of the date and of the Pharaoh of the Egyptian oppression of the Jews. But it is a question if any of the dates set, involving large cycles are correct.

The Father of an age, especially of an astrological age carries within himself both the age and the ruler of the age, which fact is often designated by his name. For instance, Abraham, or Abram

is compounded of Ab, or Ad, meaning father and Rama, the ram, which signifies the astrological Age of Aries. This definitely places the time of Abraham circ 2100 B. C., or at the dawn of the Age of Aries. And, in this connection we are constrained to ask, What relation exists between Abraham of the Hebraic MSS which compose the Old Testament and Ramses II of the Egyptian Kings, for, obviously, both names point to the same astrological setting.

Knowing as we do the clouded origin of the Bible MSS and knowing, also, that in Alexandria, when that Mecca of religious thought was in flower, there existed a group of Hebrew mystics who were the most powerful and influential scholars of the time, it appears as in no wise impossible that the Old Testament was written right out of Egypt, tho not by Egyptians. There has been more than a little speculation in this direction. But whether Abraham and Ramses signify the same High Master as Regent of the Age of Aries in the land where the Arian civilization really developed or not we are, in the light of the name, justified in placing the date of Ramses at about 500 years prior to the date assigned him by the authors of this book who make him out to be "the Pharaoh of the Oppression".

Albeit, there is a doubt if there ever was such a thing—as—an Oppression, the same being purely fictitious from the viewpoint of "history". It is history only in the sense in which—we—have—been considering history, viz., the story of the soul. Possibly the Israel-lies were in captivity, to the Egyptians as they were to the Babylonians. But such a fact, if fact it is, is merely used by—the—writer of Exodus as a peg upon which to hang the story of the soul. When the Jews got their new name, Israel, they discarded the name Jacob which means "to follow after".—Israel, according to Young's Concordance, means "ruling with God", and according to Swedenborg. "the celestial Spiritual man".—Egypt is made to stand as the land of darkness, plagues and suffering which beset the mortal man.

When the call came to the Israelites to "rule with God" they had to go up out of the land of darkness into the "promised land", the land or state of Redemption promised the soul from the day of its "fall" into generation. To get out of this land the soul has to cross the Red Sea. And what is the Red Sea? It is the sea of blood, the sea of the carnal man, the passional, animal man; of Adam whom the Rabbis called "the blood of the world". The "sea" also is the sea of Maya and mortality. The Israelites, born into the state of "the celestial Spiritual man" went up out of Egypt and the "waters" parted for they were prepared to "rule with God" in the Promised Land. But the Egyptians, dwellers in the land of darkness and children of the flesh pots, could not cross the sea; they were (are) those engulfed in the appetites and passions of the lower man.

Such is the story of the passage of the Red Sea which. taken

literally, is equal to the story of Jonah swallowing the whale, or was it the whale who swallowed Jonah? But these are the things the records of the ancients tell us, even the records of the Pyramid, and they must be known and accepted by the scientific researchers if

they ever hope to rightly know.

But by no means all of the calculations of the book can be subjected to adverse criticism; and, as said, there is a wealth of other material which is of deep interest to the student who is a matematician and an occultist. Upon the valuable scientific foundation afforded he can rear his own superstructure. There is a reading given in the Preface, and based on the passages and chambers of the Pyramid, the polar inch, and certain wall grooves which gives the dates of the beginning and the ending of the War. It says: "The Pyramid's astronomical dating for the Entrance Doorway of the 1st Low Passage into the Antechamber is the 4-5 August, 1924 A. D., and the dating for the termination of this passage on the threshold of the "Chamber of the Triple Veil' is 11th November, 1918 A. D."

If this is so another date given a little further on is of deep significance to Templars. As all Templars know, the Temple was founded an esoteric organization as the Order of The Sun, or of the 36, which is the Avataric Order for the Age of Aquarius. And to that Order the Master made the first scientific proclamation, based upon cyclic law, of the advent of the Avatar at the dawn of the coming Sixth Race. Since then all manner of information and rumor about the advent have sprung up. This was in 1898, and we are told that thirty years from that time, or 1928, would be a date of great moment. Hence it is interesting to find this date set down as an epical one foretold by the Pyramid! "It symbolizes also a second period of burden and tribulation—from 29th May, 1928 to 16th September, 1936 A. D."

I have found, and I think they will, that articles that particularly appealed to me, open my intuition to an understanding and appreciation of other articles more obscure".
