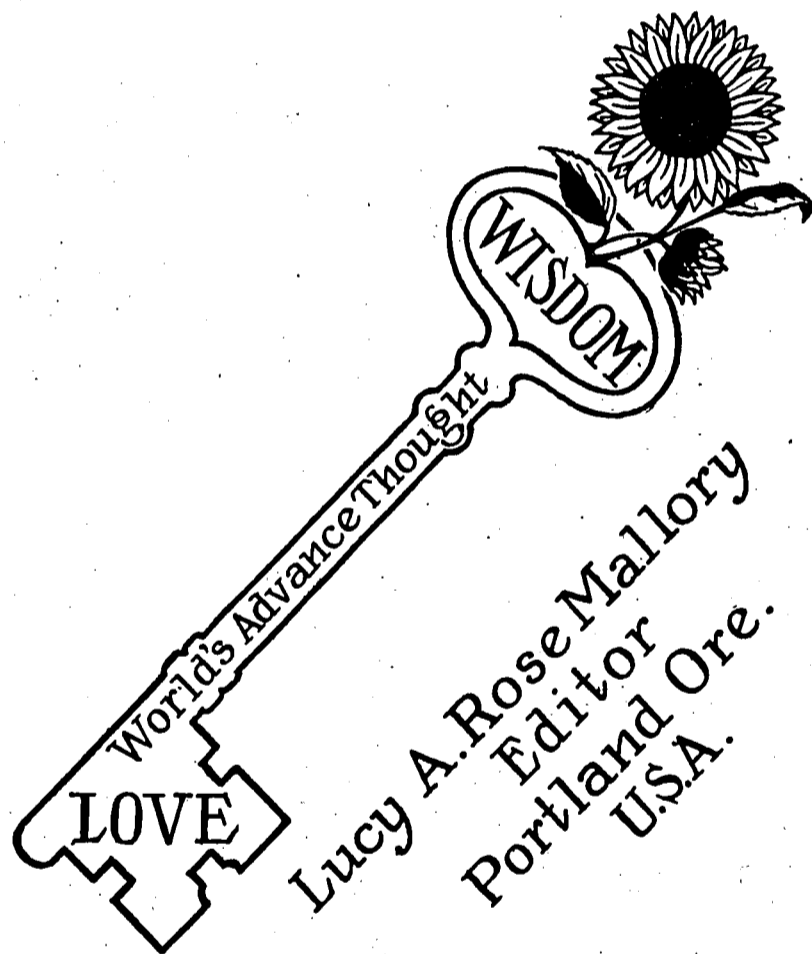

NO MORE MILITARISM.

Shirley Dare, a contributor to the "New York Herald," says: "In my opinion, it would be for the benefit of the country, the family and the individual, if every mother's son were obliged to pass a certain amount of military service before he can vote. The military training is the only one nowadays which teaches men to obey, and gives them any notion of the value of obedience. No training makes men so effective for every-day use or leaves them so alert, prompt and full of resource. The adoption of military education, in earnest would lead to the adjustment of serious questions, physical and national. The great point about military training is, that it enforces exercise for a purpose, not merely for the sake of exercise."

The movements that give him an erect bearing and cause him to walk in step, can just as well be acquired under teachings of Love and Good Will, as with the ultimate object in view, of killing his neighbors, at the behest of some politicians bent upon robbery, etc. We want men who will learn to obey the Good within themselves, at the command of their own wills, not men who will obey the evil commands of another, to shoot, kill and destroy.—Lucy A. NEEDS HELP TO RIPEN.

An argument that is sometimes brought to bear against a Vegetarian diet, is that mankind are not yet ready for it, and to let Nature take her course till they are. Those who advance this argument admit the necessity of a Vegetarian diet to Spiritual Evolution, but they would have Natural Evolution take its course to bring forth Vegetarians. Yet, Nature, unaided and uncultivated by man, never brings forth the fruits of perfection. If man had left everything to Natural Evolution, we would still have the bitter progenitors of our luscious fruits, and a coarse equine breed, instead of the perfect breed of horses. Everything of any value in man and in Nature has to be cultivated with care and attention, otherwise it does not become manifest. Unless unprogressive man is surrounded with the right thought atmosphere, his spiritual qualities cannot be developed, any more than an orchard badly drained, and infested with parasites, can produce good fruits.

It is often asserted by those who still hanker for flesh that a Vegetarian diet would be disastrous for mankind, if forced upon them, and that the energy and force of character of Humanity that have made them progress, have been stimulated by a meat diet. That which prompted man to kill his neighbor and take what he had was stimulated by eating flesh, but this was not Progression. Progression comes when the people no longer do this.

It is not proved that "mankind have been flesh-eaters, with very few exceptions." A large proportion of mankind, among the healthiest and strongest, eat no meat, or, probably, not more than a dozen times a year, on holidays; not, always, because they prefer a Vegetarian diet but, largely, for lack of means to purchase meat. The Swiss and German peasantry live on potatoes, buttermilk, cheese and sauerkraut, mainly; the staple diet of the Russian peasantry is cabbage soup, cucumbers and rye bread; numbers of the French laborers live on onion soup, bread, fruit and sour wine; the Japanese, and several hundred millions of Hindus and Chinese are Vegetarians, because their religion (Buddhism) enjoins them to be. A Japanese boatman, fed on rice, can lift a load that it requires four British sailors to carry, who are fed on meat,

rum and tobacco. It is only in the United States and Great Britain that the laboring classes eat much meat, for their higher wages enables them to afford it; but, these are also the countries in which the most drunkenness prevails. Meat eating is the cause of excessive liquor drinking and its miseries, and the latter cannot be done away with until the former is abolished.

The recent races between Vegetarians and meat eaters, in Germany, as a test of endurance, were won, by large odds, by the Vegetarians. At the start the meat eaters were ahead, but, before the races were finished, many of them had to take the train to return home, being completely exhausted before they were half over.

Meat is an excitant and stimulant that intoxicates, in a measure, but does not completely inebriate, as liquor does. When the effect of the meat eaten passes away, there is a fresh call from the system for meat, just as the liquor drinker requires another drink to stimulate him, when the effect of the last one has been dissipated.—Lucy A. Rose Mallory.

EXPERIENCES OF MME. D'ESPERANCE.

It was during these experiments (their object the photographing of the materialized forms) that I began to attribute some peculiar after effects of seances to their rightful cause. From the very beginning of our experiments in this line I had always more or less suffered from nausea and vomiting after a seance for materialization, I had grown to accept this as a natural consequence and not to be avoided. This had always been the case, except when surrounded only by the members of our home circle or children. During the course of seances for photography this unpleasantness increased so much that I was usually prostrate for a day, or sometimes two, after a sitting, and, as the symptoms were those of nicotine poisoning, experiments were made and it was discovered that none of the uncomfortable sensations were felt when seances were held with non-smokers. Again, when sick persons were in the circle, I invariably found myself feeling more or less unwell afterwards. With persons accustomed to the use of alcohol the discomfort was almost as marked as with smokers.

These seances were to me fruitful in many respects, I learned that many habits, which are common to the generality of mankind and sanctioned by custom, are deleterious to the result of a seance, or, at any rate, to the health of the medium.—Reason.

the full import of the command, 'Thou shalt
not kill'

To promote the study of the laws of ethics,
and their application to character building.

To inculcate in humanity a love for Truth,
Justice and that beautiful generosity that
makes the strong supporters, instead of op-
pressors, of the weak.

To—by individual thought, word and deed—
strive to promote Universal Harmony, and to
hasten the coming of that glad day "when there
shall be no more hurting and destroying in all
the earth, for the world shall be filled with the
knowledge of Universal Law."

Section 1. The membership shall consist
of Active, Associate and Honorary members.

Sec. 2. Application for active membership
must be submitted to and accepted by the Ex-
ecutive Committee before being enrolled as
such.

Sec. 3. Any person interested in the work
of the society may become an associate mem-
ber by the payment of the annual dues (one
dollar) when they shall receive, post paid, the
official organ, The World's Advance-Thought,
and shall be entitled to all the privileges of
the society, except voting.

Sec. 4. Honorary members shall be elected
as such by the Executive Committee, and shall
be entitled to all the privileges of the Society,
except voting.

The "modus operandi" shall be:

2nd. Seeking to present the work of the
society to all influential bodies, and all educa-
tional institutions.

3rd. Seeking to organize local clubs, espe-
cially at every county seat.

4th. To maintain a circulating library of
such books, pamphlets, etc., as, in the opinion
of the Executive Committee, best teach the
objects of the society.
