



THANK YOU FOR ASTARA

Dear Dr.'s Robert and Earlyne:

For a better understanding of why this letter is being written I will try to give you a brief outline history of my physical condition determined by Doctors October 31, 1973—arteriosclerotic heart disease, essential hypertension, osteoporosis, rheumatoid arthritis and diabetes. On December 31, 1973, surgery—thromboendart—erectomy of the right side—then February 9, 1974, surgery—thromboendarterectomy of the left side. Both arteries were ulcerated and almost entirely blocked by plaque, and calcium deposits. Attending surgeons marveled at the fact that I had not had a fatal stroke.

In April of 1974 while reading I saw your advertisement and it seemed as though I was drawn to it. That day I wrote for information and in May of 1974 was accepted in Astara. After the third lesson of the First Degree June 11, 1974, I mailed a single healing petition asking for your help and direction. Also I have been receiving and studying the lessons regularly since my acceptance.

I have nothing to attribute the changes in me and my life to but Astara. The feelings are strange but satisfying to say the least. REFLECTION ON FREEDOM




PRAYER PETITIONS

Astara has two kinds of prayer petitions, and each is worked with differently. There are the healing petitions and requests to the Circle of the Secret Seven. We suggest that Astarians follow the instructions regarding these two-types of petitions as explained in Lessons 2 and 3 of the First Degree.

Healing petitions should generally be used for healing prayers. Astara's Healing ministry doesn't work with the same kinds of problems as does the Circle, which concentrates more on personal relationships, material situations, desired goals.

Healing Petitions: When you or someone you know is in need of physical, emotional or mental healing, fill in the healing petition which is enclosed in the Voice each month.

Circle Requests: To ask assistance in other areas, write the nature of the need on this petition which is enclosed in every other issue of the Voice. (You may always ask for additional petitions of either type, and the office will be happy to send them to you. We'd appreciate a self-addressed, stamped envelope, though.)



Brevity Helps

Please make your prayer requests brief. You need not go into the depths of your problem. Simply state on your petitions what you are asking for, either from the Circle or the Healing Ministry. If you wish to go into greater detail to get it "off your chest," enclose an accompanying letter. It will be read with Astara's love.

If the areas of concern persist it is

suggested that healing petitions be renewed every month or so — Circle requests, every two months. Astara cannot acknowledge all prayer requests or reply to every letter, but you may be sure that thoughtful attention is given to each as it arrives at headquarters. The petitions are placed in Astara's prayer chest to receive the Chaneys' personal "touch," having already been linked with Astral Astara from the moment you called or wrote.

GOD ALWAYS KNOWS, and Astara tries to put wings to your prayers.

REMEMBERING AS TEXT BOOK

CONSIDER THE TATTOO

Although the tattoo today is mostly considered to be the result of a sailor's folly, there are other and ancient aspects to its checkered eareer, both noble and ignoble.

Hitler's infamous Storm Troopers reportedly were tattooed with an identifying mark, as were thousands of Jewswho suffered persecution and death at their hands.

Tattoo As Art

The ancient art of tattooing is universal, many cultures having highly regarded such markings for their socio-religious significance — others for art's sake alone.

The Japanese, for instance, have been masters of the aesthetic use of tattoos since before the time of Christ. Even today a member of one of the famous tattoo societies may have his entire body covered with scenes from folklore; mythology and history, according to Dr. Victor Newcomer, professor of medicine in dermatology at the UCLA Medical School.

Primitive Man

Primitive man esteemed the tattoo as not only a decoration, but for protection against danger; as an aid in passing from puberty to adulthood; to insure good health; as a badge of status, and even a guarantee of good luck in love. The oldest evidence of the art, according to Dr. Newcomer, is found in tools that paleolithic man left on the floors of caves hundreds of thousands of years ago.

Civilized Man

The ancient Egyptians used the markings for religious purposes. Priest-Kings often tattooed the names of the gods on their chests and arms. Even today some Hindus bear the tattooed dot on their foreheads which denotes the area of the Third Eye.

It is told that an ingenious Greek warrior shaved the head of a messenger and tattooed secret information on his scalp. After his hair grew back, he easily passed through enemy lines to deliver the message, once his head was shaven again to reveal it.

Tattooing during the Middle Ages was banned by the church in Europe as being a barbaric, pagan custom. It emerged from the "underground" during the late 19th century and, for a time, became high fashion. Since then the general fad for obvious tattoos has declined, and the tattooed man or lady is now a circus sideshow attraction.

Still remain, however, the many men and women who wish to bear a permanent record of something or someone through the tattooer's needle. There is not a culture on earth today which doesn't engage in tattooing, for whatever reason—it is that universal a practice.

CHRISTMAS IN ALL RELIGIONS


In one form or another, Christmas is hidden in all religions . . . not in name, of course, but in spirit. It is like a hidden pearl which, when found, is worth all one's possessions.


all transformed by it.

BEING CONTENT





LITERALLY by His words men, nations, kingdoms and empires live or die, survive or perish. Nor has the passing of the centuries changed that. Our day is a swift witness to the fact that without Him and His words men can do nothing.

Life. He said, is a Kingdom within you. You are potential eternity. You are time without beginning and without end. Eternity is "set in your heart." Joy is your birthright, freedom is your heritage, liberty is your habitat and you shall call "no man your master." I am the Life, He said, and you shall take your "inner parts" like a stream that waters a desert and then takes back to itself the fruits of its own life-giving power. You, He said, are neither slaves nor servants - not even to God. You are God's friends. Friends who share the very innermost secrets of His heart. He went further: You are, He said, equal with God - of the very essence; nature for nature, part for part and passion for passion. You are, He said so much a part of Me that I cannot be happy without you any more than you can experience life without Me. That is Christmas — God's answer to the whole question of life.

It will be the mark of wisdom if we, on this anniversary of His birth, pay Him more than lip service. Let us come, like wise men of old, to worship — and remain to be changed.


