COSMICALLY The Temple of the People corresponds to the femple of Humanity.

THE TEMPLE of Humanity consists of all humans who, having awakened into a knowledge of their own divinity, have undertaken to tread the Path, and of those who devote their lives to the unselfish service of mankind.

SPECIFICALLY The Temple of the People is one of the bodies or vehicles for the manifestation of the Avatar or Christos for the New Dispensation, the dawn of the New Civilization for the races of the earth. Fourth: To promote the study and practice of Art on fundamental lines, showing that Art is in reality the application of knowledge to human good and welfare, and that the Christos can speak to humanity through Art as well as through any other fundamental line of manifestation.

Fifth: The promotion of a knowledge of true social science based on immutable law, showing the relationship between man and man, and man and God and nature. When these relationships are understood we will instinctively formulate and follow the law of true brotherhood.

RELIGION, SCIENCE, AND ECONOMICS, these are the foundation stones of The Temple. There can be no true religion without its scientific basis, and there can be no right economic system not based on a science that is religious and a religion that is scientific.

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EDITORIAL MIRROR

When one desires to enter the path of occultism and seeks entrance to the doorway that leads to spiritual illumination, one of the requisites of the aspirant is to voluntarily renounce all that in any way hinders his development; renounce everything that impedes or obstructs his further progress.

As one desires to make true advancement along these lines, the selfish and useless life must be abandoned because he now enters into a covenant with his Higher Self and his Master. So from that time on he is accountable to Him, and to Him alone; and when truly accepted, all that has been given up is won back again, but it now belongs to the whole rather than the personal self. The personal will becomes subservient to the Divine Will. Every step of the way is won by Renunciation, motivated by Love, Understanding and Discrimination.

As one seeks surcease from the outer confusion and turmoil, distress and suffering, he must realize that in order to attain the highest spiritual knowledge each and everyone must work this out on the plane of struggle where there is noise and disturbance and general disruption until every fibre of his being is translated into a higher substance, which must be accomplished through renunciation and sacrifice.

Selfishness is the antithesis of selflessness. While one takes all for personal gain, the other gives all and as a result gets all in renouncing. In taking for personal gain, one draws together the negative forces of evil and thus destroys the real things in life. In giving up, one gathers the higher forces in constructive effort and this leads to the highest attainment. These two lines cannot exist at the same time; one or the other must be followed, and, for true advancement, one must work with the positive forces and abandon the selfish course.

The following advice was given to one of the leaders of The Temple in 1896 by W. Q. Judge in answer to a question on Renunciation.

"It is true that from the standpoint of the world renunciation after renunciation seems a terrible thing, but how does it appear from the point of view of **one who has renounced?** Has he nothing in the place of that which he has renounced? Has he not power

and knowledge which he could have attained in no other way, and can he not become a co-worker with nature? The valleys and planes are only delightful and pleasant to those who know nothing of the mountain heights; and strenuous exertion and renunciation are required by one who would climb to the highest peaks; but once reached the climber finds himself above all storms and clouds; he has reached the eternal sunlight and found the peace which passeth all understanding. From below, the mountain top seems to be enveloped in clouds and fog, and it requires a strong conviction and an undaunted courage to enter the cloud, but the cloud only shuts off the world of reality from the world of illusion, and in the end we shall find that what we have renounced is the illusion and that what we have is the reality. The renunciation is, however, very real at the time, because our life is so covered over by illusion and this illusion appears to us to be the reality. It is only after the conflict with, and the domination of, the lower self that we shall be able to distinguish the real from the seeming and to know what true Peace is."

True peace is the neutral center where the veil of illusion has been lifted, the struggle with the lower self has been vanquished, and the results of renunciation are realized. The Soul no longer struggles with the things that seem so real, but forgets self and sacrifices and renounces its all for the good of the whole, remembering at all times the eternal truth that all men are now and have always been One in Essence; all have the same ultimate goal in their evolutionary progress.

When the Soul has finished its journey through the maze and intricacies of the path, it can enter the sacred abode where Divinity calls its own to itself—the Place of Peace, the neutral center, where renunciation lilies fill the cosmos with their essence of purity, fragrance and beauty.

THE LORDS OF KARMA

Temple Teachings, Open Series, No. 214

In one sense the Lords of Karma are the administrators of Divine Justice—the Supreme power of the Universe, the Lord God Omnipotent—the first reflection of the Absolute—the creator of motion, therefore the creator of cyclic action upon which all law is dependent.

The Lords of Karma-high spiritual entities-guide and direct the action of every form of force and energy set free by gods, angels or men. The Higher Self of man is his own judge and executioner, but the Higher Self can only apply the effects of a given cause to the personal self after the Lords of Karma have neversed the stream of energy set free by that personal self as a tesult of any act that is contrary to law, for Divine Law cannot be broken with impunity. Disobedience to a Divine Law may obstruct the action of that law temporarily, but cannot do so permanently. Cyclic action will ultimately bring about conditions comparable to those which existed at the time the law was broken. The Karmic results of the disobedience may have been worked out in the meantime, leaving, as it were, opportunity for final adjustment and a clear field at the close of the cycle.

Man is so bound by familiar terms of expression, he is greatly handicapped in his efforts to understand super-physical phenomena when they are presented in unfamiliar terms, and there are but few terms in the English language by means of which certain forms of energy may be designated, or their action on the physical plane described; for instance, the forms or degrees of energy which are generated by different sounds and motions and which so far as may be observed by the senses have no exterior effects. Every spoken word or sound, as well as every act of man, tends to free a definite form of energy which must take a clearly defined course according to the guidance of the Lords of Karma.

If you throw a stone into a pool of water, thus setting the water in motion, you have released some form or degree of energy; the waves of water will move outward until they reach the verge of the pool, where they will receive the impetus to return to their starting point. But action will not cease with that one round, the waves will complete many rounds before the initial force is exhausted, and the number of rounds will depend largely upon the size and weight of the stone cast into the water. So it is the size and weight of the stone, the original cause or motive of the act, which is cast into the Ocean of universal Life that determines how many times the waves—the effects of that cause—will return to the one responsible for the act, or how many incarnations will be affected as a result of that act.

There are three grand divisions of the Lords of Karma, and very many times three minor divisions. As there is continuous interpenetration and correlation between different grades of force and substance, there is correspondingly continuous interchange, synchronous vibration, between all degrees and orders of the Lords of Karma and with the Higher Selves of all humanity; consequently there is no possibility of a miscarriage of Divine Justice as a finality. For instance, a man may commit a murder as a result of a carefully considered plot and from an utterly selfish motive, thus throwing a very weighty stone—a great evil—into his individual pool of life and setting free a powerful stream of energy. Instead of allowing that stream of energy, weighted with evil as a result of the action of will and motive, to run its course and injuriously affect countless others, the Karmic Lords may turn that stream of energy back on its course to the Auric sphere of the one who sent it forth. The energy so returned is utilized by the Higher Self in working out the effects of that original cause upon the lower or personal self: and, as the cause was so powerful for evil in itself, it may take the personal ego many incarnations to work out all the effects of that one cause: i. e., the waves of the individual pool would return again and again to the point—the cause --where that heavily weighted stone was cast into the pool.

It is a mistake to believe that the one who commits murder on the physical plane in one life must be killed in another life by his victim in order to satisfy the Karmic Law. Such another act of disobedience to Divine Law could not satisfy Divine Justice. Divine Law always acts for the ultimate benefit of humanity, even when its decrees bring sorrow and loss upon the units of a race or a Evil can never be overcome by evil on any plane of nation. The Higher Self has other ways of utilizing the return existence. wave-the stream of energy turned back by the Karmic Lords, in such an instance as I have mentioned. In the eyes of the average man the punishment meted out to the murderer by the Higher Self might not seem commensurate to the crime, but if he were able to see far enough into the future to behold the final result of the decrees of Karmic Law upon the incarnating ego of the murderer, he would be satisfied with the administration of Divine Justice.

I have taken one of the worst of crimes to illustrate my point; but the breaking of any Divine Law will bring results in perfect accord with Divine Justice, and all such universal laws are founded on universal principles. Those principles are the very foundation stones of the universe, and are therefore irrevocable and unalterable. So far as man-made laws are identical with Divine Laws they are just; but when they vary in the least they are mutable and cannot always stand the test of life.

THE AVATAR

As so many erroneous ideas about the Coming Avatar have been given out, especially from certain movements along advanced lines of thought, we are continuing reprints of articles from the Temple publication, "The Coming Avatar." It was through The Temple that the Lodge of Masters first gave out the truth of the Coming Avatar at this cycle.

This announcement was, in the words of Master Hilarion, The Annunciator, "The first scientific statement" made of that world event. As such it was based on the action of the exact cyclic and cosmic Law that governs the evolution of man. It foretold the far-reaching world changes that would occur in all fields of endeavor, following the descent of the forces of that great Entity into the outer planes of life.

We call the attention of readers to the June-July and October-November issues of the Artisan for more on this subject. Following is the Announcement made public not long after the founding of The Temple as the occult body of the Avatar.

THE MESSAGE

"Hearken, ye children of the New Dispensation! The time is near at hand when He who is to come will reappear among men for the Unification of the races of the earth. Open your eyes that you may see! Open your ears that you may hear! And open your hearts that the Son of Man may have a place to lay His head, lest He pass you by and ye know Him not." Because of the revolutionizing effect of this descent of the forces of the Avatar into the lives and hearts of men, precipitating the evil, and ordering, organizing and illuminating the good and the true, these words are—for him who has the Heart to read between the lines—as vital and full of power to stir the soul today as when uttered. They are as true as if only now uttered for the first time. They are as certain as is the dawn of a great New Day whose banner is even now flying in the Light of the Risen Star over the smoke of battlefields. They are Living Words, and proclaim the Son of God come again to dwell among men.

DIVINE STATUS OF AN AVATAR

The student of occultism who has accepted the teachings of the Masters of Wisdom anent the illusory character and the impermanence of all matter on the physical plane, and the reality and endurance of the three higher of the seven states of manifested life, namely, Atma, Buddhi, and Manas, is prepared to accept the statement that the Christos, or Buddhi, "the first born Son of God," is in fact a state of energy, although far beyond the investigation or even the imagination of man in his present state of existence. It is taught that this state of energy is actually Spiritual Light, the original Source of all Light, and that it is reflected within the mentality of man and also in that of every living creature in varying degrees. Therefore every man is a potential Christ.

The brighter the illumination of mind resulting from the reflected light of the Christos, the more rapidly does the mentality of the normal human being absorb or assimilate and generate that energy and approach the state of evolution which makes possible his admission to one of the highest orders of manifested life, the Avataral Order, in which he is prepared for open avowal of his mission in the world. A fully prepared Avatar has gained full power over physical life and death and over all matter which constitutes form in the lower orders of life. He has passed through myriads of lives in these lower orders, as well as through many of the higher orders of Adeptship ere he reaches the Buddhistic state, from which he enters perfection—wherein he becomes an individual Christ, a Saviour of the race to which he belongs by evolutionary right.

At the beginning of every great age in the earlier stages of a Manvantara the Avatar karmically connected with the units of a previously great race reincarnates in the body of a child, grows to maturity, and eventually proclaims his mission as teacher, therefore Saviour, of all those who may accept him.

When the Ego of an Avatar has reached and possibly passed into the Buddhistic order of life, it may not be necessary for it to reincarnate in the body of a child on earth or on any other planet of this solar system. It has evolved a form similar to that which the disciples of Jesus saw at the time of his transfiguration—a provified body, sometimes termed a Nirmanakaya Robe, which is disible only through the interior sense of sight in the case of phydical man. The Nirmanakaya Body of a great Buddha would be like unto a sun in brightness to the psychic sense of the observer; and, if in the course of the evolution of the race a change in vibration had occurred which had unsealed the interior vision of the units of that race, they might envision the Buddha or Christ as clearly as they might now behold an Avatar in a physical body, were one upon, the earth.

ANALOGY, BIOLOGICAL AND HISTORICAL

In the Bhagavad-Gita we read that Krishna, a symbol of any Avataric manifestation, reincarnates among men "whenever there is a decline of virtue and an insurrection of vice in the world," and that this manifestation is for the purpose of "the preservation of the just and the destruction of the wicked." In other words, it is the saving or redeeming principle that comes into manifestation whenever conditions have arrived at that stage of disintegration and chaos that would subvert the Divine Plan, if long continued.

We find analogies for this fundamental truth in alchemy, in chemistry, in biology, and in the history of all the old races of the earth. In alchemy the "Elixir of Life," or "Alcahest," is generated when certain grades of matter have reached a prepared stage of decomposition, fermentation or dissociation of essential elements, thus liberating the spirit of light within. This might be crudely referred to as the ferment or yeast of life. In chemistry it is a condition of nascence, when atoms are torn apart and new combinations formed. Great forces are liberated at that particular moment. In biology the process is represented when certain cells or elements are grouped so that an entirely new entity comes into manifestation with vital powers and consciousness not existing before.

In races we find this manifestation taking place when the racial consciousness has reached a low ebb of morality. Then a redeeming force appears in the form of a teacher or spiritual leader representing the Avataric Principle, according to the degree required by that particular race. Thus we have Krishna, Buddha, Confucius, and others of the East; Quetzalcoatl of the Aztecs and Incas; Hiawatha of the Indians, and Christ coming to the whole world through Jesus the Nazarene. All of these strove to unify discordant elements in the races in which they worked, or in the whole world, and to give a higher impulse to human thought and consciousness.

When the world reaches a stage of disintegration or chaos, it is an indication that it is ready for this great phenomenon to occur; for as with the atoms in the chemical reaction, a stage of nascence is imminent. and this is the beginning of a new birth, a new combination and liberation of inner forces of light, life, electricity and, in terms of the human, of higher love and Divine Light. All of these symbolize and actually represent a manifestation of Avataric Force which in the Sanscrit sense means a descent of God into or through matter.

In the year 1898 the Masters of Wisdom imparted to those in charge of the Temple work knowledge of a great event that had occurred on inner planes, namely, the descent of the Christ or Avatar from the higher plane to the lower astral by a process corresponding to that of birth. Growth and development would occur on that plane analogous to the outer plane, and this Great One would be clothed, so to speak, with forces and powers. Within thirty years of the time mentioned a full manifestation would occur, and as time went on from the date referred to (1898) humanity would feel more and more the impingement of this Avataric Consciousness.

Since 1898 a special service known to Templars of the inner degrees has been held in connection with this cosmical event, and interactions of force occur between the Avatar and those participating in this service, which has a profound occult bearing on the process of manifestation of "the Perfected Man and Master."

No one can or may know the exact moment, hour, month, or method of the Divine Coming. That is one of the great mysteries. It is a profound spiritual rule that the Great One always manifests in the most unexpected manner and will not be heralded by the blare of trumpets nor by any prearranged newspaper publicity. In other words, He will be known by His force, His power, and by what He says and does.

The heavens themselves proclaim this to be the Messianic cycle. The stars are singing it, the hearts of humanity are attuning to it. The old order is passing away and the New Order of the Ages is upon us. Look with the inner eye and harken with the inner ear, and the signs and sounds that herald the rosy dawn as a new day for humanity will be apparent.

Yet it is folly and vanity for anyone to predict just how this Christly Entity will appear and in what guise, whether it be with transcendent power or transcendent humility—or as an invisible, yet life-giving Sun (Son), warming and changing the Heart of the world in the twinkling of an eye. Those who know say that the Christ ever comes in the most unexpected way, yes, even as "the thief in the night."

OCCULTISM FOR BEGINNERS

Second Series, No. XXVI

FUNCTIONS OF THE GREEN RAY

Green is the complementary color to red. Both are kamic colors; that is, they have to do with the Desire principle on the plane of manifestation. Green is animated by the desire of intelligence, or intelligent self-consciousness, whereas red is the desire of love emotion. Both colors are closely associated in function, yet each has a distinct field of operation.

Green as the fundamental color of outer nature performs such an important function that it is well to touch on its mythology as well as etymology, showing how the older races regarded this. color.

"The Hebrew name of green is 'irq, viridis,' which also signifies verdure, green grass. This word comes from the roots 'ire,' to found, to regulate; and of 'rq' space, the firmament. Thus the name Green designates the beginning of time, the creation of the world, the birth of everything that exists. This is the meaning given to green in the work on symbolic colors, and which is constantly given to it on the Egyptian monuments.

"The God, Phtha, founder of the world, had green flesh. (On

inner planes this means a body of green light.) Phtha, says Champollion, is the active creating spirit, the divine intelligence, who undertook in the beginning the accomplishment of the universe, in all truth, and with supreme art. His flesh is always painted green. This divinity holds in its hand a sceptre, surmounted by four cornices which in the hieroglyphic writing is the symbol of co-ordination, and the root signifies to institute. This sceptre is painted of the four colors attributed to the four elements—the red denoting fire; blue, air; green, water; and the brown-yellow, or russet, sand or earth.

"Green was attributed to water, because, in Egyptian cosmogony, water was the primitive agent of creation. The word "ire," root of the name of green, signifies to place the foundation, and to sprinkle.

"From the signification of green arising from its name, and its attribution to the god-creator of the world, it is easy to make its application to other divinities. Thus the God Tore, or Thra, the world personified, is represented sitting in the ark floating on the green waters of cosmogony.

"The God Lunus, the moon, whose flesh is green, is also represented sitting in a bark, or bari, floating on green waters. The God Lunus was doubtless a cosmographic divinity, since he appears with the emblem of Phtha, the sceptre of co-ordination in his hand. The Hebrew name of the moon, 'irhe,' is formed of one of the roots of green, 'ire,' which signifies to found, to regulate, to institute. The same root, 'ire,' signifies also to instruct, to sprinkle. Thoth, the god-creator of man, founder of the social state, the god of science, of the sacred doctrine, has his flesh painted green on the monuments copied in Champollion's Egyptian Pantheon. Thoth pours over the head of the neophyte the waters of purification, symbol of the celestial dew.

"Netphe, mother of the gods, lady of heaven, as she is called, in the legend of that divinity, is often represented in the midst of the tree Persea, pouring the divine beverage over souls; her flesh is also green."

On December 31, 1900, the Master H. imparted to the inner group of Temple members the fact of the entrance into the earth's sphere, at that time, of a great Evolutionary Force belonging to the Green Ray, which would cause great changes in and with the earth and its humanity. He said, in substance, regarding this Force: It is what you would term a Master in one sense, what others would term a God in another sense. It is a form of the great evolutionary energy belonging to the Green Ray. This is very necessary at the present time in the development of the human race. It is a connecting link between the upper and lower Manasic planes, and comes for the purpose of raising the lower Manas in mankind to higher vibrations, that men may be able to accept and realize those occult truths which have been so generously poured out upon humanity in the last century. It has been doing the same work for the planet Saturn. This same Entity worked with the Earth 35,000 years ago. It requires 5000 years to do the necessary work for each planet; then it passes to the next in order, and so around until it is time for it to return, as is now the case with the earth. As soon as it contacts the outer layer of the earth's atmosphere, it at once awakens a new or more rapid vibration in the central sphere of the earth, the stationary energy of which is negative to its positive. This Force is now (1900) imminent; it has not as yet completed all connections. Some of you have seen this Force symbolized as a swan floating in green water. The swan in green water typifies the new manifestation in the new cycle, the Green Ray.

The coral insect gave into their keeping the strength, the lime, that lay within its body, then left the tiny body, and passed on to greater life, where it could do greater work.

Myriads of other coral insects have laid down their gift of lime beside that of the first one. Today large islands or reefs can be found in the ocean. The date palm grows upon them. Large passing vessels stop, and men gather the fruit, and while they gather, they study the branchlike, brain-like, fan-like, feather-like coral. They enjoy its beautiful tints and colors. They study the lessons that it teaches, and they leave, better. stronger, and more eager to help others and make their own lives more beautiful.

A little girl was lying on the sand with her mother, in front of their house. It was the same sand that had been washed in by the ocean. The house was back of one of the largest sand-hills. The hill protected then from the cold winds of the ocean. As the mother and child lay on the sand, the mother told of how, long years ago, many wise and learned people lived on the shore where they were now lying. A great city was standing where the fields were now stretched before them.

The people had not done like the coral. They had not given all their strength to help all others, and the city had been taken from them, and the people scattered about like the sand. Some people say now that the sand-hills about them represent the desires of the ancient people who are coming back to their old home, eager to help in rebuilding the city they had lost.
