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THE TEMPLE

PRIMARILY, The Temple is a cosmic organic centre, the constitutent parts of which are the units of collective humanity.

Coincident with the original impulse, the first emanation from the Central Spiritual Sun—the Universal Heart—came into manifestation, the Father-Mother-Son, the triangular corner stone of The Temple, upon which is rising age by age, a geometrically perfect edifice. The organization of The Temple, the members of which belong by evolutionary right to a certain Degree of Cosmic Life, which Degree is subdivided into seven Orders, is the continuation and expansion of the work of the Masters revivified in this country a quarter of a century ago by certain chelas or disciples.

To the efforts of the Masters is due the impulse which has caused the great advance in scientific, philosophical and social endeavor; for they are the guardians of Ancient Wisdom and Knowledge, in which lies the root of all progress; and the work of The Temple is to cultivate and embody the highest principles of all such endeavor in one stupendous living organic whole.

It is a common belief that the fires of the altars of the Ancient Temples have been permitted to die out; but "those who know" say this is not true; that they are but hidden from the view of the masses, awaiting the time when the veil of ignorance and corruption hanging before the hearts of the humanity of this transitory period, shall be rent asunder, and the light of the ages becomes manifest to all. The time is comparatively close at hand when the doors of "The Temple of the Mysteries" shall once more swing outward. The Site of that once wonderful structure has been rediscovered, and when the Lord, the Saviour, the Elder Brother of the human race once more appears to claim his own, He will find a place prepared for him by those who, having heard his call, "Come over and help us," have faithfully responded, and have taken up their share of the burden of responsibility. 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

THE EVOLUTION OF THE STARS.

To those of us who believe that stars and stones, atoms and galaxies, are living entities, no less capable of growth and development than ourselves, it is of interest to know that modern astrophysics is busying itself with the study of the evolution of the stars. It has been discovered that even now stars are being born in the headens tof those which already exist, some are youthful, some in their print, and others are slowly sinking into old age and darkness. But the study of the stars cannot be carried out without, consideration of the firequires of atoms and their parts, and it is a striking fact that our knowledge of the smallest things of which we are aware is incomplete without a study of the largest, and vice versa.

To visualize the evolution of a star through its life history we must first get an idea of the scale of our universe. To begin with the earth and the moon and planets might seem the logical way, but we must endeavor to get away from the ties of our extremely self-important but cosmically unimportant world, and this can be more easily done by beginning with the largest and working down.

In the constellation of Andromeda is a small hazy-looking object, which can be seen with the naked eye, but which in a moderately good telescope appears as a small diffuse spiral disk. All evidence points to the fact that this spiral nebula is another universe like our own, if by our universe we denote the stellar system which

includes the Milky Way and all the stars which appear to us as individual spots of light in the sky. This distant universe is so far away that to speak of it as being so many miles from us would convey no meaning; instead astronomers tell us that it is well over 200,000 light years away, where a light year is the distance a beam of light will travel in one year across empty space, at the rate of 186,000 miles a second. Thus a light year is over five thousand billion miles. This means, then, that the light by which we see the great spiral nebula in Andromeda left that universe over 200,000 years ago. Indeed, the whole nebula might have gone out of existence 190,000 years ago, and we would still be able to see it for the next 10,000 years. Other island universes have been discovered which are over 1,000,000 light years away. The light by which we see them must have left them when man was very young upon this earth

Let us imagine ourselves living, not in our own stellar universe, but on some world in this distant nebula of Andromeda. We are looking from this new vantage point up into the sky on a dark summer night. We see countless stars around us; these go to make up—the nebula in which we live. But what is that small hazy patch—up—to the left? Ah, astronomers tell us, that is a very important object; it is a distant nebula containing over a billion stars. It—is—almost 100,000 light years across. Somewhere about 10,000 light—years from its center is an insignificant star which is called The Sun, but it is too small to see without the largest—telescopes. Those—stars look very closely packed in space from here, but in reality they—are tremendously far apart. Thus the nearest star to the Sun—is—over twenty thousand billion miles from it.

Now let us come back to our earth and examine this galaxy in which we live from the inside. It is a tremendous disk shaped affair, much greater in diameter than it is thick. When we look off through an edge we see the stars very thickly packed—the Milky Way--, while off to one side they are much sparser. Our Sun is but one of countless millions of stars in this system; how many of them may have planets of their own, with worlds such as ours? If such exist we have no direct knowledge of them; we are justified in feeling, however, that it would be a peculiar thing if our Sun were—the only star blessed with planets, while there are millions of others just like it. If we study these stars individually through the largest telescopes, we can see nothing but points of light, since they are so far away, but we can find out much about them. Many of them have been weighed and measured. Their external and internal temperatures have been found, together with the substances of which they are composed. In this way astronomers have been led to classify the stars in different groups, and it is becoming increasingly apparent that the different groups contain stars of different ages and degrees of development. Some are very large and red in color,

and are supposed to be quite young. Others are almost as large, but are white hot and much brighter. These form the middle-aged groups. Finally, still others are red but are extremely small, and

this stage marks the falling of the star into old age.

Let us trace the probably life history of a star. In the beginning we have a large, fairly cool mass of vapor, a gaseous nebula, which stretches for billions and billions of miles through Such gaseous nebulae can be seen in various parts of the but should not be confused with the spiral nebulae, which tant island universes. The atoms in this mass of 'vapor each other by the force of gravitation, and the whole mass, course of millions of years, slowly condenses into a smaller volume. As this condensation takes place the nebula becomes—warmer, cause the atoms are closer together and rebound from each more often. So we have the mass of vapor getting denser and hotter, until finally it is condensed enough to be called a real star, a tremendously large star formed of hot gases. Such a star is called giant, and a number of the most famous stars of the heavens in this class.

We can now visualize the process by which this star grows old-As it radiates light and heat into space it cools off, which causes its matter to condense still further. Apparently the process condensation more than balances the heat radiated, for the star becomes hotter instead of colder, and finally reaches a state of heat, all the while becoming smaller and denser. This process continues through countless ages until the star has reached the point where it can no longer become hotter while radiating, and it then begins to cool off, still getting smaller. It has now passed its prime and is nearing old age. Our sun is in this condition, for it is a small red star. Finally the star is no longer even red hot, and it grows colder and colder and eventually becomes a dark body. How many these dark dead suns there may be in the heavens we have no sent way of knowing. A few such have been detected when happened to be near enough to bright stars to swing around them in orbits and at times eclipse their light.

In this picture of the birth, growth, and final death of a star we have omitted the most important point, namely the source of the energy which the star radiates as heat and light for countless millions of years. Many theories have been proposed, but it has not been until within the last few years that a satisfactory one has been found. Our own star, the sun, must have been at about the same temperature as it is at present for at least a billion years past, for rossil remains show that life of the type we know today existed on this earth that long ago, and organisms of this sort cannot exist at temperatures more than a few score degrees hotter or colder than our present earth temperature. This tells us that the cooling off process of a star must be an extremely slow one, for there is no rea-

son to suppose our own star exceptional. It has become necessary to suppose that the interior of a star is a laboratory where matter

is actually being transformed into energy.

The temperature of the outside of a star may be found from its color; white stars are in the neighborhood of 30,000 degrees Fahrenheit, while a red star, like the sun, is only one-third as hot. But the temperature at the center is many times as great; in fact, the clue to the source of solar energy comes from the fact that a number of stars of widely different outside temperature are found to have the same central temperature of about 70,000,000 degrees F. Apparently this is the temperature at which matter breaks down into energy; presumably a positive proton, or atomic nucleus, and a negative electron annihilate each other as matter, and a pulse of


energy is born.

The stars thus become giant thermostats, and are perfect—devices for providing light and heat at a uniform rate for billions years, so that worlds like our own can be kept at a constant temperature to serve as cradles of life of the form we know. When the sun becomes too hot it expands and cools slightly, which lowers its central temperature below the critical value of seventy million degrees, and matter is no longer transformed into energy. If the sun becomes too cool, it condenses and the rise in temperature sets free some more matter as energy which slowly fights its way through the atoms of which the sun is composed and finally emerges at its surface, to travel off through the ether as a heat wave. rate of energy radiation from the surface of a star is thus constant for many billions of years, or until so much of its matter is turned into energy that there is no longer sufficient left to raise the internal temperature to 70,000,000 degrees F., when the star as a whole Then does the star indeed ccase to function as a sun; and the worlds it illumines grow cold. The life which inhabits them must then take on forms at present unknown to exoteric science.

Owing to pressure of work at this Christmas season, the usual columns which we devote to the Blavatsky Department will be omitted in this issue, and in their place we are printing the accompanying photograph of the rostrum of the Memorial Temple at Halcyon. The folding chair seen at the left of the rostrum was the property of H. P. Blavatsky, and she carried it from place to place in her travels in the Orient... This chair was presented to the Temple by the Countess Canavarro who is at present a resident of Los Angeles, California. The Countess Canavarro was for many years Buddhist missionary in Ceylon and so endeared herself to the natives by her work among the Ceylonese women and children that on her departure for America the Governor of Ceylon asked her what she would like to take with her as a slight token of their good will. Madame Canavarro selected this chair, and decided that the proper place for it would be the Temple at Halcyon, where it now occupies an honored position on the rostrum of the Memorial Temple, a fitting tribute to the great soul of H. P. B., who laid the foundation in the hearts of the western people for the work which the Temple is doing.

The Countess Canavarro obtained knowledge of the Temple through friendly contact and association with a Temple member of many years standing, namely, Mrs. Dell Munger of Glendale, Calif. Mrs. Munger told Countess Canavarro all about the Temple work, its fundamental purposes and objects, and its line with the Great Lodge and H. P. B. Hence her decision and desire that the H. P. Blavatsky traveling chair find a permanent and honored place in the

Temple.

It always indicates impingement of My Aura, upon the near physical for constructive effort and use. It is the most satisfactory means available for distributing force generally, and for giving the immediate or individual touch. It is most important. that you keep within the Aura of Sandelwood Force at this time in conscious intimateness and for some weeks to come, most particularly during the waning of the Moon. You should be inpositive with the Ledge, its desires and forces, in order that the negative aspect of opposition be overcome by your own auric power more than by the outer position and action you may and will have to take."

Only a portion of this instruction message is given, but it will be sent out to all members as soon as possible, with appropriate comments. Members at a distance may always be sure, however, that as they are in harmony with the center, whatever Lodge Forces impinge on this Center flow outward to them also, in proportion to their spiritual aspirations.

THE DAY COME TO US

The Master Message, The New Day, published elsewhere in these pages, is so suggestive, so full of mental "meat", so bounteously replete with material for discourse and discussion, as to provoke many phases of Hermetic inquiry. It offers many points, angles, surfaces and contacts for analysis, comparison and synthesis according to the seven-fold interpretations offered by Occult Law.

The wise Son of Hermes will, as a most direct route to understanding the principles and prophecies buried in symbol and poetic anagery, apply his unfailing key of Matter, Force and Consciousness, the "Triple Key" of Temple Teachings. And although there are Divine, Celestial, Cosmic, Human and Mundane analogies in this master presage, a major clavis is offered for our guidance in the accepted language of The Stars, with allusions to their cyclic periods, their functions and influences, as well as their definitive intervention in the affairs of men: The Astrological significance carries alchemical imports which are obvious and invite deep study.

"An important measure of Time closed August 19, 1927, on the Harr and Figure marked by the Clock of Kronos..... The curse of Father Kronos is all but fulfilled". This message must be linked up with a Master Message, dated January 1, 1901, given to an inner

order of the Temple at that time. It reads:

"Within the beginning of the New Cycle there returns within the orbit of the earth a conscious Entity who has not operated in this sphere of action for 5000 years. It comes clothed in a form of Electro-magnetic energy from the planet Saturn; and the battles between it and the disintegrating energy, to which I have repeatedly alluded, will be fierce indeed. The first is a building power, the last a destroying power. Man will be either the playground of, or the coadimor with, one or the other of these great Cosmic Entities."

This reference to the rampant forces of the past cycle, whose influx culminated so dramatically at the specified time, apprises us of the impingment on the earth aura of certain major Evolutionary Forces, working through the regency of the planets. Their nature, attributes, powers and purposes, together with the omens of counter-activities of opposing forces, is described. The tragic fulfilment of the portent has been so woefully verified as to need no recapitulation in this generation.

The direct sequel to this dire prophecy was cataclysmic. How the battle between Cosmic Titans recoiled upon our little star, exacting its bloody toll in human sacrifice, is writ upon the still trembling Akashic Records. How the conflict between the constructive and disintegrating powers found its reaction on mankind is still poignant in the minds of those who suffered and endured their particular scarification. These tremble at the idea of a fresh Armageddon—hinted at with scant semblance of vagueness in the veiled

auguries of Those Who Know.

It must be emphasized that one of the vital offices of Saturn is to teach that things are not always what they seem. But even under the cognomen of Satan he functions both good and evil, since out of the depths of discord, inharmony and dissonance, by vibrating the opposite pole of the same impelling force is re-created concord, harmony and consonance. Lucifer redeemed, regenerate, becomes once more Son of Morning Light and is replaced in the Heavens as Pon of the Sky. (See Temple Teachings, page 467).

Saturn construed as Peter standing at the gates of Heaven seeking Illumination represents the lower understanding, cold, calculating brain intellect, which must be co-ordinated, lifted up, to the higher faculty of Intuition, the soul quality of spiritual insight, before it can grasp and function the Divine attributes of Justice

and Truth.

In his undeveloped or negative vibration he is Kama Manas, which must be clarified in its self-centered and in-turned vision of the Lower Self, with its crystallized objectives, inhibitions and lusts. Not that Saturn is immersed in the senses or the sensuous, for Saturn is Chastity personified, having been emasculated by his father, Uranus, Higher Mind. In the matrix of sorrow, affliction, limitation, denial, disappointment and disillusionment, is begot a higher order of senses, finer perceptions, nobler ideals, with aspirations to purer joys and deeper harmonies than those merely transitory, superficial and fleshly.

Though his blessings may be long deferred and although he makes his children WORK for them, yet his rewards for steadfastness, loyalty, patience, perseverance and purity, are manifold, rich and enduring. Benefices to Old Age are his particular delight. Eventually, to those who intelligently submit to his chastening and disciplinary rod, he gives contentment, peace, possessions, with

many interior blessings of substantial mystical value. These find implications in Saturn "devouring his children", a legend carrying many interpretations, astrological, alchemical, occult, and spiritual.

In the message The New Day these children of Saturn are alladed to as "the personal gods of exotericism" expressing through intellectualism, intelerance, bigotry, superstition, false—notions—of Modernism as well as Fundamentalism, in which the Letter is magnified and the Spirit submerged.

Sometimes we see Kronos depicted as devouring the years in the shape of children, little boys and girls representing the seasons. Sometimes we see him carrying a scythe in one hand and a scrpent swallowing its tail in the other, emblematic of the Revolution of Ages, the Renovator of Cycles, God of the Cycle and the Golden Sickle or Scythe,—which gives us our symbol of Saturn. With the scythe of Time he reaps the golden harvest, for in his dual capacity me plays the role of harvester and reaper as well as planter and sower. As Lord of the Harvest he "returns again with great joy bringing his sheaves" (redeemed children) with him.

As Father of the Gods, or planets, he gathers up the attributes, qualities and powers of the other planets and in the purgatorial crucible of Time purifies and transmutes them into sublimated principles of Eternal Law and Order. He translates the shades and shadows of Illusion and Form into definitive lines of Truth and Readity, converting the shells and husks of Kama Manas into the quickened germ of Spiritual Substance, all in the smoldering philosophic fires in the chrysalis of Time. Through curiosity, intellectual greed, he piques the lower mind into exploring into deep wells of learning, thought, reason, philosophy, but to conspire to overthrow their findings by showing up their fallacy and futility unless—they be illuminated by the soul's torch of Intuition or informed—by—the Immortal logic of Wisdom.

A less metaphysical concept is that in the mincing maw of Time, through the slow processes of days, hours, years, is swallowed, ingested, digested, assimilated, transmuted, all of those actions, experiences, knowledges—all purely physical and phenomenal objectives incident to human living, those things transitory, expedient or mutable in nature—which are to be consumed, resolved, metabolized, into elements, substances, essences and principles that are subjective, superphysical, illimitable, changeless and unconditioned. Time must be swallowed in eternity, Dross transmuted into Gold, Saturn into Sol.

According to some of the myths "instead of children they (i. e. Rhea) gave him a stone." A stone, a rock, petros, lapis. "Thou art Peter and upon this rock I will build my church." "Ye also as lively stones are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood." "A stone (understanding) shall become a great nation and fill all the earth." Mystically a stone has the most significant, of meanings,

with parallels Divine, cosmic, human, as emphasized in the Hermetic Art, since it is here, as the Philosopher's Stone, that we find the most cogent alchemical and spiritual correspondences to the work of the Temple, as to its individual units, in its relation to the Temple of humanity, which it typifies; all being now in the testing tubes of Saturnian forces, purgative and separative, preparatory to the transmutations of "The New Day". Each individual Templar, as "a stone in the guardian wall" of the new humanity, should stand prepared for the processes of The Great Sifter.

BOOK REVIEWS

Music and Health and Drum Talk.—By Eva Augusta Vascelius and Louise Vescelius-Sheldon. Third printing, enlarged edition, de luxe, bound in flexible leather. Goodyear Book Shop. Price \$3.00.

Music and Health is a condensed collection of the MSS of the late Eva Augusta Vescelius. Founder and President of the National Society of Musical Therapeutics, devoutly collated and edited by her sister and co-worker, Mme. Louise Vescelius-Sheldon. It has as its theme the theory and practice of Rhythm. Harmony. Melody, in relation to health maintenance and healing in the individual and the institution.

From far historic reaches it graciously moves through myth and legend. Oriental and Hellenic, through the mystical technic of the Pythagorean cultus and the Therapeautae, lightly touching the limpid strains of the Hebrew songsters, accenting the palpable apprehensions of the Master Musicians as to rhythmic and tonic reactions of remedial potencies, climaxing the narrative by the modern recognition of music and melody as accepted agencies for healing "this sick and poisoned world".

While not a textbook Music and Health analyzes physiological, nervous, mental and emotional responses, indeed, general therapeutical influences, of music, vocal and instrumental, upon the ill and ailing in home, prison, workshop, and insane asylum. The book sketches the progress of the movement from a mere personal adventure in healing, to its widespread adoption as a nationally accepted instrument for alleviating and harmonizing the sick in mind and body.

It is rich in incident and example of the efficiency of its theory that "music is not only an Art and a Luxury, but a Necessity". It

is highly recommended to those seeking practical information as well as suggestive hints as to the employment of vibration, rhythm, melody and harmony for uplift and cure. Musicians will find it de-

lightfully illuminating and inspiring.

The volume modestly harbors three wondrous chapters by Mme. Vescelius-Sheldon herself, under the caption "Drum Talk". Filching a bit of "Comet's hair;" with broad sweep and seductive, she flies fluently from South Africa to Paul Whiteman, the apostle of modern Jazz. She tells how the Kaffir boy with his telegraphic beat upon a tree trunk, "Drum Talk," anticipated the Morse Code and wireless antennae by a thousand years. In historic incident and biographical bit she outlines the inception of the Negro Spiritual, "ragtime" and current "jazzmania" with such gripping narrative and rippling reminiscence as to kindle the hope that there are more "Drum Talks" on the press. A Traveller Through Time.—Glimpses of a Soul's Past, by Letita Withall, Percy Lund; Humphreys and Co., London. This brochure is a prose poem of lyrical beauty and mystical quality. It is loftly conceived, deftly developed, and convincingly sets—forth the recollections of a pilgrim soul through its wheel of Incarnations. Its manner holds a message of mystical value, as well by its literary high spots as by transcendent flights into Celestial ethers. The Recoveries are in short story form, charming and inspiring. —G.
