THe Second will be a defect of the $S_{a n}$ on June the 2 I day, at eighe a Clock at Night in ten degrees of Cancer; but will fcarcely be vifible to us, becaufe the Sun is. juft Setting; vefides it will be but a very inconfiderable and finall Eeclipje in it felf.

The Third and Laft, will be an Eclipfe of the Moan, on Nfvember the thirtieth day, about eleven a Clock at Night. It will be a Vifible; Total, and Central Eclipfe, and admirably well warthy of the Induffious Aftronomers :Obfervation. This Defect is Celebrated in ninteen degrees of the 7 wins or the coeleftial Gemini, and both Lumioaries are in exaf Conjundion of the troo Nades. The Ligbt eclipjed, is with the North Node, and therefore to thefe Northern Nations will this defect be of moft concern.

In the mean time I could with rome Induftrious SOn of Mi nerve, would take the pains to Collett into a Table th Commencement of all wars, Sieges, Fires, Sackine of Cities Fismois Battels, aúd all other remarkable Violences, and grati - fie the enquiring World with a fight thereof; that we migh be the better enabled thereby to difcover, not only the cortimon heats of $\sigma^{\prime \prime}$, but all his various and afionibin Infiuencts.
