

THE DAWN OF DESTRUCTION

Good Evening, friends:

Once again you are gathered here to hear a forecast of events for the year of 1940. In giving this prophecy I will not confine myself strictly to this New Year, inasmuch as coming events are closely linked with each other in the years immediately following this one. In other words, this prediction will include the years from 1940 to at least the year of 1944.

As we look about us we see on every side portents or The Signs of the Times, indicative of calamitous events to come. The very foundations of the earth are being shaken to their depths. In every social stratum fear is being registered in the minds of those who stop their dizzy speed long enough to think. All human affairs are confronted by perilous times. Those with vision can see only more hazardous times ahead. One by one little nations pass swiftly through their last death struggle and are swallowed up. Unrest and confusion are universally distributed—omens of more direful times to come. Human gov-

ernments, institutions and liberties, achieved only at the expense of much blood, treasure and painful sacrifice through a long period of years, are suddenly destroyed and disappear as if by the magic of a demon's wand. National crises are made to develop by sinister hands in the background. Disorder and tumult follow.

A new leader, previously unknown, appears, seemingly from nowhere. Millions follow him blindly, confidently depending upon his visionary and highly impracticable promises. The deluded rabble places him in power, and he, in turn, stops at nothing to eliminate all resistance. The crowd claps its hands in childish glee as he at once proceeds to liquidate all restraint, destroy all opposition, and completely efface all safeguards that have been tested and established by well-ordered and constitutional society. It is all so incredible—a fabulous monster. That which has been decided as being worthy of continuance only after centuries of heart-breaking struggle against tremendous obstacles is imperiled or even destroyed.

Liberty of religion, liberty of speech, liberty of opinion, liberty of assembly, liberty of the press, all considered as having been permanently stabilized, are already seriously restricted—in some countries they exist in name only. The mob, clamoring for the wild

fantasy of so-called social security, is willing to cast aside all these priceless liberties for the pitifully small mess of pottage by delegating to an irresponsible dictator unlimited powers to absolutely control every detail of their private lives.

The sense of balance is being progressively lost. Things move at reckless and previously unheard-of speeds. Mammoth projects, such as the ill-fated Florida Ship Canal, and the malodorous Passamaquoddy Dams are rushed into existence and millions spent for political effect without sober thought or well-considered plans, such as any well managed private organization would carefully consider. Disorder and turmoil reign everywhere. Mutual hatred and greed embitters the relations of individuals, families, states and nations. The destructive and corrosive influence of SELF pervades the councils of the rulers. Fear, and dread, those most destructive of all human emotions, fill men's hearts. Revolt, demoralization and dissatisfaction are everywhere.

Relief projects for the alleviation of distress among the unfortunate poor, are honey-combed with political corruption and graft. Men in high places of honor, placed there by the deluded people, are discovered to be closely connected with underworld crime racketeers. Ministers orate at great length

about the holiness of their organizations while deprecating the efforts of similar organizations teaching other religious creeds. Fraternal and social organizations are rent by internal dissensions.

Everything scintillates with brilliance and jewels. Automobiles are aglow with chromium plate and brilliant colors. All is glitter and sheen. Women's clothing is the most violent in color in all history. Distracted and bewildered people with taut nerves and no particular destination, drive madly along our highways at dangerous speeds, and the inevitable result is death and injury to many. Children treat their parents and their elders with entire disrespect. Parents neglect, abandon and not infrequently murder their offspring. Children do likewise. No place is safe in which to live; neither is there security for one's possessions. Today no place is secure from revolution, invasion, confiscation or destruction.

September 16, 1936 was the date of the ushering in of great spiritual change "as a thief in the night," which marked the beginning of the downfall of the Piscean Age and the commencement of the Aquarian Age. The date of August 20, 1953, marks the end of the Piscean Age. It is also the date on which the world enters into the full influence of the Aquarian Age. The intervening time between

these dates constitutes the transitory period between the two ages, otherwise known as The Battle of Armageddon. This presages, NOT the end of the world, but a great world-wide spiritual change.

Before beginning my prophecy, I wish to state that there are a number here who will not accept that which I am about to tell. They will say that it is all highly improbable, if not altogether impossible. Therefore, I wish to call the attention of those persons to some of the developments that have taken place within recent years. Many of you here tonight can remember when there were no automobiles. Then came those funny little red contraptions on high wheels with a one cylinder engine, that chug-chugged nicely down hill or along the level road, but when it came to a hill the passengers got off to push. Many said then that the automobile would never be of any practical use, yet today, it has become a necessity—not a luxury. When Marconi reported that he had received signals from across the Atlantic Ocean, the experts(?) said that that was impossible. Meteorites were derided as non-sensical, the X-Rays were ridiculed as amusing but of no use to surgery, and the telephone was scorned as a Yankee toy.

If the people had been told then that it would soon be possible for one to sit in the

comfort of his home and listen to the news of the moment, to the music of great orchestras, and to the chimes of Big Ben in London, they would have sneered in derision, yet that is exactly what is taking place today. And so it is with hundreds of things that were condemned as being impossible by those who had no vision, yet today those same things are so commonplace that they attract no particular attention. It might be well for each one to read the 24th chapter of Matthew, the 13th chapter of Mark, and the 21st chapter of Luke—then ask the question: Where will all this end?

In giving forth this forecast, no attempt to segregate the different countries will be made, but will give the data as it comes into my mind.

Beyond all doubt, 1940 will be a most peculiar year—a very difficult year; in fact, one of the hardest years since 1876. Conditions will very likely be such that the people will not know which way to turn or which way to go. The President in Washington will be reproached from every side, and his pathway will be filled with many obstacles and stumbling blocks. Congress will bitterly oppose much of his program, and many of the people will do likewise. If much diplomacy is not used every step of the way, the United States will be plunged into the European War

sometime during the interval between April, 1940 and April, 1941. 1939 saw the beginning of the present series of wars in Europe. The war had to begin on or before November 27, 1939, else it could not have been started. inasmuch as that date limit was given in the Great Pyramid of Gizeh. Please note that 27 is a "9" day, November an "11" month, and 1939 a "22" year; all mystic master numbers.

Germany has been set aside from the world, in a way, by the sinister rulers of the world behind the scenes, but she has somewhat checkmated her enemies by drawing Russia in with her. It is the thought of that country that she will use up the resources and man-power of Germany, and then quietly absorb her. On the other hand, Germany is planning to obtain the resources and man-power of Russia and in the end, control that country. One must not forget that Russia has purged herself of the leaders and thinkers in her country and is therefore devoid of those capable of competent leadership. It is therefore within the bounds of possibility as well as probability that in the not far distant future the German experts and technicians of all fields will control and direct the immense man-power and resources of Russia.

The indices are in favor of a prolonged war extending beyond 1940. The time is not far distant when Japan, Russia and Germany

will stand together as one. On the other side England and France will remain as close allies. There is great pressure and influence exerted to bring the United States into the war on the side of the Western Allies. To overcome such propaganda, there is an increasing sentiment in the United States to remember the former disastrous experience "to make the world safe for democracy" and remain aloof.

Strenuous efforts will be made to make Italy see that it will be to the best interest of that country to join with the Allies and to forsake her place in the Axis. However, very much depends upon the diplomacy of England, as while Mussolini is an opportunist he is also very sensitive to coercion in any form. No doubt but that Italy will retain her connection with Germany.

With conditions as we see them at present, the indications are that it is very doubtful whether England and France will win the war. If they do, the victory will be an empty one, for England and France will be almost exhausted as the losers. However the future of England looks exceedingly dark.

England is almost overcome with trouble from all sides. She has been called the Mistress of the Seas for many years, but a great deal of that former prestige has been lost. Today England is confronted by the

great fight of her entire career and the leaders of that unfortunate country are aware of that fact. Their stubbornness drew them into the war and they dare not jeopardize their political standing by acknowledging their errors, but with characteristic English obstinacy will continue their present line of action, hoping to "muddle through" as they have in the past. Back to the cause of that country's present predicament: her treatment of subject peoples and her arrogance in the past has builded up a Karma which she is now paying. This Karma is merely the result of the action of the Law of Compensation.

There will be many changes in regard to the Law of the Seas. These changes will be made mostly by England in her own favor, and the rights of neutrals will be brazenly over-ridden by that country. England will experience much trouble with her food supply for 1940. Many of her difficulties will be minimized and hidden from her people as much as possible. No doubt but that the Duke of Windsor and his American wife will quietly return to his country to aid his people. But it should not occasion surprise should the man who was forced off his throne, but who has the confidence and the love of the common people, go back to his native land as a dictator to re-establish stability after the reign of the politician.

New methods of warfare that none of the other countries know anything about, are being developed by the Germans. One, for instance, is somewhat on the order of the cannon that was used to bombard Paris in the first World War, only more powerful. They are so thoroughly covered that one may get within a few feet of them without being aware of anything unusual. The present ones are directed towards Paris, and will be discharged only on direct orders from Der Fuehrer. They are capable of destroying Paris in a very short time. These implements of death operate along unusual lines.

The government of France will likely collapse and go down, but it will be re-organized. There will be a number of such changes, but eventually government will be re-established. That country, also, has builded a Karma that must be erased through suffering.

The Scandinavian countries will find it necessary to be exceedingly diplomatic or they will be forced into open warfare. If they exercise much care and diplomacy they may be able to remain out of it. It is also indicated that the King of Denmark is likely to pass out during this year. Holland is another country that must exercise diplomacy and forbearance with her neighbors, in order to escape being over-run. Eventually Germany will get back her colonies, and a place in the

sun. This is what she has been demanding for some time, but other powers refused to understand.

It is not likely that England will obtain help from India in this war, as that country is interested in securing autonomy for herself; not merely empty promises. Africa will no doubt support England in the present trouble, but that support will be much weakened by internal opposition to giving any aid to England. What is likely to occur eventually, is that smaller countries of Europe will be absorbed by the larger and more powerful countries. When this war is over, Europe will be completely revolutionized. This will be the last great war for a long, long time, and peace and harmony will reign for another Age.

However, the revolutionizing process will continue over the period of years extending until 1953. For the five years from 1940 until 1945 a very different time is foreseen. To everyone it will seem as though each succeeding year is worse than the preceding one, but this cleansing process has been decreed by the Higher Powers as being necessary. The work will proceed apace until 1945, by which time that particular portion of the work will be completed.

There are indications that the Americas and Australia will enter into some sort of pact, and they will all work together. Canada

will do the best she can to aid the Mother Country. Canada and the United States will work amicably together for common cause.

Mexico is due for much trouble of her own. She is likely to encounter trouble with the United States unless she uses more diplomacy and loses some of her recalcitrant attitude in her dealings. There is much internal strife, political scandals and religious conflict, coupled with labor disputes and unrest indicated for the near future.

Eventually Japan may yet learn that she will not be able to crush China, as that country will keep right on fighting and sapping the resources of Japan until she wins. The malevolent portents show that three hard earthquakes and two severe typhoons are scheduled for the year of 1940. With all of these things combined Japan may find that she may have almost all she can handle. That country is looking towards Hawaii and the Phillipine Islands with covetous eyes, and today these islands are very well manned by Japanese nationals in preparation for the taking of them over if and when the time seems propitious.

Here in our United States there will be storms, cyclones, heavy floods in all parts of this country, with extremely cold and unseasonable weather for the early Spring in the East and Middle West. During the sum-

mer there will again be some very hot weather along the Pacific Coast. Earthquakes will likely be prevalent all over the world during 1940, with Southern California due for her share. There will be many earthquakes in parts of the world where such manifestations of nature have not heretofore been experienced.

Many deaths will occur from drowning, fires, poison, suicide, accidents, and from every sort of violence. People will be killed en masse. Three bad train wrecks are indicated for the United States in 1940. As stated above, there will be a great increase in disasters of all kinds with trains, busses, automobiles, airplanes and ships. Increases in murders, suicides, crimes against the person, against and by women and children, are in store. It will be well for women and children to exercise unusual care in going out, to let others know where they are going and with whom even in daylight, and not to go out after dark alone or in questionable company. There are indicated increases in storms on land and sea, and all kinds of catastrophic manifestations of Nature, for ". . . these are the beginnings of sorrows." Are we not told ". . . when ye see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh." Do we not see exactly those conditions today? We are in the beginning of

that great Battle of Armageddon right now! It is on our own doorstep. Not only in some foreign country at a great distance from us, but right here! NOW!! It must not be forgotten that countries as well as individuals reap that which they sow.

Virulent poison gases have been perfected so potent in effect that only a small amount will be sufficient to annihilate the population of an entire city. Germany and the United States are the two countries that have the really dangerous gases. This war will eventually develop into the most terrible of all previous wars, and the people may well be glad to follow the biblical injunction: "Then let them that be in Judea flee to the mountains," or other places of refuge.

Now, let us look briefly at the accomplishments of science. Scientists are more or less in obscurity as far as the general public is concerned, but in these troublous times, they are the ones that are actually accomplishing almost unbelievable wonders, all over the world. Everything Germany is doing with regard to her warfare is along scientific lines, and they have perfected many new aids to their military operations. Likewise, the inventors of the United States have perfected many new things that will be used in hostilities should this country become involved in war, or revolution.

The medical profession is developing more and more new methods for the successful treatment of cancer, pneumonia and infantile paralysis. Medical men have been making exhaustive studies of these diseases and the results of their work will be a boon to the ailing world. There are indicated many new diseases, or perhaps I should say, new developments of older forms. A form of pneumonia that will cause death with scarcely any pain; only a shortness of breath. A post-mortem will show perforations of the lungs. Also indicated are different intestinal conditions—an epidemic affecting the intestinal tract. The throat will be greatly afflicted and there will be much trouble with the liver. Medical science will find it necessary to bring forth new remedies and new forms of treatment to cope with new forms of diseases indicated for the next four years. A new anesthetic will be perfected within the next two years that will be of unusual assistance for major operations. Wonderful new surgical instruments will be developed in Germany, and many of the previous methods formerly used in emergency operations will be cast aside, and new methods that are very much better than any heretofore known, will be used. All in all, medical science will come to the front with many new things within the next five years. There is likely to be a num-

ber of epidemics, but in general people will be wise to exercise care for their throats, hearts, lungs, liver and intestinal tract.

There will be many changes of a political nature in the year of 1940. If President Roosevelt manages to be "drafted" the indications at the present time are favorable for his re-election. This will be especially true if the United States is maneuvered into the war, or even if there are too many rumors of war. Also, one must not overlook the possibility of an opportune hand-made "national emergency." However, whoever is elected to the office of President of these United States, will not live to complete his term of office. There are strong indications of the advent of a third political party for 1940, and its activities will likely be the cause of considerable disturbances of the peace of mind of both Republican and Democratic parties.

Labor in this country is likely to become very much disturbed, and for those along the water-fronts constant dissension is in store. Great diplomacy must be exercised everywhere, else some of the worst and most bitter strikes known will take place on both the East and West Coasts. Labor conditions are likely to continue in a terrible turmoil. The C.I.O. will lose a great deal of its prestige.

Many abuses that have been kept under cover by powerful politicians for many years,

will be brought to light. Congress, as well as the Dies Committee will bring out many things that well may startle those who have smugly expressed their satisfaction with conditions as they have been. A new form of taxation will likely be proposed, and also new regulations regarding the holding of property. A new proposal in regard to pensions for elderly persons is indicated.

In 1940 the Navy will no doubt figure prominently in the news. The Army will also come in for some attention, but not so much as the Navy. Congress will give considerable sympathetic attention to the needs of that arm of the National Defense and much will be done for it. Many new ships will be ordered built, and new methods pertaining to the conduct of war will be brought out. However, not many of the general public will know much about the new features that will be developed under cover, such as poison gases of a very deadly nature. It is predicted that one, high in the councils of the Navy, will pass on in 1940.

Indications point to a world-wide financial and credit collapse within the coming five years. This will bring forth a new medium of exchange. Due to ensuing conditions it will be to establish a new medium of exchange in order to meet the new conditions. An opportunity for the people to exchange their

savings into the new type of money or its substitute will no doubt be given them, as the present form of money will become practically worthless. In view of the conditions in store for those who have managed to accumulate a quantity of the present existing type of money and the impending change that is indicated for that medium, it seems best for everyone to procure whatever they may need in the way of commodities. It may prove to be the part of wisdom to get the things needed, for then such needs will be provided for when the existing type of money is of little or no value, and essential commodities unobtainable with it.

As is becoming increasingly well known by the general public, there are sinister forces of great power and influence busily engaged in "boring from within" in an endeavor to break down the laws and the Constitution of this great country. As was stated last year, the Flag of these United States will go down almost into the gutter, but it will rise again in triumph over its enemies and become far more powerful and influential in the affairs of the world, than ever before. It will be a Light to lead towards Liberty all peoples.

Nations and individuals digress from their plain path of duty and therefore build up a Karma or debt to be paid in full later. The United States has also deviated from her

Path of Destiny and must return to it. By the action of the Law of Compensation the debt must eventually be paid in terms of human blood, suffering and treasure. In time these United States will control the seas and its Flag become an inspiration to the world and a Light unto its path.

Inasmuch as this great country was established under the supervision of the Higher Spiritual Powers, the United States will not be destroyed through the efforts of the dark forces now busily at work. The Constitution, also, was written at the instance of Spirit and therefore will endure. Under the control of Destiny the United States will eventually overcome the powerful invisible government that really rules the world from behind the scenes. Notwithstanding the innumerable safe-guards established by themselves these Hidden Rulers will stand unmasked before the powerful Light of Understanding, and thus their power will be destroyed. Thus the need for a change in the medium of exchange becomes apparent.

At present many are evincing increased interest in mediums or practicing psychics as they may properly be called, of which there is a greatly increased number. This is in accordance with ancient prophecies. The consultation of mediums originated in the dim haze of antiquity. At first, man was

in direct contact with his Creator and thus received spiritual guidance as a divine inheritance. But man, through his development of greed, hate and lust, gradually separated himself from that spiritual closeness with his Creator. Then it was that the consultation of mediums was instituted by the Higher Powers for man's spiritual guidance. However, as the malevolent instincts of man increased, the spiritual portion was lost and there was developed an overweening desire to obtain knowledge merely to satisfy man's greed and acquisitiveness.

Unfortunately, a similar state of mind predominates today, and an overwhelming percentage consult mediums merely to learn how to acquire material wealth without regard to the welfare of others. It is a source of deep regret to the Higher Powers that many mediums foster such consultations and cater almost exclusively to that sort of clientele for the pecuniary gain of the moment. The result of that practice has been that mediumship has been stigmatized as the "works of the Devil"; and rightly so, when those God-given faculties have been prostituted into an aid to man's baser instincts.

Today, only a pitifully small number consult mediums in quest of spiritual enlightenment, while the percentage of mediums who are actually doing the Master's work is

proportionately small. On every hand one hears the mediums referred to as doing the Devil's work, and in confirmation are pointed to as usually being poorly dressed, chronically financially embarrassed, occupying slum-like living quarters, and alternate between worry about their next meal and being torn by family dissensions. These conditions are regarded as conclusive evidence that mediumship is essentially evil. But let us now look at the other side.

It has long been taught by the lamas that it is very injurious to one who possesses an impure mind or pursues evil connections, therefore when you attempt to pronounce the sacred word be sure your thoughts are pure and your desires are holy. I warn you all that otherwise the results to yourself will be dire. Therefore when mediums use their holy God-given gifts merely as a sordid money-maker they must expect the inevitable result. There is no escape from the result of wrong thinking and wrong acting.

Consideration of the above statements will show the necessity of a complete and thorough change to pure thought and action. The new age method of working will be essentially different from those in use for the past age. Among other changes will be the elimination of clairvoyance and clair-audience as has been known. Instead the

practicing psychics will not stop to "listen" or to "see" as they have been in the habit of doing. They will work without delay, contortions or unsightly grimaces. Instead they will "know". "By their fruits ye shall know them" and people desiring to consult mediums for, let us say, financial advice will not consult one who is financially broke. Such a one is not demonstrating the laws which they claim to demonstrate, by the exhibition of "lack" instead of plenty. The mediums doing the Master's work need not and will not worry, because they will be taken care of and amply rewarded, spiritually and materially. A medium of the New Age will perforce need pure thought and pure life—there can be no other.

Taking up the subject of religion, it appears as if the Roman Catholic Church is to experience much trouble beginning with 1940. It has been prophesied that there will be only two more Popes, after which there will be rather radical changes in organization of the Papal Church. In fact, prophecy reveals such a complete reorganization that it will hardly be recognized as the original Catholic Church. The changes must be accomplished on or before 1953.

The Protestant Churches will also face reorganization, as great inroads will be made by a new religion that is forecast, which will

sweep the entire world. It is simplicity itself and is that which was taught by Jesus the Master; it will teach that GOD IS WITHIN and NOT FAR, FAR AWAY on a throne in the sky.

In 1940 the people in general will begin to evince more interest in religion and evidence a strong desire to learn more about the Higher Powers. If the present great church organizations are able to rise to the occasion thus presented and grasp the greatest opportunity ever presented by them, by teaching that which they have in the past ignored or suppressed — the PRESENCE of GOD WITHIN—they would at once save themselves from inevitable obliteration and instead lead this distracted and distraught world onward and upward to that immeasurable peace and harmony "that passeth understanding." It seems as if their lack of understanding of their opportunities an inability to grasp the importance of understanding that peace which has prompted their digression from the teachings of the Master.

If the people of these great United States would really become spiritual-minded and unite, they could certainly keep this country out of war and trouble. Unless this is done we see no other alternative ahead but—WAR. The new religion mentioned above, in combination with the spiritual influences of the

New Age will exercise a most powerful effect upon the lives and destiny of the people, and will make of this world a new, safe and sane place in which to live, where envy, greed, lust, hatred, malice and revenge will be swept away and where instead peace, harmony and love will reign.

New discoveries will be made in the Great Pyramid of Gizeh within the near future. These will disclose very interesting information hitherto unknown within modern times. A little later, perhaps between the years 1948 and 1953, another chamber will be brought to light. This chamber will not be found in the direction in which previous searches have been made in the past. As the Secret Place of the Most High or the King's Chamber, as it is commonly known, is lined with polished pink granite the new chamber will be found lined with polished blue granite, and will be known as The Hall of Peace.

In accordance with ancient teachings, there is a secret passage in a very aged and well known structure in Egypt. The entrance to this passage is closed by a large stone. Just inside and to the right of the entrance is a small niche wherein reposes a receptacle of gold, which in turn holds an old manuscript. This manuscript contains complete and long-hidden teachings about a mysterious power or force that once was well known and

distributed among the faithful. About the beginning of the fifteenth century the dominant church suppressed such teachings, liquidated all those which the church learned knew of such powers, and destroyed all known manuscripts describing those forces and the methods of attaining them; probably because their priests could not perform the demonstrations of those forces as did the masters. But TRUTH crushed to earth will rise again. Sometime during the period from 1953 to 1955 three lamas or masters, acting in strict accord with ancient practices, will chant before the stone closing the entrance to the above mentioned passage the proper incantation, whereupon the stone will swing aside and give free access to the passage and to the discovery of the priceless manuscript. In such manner will the teachings about the acquirement and use of this great force will again become available for the beneficent use of mankind.

Another thing I wish to bring to your attention, and that refers to conditions existing at your colleges wherein your youth is being taught and prepared for their life work. There will be much scandal and exposure of shocking conditions inimical to to the moral and spiritual welfare of your youth and your country. These conditions and the inculcation of foreign "isms" are causing

your young people to drift towards moral and patriotic ruination unless real effort is made to eliminate such subversive influences. The parlor pinks, reds, and scarlets will keep right on forging ahead unless something drastic is done to eradicate them. It should be borne in mind that there is an invisible government which is the REAL ruler in every country on this earth. It is here in your United States, and the ones the people have been fondly thinking are their rulers are really not the real rulers in fact. That has long been accomplished from behind the scenes.

Fortunately the people are beginning to awake to the true conditions. There are various organizations working under cover, some for good and some for evil, but all are accomplishing much towards changing conditions in the world in general. However, it is only a question of a comparatively short time until the identity of the Hidden Rulers of the World will be clearly exposed and their machinations brought out into the light. This will effectually destroy their power, which heretofore has been highly effective by virtue of its being hidden and unknown to the people.

There is indicated a sort of false prosperity in real estate that may develop during the year of 1940. It will have a tendency to

lull people into thinking that everything is all right, only to be shocked into a realization later of the true facts by the development of a fall. In fact, there is likely to be three such small booms during this year.

Again, I warn that it will be acting the part of wisdom for everyone to purchase only as much as they can pay for, and to keep themselves clear of indebtedness. People will eventually realize that it is an impossibility for either individuals or nations to spend themselves into prosperity.

The people should have a care as to the one to be their next president, as the portents lean towards the entrance of the United States into the war. It is already "planned that way," by the Hidden Rulers already mentioned. It must not be overlooked that war will bring on a dictatorship that will be as rigid as anyone ever read about. Under the power of the act already written your Bill of Rights would be indefinitely suspended—perhaps never to be completely restored.
