The declared objects of the Society of THE TEMPLE OF THE PEOPLE are:

- First:—To establish a nucleus and a vehicle for the essential UNITY of all life.
- Second:—To bring about a greater understanding of UNIVERSAL BROTH-ERHOOD and the enlightenment of all people.
- Third:—To promote a universal understanding and toleration of TRUTH by a diligent study of comparative religion, making science religious and religion scientific. Since TRUTH is an integral part of the nature and being of all WORLD RELIGIONS, there never can be, except by faulty under standing a conflict between the religions of the world.

The Society owes no allegiance or subordination to the authority of any power, body or office outside its own sphere of administration, vested in the Guardian-In-Chief, except that due respect is declared for every requirement of civil law.

The Temple Of The People: situate in the County of San Luis Obispo. State of California, U. S. A., shall be known as International Head-quarters of the Society of THE TEMPLE OF THE PEOPLE. Here shall be established the permanent residence of the Guardian-In-Chief and members of the Temple Synod.

MEMBERSHIP

- Members-At-Large:—Shall consist of all who have signed an application blank for admittance into the Temple Of The People, and pay the annual dues of six dollars. These members are considered in the light of probationers for the Order of the 36.
- Templars:—Shall consist of those members who have served the specified time (not less than one year) as members-at-large, and have been admitted into the Order of The 36, or Esoteric Section of the Society, upon the approval of the Guardian-In-Chief. These members are known as full participating members. The annual dues are seven dollars.
- Temple-Square-Members:—Shall consist of those members who are non-resident at Headquarters, but active full-participating members of the Society through a chartered Temple Square.
- Temple Square:—Seven members may make application for a Charter to organize a Temple-Square.
- Inner-Orders:—There are various Inner-Orders of the Society. Information regarding these Orders is not given out publicly.

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


THE HAIL OF CHRIST

Law and Prayer

Temple Teachings. Open Series No. 272

Over and over again, in some slightly changed form, some one of you put the same questions to me; over and over again I make the same reply. Unconsciously to yourselves, you often ask that the governing laws of the universe be changed, in order that some personal idiosyncrasy or desire be gratified. I can tell you of things to come, as I am able to judge by visible signs, as well as by my knowledge of interior laws. I can tell you how certain catastrophes might be averted if the humanity of this age would listen and obey, but bear in mind, I cannot change the laws that govern manifesting matter; I cannot make two and two make five; I cannot take two pecans from five and leave four, although I might be able to make you believe that I nad accomplished this feat, by means of hypnosis or some other ultra-physical power.

One of the greatest difficulties you are experiencing lies in your inability to accept as literally true the statements given out by me and others, regarding the action of universal laws.

The unyielding, unpliable man is invariably the man that is broken on the wheel of the world. The pliable man bends beneath the storm, and the storm either passes over and leaves him untouched or touches him so lightly, in comparison, that his rebound to a normal position is accomplished with but very little difficulty.

The strained, tense condition of the nerves, from which countless thousands of people are now suffering, is responsible for much of the evil that falls upon them. The same law that renders relaxation of the body necessary is behind an equal necessity for soul relaxation. The law commonly known as gravitation, and true prayer (aspiration) should be this relaxation of soul.

If the positive energy of intense desire is sent, and the energy is not powerful enough to force accomplishment of the desire, that energy is dissipated, and the body in which it was generated and by which it was sent forth, is broken or beaten down by the reflex action.

While in a perfect state of relaxation, if the soul, from the higher point of renunciation, sends forth a prayer to the Infinite—not for some personal favor, but of faith and love for that Infinite—the same law which compels one pole of electricity to respond to the other will compel a response from those Infinite Domains, and the response will be in accordance with the real needs of the aspiring soul.

You will frequently find that the surest way of winning a thing is to give up even the desire for that thing.

Thought is one form of energy; words are another form. Combined, they create a third form, and true prayer is this third form. Generated and sent out from the human heart it can go as far as its inherent power can take it. If the prayer or aspiration is selfish, it meets, on an interior plane, other forms of the same energy, the desires of which are in opposition to it. One neutralizes or destroys the other, and the consequence is, neither reaches those who have power to answer.

The wisdom of the ages is comprised in the words spoken by Jesus: "Not my will, but thine be done." It is only prayers preceded by that sentence, and winged by unselfish love, that asks only to love, not for love, that Omnipotence can answer.

The highest power is only won by renunciation. Renounce with thy whole heart, love with thy whole heart, work with thy whole heart, and all things in heaven and earth are thine.

Creative Fires

To all Templars: When the human race comes into a realization that the divine creative fires are generated by specific vibrations set in motion by mental, spiritual and physical power, there will be much less cause for friction between personalities who have chosen different methods for awakening those rates of vibration. All creative and preservative fires are divine whatever be the method of their materialization.

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Deficiencies of Modern Chemistry

A truly great chemist will be the first to admit the deficiencies of modern chemistry, although it ranks among the exact sciences among the superficial devotees of that branch of study.

When any substance is reduced to its elements the chemist faces an unsolvable problem, but these so-called elements are, in most cases, capable of further investigation, if one were able to bring to bear upon them the right combination of matter and force.

The different gradations from spirit to matter are so silently and unobtrusively accomplished that the line of demarcation is seldom observable. But the time will come when a delicate instrument capable of recording vibrations far more rapid than any now noted will prove conclusively this line of demarcation, the effects of heat in combining and the effects of cold in separating the different states of substance.

(CONCLUDED)

Question: What is the teaching regarding the Avatar?

The general tendency of the evolution of spirit into matter was from unity into diversity. Spirit had to spread through and permeate the universe. Just as the sap flows in the spring into the trunk, bough, branch, twig and leaf of the tree and then bursts forth into blossom and fruit, so the ensouling force goes out from the state of sleep into that of waking. The sap of the cosmic tree penetrates the various planes in their order, permeates them with its force, and impels them into outer expression. Then the culminating point is reached and the fruit is ripened on the tree, the sap commences to flow downward again into the roots and is gradually withdrawn into the reservoir of force. After this fruition a period of dormancy ensues, and exactly the same process occurs in the cosmic tree, the universe.

The withdrawing of the sap back inward again in the case of the cosmic tree consists of a gradual spiritualization and unification of the parts which were differentiated in the process of the evolution of spirit into matter. Each part has to be redeemed after its crucifixion in matter, and in this process the Temple has its part to play: "Great Unifier, Spirit of Universal Harmony, Love and Wisdom," etc. The Temple force must be a unifying one and we who have lived at the Center, and indeed many elsewhere, feel it and know it.

The many tribulations through which we have passed together have bound our hearts in bonds of holy brotherhood as nothing else could, and, no doubt, we have ahead of us many more trials and troubles which will, of course, bind us in still closer ties. All humanity is going through this process. We at Halcyon are merely an expression in a small way of what is going on all over the world. But perhaps the fact that we are getting such a great influx of Lodge force will account for the trials and victories also, for only by friction between the higher and the lower can victory be won, and if this be the case, then no doubt we are gaining spiritually as a result of the educational process which comprises all these trials and struggles.

Perhaps in human life the keynote of the new upward cycle will be giving rather than getting. Possibly the point has been passed where spirit had to grasp and permeate every cell and molecule; and now it must turn and commence, like the prodigal son, the journey toward its Father's house. Perhaps, inspired by what love it can draw down from the inner spheres, with will as a driving power and what wisdom it has gained as a result of its experiences in matter to guide it, it will now begin to draw together again and gradually establish on earth the community of spirit which exists already in heaven. This is no doubt the force which is impelling into act on and precipitating on to the physical plane many efforts along co-operative lines which have been undertaken in recent years.

It has taken humanity many, many years to reach its present condition of diversity, and it will, no doubt, require many years for it to regain a condition of absolute brotherly love and equality and liberty, but this is the goal it must attain and this is the path it must tread.

As I understand the teachings of Theosophy, the Dhyan-Chohans are the spiritual forces which form the inspiring power which causes a blossoming forth at the beginning of a manvantara or period of expression. Let us think of them as the sap which is encased during the winter time in the root of the tree. The universe gradually unfolds, first a very tenuous something which I suppose could hardly be described by words, except perhaps to say that it is basic matter-substance inspired by basic mind, the original Father and Mother. The Dhyan-Chohans commence to incarnate; the sap flows into the trunk. The next step is into the psychic plane. The matrices of what will be men in the future commence to coalesce. Universal mind begins to throw basic matter into form, but the forms are tenuous and unsubstantial, composed of "such stuff as dreams are made of." Yet they are ensouled with the mind force which flows downward from the Dhyan-Chohans. The sap is flowing into the boughs of the tree of life.

From this plane we descend in the next outbreathing into the astral plane, which we will consider as analogous to the branches and twigs of the tree. We will not try to follow the evolutionary flow in further detail, but no doubt the analogy could be carried on right through the large cycles. When the tree has blossomed and fruited the sap begins to flow inward again towards its winter reservoir in the roots, and when the period of expression is passed and the fruit of the cycle of manifestation is ripened, the resultant essence is the aggregation of Dhyani Euddhas. They are the cream resultant from the churning process which

has been gone through. The stream of life returns to its source plus the self-consciousness which has been gained on the journey.

Now, of course, the general trend of this indrawing is one of unification. At the outpouring of force at the beginning of a manvantara the tendency was toward diversity. This breaking up into small divisions occurred in all the ramifications of life, and probably a student of sociology could show how men in the early period of history have passed downward from a communal state into a purely individualistic one.

Earlier in this paper I have tried to point out that as at the present time the trend is upward toward communal life again, isolated efforts in co-operation and even in communism are being made. The unifying force is trying to push its way through the shell of individualism, and undoubtedly a communistic system will prevail in human life in the not far distant future. The sap of the tree of life is now commencing on its return journey to the Father in heaven and the first impulse it feels is toward unity.

The problem which confronts humanity will be how to arrange and adjust things to this new vibration, and the problem must and will be solved. A little experience in group co-operation will quickly prove that while all will readily agree on principles, yet in the application of those principles in practice a vast difference of opinion will occur, and friction, failure and dispersal only too frequently result. The divine impulse toward unity is split up on entering the lower mind and immediately diversity occurs. Quite often this failure is attributed to the selfishness of the individual, and quite often it is due to this cause. But possibly quite as often it is due to the fact that on joining such a group each member has a slightly different idea as to method, and when they are placed closely together in daily life each naturally expects the other to think as he does, and friction results.

Many communistic colonies have been formed and practically always have split on this rock. When there is a common purse the business of one automatically becomes the business of all, and therefore everyone s quite justified in interfering with the actions of everyone else, and t is very doubtful that brotherly love will result, except perhaps event-ally through the path of pain.

When this point is presented to the idealist he usually replies that his should not be so, that we should work together for the common ood more faithfully and well than for ourselves. This is perhaps true. We should and no doubt work in this way some time, but as the plored gentleman said, "Ought to be aint is," and the writer has yet

to see an example of it in a whole organized community. Isolated individuals do work as unselfishly and faithfully for others as for themselves, and no doubt these good souls are unconsciously leavening the lump.

approach the state of communism. One method would be that of forming plans and making laws which would tend in that direction. A matrix or mould is created out of the imagination and humanity is to be run into this mould willy-nilly and gradually induced to be brotherly whether it will or no. Perhaps, in order to externalize brotherhood and real communism by the second method, we must use the triple key again—Love, Will and Wisdom. Creeds will never open the door to brotherhood. Laws may help, systems and methods may help, but the only thing which can bring real brotherhood on earth is the triple key: Love, Will and Wisdom.

The Temple motto is: "Creeds disappear, hearts remain." When a question presents itself the solution under this method would be not to ask oneself, "Is this the law? Is this according to convention or habit or the like." but rather to say to oneself: "Which course of action—this or that—will according to my best judgment, conduce the more greatly to unity and brotherhood on earth?"

Jesus was the last Avatar to appear on earth. His incarnation into the flesh brought a new vibration. A new keynote was struck. Another Avatar is rapidly approaching incarnation. His vibration is already stirring the hearts of men toward the opening cycle of a still higher vibration. The force brought into the world by Jesus, which has so vitally influenced the race, will on the advent of the coming Avatar be stepped down, so to speak, one degree and put into expression on the outer plane. Here we have the key for future co-cperative effort. Instead of forming systems and laws and compelling adherence to the letter of the law, the new cycle will be inspired with the spiritual law.

Man will tune in with the deeper and richer chimes of the inner spheres and be thereby brought into closer touch with the Lodge of Masters and his own Higher Self. The vehicle for the expression of the Avatar is forming now, and all the true aspiration and selfless service which may be rendered by humanity form the material out of which this vehicle is being created.

Gradually universal mind is being diverted by the Avataric force as it impinges upon human mind, out of the ruts of selfish aggrandizement into the grooves of selfless service, and this—that is to say the application of the intellect toward the guidance of Nature's forces for divine purpose—is Wisdom.

Pelican Visits Our Convention Picnic, August, 1933

Last August, during the convention picnic, a number of us were gathered together on the edge of the sand dunes on the Temple picnic grounds. Some of the people were preparing the food, others were talking together in small, informal groups; still others wading in the ocean, when suddenly some one called our attention to a soaring bird coming from the direction of the dunes. Larger and larger it became as it circled over our heads and we realized that this bird was no ordinary sea gull, but a great pelican.
