I would be the last to put a limit on the power of the adventurous life. People are always doing things which I thought could not be done, going to places which I thought could never be reached, and finding things I thought could never be found.

Sometimes there are miracles.

I met such a man one night at the home of a friend on the West Coast. He was a slender, middle-aged, scholarly man with rimless glasses. We had been talking about life's unexplored and unexplained dimensions when he told me his remarkable story.

At sixteen he had been blinded, the result of an accident, and subsequently he had been provided with a seeing eye dog. The dog, Saga, became the light of his life. The dog acted as his eyes when he went to college, and when he got his degree, Saga was on the platform with him.

Some years after graduation he and Saga were walking one night on a New York street near his home. Suddenly he heard the terrifying screech of brakes and the onrush of a careening car. The dog was jerked out of his hands. Then he heard people scream. Frantically he searched about him, only to discover that Saga lay dead at his feet.

He said he stood there knowing that part of his world had been destroyed, feeling rather than hearing the voices of the people around him. A policeman asked him for information. He replied but he hardly knew what he was saying. Then he heard someone whisper to him, "Come, I will take you home."

"I took the dog in my arms and let the stranger take me to my apartment. He

went in with me. We wrapped up the body of the dog and after a moment the stranger asked, 'Do you mind if we kneel and pray together?' I said to him that this was about all there was left to do, and got down on my knees.

"I never heard a prayer so full of power. He was so confident about the presence of God that even when he prayed for the return of my sight, I believed him. I remember how I gripped his hand before he left: Then I went to bed and tried to sleep. In the morning when I awoke, I saw light streaming in through the window. I saw things I had never seen before. I saw the wrapped body of Saga. I saw my room. I was afraid to believe it. I dressed and hurried into the apartment across the hall, crying, 'I can see! I can see!'

Later he went to the police station. He reported that he was the man whose dog had been killed, the blind man. The officer called several members of his staff and asked him to repeat what had happened. They wanted everything in great detail. Then a policeman said, "There is just one thing wrong with your story. No one took you home. There was no stranger with you. You insisted on going to your apartment by yourself and we watched you go. There was no stranger."

But to him, even now as he told me the story, the stranger was real. Someone had been with him. The fact that he could see was also real and it was real to me. And I thought as I looked at him and listened to him that, perhaps, if we but had the faith to adventure and believe, nothing would be impossible.

I believe that these obstacles can be overcome through the following


steps:

FOR DEEPER UNDERSTANDING




